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JEWS RETALIATE AGAINST ARABS AS 6 DIE IN WEEKEND ATTACKS

JERUSALEM, Aug. 16. (JTA) -- Two of their number killed and 22 wounded in new attacks, the Jews began to retaliate today against the Arabs for the first time since current disorders broke out four months ago. Three Jewish policemen and a girl were killed yesterday in an ambush outside Haifa.

Several inhabitants of all-Jewish Tel Aviv attacked a group of Arabs, injuring two. Jews also replied to a hail of stones thrown from a train passing from Jaffa and were believed to have injured some of the passengers.

The incidents occurred after Daeaid Albalah, eight years old, of Castoria, Greece, was killed and 22 persons injured by the explosion of a bomb thrown from a train passing Herzl Street in Tel Aviv. All places of entertainment in Tel Aviv were closed in mourning.

Julius Wogshol, 35-year-old German Jew, was killed in an Arab ambush near Mikveh Israel while motoring to Sarafand to repair military electric lines.

Those injured in the Tel Aviv bombing seriously enough to require hospital confinement were Eziakiel Mizrachi, 41; William Fazeig, 42; Uza Kalton, 48; Isaac Jamil, 19, a Sephardic Jew; Meier Shamai, 35; Isaac Katz, 23; Bruno Karkson, 33; Sami Russo, 22, and Willis Schwartz, 25.

Small groups of Jews who gathered in Tel Aviv bitterly shouting protests against the Government's patience in dealing with terrorists were dispersed and some of them beaten by British police.

Tel Aviv Asks Wauchope to End "Anarchy"

Simon Zafilo, 49, a Jewish laborer was injured and two other Jews arrested in a scuffle that broke out in the market place between Tel Aviv and predominantly Arab Jaffa.

Rumors immediately began to circulate in Jaffa that Jews had killed scores of Arabs. A menacing crowd of Arabs gathered in the city. Police broke up the mob, injuring several Arabs with their batons.

As news of the Tel Aviv bombing spread throughout the country, indignation mounted among the Jews.

The Tel Aviv municipal council, in a telegram to High Commissioner Sir Arthur Grenfell Wauchope, urged action to end "anarchy" in the country and demanded that trains carrying "bloodthirsty Arabs" not be permitted to pass through the heart of the all-Jewish city.

A special meeting of the council adopted a resolution asking that the Government institute a searchlight system to facilitate police and military work at night.

The new deaths raised the Jewish toll to 69 in sixteen weeks of disturbances aimed at forcing the Government to halt Jewish immigration and grant Arab nationalist demands. In all, an estimated 400 fatalities have occurred.

After heavy shooting at the Rosha Pina settlement, troops demolished a number of Arab houses in the nearby village of Jaoini as a reprisal. Fields were set afire at Mikveh Israel.

Troops fought several engagements in Northern Palestine with Arab bands attempting to cut water pipelines and attack the heavily-guarded Rutenberg Electric Works. Six casualties were inflicted on Arabs in one brush at Jisrmajame.

A small Jewish boy was injured by an Arab on the Tiberias waterfront. The assailant was arrested.

3 Policemen, Girl Killed from Ambush

Three Jewish special policemen and a girl were killed yesterday and a British soldier wounded in Arab ambushes while the authorities were still investigating the assassination of Mayor Nasr el Din of Hebron and a bombing in Safed that took the lives of four Jews.

Arabs waylaid the policemen's car near Neveh Shanaan in the vicinity of Haifa and opened fire. Officer Goldhaber, although wounded by a bullet, rushed to a nearby police station for assistance. When he returned with police, they found Policemen Hammerman, Weizer and Shuller dead, as well as a girl whose identity was not immediately established.

The British soldier was seriously wounded when a military car was ambushed on the Nablus road.

Timber yards were set afire at Haifa and Rehoboth. Jewish guards, noting two Arabs escaping at Rehoboth, fired, killing one.

Three bombs were discovered on the Tel Aviv seashore, One exploded, causing no damage.

32 Arrested in Safed Bomb Outrage

Thirty-two Arabs were arrested yesterday at Safed in connection with a bomb attack on the home of Rabbi Alter Unger in which he and his three children were killed. Physicians reported the children died of bullet wounds from a volley before the bombing.

Rabbi Unger's grandmother went insane and began a deranged search for the children, whose funeral she attended Friday.

Consuls of the United States and Poland made representations to the Palestine government regarding the safety of their nationals in Safed. Ninety-two American citizens and a number of Polish nationals had appealed to their respective consulates for protection.

A throng of Arabs crowded near a synagogue in the ancient city of Tiberias, smashed windows and hurled a bomb among the Jews holding Sabbath services. One Jew was injured.

A fire brigade in Tel Aviv was fired on while extinguishing an incendiary blaze near the Jaffa boundary. Military patrols were fired on in several places near Athlith. They replied and were believed to have injured a number of Arabs.

The authorities demolished an Arab's house in Acre and prepared to demolish two more for acts of terrorism committed by their owners.

WORLD CONGRESS LEADERS TO SEE BRITISH ENVOY ON PALESTINE TODAY

GENEVA, Aug. 16. (JTA) -- The 79 American delegates to the first World Jewish Congress, which closed last night with the election of officers said today before leaving for home that results of the parley were more encouraging than anticipated.

Their statements, issued through Mendel M. Fisher, of New York, secretary of the delegation, was:

"The delegation feels satisfied with the results of the congress and has faith in its future. Our delegation contributed in large measure to the unity achieved and we have confidence that the Jewry of the United States will back up our decisions. The results were more encouraging than anticipated."

The newly-elected Executive, headed by Dr. Stephen S. Wise of New York, today drew up a declaration asking the British cabinet not to halt immigration into Palestine. A delegation headed by Dr. Wise will present it to the British legation at Berne tomorrow as the first official act of the Executive.

Members of the Executive, besides Dr. Wise, are Marc Jarblum of Paris, Israel Yefroikin of France, Leon Kubowitzki of Belgium, I. Naiditch of Paris, Dr. Mordecai Nurok of Latvia, Rev. Maurice L. Perlzweig of London and one person to be nominated by the Swiss Federation of Jewish Communities.

Judge Julian W. Mack was elected honorary president and Dr. Wise chairman of the Executive at the closing session of the congress.

Dr. Nahum Goldmann, representative of the Jewish Agency for Palestine at the League of Nations was named chairman of the administrative committee. Other officers are Louis Lipsky, chairman of the council and Louis Sturtz, of New York, treasurer.

The administrative committee, at its first session today, was to discuss establishment of central offices in Paris, Geneva and the United States.

Addressing the final sitting of the Congress, Rabbi Wise declared that there could be no peace in the world as long as nations "agitate against the Jew, as long as the Jew is persecuted. Dr. Goldmann and Mr. Lipsky also addressed the session.

The nominations committee had urged elimination of Eastern European representatives from the Executive so that it would not be hampered in taking active measures against countries of Jewish persecution.

LABOR ZIONISTS TO MAP POLICY FOR ACTIONS COMMITTEE MEETING

GENEVA, Aug. 16. (JTA) -- The World Conference of Labor Zionists, the Hitachduth, originally scheduled for Zurich, will open in Geneva on Tuesday. It will decide the labor Zionists' policy at the forthcoming meeting of the Actions Committee of the World Zionist Organization called to consider developments in Palestine.

The labor conference will be addressed by David Ben-Gurion, chairman of the Palestine Executive of the Jewish Agency for Palestine, from London, and by Joseph Sprinzak and Berl Katznelson, labor Zionist leaders, from Palestine.

GOV. FRANCO ASKS TETUAN JEWS TO DISREGARD ANTI-SEMITIC BROADCASTS

CASABLANCA, Morocco, Aug. 16. (JTA) -- General Francisco F. Franco, Spanish rebel army leader, yesterday addressed a letter to the Jews of Tetuan, Spanish Morocco, asking them to disregard certain anti-Semitic speeches broadcast from the Seville radio station since the beginning of the insurrection.

He confirmed, however, that the Jewish community there had been asked to make a "voluntary" contribution of 500,000 pesetas to the rebel cause.

Jewish refugees from Spanish Morocco were guarded in their reports, but it was learned that in the eight principal cities of Spanish Morocco Jewish life was more or less normal.

It was reliably learned that reports of rebels having shot members of the Jewish community in Mellila, Spanish Morocco, were untrue. A few of them had been arrested, it was said.

HUBERMAN QUILS VIENNA ACADEMY

VIENNA, Aug. 16. (JTA) -- Bronislaw Huberman, the Jewish violinist, has resigned from his teaching post in the Vienna State Academy to devote more time to the Palestine Symphony Orchestra, composed chiefly of refugees from Germany.

FATHER COUGHLIN SAYS JEWS NOT TO BLAME FOR "ALL" BANKING EVILS

CLEVELAND, Aug. 16. (JTA) -- Father Coughlin's speech to the convention of the National Union of Social Justice in which he urged his followers not to blame the Jews for "all" the evils of the present banking system was being carefully scanned today in Jewish circles.

Addressing 11,000 persons Friday night in an attack on the banking system, the "radio priest" laid stress on the part the Jews had played in its development, but added that they had been forced by circumstances into dealing in gold.

"Don't blame the Jew for everything," Father Coughlin cautioned. "That's Hitlerism."

After denouncing usury as un-Christian, un-American and ungodly, he held up as "Christianity" and "sound, sane and patriotic Americanism" the doctrine that money should not be owned and controlled by private individuals. He continued:

"The first principle of Christianity is 'Love thy neighbor as thyself,' but I regret to say that our ancestors in thousands of cases did not practice what they believed. We find them persecuting Jews and driving them from every nation in Europe save the Papal States. Why? Because they were bad Christians.

"They forced the Jews to own the only thing a Jew could own when every ten or fifteen years or so Jews were kicked out and driven from pillar to post in a most un-Christian manner. Jews owned only what their ingenuity permitted them to own, namely, gold, which they could easily carry with them. Under this persecution the natural talents of the Jew were nurtured.

"Oh, you can talk of the persecution of the Irish, the Poles and the Huguenots, but there never was such persecution as we Christians inflicted without reason upon the Jews."

Outlining the history of banking, Father Coughlin related that Jews began trafficking in gold, built vaults to ward off thieves; kings and princes of the Middle Ages were forced to borrow from them to pay their mercenaries and meet their bills.

Christians began to traffic in gold, too, he said, warning his followers not to blame the Jews for all the evils of the present banking system.

ANTI-SEMITES BOLT ANTI-RED PARLEY AFTER LOSING FIGHT TO BAR JEWS

ASHEVILLE, N.C., Aug. 16. (JTA) -- Anti-Semites who bolted a meeting of the anti-Communist America Forward Movement after failing to secure exclusion of Jews from the newly-formed National Conference of Clergymen and Laymen assailed Jews at a separate meeting as being behind Communism here and abroad.

Rev. Charles Vaughn, of Los Angeles, a leader of the anti-Semitic dissenters, said today he had been slugged as he entered his hotel room Friday night and that when he regained consciousness he found his belongings looted. He attributed the attack to "sinister influences."

The America Forward Movement Conference, in session here several days, voted down proposals to bar Jews and to include the word "Christian" in the conference title.

Under the cloak of patriotism and anti-Communism a number of professional anti-Semites had rallied behind the conference.

Among those who endorsed the call for the parley were: Harry A. Jung of the American Intelligence Federation of Chicago, James True of James True Associates, Washington; Col. E. N. Sanctuary of the World Alliance against Jewish Aggressiveness; Robert E. Edmondson, under indictment in New York for anti-Jewish libels; Robert E. Hillebrecht of the Paul Reveres, Chicago; Mrs. A.W. Dilling, author of "The Red Network"; Charles B. Helms, of the Minute Men of America, and Royal Scott Gulden of the Order of '76.

IMMIGRATION SUSPENSION MEANS ZIONIST DEFEAT, HERALD-TRIBUNE SAYS

NEW YORK, Aug. 16. (JTA) -- In an editorial entitled "The Impasse in Palestine," the New York Herald-Tribune declared yesterday that temporary suspension of Jewish immigration into the Holy Land as a means of ending Arab disorders would be "tantamount to complete defeat" for Zionism.

Referring to the Royal Commission appointed last June by William G.A. Ormsby-Gore, the Colonial Minister, the editorial stated:

"There is a certain unreality about the gentlemanly British vision of the Arabs abandoning their campaign, of the commission impartially carrying out its studies and, if 'legitimate grievances are found', as Mr. Ormsby-Gore puts it, announcing the impartial manner in which they are to be 'permanently removed.'"
