Secret Rites Are Staged For Dreyfus

**Family Members Only
Ones Present at
Paris Funeral**

(Jewish Telegraphic Agency)

PARIS, July 14—Secret rites marked the funeral of Col. Alfred Dreyfus here today. He was laid to rest in the presence of the members of his family only.

Fearing possible untoward incidents, a report was spread throughout the city that the funeral was being postponed. At the same time the family of the deceased was urged by the authorities to effectuate the rites in strict secrecy.

There is great speculation here as to the contents of the Dreyfus memoirs and the revelations contained therein. According to the Dreyfus will, the memoirs which he wrote during the latter years of his life are to be published now that he is dead.

The family of Col. Dreyfus is receiving messages of condolence from all over the world.

The entire French press devotes lengthy reviews to the Dreyfus affair. It praises Dreyfus editorially for the reserve which he showed after the affair was over.

The anti-Semitic daily L'action Francaise is the only newspaper to publish an anti-Dreyfus article. The paper accuses Dreyfus of having been a slacker during the last war, and asserts that he allegedly confessed treason.

Reich Today Compared With Dreyfus Case

LONDON, July 14—The Jewish situation in Germany today was compared with the Dreyfus case by Leonard Montefiore, President of the Anglo-Jewish Association.

Addressing a meeting of the Association, Mr. Montefiore declared that while Dreyfus was only one innocent victim of anti-Semitism, there are today a half-million such victims in the Reich.

"World conscience," Mr. Montefiore said, "was shocked by the fate of Col. Dreyfus on Devil's Island. But today, the conscience of the world seems to be hardened by the suffering of innocents. However, just as the outcome of the Dreyfus case brought relief, we

Salonica Law to Punish Anti-Semitic Writers

SALONICA, July 14—A bill, providing that authors of anti-Semitic articles and editors of papers wherein these articles appear shall be penalized, was approved by the Parliamentary Committee here yesterday and was publicized in today's press.

The bill is regarded as one of the most important pro-Jewish steps, in view of the fact that most of the anti-Jewish attacks here were instigated by inciting articles appearing in the local anti-Semitic press.

Norway Urges League Ponder Refugee Aid

**International Agreement
On Problem Is Also
Put Forward**

(Jewish Telegraphic Agency)

OSLO, July 14—A proposal that the problem of the German Jewish refugees should be placed on the agenda of the next session of the League of Nations was made by the Norwegian government to the Secretariat of the League, it was disclosed today by M. Koht, Foreign Minister.

At the same time the government has also proposed an international agreement on this problem, the minister added. This agreement, if accepted, will have the effect of a general regulation for dealing with all refugees. The agreement aims to place the refugees under the direct protection of the League of Nations.

Dr. Christian Lange, the Norwegian representative to the League of Nations, and Nobel prize winner, was inscribed today by the Jews of Norway into the Golden Book of the Jewish National Fund, in recognition of his humanitarian ideas in dealing with the Jewish questions coming before the League of Nations.

Only two Norwegians have so far had their names inscribed in the Golden Book of the Jewish National Fund.

Jewish Parties May Join For Elections in Poland

WARSAW, July 14—All non-Socialist Jewish parties in Poland, including the Zionist Party, are likely to participate in the elections to the new Polish parliament in a united front, it was stated today in reliable sources.

Nazi Attack Is Repulsed; Arrest Jews

**Storm Troopers Bearing
Clubs Trowned by
War Veterans**

BERLIN, July 14—A free-for-all fight between Jews and Nazis took place here when Nazi Storm Troopers invaded a meeting of Jewish War Veterans and made an attempt to attack the participants in the assembly.

The Nazis, though armed with truncheons, suffered a defeat. Twelve Jews were arrested as a result of the fight. Not a single Nazi was taken into custody.

A suggestion that the death penalty should be introduced for Jews who will rent their houses to "Aryans" or who will employ non-Jewish servants and engage non-Jewish lawyers or doctors is made in an article sent out by the Nazi Partei Korrespondenz, the official press syndicate of the Nazi party.

New Drive Seen

The article hints that a new drive against Jews will soon be started on the pretext of alleged sexual crimes which are supposedly violating the racial principals of the Reich.

The Stuermer, the notorious anti-Jewish publication of which Julius Streicher is editor, published yesterday the first list of alleged "Jewish violators of the racial laws of Germany."

A new list of 95 Jews whose naturalization was revoked in different cities of the Reich was made

Bill Is Aimed At Polish Jews

**Measure Would Oust
Them From Role
In Commerce**

(Jewish Telegraphic Agency)

WARSAW, July 14—Jewish business circles in Poland were greatly perturbed today over the news that a bill will be introduced in the Polish parliament which, if it passes, will be the greatest blow to Jewish business men.

The bill would require that no person in Poland shall be permitted to conduct a business enterprise unless he obtains a special certificate, which would be granted to him by the authorities on the basis of educational qualifications and good behavior. A minimum capital investment will also have to be proved before the certificate is issued.

The bill is sponsored by the Union of Polish Merchants. It aims definitely to oust Jews from commerce.

So great is the anxiety among Jewish business men over this proposed bill that a special conference of Jewish merchants will take place shortly to consider measures of combatting it. A decision to call such a conference was adopted today upon the initiative of leading Jewish business men in Warsaw.

Gatherings Are Ruled By Office in Hamburg

HAMBURG, July 14—A registration office for Jewish meetings was formed today under the chairmanship of the Hamburg Jewish Community.

All Jewish meetings of any kind will have to be registered with this office, which will be the intermediary between the State authorities and the existing Jewish organizations. The meetings will have to be held on the premises of the Jewish Community building. Meetings of organizations in private buildings will be forbidden.

Registry Denied To State Party In Palestine

**Demands for Majority
And Old Boundaries
Cited in Refusal**

JERUSALEM, July 14—The Palestine government yesterday notified the Jewish State Party that it does not see its way clear to registering it as one of the legally existing political parties in the country.

"Unless the Jewish State Party eliminates from its platform the demands for a Jewish majority in Palestine as a Jewish state on the basis of its historic boundaries, the Jewish State Party could not be registered by the Palestine administration," the notification of the government stated.

A convention of the Jewish State Party in Palestine which was supposed to have taken place in connection with the forthcoming World Zionist Congress was prohibited by the Palestine authorities on the pretext that the party was not registered with the government.

The formalities for a registration for the Jewish State Party were completed a year ago. The reply received today from the government provoked great surprise not only among the adherents of the Jewish State Party but also among the entire Jewish population.

Thousands Put to Work In Crimea

**Mobilize Farmers to Get
Collectives' Crops
Harvested**

(Jewish Telegraphic Agency)

MOSCOW, July 14—The entire population in the collective Jewish farms in Crimea was mobilized today for harvesting the new crop, which is expected to be the most bountiful ever produced by Jews in that region.

In view of the shortage of farmhands, all Jewish farmers and their families will be living in the fields during the harvest period. Special tents are now being pitched to accommodate the Jewish workers with lodging, dining facilities and recreation.

The mass removal from the colonies into the fields will start within the next few days. The Crimean authorities are also making arrangements for an open-air theater in the fields, where the Jewish colonists will enjoy concerts and dramatic presentations given by artists of the Jewish theaters in Moscow, Kharkov and Kiev.

The Comzet, the government committee to settle Jews on the land, has now worked out a plan for the settlement in Crimea of the rest of the declassified Jews of the Winnitza region. This region, located in the Ukraine, is particularly known for its large number of declassified Jews.

The Comzet has decided that half of the quota assigned for new Jewish colonists in Crimea this year should be allocated to Jews from Winnitza.

Local authorities in this region were instructed today by Moscow to give every assistance possible to Jews who desire to proceed to Crimea.

The Comzet has at the same time sent instructions to its representatives in the Winnitza sector to organize further emigration.

Rabbi Kook Putting Up Staunch Fight for Life

JERUSALEM, July 14—Chief Rabbi Kook, who has been seriously ill here the past few weeks, is carrying on bravely, his doctors report, although his condition is but slightly better.

Gen. Cohen of China Places Orders for War Cotton Goods

MANCHESTER, England, July 14—General Moshe Cohen—the mysterious man of China, the bodyguard of the late Dr. Sun Yat-Sen and the organizing genius behind a dozen Chinese generals—has arrived in England for the purpose of placing orders for large quantities of cotton goods with Lancashire mills, in connection with the Sino-Japanese conflict, it was discovered today.

In interviews with the local press, the Jewish general of China, who was born in London's East End, refused to discuss the exact reason for his visit to England. The presence of the Chinese-Jewish general in England was made known when he paid a visit today to his parents in Manchester.

General Moshe Cohen is credited with training some of China's best fighting units.

Arabs Report Plan to Create Distinct Legislative Councils

JERUSALEM, July 14—The Arab press came out today with a report alleging that if the Jews will not agree to participate in the proposed legislative council, the Palestine government will then establish separate legislative councils, one for Arabs and one for Jews.

The report added that the Palestine government would serve as a link between separate Arab and

Jewish councils should they be established. Little credence is given the report in Jewish circles.

Representatives of the Jewish Agency are now energetically negotiating in London with the Colonial Office to have the entire project of the legislative council postponed.

The matter will be settled one way or another with the arrival in London of Sir Arthur Wauchope, High Commissioner for Palestine, within the next few weeks.

Can Germany Last?

LONDON.

WHEN the Nazi regime came to power, far-sighter observers predicted that financial, not political, factors, would prove its chief stumbling block and that it would continue to hold the reins of power just so long as it managed by one artifice after another to avoid a day of reckoning.

Germany's political victories and advances in foreign affairs, spectacular and comforting though they may be to the Nazis, have not been accompanied by any improvement in the financial condition. The rapidly worsening financial situation, aggravated by the towering expenditures for armaments and employment works, is getting out of control. There is no question about that.

CONSERVATIVE estimates put Germany's unfunded internal loans at five billion dollars. More accurate estimates are likely to put this total in excess of nine billion dollars. Much of this is believed to be in the shape of short-term loans.

What the exact position is, no one, possibly not even Dr. Schacht can say with certainty. It is stated officially that the Reich budget for 1934-35 has been balanced. But this balancing counts as revenue, the proceeds of a bond issue of \$365,000,000. And it is a well-known fact that the ordinary budget of the Reich does not include the tremendous expenditures for armaments and most of the amounts expended for the public works program to furnish the employment Hitler promised Germany's jobless millions. Most of these expenditures are charged to various state institutions and agencies.

IN RECENT months, forced loans have been relied upon by the government for income. Insurance companies and banks have had to subscribe \$4,000,000. Householders, instead of getting a reduction in taxes, have had to pay the higher rate to accept "Certificates" for the difference—a total of \$2,000,000,000 more for the government.

Industry, as has been previously reported, has had to submit to an arbitrary assessment of two to three percent of its total business within Germany in order to provide funds for Schacht's desperate expedient of financing a dumping program abroad. A fund of \$250,000,000, it is estimated, has been raised by this "voluntary" levy.

The Reichsbank and the Gold Discount Bank, it is an open secret, have been involved up to their

necks in all sorts of manipulations to provide cover for the huge drains upon the government finances and coming so close to the straining point that much doubt exists that Schacht's prestidigitations will be able to pull them through the Summer without some form of devaluation.

THE GOLD Discount Bank, for instance, according to the London Times, has increased its capital by 200,000,000 reichsmarks (about \$80,000,000). This sum was taken over by the Reichsbank in return for fixed-interest bearing securities from its own holdings. At the same time, according to The Times, the Gold Discount Bank was authorized to issue three-month promissory notes which the capital increase was meant to cover.

"It was then announced that the Gold Discount Bank would use the proceeds of the promissory note issue to take up 'employment scheme bills' from the Reichsbank. The extent of credit elasticity that can be obtained on the nominal working foundation of 200,000,000 marks cannot be estimated, but it is understood that over 250,000,000 marks worth of 'employment scheme bills' with which by this time bills creating employment through rearmament orders must be considered identical."

THIS is financial juggling of a high order that only Dr. Schacht can conceive. But to a layman, and I suspect to the banker as well, it looks suspiciously like taking out of one pocket to put in another—with the difference that all the transactions are paper. Such measures can only be considered temporary alternatives to forestall a final, inevitable reckoning. "Taking in each other's washing" never provided a solution to any problem.

With regard to external obligations, the Reichsbank has had to announce that the moratorium on cash transfers for foreign debt payments will be extended from June 30, when it was to have expired, for another year. This announcement was not unexpected since Dr. Schacht's determination not to allow any funds to leave the country for any purpose other than armaments or Nazi propaganda had long been recognized.

GERMANY'S position will be further complicated by the expiration on July 15 of her trade agreement with France. If negotiations for a renewal of the agreement are not successful, Germany will lose an important source of raw materials as well as a market which has proven profitable for many of her industries.

Within Germany, the ruthless subordination of everything to the determination of the Nazi leaders to make Germany an invincible war-machine is having its effects.

Industrial enterprises, suffering from the difficulty of obtaining raw materials, the loss of foreign markets and the fast-dwindling purchasing power of the home markets, and the excessive levies and taxes they have to meet, are fast approaching a parlous state. The metal industries in particular suffer seriously from high prices for raw materials caused by the shrinkage of imports.

THE COST of living has increased and is increasing further, while the wage level is being further degraded. According to official figures, the amount of wages paid in Germany has greatly increased—but the individual wages

Warning to Zionist Congress

It seems that the Palestine government has definitely made up its mind not to permit any propaganda in Palestine for a Jewish majority there. This can be seen from the fact that the Jewish State Party was refused registration by the government on the basis that it demands a Jewish majority and "Palestine on both sides of the Jordan."

With the nineteenth World Zionist Congress opening next month in Lucerne, this outspoken attitude of the Palestine government looks like a warning to the Congress that nothing can induce the Palestine administration to open Transjordan to Jews. It also serves as notice that the Palestine government is far from permitting the Jews to become a majority in Palestine.

It is difficult to understand why the government should refuse the legalization of the Jewish State Party on the grounds that it demands a Jewish majority in the country and the restoration of Palestine along historical boundaries, when it permits the existence of Arab political parties whose platforms include a demand for the creation of a Federation of Arab countries.

It seems to me that the propaganda conducted by the Arabs to have Palestine as a link in the chain of a federation of Moslem lands is more dangerous to the interests of the Palestine government than the propaganda to reunite Palestine with Transjordan.

Challenging Jewish Aspirations

The refusal to register the Jewish State Party as a legal party in Palestine is contradictory to the spirit of freedom of speech in that country. The Jewish State Party in Palestine is today not one of the major parties. It has no large following. It certainly is not a party which preaches violence.

The refusal to register it is, therefore, not a challenge to this particular party but to the Jewish demand for a larger immigration into Palestine and for the restoration of Transjordan as a part of Palestine.

The official reasons given for the refusal to register the party is the best argument as to why Jews must oppose the establishment of a legislative council in Palestine. A council which will be composed of Arabs and officials of the Palestine government will not only prevent the Jews from ever attaining a majority in Palestine but will pass all kinds of legislation to keep the Jews in a national minority status, no matter how large the Jewish immigration to Palestine may be.

Serious Rumors

Rumors now coming from London indicate that while Zionist leaders are on the one hand urging the Jews of the world to fight the establishment of a legislative council in Palestine, they are on the other hand preparing the ground to enter this council.

If these rumors are correct, then certain Zionist leaders involved will eventually be put in the same position as the shepherd who constantly cried "wolf." Their word will not be taken seriously by Jews in many countries, even at a time when the danger is real. One cannot organize opposition against the legislative council and later change one's mind and join the council.

The political situation in Palestine is such that the mobilization of Jewish forces throughout the world will be necessary more than once. In mobilizing the Jews of the world now to fight the legislative council, the Zionist leaders must once and forever

Dies Alien Bill Is Ridiculed

The New York Daily News, in an editorial criticizing the bill to deport unnaturalized aliens from the United States, says:

The height of the silly season being just about here, today seems as good a time as any to say a few words on the subject of the deport-6,000,000-unnaturalized-alien bill introduced in Congress by Representative Martin Dies (Dem., Tex.).

Dies' bill provides for just that—the fringing out of this country of some 6,000,000 foreigners who have not taken steps toward naturalization fast enough to suit Dies.

Dies argues that to deport these people would solve our unemployment problem, by ridding us of 12,000,040 hands which now have or want work on our farms or in our factories. He has just sent up a howl to the effect that Federal Immigration Commissioner D. W. McCormack is wickedly flooding the country with propaganda against the bill. McCormack and everybody else who is interested in American business recovery should concern themselves with seeing that the bill dies the death.

To deport 6,000,000 aliens would rid us of 12,000,000 working hands, true. But it would also rid us of:

have been decreased on the average in the neighborhood of thirty-five to forty percent.

This, curiously enough, has not resulted in much more than grumbling, partly because of the Messianic fervor with which Hitler has inculcated large numbers of the German people. The willingness to sacrifice is still strong.

Dr. Ley, leader of the Labor Front, staved off much dissatisfaction early in May with promises of increased pay for workers. Dr. Ley's speech, however, led to his "going on leave" with his return to power problematical. The financial powers were not and are not in favor of wage increases.

SEVERAL STRIKES in industrial concerns against law wages from numerous "contributions" have to be paid before the worker takes his envelope home, have been reported, but industrial unrest has not yet reached the point where it can be considered serious.

In the meantime, the fate of the Nazi regime rests on the relative speeds of the Nazi armaments race and Dr. Schacht's ingenuity in devising schemes to meet its cost. Should the Nazi extremists become heedful of Dr. Schacht's admonitions and temper their plans to the means, the Reichsbank master can furnish, the Nazi regime may coast along for some time. But judging from what has been done to date, this is not likely. Schacht is forced to one expedient after another to "cover up" after the armament orders. How long he can continue is problematical.

There is a report making the rounds that gives an apt idea of what he is up against. Schacht is said to have protested in no mild manner to the pachydermous Goering that the Air Ministry, in the current year alone, had exceeded its budget by over \$290,000,000. To this the ponderous general is said to have replied loftily that the financial side of the business did not concern him in the least.

If this is to be the general attitude of the rulers of the Reich, the day is not far off when inflation will be the rule in Germany. And not even a Hitler can survive an inflation similar to the post-war days.

Dreyfus' Innocence Stressed In Comments of U. S. Papers

The metropolitan press and newspapers throughout the country, in paying tribute to Col. Alfred Dreyfus, emphasized his innocence of the espionage charges which resulted in his incarceration on Devil's Island.

"There never was a particle of genuine evidence against Captain Alfred Dreyfus," says the New York Times. "Yet he was twice convicted of high treason."

"In 1894 the court-martial of Paris, knowing him to be innocent, found him guilty and sentenced him to imprisonment for life in a fortified place, which an ex post facto law designated as Devil's Island."

The New York Herald-Tribune regards the story of Col. Dreyfus as "one of the most tragic in the history of human injustice."

"At the age of thirty-five," the newspaper says, "already bearing honors which none of his race had achieved in the French army, he was publicly branded a traitor to his country, convicted of high treason, stripped of his military trappings and sent to Devil's Island, the most notorious penal colony of modern times . . ."

"The bitterest drop in the Dreyfus cup was the fact, recognized by most of the world, that there was not a scintilla of real evidence against him. Yet he endured the disgrace, the humiliation of his family, and the smug hypocrisy of the French officers and courts without losing his self-respect."

"He was the victim of a conspiracy which, most of his countrymen eventually were convinced, was one of the most monstrous ever devised against an individual."

Wing to Synagogue Built in Bucharest

Structure Houses Museum and Library; Endowed by Jewish Philanthropist

Present at the opening were: Dr. William Fildermann, president of the Union of Rumanian Jews; Lazar Eckstein, member of the board of the Bucharest Jewish Community; ex-Senator Horia Carp, general secretary of the community; M. Alumni and Dr. Caleff of the Sephardic Community, M. Sarateanu, president of the B'nai B'rith Lodge Lumina and Advocate Robert Weinberg of the Maccabi.

Rabbi Niemirower emphasized the intimate association of the Jews with religion and culture throughout the centuries. In expressing appreciation of M. Zentler's gift, the rabbi recalled that he had also erected a school and synagogue in the Palestine colony Kfar Baruch.

Agudist Groups to Meet At Antwerp Next Month

ANTWERP, July 14—Western European Agudist organizations will hold a conference here under the auspices of the Belgian Agudist Organization August 9 to 13, it was announced here today. The Agudah is an extreme orthodox group.

Among those scheduled to participate in the deliberations are Jacob Rosenheim, president of the world organization; Dr. S. Ehrmann, director of the Palestine Department; I. M. Lewin, president of the Polish Department, and H. A. Goodman of London.

The conference will discuss recent developments in Palestine problems arising in Poland, and other matters. Public meetings in connection with the conference will be held in Antwerp and Brussels.

Missionaries Work Among Polish Jews

Proselytizing Groups Urge Parents to Send Children To Their Camps

WARSAW, July 14—Taking advantage of the growing misery among Poland's Jews, Christian missionary organizations have launched a campaign among Jewish parents to send their children to summer camps financed by missionary funds.

Jewish parents, despairing of aid from Jewish organizations, in many cases allow themselves to be persuaded by the propaganda of the missionaries.

A particularly active proselytizing group is the Society of Jewish Christians which operates in Warsaw and Lodz. It holds meetings in Beth El Hall, Warsaw.

Historians have said that it was part of a German plot to demoralize the French army by stirring up anti-Semitic feeling in the ranks and in the nation and that Col. Dreyfus was marked as a scape-

goat because he was the first Jew to serve on the French general staff."

2,000,000th V-8 Ford Goes to San Diego Fair

The 2,000,000th V-8 Ford—the one-millionth Ford produced in less than twelve months and the 23,000,000th Ford ever built—is en route to San Diego, Calif., where it will be exhibited in the Ford Exposition at the California Pacific International Exposition. The historic car

was built June 13, under the watchful eyes of Henry and Edsel Ford, just six days less than a year from the day when the 1,000,000th V-8 Ford was produced June 19, 1934, for exhibition at the World's Fair in Chicago. When the 2,000,000th V-8, a de luxe Fordor touring sedan

in royal blue and gold, came off the final assembly line at the Rouge plant at Dearborn, Mich., Mr. Ford personally waved it on its way to the Pacific coast, after Mayor Clyde M. Ford of Dearborn had signed the original entry in its log book.

United Front For Boycott Drive Asked

A.J.C. Sends Letter to Anti-Nazi League on the Proposition

The American Jewish Congress boycott committee has addressed a letter to Samuel Untermyer, president of the Non-Sectarian Anti-Nazi League to Champion Human Rights, calling for coordination of boycott activities of the two organizations, it was announced yesterday.

The request for a united front was made after a decision reached by the A.J.C. boycott committee. The letter was signed by Dr. Joseph Tenenbaum, chairman.

The letter emphasized that the break-down of the boycott movement in Poland placed an additional responsibility on anti-Nazi forces in the United States.

"It is greatly to be deplored," the letter said, "that after two years of intensive boycott work, the country at large, outside of New York, is totally disorganized.

"I personally have felt from the outset that we cannot afford to split our forces, especially in view of the extensive resources of the German government and the lukewarm response of the non-Jewish population of the United States."

Jung Directs State's Board of Kashruth

The Kashruth advisory board authorized by the State Legislature at its last session will be headed by Rabbi Leo Jung of New York City, it was learned yesterday. Other members are: Rabbi Nachman H. Ebin, Rabbi Drob and Rabbi M. Suchatnowitz of New York; Rabbi Max M. Yellin, Buffalo; Prof. Emil Isaacs, Yonkers, and Rabbi Jeremiah Berman, Rochester.

The board will aid in the enforcement of the state kosher food law.

Richard Strauss, distinguished composer, resigned yesterday as president of the Third Reich's Music Chamber. He said he was stepping out because of "advanced age" but it was no secret that his withdrawal was a result of politics.

Zweig's Part Resented
When Strauss's latest opera, "The Silent Woman," was presented at Dresden three weeks ago Nazi leaders were significantly absent. This, it was understood, was traceable directly to their resentment over his retention of Stefan Zweig, renowned Jewish author, to write the libretto for the opera.
Production of "The Silent Woman" provoked a fight in Nazi ranks between factions of Dr. Paul Joseph Goebbels, Propaganda Minister, and Dr. Alfred Rosenberg, philosophic dictator and pagan faith leader.
Goebbels permitted the presentation of the opera, apparently fearing an international scandal if he refused, but Rosenberg opposed this action vigorously.

Ousted Instructor Calls Student House Nest Of Nazi Activity

NEW BRUNSWICK, N. J., July 14—Dr. Lienhard Bergel, former German instructor at the New Jersey State College for Women, charged that the German student house on the college campus is a center of Nazi propaganda, in concluding his testimony yesterday before a trustees' committee investigating alleged Hitlerite activities at the college.

Dr. Bergel reiterated the accusation which brought about the probe—that he had failed to secure reappointment as a German instructor because of opposition to the views of Dr. Frederick J. Hauptmann, head of the German Department.

He said he would have pressed the matter until he got a reasonable explanation, whether or not he were successful in obtaining a position elsewhere.

Dr. Hauptmann testified he had dropped Dr. Bergel for incompetence.

The committee adjourned until Wednesday. Until now, 108 witnesses have been heard. Their testimony it estimated at 1,000,000 words.

Asked by a Jewish Daily Bulletin reporter how long he thought the hearings would continue, Dr. Ashmead, who is in charge of the investigation, said they would go on until all witnesses had been heard. He could not estimate how long this would take.

12,000 Acres in Cyprus Held By Jews Despite British Policy

(Jewish Telegraphic Agency)
LONDON.—Much interest has been aroused here by a report from Famagusta in the Morning Post that, according to information obtained from the Land Registry Office, land held by Jews in Cyprus now amounts to some 12,000 acres, representing an investment of about £72,000 (\$360,000).

About half of this land, according to the Morning Post, was taken over by new companies and immigrants from unsuccessful Jewish farmers.

Although the land was acquired at an average price of £6 (\$30) per acre—the prevailing price for cereal land—it is really worth far more, according to the newspaper's correspondent, since it is well situated near water-supply and is suitable for orange planting.

Orange growing land usually sells for £30 (\$150) per acre in Cyprus.

What makes these figures interesting is that only recently the new Secretary for the Colonies, in his

Measures for alternative crops, such as deciduous fruits, are also being considered. Cyprus cherries, for instance, fetch high prices in Palestine and the demand far exceeds the supply.
