PALESTINE REPORT OUT JULY 8; U.S. TREATY RIGHTS TO BE RESPECTED, COMMONS TOLD

LONDON, JUNE 30. (JTA) -- THE BRITISH GOVERNMENT ANNOUNCED TODAY THE REPORT OF THE ROYAL COMMISSION ON PALESTINE WOULD BE PUBLISHED JULY 8 AND AT THE SAME TIME PROMISED TO RESPECT THE RIGHTS OF THE UNITED STATES REGARDING PALESTINE UNDER A TREATY SIGNED IN 1924.

WILLIAM G.A. ORMSBY-GORE, THE COLONIAL SECRETARY, TOLD THE HOUSE OF COMMONS THE GOVERNMENT PROPOSED TO RELEASE THE REPORT IN TIME FOR ITS PUBLICATION AS A COMMAND PAPER CONTAINING A SHORT STATEMENT OF POLICY ON THE MORNING OF JULY 8. RECOMMENDATION FOR PARTITION OF PALESTINE BETWEEN ARABS AND JEWS ARE BELIEVED A FEATURE OF THE REPORT.

COPIES WILL BE AVAILABLE FOR MEMBERS OF PARLIAMENT LATE WEDNESDAY EVENING, JULY 7, MR. ORMSBY-GORE ADDED. HIS STATEMENT CAME WHILE THE CABINET WAS UNDERSTOOD TO BE

DISCUSSING THE REPORT AT ITS WEEKLY MEETING TODAY.

GEOFFREY MANDER, LIBERAL, ASKED THE COLONIAL SECRETARY WHETHER IT WAS PROPOSED TO CONSULT THE UNITED STATES GOVERNMENT REGARDING FUTURE POLICY IN PALESTINE IN VIEW OF THE TREATY OF DEC-3, 1924, BETWEEN GREAT BRITAIN AND THE UNITED STATES BY WHICH THE LATTER BECAME A PARTY TO THE AGREEMENT TO ESTABLISH PALESTINE AS A JEWISH NATIONAL HOME AND WHICH INCLUDED IN ITS FIRST ARTICLE A PROVISION THAT ANY MODIFICATION IN THE LEAGUE OF NATIONS MANDATE FOR PALESTINE MUST BE CONSENTED TO BY THE UNITED STATES.

THE COLONIAL SECRETARY REPLIED:

"In considering the future policy to be pursued in Palestine His Majesty's Government will, of course, keep constantly in mind any rights of the Government of the United States under the instrument to which Mr. Mander referred."

MR. MANDER ASKED:

"Have any representations been received from the United States Government up to date?"

"No," REPLIED THE COLONIAL SECRETARY.

ROUND-TABLE PARLEY REPORTED SET BY ZIONISTS, REVISIONISTS

LONDON, JUNE 30. (JTA) -- NEGOTIATIONS BETWEEN THE WORLD ZIONIST ORGANIZATION AND THE DISSIDENT RIGHT-WING NEW ZIONIST ORGANIZATION HAVE RESULTED IN AN AGREEMENT TO CONVENE A ROUND-TABLE CONFERENCE FOR THE PURPOSE OF ACHIEVING A UNITED FRONT, IT WAS LEARNED TO-DAY.

THE MIZRACHI FEDERATION OF GREAT BRITAIN, ORTHODOX ZIONIST BODY, ADOPTED A RESOL-UTION WELCOMING THE AGREEMENT AND VOICING HOPE THE CONFERENCE WOULD LEAD TO "A TRULY UN-ITED ZIONIST FRONT" IN VIEW OF POLITICAL DIFFICULTIES FACING THE ZIONIST MOVEMENT.

DETAILS OF THE CONFERENCE, SUCH AS SELECTION OF A NEUTRAL CHAIRMAN, THE PLACE AND DELEGATES WILL BE SETTLED SOON. IT WAS LEARNED.

RUMANIAN ANTI-SEMITES MOVE TO FORM NATIONAL FRONT; GHETTO URGED

JASSY, RUMANIA, JUNE 30. (JTA) -- FORMATION OF A NATIONAL ANTI-SEMITIC FRONT OF SEVERAL POLITICAL PARTIES WAS UNDER MAY TODAY AFTER FORMER PREMIER NICOLAE JORGA, NOTED HISTORIAN AND ONE-TIME OPPONENT OF ANTI-SEMITISM, HAD URGED REVIVAL OF THE GHETTO IN RUMANIA IN AN ADDRESS BEFORE A CONGRESS OF THE RUMANIAN CULTURAL LEAGUE.

PROFESSOR JORGA DEMANDED SEGREGATION OF JEWS FROM THE REST OF THE POPULATION AND CREATION OF "PURE RUMANIAN ZONES" AROUND CHURCHES, CULTURAL AND GOVERNMENT IN-

STITUTIONS . .

THE SUGGESTION FOR RE-INTRODUCTION OF THE GHETTO WAS OFFERED BY PROFESSOR JORGA AS A RESULT OF A POLITICAL TIE-UP BETWEEN HIM AND PROFESSOR ALEXANDER CUZA, LEADER OF

THE ANTI-SEMITIC NATIONAL CHRISTIAN PARTY.

PROFESSOR JORGA BEGAN HIS POLITICAL CAREER AS AN ANTI-SEMITE, BUT TURNED INTO AN OPPONENT OF ANTI-SEMITISM AFTER THE WORLD WAR. AS PREMIER HE ACCUSED PROFESSOR CUZA IN 1931 OF "POISONING YOUTH" AND ADVOCATED HIS ARREST. NOW, HOWEVER, HE HAS RETURNED TO THE ANTI-SEMITIC CAMP AND IS NEGOTIATING FOR MERGER OF HIS NATIONAL DEMOCRATIC PARTY WITH CUZA'S NATIONAL CHRISTIANS.

MARSHAL AVARESCU, FAMOUS WAR COMMANDER, DR. ALEXANDER VAIDA VOEVOD, LEADER OF THE RUMANIAN FRONT, AND PROFESSOR GEORG BRATIANU, LEADER OF THE NATIONAL LIBERAL PARTY ARE ALSO NEGOTIATING WITH PROFESSOR CUZA FOR FORMATION OF A NATIONALIST ANTI-SEMITIC COALITION WITH A VIEW TO FORMING THE NEXT GOVERNMENT FOR CARRYING OUT AN "ARYAN LEGIS—

ATION PROGRAM.

PEASANT LEADER ASSAILS CUZISTS

KISHINEV, RUMANIA, JUNE 30. (JTA) -- THE ANTI-SEMITIC PROPAGANDA OF FOLLOWERS OF PROF-ESSOR ALEXANDER CUZA WAS CONDEMNED TODAY BY NICOLAE LUPU, VICE-PRESIDENT OF THE NATION-AL PEASANT PARTY, ADDRESSING A MASS MEETING HERE.

M. LUPU DEMANDED THAT ALL EDUCATED PERSONS BE GIVEN AN OPPORTUNITY TO OBTAIN EM-

PLOYMENT WITHOUT DISTINCTION OF CREED OR RACE.

"We have ten thousand villages without doctors," he said. "We have many regions without roads. There is plenty of work for all. There is no need to be chauvinists regarding the Jews, who are the minority friendliest toward Rumanians and no danger to us."

PALESTINE LEAGUE BODY ASKS ACTION ON EAST EUROPEAN JEWS

PRAHA, JUNE 30. (JTA) -- THE CONGRESS OF THE INTERNATIONAL FEDERATION OF LEAGUE OF NATIONS SOCIETIES HAD BEFORE IT TODAY A DEMAND OF ITS PALESTINIAN BRANCH FOR ADOPTION OF A RESOLUTION PROTESTING ANTI-JEWISH DISCRIMINATION IN POLAND AND RUMANIA.

IN A STATISTICS-BOLSTERED MEMORANDUM ON THE SITUATION OF THE JEWS IN EASTERN EUROPE, THE PALESTINE SOCIETY ACCUSED THE POLISH GOVERNMENT OF TOLERATING ANTI-JEWISH TERRORISM AND QUSTING JEWS FROM ECONOMIC POSITIONS.

POLICEMAN, ARAB BANDIT LEADER KILLED IN PALESTINE

JERUSALEM, JUNE 30. (JTA) -- A POLICEMAN, MOHAMMED MAHMOUD, WAS KILLED YESTERDAY, WHEN A POLICE PATROL WAS FIRED ON NEAR KALKILLIA BY THE NOTORIOUS ARAB GANGSTER, ABDUL LATIF, THE POLICE REPLIED, KILLING LATIF.

LATIF WAS WANTED FOR THE MURDER OF ABRAHAM GOLUTHMAN, A JEW, IN MARCH, 1936. THE BRIGAND WAS A MEMBER OF THE GENERAL STAFF OF FAUZI BEY E KAUKAJI, SYRIAN TERRORIST LEADER WHO WAS ACTIVE IN PALESTINE DURING LAST YEAR'S DISORDERS.

ENTIRE FAMILY SLAIN IN POLISH TOWN

WARSAW. June 30. (JTA) -- POLICE WERE SEARCHING TODAY FOR PERSONS WHO MASSACRED A JEWISH FAMILY OF FIVE AND A VISITOR IN THE TOWN OF IWAGEWICZE, IN THE BRZESC (BREST-LITOVSK) DISTRICT. THOSE MURDERED WERE ABRAHAM SOKOLOWSKY, HIS WIFE, A SIX-WEEKS-OLD SON. THE FATHER AND MOTHER-IN-LAW AND A GIRL WHO WAS STAYING WITH THE FAMILY.

POLAND DENIES RELIEF TO JEWS IN TOWN RAZED BY FIRE

WARSAW. June 30. (JTA) -- A HUNDRED HOMELESS JEWISH FAMILIES IN THE TOWN OF BYCHAWA, NEAR LUBLIN. WHICH WAS THREE-FOURTHS RAZED BY FIRE, WERE INFORMED YESTERDAY BY THE DISTRICT GOVERNOR THAT THEY NEED NOT EXPECT ANY RELIEF FROM THE GOVERNMENT.

A DELEGATION OF THE JEWISH POPULATION, WHICH WAS RENDERED ALMOST DESTITUTE, WAITED UPON THE GOVERNOR WHEN HE VISITED THE TOWN, BUT HE REFUSED TO ALLOT ANY RELIEF TO JEWS. SAYING: "YOU JEWS HAVE PLENTY OF YOUR OWN CAPITAL."

U.S. EXPECTS BRITAIN TO KEEP MANDATE OBLIGATIONS, WAGNER TELLS ZIONISTS

NEW YORK, June 30. (JTA) -- AMERICA HAS "THE RIGHT" TO EXPECT GREAT BRITAIN TO KEEP HER PROMISES TO ESTABLISH AND MAINTAIN A JEWISH NATIONAL HOME IN PALESTINE, UNITED STATES SENATOR ROBERT F. WAGNER DECLARED LAST NIGHT BEFORE A MASS MEETING OF 2,000 ZIONISTS AT CARNEGIE HALL.

WHILE OTHER SPEAKERS AT THE MEETING, WHICH CLOSED THE FORTIETH ANNUAL CONVEN-TION OF THE ZIONIST ORGANIZATION OF AMERICA, DENGUNCED THE PROPOSAL FOR PARTITION OF THE COUNTRY BETWEEN JEWS AND ARABS, BELIEVED CONTAINED IN THE UNPUBLISHED REPORT OF THE ROYAL COMMISSION ON PALESTINE, AND MAYOR LAGUARDIA OF NEW YORK EXPRESSED CONFID-ENCE IN "THE SENSE OF JUSTICE AND FAIR PLAY OF ENGLAND," SENATOR WAGNER SAID THAT THE UNITED STATES AND BRITAIN ARE "PLEDGED TO ESTABLISH PALESTINE AS A HOMELAND FOR THE JEWISH PEOPLE."

"BRITAIN'S OBLIGATION," SENATOR WAGNER SAID, "IS NOT ONLY TOWARD THE JEWS. SHE HAS SIGNED A COMPACT IN THE NAME OF DEMOCRACY. BRITAIN CAN MAINTAIN HER FAITH ONLY BY HONORING THIS OBLIGATION. AMERICA HAS THE RIGHT TO EXPECT HER TO DO SO. THE AMER-ICAN PEOPLE, WHEREVER POSSIBLE, MUST HELP HER TO DO SO. COLONIZATION OF PALESTINE MUST BE ENCOURAGED. THE PROMISES FOR PALESTINE MUST BE KEPT."

OTHER SPEAKERS, ALL OF WHOM DENOUNCED PARTITION, INCLUDED MORRIS ROTHENBERG AND DR. ISRAEL GOLDSTEIN. BEN ZION MOSSINSOHN, A PALESTINIAN ZIONIST LEADER, ASSUR-ED THE CONVENTION THAT JEWISH SETTLERS IN PALESTINE WOULD STAND UP FOR MAINTENANCE OF THE HOMEZAND INTACT.

FEDERAL JUDGE JULIAN W. MACK PRESIDED IN PLACE OF DR. STEPHEN S. WISE, PRES-

IDENT OF THE ZOA WHO, HE ANNOUNCED, WAS "UTTERLY EXHAUSTED."

RESOLUTIONS ADOPTED BY THE CONVENTION AT ITS CONCLUDING BUSINESS SESSIONS IN-CLUDED ONE TO GIVE THE ZOA'S SERVICES TO AMERICANS SEEKING COMPENSATION FOR PROPERTY DESTROYED IN PALESTINE DURING ARAB DISORDERS. AND APPEALING TO THE AMERICAN GOVERN-MENT TO SEEK REDRESS. ANOTHER RESOLUTION RECOMMENDED ORGANIZATION OF A PRIVATE LAND DEVELOPMENT COMPANY UNDER ZOA AUSPICES TO COOPERATE WITH THE PALESTINE LAND DEVELOP-MENT COMPANY.

ANOTHER RESOLUTION DECLARED THE UNITED PALESTINE APPEAL HAD NOT RECEIVED A LARGE ENOUGH SHARE FROM COMMUNITY FUND-RAISING CAMPAIGNS IN SOME CITIES AND CALLED ON LOCAL ZIONIST ORGANIZATIONS TO REFRAIN FROM JOINT FUND CAMPAIGNS EXCEPT ON A BASIS OF PARITY WITH THE JOINT DISTRIBUTION COMMITTEE.

A RECOMMENDATION BY THE PUBLICATIONS COMMITTEE TO DISCONTINUE DOS YIDDISCHE FOLK, ZOA YIDDISH PAPER, WAS DEFEATED BY A SUBSTANTIAL MAJORITY AFTER A FLOOR FIGHT AGAINST THE PROPOSAL LED BY JOSEPH WEINSTEIN OF BALTIMORE.

STREICHER CHARGES U.S. WITH MAKING FALSE STATEMENTS ON HIRSCH

BERLIN, JUNE 30. (JTA) -- JULIUS STREICHER, NAZI CHIEFTAIN FOR THE FRANCONIAN DIST-RICT AND LEADING ANTI-SEMITE, TODAY ACCUSED THE GOVERNMENT OF THE UNITED STATES OF HAV-ING MADE FALSE STATEMENTS IN ITS ATTEMPT TO SAVE HELMUTH HIRSCH FROM BEHEADING ON APRIL 6. THE HAVAS NEWS AGENCY REPORTED.

HIS CHARGES CONSTITUTED THE FIRST INTIMATION THE GERMAN READING PUBLIC HAD HAD OF ANY OUTSIDE INTERVENTION IN BEHALF OF THE YOUNG JEW WHO WAS BEHEADED FOR "HIGH TREASON" DESPITE THE CLAIM OF THE AMERICAN STATE DEPARTMENT THAT HE WAS AN AMERICAN

"PUBLISHED ON THE FIRST PAGE OF STREIGHER'S WEEKLY ANTI-SEMITIC NEWSPAPER, DER STUERMER, THE ARTICLE SAID THAT "TO SAVE A JEW, A MAN TRUE TO JUDAISM, THE AMERICAN GOVERNMENT HAD DECLARED THAT THE MAN CONDEMNED TO DEATH WAS AN AMERICAN CITIZEN."

"When A Jew is called to account before an Aryan Judge," it added "all Israel intervenes to save the criminal. "They even have recourse to the intervention of non-Jewish Governments. The financial and political powers of Judaism in the U.S.A. were favorably heard in the White House in the matter of Hirsch."

PROF. ADLER, AUTHORITY ON SOCIALISM, DIES IN VIENNA

VIENNA, JUNE 30. (JTA) -- PROF. MAX ADLER, WHO ACHIEVED A WIDE REPUTATION AS A SOCIOLOGIST AND AUTHORITY ON MARXISM, DIED HERE TODAY AT THE AGE OF 64. PROF. ADLER WROTE MANY WORKS ON SOCIALISM.

LADY ASTOR WARNS JEWS AGAINST ANTI-GERMAN PROPAGANDA

NEW YORK, JUNE 30. (JTA) -- LADY NANCY ASTOR, SAILING BACK TO ENGLAND TODAY ABOARD THE NORMANDIE, CRITICIZED JEWIGH PROPAGANDA AGAINST GERMANY. DECLARING HERSELF NOT PROGERMAN BUT PRO-JEWISH, LADY ASTOR SAID SHE WAS "APPALLED" AT THE AMOUNT OF ANTI-GERMAN SENTIMENT IN THE UNITED STATES.

"I DON'T KNOW WHETHER THE JEWS ARE RESPONSIBLE FOR THIS," SHE SAID, "BUT IF SO IT IS BOUND TO REACT TO THEIR DISADVANTAGE."

GREEK ARCHBISHOP PRAISES JEWISH CHARITIES

SALONICA, JUNE 30. (UTA) -- THE ARCHBISHOP AND THE MAYOR OF CASTORIA TODAY RECEIVED BUCO DE MAYO, OF NEW YORK, WHO ANNOUNCED HE WAS CONTRIBUTING 150,000 DRACHMAS TO VARIOUS NON-JEWISH CHARITIES. Mr. MAYO, WHO IS HONDRARY PRESIDENT OF THE CASTORIA CHESSED VA"EMETH SOCIETY, JEWISH CHARITABLE ORGANIZATION, ALSO ANNOUNCED THAT THE SOCIETY WAS CONTRIBUTING 10,000 DRACHMAS TO THE CASTORIA MUNICIPAL HOSPITAL.

IN THANKING HIM, THE ARCHBISHOP PRAISED JEWISH CHARITABLE INSTITUTIONS. "YOU JEWS HAVE TAUGHT THE WORLD THE MEANING OF CHARITY," HE SAID. A WARD IN THE MUNICIPAL HOSPITAL WAS NAMED AFTER MR. MAYO.
