NAZIS ARREST DAUGHTER OF AUSTRIA'S CHIEF RABBI

VIENNA, Oct. 14. (JTA) -- Edith Taglicht, daughter of the seventy-four-year old Chief Rabbi Taglicht, has been arrested in Berlin for writing an anti-Nazi article, it was learned here today.

Rabbi Israel Taglicht has asked and received Cardinal Innitzer's promise to intervene in behalf of his daughter. Dr. Taglicht left here today for Berlin.

Miss Taglicht, a teacher of Jewish religion in Berlin schools, was meanwhile transferred to Moabit Prison.

GREEK JEWS UNAFFECTED BY RESTORATION OF MONARCHY

SALONICA, Oct. 14. (JTA) -- The situation of the Jews remains unaffected by the proclamation of a monarchy in Greece.

Field Marshal George Kondylis, the new Regent, who is also Premier and Minister of Navy, declared today that, "We cannot forget that we are indebted to the Jews for our God." Premier Kondylis has been known for his pro-Jewish sentiment in the past.

At least one of the cabinet ministers, Theotokis Mandas, has repeatedly expressed appreciation of the Jews' contributions.

The monarchy was restored in Greece last Thursday after a military coup d'etat which removed President Zaimis from power.

NEW PIPE LINE TO GIVE JERUSALEM ADEQUATE WATER SUPPLY

JERUSALEM, Oct. 14. (JTA) -- For the first time in recent history the residents of Jerusalem will have an adequate water supply

when the Ras-el-Ain pipe-line opens on or about Nov. 1, according to the report of Mayor Khalidi to the Municipal Council.

The demand is at first expected to be about 1,000,000 gallons daily. The present consumption of water is less than 750,000 gallons.

Two or three pumps will be used continuously, each pumping 800 gallons of water a minute. If the demand increases, there is room for installation of a fourth set of Diesel engines and pumps.

The profits of the first two months' operation of the new system are expected to defray the cost of scrapping the present pipe-lines.

VAAD LEUMI PROTESTS TO LEAGUE ON REICH LAWS

JERUSALEM, Oct. 14. (JTA) -- The Vaad Leumi, Jewish national council of Palestine, today forwarded to the League of Nations a protest against the marriage and citizenship laws recently enacted by the German Reichstag at Nuremberg.

The protest urged the League to "stand up and protect persecuted Jewry against this degradation and defamation."

CANADIAN JEWISH CONGRESS PROTESTS NAZI LAWS

MONTREAL, Que., Oct. 14. (JTA) -- A protest in behalf of Canadian Jewry was cabled to the League of Nations today against German legislation "which has outlawed German Jewry" by S. W. Jacobs, president of the Canadian Jewish Congress.

JEWS HIT PROPOSED ANGLO-GERMAN FOOTBALL GAME

LONDON, Oct. 14. (JTA) -- Thousands of Jewish sports fans are lodging indignant protests against the holding of an international Anglo-German football match, scheduled to be played Dec. 4 on the Hotspurs Grounds at Tottenham.

As a result of the protests the Tottenham Club is considering the advisability of withdrawing the use of the field for the match.

RADIO PHONE SERVICE OPENS BETWEEN SALONICA, PALESTINE

SALONICA, Oct. 14. (JTA) -- Direct radio telephone service between Salonica and Palestine was inaugurated today.

PARIS POLICE GUARD AGAINST ANTI-SEMITIC RIOTING

PARIS, Oct. 14. (JTA) -- After a number of complaints had been lodged, the Paris police prefecture gave assurances that the strictest measures would be taken to prevent adherents of the Solidarite Francais, French Fascist and anti-Semitic organization, from rioting in the Jewish districts of Paris, it was learned today.

Two weeks ago three persons were injured in a riot in the Jewish section of the city.

TWO GERMANS SENT TO CONCENTRATION CAMP FOR MISTREATING JEWS

BERLIN, Oct. 14. (JTA) -- Two Germans in the town of Hassloch have been confined in the Dachau concentration camp for brutal treatment of Jews, the Ludwigshaven state police announced yesterday in a communique.

One of them, a butcher, was especially guilty of conduct calculated to injure the prestige of the Nazi Party, the communique said, because he not only mistreated a Jew but had business dealings with him.

VIENNA JEWS LAUNCH WINTER RELIEF DRIVE

VIENNA, Oct. 14. (JTA) -- In connection with the steadily worsening plight of Jewish professional classes and German refugees here, the executive board of the Vienna Jewish Community today issued a proclamation calling for special Winter relief for the needy.

Refugees coming from Germany are frequently obliged to flee without funds or property and arrive here penniless, proving a serious maintenance problem for the Jewish community. The systematic unofficial campaign against Jewish professionals has impoverished hundreds of them.

Striking figures illustrating the impoverishment of the Vienna Jewish Community were given by Dr. Joseph Loewenherz, vice-president and treasurer of the community, in an interview with the Jewish Telegraphic Agency.

Impoverishment of the middle class, he stated, has reduced from 60,000 in 1929 to 48,000 this year the number of contributors to the support of the board of the community. In the bank clerks' group alone, the community has lost about 4,000 payers of a special tax, the number having decreased to 325.

REICH JEWS URGED BY LEADERS TO CONCENTRATE ON EMIGRATION

BERLIN, Oct. 14. (JTA) -- German Jewry was urged by its leaders tonight to concentrate on leaving Germany "since there is no other alternative left," at the first public meeting devoted to emigration.

At the same time, the Reich Government issued an order which will prevent Jews wishing to leave the country from taking with them even such capital as was hitherto permitted under the currency regulations.

The edict, known as "Order 198," declares that recently there has been a sudden rise in the demand for foreign bonds, which emigrants are allowed to take out of the country, owing to the increase in the number of persons wishing to emigrate.

The order therefore instructs custom authorities to cancel immediately and with retroactive effect all permits issued to emigrants to withdraw bonds and to issue no new permits, except where the emigrants are able to prove that the bonds were purchased before January, 1933.

German-Jewish circles regarded the order as a serious blow to the Jews since it deprives them of practically the last chance of taking any capital out of Germany, even at a loss.

The increase in bond activity became noticeable after the passage of the new marriage and citizenship laws by the Reichstag at Nuremberg Sept. 16.

The meeting on emigration was addressed by a number of leaders of the Berlin Jewish Community, who declared that there was no other solution to the problem of the German Jews.

Increased emigration of Jewish youths to Palestine is the purpose of a three-day all-German conference of Hechalutz, organization promoting Jewish pioneer work in Palestine, which opened here tonight.

The meeting was greeted by Dr. Leo Baeck, chief rabbi of Germany and president of the Reichsvertretung der Deutschen Juden; Dr. Franz Mayer, general secretary of the German Zionist Federation and Herren Adler and Rudel of the Reichsvertretung.

The conference will work out a program whereby the training of Jewish youths for pioneering in Palestine will be carried out in Jewish schools since hachsharah (training for agricultural work in Palestine) is becoming increasingly difficult as a result of restrictions on Jewish farming.

REICH TOWN RENAMES MAHLERSTRASSE FOR "ARYAN"

BERLIN, Oct. 14. (JTA) -- Mahlerstrasse, the street in Dahlem named after Gustav Mahler, noted Jewish composer, today became Regerstrasse, after Max Reger, "Aryan" musician, by order of the Municipal Council.

ANTI-JEWISH DRIVE GAINS MOMENTUM ON 3 FRONTS IN REICH

BERLIN, Oct. 14. (JTA) -- The anti-Jewish drive gained momentum today with attacks against the Jewish position in Germany being concentrated on three distinct fronts--charity, business and the legal profession.

In an internal order, Propaganda Minister Paul Joseph Goebbels demanded that the word Winter be eliminated from the name describing the special campaign German Jews were forced to inaugurate when they were ordered excluded from participation in the general Winter relief drive.

The same order directs the Nazi press to refrain from mentioning the Jewish drive, in order to avoid "confusion with the general campaign." At the same time the Jewish press has been ordered to describe the Jewish relief campaign as the "Jewish Charities Campaign."

German Jewry was in a state bordering on panic today as a result of Minister of the Interior Wilhelm Frick's announcement that the government is planning "legal measures" to restrict the economic activities of the Jews. Frick's announcement, which marked the first time that a cabinet member has officially announced government plans for the ousting of Jews from commerce, was widely published in today's German press.

In the legal profession, it became clear today that even those Jewish lawyers who have been previously exempt from provisions of the "Aryan Clause" will soon be deprived of the right to practice. Indication of this development's imminence was contained in a circular sent out by the Ministry of Justice which states that all lawyers are required to register anew with the department.

The new registration, the circular specifies, must show proof of racial origin as qualification under the "Aryan clause." The order is in accord with the speeches made at Nuremberg recently in which it was demanded that not a single Jew be admitted to German courts. If put into effect, the order will add hundreds of Jewish families to the number put in desperate straits as a result of disbarment of Jewish lawyers since the advent of the Nazi regime.
