ARABS TO BOYCOTT ROYAL COMMISSION HEARINGS

JERUSALEM, Nov. 6. (JTA) -- The Arab Supreme Committee announced today it will boycott the hearings of the British Royal Commission, en route here to open an inquiry on Nov. 12 into the Arab disorders.

In a manifesto, the Arab leaders stated the step was taken because of the action of the British Colonial Office in announcing yesterday a Jewish labor immigration schedule of 1,800 certificates in the face of Arab demands for suspension of immigration.

The six-man commission, headed by Lord Peel, left London yesterday and will come to Jerusalem via Marseille. It is empowered to inquire into the recent disturbances, and the Arabs' and Jews' grievances.

Weizmann Calls Schedule Victory for Jews

LONDON, Nov. 6. (JTA) -- The 1,800-certificate immigration schedule granted to the Jewish Agency for Palestine for the next six months was described as "measly" by Dr. Chaim Weizmann, president of the Agency, but he hailed the grant as a victory for the Jews.

Addressing a meeting of the British Friends of the Hebrew University last night, he interpreted the schedule as signifying maintenance of an "open door policy" in Palestine "despite many attempts to close it."

Declaring that, without being too optimistic, there was no ground for pessimism, he stressed the need for intensive efforts in behalf of the Zionist cause.

"It is unthinkable that this work, which has been so successful, shall be interfered with or curtailed," he said, "but we shall have a hard struggle."

Sir Herbert Samuel, first High Commissioner of Palestine, declared there was no inherent obstacle to bringing together Arabs and Jews in the Holy Land.

"There is no antipathy between the two races among the rank and file," he said. "There is no real clash between economic interests. The difficulty is political and psychological, and wise statesmanship can find a way to solve that difficulty."

He denied that any incompatibility existed between the wartime promises made by Great Britain to the Arabs and to the Jews. Urging an attitude of optimism on Palestine, he said:

"There is no incompatibility in the pledges made to the Arab and to the Jew during the war. I hope the Royal Commission will, and it should render an authoritative statement in this respect."

PALESTINE DEPORTS 12 COMMUNISTS TO SPAIN

JERUSALEM, Nov. 6. (JTA) -- It was announced officially today that the Government has deported twelve Communists to Spain.

NAZIS DICTATE SLATE OF BERLIN JEWISH COUNCIL

BERLIN, Nov. 6. (JTA) -- Following negotiations with Jewish leaders, the authorities today withdrew an order issued Tuesday directing the Berlin Jewish Community to reduce the size of its council from 41 to 21 by eliminating ten Zionists and ten non-Zionists.

Although an election slate of 41 was permitted, the authorities ordered the names of a number of Zionists withdrawn, to be replaced by other Zionists.

The community elections will be held on Nov. 29. A united list, comprising an equal number of Zionists and non-Zionists, has been drawn up. The list includes Dr. Georg Kareski, head of the German State Zionist Organization.

GUSTLOFF TRIAL TO SET OFF NEW PROPAGANDA DRIVE

BERLIN, Nov. 6. (JTA) -- National Socialist Party Korrespondenz, Nazi news agency, said today plans were under way for an intensive propaganda campaign to be opened in connection with the forthcoming trial in Chur, Switzerland, of David Frankfurter, Yugoslavian Jewish medical student, for the murder last February of Wilhelm Gustloff, Nazi leader in Switzerland.

Stating that the trial would open in December, the agency reported that Dr. Grimm, who successfully defended Nazis accused of anti-Semitic libel in Cairo last year, would institute a civil action in behalf of Gustloff's widow.

Dr. Grimm is applying to the Chur Cantonal Court for permission to join the prosecution, the agency reported. (The libel action he defended in Cairo was brought by Egyptian Jews against Nazis in connection with the distribution of copies of the so-called Protocols of the Elders of Zion.)

NAZI PAPER WANTS BIBLE REWRITTEN TO DELETE MOSES EPISODE

BERLIN, Nov. 6. (JTA) -- A demand that the Bible be rewritten to eliminate mention of God's entrusting of the Ten Commandments to Moses was voiced today by the Westdeutscher Beobachter, an organ of the Nazi Party.

The paper makes the demand on the ground that school teachers are unable to explain to their pupils why God selected a Jew as his instrument to reveal the commandments when Nazi teaching describes Jews as inferior and unworthy.

STREICHER AIDE URGES EXTERMINATION OF "JEWISH CRIMINAL"

NUREMBERG, Germany, Nov. 6. (JTA) -- Karl Holz, deputy leader of Franconia, urged extermination of "the Jewish criminal" as the only solution of the Jewish question in Germany at a meeting here today. Holz is chief aide to Julius Streicher, overlord of Franconia and publisher of the anti-Semitic weekly Der Stuermer.

Jews BARRED FROM BAZAAR IN GERMAN TOWN

BERLIN, Nov. 6. (JTA) -- The municipality of Sonneberg today barred Jewish peddlers from the annual bazaar, permitting them instead to display their wares in a distant vacant lot.

GERMAN ARRESTED IN PRAHA FOR DEATH THREAT TO JEWISH PROFESSOR

PRAHA, Nov. 6. (JTA) -- The police today arrested a German student as author of a death threat contained in a letter, signed "Heil Hitler," sent to Dr. Hans Kelsen, professor of international law at the German University here and a recent emigre from Germany.

The letter, decorated with a swastika, warned Prof. Kelsen that a fate similar to Prof. Theodor Lessing's awaited him unless he left the university. (Prof. Lessing, a famous German-Jewish philosopher, was killed by Nazis on Aug. 31, 1933, in his villa at Marienbad following receipt of threatening letters.)

Arrest of the student followed comparison by the police of typewriters in numerous German student centers with the typescript in the threatening letter.

Dr. Kelsen's first lecture Oct. 22 was marked by anti-Semitic rioting by Nazi students.

IRON GUARD THREATENS TO KILL GOVERNMENT "TOOLS OF JEWS"

BUCHAREST, Nov. 6. (JTA) -- The anti-Semitic Iron Guard, in a manifesto denouncing Rumanian statesmen as "tools of Jews and Freemasons," warned Government officials today they must "guarantee with their heads the success of their policies."

The Fascist military organization declared if Rumania fights on the side of Soviet Russia in a future war, the Nationalists will shoot first those who send them to war, then commit suicide.

The declaration was issued in connection with the opening of the college year. Many students are Iron Guard supporters. The declaration caused uneasiness in official circles in view of the Iron Guard's past record of plotting officials' assassinations and other terrorist activities.

The manifesto was particularly strong in its attack on Nicolae Titulescu, former Foreign Minister, who leaned toward France and opposed anti-Semitism in Rumania.

RUMANIAN ANTI-REVISIONISTS WARN ITALY ON CLAIMS

BUCHAREST, Nov. 6. (JTA) -- An implied warning to Premier Benito Mussolini that Rumania will "not be intimidated" was issued by anti-Revisionists here tonight as resentment mounted over Italy's support of Hungarian Revisionist claims, according to the Havas News Agency.

Referring to the territories gained by Rumania as a result of the World War, a resolution passed by the Rumanian Anti-Revisionist League declared:

"Rumania has decided to show to the entire world that it will defend its rights even if it entails the supreme sacrifice, and that the support given its former enemies will not intimidate it."

SEEK ROYAL PARDON FOR JAILED FASCIST PUBLISHER

LONDON, Nov. 6. (JTA) -- Friends of Arnold S. Leese, editor of The Fascist, who is serving a six-month prison term for publishing a charge that Jews practice ritual murder, today started circulating for signatures a petition to King Edward that he be pardoned. Leese, who was sentenced Sept. 21 in the first "race libel" suit trial in modern British history, refused the alternative of a fine.

REPORT TRADE PACTS SOUGHT AMONG ARAB COUNTRIES

JERUSALEM, Nov. 6. (JTA) -- Al Liwaa, Arabic daily, reported today that serious efforts were under way in influential Arab circles in Baghdad, Jerusalem and Cairo for conclusion of political and economic treaties among Arab countries.

The paper said the British Government was considering making Haifa, Palestinian Mediterranean harbor, a free port for Iraq and to build a Haifa-Baghdad railway.

2 ARRESTED AFTER DISORDERS IN POLISH TOWN

WARSAW, Nov. 6. (JTA) -- Police arrested two anti-Semitic rioters today in the township of Janblonka following renewed anti-Jewish excesses there. Order was restored by police from the neighboring town of Wysokie Mazowiec.

BUDAPEST JEWISH LEADERS AID ANTI-RED DRIVE

BUDAPEST, Nov. 6. (JTA) -- Jewish leaders, meeting to consider formation of an anti-Bolshevist front, promised today to support the fight against Communism in Hungary. Samuel Stern pledged the Budapest Jewish Community to support the anti-Red drive, and Samuel Kahn Frankl, president of the Orthodox Jewish Community, pledged the aid of his group.

PRINCES ATTEND FUNERAL OF JEWISH PHYSICIAN IN STOCKHOLM

STOCKHOLM, Sweden, Nov. 6. (JTA) -- Princes Karl and Eugene, brothers of King Gustav, and Princess Ingeborg attended funeral services yesterday for Dr. Arthur Fuerstenberg, noted physician, who died at the age of 71. He had frequently treated members of the royal family.

Wreaths were laid on his grave which had been sent by the Crown Princess, King Christian of Denmark and the Queen, King Leopold of Belgium and the Crown Prince of Norway.

BRAZIL POLICE CHIEFS TO BAR JEWS FROM CITY JOBS

NEW YORK, Nov. 6. (JTA) -- Brazil's chiefs of police, closing their first national convention in Rio de Janeiro today, announced that they are prepared to prevent the entry of "Jews and other immigrants" seeking city jobs, the Associated Press reported.

186,134 JEWS LEFT POLAND IN 10 YEARS

NEW YORK, Nov. 6. (JTA) -- Poland, whose government is seeking expatriation of 80,000 Jews annually, has had an emigration of 186,134 Jews between 1925 and 1935, according to figures published in Paris by the HIAS-ICA Emigration Association and made public here by HIAS.

The peak year of the Jewish exodus was 1935, when 30,717 Jews emigrated from Poland as compared with 23,393 in 1926.

During the ten years, 67,242 of the emigrants settled in Palestine, 27,755 in the United States, 15,466 in Canada, 4,689 in Central American republics, 31,098 in Argentina, 13,098 in Brazil, 4,378 in Uruguay, 1,150 in Australia, 17,169 in European countries and 3,774 to other overseas countries.
