BritishOpen Probe Into Nazi Terror

Wife of Kidnaped Writer **Collapses During** Testimony

(Jewish Telegraphic Agency) LONDON, July 11-Public hearings into Nazi terrorism in England and in other countries were opened today under the chairmanship of Hector Hughes, member of the The hearings are King's Court. spnsored by the Bishop of Birmingham, and by a special commission consisting of Prof. J. B. S. Haldane and a number of members of the British Parliament.

The principal witnesses at the hearing today were Mrs. Berthold Jakob, wife of the German-Jewish journalist who was kidnaped by the Nazis in Switzerland, and Mrs. Theodor Lessing, widow of the German-Jewish professor who was as sassinated two years ago by Nazi agents in Czechoslovakia.

Mrs. Jacob Collapses

Mrs. Jacob collapesd as she was testifying at today's hearing. She was not able to continue her testimony, in which she related the details of a visit paid by her fatherin law to the kidnaped journalist in Berlin jail. Mrs. Jakob's story is the first public intimation that Herr Jakob is still alive. After his kidnaping it had been reported that he had been beaten to death in a concentration camp.

Mrs. Lessing calmly related the details of her husband's assassination by Nazi agents in Marienbad in 1933, a few months after he left Germany as a political refugee.

Sao Paulo Acts To Spur Entry Of Foreigners

Brazilian State's New Charter Guarantees Religious Freedom

(Jewish Telegraphic Agency) SAO PAULO, Brazil, July 11-The government of Sao Paulo today

issued a decree which will facilitate a larger immigration into this State. The decree aims to increase colonization in the State.

Racial and religious freedom for the entire population was guaranteed in the new constitution proclaimed yesterday by the govern ment of Sao Paulo.

At the same time it became known today that 101 Integralistes, members of the anti-Semitic Fascist organization of Brazil, most of whom are Germans, left for Germany in order to study Nazi methods on the spot and return later to Brazil as trained Nazi agitators.

Mucio Carneiro Leon of the Journal de Brazil of Ria de Janeiro, and Vaz de Barros of Estado Sao Paulo, left on the Graf Zeppelin for Germany upon special invitation sent to them by the Nazi Party headquarters in Berlin for the purpose of mapping a program of Nazi propaganda in South American coun-

The Brazilian newspaper, A Manha, published a statement that the entire Integraliste expedition is financed by Hitler agents in Brazil.

In connection with the growing Integraliste movement the Navy Department of the Brazil government issued an order forbidding its personnel to belong to the Integraliste party. It is expected that the Minister of War will extend this order to the army.

Lord Melchett Stresses Land's Strategic Importance to Britain

(Jewish Telegraphic Agency)

LONDON, July 11-The hope that Palestine will in the near future be settled with three million Jews and that it will become as important a strategic and economic base as Singapore, was expressed here last night at a banquet attended by more than 600 of the most outstanding Jews in England.

The banquet took place at the Guild Hall and was arranged in conjunction with the campaign now being carried on in England to enable the planting of a forest in Palestine in the name of King George, whose Silver Jubilee is being celebrated throughout the United Kingdom this year. Lord Melchett was chairman.

"With three million loyal and devoted Jews to protect it," Lord Melchett said, "Palestine can become the most valuable link in the great trading route to the Near East and other British possessions. It certainly can be as important to Great Britain as is Singapore at present."

Urged Palestine Restoration

Sir Herbert Samuel, first High Commissioner in Palestine, disclosed the fact in his speech that he advocated the restoration of Palestine to the Jews under British auspices while the World War was at it height.

Soon after Turkey entered the war, Sir Herbert said, he was the first to draw the attention of the British Cabinet to the significance of acquiring Palestine and aiding the Jews to establish their national home there.

LatviaDisbands Parents' Union

Jewish Group Is Held 'Detrimental' to the State

(Jewish Telegraphic Agency)

RIGA, Latvia, July 11—The Jew ish Parents' Union was closed here today by the Minister of the Interior. The reason given is that the existence of this group is "detrimental to the interests of the State."

The action is part of the general policy of the Latvian government to suppress Jewish activities in the country. The Union did not indulge in any political work, limiting itself to Jewish educational activities.

The Union was composed of parents who do not send their children to strictly religious Jewish schools. The present policy of the Latvian government is to entrust Jewish matters only to the Agudath Israel, the extreme orthodox Jewish party.

Denmark Bans Play That Lampoons Hitler

COPENHAGEN July 11-A satiric review lampooning Hitler and his regime in Germany, which was to have been performed at the Royal Theater here, was today banned by the government of Denmark.

The Socialist Minister of Education stated that the reason for banning production of the review is that it attacked the head of a neighboring friendly State.

Will Try Nazis Classing Jews In White Race

Party Members Warned By Beobachter of Consequences

(Jewish Telegraphic Agency)

BERLIN, July 11-Members of the Nazi party heard saying in public that "the Jews also belong to the white race," will be put on trial as untrustworthy elements, the Voelkischer Beobachter, chief organ of the Nazi party, warns to-

"The swastika," the paper writes, is the symbol representing our fight with the Jews."

The Nazi paper harangues at length against those Germans who do not approve of the anti-Jewish persecutions. "To those who claim that there are also decent Jews in existence in Germany, we say that our party is not concerned with decency or indecency of the Jew but against his damaging influence on the life of the German people," the paper writes.

In warning the Nazi members against saying that the Jews belong to the white race, the Voelkischer Beobachter declares that such an allegation is tantamount to admitting that the Jews are blood relations of the "Aryans."

Anti-Semitic 'European Party' Involved in Oran Outbreak

ALGIERS, July 11-The trial of a group of Mohammedans accused of organizing the anti-Jewish pogrom in Constantine last August. during which scores of Jews were killed and many injured, concluded here today. Six of the accused were sentenced to hard labor for terms ranging from three to fifteen years. Three were acquitted.

(Jewish Telegraphic Agency ORAN, Algeria, July 11—Clashes between the anti-Semitic "European Political Party" of Algeria and other organized political groups broke out today in Tiaret, near Oran, resulting in the serious wounding of one person and light injuries to another.

During the clashes, a Jew, it is charged, fired his revolver. police intervened in time to prevent the clashes from developing into a serious outbreak.

The police authorities in Oran, disturbed by the fight in Tiaret, have started an investigation into the causes of the disturbances. The authorities in Algeria are anxious to check any possible outbreaks in order to prevent anti-Jewish riots on a large scale similar to the one which took place last year in Constantine and in other sections of

An Experiment in Microcosm

DANZIG T HAS BEEN the proud boast of Danzig's Nazis that, forbidden by the treaties to rejoin the Reich and surrender its status as a Free City under League of Nations auspices, Danzig has nevertheless been a Germany in miniature, that the Nazi program in Germany has been duplicated in Danzig in microcosm.

To an extent that has been true. Danzig's Nazi rulers gave the city a reign of terror restrained from reaching the limits

League's High Commissioner and been torn by Poland's demand for Commissioner - General. They brutally crushed all minority opposition at the same time paying lip service to the Danzig constitution. They adopted Nazi measures throughout. Non-Nazi administrators and civil servants were unceremoniously ousted to be replaced by Nazis. The Danzig Senate became a helpless replica of the Reichstag. The public debt increased alarmingly, trade decreased, commerce had to submit to strangling restrictions as the Nazi regime struggled to save the gulden and keep the city from bankruptcy.

TODAY, under Nazi rule, the city is bankrupt—a little sooner, perhaps than Germany, but by the same methods as Germany is now following. The Nazi program, zealously imitated here, has just about ruined the city.

Hitler's armament and political program have raised Germany's internal debts alone to almost nine billion dollars. Danzig's coffers have been looted to provide funds for illegal armaments and for political purposes.

IT WOULD BE interesting to follow chronologically, the steps Germany took under Hitler which have been followed by Danzig under the Nazis. The Danzig Nazis followed their masters closely until circumstances took control. Today, Danzig leads the way that Germany tomorrow must inevitably follow.

Just as Germany, through a combination of unfavorable economic factors resulting from the world depression and resentment of the people at the inequalities of the Versailles system, was prepared for Hitler and a Nazi program promising restoration to front rank on all fronts, so was Danzig prepared for Nazism by the combination of unfavorable economic conditions and the desire of the majority to be united again with the Fatherland.

In Danzig, as in Germany, honest patriots were beguiled by Nazism and became its supporters. In Danzig, the desire to become again a part of Germany from which it had

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
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

a gateway to the sea, brought many lovers of Germany into the Hitler fold—to repent later. Dr. Rauschning, the first Nazi president of the Senate, is a case in point.

DR. RAUSCHNING, an honest Danziger, tried to enforce the equality provisions of the Danzig constitution. Disillusioned and shelved by the zealous Nazis, he had the courage to come out openly in the last elections against the Nazi Party ticket. He is now a refugee from Danzig, but he is an example of many honest Danzigers who once supported the Nazis only to have recovered their senses

No one can estimate the position of the Danzig Nazis with certainty today. But I have heard competent observers state that were an election to be held tomorrow, the Nazis would not get the plurality necessary for control, let alone a convincing majority.

Germany's citizens have not yet reached this point. But the experiment in microcosm points the way.

SINCE Dr. Rauschning's ousting, more than 100 Danzig Nazi leaders have left the party. They represent the moderate element, the Danzig burgher. Most important was the resignation of Herr von Wunck as president of the Danzig Diet and as member of the Nazi His resignation was ac-Party. companied by a statement of lack of confidence in the Nazi policy pursued in Danzig and his refusal to sanction illegal expenditures for armaments and political purposes.

The Nazi Party in Danzig, even the most loyal members will assert, is in a serious position. The "respectable" element is rapidly quitting it, leaving it to such typical Nazis are Arthur Greiser, the Senate president, who can solemnly swear adherence to the constitution at Geneva and hasten home to violate every clause in it guaranteeing the rights of individuals.

The same process, I am coninced, is being duplicated in Germany, but more slowly and, of course, far less spectacularly. One does not announce disagreement with Hitler and openly resign from the partly unless one is tired of life or prefers a concentration camp to the amenities of home.

Today Danzig is struggling with a full-fledged currency crisis such as only Dr. Schacht's prestidigatations have been able to stave off in Germany. The gulden has been devalued. A "banking holiday" has almost ruined Danzig's commerce and currency regulations stricter than Germany's are spelling the dom of hundreds of Danzig commercial enterprises.

ONE result of Nazi methods in meeting a crisis forced by the Nazi program has been to arouse Poland to reprisal measures. If Danzig merchants are not allowed to pay Polish merchants for Polish merchandise, then Polish merchants must be paid in Poland in advance for shipments to Danzig. If Danzig debtors are not to be allowed to pay Polish debts, then they can have no more credit.

And a Danziger travelling to Poland on business, finds that a ticket bought and paid for in Danzig will only take him as far as one of five border towns. Danzig's dictators won't allow the propor-(Continued on Page Three)

Syria Again The French government has

again invited Jewish organizations to promote settlement of Jews in Syria. This time the invitation is extended by none other than the French Colonial Under-Secretary, M. Candace.

When the French High Commissioner in Syria extended a similar invitation to the Jews several months ago he attached certain reservations to it. He demanded that the Jews who settle in Syria first of all refrain from spreading Zionist propaganda. He stipulated that the settlers must learn the Arabic language. He warned that no Jewish settlement will be permitted in the Syrian regions neighboring Palestine.

The invitation by the French Colonial Under-Secretary contains no such reservations. On the contrary, the French official makes it clear that his government will assist Jewish immigration and colonization in Syria along the same lines as the British government does in Palestine.

Large Acceptance Doubtful

Nevertheless, it is doubtful whether a substantial number of Jews will take advantage of the French invitation. Much as the present immigration to Palestine does not consist of idealists, there is, however, the hope entertained by every immigrant to Palestine that sooner or later this country will become a Jewish National Home.

No such hope can, however, be entertained with regard to Syria. Jews settling in Syria will feel themselves strangers there for a long time. They will be settled in Syria but their eyes will be turned toward Palestine, the neighboring country, where Jews feel themselves perfectly at home in every respect.

But Offer Is Not in Vain

Although the inducement for settling in Syria is not exceptionally attractive it would, however, be a mistake to think that the repeated offer of the French government will be entirely in vain. There may not be a large Jewish immigration to Syria but certain groups of Jews, especially German Jews, will no doubt be interested in the French offer. Some of them are already interested.

There are today groups of German Jews who are seriously considering plans to develop certain industries in Syria and to invest their capital there since they find no fields for investing it in Palestine. A group of German Jews is already publishing a German-Jewish newspaper in Sy-This newspaper, a supplement to a local Syrian-Arab daily, is devoted entirely to Jewish life in Palestine and in Germany and is sold even among German Jews in Palestine. Stimulating the Palestine Govt.

The invitation by the French government-whether or not it is accepted by some Jewish groups -may well spur the Palestine government, which is anxious to prevent the transfer of Jewish capital from Palestine to Syria, into taking a greater interest in developing Jewish agriculture and industry in Palestine. Partly, this is already being done by the Palestine government, which is now seeking ways and means to secure favorable trade agree-

ments with other countries. It is not a secret any longer that the Palestine government is ambitious to develop four large cities in the Holy Land, each of which would have a population of 250,000. These four cities are to serve as the industrial backbone of the country. Three of these

World Press Diges

Even Newsboys Must Be 'Aryan'

The London Times, commenting on the revival of anti-Jewish activities in Germany, says:

The fact that the publication of the special anti-Jewish number of the Westdeutscher Beobachter was understood to have been delayed until after the visit of Sir John Simon and Mr. Eden to Berlin suggests that the revival is not entirely unconscious. A hitherto unrecorded development is that, the Reich Press Chamber having deprived "non-Aryan" newsvendors of their livelihoods, the Reich Chamber of Writing (or Literature) recently informed several thousands of Jewish writers that they were not fit to write or publish books in National-Socialist Germany.

'Non-Aryans' Come To London to Wed

A British marriage clerk relates in the London Daily Express how Germans come to England from Nazi Germany to marry "non-Aryans." He writes as follows:

"Germans or any other nationals may qualify for marriage in this country to fifteen days' residence put in by one of the parties to the marriage in the area where the marriage is to take

"After establishing fifteen days" residence, and as long as the other party to the ceremony is in England, a declaration may be made, and the marriage take place by license within one clear

"I have personally married scores of German couples. They have told me that because of Jewish blood in a grandparent they have been forbidden the right to wed in Germany.

"Immediately after the ceremony they have left again for

"The word seems to have gone round in Germany, for there are hotels in my district and in others cartering specially for German bride visitors. An interprefer is always available, and the preliminaries are accomplished with his aid."



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Boycott Slashed Reich Exports Here 49%

Steep Decline In Sales to U.S. Dates 3 Years

World Exports in Same Time Off 37%, Anti-Nazi Body States

German export to the United States have slumped forty-nine per cent in the last three years.

The Reich's world exports have taken a dip of thirty-seven per cent in the same period.

These are, in brief, the fruits of which anti-Nazis boycott throughout the world have waged against the regime in power in Germany today. The results of the boycott are covered in a statistical report made public yesterday by Non-Sectarian Anti-Nazi League, covering German trade for 1932, 1933, 1934 and the first part of 1935.

The report reveals that German exports of cotton textiles hase dropped seventy-five per cent. But other figures are even more start-

Toy Trade Hard Hit

For instance, the once thriving German toy export trade has been cut by eighty-five per cent.

German fur exports have suffered a sixty per cent decline.

In a statement accompanying the report, the Anti-Nazi League says: "These figures amply prove the success of the boycott. If more proof is needed, it is furnished by Mr. Schacht himself, the financial dictator of Germany, who has admitted that Nazism stands or falls with the success or failure of Germany's export trade.

"He has resorted to means which no government has been known to use during peace-time, that is, depriving the industries of the entire country of their profits for the purpose of raising an export fund of one billion marks, avowedly in order to subsidize the efforts of German manufacturers to dump their products abroad at any price.

"It seems, however," the statement continues, "that Mr. Schacht omits one fact from consideration. He may succeed in taking all the profits from German industries and rule Germany. have the export industries attempt to sell their goods at any price. However, he may scarcely expect to to succeed in finding outside of Germany a sufficient number of people who would be willing to bargain their reaction to the Nazi system of barbarism for cheap

Hitler Years Compared

In the report, for the purpose of marks. comparison, the first four months of 1932, the pre-Hitler year, are comparison, the first four months of

of the subsequent years. The total exports for that period in 1932 were \$28,000,000. In 1933 there was a precipitous drop to \$20,500,000 and in 1934 there was what superfically appeared to be a rise to \$25,750,000. But, it was pointed out, the United States meanwhile went off the gold standard and the figures for 1935 and 1935 represent devalued dollars.

Allowing for a forty per cent devaluation, the corrected export figure for the first four months of **1934** is \$15,500,000, showing an actual drop in exports from the 1933 figure. And in that period in 1935, there was a further decrease to \$15,000,000 (corrected figure).

Conference to Plan **Colonization Body**

Jewish Organizations to Meet In London July 21 to Map International Unit

LONDON, July 11-A conference for the purpose of creating an in ternational organization to promote Jewish overseas colonization in countries presenting favorable conditions for large-scale Jewish settlement, will be held here July 21.

Sponsors of the so-called "Frailand movement" will meet at the conference to seek a common basis for operations and the creation of an international organization. Among the organizations participating will be the Jewish Territorial League of Poland; the Ligue de Colonization Juive, of France, and the League for Jewish Colonization of England.

After assurances that "I am neither a Fascist nor a Nazi. I do not approve of concentration camps, or of Jew-baiting, or of sabre-rattling,' Dean Inge, in his weekly article in the London Evening Standard, reports the following blessing in Germany:

"The strong point in Nazism is the abolition of class-jealousies. From all accounts, the employers and employed fraternize in Germany s they never did before. When we remember the extreme bitterness of German Socialism, this is a great achievement. people are really in good heart after many years of despair and misery. And they have made a great effort to clean up certain unsavoury corners of their moral stable which had long been a reproach to German civilization."

Expressing the pious hope that the Nazi regime may not go on much longer, he nevertheless finds it necessary in order to preserve the peace.
