REICH ISSUES RULES ON ADMISSION OF JEWS TO GERMAN SCHOOLS

BERLIN, JULY 16. (JTA) -- A STATE PAPER REGULATING ADMISSION OF JEWS TO GERMAN SCHOOLS WAS MADE PUBLIC HERE TODAY BY THE REICHSMINISTER OF EDUCATION, DR. BERNHARD RUST.

THE REGULATIONS DISTINGUISH BETWEEN COMPULSORY ELEMENTARY SCHOOLS, THE HIGHER STANDARD SECONDARY SCHOOLS AND THE HIGH SCHOOLS (INCLUDING COLLEGES AND UNIVERSITIES.)

ADMISSION OF JEWS TO THE ELEMENTARY SCHOOLS IS TO BE REGULATED UNDER THE GENERAL LAW FOR COMPULSORY EDUCATION. THUS, IF SPECIAL JEWISH SCHOOLS ARE NOT AVAILABLE OR THE EDUCATIONAL AUTHORITIES ARE UNABLE TO PROVIDE SPECIAL SCHOOLS FOR JEWS, JEWISH CHILDREN MUST ATTEND THE GENERAL ELEMENTARY SCHOOLS.

(LATEST AVAILABLE STATISTICS REVEAL THAT MORE THAN 20,000 JEVISH SCHOOLCHILDREN, OR ABOUT HALF OF THE TOTAL NUMBER, ARE NOW ENTERED IN JEWISH SCHOOLS. EFFORTS TO PROVIDE FOR SCHOOLING OF THE REMAINDER ARE BEING MADE BY JEWISH COMMUNITY ORGANIZATIONS.)

IN THE HIGHER SCHOOLS, ACCORDING TO THE REGULATIONS, JEWISH STUDENTS MUST FORM ONLY I.5 PER CENT OF THE TOTAL REGISTRATION. "MISCHLINGS," CHILDREN OF MIXED BLOOD, MAY ATTEND THE GENERAL ELEMENTARY AS WELL AS THE SECONDARY SCHOOLS, BUT ARE ALSO ALLOWED TO ATTEND THE SPECIAL JEWISH SCHOOLS. IF THEY ATTEND THE LATTER, HOWEVER, IT IS SPECIFIED THAT THEY LOSE THE RIGHT TO BECOME GERMAN NATIONALS.

THE "MISCHLINGS" ARE ALLOWED TO PARTICIPATE IN ALL SCHOOL FUNCTIONS, INCLUDING EXCURSIONS AND SPORTS, WHILE JEWISH CHILDREN ARE PERMITTED ONLY TO ATTEND CLASSES BUT WITHOUT THE RIGHT TO SIT FOR EXAMINATIONS.

THE REGULATIONS ALSO SPECIFY THAT JEWS AND "MISCHLINGS" MAY NOT BECOME TEACHERS IN GERMAN SCHOOLS. JEWS, HOWEVER, MAY AIM AT TEACHING CAREERS IN JEWISH SCHOOLS, AND WILL BE PERMITTED TO TAKE EXAMINATIONS FOR SUCH POSTS.

THE REGULATIONS FINALLY POINT OUT THAT THE TERM "NON-ÂRYAN," WITHIN THE MEANING OF THE ACT, IS APPLICABLE ONLY TO JEWS.

DAS SCHWARZE KORPS, ORGAN OF CHANCELLOR HITLER'S ELITE GUARDS, IN ITS CURRENT ISSUE WARNS GERMAN SCIENTISTS NOT TO HOLD UP JEWISH SCIENTISTS AS "MODELS."

THE TERM "JEWISH SCIENTIST," THE PERIODICAL CONTENDS, "MUST BE EXTENDED BEYOND THE PURELY RACIAL CONCEPTS." SCIENTISTS WHO CONTINUE TO RESPECT JEWISH COLLEAGUES WILL BE CLASSIFIED AS "WHITE JEWS," THE PAPER WARNS.

"White Jews," The publication states, "are persons of Aryan blood who have shown themselves receptive to Jewish intellect, to which they are slaves. The Definition of Jews must be extended to those of Jewish Feeling, Jewish Intellect and Jewish character. All these representatives of Jewoom in German intellectual life must disappear, even as the Jew Himself."

THE PAPER THEN ATTACKS PROF. WERNER REISEMBERG OF LEIPZIG, NOBEL PRIZE WINNER IN 1934, FOR HAVING "BMUGGLED" AN ARTICLE INTO AN OFFICIAL NAZI SCIENCE PAPER, IN WHICH HE STATED THAT THE RELATIVIST PHILOSOPHY FORMS THE BASIS OF MODERN SCIENTIFIC RESEARCH. IT TERMS THE SCIENTIST THE "OSSIETZKY OF PHYSICS."

TAX EXEMPTIONS TAKEN FROM REICH-JEWISH CHARITIES

BERLIN (JTA) -- THE REICHMINISTER OF JUSTICE AND THE PRUSSIAN MINISTER OF FINANCE HAVE ISSUED A JOINT ORDER STATING THAT JEWISH CHARITABLE INSTITUTIONS WILL NO LONGER BE EXEMPTED FROM TAXATION OR THE PAYMENT OF ANY COURT FEES.

ACCORDING TO THE NEW TAXATION LAW, THE ORDER STATES, ONLY SUCH INSTITUTIONS AND SOCIETIES CAN CLAIM TO BE CHARITABLE WHICH GIVE RELIEF TO NEEDY GERMANS. THIS LAW DEPRIVES, THEREFORE, THE JEWISH CHARITABLE INSTITUTIONS OF THEIR CHARITABLE CHARACTER.

ITALY IGNORES LEAGUE ON BRITISH REQUEST FOR EARLY PARTITION ACTION

GENEVA, JULY 16. (JTA) — IT WAS REVEALED HERE TODAY THAT ITALY HAS NOT REPLIED TO GENERAL SECRETARY JOSÉPH AVENCL'S NOTE ON GREAT BRITAIN'S REQUEST THAT THE LEAGUE OF NATIONS COUNCIL PERMIT THE PERMANENT MANDATES COMMISSION TO TAKE UP THE BRITISH ROYAL COMMISSION'S REPORT RECOMMENDING TRIPARTITION OF PALESTINE AT THE EXTRAORDINARY SESSION JULY 30.

SEVERAL GOVERNMENTS HAVE REPLIED TO MR. AVENOL'S LETTER, VOICING APPROVAL OF THE BRITISH PROPOSALS. POLAND, HOWEVER, RESERVED THE RIGHT TO CRITICIZE THEM AT A PLENARY SESSION.

THE MANDATES COMMISSION IS SCHEDULED TO CONSIDER THE MANDATORY'S DELAYED REPORT ON ITS PALESTIME STEWARDSHIP DURING 1936. SINCE, THE ROYAL COMMISSION'S REPOR AFFECTS THE MANDATE, PERMISSION OF THE COUNCIL IS NECESSARY BEFORE THE MANDATES COMMISSION MAY CONSIDER IT.

POLISH GOVERNMENT PAPER HITS U.S. JEWS FOR ASKING HULL TO INTERCEDE

WARSAW, JULY 16. (JTA) - AMERICAN JEWS' PROTESTS TO THEIR GOVERNMENT OVER PERSECUTION OF POLISH JEWS WERE ASSAULED AS "ATTEMPTS TO INTERFERE IN THE INTERNAL AFFAIRS OF POLAND" BY THE GAZETA POLSKA, SEMI-OFFICIAL POLISH GOVERNMENT ORGAN, TODAY.

COMMENTING EDITORIALLY ON THE MEMORANDUM ON POLISH PERSECUTION SUBMITTED TO SECRETARY OF STATE CORDELL HULL BY A DELEGATION HEADED BY DR. STEPHEN S. WISE, THE GAZETA DECLARED:

"ATTEMPTS TO INTERFERE IN THE INTERNAL AFFAIRS OF POLAND MUST PROVOKE THE IN-DIGNATION OF THE POLES. THE POLICY OF THE JEWS IS SURPRISINGLY BLIND, ASKING ON THE ONE HAND POLAND'S DIPLOMATIC ASSISTANCE WITH REGARD TO PALESTINE, AND ON THE OTHER HAND OPPOSING POLAND'S EMIGRATION PLANS AND CONDUCTING AN ANTI-POLISH CAMPAIGN ABROAD."

RETALIATION UPON POLISH JEWS FOR THE AMERICAN PROTEST WAS SUGGESTED BY ABC, CHIEF ORGAN OF THE ANTI-SENITIC NATIONAL RADICAL PARTY, WHICH STATED THAT THE CAMPAIGN WAS UNDOUBTEDLY INSPIRED BY POLISH JEWS AND DEMANDED THE DISCOVERY AND PUNISHMENT OF THE CULPRITS.

POLAND, REICH TAKE OVER OWN AREAS IN UPPER SILESIA

BETHUEN, UPPER SILESIA, JULY 16. (JTA) -- UPPER SILESIA, DIVIDED BETWEEN GERMANY AND POLAND, EXPERIENCED ITS FIRST DAY UNDER THE NEW REGIMES TODAY WITH DIFFERENCES BETWEEN THE TWO COUNTRIES OVER ADMINISTRATION OF THE TERRITORY STILL LARGELY UNSETTLED.

THE FIFTEEN-YEAR-OLD GENEVA CONVENTION INTENDED TO BRING HARMONY, AND UNDER WHICH THE LEAGUE OF NATIONS ADMINISTERED THE REGION, EXPIRED AT MIDNIGHT WEDNESDAY, AND UPPER SILESIA WAS SPLIT BETWEEN POLAND AND GERMANY IN ACCORDANCE WITH THE PLEBISCITE OF 1920. BUT A PROVISIONAL AGREEMENT ANNOUNCED IN BERLIN COVERED ONLY MINOR MATTERS. MAJOR POINTS SUCH AS RESIDENTIAL RIGHTS OF MINORITIES REMAINED IN DISPUTE.

ANTI-JEWISH MEASURES AFFECTING THE GERMAN PORTION OF THE TERRITORY WERE ANNOUNCED SOME TIME AGO BY CHANGELLOR ADOLF HITLER.

DR. A. CORALNIK, JOURNALIST, DIES OF HEART ATTACK AT 54

NEW YORK, JULY 16. (JTA) -- Dr. ABRAHAM CORALNIK, WRITER AND VETERAN MEMBER OF THE STAFF OF THE DAY, NEW YORK YIDDISH NEWSPAPER, DIED EARLY THIS MORNING AT MT. KOSCO (N.Y.), FOLLOWING A HEART ATTACK EARLIER THIS WEEK. HE WAS 54 YEARS OLD.

DR. CORALNIK WAS SPENDING THE SUMMER AT ARMONK, N.Y. HE HAD BEEN SUFFERING FROM A HEART AILMENT FOR MONTHS. AFTER HE WAS STRICKEN HE WAS PLACED UNDER AN OXYGEN TENT, WHERE HE REMAINED FROM MONDAY UNTIL HIS DEATH.

DR. CORALNIK WAS HIGHLY REGARDED IN YIDDISH LITERARY CIRCLES FOR HIS ORIGINAL STYLE, DEEP UNDERSTANDING OF JEWISH PROBLEMS AND MANY-COLORED PERSONALITY.

HE WAS BORN OCTOBER 16, 1883, IN UMAN, PROVINCE OF KIEV, RUSSIA. HIS FATHER, DAVID CORALNIK, IS NOW A MERCHANT IN JERUSALEM. DR. CORALNIK STUDIED IN THE UNIVERSITIES OF KIEV, FLORENCE, BERLIN, BONN AND VIENNA. THE UNIVERSITY OF VIENNA AWARDED HIM A PH.D. DEGREE IN 1908.

IN 1915, DURING THE WORLD WAR, HE CAME TO AMERICA, WHERE HE JOINED THE STAFF OF THE DAY, WRITING FOR IT REGULARLY UNTIL THE LAST. HIS ESSAYS AND ARTICLES APPEARED IN VARIOUS JEWISH PERIODICALS IN AMERICA AND EUROPE. MANY OF HIS WRITINGS WERE PUBLISHED IN BOOK FORM A FEW YEARS AGO IN FIVE VOLUMES.

DR. CORALNIK WAS ACTIVE FOR A TIME IN THE ZIONIST MOVEMENT, SERVED AS PRES-IDENT OF THE UNION OF UKRAINIAN JEWS IN AMERICA, AND PRESIDENT OF THE JEWISH WRITERS' CLUB.

HE IS SURVIVED BY A WIDOW AND TWO CHILDREN. HIS BROTHER, B. CORALNIK, IS EDITOR OF THE JERUSALEM BUREAU OF THE JEWISH TELEGRAPHIC AGENCY.

LIBERAL WEEKLIES HERE CITE DANGERS OF PARTITION

NEW YORK, JULY 16. (JTA) -- Serious difficulties facing the partitioning of PALESTINE, and grave dangers which will beset the proposed Jewish State, were emphasized in editorials today in the liberal weeklies the Nation and the New Republic.

BOTH MAGAZINES REFRAINED, HOWEVER, FROM PASSING FINAL JUDGMENT ON THE BRITISH GOVERNMENT'S PLAN FOR ENDING THE HOLY LAND'S TROUBLES.

TERMING PARTITION "AN AWKWARD WAY OUT OF THE PROBLEM," THE NEW REPUBLIC DECLARED THE BRITISH ROYAL COMMISSION HAD NOT TOUCHED "THE MOST SERIOUS OF ALL PROBLEMS IN PALESTINE," -- POVERTY.

"IF THE BRITISH ROYAL COMMISSION COULD HAVE SOLVED THE PROBLEM OF MALDISTRIBUTION OF WEALTH IN BOTH THE JEWISH AND ARAB COMMUNITIES, THERE WOULD HAVE BEEN NO NEED FOR SUCH HEROIC MEASURES AS HAVE NOW BEEN PROPOSED. BUT MAGNIFICENT COMMON SENSE OF THIS SORT IS PERHAPS HARDLY TO BE EXPECTED, AND LEAST OF ALL FROM A ROYAL COMMISSION."

THE NATION WAS MORE OPTIMISTIC ABOUT THE CHANCES THAT PARTITION WILL SUCCEED, THOUGH IT DECLARED: "FROM AN ECONOMIC POINT OF VIEW IT IS MANIFESTLY ABSURD TO DIVIDE, A TINY COUNTRY OF NOT MORE THAN 10,000 SQUARE MILES INTO THREE DISTINCT POLITICAL AND ECONOMIC UNITS." IF THE PLAN IS APPROVED BY THE LEAGUE OF NATIONS, THE UNITED STATES SHOULD NOT STAND IN THE WAY, THE MAGAZINE SAID.

"ONCE THE PRINCIPLE OF PARTITION IS ACCEPTED THE DETAILS OF THE COMMISSION'S PLAN STAND OUT AS A REASONABLE COMPROMISE." THE NATION HELD.

THE CHIEF DANGER LIES IN THE IMMEDIATE FUTURE, THE EDITORIAL SAID, WITH ARAB AND ZIONIST FEELINGS AT HIGH PITCH. AFTER THE NEW STATES ARE ESTABLISHED FRICTION MAY DIMINISH, IT SAID.

BUT, THE NATION WARNED, THE JEWISH STATE WILL "STRUGGLE UNDER TREMENDOUS HANDICAPS."

"THE DIFFICULTIES WILL BE MAGNIFIED IF THE SOCIALISTS GAIN CONTROL OF THE NEW STATE, AS SEEMS PROBABLE," THE NATION SAID. "NO MATTER HOW MODERATE OR WISE SUCH A GOVERNMENT'S POLICIES MIGHT BE, THEY WOULD BE HELD UP AS A TERRIBLE EXAMPLE OF JEWISH RADICALISM. AND JEWISH CAPITALISTS FROM WHOM AID WOULD STILL BE MEEDED MIGHT FIND IT INCREASINGLY DIFFICULT TO RECONCILE THEIR BELIEF IN A JEWISH NATIONAL HOME WITH THEIR BITTER OPPOSITION TO SOCIALISM."
