### NAZI ECONOMIST URGES JEWISH CAPITAL BE WIPED OUT

BERLIN, Dec. 21. (JTA) -- Jewish firms with a capitalization totalling millions of marks passed into "Aryan" hands in the past week, it is announced in the Voelkischer Beobachter, official organ of the Nazi Party.

Coincident with this announcement, the German press published reports of an appeal issued by Werner Daitz, leading Nazi economist, to wipe out Jewish capital in Germany.

Addressing a meeting yesterday of Hitler Youth leaders, Herr Daitz declared that "the Jewish capitalistic manner must be uprooted from Germany because it has poisoned the cultural Nordic." He charged that Jewish capitalists are to blame for the spirit of imperialism in the world today and insisted that the "pure Nordic spirit" must prevail in the Reich.

### KISSED WILLING "ARYAN" GIRL, YOUNG JEW JAILED FOR 3 MONTHS

BERLIN, Dec. 21. (JTA) -- The girl, an "Aryan", was willing. The youth, a Jew of 18, was willing. So they kissed. But somebody told and today the Jewish youth began a three-month term in a Darmstadt jail.

The court, according to Berlin newspaper reports of the case, in sentencing the youth ruled as follows:

"Although the girl wanted to be kissed, the accused should have known that in these days no such tenderness (between Jews and 'Aryans') is permitted."

### WAR VETERAN GIVEN YEAR'S JAIL TERM FOR "RASSENSCHANDE"

BERLIN, Dec. 21. (JTA) -- Because he continued to maintain a three-year-old relationship with an "Aryan" woman in defiance of the

Nuremberg laws which make "Rassenschande" (race defilement) a crime, a Mannheim court has sentenced a Jewish war veteran to a year's term in jail. In passing sentence, the press reports, the court explained it was lenient in consideration of the defendant's war record.

PLAN WORLD CONGRESS OF LITHUANIAN JEWS

KAUNAS, Lithuania, Dec. 21. (JTA) -- The Jewish War Veterans of Lithuania today submitted a petition to the Government asking permission to convoke a world congress of Lithuanian Jews to be held here next August.

U.S. JEWRY PAYS TRIBUTE TO MISS SZOLD ON 75TH BIRTHDAY

NEW YORK, Dec. 22. (JTA) -- Jews of the United States paused yesterday to pay tribute to the Grand Old Lady of American Zionism, Miss Henrietta Szold, on the occasion of her seventy-fifth birthday,

While 300 chapters of Hadassah, women's Zionist organization which she founded, were celebrating the event throughout the country, and hundreds of rabbis were devoting their Chanukkah sermons to extolling her career, Miss Szold passed the day quietly with her family in Baltimore.

From Governor Herbert H. Lehman of New York came the following message, released by Hadassah:

"At the age of 73 Miss Szold, with historic courage, undertook the task of rescuing the disinherited children of Germany, and today, upon her 75th birthday, she has the joy of finding Hadassah, the creation of her spirit, turning its immense reservoir of energy to the service of those children and to the fulfillment of one of the greatest tasks that has yet confronted the Jewish people."

Glowing tribute to Miss Szold was paid by Dr. Israel Goldstein, president of the Jewish National Fund of America, in a sermon at Congregation B'nai Jeshurun of which he is rabbi.

Dr. Goldstein said in part:

"Henrietta Szold is not only the greatest Jewish woman of American Israel, but probably ranks with Justice Louis D. Brandeis and Dr. Stephen S. Wise, as one of the three outstanding Jewish personalities to the credit of American Jewry today. . . . On this Macca-bean Festival, when we recall the story of Judith and of Hannah, we can speak of Miss Szold as one who represents a synthesis of Judith's nationalistic zeal and Hannah's religious passion.

JEWISH RESEARCH ACADEMY MEETS DEC. 26

NEW YORK, Dec. 22. (JTA) -- The annual meeting of the American Academy for Jewish Research will be held Dec. 26 at the Jewish Theological Seminary, it was announced today by Prof. Salo W. Baron, corresponding secretary.

Papers will be presented by Prof. Baron, Dr. S. Belkin, Prof. Z. Diesendruck, Dr. Abraham S. Halkin, Dr. Michael Higger, Prof. Guido Kisch, Dr. Paul Romanoff, Dr. Samuel Rosenblatt, and Prof. Solomon Zeitlin.

MASLIANSKY SEES U.S., PALESTINE, IDEAL FOR JEWS

TEL AVIV (JTA) -- "The United States is the only country, with the exception of Palestine, where a Jew can live a completely Jewish life," declared Zvi Hirsch Masliansky, 80-year-old dean of American Zionists, at a meeting of the American Jewish Association here. Mr. Masliansky recently came here from New York to live.

He asserted that the basis of Zionist operations must be in the United States, where the Jewish center of gravity lies. He cited the fact that four and a half million Jews live in the United States.

He lauded the support that American Jews are giving to Zionist work in Palestine.

PALESTINE FIRM LEADER URGES ARAB-JEWISH ACCORD

TEL AVIV (JTA) -- A warning that unless measure are taken for Jewish-Arab cooperation soon, future cooperation will be impossible is contained in an article by Moshe Smilansky, president of the Jewish Farmers Association, in Boustena, the association's organ.

Citing the growing nationalist tendency the worldover, Mr. Smilansky declares that the merest spark could explode the enmity between the Jews and the Arabs, unless steps are taken to assure peaceful collaboration in a land which, he says, belongs to both peoples.

To this end, he suggests that the consciousness of common ties between Jew and Arab be developed in the younger generation.

WAUCHOPE NOTIFIES ARAB LEADERS OF LEGISLATIVE COUNCIL

JERUSALEM, Dec. 21. (JTA) -- A brief communique issued by the Government announced that the High Commissioner, Sir Arthur Grenfell Wauchope, yesterday received a group of Arab notables and proposed the establishment of a legislative council for Palestine.

Today, the High Commissioner will meet with Zionist leaders to make the same announcement.

The event, which came with dramatic suddenness after having long been postponed, has stirred all Palestine to the depths. Jewish leaders of all groups throughout the world have long waged an energetic battle against the proposed semi-democratic assembly, charging that Palestine Jewry will be fixed permanently as a minority under such a legislative set-up.

WAUCHOPE ANNOUNCES COUNCIL OF 28 MEMBERS, INCLUDING 7 JEWS

JERUSALEM, Dec. 22, (JTA) -- A Legislative council for Palestine comprising twenty-eight members was officially announced by the High Commissioner, Sir Arthur Grenfell Wauchope, at a meeting yesterday with Arab leaders.

Stating that the Government, as a result of its satisfactory experience with local municipal governments which are operated on the council plan, had become convinced that the time was ripe for the establishment of a national assembly, Sir Arthur divulged the following details:

The council will comprise seven Jews, five Government officials, three Arab Christians, eleven Moslems and two merchants, one of whom it is believed will be a Jew.

Three of the seven Jews will be appointed, the remaining council seats allotted to the Jews to be filled by election.

Of the eleven Moslem seats in the council, three will be filled by appointment and eight by election.

The council will not have jurisdiction in political questions of any nature, the High Commissioner stated, although he failed to specify which political questions he meant.

The president of the assembly, Sir Arthur revealed, will not be elected and will not be connected with Palestine. It is believed that the office will be filled by a British Government official from London.

Following the meeting, it was learned that the Arab leaders had reserved their answer, informing the High Commissioner that they would give him their official reaction on January 7 after a conference of the Arab parties.

The full text of Sir Arthur's speech announcing the council will be issued following tomorrow's meeting with Zionist leaders during which he will make a similar announcement.

TEL AVIV STREET MEETINGS PROTEST COUNCIL

TEL AVIV, Dec. 22. (JTA) -- Spontaneous, turbulent meetings were held in the principal squares of this all-Jewish city yesterday protesting the establishment of a legislative council for Palestine as announced by the High Commissioner at a conference in Jerusalem with Arab leaders.

Speakers declared that any Jew who accepted nomination to the council would suffer the consequences.

The crowds were dispersed by the police.

AGENCY GETS 3,400 CERTIFICATES; HAD ASKED 11,000

JERUSALEM, Dec. 22. (JTA) -- The Jewish Agency for Palestine has obtained 3,400 immigration certificates in place of the 11,000 it had requested of the Palestine Government, it was learned here today.

The Agency actually receives only 1,900 of the total allotted since 1,000 had previously been advanced against the new schedule and 500 were deducted for tourists who had illegally remained in the country.
