POLAND, RUMANIA SEEK UNITED LEAGUE STAND ON JEWISH EMIGRATION

BUCHAREST, JULY 28. (JTA) -- A JOINT RUMANIAN-POLISH FRONT TO PRESS THROUGH THE LEAGUE OF NATIONS FOR A POLICY OF FURTHER JEWISH EMIGRATION FROM BOTH COUNTRIES WAS DISCUSSED DURING A RECENT VISIT OF POLISH STATESMEN TO BUCHAREST, IT WAS DISCLOSED TODAY.

THE REVELATION WAS MADE IN AN ARTICLE BY JON MICHALACHE, LEADER OF THE NATIONAL PEASANTS PARTY, IN THE NATIONALIST PAPER CURENTUL. THE PEASANTS' LEADER HAS BEEN CONSIDERED THE LEAST ANTI-SEMITIC OF ALL RUMANIAN POLITICIANS.

HE DECLARED THE LEAGUE OF NATIONS IS THE ONLY BODY ABLE TO SOLVE THE PROBLEM OF PALESTINE SINCERELY AND COMPETENTLY.

HOLDING THAT A "JEWISH PROBLEM" EXISTS IN RUMANIA, HE ASSERTED THAT ITS ONLY SOL-UTION WOULD BE "PEASANT CO-OPERATIVES, EDUCATION OF YOUTH AND GOVERNMENT SUPPORT FOR RUMANIAN ELEMENTS TO COMPENSATE FOR HISTORICAL, SOCIAL, NATIONAL AND ECONOMIC INJUSTICES.

BY THIS STATEMENT MICHALACHE INDICATED SUPPORT FOR MEASURES TO GIVE NON-JEWS ADVAL TAGES AND ELIMINATE JEWS FROM THEIR PRESENT POSITIONS.

WHAT STALIN SAID ABOUT JEWS QUOTED IN NEW FEUCHTWANGER BOOK

LONDON, JULY 28. (JTA) -- JOSEPH STALIN WAS QUOTED BY LION FEUCHTWANGER TODAY AS DECLARING, "YOU JEWS HAVE CREATED ONE ETERNALLY TRUE LEGEND -- THAT OF JUDAS."

THE REMARK WAS MADE, FEUCHTWANGER SAYS IN HIS NEW BOOK, "MOSCOW, 1937," DURING AN INTERVIEW WITH STALIN IN MOSCOW WHEN THE SOVIET DICTATOR BECAME EXCITED IN THE COURSE OF DISCUSSING THE TRIALS OF TROTSKYISTS.

"IT WAS STRANGE TO HEAR A MAN OTHERWISE SO SOBER AND LOGICAL UTTER THESE SIMPLE AND EMOTIONAL WORDS," DECLARES THE EXILED GERMAN WRITER.

ARAB-JEWISH TALKS TO AVOID PARTITION SEEN IN OFFING

LONDON, JULY 28. (JTA) -- A MOVEMENT FOR AN ARAB-JEWISH RAPPROCHEMENT TO AVOID PROPOSED PARTITION OF THE HOLY LAND IS MAKING RAPID STRIDES IN PALESTINE, THE JERUSALEM CORRESPONDENT OF THE TIMES OF LONDON DECLARES IN A DISPATCH TODAY.

CONSIDERABLE IMPETUS HIS BEEN GIVEN THE MOVEMENT BY THE PARLIAMENTARY DEBATES, THE CORRESPONDENT ASSERTS, AND BY THE LETTER OF SIR HENRY MACMAHON, FORMER BRITISH HIGH COMMISSIONER FOR EGYPT, DENYING THAT PALESTINE WAS INCLUDED IN HIS 1915 PLEDGE TO THE ARABS.

As a result of the debates and the letter Palestinian Jews feel the case against partition has been strengthened, the writer reports.

THE EFFECT ON THE ARABS, HE SAYS, HAS BEEN TO REDUCE TENSION CREATED BY FEAR OF PARTITION AND TO TURN THEIR MINDS IN THE DIRECTION OF NEGOTIATIONS FOR AN AGREEMENT WITH THE JEWS WHICH WOULD OBVIATE IT:

WARSAW, JULY 28. (JTA) -- FOR BOYDING THE PLANT OF THE POLISH-LANGUAGE JEWISH NEWS-PAPER NASZ PRZEGLAD, A WARSAW UNIVERSITY MEDICAL STUDENT, TADEUSZ BIERNACKI, WAS SENTENCED TODAY TO A YEAR IN PRISON. HE WAS RELEASED IN 500 ZLOTYS BAIL (ABOUT \$100) PENDING APPEAL.

BIERNACKI WAS CAUGHT RUNNING FROM THE NEWSPAPER BUILDING ON THE NIGHT OF APRIL 30 WITH A REVOLVER IN HIS POSSESSION, AFTER THREE BOMBS HAD BEEN THROWN ON THE PREMISES.

WOMEN ZIONISTS OF 42 COUNTRIES HOLD NINTH WORLD CONGRESS IN ZURICH

ZURICH, SWITZERLAND, JULY 28. (JTA) -- THE NINTH CONFERENCE OF THE WOMEN'S INTER-NATIONAL ZIONIST ORGANIZATION, WITH DELEGATES FROM 42 COUNTRIES REPRESENTING 85,000 MEMBERS ATTENDING, OPENED TONIGHT IN THE KURSAAL.

VERA WEIZMANN, IN AN ADDRESS, REPORTED AN INCREASE OF 5,000 IN MEMBERSHIP. SHE DISCUSSED THE WORK OF THE WIZO IN CHILD CARE AND ITS HACHSHARAH (PIONEERS' TRAINING FARM) FOR GIRLS.

DELEGATES FROM 16 LANDS TO ATTEND ANTWERP PARLEY OF POLISH JEWS

ANTWERP, JULY 28. (JTA) -- SIXTEEN COUNTRIES WILL BE REPRESENTED AT A CONFERENCE OF THE WORLD UNION OF POLISH JEWS ABROAD, TO BE HELD HERE BEGINNING AUGUST 22, TO DISCUSS THE LEGAL, POLITICAL AND ECONOMIC POSITION OF POLISH JEWRY.

IDEA OF JEWISH NATION HIT BY SCHULMAN; TRUST IN BRITAIN URGED

NEW YORK, JULY 28. (JTA) -- PALESTINE IS RECEIVING TOO MUCH ATTENTION AS A MEANS OF SOLVING "THE SO-CALLED JEWISH PROBLEM," DR. SAMUEL SCHULMAN, RABBI EMERITUS OF TEMPLE EMANU-EL, DECLARED IN A LETTER PUBLISHED IN THE NEW YORK TIMES YESTERDAY.

COMMENTING ON THE REPORT OF THE BRITISH ROYAL COMMISSION RECOMMENDING PARTITION OF THE HOLY LAND, DR. SCHULMAN, LONG AN OPPONENT OF POLITICAL ZIONISM, ATTACKED THE ENTIRE ZIONIST IDEA OF THE JEWS AS AN INDEPENDENT NATION.

"EVERY JEW SHOULD REALIZE THAT ALTOGETHER TOO MUCH THOUGHT HAS BEEN CENTERED UPON PALESTINE AS A SO-DALLED SOLUTION OF THE JEWISH PROBLEM," DR. SCHULMAN WROTE. "THE PROBLEM OF THE 2,000,000 JEWS IN POLAND AND OF OTHERS PERSECUTED IN OTHER LANDS; THE PROBLEM OF THE JEWS IN GERMANY, CANNOT BE SOLVED BY WHATEVER WILL BE DONE IN PALESTINE.

"WE MUST FACE REALITIES AND WE MUST INSIST UPON THE FACT THAT THE SIN OF WESTERN CIV-ILIZATION WHICH IT CARRIES ON ITS CONSCIENCE IS THE INJUSTICE TO THE JEW. THE JEWISH PROB-LEM MUST BE SOLVED IN THE LANDS IN WHICH THE MASSES OF JEWS LIVE, AND IT CAN ONLY BE SOLVED BY THE RECOGNITION OF CHRISTENDOM'S RESPONSIBILITY FOR THE EQUALITY OF HUMAN RIGHTS TO WHICH THE JEW IS ENTITLED."

TO THE CONCEPTION OF A JEWISH NATION, DR. SCHULMAN OPPOSED HIS VIEW OF ISRAEL AS A PURELY RELIGIOUS COMMUNITY, WITH JEWS SCATTERED THROUGHOUT THE WORLD OWING POLITICAL ALLEGANCE EACH TO THE COUNTRY WHERE HE LIVES. THIS IS THE TRUE PICTURE OF THE JEWISH PEOPLE, AND AT THE SAME TIME THE WISEST FROM THE STANDPOINT OF STATESMANSHIP, DR. SCHULMAN HELD.

"NATIONALISM," HE WROTE, "IS ABOUT THE WORST CONCEPTION WITH WHICH ISRAEL CAN BE CALLE UPON TO OPERATE... NATIONALISM BRISTLES WITH RACIAL ANIMOSITIES."

CITING NAZI GERMANY AS AN EXAMPLE OF EXTREME NATIONALISM, HE DECLARED "IF SUCH NATIONALISM IS BAD IN GERMANY IT IS BAD IN PALESTINE."

HE TOOK ISSUE WITH THE VIEW EXPRESSED IN THE TIMES EDITORIAL ON THE ROYAL COMMISSION RECOMMENDATIONS, THAT THE QUESTION OF THE WISDOM OF ZIONISM LOSES SIGNIFICANCE IN THE FACE OF THE FACT THAT 400,000 JEWS ARE NOW LIVING IN PALESTINE.

"After all," said Dr. Schulman, "from the point of view of Israel, 400,000 individuals are a comparatively small number when Israel -- far flung all over the world -- is made up of sixteen and one-half million."

DR. SCHULMAN TOOK ISSUE WITH DR. JUDAH L. MAGNES, PRESIDENT OF HEBREW UNIVERSITY IN JERUSALEM, ON HIS STATEMENT IN A LETTER TO THE TIMES THAT "ALL FAILED -- JEW, ARAB AND THE ENGLISH." JEWS AND ARABS MAY HAVE FAILED, HE SAID, BUT NOT THE ENGLISH, VOICING A BELIEF THAT "TAKING IT ALL IN ALL, THE JEW CAN STILL TRUST BRITISH STATESMANSHIP."

LOUIS BLAUSTEIN, OIL MAGNATE, PHILANTHROPIST, DEAD AT 68

ATLANTIC CITY, N.J., JULY 28. (JTA) -- LOUIS BLAUSTEIN OF BALTIMORE, PROMINENT IN THE PETROLEUM INDUSTRY, DIED HERE YESTERDAY AT THE AGE OF 68, OF CEREBRAL HEMORRHAGE. MRS. BLAUSTEIN, THEIR SON JACOB, AND THEIR DAUGHTERS, MRS. ALVIN THALHEIMER AND MRS. HENRY A. ROSENBERG, WERE WITH HIM AT THE END.

MR. BLAUSTEIN CAME TO NEW YORK AS AN IMMIGRANT IN 1883, AND ENTERED THE OIL BUSINESS ALMOST IMMEDIATELY -- PEDDLING KEROSENE IN CAMS FROM A HORSE-DRAWN BUGGY. LATER HE WENT TO WORK FOR THE STANDARD OIL COMPANY IN BALTIMORE, WORKING HIS WAY UP THROUGH EXECUTIVE POSITIONS UNTIL HE ACCUMULATED A SMALL CAPITAL AND STARTED HIS OWN AMERICAN OIL COMPANY IN 1910.

THE BUSINESS GREW UNTIL ITS FILLING STATIONS WERE TO BE SEEN ALONG EVERY ROADSIDE FROM MAINE TO FLORIDA. IT OWNED VAST REFINERIES, STEAMSHIP TERMINALS AND FLEETS OF TANK TRUCKS. IN 1924 THE PAN-AMERICAN PETROLEUM AND TRANSPORT COMPANY BOUGHT A HALF INTEREST IN THE BLAUSTEIN FIRM FOR \$5,000,000.

IN THE LAST TWENTY-FIVE YEARS MR. BLAUSTEIN HAD CONTRIBUTED LARGELY TO CHARITY, MOST

MR. BLAUSTEIN MARRIED MISS HENRIETTA GITTLESON, OF AN OLD BALTIMORE FAMILY, IN 1890. HIS SON, JACOB BLAUSTEIN, WHO WAS WITH HIS FATHER IN THE OIL BUSINESS FOR TWENTY-FIVE YEARS IS A MEMBER OF THE BOARD OF DIRECTORS OF THE JEWISH TELEGRAPHIC AGENCY.

GRZESINSKI, FORMER HIGH PRUSSIAN OFFICIAL, ARRIVES HERE

NEW YORK, JULY 28. (JTA) -- ALBERT GRZESINSKI, FORMER BERLIN POLICE PRESIDENT AND PRUSSIAN INTERIOR MINISTER, WHO HAS BEEN LIVING IN PARIS SINCE ADVENT OF THE HITLER REGIME, ARRIVED YESTERDAY ON THE ILE DE FRANCE FOR AN EXTENDED STAY. HE BROUGHT WITH HIM A VOLUME OF CLIPPINGS FROM THE GERMAN PRESS IN SUPPORT OF HIS CONTENTION THAT A WIDE-SPREAD ANTI-AMERICAN CAMPAIGN IS BEING CONDUCTED BY NAZI NEWSPAPERS WITH THE AIM OF DISCREDITING AMERICAN LIVING STANDARDS.
