LUDENDORFF SEES JEWS AGAINST MUSSOLINI

BERLIN, Oct. 9. (JTA) -- Under the heading "Jewish Front Against Mussolini," the current issue of Halbmonatschrift out today, carries an article by General Erich Ludendorff, accusing the Jews of instigating the Italo-Ethiopian war.

"England and the Jews are now going together against Italy," Ludendorff alleges.

The former member of the German General Staff and Hitler aide in the latter's beer-hall putsch in Munich asserts that world Jewry has always aided Great British in to inflame the world." Jewry helped British imperialism in the 18th century and also in the last World War, he writes, stating that the Balfour Declaration was Britain's remuneration to the Jews for this support.

The article further asserts that Jews sought to stir a revolution against Mussolini, and also to help the expansion of Ethiopia because "Jews are the illegitimate children of the Queen of Sheba."

REICH JEWS PIAN THEIR OWN WINTER RELIEF DRIVE

BERLIN, Oct. 9. (JTA) -- Deprived of a share in the Winter Relief Campaign to be opened today by Reich Chancellor Hitler, Jews will conduct their own campaign for Winter relief with the permission of the government, according to a plan submitted to the authorities today by the Reichsvertretung, central representative body of Jews in Germany.

Approval of the plan by the Nazi Commissariat for Winter Relief is expected tomorrow.

The plan provides for special Jewish fund collections among Jews similar to the campaign to be waged among the Nazis. The larger

Jewish communities will share part of their income with the smaller communities.

The Berlin Jewish Community Council declared that it would conduct its own campaign by visiting all Jewish houses, and also by soliciting Jewish firms to assign a percentage of their income for Jewish relief. Jews will also be urged to sacrifice one meal a month, contributing what it would cost to the relief fund.

PALESTINE APPROVES HEBREW U. BUILDING PLANS

JERUSALEM, Oct. 9. (JTA) -- Approved by the Palestine Government, the Hebrew University is now preparing to proceed with its program of expansion, including the construction of the Rosenbloom Building for the Faculty of Humanities, named after the late Sol Rosenbloom, Pittsburgh merchant, it was announced here today.

Other buildings to be erected are the Students' Dormitory, the Institutes for Climatology and Science, the University offices and various other buildings.

They are all to be located on Mount Scopus, site of the University. The bulk of the funds for the new buildings will, it is expected, come from American donors.

RUMANIA LIFTS BAN ON HITLER'S BOOK

BUCHAREST, Oct. 9. (JTA) -- The ban on Hitler's book "Mein Kampf" was lifted today by the Rumanian authorities.

The book had been prohibited since the Nazis seized power in Germany in 1933.

LIBEL CONVICTION NOT TO AFFECT TISSOF CANDIDACY

OTTAWA, Ont., Oct. 9. (JTA) -- Although convicted of criminal libel, the name of Jean Tissot, anti-Semitic and anti-Communist candidate for Ottawa East will appear on the ballots in next Monday's federal elections here, it was revealed today.

Dominion election officials today said that Tissot's conviction will not interfere with his name appearing on Monday's ballot papers as he is eligible for election.

Tissot was yesterday found guilty by a jury in the Ontario Surreme Court on two charges of criminal libel against A. J. Freiman,

president of the Zionist Organization of Canada and prominent Ottawa merchant.

Tissot libelled Freiman by delivering to William M. Graham and Herbert G. Munro, department store executives, a typewritten document purporting to be an English translation of an article appearing in Le Patriote! Montreal anti-Semitic publication, and a cartoon from the same paper carleaturing Freiman.

A former detective with a record of 25 years on the Ottawa police force, Tissot was committed to jail yesterday. He will probably be sentenced at the end of the week.

During the trial Mumro said that Tissot last Winter sought to enlist his help "to drive all Jews out of Ottawa" and to form an association of Christian merchants.

2 REICH JEWISH LEADERS ARRESTED BY GESTAPO

EERLIN, Oct. 9. (JTA) -- Dr. Otto Hirsch, President of the Executive Board of the Reichsvertretung, central Jewish representative body in Germany, was arrested today by the Gestapo, German secret police.

Chief Rabbi Dr. Leo Baeck, president of the Reichsverbretung, was arrested Monday for issuing a Yom Kippur message to German Jews on behalf of the Reichsverbretung, it became known today.

The text of the message was to have been read in every synagogue throughout the country on Yom Kippur, but at the eleventh hour the Gestapo telegraphed instructions prohibiting reading of the message. The message contained several passages referring to the present oppression of the Jews in Germany.

After being detained for 24 hours in the notorious Columbia House, known as the "torture chamber of the Gestapo," Dr. Baeck was released.

Dr. Hirsch, who was absent from Berlin on Yom Kippur, was arrested when he returned today. His fate is so far not known.

Great consternation was caused among members of the Jewish community here today when they first learned of the arrest of these two outstanding leaders of German Jewry. This is the first time that the Mazis have dered to arrest the Chief Rabbi of Germany, thus interfering with Jewish religious life.

NAZI PRESS REPORTS PALESTINE WATCHING ITALO-ARAB RELATIONS

BERLIN, Oct. 9. (JTA) -- In connection with the Italo-Ethiopian war, Germany has suddenly begun to show a marked interest in the situation in Palestine.

Reports based on the Arab press appear in today's German newspapers, which feature cabled dispatches from Jerusalem alleging that the Palestine government has instituted a strict watch over the relations between Palestine Arabs and the Italian consulates.

The papers also report that Ragheb Bey Nashashibi, former mayor of Jerusalem and leader of a strongly nationalist Arab party, to-day issued a call to all Arab parties in Palestine, Transjorden and Syria for an understanding that would enable them to utilize the present international situation to achieve Arab independence.

Nashashibi, the German papers report, also urged the calling of an Arab congress to create a united Arab front.

The Deutsche Nachrichten Bureau, German news service, today states that twenty British war ships are now anchored at Akaba. Another report states that Italian steamers are subjected to strict control when docking and clearing at Haifa harbor, and also at Jaffa and Akaba.
