LAW TO SEIZE REALTY BEING MAPPED; BERLIN AGAIN HEARS

BERLIN, March 8. (JTA) -- Jewish circles were disturbed today by a new report in the Berliner Tageblatt that a law was in preparation to "dispossess" certain elements of the population of their real estate in accordance with "the interests of the State." Reports of such a law have been circulated on previous occasions.

The report did not disclose details of the projected law, but it was assumed some time would elapse before its promulgation.

Reports reaching Berlin stated Jews in provincial towns were selling out their holdings for small sums. In cities like Berlin and Frankfurt-on-the-Main, however, Jews are holding their property, being impelled by these considerations:

1. Converting property into cash, they would face classification as "suspected emigres" and might be forced to deposit 25 per cent of their capital as security for the "flight tax."
2. Buildings are one of the few sources of income left to them.
3. Economic pressure against them is not yet as strong in Berlin and other large cities as in the provinces.

REICH FINANCING HUNGARIAN FASCISTS, BUDAPEST COUNCIL TOLD

BUDAPEST, March 8. (JTA) -- Open charges that Germany was financing Hungarian right-wing organizations were made today by Social Democratic deputies in the Municipal Council despite police assertions that they had no proof of the reported pro-Nazi putsch plan.

Deputy Herman Peyser, a Social Democrat and M. Petrovacs, a Unified Christian Party deputy, declared that Germany had sent 3,000,000 pengoes into Hungary to finance pro-Nazi propaganda. Petrovacs said that the rightist organizations were semi-military in character and were fully prepared to carry out a coup. the Havas News Agency reported.

HINTS HENRY FORD AIDED HITLER FINANCIALLY

LEEDS, England, March 8. (JTA) -- The name of Henry Ford was mentioned here last night as a possible contributor to German Nazi funds, the Havas News Agency reported.

During a political speech, Miss Ellen Wilkinson, Laborite Member of Parliament, said: "I would be interested to know how much money Henry Ford has contributed to Nazi funds." She said she considers Chancellor Hitler's masters are capitalists of Germany and other countries.

WORLD ZIONIST CONGRESS SET FOR AUGUST

WARSAW, March 8. (JTA) -- The twentieth biennial World Zionist Congress will open the first week in August and conclude the following week, it was announced today by Isaac Gruenbaum, director of the organization department of the World Zionist Executive. (It was reported from Praha recently that Switzerland would again be the site of the Congress.)

The Council of the Jewish Agency for Palestine, will hold its meeting concurrently with the Congress, he declared.

A meeting of the Zionist General Council, directing Zionist body when the Congress is not in session, will convene on April 13 in Jerusalem. Mr. Gruenbaum informed a conference of central committees of all Polish Zionist groups.

Mr. Gruenbaum announced the Hebrew month of Nissan (March 13 to April 10) as the period for world-wide sale of "shekolim," the certificates entitling Jews to vote in the elections for Congress delegates.

HEBREW U. RECTOR ARRIVES IN WARSAW

WARSAW, March 8. (JTA) -- Dr. Hugo Bergmann, rector of the Hebrew University in Jerusalem, arrived here today for a brief visit prior to a trip to the United States.

UNREST CONTINUES IN HOLY LAND

JERUSALEM, March 8. (JTA) -- Signs of unrest continued today to be evidenced in various parts of the Holy Land after one of the most violent week-ends in many months.

A bomb was thrown by Arab terrorists at a police station in Haifa, target of many similar attacks. A passing Arab woman was wounded in the explosion. Many shots were fired in the tense Hattiqvah quarter of Jaffa, scene of frequent clashes during the 1936 disorders.

Haaretz, Hebrew daily, was suspended for one week by the authorities.

BIBLICAL STORIES BEING FILMED IN PALESTINE

JERUSALEM, March 8. (JTA) -- Educational films illustrating stories from the Bible are being taken here by Aiden Crawley, son of the Rev. A.S. Crawley, Dean of Windsor.

HADASSAH CHILDREN'S VILLAGE ADMITS 30; 400 AWAIT ENTRY

JERUSALEM, March 8. (JTA) -- Thirty children were admitted today to Meir Shfeyah, children's village operated by Hadassah, American women's Zionist organization. They were part of a waiting list of 400.

J.N.F. WARNS SETTLERS TO OBSERVE SABBATH

JERUSALEM, March 8. (JTA) -- Settlers on Jewish National Fund land were warned by the Fund's directorate today failure to observe the Sabbath would be punished in accordance with their contracts.

REAFFIRMS BAR ON JEWISH SETTLEMENT IN TRANS JORDAN

LONDON, March 8. (JTA) -- The British Government will not permit settlement of Jews in Transjordan, Colonial Secretary William Ormsby-Gore reaffirmed in the House of Commons today.

NATALIA BAECK DIES AT 59; WIFE OF BERLIN'S CHIEF RABBI

BERLIN, March 8. (JTA) -- Mrs. Natalia Baeck, 59, wife of Chief Rabbi Leo Baeck of Berlin and daughter of the noted Rabbi Adolf Weiner of Oppeln, died today.

REICH EMBASSY SHUNS FUNCTION TO BE ADDRESSED BY LAGUARDIA

WASHINGTON, March 8. (JTA) -- The German embassy has turned down an invitation to the Bronson Cutting memorial lecture tonight because Mayor LaGuardia was scheduled to speak, it was learned today.

The ~~Mayor~~ politician's association that Hitler's figure should be placed in a World's Fair horror chamber and added: "I think that the opening paragraph of the (State Department) apology, pointing out that we have freedom of speech in this country, was more embarrassing to the embassy than the apology was to me."

As to the Cutting lecture, a Reich Embassy attache was reported to have said: "Oh, yes, I remember the invitation, but of course we will not attend. That was decided when we saw Mayor LaGuardia's name on the program."

Billy Rose Offers to Create 'Horror Chamber'

NEW YORK, March 8. (JTA) -- Billy Rose, theatrical producer, applied to the World's Fair authorities today for a concession to build a "chamber of horrors" called "The New Germany" and posted \$5,000 as a guarantee of good faith.

He asked five acres of space to include a chamber of horrors, a concentration camp, a wax representation of the "blood purge," and a hall of cultural creations banned in Germany. Mr. Rose said he thought such a spectacle would attract 10,000,000 persons.

Perley Boone, World's Fair publicity director, said the application would be considered among "thousands of others" received "in due course."

The Women's Division of the American Jewish Congress telegraphed the State Department in Washington demanding that an apology be obtained from Germany for the references in the Nazis press to "women of the streets" attending the A.J.C. luncheon last week at which Mayor LaGuardia spoke.

HITLER'S DEPUTY TO ADDRESS WOMAN'S CONGRESS BY FILM AND RADIO

NEW YORK, March 8. (JTA) -- Rudolf Hess, Nazi Cabinet minister and Chancellor Hitler's deputy, will address the fourth annual Woman's Congress in Chicago sponsored by the Chicago Tribune on Wednesday through the mediums of a special talking picture and short-wave radio, it was announced today.

Mrs. Stephen S. Wise, scheduled to speak after Hess, said today she would not withdraw. The fact the Nazi leader will speak was "all the more reason" she should present the other side, Mrs. Wise told the Jewish Telegraphic Agency, adding that it would be "cowardly" to permit only the Nazi side to be given.

Mrs. Wise said she understood Hess would only address the Chicago audience, while her speech on "Women in Democracy," which attacks Nazi Germany, will be broadcast over a nation-wide network. Hess' spech will be ten minutes, while Mrs. Wise said she would speak fifteen or twenty minutes.

Mrs. Wise, who is president of the Women's Division of the American Jewish Congress, said her references to Nazi Germany were included in her speech before she knew that it would serve as a reply to Hess.

The Non-Sectarian Anti-Nazi League telegraphed Mrs. Wise asking her to withdraw from the program and also protested to Col. McCormack, publisher of the Tribune, against inclusion of Hess' addresses. Another telegram to William Green, president of the American Federation of Labor, asked him to use his influence for withdrawal of trade union speakers from the program.

PROF. FRANKFURTER FAVORED BY LAWYERS FOR SUPREME COURT

NEW YORK, March 8. (JTA) -- Prof. Felix Frankfurter, of Harvard University, leads the list of the legal profession's preferences for membership in the Supreme Court if a new justice were named, according to a poll conducted by the American Institute of Public Opinion.

A "cross-section" of the profession, including 5,000 lawyers, were polled and asked: "Is there anyone you would like to see named to the Supreme Court? If so, who?" Prof. Frankfurter was mentioned by the highest number.

TURKEY SEEN AS VIRTUAL REICH COLONY

NEW YORK, March 8. (JTA) -- Germany has almost succeeded in getting a stranglehold on Turkish trade -- to the point where the country is virtually a colony for the Nazis -- the New York Sun reports from Istanbul. Something like 54 per cent of Turkish commerce is with Germany, the dispatch says.

The method used to accomplish this is the "clearing" system, under which Germany buys in Turkey, pays the Government in blocked marks and Turkey is piling up credits in the Reich since her people have no use for large quantities of German manufactured goods.

HUGE GRAIN IMPORTS SEEN NEEDED BY GERMANY THIS YEAR

NEW YORK, March 8. (JTA) -- Germany must import this year no less than 3,500,000 tons of grain and another 500,000 tons of high protein feeds, according to a survey in the Koelnische Zeitung quoted in a Berlin dispatch by Otto D. Tolischus to the New York Times.

The actual demand is 3,750,000 tons of grain and fodder and between 500,000 and 750,000 tons of protein foods, according to the survey. There are charges that various Nazi projects are turning Germany gradually into a steppe, the dispatch says.

JEWISH STUDENTS IN POLISH UNIVERSITIES AT RECORD LOW

NEW YORK, March 8. (JTA) -- The lowest number of Jewish students in higher educational institutions in Poland in twelve years is revealed in a report made public by the Joint Distribution Committee. There were 1,114 Jewish students in universities in the year 1934-35.

STORY OF HAYM SALOMON FEATURES NEW BOOK ON WASHINGTON

NEW YORK, March 8. (JTA) -- "General Washington's Son of Israel and Other Forgotten Heroes of History," by Charles Spencer Hart, has been published by Lippincott. The first story concerns Haym Salomon, the Jewish broker who helped finance the American Revolution.
