"ARYANS" WHO CONSORT WITH JEWS TO LOSE RIGHTS

BERLIN, Oct. 8. (JTA) -- "Aryans" maintaining social or business relations with Jews will be deprived of their municipal citizenship rights, the mayors of several German cities announced today.

In making the announcement the municipal heads stated that they are doing so "in accordance with the Nuremberg laws."

"Those who maintain social relations with Jews, are traitors to the nation," the mayor of Halsenbach decreed. "No traitor may enjoy citizenship rights in our midst."

A number of banks in Bavaria have stopped payment on checks issued to Jews. The banks declare that this action is prompted by the desire to prevent "Aryans" from patronizing Jewish shops.

In Pomerania, every Jewish enterprise has been ordered to display conspicuously the full name of the owner "to ensure that 'Aryans' will not be misled by the anonymity of the enterprise."

The Jewish owners of the famous Belischowsky linen firm in Breslau, the largest in Germany, have been forced to sell their business to "Aryans," it was reported here today.

Local authorities throughout Thuringia have reported that it is difficult for them to establish special schools for Jewish children. The new school law, issued by Minister of Education Rust, provides that such schools shall be established only where there are at least twenty Jewish children. In Thuringia, however, the Jewish population is widely distributed and as a result there are only four places in the whole province that number twenty children.

NEW JERSEY A.A.U. INSTRUCTS DELEGATES TO OPPOSE BERLIN OLYMPICS

NEWARK, N.J., Oct. 8. (JTA) -- Falling in line with the precedent set by the South Atlantic Association, the New Jersey Association of the Amateur Athletic Union last night instructed its six delegates to the national A.A.U. convention to oppose American participation in the Berlin Olympic games.

There are thirty-three regional associations which must hold conventions before the national parley Dec. 6, 7 and 8 at the Hotel Commodore here. With Jeremiah T. Mahoney, national president, pressing for the boycott, all the associations are expected to take some action.

An A.A.U. decision to boycott would virtually result in American withdrawal from the games, since the union controls most of the amateur athletes. Only amateurs may compete in the Olympics.

A movement to prevent college athletes (the only athletes who do not need A.A.U. sanction to participate) from going to Berlin was under way in colleges and universities throughout the country. Officials at Harvard University, Boston College and Columbia University have already voiced objections to allowing athletes to compete in the Berlin games. Fordham University and the College of the City of New York are among the institutions which are scheduled to take action shortly.

The New Jersey Association, by an open vote at its state convention adopted a resolution offered by Richard F. Hudson of Newark basing its action in instructing the delegates on "the treatment of various groups in Germany."

ARABS AGITATE AGAINST JEWS, NAZI PAPER REPORTS

BERLIN, Oct. 8. (JTA) -- The Arabs in Palestine are utilizing the war situation to start an organized movement "For Arab Palestine," the Voelkischer Beobachter, official Nazi organ, reports here from Jerusalem.

The Arabs in Palestine, the Voelkischer Beobachter alleges, are trying to force the British Mandatory Power to discontinue Jewish immigration immediately. Arab leaders are planning several huge demonstrations, the paper states.

The paper also alleges that the movement is spreading into Syria.

NAZI WEEKLY WOULD BAR CONVERSION TO JEWS

BERLIN, Oct. 8. (JTA) -- A demand that no Jew be permitted to undergo conversion to Christianity and that all former conversions be annulled, was voiced here today by Der Judenkenner, anti-Semitic weekly.

The Judenkenner makes its demands on the ground that the churches are guilty of tolerating "this veiled race-violation."

RUMANIA BARS ANTI-SEMITIC PARTY'S PARLEY

BUCHAREST, Oct. 8. (JTA) -- Following the intervention of Dr. Ebner, president of the Jewish Community, and Deputy Fischer, the Rumanian Minister of the Interior prohibited the anti-Semitic League of Christian National Defence, headed by Prof. Alexander Cuza, from holding their conference in Czernowitz.

Originally scheduled for September 28 and 29, to coincide with the Jewish New Year, the conference had been postponed for Monday to coincide with Yom Kippur.

Prof. Cuza was to have delivered an address on the results of the recent German Nazi Party Congress in Nuremberg.

SURVEY REVEALS HAIFA HAS NOT BEEN FORTIFIED

JERUSALEM, Oct. 8. (JTA) -- Rumors circulated abroad about the fortification of Haifa, Palestine seaport town, because of the Italo-Ethiopian war, are thus far baseless, a Jewish Telegraphic Agency survey there disclosed today.

Except for a slight economic nervousness, especially in Tel Aviv, the all-Jewish city, Palestine is so far unaffected by the war and is continuing its normal work though it is eagerly watching developments.

Haifa, whose harbor has recently been greatly developed, is the terminus for the Mosul pipe-lines and one of the most valuable oil-shipping ports on the Mediterranean.

BLEW SHOFAR AT WAILING WALL, REVISIONIST IS JAILED

JERUSALEM, Oct. 8. (JTA) -- For blowing the Ram's Horn near the Wailing Wall on Yom Kippur, Shraga Haikin, a newcomer from Kaunas, Lithuania, was in jail here today.

Haikin is a member of Brith Trumpeldor, Zionist Revisionist youth group.

According to a ruling made by the international commission appointed by the League of Nations to draw up regulations for worshippers at the Wailing Wall, believed to be the only remaining wall of the Temple, after riots between Jews and Arabs had occurred there, the blowing of the Shofar, is forbidden.

Last year Chaim Ruben Horowitz, a Zionist Revisionist, was arrested for attempting to blow the Shofar near the Wailing Wall. The year before, Aaron Zuckerman, also a Zionist Revisionist, was arrested for a similar offense.

JEWS OUT OF GERMAN CULTURE, HINKEL BOASTS

DRESDEN, Oct. 8. (JTA) -- The elimination of Jews from German cultural fields has been completed, Hans Hinkel, special commissar for Jewish intellectual and artistic affairs, declared today, in an address before a Nazi meeting here.

Hinkel pointed out that Jews have been completely ousted from the film industry, where they formerly dominated, and from the German theater. Jews have also been completely eliminated from the journalistic field and from the schools, he said. "Their influence on German culture today is nil," the Nazi cultural commissar declared.

WAUCHOPE RETURNS TO LONDON AFTER VACATION

LONDON, Oct. 8. (JTA) -- Sir Arthur Grenfell Wauchope, High Commissioner for Palestine, returned here today from a vacation in Scotland. It is understood he will take up with the British Colonial Office the question of the proposed representative legislative Council for Palestine.

Norman Bentwich, former attorney general of Palestine, in a letter to the London Times suggests that in inaugurating a legislative council in Palestine, Jews should be treated equally with the Arabs. Both should have the same number of representatives, Mr. Bentwich proposes.

5 NAZIS BEATEN WHILE ADVERTISING RALLY IN GARMENT CENTER

NEW YORK, Oct. 8. (JTA) -- Five brown-shirted members of the American National Socialist League who rode through the garment center in a truck today to advertise a Nazi Yorkville meeting with signs and handbills were saved from injury by mounted police and radio car squads who arrived in time to disperse a crowd of 2,500 which had begun to beat them.

When the motor inadvertently stalled, the crowd dragged the Nazis from the truck. There were no serious injuries reported. One Nazi and two of the crowd were arrested.

HARBIN MERCHANT BELIEVED KILLED BY CAPTORS

HARBIN, Oct. 8. (JTA) -- M. Leonson, Harbin Jewish provision merchant, who was kidnaped by bandits several months ago, is believed to have been killed by his captors, it was revealed here today.

His wife, who has been negotiating for his release, has had no word from the agent of the kidnapers since July 31, when a

ransom of \$5,000 was demanded. She agreed to pay this sum but demanded a letter from her husband as proof that he is still alive.

The agent of the kidnaping gang declared that this could not be produced as Leonson had been "bricked into a pit" from which there was no egress. Although food could be thrown in to him, he could not pass anything out, his captors alleged.

11 NARAS SENTENCED TO JAIL TERMS FOR RIOT SLAYING

WARSAW, Oct. 8. (JTA) -- Four Naras, members of the anti-Semitic National Radical Party, were today sentenced to five and one-half years imprisonment each for the murder of Jechezkiel Delman, a Jew, in a riot in Powonski section of Warsaw, in June, 1934.

Six other Naras were sentenced to two years each, and one was sentenced to one year in the penitentiary, for their share in the riot. Eleven other Naras were acquitted for lack of evidence.

Delman's family will be paid one zloty, less than twenty cents, moral damages by the prisoners. Delman's mother sued for this amount, in order to be able to bring out the political character of the Nara riots. The court, however, ruled that the trial must be strictly non-political and did not allow Lawyer Surewicz, attorney for Delman's mother, to proceed with his speech.

All except the first four convicted Naras were released on bail today pending an appeal.

Delman was murdered in a riot instigated by the Naras in the Warsaw suburb on Friday night, June 8, 1934. The Naras marched through the Powonski section, demolishing Jewish shops and homes. Delman, 35, was seriously wounded and later died in the Jewish hospital. The terror-stricken Jews fled to the center of Warsaw, and did not return to their homes until the authorities assured them of police protection.

POLISH OFFICIALS AT RITES FOR WISLICKI

WARSAW, Oct. 8. (JTA) -- Funeral rites were conducted here today for Wacław Wislicki, president of the Central Jewish Merchants Association and member of the Polish Sejm, who died here last Friday following a heart attack.

atives of Polish and Jewish businessmen's associations, participated. Wislicki's bier was piled high with floral tributes. Graveside eulogies emphasized Wislicki's great services in the fight for Polish independence and also for the defense of Polish Jewish rights.
