Nazi Ritual
Murder Lie
Is ExposedOfficials in Shanghai
Brand Charges, Vin-
dicate Community

SHANGHAI, July 19.—Branding the Nazis as liars and accusing them of malicious libel, the Shanghai Municipal Council today issued an official memorandum denying charges published in a Nazi paper that Jews practiced ritual murder in a Jewish cemetery here.

The memorandum, released in the North China Daily News, leading English newspaper, characterizes the anti-Semitic report appearing in the Nazi paper as fantastic slander and strongly condemns the Nazi lies.

The Municipal Council officially stamps the accusation of the Nazis as libelous, and intimates to the Jewish Community in Shanghai that it can make use of the official document to refute the wrongful accusation hurled against them by the Nazis.

Copies of the official report vindicating the honor of the Jews of Shanghai were forwarded to the German consul-general here. No answer has as yet been forthcoming.

Swedish Bill Aims
To Ban ShechitaMeasure Would Require the

Is Worth More Than Two Shoes

That is the classified ad Abraham Starr had put in the papers Friday as he saw visions of a fabulous fortune fading. Capetown lawyers, dispatches said, couldn't find a trace of Harry Koeslak who was supposed to have bequeathed a \$7,000,000 legacy to the Starr family.

Mr. Starr knew about the rumor of the bequest was that a Montreal lawyer had written him saying he had learned about the fortune from an old Capetown newspaper. He also knew, (and this seemed more important to him) that what with reporters, photographers and salesmen cluttering up his shop, he couldn't do his work alone.

DAILY BULLETIN SUSPENDS

The publisher announces with deep regret that publication of the daily issue of the Jewish Daily Bulletin is discontinued with this edition. Financial difficulties have dictated this action.

The Bulletin was founded October 15, 1924. It was the first Jewish daily newspaper, published in the English language, which was devoted exclusively to the dissemination of Jewish news.

Feminists Win League to Act
Equal Rights On Question
In Palestine Of RefugeesVictory Concerned With
Property Obtained
By U. S. Aid

A long struggle for equal property rights carried on by the Jewish women of Palestine, with the aid of American Jewish women, has just resulted in a feminine victory, it was announced yesterday by Hadassah, the Women's Zionist Organization, which led the American support of the movement.

The Jewish National Fund, Zionist land-purchasing agency in Palestine, has granted the demand that a wife be permitted to be co-lessee with her husband and that the signatures of both appear on a lease of Jewish National Fund land. Since 1901, when the Jewish National Fund began functioning, only the male head of the family was recognized as leaseholder.

Under the leadership of the Jewish Women's Equal Rights Society of Palestine and the Palestine Women's Labor Council, the Jewish women of Palestine have waged a continuous battle for leasehold rights.

Dr. Rosa Welt Straus, head of the equal rights organization, interested the American women of Hadassah in the cause.

The combined forces declared that the omission of the wife as a co-lessee was "discriminatory."

"For a pair of shoes you can have my millions," he told a reporter. "Not so skeptical were his son Maxie, and his son-in-law, Harry Cohen, who stood outside on the sidewalk giving oral press bulletins to all and sundry.

The facts of the case—if, indeed, there is a case—still aren't straight. But it seems that Harry Koeslak, a grand-uncle, was supposed to have died in Capetown six years ago, leaving a \$12,000,000 fortune of which \$5,000,000 was bequeathed to Mrs. Fannie Starr, Abraham's mother.

League to Act
On Question
Of RefugeesNorway Has Problem
Put on Agenda
Of Assembly

GENEVA, July 19.—The Secretariat of the League of Nations today sent a memorandum to all its members informing them officially of the request made by Norway that the question of Jewish and other refugees from Germany be placed on the agenda of the next session of the League in September.

According to the declaration made by M. Koht, Foreign Minister of Norway, the Norwegian government proposes that an international agreement be arrived at whereby all Jewish and other refugees from Germany will be placed under the direct protection of the League of Nations.

A similar recommendation was made the other day by James G. McDonald, the League's High Commissioner for Refugees, in his report before the governing body of the High Commission.

Intourist Explains
'Ad' in Stuermer

An explanation of reports that the Intourist, Soviet travel company, had advertised in Julius Streicher's rabid Nazi paper, Der Stuermer, was offered Friday by G. B. Elinsky, president of the United States Intourist.

"According to information I have received," he said, "I can definitely state that the Intourist in Berlin placed no advertising in Der Stuermer at any time. Misleading reports to this effect are probably due to the following situation:

"The Berlin office of the Intourist placed an advertisement concerning the Third Moscow Theatre Festival in the organ of the German Musical Chamber. Der Stuermer reproduced the advertisement with an accompanying article attacking the editor of the Chamber organ for accepting Intourist advertising.

Yiddish Urged
For Bureya's
Sole LanguageAutonomous District's
Russification Fought
By Press

MOSCOW—A fight against the Russification of the Jewish autonomous district in Bureya, and the demand that Yiddish be used there exclusively, has been raised by the Yiddish Soviet press.

In an article by its co-editor, M. Sprach, the Moscow Emess, leading Yiddish daily in Soviet Russia, points out that while Yiddish is being spoken in the homes and on the streets in the Jewish districts, a number of Jewish Communist officials fail to employ Yiddish in the administrative, economic, professional and other institutions under their charge.

In a number of institutions, the Emess complains, the only concession to Jewish nationalism is a sign or two in Yiddish, and not always correct Yiddish at that.

Groups Join Meeting Monday
To Fight New Reich Terror

A number of national Jewish organizations associated themselves on Friday with the American Jewish Congress and the Jewish Labor Committee in a call to an emergency conference at the Hotel Pennsylvania tomorrow night (Monday) to take action on recent assaults upon the Jews in Germany.

The Labor Committee, of which B. C. Vladeck is chairman, in a statement Friday, declared that the Jewish workers of America do not need to have interpreted for them the most recent physical attacks upon the Jews of Germany or to have explained for them the meaning of Hitlerism and Fascism.

New Riots Seen as
Count Heildorf
Heads Police

BERLIN, July 19.—That the Nazi government directly approves of the anti-Jewish riots which took place on the Kurfurterendamm this week, and that it means to encourage further riots of this kind, was indicated today when Count Wolf von Heildorf, Jew-hater, was appointed chief of police of Berlin.

Count von Heildorf became notorious in 1932, before the Nazis came to power, as the first organizer of an anti-Jewish pogrom on Kurfurterendamm. The pogrom took place on the eve of Rosh Hashanah, when the Jews were on their way home from the synagogues. Count von Heildorf was then sentenced to six months imprisonment by the pre-Nazi regime.

Today's appointment of Count von Heildorf followed the ousting of the Chief of Police Magnus von Levelow, apparently because of his failure to rid Berlin of the Jews.

Accepting his new post, Count von Heildorf issued a statement to the effect that he will utilize all the necessary "to dampen the growing Jewish aggression."

The appointment of Count von Heildorf took place upon the instructions of Premier Goering. Immediately after the appointment was announced, a conference between Goebbels and Heildorf took place and a statement was issued that the Nazis intend to press their campaign against the Jews more vigorously than heretofore.

Hans Kerri, another old-time Nazi, also was appointed today by Goering to assume charge of all church matters in the country and to help in the campaign against Catholics and Jews.

Count von Heildorf has not been heard of much since the Nazis came to power. He has been holding an insignificant position as chief of police in Potsdam. His elevation to the Berlin post has thrown the Jewish population today into a state of panic.

the anti-Hitler battle on all fronts as Jews, as citizens and as workers. Our ranks must be closed. Our action must be determined.

Mortimer Rottenberg, speaking for the Zionist Organization of America, said that "the bloody events of the past week in Nazi Germany, make clear that unless decisive action is taken at once to halt the Hitler terror, we may expect to find bloody atrocities upon the Jews as daily occurrences in Germany."

Other organizations which joined in the call are Independent Order B'nai B'rith, Hadassah, Jewish National Workers Alliance, Federation of Polish Jews, Young Israel, Order Sons of Zion, and Order B'nai Abraham.

WEEK'S EVENTS REVIEW

One of the darkest pages in German Jewish history was written this week when anti-Jewish riots broke out in Berlin, resembling the first days when the Nazis came to power.

Hundreds of Jews were driven out of cafes and restaurants in Kurfuerstendamm, the fashionable Berlin street, and were mercilessly beaten by the reformed and semi-reformed Nazis. The Jewish cafe houses were attacked and their windows and furniture smashed. No exception was made by the hoodlums when Jewish women. Everybody who seemed Jewish was assaulted. Automobiles passing the Kurfuerstendamm were stopped by the Nazi mobs. Passengers of Jewish appearance were dragged out of the car and physically mistreated.

All this took place upon orders of higher Nazi officials. The London press reports that Hitler himself ordered these riots.

Thrown into panic, the Berlin Jews now fear to walk evenings on the streets of the city. The Jewish community of Berlin has appealed to the Jewish population to abstain from appearing in public places in order not to give any grounds for new provocations.

The attacks on Jews on Kurfuerstendamm immediately found an echo in other parts of the Reich. In Wannsee, a bathing suburb of Berlin, Nazis armed with pitchforks invaded the beach and drove out all Jews there. In other parts of the country the Jews were arrested in violation of the racial principles of the Reich, because they married non-Jewish girls during the last few years.

Press Expresses Universal Horror

The anti-Jewish pogrom in Berlin provoked great consternation abroad. The entire press in London and America condemned the Berlin riots in the strongest possible terms. This universal reprobation had its effect, but only to a certain extent. It resulted in an order issued by the Nazi authorities to the police to take stronger measures for maintaining order in the city of Berlin. It did not, however, stimulate the Nazi leaders in Germany to issue an order that the anti-Jewish propaganda which led to the Berlin disorders should be abolished in the German press or at least be modified.

The Nazi press, especially such papers as the Stuermer and the Judenkenner, consequently continued to display in every office and in all factories by Nazi leaders in Berlin.

The anti-Jewish riots which took place this week in Berlin are the result of the growing influence of Julius Streicher, Germany's most notorious anti-Semite. While Dr. Schacht, the economic dictator of Germany, continues to urge that Jews be left alone in commerce in Germany, Streicher and his followers are insistent that Jews should not only be ousted also from Germany's commercial life but that they should be confined to ghettos and not be permitted to appear on the streets after ten o'clock in the evening.

Streicher Power Grows Apace

The influence of Streicher, hitherto limited to Franconia, where he is the ruler, has re-

cently also grown in other parts of the country, especially Bavaria. It also reached Berlin. As one of the Hitler-Stuermer Streeters is permitted to build stations all over Berlin where his Jew-baiting organ, Der Stuermer, is openly sold and his anti-Semitic placards conspicuously displayed.

Time was when the Nazi government was ashamed of Streicher's publications and did not permit it to be sold in Berlin, where it openly violated the German law under the Nazi regime. It also did not permit the Stuermer to be sent out abroad, because of its obscene contents.

This time has passed. Apparently aiming to play the same role in Berlin that he does in Franconia, Streicher succeeded in gaining the patronage of Hitler for his publications. The Stuermer now sold openly on the streets of Berlin, but special Stuermer units are operating in the capital of Germany, making their rounds in the German population in Berlin. This popularity has reached so great a state that during the anti-Jewish riots on Kurfuerstendamm many of the Nazis shouted "Heil Streicher" instead of "Heil Hitler".

The anti-Jewish pogrom this week in Berlin can be attributed chiefly to the fact that Germany is no longer interested in public opinion abroad in the manner in which it was only a few weeks ago. Permitted by England to restore its army and its navy, the Nazi leaders feel that they have practically achieved what they wanted for the time being in the field of foreign politics. Hence, their attention is focussed now on internal politics.

Nazis at War With Catholics

The first victims of this increased attention of the Nazi leaders to the internal problems of the country were the Jews and the Catholics. Simultaneously with the anti-Jewish riots on Kurfuerstendamm the Nazis increased anti-Jewish propaganda all over the Reich, the Nazi government started a crusade on a large scale against the Catholic Church this week. This crusade has reached such a point that the Vatican has been compelled to come out with an open statement against Nazi Germany for the first time since the Nazis are in power. To this statement General Goering replied with an order issued to the authorities throughout the country to arrest any Catholic priest who dares to say a word against the present regime in Germany.

This actual war between the Catholics and the Nazi government will, no doubt, lead to the breaking up of the Concordat concluded only a year ago between the Nazi government and the Pope through the mediation of Franz Von Papen, who is now the German ambassador to Austria. This state of war, which Goering dared for the first time this week to declare in the most vigorous terms against Catholics in Germany, may perhaps lead to a united front between Jews and Catholics all over the world to counteract the persecution of Jews and Catholics in Germany.

A plea for such a united front has been made by the Jews by the Belgian Catholics. The Catholic world in Europe is much perturbed by the fact that the Catholic position in Germany is becoming similar to that of Jewish. The question of supporting a

world-wide boycott against Germany is now seriously being discussed in leading Catholic circles in Europe as one of the measures of checking the strength of the Nazis.

In addition to the anti-Jewish riots on Kurfuerstendamm, Nazis this week invaded a meeting of the League of Nations in Berlin, provoking a fight. A number of Jews were arrested as a result of this fight, in which the Nazis were driven out from the meeting hall.

Following the riots on Kurfuerstendamm, an order was issued to all enterprises in Germany where employees are to be dismissed, Jewish employees must be the first to go. In this respect no difference is to be made between Jews and people of Jewish descent or German who are married to Jews, the order provides.

Direct League Aid Urged for Refugees

The precarious situation of the Jews in Germany and the dark future which is in store for them was discussed at great length this week at the governing council of the High Commission for Jewish and Other Refugees from Germany, which was set up by the League of Nations. Picturing the plight of the German-Jewish refugees outside of Germany and the possibilities that the number of refugees may increase, James G. McDonald, the High Commissioner, demanded that his office be liquidated at the end of the year and be replaced by an office conducted directly by the League of Nations. He expressed his opinion that the League of Nations must take full responsibility for the fate of the refugees from Germany. He pointed out that such responsibility was taken by the League of Nations for Greek, Assyrian, Russian and Armenian refugees and that, therefore, there is no valid reason why the League should remain indifferent to the condition of the exiles from Germany.

The demand of Mr. McDonald was supported by Viscount Cecil. In his report Mr. McDonald disclosed that approximately ten million dollars has been spent during the last two years for relief of refugees from Nazi Germany. Virtually all this money came from Jewish relief organizations, such as the American Joint Distribution Committee, the German Colonization Association, and others. The League of Nations itself did not spend a cent for the refugees from Germany.

80,000 Exiled From Hitlerland

Over eighty thousand refugees left Germany since Hitler came to power, according to the report. The majority has been settled in different countries, but there are

still a good number depending on relief. Mr. McDonald revealed the fact that a fund of ten million dollars is now being raised quietly by a group of Jews in America for the rehabilitation of German Jews in countries outside Germany. This money will be spent on constructive work only.

One of the major troubles with regard to the refugees from Germany is the fact that no country wishes to admit refugees who have no capital. A report was spread recently by irresponsible correspondents that the Albanian government decided to invite Jewish refugees for settlement in Albania. This report was, however, immediately denied by Albanian authorities who made it clear that no such invitation has ever been extended. They emphasized that only those with capital will be admitted.

A ray of hope—not only for the Jewish refugees from Germany, but also for thousands of Jews from Poland who must migrate because of oppression—was seen in the official announcement this week that the government of Ecuador has agreed to set aside large tracts of land for Jewish colonization in Ecuador. The agreement, according to the announcement, has already been signed by the president of Ecuador. It gives a million and a quarter acre of land to the Jews, facilitating the settlement of not less than fifty thousand Jewish families.

Capital Comment

REACTION in official Washington circles to the renewed anti-Semitic and anti-Catholic drives now current in Germany are filled with a mixture of sympathy and condemnation. Underneath it all is the feeling that the United States should take positive action in protesting these anti-racial and anti-religious attacks which have been going on in Germany under complete governmental sanction ever since Hitler came into power in the Spring of 1933.

That the United States government may take official action against nations engaged in the persecution of minority groups, particularly in cases where American citizens are involved or affected, has been indicated by President Roosevelt. If this should be done, the present Administration would be following along traditional lines in the protection of the interests of minorities.

UP TO NOW, the Roosevelt Administration has been silent on the question of racial, religious and political persecution in foreign countries. Congressional and other demands for governmental protests to Germany on the persecution of Jews, particularly in Mexico on the treatment of Catholics, have been pigeon-holed. Nothing of an official public character has been put on record by the present Administration for the traditional American principle of religious liberty, particularly where the rights of United States citizens are involved. It is life came to regard the Administration's silence with deep concern. This concern grew deeper as anti-religious activities in Germany, particularly in Mexico, became more intense. The reason for this is quite obvious, since Mexico is so close to the United States. As a result of this keen interest, the American Congress circulated a petition among themselves. This petition requested an inquiry by the United States into the religious status of American citizens living in Mexico and pointed out the fact that this government had been placing a policy of silence while the anti-religious activities had been going on. The petition, signed by 242 House members, was placed in President Roosevelt's hands.

IMMEDIATELY upon receipt of the petition, President Roosevelt issued a statement which is being interpreted in Washington circles to mean that the United States may take a more vigorous attitude of disfavor toward foreign governments sponsoring the persecution of minority groups. The statement itself was significant in that it reaffirmed this country's desire for freedom of religious worship throughout the world. The statement of the President's reaction to the petition said, "The President stated that he is in sympathy with all people who make it clear that the American government believes in the freedom of religious worship, not only in the United States but also in other nations."

THE MOST RECENT anti-religious and anti-racial developments in Germany now are being watched in Washington with more than the usual amount of interest. There are many reasons behind this. The principal ones, however, arise out of President Roosevelt's reaffirmation of the United States' position on religious freedom, and the fact that Germany still is desirous of negotiating a trade agreement with this country.

From a practical standpoint, it appears as if Germany is more concerned with the future of her trade relations with the United States than she is with any other single item involved in German-American relations. Most of the conversations between the two governments have been about trade and financial matters.

WASHINGTON.

ON OR BEFORE October 15, it is expected that President Roosevelt will issue a proclamation barring German imports from most-favored-nation tariff rates and assessing the highest tariff rates against them. This indeed would be a severe blow at what little trade there remains between Germany and the United States in spite of the boycott against German-made goods. Such action would have the effect of almost keeping German-made goods out of the American market. Thus, Germany's ability to obtain dollar exchange with which to buy needed American cotton and other raw materials would further be crippled.

Such action by President Roosevelt is made necessary by the fact that on October 15 the most-favored nation clause in an old commercial treaty with Germany becomes operative as a result of a request made last spring by the German government. Unless a new trade understanding is reached between the two countries before that date, the United States will be obliged to withdraw from Germany the privileges of lower tariff rates on imported German goods which are now being enjoyed because of the most-favored-nation clause in the treaty. After October 15 a new agreement will become effective. This agreement, signed June 2, extends all provisions of the old treaty, except the most-favored-nation clause.

A NEW trade agreement between the United States and Germany is quite unlikely at this time. Under the reciprocal trade agreement, policies to which the United States clings, whatever reduction in tariffs are granted to individual nations must also be granted to all other countries that do not discriminate against the United States. By renouncing the most-favored-nation clause, Germany is trading itself now in effect, Germany has indicated that it would be impossible for her to comply with this most important requirement of reciprocal trade agreements.

Germany would like to enter into an agreement with the United States through which she could sell more of her goods in this country and be in position to obtain much-needed raw materials. Also, Germany wants to retain the right to extend special concessions to other countries with whom she may enter into trade agreements, without making these same concessions available to the United States, as demanded by this country's reciprocal trade agreement policy. In other words, the Hitler government is anxious to obtain special trading privileges from the United States. This country may expect to hear more about this desire as soon as Dr. Hans Luther, German ambassador to the United States, returns to this country from his visit to Berlin.

Illegal Immigrants End Hunger Strike Protest

JERUSALEM, July 19.—The six Jews held in jail for deportation as illegal immigrants have ended their hunger strike, it was announced today.

Four of the strikers broke their fast yesterday, and the remaining two, who had continued their strike, claiming that they cannot be deported because they are Russian citizens, terminated their fast

He will also meet in London with a number of Zionist and non-Zionist members of the Executive of the Jewish Agency.
