ENDEKS ATTACK JEWS IN WARSAW PARK.

WARSAW, July 13. (JTA) -- Attacks on Jews in a Warsaw park in which women, old men and children were beaten by Endeks (Nationalists) were reported today in local newspapers.

Armed with iron rods, the Endeks stationed guards at the gates of Trugus Park to further assault Jews who attempted to escape. They proceeded to carry on their attack for several hours.

Police arrived after the disturbance had ended, arresting 150 persons, most of whom were Jews.

Excesses occurred in the village of Mianowe near Nadworne in Eastern Galicia. Ukranian peasants pillaged Jewish-owned stalls and destroyed a quantity of merchandise.

Premier Skladkowski received a delegation of Jewish merchants in Warsaw and assured them the Government would not permit unfair treatment of Jews.

NAZI LEADERS HINT AT RENEWED ANTI-JEWISH DRIVE

BERLIN, July 13. (JTA) -- Further indications that the Nazi campaign against the Jews would shortly be intensified were given today by speakers at a district conference of high Nazi leaders at Frankfort-on-the-Main.

The speakers included Wilhelm Frick, Minister of Interior; Walther Darre, Minister of Agriculture, and Robert Ley, head of the German Labor Front.

Speaking of the Jewish question, another high Nazi official, Dr. von Leers, declared the world might be opposed to the Nuremberg laws and other racial legislation, but the German nation was insistent that "we are combating not only the invasion of Jewish blood, but the invasion of the Jewish spirit."

JUNK INDUSTRY IN REICH TO BE "ARYANIZED"

BERLIN, July 13. (JTA) -- The authorities will not renew the licenses of Jewish rag-dealers and rag-pickers because Jews are "not sufficiently reliable," it was announced today in Der Angriff. Thousands of Jews are expected to lose their livelihood as result of the order.

The paper said there were at least 5,000 rag-dealers and 30,000 rag-pickers in Germany, of whom the majority were Jews. The decision to "Aryanize" the trade was made because of its importance in supplying raw material to German industry, the Angriff explained.

BRITISH TROOPS KILL 7 ARABS

JERUSALEM, July 13. (JTA) -- Seven Arabs were killed today when a military escort replied with heavy fire to an attack on a party of laborers repairing wires 107 kilometers from Jerusalem.

An official communique reported sporadic shooting in various places and bomb explosions in Bethlehem and Haifa which caused no damage.

MORE BRITISH SOLDIERS ORDERED TO PALESTINE

LONDON, July 13. (JTA) -- The second battalion of the Rifle Brigade, stationed at Malta, has been ordered to stand ready to proceed to Palestine on short notice, it was learned today. Three other battalions are scheduled to leave tomorrow.

10-DAY BEDOUIN ULTIMATUM TO WAUCHOPE EXPIRES

LONDON, July 13. (JTA) -- The Daily Telegraph reports today from Jerusalem that the ten-day ultimatum to High Commissioner Sir Arthur Grenfell Wauchope by a meeting of 200 Transjordan Bedouin chiefs, threatening a march on Jerusalem of 100,000 Bedouin warriors unless Palestine Arab demands are granted, has expired.

The paper quotes Emir el Saleh, chief of the Zazawiya Bedouins, as saying the situation in the Transjordan is difficult and that he does not know what the tribes will do if the British Government refuses to agree to the demands.

MACCABI UNION PROTESTS ACTION AGAINST CZECH JEWISH CLUBS

PRAHA, July 13. (JTA) -- The Maccabi Union, Jewish sports organization, today filed an official protest with the Czechoslovak Swimming Union against its action in disqualifying for two years and fining the Hagar and two Bar Kochba clubs, member units, for refusing to participate in the Olympic Games which open next month in Berlin.

The protest points out that the Czechoslovak Olympic Committee on December 21, 1935, decided not to compel Jewish athletes to take part in the Games. It also cites Foreign Minister Krofta's recent declaration that the Foreign Office had no objection to non-participation by Jewish athletes.

The Swimming Union demands payment of the fine, about \$160 for each of the three clubs, within three days, threatening an additional year's disqualification unless paid.

Members of the Jewish clubs are the nation's champion swimmers. Czechoslovakia's chances in the water sports at Berlin are considered slim without their participation.

FASCIST ASSAILED AS "BLACKGUARD" FINED BY LONDON MAGISTRATE

LONDON, July 13. (JTA) -- Assailing him as a "young blackguard," Magistrate Herbert Metcalfe in Old-street Court today fined a Fascist forty shillings (about \$10) for pelting yesterday's anti-Fascist parade and ordered him to put up ten pounds (about \$50) as surety that he will keep the peace for one year.

In passing sentence, Mr. Metcalfe, who on previous similar occasions has been outspoken in condemnation of Fascist methods of intimidation, declared:

"It's perfectly disgraceful that young blackguards like you should be going around disturbing the peace in this fashion. So far as I can, I shall do all in my power to stop this kind of thing."

DANZIG SENATE TO PAY FOR POGROM DAMAGES

DANZIG, July 13. (JTA) -- The Nazi-controlled Senate today agreed to comply with a court's decision that it must compensate Jewish traders, Polish citizens, for damage done in the Dominik Market pogrom of last Summer by paying fifty per cent of the damages.

EPHRAIM SIEFF, PIONEER ENGLISH ZIONIST, DIES AT 75

LONDON, July 13. (JTA) -- Ephraim Sieff, pioneer Manchester Zionist and father of Israel M. Sieff, vice-president of the English Zionist Federation, died Friday at the age of 75, it was made known here today. A friend of Dr. Chaim Weizmann, president of the Jewish Agency for Palestine, he was one of the first Jews in Manchester to espouse the cause of modern Zionism.

POLISH EDITOR OFFERS PLAN TO "EXCHANGE" JEWS FOR BRAZILIAN COFFEE

WARSAW (JTA) -- A seriously proposed thirty-year plan for expatriating Poland's 3,000,000 Jews by exchanging them for Brazilian coffee at the rate of 100,000 a year has aroused discussion here.

Its author is Wladyslaw Studnicki, editor of the Wilno daily, *Slowo*, and one of the mainstays of the pro-Government press. His viewpoint is typical of the so-called "non-anti-Semitic" Government camp in Poland.

In a recently-published book entitled, "The Polish-Jewish Issue," he declares that since immigration into Palestine meets with certain difficulties, it is advisable for Jews to emigrate to Brazil. Poland would grant Brazil a monopoly of the coffee market here in return for accepting the Jews, under his plan.

Pending total elimination of the Jews, M. Studnicki suggests that the Government restrict civil rights, limit Parliamentary and municipal representation of the Jews and restrict the number of Jews in the school system to ten per cent.

He would allow a maximum of 120 Jewish municipal councillors. In Warsaw, where they comprise 33 per cent of the population, he would permit them ten per cent of the council seats.

Protesting his sympathy for the Jews, he characterizes them as "talented and capable." He neither hates them nor despises them, he says, and that is why he is opposed to their forcible expulsion from Poland.

JEWISH CONGRESS TO PROBE BIAS IN SO. AMERICAN LANDS

NEW YORK, July 13. (JTA) -- A special committee to investigate anti-Semitic propaganda in Central and South American countries has been named by the American Jewish Congress administrative committee, it was announced today.

The action was taken after Manuel Graiver, special representative of the Palestine Foundation Fund in Latin America, had brought the congress a plea from 15 Jewish communities for help in stemming anti-Semitism.

The committee comprises Louis J. Gribetz, attorney, chairman; Louis Lande, Judge Joseph Siegler of Newark, Rabbi Morton Berman, Abraham Goldberg and Harold S. Budner.

Describing anti-Semitism in the commercial and educational fields, Mr. Graiver said the Nazis were behind the anti-Jewish campaign. He described the propaganda as including dissemination of news to provincial papers by the German Transocean Agency, radio broadcasts in praise of "Aryan" laws and veiled attacks through members of the clergy linking Jews and Communism.

He reported anonymous anti-Semitic leaflets were distributed among peasants and youths and illustrated journals and brochures against the Jews were circulated among Government officials. This type of propaganda, he said, influenced officials to advocate tightening of immigration laws.

Propaganda in Argentina, Chile, Peru, Colombia, Costa Rica and Mexico was particularly strong under the Nazi influence, Mr. Graiver declared.

The Costa Rican Jews transmitted through him an appeal for American Jewry's intercession. He said the entire press there had begun agitating for isolation of the Polish-Jewish community and for creation of special laws prohibiting peddling -- the source of livelihood of many Jews.

A new decree issued in Costa Rica will mean the closing of Jewish immigration, he said. Under it, persons desiring to bring their families into the country must post 5,000-colon bonds. The regulation is directed against the Polish Jews, Mr. Graiver held.
