Baltimore

The Rev. Dr. Samuel Rosenthal, rabbi of the Beth Tefith Congregation, will leave August 5 for the Palestine to attend the World Zionist Congress in Lucerne on August 20. Dr. Rosenthal and Louis I. Kanner, also of this city, will represent the Mithraei organization. Other Baltimoreans who will attend the Congress are the Rev. Dr. Edward L. Israel, rabbi of the Har Sinai Temple, who was elected by the General Assembly, and Dr. Herman Seidel, who ran on the Labor ticket.

Abraham Joseph, Baltimore attorney, has been suggested for appointment to the United States Court of Appeals for the District of Columbia to fill a vacancy caused by the recent death of Justice William H. Taft.

Dr. Joseph S. Sussman, prominent specialist in industrial accident injuries and cases in Jewish hospitals, is dead here at the age of 40 of a cerebral hemorrhage. Poor Jews to Benefit by Clearance Program Of Government

ATHENS, July 17.—The Greek government today notified Jewish leaders that a sum of one million drachmas has been assigned for re-habilitating the Jewish slums in Salonica.

The decision was adopted after the recent visit to Salonica by the Minister of the Interior, who made a special study of the Jewish situation there. He promised to see to it that the government assisted in the solution of the housing problem for the poorer part of the population.

The Jewish community of Salonica received the news of the government's decision with great joy. The entire Jewish population in Salonica has long displayed its readiness in the present regime by voting for it and supporting it during the recent Venizelos revolution.

At a united front of all Jewish groups for Jewish communal activities was organized here a few days ago.

er? It has long been apparent to the outside world and it must now be manifest to the Catholics that destruction of the Catholic Church is the ultimate end of the Nazis and that it is being pursued with a steady and relentless venom. It is possible that our Catholic brethren may choose to repeat the hundreds of the German Jews in waiting upon the final blow has fallen? Or will they now protect themselves?

Or is there possibly something deeper hidden? May not the fear of an impending economic crisis be motivating the Nazi leaders? May not the growing unrest, mainly undegraded as yet, an unrest largely caused by the continual lowering of the living standard of the German war weary, be partly responsible for this new outbreak against both Jews and Catholics? By these new attacks upon Catholics, their churches and organizations and upon the Jews, the Nazis have again proven to an outraged world that no minorities are safe in Germany today.

Boycott a Success

"Yesterday it was the Catholics, today the Jews. Tomorrow it may be the German Protestants, the Masons or the great body of German labor, each of which have in the past suffered under the Nazi lash. The boycott is the only effective weapon. If the Catholics of the world will join in this boycott as a body, they can destroy this unholy pagan revelation to the dark ages almost over night."

"These barbarians have no real conception of world opinion. That has been at the root of all Germany's misfortune. The boycott is proving its success by the desperate attempts Dr. Schacht is making to increase German exports by means of dumping 'subsidies,' by robbing Peter to pay Paul."

"A united boycott drive by Catholics, Protestants and Jews of the world will eventually cause the collapse of the German economy, will inevitably result in a German war against the English."

G. Richard Davis, co-sponsor of the luncheon, reiterated the plea. He compared the conditions of Spanish Jews to those of the German Jews under the Inquisition.

Press Unanimous in Scoring Reich for Latest Nazi Riots

The entire English press in New York, in leading editorials, yesterday greeted Hitlerized Germany for the anti-Semitic riots which took place on Kurfürstendamm in Berlin on Monday evening.

Emphasizing that the accounts of what happened in Berlin are irrefutable, The New York Times says:

"The official explanation of the rioting and terrorism in Berlin restaurants and hotels is that they were the work of 'irresponsible elements.' But the police did nothing to make them keep order or to protect innocent and helpless persons. The Nazis who raged through the streets and forced their way into private houses and public places of entertainment may have been irresponsible, but at any rate they know or had been told exactly the people whom they were to assault. Their furor Teutonicus appeared to have something morbid or sadistic about it. It must be seldom that a mob anywhere will be so completely and best and kick them as they lie flat and conscious, but it was a common sight in Berlin on Monday. The reports read as if the brutal men guilty of such deeds were really gratifying a long repressed blood-lust."

"The world has been given another glimpse of Nazi mentality and methods," the Times says. "Yet it shall be told again by the Nazis that Berlin is the very place to hold the Olympic Games, which emphasize good sportsmanship, fair play and respect for womanhood."

The Herald-Tribune editorializes: "Monday night's riot did not become in any sense a popular one until an organized band of Nazis had set the mob many examples of sadistic brutality and had demonstrated that the police who arrived on the scene were not there to afford their Jewish victims any protection whatever. But the fact that the inspiration of these disgraceful scenes was undoubtedly official, emanating from Adolf Hitler's intimate circle, is no apology for the insatiable zest with which the German populace takes part

in such nights of cruelty. Monday night's incidents are strongly reminiscent of the anti-foreign riots with which Chinese officials used to divert public attention, a generation or more ago, from the miseries that followed upon maladministration. We have here the same official and semi-official dissemination of mendacious, scurrilous propaganda, the same use of ruffians to show the mob how far it could go, the same reluctance of the uniformed guards to use the peace to rescue the scapegoats and the same display of a vicious and cowardly delight in the abuse of harmless and helpless folk that is characteristic of an illiterate, credulous mob of Oriental coxies. This comparison does the citizenry of Berlin no credit, and it is not meant to. They do not deserve any."

The Daily News' popular editorial, "Hitler Hounds the Jews Again," comments: "Well, most of us are wise to Mr. Hitler now. As Tennyson pointed out, when you go in for persecuting somebody else you only inform the onlookers that you are afraid of something or mistrustful of yourself. Mr. Hitler has plenty to worry about, at home and abroad. All we'd like to know is what particular worry or fear started him hounding the defenseless Jewish minority in Germany this time."

The New York Post pins the blame directly on Hitler.

"The anti-Jewish persecution by violence is official policy, as is the anti-Catholic repression," the paper says.

"Official Catholic circles now realize that the and the strong note sent to Germany by the Pope yesterday, protesting attacks on the church, smacked to a great charge that the mistreatment of Catholics and their secular and lay leaders are part of definite public policy in Hitlerland."

were ready to close at a moment's notice, it is reported to the Jewish Telegraphic Agency from Berlin. The fear of renewed anti-Jewish riots still prevails in the city, despite the assurances of the authorities that complete order will be maintained.

Notwithstanding these "guarantees," the Nazi youth today pasted anti-Semitic stickers on the windows of numerous Jewish shops. People who entered Jewish ice-cream parlors were branded as traitors by Nazi youths who picketed these establishments.

Leaders of the Hitler youth movement came out today with renewed demands that the government decree a curfew for all Jews in Germany, making it mandatory for Jews to clear the streets at ten o'clock in the evening.

In the city of Stralsund, two Jews were taken into "protective custody" today by the local police because they were married to German girls. The arrest was explained as a measure to protect the Jews from the indignation of the "Aryan" population.

nationalistic movement which is now affecting almost every country in Europe. This movement is the outcome of a number of historical causes going back many years and is made exceedingly acute now by the economic conditions which are oppressing the world at present."

Mr. McDonald emphasized that, out of a total of 80,500 refugees from Germany, the largest number has been settled in Palestine. There are today 27,000 German refugees located in Palestine, 6,000 in the United States, 3,000 in South American countries and 800 in other overseas countries. Eighteen thousand have been repatriated to countries of Central and Eastern Europe. Refugees still living in European lands number 25,700, Mr. McDonald said.

In his report he paid particular tribute to the work of the American Joint Distribution Committee, which has been the most active force in the provision of relief to the refugees in many countries.

Reporting to the governing body on his recent trip to countries of South and Central America to study economic opportunities and immigration possibilities for refugees there, he stated:

"In all Latin-America the largest economic possibilities are in Argentina and in Brazil, but it is precisely in those countries that the present obstacles to immigration are most difficult. Elsewhere in South and Central America the immigration restrictions are much less severe."

Commenting on the absorption of German Jewish refugees in Palestine, the High Commissioner declared that "Palestine continues to be the chief country of refuge. That small territory, about the size of Wales, has absorbed on a permanent basis more refugees than all other countries in the world to date. This is a great credit to the organizations chiefly concerned may fairly take pride.

"But Palestine might not have absorbed these tens of thousands if it had not been for the preparatory work carried through during many years of self-sacrifice and devotion by the thousands who have striven ceaselessly for the ideal of a Jewish National Home. Nor is it without significance that Palestine continues to be one of the very few countries prosperous enough to complain of a shortage of labor.

"The refugees in Palestine are playing a constructive role not only in material things but also in the spiritual and moral upbuilding of their new homeland."

German Repatriation Impossible

Referring to the possibility of repatriation to Germany of refugees unable to find openings in countries of refuge, Mr. McDonald declared that "it is impossible for the organizations to recommend in any case any person who had fled Germany to return. The German government has taken drastic measures against those returning, not only preventing them from taking employment, but confining them in 're-education' camps."

Of approximately 50,000 refugees who remain in Europe and who have not been able to emigrate overseas, "fifteen to twenty percent are non-Jews who have left Germany for political causes for reasons of conscience," High Commissioner McDonald reported. He stated that "owing to the falling off of the contributions for relief of the German government among the thousands of the refugees in Paris and Prague and among a smaller number in Amsterdam and other centers. The position is particularly difficult for the non-Jews in these places because of the failure of the Christian bodies hitherto, with the splendid exception of the Quakers, to raise funds for assistance."

A.J.C. Drafts Plan To Aid Reich Jews

realistic index of the human policy adopted by the German government toward the 600,000 German Jews, natives of the land, who only yesterday enjoyed equal civil, economic and political rights. In the Germany of today, the extermination of the members of a race, regardless of political views and religious belief, may be advanced by governmental agencies of propaganda. Government-protected bodies may with impunity trample under foot, without the slightest remorse and without hindrance by government, all those rights that are regarded in Western lands as fundamental in a civilized community and for which whole centuries in various lands fought and died. Pogroms are the inevitable consequence of such a reactionary policy.

"Under these circumstances, it seems to us that the American government, which indicates a deep and sincere interest in the maintenance of peace as between Italy and Abyssinia, which is still as anxious to be concerned with the preservation of fundamental rights, no matter where and by whom they may be violated, may, with all respect and due deference, be called upon to make representations to the German government in what seems to us, as well as to a large mass of American citizens, a state of affairs which has been suffered without rebuke now for about three years, and which demands redress."
