NEW ANTI-JEWISH ATTACKS IN RUMANIA; POLICE HOLD ALOOF

BUCHAREST, July 27. (JTA) -- With police failing to interfere, anti-Jewish attacks were resumed today in various parts of Rumania.

A crowd of about 100 persons attacked Jewish passersby in Radauti, in the province of Bukovina, and proceeded to demolish a Jewish-owned hotel in the town. No arrests were made.

A Jewish merchant, Leon Druckmann, was assaulted by hoodlums on a train near Darmanesti. They had tried unsuccessfully to force him to leap from the train while it was in motion.

Attacks on Jews were reported in Putna.

Failure of police to intervene is causing nervousness among Jews throughout the country. Commenting on the situation, the Czernowitz Morgenblatt declares the inaction of the authorities is encouraging anti-Semites to new excesses.

HITLER PAPER URGES OUSTING OF JEWS FROM COMMERCE

BERLIN, July 27. (JTA) -- Reichsfuehrer Hitler's personal organ, the Voelkischer Beobachter, demanded today a reorganization of Germany's economic system so that "Jews do not appear in Germany's economic plans."

In an editorial entitled "No Misunderstanding," the paper declares that the time has come to carry out the Socialist part of the National Socialist program, to put an end to the capitalistic system in Germany and to discontinue economic experiments in which Jews are permitted to play a role in commerce.

REICH WITHDRAWS PRIVILEGES FROM JEWISH WAR BLIND

BERLIN, July 27. (JTA) -- The Association of Jewish Front Fighters was today officially notified that members blinded in the War are no longer to enjoy privileges extended to others similarly afflicted.

AMERICAN JEW INJURED IN WARSAW OUTBREAK

WARSAW, July 27. (JTA) -- An American citizen, Judel Fussberg, was wounded during an anti-Semitic attack today in the streets of Praga, a Warsaw suburb. Fussberg is visiting relatives here.

A gang of anti-Semites shouting "Beat the Jews" sent Jewish passersby fleeing, Fussberg alone standing his ground. No arrests were made.

2 JEWS, 12 ARABS HURT IN TIBERIAS STRIKE DEMONSTRATION

JERUSALEM, July 27. (JTA) -- With twenty of their coreligionists slain in week-end encounters with British troops, Arabs today staged demonstrations marking the hundredth day of the general strike against Jewish immigration and sale of Arab land to Jews.

Two Jews and twelve Arabs were injured during a clash lasting hours that followed an attempt by an Arab crowd to invade the Jewish quarter in Tiberias. Police and troops finally succeeded in dispersing the mob.

Two British soldiers were wounded by snipers while convoying a group of telephone company laborers between Tulkarem and Kakun. Bloodhounds were employed to track the snipers down.

Strong attacks were launched on colonies throughout the Sharon Plain, but were repelled by police and special guards. No casualties were reported.

Fines of \$500 each were imposed on the Arab villages of Kalkillia and Jaljillia, near Tel Aviv, in connection with the wrecking Saturday of a freight train. It was learned the wreckers had intended to derail a Haifa passenger train.

Lifting of press censorship, announced Saturday, was today extended experimentally to correspondents of newspapers and news agencies.

The Jewish Community of Tel Aviv withdrew from participation in relief of refugees from other points now quartered in the all-Jewish city. The action was in protest against the Government's attitude on refugees.

Curfew from 7 p.m. to 3:30 a.m. was imposed on the area 500 meters on each side of the Jerusalem - Nablus road.

The mother of Abraham Donagi, 21, a Jewish watchman killed by Arabs while defending the Even Yehuda settlement from an attack on July 21, went insane today as a result of the loss of her only son.

OIL PIPES BOMBED BY TRANSJORDAN TRIBESMEN; TRIBAL CLASHES FEARED

LONDON, July 27. (JTA) -- The Daily Herald reports from Jerusalem today that pipes owned by the Iraq Petroleum Company were dynamited Sunday by Bedouin tribesmen.

The report states the company recently employed 1,000 armed Benisakr tribesmen to defend its property. Aware of this, rival sheikhs, said to have been influenced by Palestine agitators, threatened to blow up the pipes unless similarly subsidized.

The Government has warned, according to the Herald's correspondent, that crushing fines will be imposed on the tribes responsible for the sabotage.

Six planes are now patrolling the area through which the oil-bearing pipes run and detachments from the Transjordan frontier forces have been rushed to the scene.

The situation is described as tense, with clashes between the rival tribes feared hourly.

LONDON PARLEY MAPS FIGHT ON ANTI-SEMITISM

LONDON, July 27. (JTA) -- An eight-point program for combating Fascist anti-Semitism in England was adopted yesterday by a conference of 200 delegates of Jewish organizations under the auspices of the Jewish Labor Council.

It was decided to form a united body to conduct the fight against anti-Semitism.

FATHER COUGHLIN AGAIN SINGLES OUT JEWISH BANKERS FOR ATTACK

HANKINSON, N.D., July 27. (JTA) -- Father Charles E. Coughlin's reference to the Rothschilds alone among the bankers in an address to 15,000 Dakota and Minnesota farmers recalled his previous practice of concentrating on Jewish names in denunciation of bankers.

The head of the Union for Social Justice, now supporting the candidacy of William Lemke for president, charged last night that under the Roosevelt administration the right of Congress to coin money was being used "for the Rothschilds of Wall Street."

It was the second time in recent weeks that he mentioned only the Rothschilds in discussing the bankers. Last year, he was condemned for devoting his attention largely to Jewish financiers in an address during which he assailed "international" bankers.

In the past, Father Coughlin has denied accusations that in singling out Jewish bankers he was indulging in a subtle form of anti-Semitism.
