POLISH-JEWISH CHEMIST GETS 8-MONTH TERM FOR HITLER "INSULT"

WARSAW, Sept. 25. (JTA) -- Found guilty of "wilful insult" to Reich Chancellor Adolf Hitler, Nahum Halberstadt, Polish Jewish dealer in chemicals and laboratory supplies, was today sentenced to eight months imprisonment.

Packed with eager spectators, the courtroom was in a turmoil when the verdict was handed down.

Article III of the Criminal Code, which makes it a crime to insult the head of a friendly nation, provides maximum sentence of three years. But the court in passing sentence declared that it took into consideration extenuating circumstances, namely, the fact that Halberstadt "acted under provocation," and also that he was never before arraigned in a court.

Halberstadt's alleged slur on Hitler was contained in a letter written by him to a German chemical concern in 1933. On an inquiry from the German firm as to why he had broken off dealing with them, Halberstadt answered that he would not purchase goods made in Germany "as long as Hitler and his mob rule the country."

German postal authorities intercepted the letter, and following its submission to the Foreign Office, representations were made to the Polish Government.

Halberstadt was today permitted to go free in the custody of his attorney, Alexander Margolis, pending an appeal to a higher court.

HEBREW TEACHERS IN PALESTINE THREATEN STRIKE

JERUSALEM, Sept. 25. (JTA) -- The threat of a teachers' strike in most of Palestine's Hebrew schools was contained in an ultimatum given today by the Hebrew Teachers' Union to the Vaad Leumi, Jewish national council in Palestine.

The ultimatum declares that unless the wage scale of Hebrew teachers is increased, the teachers will not return to work on Monday, after Rosh Hashonah.

The Vaad Leumi issued a communique stating that lack of funds makes it impossible to meet the teachers' demand.

A special meeting of the council is being called for tomorrow, in the hope that some means of conciliation may be found.

RIFT IN RUMANIAN ANTI-SEMITIC FRONT WIDENS

BUCHAREST, Sept. 25. (JTA) -- Widening of the breach in the Rumanian anti-Semitic movement was disclosed today when it was learned that Prof. Alexander Cuza is convening his former League of Christian National Defense for a conference in Czernowitz this Saturday and Sunday. Prof. Cuza will deliver an address on the recent Nazi Party Congress in Nuremberg, Germany.

The Nuremberg congress was the cause of a serious rift between Prof. Cuza and Prof. Octavius Goga, Fascist leader in Rumania, who joined forces two months ago to form a united anti-Semitic organization known as the Christian Party. Prof. Cuza insisted that the organization be represented at the Nuremberg congress, while Prof. Goga opposed sending delegates.

Grave apprehension is felt in Jewish circles here because the conference of the Cuza part will take place on the same days as the Jewish New Year holiday.

QUOTA CLAUSE DROPPED FROM HUNGARIAN BILL ON LAWYERS

BUDAPEST, Sept. 25. (JTA) -- The racial clause in the proposed bill on the number of lawyers to be admitted to practice in Hungary has been dropped, according to a statement issued today by the Ministry of Justice, which sponsored the measure.

The bill would have empowered the Ministry of Justice to limit the number of new lawyers in proportion to the number of racial and religious minorities in the country.

The Hungarian Bar Association, at its conference last week, voiced militant opposition to the racial clause in the proposed bill.

OLDEST PALESTINE JEW, 116, DIES IN HAIFA

SOVIET PRESS MARKS 30TH BIRTHDAY OF EINSTEIN THEORY

MOSCOW, Sept. 25. (JTA) -- The entire Soviet press is running special articles to commemorate the thirtieth anniversary of the publication of Prof. Albert Einstein's relativity theory.

Pointing out that Einstein's article "Relativity -- Special and General Theory," which first appeared in a German-language scientific publication in 1905, was one of the greatest contributions to the scientific knowledge of humanity, the papers strongly emphasize the barbarity of the Nazis in Germany who drove Einstein into exile.

The papers also point out the fact that Einstein encountered numerous material difficulties as a student and scientist, and that he suffered considerably before he achieved world-wide recognition for his work.

CONFIRM REPORT NAZIS KILLED JEWISH FOOTBALL PLAYER IN SILESIA

PRAHA, Sept. 25. (JTA) -- Reports of the death of a Jewish player after being mobbed by Nazis during a Polish-German football match in Silesia were confirmed here today.

Both the Polish and German press suppressed all news of the incident, evidently fearing its possible effect on participation in the Olympic games.

The Jew, Edmond Baumgartner, 21, was one of the players on the Polish team in the match which took place in Ratibor, Silesia, Sept. 15. Nazi spectators shouted, "Come out, Jew!" and "Perish the Jew!" They stoned Baumgartner, forcing the referee to halt the game twice.

Finally, the mob invaded the grounds and set upon the Jewish player. He was removed to the hospital in serious condition and died three days later.

REICH STUDENT FRATERNITY REFUSES TO EXPEL JEWS

BERLIN, Sept. 25. (JTA) -- The student fraternity "Kosener Student Corporation," one of the oldest and best known in Germany, with many notables and Nazi officials on its membership rolls, has notified the office of Reich Chancellor Hitler that it will not adhere to the "Aryan" principle and will not expel its Jewish members, it was officially announced here today.

As a result of this daring and dangerous act, Nazi Storm Troop headquarters today issued an order forbidding its members to join the fraternity, and also warning that all Storm Troopers belonging to the student corporation must resign their membership before October 15, or be expelled from the Storm Troops.

A big anti-Jewish demonstration was today conducted in Guttstadt against Jewish "rassenschande" (race defilement).

A local Jew, Max Heilmann, was led through the streets by a mob carrying placards with the inscription "German Girls and Women Beware of Jewish Rassenschande."

An announcement was issued in Mannheim today that no Jews will be admitted to its annual Autumn bazaar.

Several Nazi officials today joined in accusing Jews of carrying on propaganda against Germany by engaging in libel suits against disseminators of the "Protocols of Zion." They attacked particularly the recent libel case in Cairo, but failed to mention the trial in Berne, Switzerland, at which the "Protocols" were declared to be a forgery.

The commander-in-chief of Storm Troops in Thuringia today orders his followers to abstain from maltreating Jews.

Complaining that reaction abroad to the newly enacted Reichstag laws "does not make the international situation easier for Germany for the time being," Der Schwartzter Korps, official organ of the Schutz Staffel, Hitler's personal bodyguard, in an editorial today protests that "this attitude shows that public opinion abroad does not understand these new measures."

Jews in Germany are to be recognized as guests only, the editorial says. As such, the Nazis will guarantee them freedom of religion and will permit them to conduct their own cultural activity, including the maintenance of segregated Jewish schools. The Nazis must insist, however, the paper emphasizes, that Jews accept this status as guests and live "within the limits of their own internal circles only."

The paper warns that if the Jews are dissatisfied with the status of guests, revision of the Reichstag laws will become necessary and the Jewish position will be made worse.

"We hope the Jews have in their own interests heard and understood what the voice of our leader pronounced before the Reichstag," the paper concludes.

NEW REICH-JEWISH BARTER PACT AIMS TO SPUR CYPRUS MIGRATION

BERLIN, Sept. 25. (JTA) -- A new barter pact between Germany and Jews to enable the latter to remove part of their capital from Germany in the form of German goods, has been concluded, it was officially announced here today.

The new pact is between the German Government and a Jewish committee in Berlin to promote emigration to Cyprus. The exact terms of the agreement are not made known yet, but it is expected to be patterned after that between Germany and Palestine.

The Berlin committee, it was revealed today, has already made arrangements to send a commission of experts to Cyprus on October 2, to create the basis for large colonization there of German Jews.

GER REBBE NARROWLY ESCAPES ARREST IN PALESTINE

Unaware that a permit is needed to visit the cave, which is now in Arab hands, the Ger Rebbe succeeded in vanishing when police arrested many of his followers who crowded around in an attempt to enter the holy tomb. Many of the Rebbe's followers were beaten up by the police.
