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NUREMBERG JEWS QUIT CITY AS NAZIS OPEN ANNUAL CONGRESS

BERLIN, Sept. 7, (JTA) -- The city of Nuremberg, where the annual Nazi party congress starts tomorrow, today approached complete "Aryanism" as two-thirds of the Jewish residents there fled fearing possible unpleasant incidents during the course of the sessions. Most of them have arrived here for refuge until the congress is over.

Forebodings that the results of the Nuremberg conclave may mean a new drive against "non-Aryans" seem to be fully confirmed today by the German press which uniformly predicts an increased campaign to make the non-Nazi part of the population more fully Nazi-conscious after the convention.

The Voelkischer Beobachter, Adolf Hitler's personal newspaper, prints an article on its front page by Walter Darre, Minister of Agriculture, who blames a Jewish professor for Germany's defeat in the World War.

Professor Eltsbacher reported in 1914, Herr Darre's article declares, that the Reich had too many pigs which ate too much. As a result of this statement, nine million pigs were slaughtered which eventually resulted in a shortage of army food supplies.

Jewish circles anticipate that the present anti-Soviet propaganda drive will be linked by the Congress with a campaign of incitement against Jews that will stress the old allegation that the forces of "international Jewry" are supporting the Soviet threat against the Western World.

These apprehensions are apparently well-grounded, to judge from the tone of the Nazi press, particularly the Voelkischer Beobachter and the Angriff, two chief Nazi Party organs, in the last few days.

The Jews of the Reich, who have been enjoying a comparative respite from the activities of the Nazi propaganda machine as a result of the Olympics, are now looking forward to a campaign of virulence and abuse which may be expected to intensify the difficulties of existence within Germany.

The Nazi leaders are not expected to overlook the impending trial in Switzerland of David Frankfurter for the assassination of the Swiss Nazi leader, Wilhelm Gustloff. That they will make capital of the Gustloff case in an effort to influence the Swiss verdict is considered certain.

The Congress is also expected to provide a platform for proclamation of new decrees legalizing and extending economic discriminations which are already being practiced against the Jews.

Speakers at Erlagen, where 5,000 foreign Nazis, many of them American citizens, are attending a conference on the propagation of Nazi doctrines abroad, today made the strongest anti-Jewish speeches heard since the end of the Olympic Games.

Revision of foreign trade policy was urged as a means of eliminating Jews and other "undesirable elements" from firms handling German exports.

MARTIAL LAW PREPARATIONS COMPLETE; JEWISH OFFICIAL ATTACKED

JERUSALEM, Sept. 7, (JTA)-- Defying preparations for martial law, which are believed to have been completed at a military conference last night, Arab rebels today pressed their campaign of guerilla warfare against Jews and Government with undiminished vigor.

Unidentified assassin early this morning made an unsuccessful attempt on the life of Max Nurock, Jewish assistant-secretary in the Chief Secretary's office, as he walked near the New Gate of Jerusalem's old city. As he passed the General Post Office, four shots were fired at Nurock, none of them taking effect. Nurock, who was accompanied by Abraham Tattenbaum of the Secretariat, returned the fire. The assailants escaped.

The authorities imposed a nineteen-hour day and night curfew on the ancient city of Nablus, hotbed of the revolt, until a \$25,000 collective fine has been paid.

Four Arabs were dead today following yesterday's battle with troops near Nablus. The battle continued throughout the night and was reported still going on this morning. Planes came to the aid of the infantry when a convoy was attacked by gunfire three miles west of Nablus.

At a special meeting last night British military authorities were reported to have divided the Holy Land into districts where martial law will be imposed. Re-establishment of military courts and other offices necessary for enforcement of military rule were decided upon by the army officials.

Aircraft inflicted eight casualties on small armed bands of Arabs preparing military positions in the Nablus hills.

One Arab was wounded and four others arrested when caught attempting to cut wires near Hakania.

Police along the Tel Aviv seashore beat off repeated Arab attempts to attack the all-Jewish city from the sea.

An Arab was arrested when he tried to steal a constable's rifle in Haifa.

The disorders Saturday claimed the twenty-second British soldier victim, Private Oates, who was wounded in the derailment by Arabs of a freight train near Kalkillia, and the eightieth Jewish victim, Yehuda Spivak, who died of wounds received Sept. 1 in an attack on Kfar Brandeis, Jewish colony named in honor of United States Supreme Court Justice Louis D. Brandeis.

The Arab Supreme Committee decided Saturday to continue the general strike against Jewish immigration, sale of land to Jews and for an Arab national government.

Nuri Pasha as-Said, Iraq's Foreign Minister who has been negotiating with high Arab dignitaries to end the Arab general strike now informed the Committee that his mediation was purely on his own initiative and had not been authorized by High Commissioner Sir Arthur Grenfell Wauchope.

Fausi Bek Elkaukagi, famed Syrian rebel who joined Arab guerilla warriors in Palestine last week and established headquarters in the country's hilly regions, today issued the third of a series of communiques.

The statement announces that eighty British soldiers were killed in the "victorious" battle of Bala last Thursday. "Arab military" strongly hold strategic positions, he states, calling upon Arab youth to join his forces.

REPORT 10,000 TROOPS SAIL FOR PALESTINE FRIDAY

LONDON, Sept. 7, (JTA) -- The Daily Telegraph reports that 10,000 troops of the First Division will sail for Palestine Friday. No confirmation of the report was available at the War Office.

According to the Daily Telegraph, the reinforcements will include twelve infantry battalions, four field companies of Royal Engineers, three companies of the Signal Corps and three companies of the Service Corps.

It is understood the Seaforth, Cameron and Loyal battalions now in Palestine will be relieved by additional battalions from England.

PATIENCE WITH ARABS AT END, BRITISH WAR CHIEF DECLARES

LONDON, (JTA)-- Sir Thomas Inskip, Minister of Defense, made it clear in a strong address last week that Great Britain's patience with the Palestine disorders had reached the point of exhaustion.

"The government must assert its authority," he declares, "it is all the more urgent that violence of the past four months be ended because the Royal Commission cannot enter on its task until order is restored."

Declaring that "we have to administer the Palestine mandate which is our trust", the Cabinet Minister said:

"It is obvious that British troops must be used."

LONDON PRESS OFFERS VARYING SOLUTIONS OF PALESTINE CRISIS

LONDON, Sept. 7, (JTA) -- Considerable interest was aroused in official and Jewish circles today by three varying solutions of the critical Palestine situation offered by three London newspapers.

The Times, caustically commenting that the Arabs, gambling on the supposed weakness of Great Britain, are seeking not an agreement but outright expulsion of the Jews, urges that measures be taken at once to suppress the violence.

Numerical and geographical restriction of the Jewish population in the Holy Land is counselled by the Sunday Observer.

The Sunday Express offers the suggestion that Great Britain wash its hands of the entire business by returning the Mandate to the League of Nations

The Times editorial declares that if the Arabs are really concerned about their grievances they should accept the Jewish offer of a round-table conference.

"But the Arab leaders," it continues, "refuse to meet the Jews because they do not want an arrangement, but Jewish expulsion. They are still gambling on the supposed weakness of Great Britain. It is quite time for British statesmen to show them and everyone else in the East that the assumption underlying such a gamble is baseless. Given adequate troops, a whole-hearted administration and, if necessary, martial law, there is no serious obstacle to our restoring order and stamping out political crime. The sooner we do this, the better."

The Times contends that Jewish developments in the Holy Land have made it clear that whatever the Arab social and economic causes for complaint they are not the mainspring of the revolt, which is nationalistic.

The Sunday Observer, while praising Zionist achievements in the Holy Land, declares:

"The way clearly revealed is a strict limitation, numerical and perhaps also geographical, of the Jewish element in Palestine."

The Star in an editorial Saturday declared the War Office action in summoning 3,000 reservists to bring the First Division up to its full strength reveals the serious view the authorities are now taking of the Palestine situation.

The editorial warned that any appearance of weakness in the face of "blackmail by violence" would simply lead to new demands by the Arabs.

Older Arab leaders were described as probably secretly welcoming the show of firmness inasmuch as it will enable them to reconsider their flat rejection of the Jewish offer to meet in round-table conference. The editorial saw the leaders becoming embarrassed by "their own hotheads."

RUMANIAN SPORTS EVENTS MARKED BY ANTI-JEWISH OUTBREAKS

BUCHAREST, Sept. 7, (JTA) -- A crowd of anti-Semitic demonstrators sought to mob Motzi Spakov, Jewish heavyweight champion, when judges announced a decision in his favor at the end of an exciting ten-round bout Saturday night.

A similar outburst at a football game at the Ciocan grounds Sunday morning between the Maccabi team and the anti-Jewish Students Football Club was avoided when the students won the match 2-to-0.

At the boxing contest troops and constabulary used tanks of identifying colored liquid designed to spray agitators. Throughout the fray, hundreds of spectators shouted, "Down with Jews." Since a description of the battle was broadcast, the taunts were heard all over the country.

As soon as the result was announced, the hostile crowd, whose shouts had not prevented the fighter, Spakov, from exhibiting his skill, rushed the ring. The tired boxer was rescued and escorted to his dressing-room by a few husky friends. It is understood that as a result of the disturbances, Spakov is determined never to fight again in Rumania. He had successfully defended his heavyweight crown for the eleventh successive time.

IRON GUARDISTS ASSAULT TRAIN'S PASSENGERS

BUCHAREST, Sept. 7, (JTA) -- Openly defying the new cabinet's anti-terrorism edicts, members of the anti-Semitic Iron Guard Saturday boarded a crowded Czernowitz-Bucharest express train and beat up Jewish passengers. Non-Jews who tried to protect the Jews were also assaulted.

JEW KILLED, MANY WOUNDED IN POLISH RIOTS

WARSAW, Sept. 7, (JTA) -- Scores of Endeks (Polish Nazis) were under arrest today following anti-Socialist and anti-Jewish riots yesterday which claimed the life of one Jew and brought wounds to at least thirty others..

Jacob Glitzenstein, 44, was set upon and killed by Endeks as he passed a memorial celebration in Lodz by the Polish Socialist Party marking the thirtieth anniversary of the abortive 1906 revolt. Windows of many Jewish shops were smashed during the rioting that followed.

Fifteen Jewish passersby were injured, one of them seriously, in similar disorders in Warsaw. One Christian worker was wounded. Police arrested fourteen Endeks, most of them students.

Scattered anti-Jewish outbreaks were reported from Kattowice and Lwow.

In Lwow stones were thrown at a synagogue. Several Sabbath-worshippers were slightly injured. No casualties were reported following a bomb explosion in the Kattowice shop of Chana Edeleit. The shop windows were completely smashed.

NO GROUP GETS MAJORITY IN WARSAW JEWISH ELECTIONS

WARSAW, Sept. 7, (JTA) -- Jewish community elections failed today to return expected majorities for the Jewish labor party, the Zionist or Agudath Israel blocs. As a result, difficulties are expected to be encountered by the community executive when a working majority is needed.

The Communists supported the labor bloc.

Fourteen seats in the executive went to the Jewish labor party; eleven to the Agudath Israel; ten to the General Zionists; four to the Miz-rachi; two each to the Grodzis Chassidim and the right Poale-Zion; one each to the Revisionists, the Peoples Party and the left Poale-Zion and four to independents.

5,128 IMMIGRANTS SETTLED IN BIRO-BIDJAN IN 8 MONTHS

MOSCOW, Sept. 7. (JTA) -- Official figures issued here today disclose that 5, 128 immigrants settled during the last eight months in Biro-Bidjan, autonomous Jewish territory in Soviet Siberia.

The number includes 684 families and 1, 964 individuals.

The announcement states that the Jewish immigration program for the year has been 51.3 percent filled.

FAMED RAMBAM SYNAGOGUE NOW REBEL HOSPITAL

BARCELONA, Sept. 7. (JTA) -- It was learned here today that the rebels have converted into a military hospital the historic Cordoba synagogue which last year had been turned over to the Jews of that city during festivities marking the 800th anniversary of the birth of Maimonides, famous Jewish sage. Cordoba was the birthplace of Maimonides, popularly known as the Rambam.

It was reported here that Leon Baum, well-known Paris Jewish Communist and one of the first volunteers from abroad to join the Spanish Loyalist forces, was killed during action on the San Sebastian front.

EMANUEL VISCHER REPORTED AMONG SPANISH REBEL DEAD

PARIS, Sept. 7. (JTA) -- It was learned today that Emanuel Vischer, Swiss-Jewish painter, has died of wounds received while fighting on the side of the rebels in the Spanish Civil War.

LONDON JEWS LAUNCH DRIVE ON ANTI-SEMITIC AGITATORS

LONDON, Sept. 7. (JTA)-- Jewish organizations yesterday launched their first offensive against anti-Semitic agitators in England.

Under the sponsorship of the new coordinating defense committee established recently by the Board of Deputies of British Jews to combat anti-Jewish agitation here, a big open-air rally was held at Hyde Park where Sir Oswald Mosley's Blackshirts and other Fascist groups have recently been conducting their anti-Jewish meetings.

The committee is organizing a series of meetings in districts where the Fascists have been most active, including Shoreditch.

BRITISH JEWS PLAN \$100,000 DRIVE TO FEED POLISH-JEWISH CHILDREN

LONDON, Sept. 7. (JTA)-- The Federation of Jewish Relief Organizations today announced it will launch a \$100,000 campaign here for the feeding of Jewish school children in Poland.

The Federation disclosed that the American Jewish Joint Distribution Committee has agreed to contribute \$20,000. It is hoped to provide food for 10,000 children during the Winter months.

4,000 REICH JEWISH DOCTORS LOST RIGHT TO PRACTICE

LONDON, Sept. 7. (JTA) -- Lancet, organ of the Medical Association, today publishes an estimate that 4,000 Jewish doctors have lost the right to practice in Germany since the advent of the Hitler regime.

The periodical states that 650 of this number have emigrated to Palestine, 400 have gone to the United States and 300 are now practicing in Great Britain.

DOLRY, FAMED RUSSIAN BANKER, DIES IN PARIS AT 68

PARIS, Sept. 7. (JTA) -- Abraham Dobry, famous Russian banker, died here today at the age of 68. Dobry negotiated the Ukrainian-German economic treaty of 1918, for which he was kidnaped by a dissatisfied Ukrainian Government. The kidnaping resulted in the sensational trial and conviction of the Ukrainian Premier Golubovitch, who was held responsible.

NAZI CHIEF PRAISES WORK OF JEWISH CULTURAL UNIONS

BERLIN, Sept. 7. (JTA) -- Praise for the work of Jewish cultural unions as possessing "a specific nationalistic mission" was expressed here yesterday by Hans Hinkel, Nazi commissar for "non-Aryan" culture in Germany. He addressed a convention of the unions.

A report made public at the meeting said that although 500 "non-Aryan" artists are employed in "ghetto" theatres, 2,000 are still unemployed and struggling for existence.

Jewish Cultural Week was formally opened yesterday with an imposing exhibition of art and literary work.

POLISH EAST EUROPEAN JEWS RECEIVED \$1,040,000 AID IN 1935

NEW YORK, Sept. 7. (JTA)-- Jews in Poland and other East European lands benefitted to the extent of \$1,040,000 last year by funds raised for their aid by the American Jewish Joint Distribution Committee and its affiliate, the American Joint Reconstruction Foundation, according to the annual report made public today by Joseph C. Hyman, executive director. The document deals with the committee's East European activities.

The 1935 appropriation brings the total of J.D.C. funds expended since 1914 on behalf of Polish Jews to more than \$27,000,000.

The report on Eastern Europe is the second of four pamphlets which together will form the annual report of J.D.C. activities for 1935. A report accounting for \$300,000 expended by the J.D.C. in aid of Jews in Germany already has been made public. The third pamphlet, based on J.D.C. activities in behalf of refugees from Germany, will be issued shortly.

During last year, the J.D.C. appropriated \$376,000 to child care federations, trade training schools, medical and sanitary institutions, educational, religious and cultural bodies, and to free loan societies rendering economic assistance to Jewish masses in Poland, Rumania, Latvia, Lithuania, Czechoslovakia and other East European lands.

The largest single grant for Polish Jews was \$74,500, allocated to organizations in child care and summer colony work in that country.

Declaring that continued support of Jewish schools in Poland is of paramount importance, the report points out that "children in attendance in non-Jewish schools are being forced out by the anti-Semitism of their classmates and teachers.

"In spite of their great poverty, the Jewish population is making every sacrifice to enable their children to go to school. The budgets of the various Jewish schools run into millions of zlotys and are for the most part provided directly by the parents who have children at school or through collections from the Jewish masses. The local income must be supplemented, however, since the stoppage of government and communal contributions has resulted in a considerable deficit in the school budgets."

Normal subsidies given by East European governments, says the report, in support of Jewish cultural, educational, health and other activities of a social or welfare nature have either been drastically reduced or stopped.

"The efforts of the Joint Distribution Committee," the document concludes, "and its allied organizations are by no means commensurate with the needs of East European Jewry. The Jews are victims of every calamity that plagues the world today. In addition to the ravages of the world economic depression, war and threats of war from which all people suffer, the Jews are ever confronted with constantly rising waves of anti-Semitism.

"While the impoverished masses in most countries are helped in some measures by their respective governments, the Jews are neglected and discriminated against."

The American Joint Reconstruction Foundation last year appropriated \$266,000 in new funds to cooperative loan societies it maintains for economic aid to Jews in East European lands.

The Foundation, established by the J.D.C. in cooperation with the Jewish Colonization Association in 1924 to strengthen the cooperative credit movement which the J.D.C. had begun, appropriated new funds during 1935 to cooperative banks. These units loaned about \$16,000,000 at low interest rates to approximately 213,000 Jews, mostly artisans, small traders and farmers.

Apart from rendering financial aid to small merchants and tradesmen through its cooperative banks, the Foundation stimulates the organization and continued operation of consumers cooperatives for workers, producers cooperatives for artisans, and gives assistance to Jewish farmers.

LATE LONDON BULLETIN

ENTIRE FIRST DIVISION TO EMBARK FOR PALESTINE

LONDON, Sept. 7. (JTA) -- The Government today announced that the entire First Division will be sent to Palestine to quell the Arab disorders which are now in their twenty-first week with no sign of abatement.

Supreme military control in Palestine is placed in the hands of Lieutenant Gen. J.G. Dill, who is expected to leave for the Holy Land on Friday by plane.

A long explanatory statement accompanying the announcement deplores the continued disorders and voices regret at the drastic character of the step.

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
