Secret Rites Are Staged For Dreyfus

Family Members Only Ones Present at Paris Funeral

(Jewish Telegraphic Agency) PARIS, July 14-Secret rites marked the funeral of Col. Alfred Dreyfus here today. He was laid to rest in the presence of the members of his family only.

Fearing possible untoward incidents, a report was spread throughout the city that the funeral was being postponed. At the same time the family of the deceased was urged by the authorities to effectuate the rites in strict secrecy.

There is great speculation here as to the contents of the Dreyfus memoirs and the revelations contained therein. According to the Dreyfus will, the memoirs which he wrote during the latter years of his life are to be published now that he is dead.

The family of Col. Dreyfus is receiving messages of condolence from all over the world.

The entire French press devotes lengthy reviews to the Dreyfus affair. It praises Dreyfus editorially for the reserve which he showed after the affair was over.

The anti-Semitic daily L'action Francaise is the only newspaper to publish an anti-Dreyfus article. The paper accuses Dreyfus of having been a slacker during the last war, and asserts that he allegedly confessed treason.

Reich Today Compared With Dreyfus Case

LONDON, July 14-The Jewish situation in Germany today was compared with the Dreyfus case by Leonard Montefiore, President of the Anglo-Jewish Association.

Addressing a meeting of the Association, Mr. Montefiore declared that while Dreyfus was only one innocent victim of anti-Semitism, there are today a half-million such victims in the Reich.

(Jewish Telegraphic Agency) SALONICA, July 14—A bill, providing that authors of anti-Semitic articles and editors of papers wherein these articles appear shall be penalized, was approved by the Parliamentary Committee here yesterday and was publicized in today's press.

The bill is regarded as one of the most important pro-Jewish steps, in view of the fact that most of the anti-Jewish attacks here were instigated by inciting articles appearing in the local anti-Semitic press.

Norway Urges League Ponder Refugee Aid

International Agreement On Problem Is Also Put Forward

(Tewish Telegraphic Agency) OSLO, July 14-A proposal that the problem of the German Jewish refugees should be placed on the agenda of the next session of the League of Nations was made by the Norwegian government to the Secretariat of the League, it was disclosed today by M. Koht, Foreign Minister.

At the same time the government has also proposed an international agreement on this problem, the minister added. This agreement, if accepted, will have the effect of a general regulation for dealing with all refugees. The agreement aims to place the refugees under the direct protection of the League of Nations.

Dr. Christian Lange, the Norwegian representative to the League of Nations, and Nobel prize winner, was inscribed today by the Jews of Norway into the Golden Book of the Jewish National Fund, in recognition of his humanitarian ideas in dealing with the Jewish questions coming before the League of Nations.

Only two Norwegians have so far had their names inscribed in the Golden Book of the Jewish National Fund.

Nazi Attack Is Repulsed; Arrest Jews

Storm Troopers Bearing Clubs Trounced by War Veterans

(Jewish Telegraphic Agency) BERLIN, July 14-A free-for-all fight between Jews and Nazis took place here when Nazi Storm Troop ers invaded a meeting of Jewish War Veterans and made an attempt to attack the participants in the assembly.

The Nazis, though armed with truncheons, suffered a defeat. Twelve Jews were arrested as a result of the fight. Not a single Nazi was taken into custody.

A suggestion that the death penalty should be introduced for Jews who will rent their houses to "Aryans" or who will employ non-Jewish servants and engage non-Jewish lawyers or doctors is made in an article sent out by the Nazi Partei Korrespondenz, the official press syndicate of the Nazi

New Drive Seen

The article hints that a new drive against Jews will soon be started on the pretext of alleged sexual crimes which are supposedly violating the racial principals of the Reich.

Bill Is Aimed At Polish Jews

Measure Would Oust Them From Role In Commerce

(Jewish Telegraphic Agency) WARSAW, July 14-Jewish business circles in Poland were greatly perturbed today over the news that a bill will be introduced in the Po-

business men.

The bill would require that person in Poland shall be permit ted to conduct a business enterprise unless he obtains a special certificate, which would be granted to him by the authorities on the basis of educational qualifications and good behavior. A minimum capital investment will also have to be proved before the certificate is issued.

The bill is sponsored by the Union of Polish Merchants. It aims definitely to oust Jews from com-

So great is the anxiety among Jewish business men over this proposed bill that a special conference of Jewish merchants will take place shortly to consider measures of combatting it. A decision to call such a conference was adopted today upon the initiative of leading Jewish business men in Warsaw.

Gatherings Are Ruled By Office in Hamburg

(Jewish Telegraphic Agency) HAMBURG, July 14—A registration office for Jewish meetings was formed today under the chairmanship of the Hamburg Jewish Community.

All Jewish meetings of any kind will have to be registered with this office, which will be the intermediary between the State authorities and the existing Jewish organizations. The meetings will have to be held on the premises of the Jewish Community building. Meetings of organizations in private buildings will be forbidden.

RegistryDenied To State Party In Palestine

Demands for Majority And Old Boundaries Cited in Refusal

JERUSALEM, July 14-The Palestine government yesterday notified the Jewish State Party that it does not see its way clear to registering it as one of the legally existing political parties in the coun-

"Unless the Jewish State Party eliminates from its platform the demands for a Jewish majority in Palestine as a Jewish state on the basis of its historic boundaries, the Jewish State Party could not be registered by the Palestine administration," the notification of the government stated.

A convention of the Jewish State Party in Palestine which was supposed to have taken place in connection with the forthcoming World Zionist Congress was prohibited by the Palestine authorities on the pretext that the party was not registered with the governmet.

Tne formalities for a registration for the Jewish State Party were completed a year ago. The reply received today from the govern ment provoked great surprise not only among the adherents of the Jewish State Party but also among the entire Jewish population.

Thousands Put to Work In Crimea

Mobilize Farmers to Get Collectives Crops Harvested

(Jewish Telegraphic Agency) MOSCOW, July 14—The entire population in the collective Jewish farms in Crimea was mobilized today for harvesting the new crop, which is expected to be the most bountiful ever produced by Jews in

In view of the shortage of farmhands, all Jewish farmers and their families will be living in the fields during the harvest period. Special tents are now being pitched to accommodate the Jewish workers with lodging, dining facilities and recreation.

The mass removal from the colonies into the fields will start within the next few days. The Crimean authorities are also making arrangements for an open-air theater in the fields, where the Jewish colonists will enjoy concerts and dramatic presentations given by artists of the Jewish theaters in Moscow, Kharkov and Kiev.

The Comzet, the government committee to settle Jews on the land, has now worked out a plan for the settlement in Crimea of the rest of the declassed Jews of the Winnitza region. This region, located in the Ukraine, is particularly known for its large number of declassed Jews.

The Comzet has decided that half of the quota assigned for new Jewish colonists in Crimea this vear should be allocated to Jews from Winnitza.

Local authorities in this region were instructed today by Moscow, to give every assistance possible to Jews who desire to proceed to Crimea.

The Comzet has at the same time sent instructions to its representatives in the Winnitza sector to organize further emigration.

Can Germany Last?

LONDON.

WHEN the Nazi regime came to power, far-sighter observers predicted that financial, not political, factors, would prove its chief stumbling block and that it would continue to hold the

reins of power just so long as it 4. other to avoid a day of reckoning.

Germany's political victories and advances in foreign affairs, spectacular and comforting though they may be to the Nazis, have not been accompanied by any improvement in the financial condition. The rapidly worsening financial situation, aggravated by towering expenditures for armaments and employment works, is getting out of control. There is no question about that.

CONSERVATIVE estimates put Germany's unfunded internal loans at five billion dollars. More accurate estimates are likely to put this total in excess of nine billion dollars. Much of this is believed to be in the shape of short-term loans.

What the exact position is, no one, possibly not even Dr. Schacht can say with certainty. It is stated officially that the Reich budget for 1934-35 has been balanced. this balancing counts as revenue, the proceeds of a bond issue of \$365,000,000. And it is a well-known fact that the ordinary budget of the Reich does not include the tremendous expenditures for armaments and most of the amounts expended for the public works program to furnish the employment Hitler promised Germany's jobless millions. Most of these expenditures are charged to various state institutions and agencies.

IN RECENT months, forced loans have been relied upon by the government for income. Insurance companies and banks have had to subscribe \$4,000,000. Householders, instead of getting a reduction in taxes, have had to pay the higher rate to accept "Certificates" for difference—a total οf \$2,000,000,000 more for the government.

Industry, as has been previously reported, has had to submit to an arbitrary assessment of two to three percent of its total business within Germany in order to provide funds for Schacht's desperate expedient of financing a dumping program abroad. A fund of \$250,000,000, it is estimated, has been raised by this "voluntary"



> THE GOLD Discount Bank, for instance, according to the London Times, has increased its capital by 200,000,000 reichsmarks (about \$80,000,000). This sum was taken over by the Reichsbank in return for fixed-interest bearing securities from its own holdings. At the same time, according to The Times, the Gold Discount Bank was authorized to issue three-month promissory notes which the capital increase was meant to cover.

"It was then announced that the Gold Discount Bank would use the proceeds of the promissory note issue to take up 'employment scheme bills' from the Reichsbank. extent of credit elasticity that can be obtained on the nominal working foundation of 200,000,000 marks cannot be estimated, but it is understood that over 250,000,000 marks worth of 'employment scheme bills' with which by this time bills creating employment through rearmament orders must be considered identical."

With regard to external obligations, the Reichsbank has had to announce that the moratorium on cash transfers for foreign debt payments will be extended from June 30, when it was to have expired, for another year. This announcement was not unexpected since Dr. Schacht's determination not to allow any funds to leave the country for any purpose other than armaments or Nazi propaganda had long been recognized.

GERMANY'S position will be further complicated by the expiration on July 15 of her trade agrement with France. If negotiations for a renewal of the agreement are not successful, Germany will lose an important source of raw materials as well as a market which has proven profitable for many of her industries.

Within Germany, the ruthless subordination of everything to the determination of the Nazi leaders to make Germany an invincible war-machine is having its effects.

Industrial enterprises, suffering from the difficulty of obtaining raw materials, the loss of foreign markets and the fast-dwindling purchasing power of the home markets, and the excessive levies and taxes they have to meet, are fast approaching a parlous state. The metal industries in particular suffer seriously from high prices for raw materials caused by the shrinkage of imports.

THE COST of living has increased and is increasing further. while the wage level is being further degraded. According to official figures, the amount of wages paid in Germany has greatly increased—but the individual wages (Continued on Page Three)

Warning to Zionist Congress It seems that the Palestine government has definitely made up its mind not to permit any proganda in Palestine for a Jewish majority there. This can be seen from the fact that the Jewish State Party was refused registration by the government on the basis that it demands a Jewish majority and "Palestine on both

sides of the Jordan." With the nineteenth World Zionist Congress opening next month in Lucerne, this outspoken attitude of the Palestine government looks like a warning to the Congress that nothing can induce the Palestine administration to open Transjordan to Jews. It also serves as notice that the Palestine government is far from permitting the Jews to become a

majority in Palestine.

It is difficult to understand why the government should refuse the legalization of the Jewish State Party on the grounds that it demands a Jewish majority in the country and the restoration of Palestine along historical boundaries, when it permits the existence of Arab political parties whose platforms include a demand for the creation of a Federation of Arab countries.

It seems to me that the propaganda conducted by the Arabs to have Palestine as a link in the chain of a federation of Moslem lands is more dangerous to the interests of the Palestine government than the propaganda to reunite Palestine with Transjordan.

Challenging Jewish Aspirations

The refusal to register the Jewish State Party as a legal party in Palestine is contradictory to the spirit of freedom of speech in that country. The Jewish State Party in Palestine is today not one of the major parties. It has no large following. It certainly is not a party which preaches violence.

The refusal ot register it is, therefore, not a challenge to this particular party but to the Jewish demand for a larger immigration into Palestine and for the restoration of Transjordan as a part of Palestine.

The official reasons given for the refusal to register the party is the best argument as to why Jews must oppose the establishment of a legislative council in Palestine. A council which will be composed of Arabs and officials of the Palestine government will not only prevent the Jews from ever attaining a majority in Palestine but will pass all kinds of legislation to keep the Jews in a national minority status, no matter how large the Jewish immigration to Palestine may be.

Serious Rumors

Rumors now coming from London indicate that while Zionist leaders are on the one hand urging the Jews of the world to fight the establishment of a legislative council in Palestine, they are on the other hand preparing the ground to enter this council.

If these rumors are correct, then certain Zionist leaders involved will eventually be put in the same position as the shepherd who constantly cried "wolf." Their word will not be taken seriously by Jews in many countries, even at a time when the danger is real. One cannot organize opposition against the legislative council and later change one's mind and join the council.

The political situation in Palestine is such that the mobilization of Jewish forces throughout the world will be necessary more than once. In mobilizing the Jews of the world now to fight the legislative council, the Zionist leaders must once and forever

Dies Alien Bill Is Ridiculed

The New York Daily News, in an editorial criticizing the bill to deport unnaturalized aliens from the United States, says:

The height of the silly season being just about here, today seems as good a time as any to say a few words on the subject of the deport-6,000,000-unnaturalized-aliens bill introduced in Congress by Representative Martin Dies (Dem., Tex.).

Dies' bill provides for just that the firing out of this country of some 6,000,000 foreigners who have not taken steps toward naturalization fast enough to suit Dies.

Dies argues that to deport these people would solve our unemployment problem, by ridding us of 12,000,0400 hands which now have or want work on our farms or in our factories. 

This, curiously enough, has not esulted in much more than grumbling, partly because of the Messianic fervor with which Hitler has inculcated large numbers of the German people. The willingness to sacrifice is still strong.

Dr. Ley, leader of the Labor Front, staved off much dissatisfaction early in May with promises of increased pay for workers. Dr. Ley's speech, however, led to his 'going on leave" with his return to power problematical. The financial powers were not and are not in favor of wage increases.

SEVERAL STRIKES in industrial concerns against law wages "contributions" numerous have to be paid before the worker takes his envelope home, have been zar Eckstein, member of the board reported, but industrial unrest has not yet reached the point where it can be considered serious.

United Front For Boycott Drive Asked

A.J.C. Sends Letter to Anti-Nazi League on the Proposition

The American Jewish Congress boycott committee has addressed a letter to Samuel Untermyer, president of the Non-Sectarian Anti-Nazi League to Champion Human Rights, calling for coordination of boycott activities of the two organizations, it was announced yesterday.

The request for a united front was made after a decision reached by the A.J.C. boycott committee. The letter was signed by Dr. Joseph Tenenbaum, chairman.

The letter emphasized that the break-down of the boycott movement in Poland placed an additional responsibility on anti-Nazi forces in the United States.

"It is greatly to be deplored," the letter said, "that after two years of intensive boycott work, the country at large, outside of New York, is totally disorganized.

"I personally have felt from the outset that we cannot afford to split our forces, especially in view of the extensive resources of the German government and the lukewarm response of the non-Jewish population of the United States."

The police authorities today closed the cattle market in Fulda on the allegation that "Jewish cattle dealers were demanding preposterous prices and provoked unrest at the market."

Richard Strauss, distinguished composer, resigned yesterday as president of the Third Reich's Music Chamber. He said he was stepping out because of "advanced age" but it was no secret that his withdrawal was a result of politics.

Zweig's Part Resented

When Strauss's latest opera, "The Silent Woman," was presented at Dresden three weeks ago Nazi leaders were significantly absent. This, it was understood, was traceable directly to their resentment over his retention of Stefan Zweig, renowned Jewish author, to write the libretto for the opera.

Production of "The Silent Woman" provoked a fight in Nazi ranks between factions of Dr. Paul Joseph Goebbels, Propaganda Minister, and Dr. Alfred Rosenberg, philosophic dictator and pagan faith

Goebbels permitted the presentation of the opera, apparently fearing an international scandal if he refused, but Rosenberg opposed this action vigorously.

Ousted Instructor Calls Student House Nest Of Nazi Activity

(Special to the J.D.B.) NEW BRUNSWICK, N. J., July 14-Dr. Lienhard Bergel, former German instructor at the New Jersey State College for Women, charged that the German student house on the college campus is a center of Nazi propaganda, in concluding his testimony yesterday before a trustees' committee investigating alleged Hitlerite activities at the college.

Dr. Bergel reiterated the accusation which brought about the probe-that he had failed to secure reappointment as a German instructor because of opposition to the views of Dr. Frederick J. Hauptmann, head of the German Department.

He said he would have pressed the matter until he got a reasonable explanation, whether or not he were successful in obtaining a position elsewhere.

Dr. Hauptmann testified he had dropped Dr. Bergel for incom-

The committee adjourned until Wednesday. Until now, 108 witnesses have been heard. Their testimony it estimated at 1,000,000 words.

Asked by a Jewish Daily Bulletin reporter how long he thought the hearings would continue, Dr. Ashmead, who is in charge of the investigation, said they would go on until all witnesses had been heard. He could not estimate how long this would take.

12,000 Acres in Cyprus Held By Jews Despite British Policy

(Jewish Telegraphic Agency) LONDON .- Much interest has Palestine and the Near East, came been aroused here by a report from Famagusta in the Morning Post that, according to information obtained from the Land Registry Office, land held by Jews in Cyprus now amounts to some 12,000 acres, representing an investment of about £72,000 (\$360,000).

About half of this land, according to the Morning Post, was taken over by new companies and immigrants from unsuccessful Jewish

Although the land was acquired at an average price of £6 (\$30) per acre—the prevailing price for cereal land-it is really worth far more, according to the newspaper's correspondent, since it is well situated near water-supply and is suitable for orange planting.

Orange growing land usually sells for £30 (\$150) per acre in Cyprus. What makes these figures interesting is that only recently the new Secretary for the Colonies, in his
