ARAB POLICEMAN KILLED; 80 REDS DETAINED IN WOUNDING OF 2 ARABS

JERUSALEM, Oct. 18. (JTA) -- An Arab special policeman was shot dead today on the Nazareth-Jenin road while police in the all-Jewish city of Tel Aviv pressed an inquiry into the wounding of two Arabs there yesterday.

Eighty Communists of Tel Aviv and surrounding colonies were detained in Tel Aviv in connection with yesterday's shorting. Several members of the right-wing semi-military organization', Brith Trumpeldor, were also held. About half of the suspects were later released.

The Jewish National Council issued a statement condemning the shootings,

The Arab Supreme Committee, which last week ended a 175-day strike against the Jews and the Government; telegraphed High Commissioner Sir Arthur Grenfell Wauchope, declaring the Arab rulers of meighboring countries had protested the attacks. The protest said the Arabs were keeping the peace agreement, while the Jews were not.

The committee, however, issued a proclamation to the Palestine Arabs urging restraint in the face of the attacks.

The Tel Aviv Municipal Council characterized the assaults as a "provocative crime," condemned the assailants and expressed hope they would be brought to justice.

Scattered attacks continued as the Palestine disorders entered their twenty-sixth week. The settlement at Sejera was fired on, but no casualities were reported. Colonists at Kfar Hassidim, aided by British troops, repelled an all-night attack. Other raids were reported on settlements and suburbs around Haifa.

The authorities announced further relaxation of military control, removing restrictions on international telephone calls, effective tomorrow. On the same day, military convoys of buses plying between Jarusalem, Tel Aviv and colonies in the Jezreel Valley will be withdrawn.

Thirty Arab leaders, held in a Government concentration camp at Sarafend since early in the disorders, were released yesterday.

A British officer and a private were slightly wounded Friday night in a skirmish near Acre between a military patrol and a band of Druses. The band suffered three casualties. Two planes sent to aid the soldiers were also fired at.

JENS STRIKE AGAINST TERRORISM IN IRAQ AS 2 DIE

EAGDAD, Iraq, Oct. 8. (JTA) -- Jews of this city proclaimed a strike today against Arab terrorism after two Jews had been killed in the capital and in Basra.

David Judah Azir, 50 years old, was slain near a mosque on Main Street by an Arab mob. Twenty thousand persons attended his funeral. George Chalif, 30 years old, was stabbed fatally in Basra.

BOARD OF DEPUTIES URGES BRITISH JEWS TO AVOID FASCIST DISORDERS

LONDON, Oct. 18. (JTA) -- The Board of Deputies of British Jews, at a meeting today, urged Jews to steer clear of disorders inspired by Fascists. A resolution was adopted protesting against Fascist attempts to identify Jews with Communists.

Neville Laski, president of the board, reporting on the foreign situation in the absence of Leonard G. Montefiore, said the Jews had received little encouragement from the recent session of the League of Nations.

While the Assembly's decision to continue the office of High Commissions: for Refuges indicated awareness of its responsibility for alleviating the suffering of expetriates, Mr. Laski said, the removal of causes creating refugees could not be expected in view of the present "impotence" of the Legrue.

Referring to Germany, he assailed "fashionable journalists" who write about the Reich after short visits there. He described the continued Mazi boycott and persecution of Jews.

Simon to See Labor Delegation

Sir John Simon, Home Secretary, has announced his willingness to receive a Labor deputation to discuss the Fascist problem, expressing the hope it would make a practical contribution to the solution of the question.

Sir Archibald Sinclair, Liberal leader, declared in a statement that the "provocative marches" of Sir Oswald Mosley's Blackshirts into the Jewish East End were "outrages against a free constitution."

The London County Council, which is headed by Herbert Morrison, Laborite leader, cancelled the permit for a Fascist meeting at the Hoxton House School because of the danger of disturbances.

The request for the interview with the Home Secretary was made by Mr. Morrison, in the name of municipal councillors and labor deputios, in a letter warning that "rapid, decisive action" was necessary if "social disaster and political chaos" were to be averted.

Urge Ban on Private Armies

The Star reported that a Government subcommittee has recommended a ban on private arms and anything of a quasi-military nature in order to suppress disorders in London's East End and other parts of England.

According to the Star, the subcommittee made its recommendations to the Cabinet on the grounds that "gubversive methods entirely foreign to British traditions of democratic freedom" were being employed by such groups as Sir Oswald ! sley's Blackshirts.

Prohibition of banners bearing provocative personal and racial slogans will also be asked. it was stated.

POLE SEIZED IN MURDER OF 5; JEWISH MERCHANT KILLED

WARSAW, Oct. 18. (JTA) -- Police in the village of Stawy in the Kielce district today arrested a Pole suspected of complicity in the murder of five Jews on Friday after barely saving him from lynching by a crowd of enraged pessants.

The suspect was held for questioning in the death of Moses Smuelewicz, his wife, mother and niece and the village Jewish teacher.

A Jewish merchant named Klass was murdered by Ukrainian peasants in the village of Opilek in the Sodol District of Eastern Galleia. A Jewish peddler, Joseph Wischnitzer, was seriously wounded.

The Havas News Agency reported that during anti-Semitic disturbances here today a peasant from Przytyk was arrested and sentenced to 15 days in prison for molesting an American woman, Mrs. Anna Carlen, whom he took for a Jewess.

POLISH FASCIST PARTY DENIES AIM OF RESTRICTING JEWS

WARSAW, Oct. 18. (JTA) -- The Iskra News Agency, mouthplece of the Polish Legion, officially denied today the reports that the new government party headed by Colonel Adam Koc, commander of the legion, would demand ourtailment of Jewish rights.

The new party, to begin functioning soon with the support of a strong group of General Rydz-Smigly's followers, advocates an authoritarian form of government in Poland, including some of the features of Nazism and Italian Fascism,

Little importance was attached here to a report in the Berlin Tageblatt from Warsaw that the Polish Government would proclaim on Nov.11, anniversary of Poland's independence, racial legislation against Jews, drawing specific distinctions between them and "Aryan" national minorities.

Apparently, the Tageblatt confused the discredited reports that Col. Koe's party would ask curtailment of Jewish rights with an intention of the government to issue legislation to this effect.

The purposes of the new party, for which the name Union of Work for the State has been suggested, were outlined in a memorandum submitted to government leaders. Parliamentary democracy was rejected in the statement and a new political organization proposed, which would be headed by General Rydz-Smigly and have its own militia like the Nazi storm troops.

The authoritarian system was held the only one possible because of Poland's location between Germany and Russia, her unemployment and her large proportion of national minorities, particularly the Jews.

The Polish storm troops, which would stand as the bulwark behind the authoritarian leader, would be recruited from labor unions and parliamentary associations. The political organization is to include men and women of all shades of opinion.

POLISH VILLAGE RAZED BY FIRE

WARSAW, Oct. 18. (JTA) -- The village of Staszow near Kickee was razed by fire early this morning destroying 34 houses and leaving 60 Jewish families homeless. The damage was estimated at approximately \$100,000.

NAZIS START DRIVE TO PROVE JENS CRIMINALS

BERLIN, Oct. 18. (JTA) -- An investigation into the family records of criminals back to 1800 in connection with a Nazi drive to establish the Jewish proportion of criminals was announced today.

"In this campaign, the Jewish traditions and Old Testament, boing basically criminal in concepts, should not be listed without the tactical consideration of exposing the Jews as criminally-minded poople," the announcement stated.

The instructions covering the investigation, according to the Frankfurter Zeitung, were issued by Dr. von Leers, Nazi juridical expert, at the recent conference of professors and legalists on the position of the Jows in jurisprudence.

The Juristische Wochenschrift, German weekly of jurisprudence, revealed that a special session of the conference was held on the question of exposing the Jews as criminals.

Dr. von Leers was quoted as declaring at this session that history revealed the Jews in Germany and elsewhere were closely connected with criminals and that from 1800 to 1804, armed Jewish bands frequently invaded the Rhineland.

He added that the next generation of Jews changed their methods, becoming a movement of speculators and deceivers, subsequently extending their oriminal activities to become linked with the Marxists.

MAZI PARTY CONTROL SOUGHT FOR "SUSPECTED" JEWISH STORES

BERLIN, Oct. 18. (JTA) -- Der Angriff, Nazi Farty organ, yesterday opened a drive for party control of department stores suspected of belonging to Jews.

The paper, mouthpiece of Fropaganda Minister Goebbels, alleged that many Jewish stores have been flittleously "Aryanized" to avoid the anti-Jewish boycott. It asserted that Wertheim's, Berlin's largest department store, belonged in that category.

Charging that Reichaminister of Economics Dr. Hjalmar Schacht had frustrated a party investigation of the situation a year ago, Der Angriff demanded that the issue be revived.

The paper also demanded elimination of Jewish real estate agents.

"ARYANS" IN REICH BARRED FROM MAKING BEQUESTS TO JEWS

BERLIN, Oct. 18. (JTA) -- A decision by Ministry of Justice experts, announced yesterday in Deutsche Justiz, invalidates bequests by "Aryans" to Jews on the grounds that transactions delivering "Aryan" property to Jews are "immoral" and violate Nazi minipoles.

The decision legalizes concentration of capital in mixed marriages in the hands of the "Anyan" members. Wills bequeathing property to Jews, whether drawn before or after enactment of the Nuremberg race laws, are invalidated despite the fact that the laws do not specifically prohibit Jews from inheriting "Aryan" property or capital.

The Frankfurter Zeitung reported the decision of a Leipzig court nullifying the will of an "Aryan" woman bequesting her property to a Jew instead of to her "Aryan" heirs, whom she had disinherited.

The court ruled the will was contrary to the spirit of the German racial laws, and against the Nazi view and the prevalent spirit of Germany that "Aryan" property should not pass into Jewish hands.

BARRING OF JEWS FROM JUNK TRADE HINDERS GERMAN RAW MATERIAL DRIVE

BEILIN, Oct. 18. (JTA) -- Nazi newspapers today gave evidence that the Jewish "old clo' man," who has been eliminated from his ancient trade on the grounds that Jews could not be trusted with the collection of rags and junk for conversion, into much-needed raw materials, is being sorely missed.

The papers complain that since the Jews have been ousted from the business German households are finding it difficult to dispose of their rags.

Pointing out the importance of rag-collecting in the drive for raw materials, Der Amgriff, Nazi Party organ, suggests that members of the Hitler Youth organization take up the task,

The Ministry of Economics has ordered all Government offices and institutions to save waste paper and turn it over to collectors.

MACCABI MEETS IN BERLIN

BERLIN, Oct. 18. (JTA) -- With the permission of the authorities, the Macabl Sports Organization yesterday opened its biennial convention here.

ROSENBERG HITS AT SOVIET 'UNDER JENS'

SAARBRUECKEN, Germany, Oct. 18. (JTA) -- Dr. Alfred Rosenberg, Nazi Party ideologist, declared in a speech here last night that the present Franco-Soviet understanding is "far different" from the Franco-Soviet Alliance in 1914, accordomy to the Havas News Agency.

"Russia in 1914 was at least half European," he said, "but today the Soviet Union, under the direction of Jews, is not only a threat to all nations but stands against the ideas which lead all civilization."

RUMANIAN ANTI-SEMITIC LEADER KILLED BY IRON GUARDIST

BUCHARET, Oct. 18. (JTA) -- Open warfare broke out today between the Iron Guard and the National Christians, rival anti-Semitic groups, resulting in the death of a National Christian leader. Marin Costache, leader of the National Christian Farty for the Buzau department, was fatally stabbed by Hon. Bogan, an Iron Guardist.

The dissension within the National Christian Party, which is headed by Prof. Alexander Cuze, resulted in the postponement of a demonstration of 200,000 persons from all over the country from Oct. 26 to Nov. 1.

Jewish circles expressed relief at the postponement, for King Carol, whose presence it is hoped will keep the demonstration in check, will be absent from Rumania on Nov. 26 but is scheduled to be back before Nov. 1.

King Carol today sent a message of thanks to the Central Jewish Council of Rumania for birthday greetings.

Young peasants of Sinaia, King Garol's seat in the Transylvanian Alps, have formed a volunteer bodyguard to protect leaders of the National Peasants Party who have been marked for death by Rumanian Nazis. The peasant youths announced they intend to "preserve the rights of oitizens."

Consul Reported Aiding Anti-Semites

GAIATZ, Rumania, Oct. 18. (JTA) -- Comment was aroused today by the report that the Danish consul here, C. Jorgenson, had donated a large sum to the anti-Semitic National Christian Party to acquire headquarters for its blueshirted militia.

RUMANIAN ENGINEERS ASK NUMERUS CLAUSUS PR JEWS

BUCHARES, Oct. 18, (JTA) -- A general meeting of the Union of Rumanian Engineers adopted a resolution today favoring restriction of the number of Jewish engineers to their proportion in the population.

The Union of Private Employees withdrew its representatives from the Chamber of Labor in protest against the chamber's refusal to admit to its council representatives from the union on the ground they are Jewish.

RUMANIA TRADES CAVIAR FOR NAZI ARMS

BUCHAREST, Oct. 18. (JTA) -- Rumanian caviar will be traded for German machinery with which to manufacture bullets and armaments by a new trade agreement just entered into between the two countries, it was revealed here today.

BRITISH PACIFISTS ASK INDEPENDENCE FOR ARABS

LONDON, Oct. 18. (JTA) -- The convention of the No-War-Movement, a pacifist organization, adopted a resolution today asking Great Britain to withdraw the 30,000 troops stationed in Palestine and grant the Arabs independence.

BRITH TRUMPELDOR PROTESTS RAIDS

TEL AVIV, relestine, Oct. 19, (JRA) -- The Brith Trumpeldor, rightwing Zionist youth organization, protested tonight against sudden searches of its clubs in Tel Aviv, Petach Titvah and Ness Ziona and mass arrests made in connection with the wounding of two Arabs by gunfire in Tel Aviv yesterday.

Officials of the organization said the raids showed prejudice in the investigation and a desire to create a wrong impression as the the responsibility for the attacks.

ENGLISH JEW GIVES 10% OF PROFIT FOR DEFENSE AND CHARITY

MANCHESTER, England, Oct. 18. (TTA) -- Solomon Aschkenayy, local merchant and shipper, announced yesterday he is giving the British Government five per cent of all his profits to be used for defense of the Empire. An additional five per cent will go to charity irrespective of creed and "not excluding Palestine," he declared.

Aschkenazy is an Austrian Jew who became a British subject 36 years ago.

SARLOURIS TO BE CHIEF RABBI OF AMSTERDAM

AMSTERDAM, Oct. 18. (JTA) -- Rabbi L. H. Sarlouris will be appointed chief rabbi of this city, it was announced today.

REPORT BRAZIL PLANS HAVEN FOR 10,000 REFUGEES

NEW YORK, Oct. 18. (JTA) -- The Associated Press reports from Cuyaba, Brazil that the State of Matto Grosso has announced plans in the making to harbor 10,000 Jewish refugees from Germany along the Sac Lourenco river. Nationalist opposition was forecast, the A.P. said.

WOHEN PIONEERS HIT PALESTINE GOVERNMENT FOR "WEAKNESS"

BOSTON, Oct. 18. (JTA) -- Spurred by an annual report which castigated the Felestine Government for "its indecision, weakness and delay," the Women's Fioneer Organization at its convention, adopted a program to strengthen its agencies in the Holy Land to meet the pressing requirements of Jewry in Germany and other European countries.

The report declared that the Palestine Government's policy "seemed to encourage the terrorists" and had failed "to maintain security and public order."

"Despite this situation, and in the face of these gruesome provocations, the economic life in Pelestine continues to function, b With undaunted heroism, Pelestine Jewry sees that the channels of economic life and contact is not broken," the report said.

A banquet last night at the Hotel Statler, where the four-day convention was meeting, was attended by 1,000 delegates, visitors and friends.

Despite threats of secession and the leaving of a good portion of the assemblage to another room to hear the message of Tony Sender, a German exile, who was originally scheduled to speak, the organization, in the closing hours of its convention, today dismissed its secretary and elected a secretariat of two to replace how.

The wrangling, which began at the morning session, dragged all day, displacing scheduled sessions for guest speakers and resolutions, and it was only when floor leaders realized that they would have to give up the auditorium to the Hotel that a decision was reached.

Mrs. Sarah Feder of St. Louis and Mrs. Idelsohn of Palestine were elected to serve as secretaries to succeed Mrs. Sophie Udin of New York. Despite the decision, Mrs. Udin told the members that she would continue to throw herself into the work for the movement.

It is understood that she will be named to serve as national field secretary and organizer, so as to continue her activities of the past year, during which time she organized close to forty new clubs.

A victory for democracy throughout the world will be the deciding factor for the success of Palestine as a Jewish National Homeland, Tony Sender told several hundred of the listeners to her address.

Although America may be safe from the complete invasion of Fascism for another twenty years, she said, Fascism will endanger America if it succeeds completely in Europe.

At the Friday night session, Mrs. Udin told the 1,000 delegates and visitors that in the past ten years the Pioner Womon's Organization had sont nearly \$500,000 to Falostine for the establishment and support of training schools and girls! cooperative farms, for agricultural equipment and the building of farm buildings and living quarters.

Despite the crisis caused in Falestine by recent disorders, she said, Jewish achievement continued to be noted there, and at the height of the disturbances, 2,865 Jews entered Falestine in August alone. Many Arabs are cognizant of the benefits brought to Palestine by Jewish labor and intitative, she declared.

Pleading for the combating of Fascism, which she declared "carries with it a cruel and inhuman enti-Semitism," she emphasized that "all democratic forces must be mustered to fight this menace."

2,000 ASSEMBLE IN PHILADELPHIA FOR OPENING OF HADASSAH CONVENTION

PHILADELPHIA, Oct, 18. (JTA) -- Two thousand women representing 45 states assembled tenight at the Benjamin Franklin Hotel to hear addresse by Mrs. Zdward Jacobs, president, and Covernor George H. Earle, guest speaker, opening the four-day 22nd annual convention of Hadassah, women's Zioniat organization.

Mrs. Jacobs declared that the Jows have a historic claim for resettlement of Palestine. "Palestine has become to Jews everywhere a symbol of corporate existence," she said. "Jowish activities in all countries which have constructive character derive from the inspiration of Palestine."

Governor Earle spoke over a nation-wide network of the National Broadcasting Co. In introducing him, Mrs. Moses P. Epstein spoke of his hatred of intolerance and bigotry.

Miss Henrietta Szold, founder of Hadassah, declared in a message sent from Jerusalem that political conditions could increase the

Miss Henrietta Sgold, founder of Hadassah, declared in a met from Jerusalem that political conditions could increase the difficult ies of building the Jewish homeland, but could not "impair the spiritual foundation of the structure." She praised the restraint of the Jewish settlers in the face of recent disorders.

Other messages were received from Sir Arthur Grenfell Wauchope, Palesting's High Commissioner; Governor Herbert H. Lehman of New York; James G. MoDonald, associate editor of the New York Times; Dr. Chaim Weizmann, president of the World Zionist Organization, Isaac Ben Zvi, president of the Jewish National Council in Palestine, and the Zionist Organization of America.

Hadassah raised in the past year \$600,800 -- the highest sum in any one year -- to support its projects in Felestine, it was announced. This included \$264,000 for hespital maintenance and health work, \$60,000 for the Rothschild-Hadassah-University Hospital and Medical School and \$110,000 for transferring 300 Jewish children from Germany to Falestine and maintaining them there.

Tomorrow evening a panel discussion will be held on Jewish education. A discussion of "Zionism -- a DyMAMic Approach to Present Day Jewish Problems" will be presented with Marvin Lowenthal, Dr. Horace M. Kallen, Rabbi David de Sola Pool, Rabbi Simon Greenberg and Mrs. Hyman B. Ullian as speakers.

A symposium on Palestine, with emphasis on recent developments will be held Tuesday evening.

JDC SPENT \$208,500 FOR REFUGEES IN 1935

NEW YORK, Oct. 18. (JTA) -- The Joint Distribution Committee reported today spending \$208,500 for relief and emigration of refugee Jews from Germany in 1955.

The annual report of the J.D.C.'s refugee activities, made public by Joseph C. Hyman, executive director, said that since the beginning of the emergency, it contributed \$957,000 to Jewish and non-sectarian groups to aid refugees.

MANCHESTER POLICE FORCE MOSLEY TO MODIFY ANTI-JEWISH ATTACKS

MANCHESTER, England, Oct. 18. (JTA) -- A detonator was thrown at Sir Oswald Mosley, British Fascist leader, while he was attacking the Jews in a speech here tonight, but failed to injure the Blackshirt Chieftain, according to the Havas News Agency.

Police intervened, informing Mosley he would have to modify his statements or out short his address. Thereafter the meeting proceeded on schedule without disorder.
