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Autonomy Is Upheld By Hungary

Highest Court Decides Community Rules Its **Internal Affairs**

(Jewish Telegraphic Agency) BUDAPEST, July 16-The autonomy of the Jewish community in Hungary in internal Jewish matters was reaffirmed today in a decision handed down by the Supreme Court here.

Jewish autonomy was upheld when the Court dismissed the case of a Jewish doctor working in a Jewish hospital who had sued the institution for damages because it retired him when he reached retirement age.

Not satisfied with the action of the hospital, the doctor took his case to court. When a lower court decided against him, he appealed to the Supreme Court, which however, ordered the case dismissed.

In rendering its decision the high tribunal emphasized that the Jewish community is autonomous in matters pertaining to its inter-

Employes in Jewish hospitals and other Jewish charitable institutions run by the community, the court found, are subject to the legal practices of the Jewish community. and therefore must abide by its de-

Court Sentences 2 in Polish Attack

Race Bias of Prosecutor Results in One Year Prison Terms

WILNO, July 16—For allegedly inflicting an injury on a Polish drunkard who attacked them in the street, two Wilno Jewish business-Victor Chelem and Herz Machtel, were today sentenced by the local Court of Appeals to one year in prison.

During the trial the prosecutor delivered a speech replete with anti-Semitic barbs. The assault by the Jewish merchants on the Pole, he said, is an indication of the insolence of the "chosen people."

12-Year-Old Prodigy's Composition Praised

(Jewish Telegraphic Agency) ROME, July 16-The musical composition of a twelve-year-old Jewish boy, Giorgio Levi, played last night in the Cremona Theatre, is highly praised today by all music critics in the Italian

The composition, which carries the title "Cantimistici," was inspired by the Psalms which the Jewish boy has studied. The boy comes from an orthodox Jewish family.

The Order of Saints Maurizzio and Lazzaro was conferred today by the Italian government upon Leo Solschki, the most prominent Jew in Florence. Mr. Solschki was honored for his distinguished services as a publisher.

Arabs Plotting For War Coup, British Hear

Secret Parley Discusses Striking if England **Becomes Involved**

(Jewish Telegraphic Agency) JERUSALEM, July 16-Serious attention was paid by the Palestine government today to reports Arab leaders have held a secret conference at which the possibilities were discussed of getting rid of the British regime in case of a world war involving England.

Though the Palestine administration is aware that the extreme Arab circles are looking forward to a war in which England will be entangled, it does not believe that moderate Arab leaders would indulge in plotting against England at the moment.

Officials here are of the opinion that the impending war between Italy and Ethiopia will put an end to the schemes of some Arab extremists to link their interests in Palestine with Italy, as indicated by the recent letter of Emir Arslan published in the Arab press here.

The Arabs in Palestine, Syria and neighboring countries are in definite sympaty with Ethiopia.

Official figures made public by the government here state that approximately \$75,000,000, more than twice as much as two years ago, are now lying in Palestine banks awaiting investment.

Hightstown Seminary Students | partment investigation was expected yesterday. Live Like Pioneers in Camp

(Special to the J.D.B.) HIGHTSTOWN, N. J., July 16-Conducted in the spirit of the Palestinian collective colonies (Kutzvoth), the second annual Seminary on Palestine and Jewish problems, sponsored by the Hechalutz Organization of America, is under way today, concerning itself with an intensive study of the Zionist and Jewish labor movements, as well as with the Hebrew language and Hebrew and Yiddish literature. The seventeen-day sessions will last until the end of this month.

The whole Seminary is arranged on a cooperative basis, the students from the Hachalutz farm. sharing in all the menial work, The Seminar numbers eighty-five

students, twenty-seven of them, members of the Hachshare (pioneer training) farm proper, come to evening lectures after a hard day's toil in the fields. Many of the Seminar students assist in the field work, thus tasting some of the travail of pioneering, while at the same time they study the philosophy and history of the pioneer movement in Palestine. At lectures there are a number of visitors, Jewish farmers of the neighborhood and members of the Mizrachi training farm situated four miles

Set to Open In London

Finding Lands to Take Colonists Is Aim Of Sessions

(Jewish Telegraphic Agency) LONDON, July 16 - Delegates from various European countries arrived in London today to participate in an international conference for the purpose of seeking out new territories for Jewish immigration and colonization.

The conference will open tomorrow in the Great Russell Hotel and continue for three days. Dr. Moses Gaster, sage, will preside at the gathering.

The delegates will be given a uncheon at the House of Commons during the conference. Numerous members of Commons and of the House of Lords are interested in the projects which the parley will discuss.

The initiative for the calling of the meeting came from the Jewish Territorialist League in Poland, the French League for Jewish Colonization and the League for Jewish Colonization in Great Britain. Representatives of Central Jewish organizations in Europe will be present.

Results of investigations made in certain territories where Jews could be settled will be reported. Special reports will be submitted on the possibilities of Jewish colonizations in Angola, Syria and countries in Central and South America.

The conference will be addressed by prominent Jewish and non-Jewish speakers. Special stress will be laid on the present situation of the Jews in Poland and Germany.

Jr. Hadassah Gifts Increase \$8,000 in Year

More Than \$47,000 Is Collected for Work In Palestine

Gifts to the 200 units of Junior Hadassah, the Young Women's Zionist Organization of America, increased by \$8,000 over last year's total contributions, according to a report issued yesterday by the Misses Pauline Englander and Martha Loewenstein, both of Jersey City, N. J., co-chairmen of fundraising. The society raised more funds during its fiscal year, ending July 1, than during any of the corresponding periods since 1932, the report reveals.

The report states that \$47,000 was collected for the organization's Palestinian work, which includes the maintenance of a children's village of 115 boys and girls, an orange grove for agricultural training and the Hadassah Nurses' Training School in Jerusalem. In addition, the 200 units raised an aggregate of close to \$14,000 for the Jewish National Fund, which is \$4,000 more than the organization set as its goal.

Further Outrage Is Feared in Beach Panic Wake

(Jewish Telegraphic Agency)
BERLIN, July 16—The anti-Jewish riots which started last night in Berlin were followed up today by uniformed Nazis in Wannsee, a few hours distant from Berlin.

Armed with pitchforks, the mob invaded the beach at Wannsee this morning, and created a panic by shouting, "Jews get out." Jews were driven from the beach by the Nazis.

Similar events are reported today from other parts of the country, where local Nazis, inspired by the race attacks last night in Berlin, indulged in terroristic acts against Jews.

In Berlin, many foreign visitors hurriedly prepared to leave Germany as a result of the outbreaks, during which Jewish cafes were wrecked and Jewish and foreign guests assaulted. American citizens were also among the victims.

Americans who witnessed the anti-Jewish riots last night on Kurfuerstendamm, the fashionable section of Berlin, feared to remain, because it is believed that the riots of last night are only the beginning of a series of outbreaks aimed to force the Jews out of Germany by terrorist methods.

Scars of Battle

The restaurants attcked last night by the Nazis today bore the scars of battle, with their furniture broken and windows smashed. The worst sufferers from the outrages were the cafes Bristol, Dobrin and Kranzler, which are located in the center of Kurfuerstendamm.

Few Jews were seen at the streets today after the bloody events of last night. The principal Jewish cafes in the city remained closed. Others were closed early in the evening, fearing a repetition of the outbreaks.

The number of Jewish victims of last night's rioting has not yet been established. The Nazis not only dragged them from cafes and restaurants, but also attacked Jewish pedestrians. They stopped every

The Jews in Algeria

ALGIERS.

THE RECENT recrudescence of anti-Semitism in Algiers has faced the Jewish population with a problem which is becoming increasingly important as the agitation against the Jews increases in virulence.

The entire population of Algiers is about five and a half million souls, a million of whom are of European origin. These include 75,0000 Frenchmen and

etc. Four-fifths of the total population are Mohammedans. Altogether there are only about 10,000 Jews in the whole of Algiers.

So small a proportion is hardly calculated to alarm the rest of the inhabitants of the province; but in Algiers, as elsewhere, there exists a very active group of people who regard the Jew as their chief enemy, because of the fact that he occupies an enviable position both in economic and professional life.

THE Jew naturally lays much store on education, with the result that he secures positions of trust in the administrative organs of the country. He is also strongly represented in the municipal bodies in the towns. He is often a municipal councillor, a financial official, a deputy mayor, and even a mayor. In this way, he undoubtedly obtains a certain position of privilege and power.

The Jewish and Mohammedan electors have always worked amicably, side by side, but the differbetween the Jew and the Arab is that the Arab is usually indifferent to public affairs, whereas the Jew invariably takes a keen interest in local administration.

The Arab regards himself as the real master of the country, although for the time being deprived of his patrimony by the French. Hence, his somewhat resentful attitude to the Jews, who seem to handle local affairs so much better than he.

IN ADDITION, the Jewish persecutions in Germany have increased the nervousness of the Algerian Arab, who fears that the German Jews might attempt to find a new home in Algiers. Thus, a very big commercial non-Jewish firm recently had to put up with a violent agitation against its management for the alleged and wholly unsubstantiated reason that it contemplated giving jobs to German Jews. This firm has large interests not only in Algiers, but in the whole of North Africa. Fearing the effect of such an accusation among the Arabs, it felt itself compelled to repudiate its alleged intention of employing German Jews as a slanderous invention spread abroad by its competitors.

FURTHER grist for the anti-Se-Semitic mills is provided by the

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200,000 Italians, Spaniards, Maltese, dissensions between the Jews and Arabs in Palestine, influencing Arab opinion throughout the whole of North Africa. Local municipal rivalries provide other sources of anti-Semitic propaganda, especially in localities where the Jewish vote has a not inconsiderable influence on the result of the elections and where the defeated party does not hesitate to accuse the Jew of every conceivable crime on the calendar.

> Such an appeal to the grosser instincts of the Arab population is all the more effective since the majority of the Arabs, belonging to the poorer non-tax-paying classes of the population, is not entitled to vote in the municipal elections. whereas the Jews, who are regarded as "gate crashers," belong to the propertied, tax-paying classes who, naturally, enjoy the right to

ASTLY, the world crisis is responsible for the spread of anti-Semitism by plunging the agricultural producer in Algeria into a state of hopeless and unrelievable penury, with the result that he becomes susceptible to all sorts of rumors about Jewish machinations against the Arab peasant, chief among which is the accusation that the Jew is a usurer fattening on the blood of the impoverished fellaheen, although, among the hundred known money-lenders in the province, hardly five are Jews.

Actually seventy per cent of the population in the towns depends on its livelihood on charity. To consider them responsible for a crisis of which they themselves are victims, is indeed not without its bitter irony.

But anti-Semitism the world over has always thrived on lies and, unfortunately, it has an easy time in Algiers, because of the fact that the local authorities have so far failed to realize the dangerous implications of an anti-Jewish agita-

Cornerstone Is Laid For Gordon Museum

JERUSALEM, July 16-The cornerstone was laid today for a new museum in Dagania bearing the name of Aaron David Gordon, exponent of "the religion of labor."

The new museum, devoted to natural history and agriculture, will honor the memory of one of the most colorful characters in the upbuilding of the new Palestine. Frequently referred to as the "Jewish Tolstoi," Gordon left his home and family in Russia when already in his fifties and came to Palestine to be a "chalutz."

Scorning the ministrations of his friends, Gordon went from commune to commune in Palestine, doing the hardest labors and serving as an example to his much younger comrades by the simplicity of his life and the devotion he bore to

Gordon wrote several volumes of essays in Hebrew, devoted mainly to his belief that only physical labor on the soil can ennoble the human being. He died at Dagania in 1922.

The Berlin Riots

The anti-Jewish bloody events which took place Monday evening on Kurfuerstendamm, in the very heart of Berlin, indicate that there is no hope whatsoever for the Jews in Germany and that the Nazi government has definitely decided to use terror in order to compel the Jews out of the country.

Attacks on Jews are not new in Germany of today. They are, however, new on Kurfuerstendamm. Fearing foreign observers who frequent this section of Berlin, the Nazi authorities were especially keen on avoiding anything that resembled disturbances in the vicinity of Kurfuerstendwamm. They did not mind Jews being attacked in Nuremberg, Munich, in Frankfurt-am-Main and in the smaller provincial citiesc where foreign visitors are rare. They did not, however, want to see any such attacks in Berlin, and, particularly, in the Kurfuerstendamm section of Ber-Ku rfuerstendamm section of Ber-

Public Opinion Scorned

The anti-Jewish pogrom Monday evening, which was tolerated by the police and which carried all the marks of an organized affair, shows that the Nazi authorities have now made a step further in their plans to make life miserable for the Jews in Germany. Apparently encouraged by the concessions which they recently obtained to increase their army and navy, the Nazi governmenet does not care any longer for public opinion abroad. Hence, it is no longer interested in what foreign visitors may see in Berlin and may relate later abroad.

The cafe houses attacked by the Nazis on Kurfuerstendamm on Monday evening are all Jewish enterprises, patronized by Jews only. It is in these cafes that the Jews of Berlin sit in the company of other Jews, since they are isolated from keeping company with their former non-Jewish friends. These cafes have long been termed even by Nazis as "ghetto cafes." They have long been avoided by "Aryans," for the Nazi press has more than once classified them as "Jewish cafes" which are visited by Jews and foreigners only.

Monday's attacks are, therefore, an indication that the Nazis wish to drive the Jews not only into ghettos, but altogether out of sight of public places in Berlin. Not being able to get rid of them at once, they wish to see them confined to their homes and totally isolated from the rest of the population.

Terror Increases

It is in line with this wish that the Nazi youth organizations only a few days ago warned the Jews appear streets after ten o'clock in the evening. It is also in compliance with this wish that the Jewish community of Berlin has issued an appeal to the Jewish population to abstain from frequenting public places.

German Jewry, which has hitherto suffered legal and economic persecutions, is now on the way to suffer from physical terror. The Nazi government has embarked on the course of stimulating anti-Jewish terror openly and without any hesitation. It seems that the Streicher spirit has gained the upper hand in the Nazi government circles, and that those who were urging moderation in the anti-Jewish treatment have lost their battle. Germany Jewry has gone through many dark months since the Nazis came to power, but it seems that darker months are now ahead of them.

World Press Digest -

Dignity of Dreyfus Lauded by 'Times'

The New York Times comments on the dignity of Colonel Alfred Dreyfus's bearing after his trial and imprisonment, as follows:

History, as defined by one of the greatest historians, has a twofold principal office. It is to prevent virtuous actions from being forgotten and to cause evil words and deeds to fear "an infamous reputation with postery." In the case of Alfred Dreyfus, history has a proud task in recalling the heroic way in which he accepted and endured the most degrading and inhuman of human punishments, conscious of his innocence, and the almost superhuman way in which, after his exculpation and clearly established innocence, he bore himself in the country which he had chosen as his own and which had for a time made him a man without a country.

His suffering in the tropical island to which he was banished must have been even greater than that of the Titan, nailed to the frosty wall of "the eagle-baffling mountain, black, wintry, dead, unmeasured, without herb, or beatst, or shape, or sound of life." But, released from the hell of Devil's Island, Dreyfus bore no resentment. He would even let history omit the second part of its office —that is, of giving "infamous reputation" to hte words and deeds of those who condemned him unjustly. Like the Titan, he too, had in his suffering lost all memory of what is hate. Plucked by a great wrong from obscurity, as one of our poets said at the time, he mad many a true and fainting cause heir of all his courage. He has given France, "impassioned nobly to retrieve her passion past," reason not only for readmitting him to citizenship but also for bestowing honors upon him—and not mere "penitential laurels." He was decorated where he was degraded. He was admitted to military service in the World War, was promoted and was given the greater satisfaction of having his name, once scorned and despised. carried to new honors on the battlefields of France by the next generation of his family.

It cannot be that his sufferings have been as he feared, "all in vain." Rather did he give fresh illustration of the glory of forgiving "wrongs darker than death or night," and going bravely on till hope creates "the thing it contemplates."

Nazi Anti-Semitism Hurts British Cause

Concerning the relations between Great Britain and Germany, The London Spectator says:


Signs of a new drive against Jews in Germany multiply. Dr. Goebbels, who must be distressed at possessing so few of the outward characteristics of the blond Nordic himself, did his utmost to set the fires of racial hatred ablaze again on Saturday in a speech in which he conceded that a Jew is indeed a man in the sense in which a flea must be admitted to be an animal, and declared that Germany wanted the Jew no longer. This is deliberate incitement from the Minister for National Enlightenment and Propaganda. The provocative campaigns of Julius Streicher's fou lorgan, Der Stuermer, continue unabated, and signs multiply of anti-Semitic action, all of it intolerant and much of it brutal, in other fields. It is useless to pretend that this is a matter which concerns Germany alone. It concerns Germany's relations with Great Britain directly. Agreements like the naval accord are all to the good, but a spirit of mutual appreciation and sympathy between peoples is worth ten times more. And of that there can be none while the German government not merely condones but instigates racial persecution through its official spokesmen. Such a policy leaves advocates of an Anglo-German understanding in this country powerless.

Cites Contradictions In Nationalism Here

The Press, of Mobile, Alabama, in an editorial on nationalism, writes:

A bill has been introduced in Congress to send all aliens out of the country, and another bill has been introduced to require ex-patriates to come home. These bills would seem to constitute a flat contradiction, but they are both an outgrowth of that spirit of nationalism which is a plague not only in the United States, but in every country in the

The bill to deport all aliens represents the hope that the actionwill mean that American citizens can obtain the jobs thus vacated.



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Pioneer, Dies

Builder of Movement Founder of Board of Jewish Deputies

JOHANNESBURG, July 16-Ben-Zion S. Hersch, one of the builders of the Zionist movement in South Africa, and a founder of the South African Jewish Board of Deputies. died here today.

Mr. Hersch was born in Janishky, Lithuania, and came to South Africa in 1902. He was fifty years old. Two children survive him.

Ben-Zion S. Hersch was one of the most prominent Jews in South Africa. He was associated with the national movement from the early days of Herzl. He helped organize the South African Zionist Federation and served as a member of the Executive Council of that body

Mr. Hersch, the first immigration officer of the Board of Deputies in Capetown, rendered extensive services to the Jewish community in matters of immigration and naturalization.

The deceased also contributed to the local and overseas press. For a period he was editor and publisher of the Jewish Standard of Johannesburg. He helped develop the Zionist Record from a monthly official magazine to a weekly journal of large circulation. Up to his death, he was honorary chairman of the editorial board of the paper.

The entire Jewish community of South Africa greatly mourns the passing of Mr. Ben-Zion S. Hersch.

Judge Nathan D. Perlman, accompanied by Mrs. Perlman and their son, Jack, will sail today aboard the S. S. Manhattan for a two month's visit to Europe and Palestine.

While abroad Judge and Mrs. Perlman will confer with a number of Jewish leaders and will study conditions affecting Jewish life to report back to the organizations with which they are affiliated. It is modeled after the Palestinian seminars that are conducted in the various labor colo nies under the supervision of the cultural commission of the Histadruth, the General Federation of Jewish Labor. Similar undertakings are common in European countries, where thousands of students partake in the courses.

This year marks the first attempt to encompass so many subjects. The Hechalutz has gathered a volunteer staff of instructors, each of whom is a recognized authority in his field.

Rubashov a Lecturer

One of the inspirers of the Seminary is Zalman Rubashov, veteran Palestinian labor leader and editor the the Hebrew labor daily, Davar. He is a writer and translator, and has published a critique of the Bible. Rubashov is delivering a series of lectures on contemporary Jewish and labor the history of the Zionist labor movement.

Among the volunteer faculty is Raphael Margolin, who for a long time was a resident of Palestine and a member of the Histadrutlf cultural commission. He is a fellow of the Royal Economic Society of England. Mr. Margolin is giving a comprehensive course in Palestinography, including the physical, historical and social geography of the Jewish national home in the process of rebuilding.

The history of the old Jewish settlement in Palestine prior to the coming of the pioneers of the modern Zionist movement is being reviewed by Dr. J. Rifkind, librarian of the Jewish Theological Semin-

A sociological analysis of modern Palestine will be presented by Abraham Revusky, journalist and author of "Jews in Palestine," the most recent handbook on Zionist achievements in Palestine. Revusky has just returned from a visit to the Homeland and has brought back an account of the latest developments in the country.

Isaac Zaar, former editor of the "Vanguard," will trace the evolution of socialist Zionist theory. Marie Syrkin, associate editor of the "Jewish Frontier," will deliver a series of lectures on the life and works of her father, the late Dr. Nachman Syrkin, who was one of the founders and leading spirits of the socialist Zionist movement.

Economic Conditions Reviewed Dr. Herman Frank, journalist and economist, will start a cycle on the problems of world Jewry, beginning with the economic conditions of the Jewish people.

Dr. I. Shapiro, of Philadelphia, will lead a historical review of the Jewish labor movement in all coun-of the financial department.


Say Nazis Seized American Seaman

Anti-Nazi Commission Claim Secret Police Kidnaped Sailor on Manhattan

The charge that an American seaman had been kidnaped from an American ship while it was docking in Hamburg was contained in a letter sent yesterday by the Anti-Nazi Commission, 168 West Twenty-third Street, to the Non-Sectarian Anti-Nazi League, the American Jewish Congress and other organizations.

The letter called on the organizations to protest to the German embassy in Washington and to Secretary of State Cordell Hull the arrest and kidnaping of Lawrence B. Simpson, 35, an American citizen and able bodied seaman on the S.S. Manhattan.

Edward Walisch, another seaman on the ship, the letter said, reported that Simpson was removed from the ship by Nazi secret service men who raided his locker and removed his belongings, including anti-Nazi literature.







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Eye-Witness Describes Brutal Scenes As Nazi Mob Struck, Kicked and Spat

Attackers in Gay Mood. Police Indifferent, Editor Reports

The first eye-witness account by an American on the anti-Jewish riots in Berlin was related yesterday to the Associated Press by Varian Fry, editor of the Living Age, who is now visiting Germany.

The story, as related by the Associated Press, reads as follows:

"I was informed at about 8 o'clock last night that there was an anti-Jewish demonstration in the streets. I hurried out and presently heard shouting toward the east end of Kurfuerstendamm Boulevard.

"When I got there I found a large crowd lined up on both sides of the street, forcing each car which came by to run the gantlet, stopping all cars in which Jewishlooking men or women were riding, and dragging out the Jews and beating them up.

and spat on as he lay on the sidewalk, a woman was bleeding, a dirty tear-stained face, a man head was covered with blood, hysterical women crying, men losing their temper at the police or the Storm Troopers being kicked or dragged off, women begging their men to keep out of the fight and crying and pleading.

Police Don't Interfere

"Nowhere did the police seem to make any effort whatever to protect the victims from this brutality. Occasionally they attempted to clear areas for motor traffic to get through or to prevent the crowds from collecting in front of certain apparently favored cafes.

"All along the Kurfuerstendamm the crowd raised the shout 'Jude!' whenever any one sighted or thought he had sighted a Jew. The cry sent the crowd converging on the poor victim, who was asked for his identification papers.

"It he could not prove himself a good 'Aryan' he was insulted, spat on, roughly handled, and sometimes knocked down, kicked and beaten.

Crowd Shifts

"The cry 'Jude!' would be raised at another point and the crowd would hurry off to a new victim.

"At times a chant would be raised-I can't remember the German, but the chant was something like Get the hell out-Blood-Running-Noses-The best Jew is a dead Jew"-precisely like a Christian liturgy, with leader speaking the lines first and the crowd chanting them over again, line by line, after he had finished.

"Everywhere the people were in holiday mood. In fact, one German youth said to me: 'This is a holiday for us.' Old men and young men in striped trousers and men in shirt sleeves, boys, Storm Troops, police, young girls of the domestic servant type, well-bred women, and even some women in the forties and over-all seemed to be having a good time.

"This morning, as I walked along Kurfuerstendamm, to inspect the broken windows, I passed in half an hour eight or ten persons, three obviously Jews, with bandaged heads, bandaged hands, and fresh, clean slings of plaster over their

"This was a sight I had never seen in Berlin before. It pretty obviously was connected with last night's circus."

Under the title "The Nazi Jekyll-Hyde," the Star editorial contrsated the riots with the friendly words of Nazi leaders to the visiting British war veterans.

the presentation of the film Peterson and Bendel' in a Berlin photo play house on Kurfuerstendamm resulted Monday evening in demonstrations before the theater. A large crowd expressed displeasure with the provocative behavior of the Jewish patrons of the photo-

play house. "In nearby cafes the public protested against the increasingly arrogant behavior of the Jews. The appearance of outraged citizens was sufficient in most cases to induce the Jewish patrons to leave in what amounted to a flight. In the Cafe Bristol excited disputes arose, during which a window was broken.

"Minor accidents occurred before the arrival of the police, but the latter and emergency squads prevented further clashes."

It is believed that the signal for the riot, the worst anti-Jewish out break ever witnessed in Berlin, was given by Dr. Goebbels and by Alfred Rosenberg, Hitler's righthand man. The Angriff, the evening paper published by Goebbels in Berlin, came out a few hours before the riots with an article inviting Nazis "to protest energetically against Jewish insolence."

Funeral Services Held For Rev. Morris Stein

His widow, three sons, two daughters, a brother, sister and ten grandchildren survive him.

"Elements inimical to the State sought to take advantage of a comprehensible demonstration against the arrogant attitude of Jews and attempted to bring the State and the party movement into dis- ing statement last night: repute," the police report says.

Though the official police version seeks to create the impression that the riots were not instigated by the Nazis, all foreign observers in Berlin who witnessed the scenes testified to the fact that the attacks were started by uniformed and civilian Nazis. Three members of the Nazi party, dressed in full uniform, motored up and down the Kurfuerstendamm, giving instructions and shouting encouragement to the hooligans.

The riots, continuing far into the night, were not checked by the pohouse on Kurfuersten- lice. Flying patrol squads, arriving on the ecene, did not intervene. At midnight the disorders spread from Kurfuerstendamm to Kanstrasse, a neighboring parallel street, where Jews were dragged out from cafes and severely beaten.

Jews in 'Custody'

A number of Jews were taken by police into "protective custody." Some of the rioters who were arrested after the intervention of bystanders were later released.
