REICH PUBLICATION URGES VIOLENCE AGAINST JEWS

BERLIN, Dec. 13. (JTA) -- Violence is urged as the only solution of the Jewish question in Germany in today's issue of the Deutsche Podium, music publication published under control of the Ministry of Propaganda and the Reich Chamber of Music.

Appealing to German musicians not to play the works of Jewish composers during the Christmas month, the magazine declares:

"History has taught us that there is only one way of fighting the Jews and that is violence. If the parlor anti-Semites do not believe this, let them consider the fact that even the severest anti-Jewish laws in the world today have not succeeded in checking the Jews."

NAZIS RELEASE PHILADELPHIA GIRL, HOLD FATHER

BERLIN, Dec. 13. (JTA) -- Jennie Goodhartz, American-Jewish citizen of Philadelphia, who with her father Sam has been held in Karlsruhe prison since last July on charges of violating Germany's exchange laws, was released today pending trial.

News of the release was given the Jewish Telegraphic Agency by United States Consul Hoenniger in Stuttgart, who has intervened in the case and is pressing for trial before the end of the month.

Mr. Goodhartz continued to be held in jail. Miss Goodhartz's passport is still detained by the authorities.

TOWN WITHOUT JEW GETS "STUERMER" DISPLAY

BERLIN, Dec. 13. (JTA) -- Although not a single Jew is left in the town of Wiesensteig, Julius Streicher's anti-Semitic weekly Der Stuermer went on display in the town's public square today with the explanation that it was intended to "keep the youth fit for anti-Jewish action."

"ARYANS" BUY CONTROL OF JEWISH FIRM IN FRANKFURT

FRANKFURT-AM-MAIN, Dec. 13. (JTA) -- Control of the Jewish-owned Carl Froelich Corporation, wholesale food distributors, today passed into "Aryan" hands. According to the terms of the sale, seventy-five per cent of the company's stock was purchased outright, the remainder, valued at 64,000 marks, being held by the present ownership. A provision in the sale agreement requires the Jewish-owned shares to be deposited with a notary as guarantee that they will not be offered on the market.

TEL AVIV LIBRARY APPEALS FOR BOOKS

CINCINNATI, Dec. 13. (JTA) -- An appeal for books to fill the shelves of the Tel Aviv Municipal Library has been received by Jacob R. Marcus of the Hebrew Union College.

The appeal points out that the beautiful building has few volumes because the Palestine Government does not look with favor upon an appropriation for the library.

The library of the all-Jewish city, the appeal says, needs reference books of a general nature as well as books of Jewish interest.

MCDONALD SAILS SUNDAY FOR NEW YORK

LONDON, Dec. 13. (JTA) -- League of Nations High Commissioner for Refugees James G. McDonald will leave for New York Sunday on the Manhattan, it was announced here today. Mr. McDonald is resigning his League post at the end of the year.

NAZI POLITICAL POLICE ARREST RABBI

BERLIN, Dec. 13. (JTA) -- The political police today arrested Rabbi Dr. Ignatz Maibaum, distinguished spiritual leader of Frankfurt-am-Oder. The arrest was made following an address made by Dr. Maibaum at a Jewish meeting.

JEWISH STORE FORCED TO EMPLOY NAZI EXECUTIVE

BERLIN, Dec. 13. (JTA) -- To force the Jewish owners of the Bachrach Bros. Department Store to employ "Aryan" help, the local authorities of the city of Magdeburg today publicly charged all the store's Jewish employes with maintaining intimate relations with the "Aryan" salesgirls.

The chief of police announced officially that he has forced the store's owners to dismiss the director of personnel and replace him with a member of the Nazi party.

LOCKER, VLADECK TO DEBATE TRANSFER PACT

NEW YORK, Dec. 13. (JTA) -- A public debate on the topic, "Is the Germany-Palestine Transfer Agreement Justified?" will be held

at Mecca Temple Dec. 22. Berl Locker, former member of the World Zionist Executive, will defend the agreement; B.C. Vladeck, general manager of the Jewish Daily Forward, will oppose it. The debate is jointly sponsored by the Poale Zion-Zeire Zion Organization and the Jewish Labor Committee.

SURVEY BY PRAHA JEWS REPORTS TOO MANY IN PROFESSIONS

PRAHA, Czechoslovakia (JTA) -- There are too many Jews in the liberal professions in Czechoslovakia, declares the Praha Jewish Community in its official organ.

In connection with the decision of the community to establish a special Inquiry Bureau for Jewish professionals, the newspaper deplores the preponderance of Jews in the intellectual proletariat and urges Jews to attend artisan schools.

Official figures for the school year 1933-4 quoted in the journal show 37,594 Jews attended Czech municipal schools, 7,783 went to elementary schools, 8,205 to secondary schools, 82 to agricultural schools, 1,359 to trade schools, 1,482 to artisan and special schools and 781 in other schools.

In higher education institutions, there were 3,607 Jews including 746 from abroad. Of these 1,410 are studying medicine and 1,178 law.

KURT BLUMENFELD NAMED TO HEBREW U. POST

JERUSALEM (JTA) -- Dr. Kurt Blumenfeld, German Zionist leader now resident in Palestine, has been appointed head of the Organization and Propaganda Department of the Hebrew University.

Before coming here, Dr. Blumenfeld was president of the German Zionist Federation more than ten years and a member of the Zionist Actions Committee since 1920.

816 GAVE \$1,000 OR MORE TO FEDERATIONS

NEW YORK, Dec. 13. (JTA) -- More than half of the income of five of the largest Jewish federations and welfare funds in 1934 came from 816 contributors who gave \$1,000 or more, it was disclosed in an analysis of Baltimore, Chicago, Brooklyn, New York and Toronto contained in the report on financing for the fiscal year of 1934 of the National Council of Jewish Federations and Welfare Funds.

The five federations raised a total of \$4,677,538 in 1934 in 54,724 contributions ranging from less than \$5 to \$5,000 and over, the report showed. The Jewish population of these five communities is approximately 2,180,000.

Slightly over 85 per cent of the funds were raised in gifts of \$100 and over from 13.8 of the total number of subscribers.

At the other end of the scale, gifts under \$100, received from 86.2 per cent of the number of subscribers, account for only 14.8 of the total.

The situation is somewhat different in smaller communities, the report stated. In these there is found a greater dependence on small gifts.

REVISIONISTS TO LAUNCH \$100,000 CAMPAIGN

PARIS (JTA) -- A \$100,000 campaign will be conducted between Dec. 29 and Jan. 5 to build a National Workers Home in Palestine, it was decided at a joint meeting of the executive committee of the New Zionist Organization and the directorate of the Keren Tel Hai. Proceeds will also be used for improving pioneer training farms and for the internal national loan approved by the NZO Vienna congress in September.

ANTI-OLYMPICS PARADE MARKS FRENCH SOCCER GAMES

PARIS, Dec. 13. (JTA) -- Mounting sentiment against holding of the Olympic Games in Berlin reached a climax today during a soccer match at Vincennes Stadium near here when a group of sportsmen paraded around the field in an anti-Berlin demonstration.

The paraders carried posters bearing the inscription:

"Transfer the Olympic Games from Berlin elsewhere."

Formation of an anti-Olympics committee, called "Fair Play", was announced today. M. Campinchi, attorney, was named chairman of the committee. Among the foreign members listed on its board are Sir Robert Mond of London and Judge Louis D. Brodsky of New York.
