

BRITAIN SEEKS EARLY LEAGUE ACTION ON PARTITION

GENEVA, JULY 11. (JTA) -- IT WAS RELIABLY LEARNED TODAY THAT THE BRITISH GOVERNMENT HAS REQUESTED THE LEAGUE OF NATIONS COUNCIL TO PERMIT THE MANDATES COMMISSION TO CONSIDER THE ENTIRE REPORT OF THE ROYAL COMMISSION, TOGETHER WITH ITS PROPOSAL TO TRIPARTITION PALESTINE, AT ITS JULY 30 EXTRAORDINARY SESSION.

SINCE THE ROYAL COMMISSION'S PROPOSALS AFFECT THE MANDATE OVER PALESTINE, THE MANDATES COMMISSION MAY NOT CONSIDER THE REPORT WITHOUT THE COUNCIL'S PERMISSION.

GENERAL SECRETARY JOSEPH AVENOL, AFTER RECEIVING THE BRITISH GOVERNMENT'S REQUEST, IMMEDIATELY CONSULTED WITH COUNCIL MEMBERS. NEGOTIATIONS ARE CONTINUING, WITH A DECISION EXPECTED AT AN EARLY DATE.

PROF. WILLIAM RAPPARD, VICE-PRESIDENT OF THE MANDATES COMMISSION, TOLD THE JEWISH TELEGRAPHIC AGENCY TODAY IT WAS THE COMMISSION'S DUTY TO SAFEGUARD COMPLETE APPLICATION OF THE MANDATE AND THAT IT WOULD DO SO AT THE NEXT SESSION.

AGUDIST LEADERS ACCEPT PARTITION WITH RESERVATIONS

LONDON, JULY 11. (JTA) -- VIRTUAL ACCEPTANCE OF THE PROPOSED JEWISH STATE IN PALESTINE WAS DECIDED UPON TODAY BY RELIGIOUS NON-ZIONIST LEADERS, WITH THE QUALIFICATION THAT THE SUGGESTED BOUNDARIES "UNDOUBTEDLY REQUIRE REVISION."

THE LEADERS, COMPRISING THE EXECUTIVE OF THE WORLD AGUDATH ORGANIZATION, CENTRAL JEWISH RELIGIOUS BODY NOT IDENTIFIED WITH THE ZIONIST MOVEMENT, AGREED TO PRESENT THE WHOLE PROBLEM TO THE WORLD CONGRESS SCHEDULED TO OPEN IN MARIENBAD, CZECHOSLOVAKIA, NEXT MONTH.

MEANWHILE, THE EXECUTIVE ADOPTED A RESOLUTION SETTING FORTH THESE VIEWS:

THAT THE SUGGESTED BOUNDARIES OF THE PROPOSED STATE UNDOUBTEDLY REQUIRE REVISION; THAT ASSOCIATION OF JEWRY WITH JERUSALEM, WHICH IS TO BE UNDER A NEW PERMANENT BRITISH MANDATE, MUST BE MAINTAINED; THAT IT IS ESSENTIAL TO ESTABLISH THE NEW JEWISH COMMONWEALTH

ON THE BASIS OF THE TORAH, THUS ENABLING JEWS AGAIN TO FULFILL THEIR MISSION IN THE HOLY LAND; THAT THE MANDATORY AND THE LEAGUE OF NATIONS CONSIDER THE VIEWS OF THE WHOLE OF JEWRY, NOT ONLY INDIVIDUAL ORGANIZATIONS, IN THE NEGOTIATIONS TO TAKE PLACE WHEN THE TREATIES ESTABLISHING THE TWO STATES ARE TO BE SIGNED.

"SUPERFICIAL ENTHUSIASM" FOR JEWISH STATE HIT IN POLAND

WARSAW, JULY 11. (JTA) -- THE "SUPERFICIAL ENTHUSIASM" WITH WHICH THE JEWISH MASSES IN POLAND HAVE GREETED THE PROPOSED CREATION OF A JEWISH STATE IN PALESTINE IS DEPRECATED BY YIDDISH NEWSPAPERS TODAY.

THE HAJNT, WHICH FAVORS ACCEPTANCE OF THE STATE IN PRINCIPLE, VOICES STRONG OPPOSITION TO ALL DETAILS OF ITS PROPOSED ESTABLISHMENT.

IN AN EDITORIAL CAPTIONED "ROSES AND THORNS," THE ZIONIST DAILY DEMANDS A FIGHT FOR THE MAXIMUM CONCESSIONS OBTAINABLE, NOTABLY LARGER TERRITORY.

"UNTIL THIS HAS BEEN ACHIEVED," THE EDITORIAL STATES, "WE SHALL NOT RELIEVE ENGLAND OF HER OBLIGATIONS UNDER THE MANDATE. LET'S REMOVE THE THORNS BUT NOT REJECT THE ROSE."

DER MOMENT COUNSELS THAT WHETHER THE ROYAL COMMISSION'S REPORT IS ACCEPTED OR REJECTED, IT MUST BE FOUGHT WITH THE "UTMOST DISCIPLINE."

DOS NAJE WORT CONDEMNS THE PROPOSALS AS FAILING TO SATISFY JEWISH NATIONAL NEEDS. CHWILA, LWOV ORGAN OF THE EAST GALICIA ZIONIST ORGANIZATION, URGES THAT THE REPORT BE GIVEN CAREFUL CONSIDERATION, ADVISING THAT "THE MERE SOUND OF A JEWISH STATE MUST NOT DEPRIVE US OF OUR REASONING FACULTIES."

ABDULLAH SNUBS ARAB HIGHER COMMITTEE

JERUSALEM, JULY 11. (JTA) -- A GENERAL CONFERENCE OF PALESTINE ARABS IN OPPOSITION TO GREAT BRITAIN'S PLAN TO PARTITION THE COUNTRY BETWEEN THEM AND THE JEWS, TO BE HELD JULY 17, WAS DECIDED UPON TODAY BY THE ARAB HIGHER COMMITTEE.

THE CONFERENCE WAS PLANNED AFTER DISCORD AMONG THE ARABS OVER THE PARTITION PROPOSAL HAD BEEN FURTHER EMBITTERED BY WHAT THE COMMITTEE FELT WAS A SLIGHTING MESSAGE FROM THE PALACE OF EMIR ABDULLAH OF TRANSJORDAN.

IT CAME IN RESPONSE TO AN APPEAL FOR ADVICE ON HOW TO COPE WITH THE PARTITION PLAN, SENT BY THE COMMITTEE TO RULERS OF NEIGHBORING ARAB STATES, AND IT READ:

"EVENTS OF THE PAST ARE A LESSON TO THE WISE. ABDULLAH WILL CONTINUE TO SERVE THE ARABS FOR THEIR BENEFIT ACCORDING TO HIS CONSCIENCE."

ABDULLAH, REGARDED AS A STRONG ADVOCATE OF PARTITION INASMUCH AS HE STANDS TO HAVE THE PROPOSED ARAB PORTION OF PALESTINE ADDED TO HIS DOMAIN, IS OPPOSED BY HAJ AMIN EL HUSSEINI, GRAND MUFTI OF PALESTINE AND CHAIRMAN OF THE ARAB HIGH COMMITTEE. THE COMMITTEE GAVE EVIDENCE OF ITS OFFENDED FEELINGS BY NOT SENDING A FORMAL MESSAGE OF THANKS FOR THE TELEGRAM.

IN RESPONSE TO SIMILAR APPEALS TO OTHER ARAB RULERS, THE COMMITTEE HAD RECEIVED SYMPATHETIC REPLIES FROM HIKMET SULEIMAN, PREMIER OF IRAQ, AND THE EMIR OF KUWAIT, BRITISH PRINCIPALITY ON THE PERSIAN GULF. THE IRAQ PREMIER CABLED THE BRITISH GOVERNMENT PROTESTING AGAINST PARTITION AND ANNOUNCING HIS COUNTRY WAS READY TO PEACEFULLY ASSIST ITS ARABIAN BRETHREN IN PALESTINE.

A GENERAL STRIKE BY ARABS TO PROTEST PARTITION IS BEING PLANNED, ACCORDING TO A DISPATCH FROM DAMASCUS TO THE ARAB PAPER AL LIWA, HERE. AL LIWA SAID NO DATE HAD YET BEEN SET FOR THE STRIKE.

SEES ARABS ACCEPTING PARTITION IF LEADERS ARE GUARANTEED GOOD POLITICAL JOBS

NEW YORK, JULY 11. (JTA) -- GUARANTEE OF GOOD POLITICAL JOBS FOR ALL ARAB LEADERS WOULD WIN ARAB ACCEPTANCE OF THE BRITISH DECISION TO TRIPARTITION PALESTINE, IT IS ASSERTED TODAY BY JOSEPH M. LEVY, NEW YORK TIMES CORRESPONDENT, IN A DISPATCH FROM JERUSALEM.

"THE ARAB REACTION TO THE (ROYAL) COMMISSION'S PROPOSALS," HE WRITES, "MAY BE SUMMED UP AS FOLLOWS: IF ALL THE ARAB LEADERS COULD BE GUARANTEED IMPORTANT POLITICAL JOBS IN THE NEW ARAB STATE THEY WOULD ACCEPT THE PARTITION SCHEME WITHOUT THE SLIGHTEST HESITATION."

"TEMPORARY" CONTROL OF HAIFA MAY HAVE EGYPTIAN MEANING

NEW YORK, JULY 11. (JTA) -- POINTING OUT THAT GREAT BRITAIN WILL "KEEP HER IMPERIAL FINGER IN THE EASTERN MEDITERRANEAN" DESPITE THE PROPOSED PARTITION OF THE HOLY LAND, FERDINAND KUHN JR., LONDON CORRESPONDENT OF THE NEW YORK TIMES, INDICATES IN A DISPATCH TODAY THAT PROPOSED BRITISH CONTROL OF HAIFA MAY NOT BE QUITE AS "TEMPORARY" AS THE ROYAL COMMISSION'S PROPOSALS INTIMATE.

"SHE WILL KEEP THE ALL-IMPORTANT NAVAL BASE AND PIPELINE TERMINUS AT HAIFA," HE WRITES, "'TEMPORARILY' UNDER HER CONTROL -- AND 'TEMPORARILY' IS A WORD WHICH IN THE CASE OF THE BRITISH OCCUPATION OF EGYPT WAS STRETCHED OVER HALF A CENTURY."

ALL GERMAN JEWISH BODIES JOIN REICHSVERTRETUNG; PACT ENDS DISPUTE

BERLIN, JULY 11. (JTA) -- DIFFERENCE BETWEEN THE BERLIN JEWISH COMMUNITY AND THE REICHSVERTRETUNG, GENERAL ORGANIZATION OF GERMAN JEWS, WHICH RECENTLY THREATENED TO DISRUPT THE NATIONAL ORGANIZATION, WERE SETTLED TODAY.

AN AGREEMENT WAS REACHED UNDER WHICH ALL JEWISH ORGANIZATIONS IN THE COUNTRY, INCLUDING STATE ZIONISTS AND INDEPENDENT ORTHODOX GROUPS WILL JOIN THE REICHSVERRETUNG, MAKING IT THE OFFICIAL REPRESENTATIVE ORGANIZATION OF GERMAN JEWRY IN DEALING WITH THE GERMAN AUTHORITIES AS WELL AS WITH JEWISH RELIEF ORGANIZATIONS ABROAD.

THE REICHSVERRETUNG, OF WHICH DR. LEO BAECK IS PRESIDENT, WILL CONTROL INCOMING FUNDS AS THE CHIEF ORGANIZATION FOR RELIEF WORK IN GERMANY AND THE PLANNING CENTER FOR ALL JEWISH ACTIVITIES. THE AGREEMENT SPECIFIES THE ESTABLISHMENT OF SCHOOLS AND INSTITUTES FOR VOCATIONAL TRAINING TO REMAIN UNDER SUPERVISION OF THE UNIONS OF JEWISH COMMUNITIES. A NEW EXECUTIVE BOARD WAS NAMED.

ROTHSCHILDS ASSAILED BY NAZI SPOKESMAN AT ERFURT PARLEY

BERLIN, JULY 11. (JTA) -- JEWISH FINANCIERS, AND PARTICULARLY THE HOUSE OF ROTHSCCHILD, WERE ATTACKED AS "DESPTS SEEKING WORLD DOMINANCE" BY PROFESSOR WILHELM GRAU, HEAD OF THE INSTITUTE FOR THE HISTORY OF THE THIRD REICH, IN AN ADDRESS BEFORE THE FIRST CONGRESS OF GERMAN HISTORIANS UNDER THE NAZI REGIME, AT ERFURT.

"THE ROTHSCHILDS INTRODUCED THE RULE OF MONEY INTO EUROPEAN POLITICS," PROFESSOR GRAU CHARGED. "MONEY WITHOUT A FATHERLAND, WITHOUT SOUL AND WITHOUT FAITH BECAME THE DOMINATING INFLUENCE IN POLITICS."

THE IDEA OF A WORLD RULED BY FINANCE "INCLUDED NO NATIONS, ONLY ECONOMIC PROVINCES," HE SAID.

"THIS IDEA IS CLOSELY RELATED TO THAT OF THE MARXISTS," PROFESSOR GRAU DECLARED. "ROTHSCCHILD AND MARX WERE BROTHERS IN BLOOD AND SPIRIT. NATIONAL SOCIALISM'S VICTORY STRUCK THE FIRST REAL BLOW TO AN INTERNATIONALISM OF THIS FORM AND RECALLED THE NATIONS TO THEIR REAL DUTIES."

PALESTINE LABORITES WIN 67% OF ZIONIST CONGRESS VOTE

JERUSALEM, JULY 11. (JTA) -- THE LABORITES WON A 67 PERCENT MAJORITY IN WEDNESDAY'S ELECTIONS FOR PALESTINIAN DELEGATES TO THE WORLD ZIONIST CONGRESS, IT WAS ANNOUNCED TODAY. A TOTAL OF 123 DELEGATES WERE CHOSEN.

THE GENERAL ZIONISTS, GROUP A, HAD 4 PER CENT; GENERAL ZIONISTS, GROUP B, 7 PER CENT; MIZRACHI, 4 PER CENT; AND POALE MIZRACHI 13 PER CENT.

POLAND RESTRICTS ZIONIST CONGRESS CANDIDATES TO NATIONALS

WARSAW, JULY 11. (JTA) -- THE NAMES OF LORD MELCHETT AND PROF. SELIG BRODETSKY OF ENGLAND, AND DAVID BEN GURION, CHAIRMAN OF THE JERUSALEM EXECUTIVE OF THE JEWISH AGENCY FOR PALESTINE, WERE REMOVED FROM THE LIST OF CANDIDATES IN THE ELECTIONS FOR THE WORLD ZIONIST CONGRESS BY GOVERNMENT ORDER TODAY.

POLISH AUTHORITIES GAVE INSTRUCTIONS THAT ONLY POLISH NATIONALS MIGHT RUN IN THE ZIONIST ELECTIONS.
