SCORES FLEE AS DISORDERS SPREAD IN BIALYSTOK PROVINCE OF POLAND

WARSAW, Aug. 26. (JTA) -- Scores of Jews were reported fleeing to Warsaw today as anti-Semitic disorders spread through the Bialystok province accompanied by a severe boycott campaign. Disorders were reported in the towns of Ostrow-Mazowięcki, Briansk, Malkinie, Uniado, Brobszczyk and Czechanowiec.

THE EXCESSES WERE SET OFF BY DEMONSTRATIONS ON AUG. 15 ON THE ANNIVERSARY OF THE VICTORY OF THE POLISH ARMY OVER THE INVADING SOVIET FORCES IN 1920. AFTER A SERIES OF MINOR DISORDERS IN PROVINCIAL TOWNS MORE SERIOUS RIOTS BROKE OUT IN SEVERAL TOWNS. SERIOUS DISTURBANCES OCCURRED IN OSTROW-MAZOWIECKI ON AUG. 16, FOLLOWED BY CONTINUOUS RIOTING IN CERTAIN DISTRICTS.

FIFTY JEWS WERE INJURED IN DISORDERS IN BRIANSK ON MONDAY, ACCORDING TO DEPUTIES EMIL SOMMERSTEIN AND ISAAC RUBENSTEIN, WHO RETURNED FROM THERE TODAY. THE ANTISEMITIC CAMMAIGN THERE IS CONDUCTED BY ENDERS, MOSTLY FROM OTHER DISTRICTS, AND HAS FAILED TO GAIN THE SYMPATHY OF THE LOCAL POPULATION, THE DEPUTIES SAID. THEY REPORTED THE JEWISH INHABITANTS IN A STATE BORDERING ON PANIC. THE DEPUTIES INTERVENED WITH THE LOCAL AUTHORITIES DEMANDING THAT ACTION BE TAKEN TO HALT THE TERRORISM AND DECLARING THAT PICKETS WERE NOT ONLY TERRORIZING JEWISH SHOPKEEPERS, BUT ALSO NON-JEWS WHO DEALT WITH JEWS.

REPORTS FROM OTHER TOWNS SAID TEN JEWS WERE BEATEN AND WINDOWS OF JEWS! HOMES BROKEN IN MALKINIE, TWO MARKET-TRADERS ATTACKED IN UNIADO AND THEIR GOODS DESTROYED. IN BROBSZCZYK, AFTER A YOUNG ENDEK HAD BEEN ARRESTED BY POLICE A CROWD ATTACKED JEWS AND THE POLICE WERE FORCED TO CALL REINFORCEMENTS FROM A NEIGHBORING TOWN TO RESTORE ORDER. A JEWISH CART-DRIVER NAMED LEIB KOZE WAS ATTACKED AND SERIOUSLY INJURED IN CZECHANOWIEC.

MEANWHILE, IN CZESTOCHOWA A COURT SENTENCED TWO NATIONAL DEMOCRATS TO SIX MONTHS' IMPRISONMENT FOR BREAKING WINDOWS OF JEWS' HOMES LAST JUNE. TWO OTHERS WERE ACQUITTED.

PARIS JEWISH COMMITTEE SEEKS PARLEY WITH ARABS ON PARTITION

LONDON, Aug. 26. (JTA) -- ARAB PUBLIC OPINION MIGHT BE TURNED IN FAVOR OF ESTABLISHMENT OF A JEWISH STATE IN PALESTINE UNDER CERTAIN CONDITIONS, ACCORDING TO A DISPATCH TO THE TIMES OF LONDON FROM PARIS REPORTING EFFORTS TO CONVENE A JEWISH-ARAB ROUND-TABLE.

WHILE PARTITION OF THE HOLY LAND AS RECOMMENDED BY THE BRITISH ROYAL COMM'SSION IS NOT ACCEPTABLE TO THE ARABS, THE TIMES DISPATCH SAID, IT MIGHT BECOME MUSH MORE PALATABLE IF THE PROPOSED JEWISH STATE ENTERED A FEDERAL UNION WITH THE ARAB STATE.

THE STATEMENT BY DR. CHAIM WEIZMANN, PRESIDENT OF THE WORLD ZIONIST ORGANIZATION, INTERPRETED AS FAVORING AN ARAB FEDERATION PRODUCED A FAVORABLE IMPRESSION IN ARAB CIRCLES, THE TIMES SAID.

THE MOVE FOR A ROUND-TABLE, THE TIMES SAID, IS BEING FOSTERED BY THE COMMITTEE
FOR THE DEFENSE OF THE RIGHTS OF ISRAELITES OF CENTRAL AND EASTERN EUROPE, WHICH IS
SEEKING TO BRING TOGETHER QUALIFIED REPRESENTATIVES OF THE PALESTINE ARABS AND JEWS.

THE COMMITTEE BELIEVES, THE TIMES REPORTED, THAT ARAB CIRCLES WILL AGREE TO SUCH A MEETING ON CONDITION THAT THE JEWISH DELEGATES ARE INVITED PERSONALLY AND NOT AS REPRESENTATIVES OF THE JEWISH AGENCY. THIS RESERVATION IS MADE BECAUSE THE ARABS HAVE NEVER RECOGNIZED THE BALFOUR DECLARATION AND THE MANDATE UNDER WHICH THE AGENCY WAS ESTABLISHED.

MUFTI NOT TO ATTEND PAN-ARAB CONGRESS

JERUSALEM, Aug. 26. (JTA) -- THE PAN-ARAB CONGRESS WHICH HAS BEEN SCHEDULED FOR SEPT. 8 AT BLUDAN, NEAR DAMASCUS, AFTER SEVERAL ABORTIVE ATTEMPTS TO CONVENE SUCH A GATHERING, WILL MEET UNDER CIRCUMSTANCES LIMITING ITS SIGNIFICANCE, IT APPEARED TO-DAY.

GOVERNMENTS OF ARAB COUNTRIES ARE NOT PARTICIPATING AS HAD BEEN HOPED. THE GRAND MUETI OF PALESTINE, HAJ ANIN EL HUSSEINI, WHO HAD BEEN ACTIVE IN PROMOTING A CONGRESS IS NOT LEAVING JERUSALEM. THE ARAB SUPREME COMMITTEE DESIGNATED IZZAT DARMAZA, JAMAL HUSSEINI, HILMI PASHA AND YACOUB HUSSEINI AS ITS REPRESENTATIVES. THE SHEIK

PRINCE TALLAL, HEIR-APPARENT OF EMIR ABBULLAH OF TRANSJORDAN, IS LEAVING FOR BAGHDAD SATURDAY ON A MISSION TO IMPROVE TENSE RELATIONS BETWEEN TRANSJORDAN AND TRAY.

IMAM YAHYA OF YEMAN TODAY TELEGRAPHED TO THE MUFT! A PROTEST AGAINS THE PROPOSED PARTITIONING OF PALESTINE AND OFFERED TO INTERCEDE WITH THE BRITISH GOVERNMENT AGAINST THE PLAN, THE HAVAS NEWS AGENCY REPORTED.

THE MUNKHTAR (VILLAGE CHIEF) OF BIRZEIT WAS SHOT AND KILLED YESTERDAY IN WHAT WAS BELIEVED TO BE AN ATTACK WITH POLITICAL MOTIVES. HE WAS ALSO THE LEADER OF THE NATIVE ANGLICAN CHURCH.

GEN. WAVELL ARRIVES IN PALESTINE TO COMMAND BRITISH FORCES

JERUSALEM, Aug. 26. (JTA) -- MAJOR-GENERAL ARCHIBALD P. WAVELL ARRIVED HERE TO DAY TO ASSUME COMMAND OF THE BRITISH FORCES IN PALESTINE AND TRANSJORDAN, SUCCEEDING LIEUTENANT-GENERAL JOHN G. DILL.

HIGH COMMISSIONER WAUCHOPE WILL LEAVE FOR A TWO-MONTH VACATION IN GREAT BRITAIN, IT WAS OFFICIALLY ANNOUNCED TONIGHT, ACCORDING TO THE HAVAS NEWS AGENCY.

U.S. DIPLOMAT TO ATTEND NAZI CONGRESS FOR FIRST TIME

BERLIN, AUG. 26. (JTA) -- CHARGE O'AFFAIRES PRENTISS B. GILBERT OF THE UNITED STATES EMBASSY WILL BE AMONG FOREIGN DIPLOMATS WHO WILL SET PRECEDENTS BY ATTENDING THE MAZI PARTY'S FORTHCOMING NUREMBERG CONGRESS, IT-WAS LEARNED TODAY. WHILE MOST OF THE FOREIGN ENVOYS WILL BE REPRESENTED, IT WAS UNDERSTOOD THE SOVIET EMBASSY WOULD WITHHOLD ITS PARTICIPATION.

BOYCOTT GROUP PROTESTS TO HULL

AMEN YORK, Aug. 26. (JTA) -- A PROTEST AGAINST ACCEPTANCE OF AN INVITATION TO ATTEND THE NAZI PARTY CONGRESS NEXT MONTH AT NUREWEERG GERMANS BY PRENTISS GILBERT, AMERICAN CHARGE O'AFFAIRES IN BERLIN, WAS BENT TO SECRETARY OF STATE CORDELL HULL TO-DAY BY THE JOINT BOYCOTT COUNCIL OF THE AMERICAN JEWISH CONGRESS AND JEWISH LABOR COMMITTEE.

STUERMER DEMANDS LIFE IMPRISONMENT FOR "RACE DEFILEMENT"

NUREMBERG, GERMANY, Aug. 26. (JTA) -- LIFE IMPRISONMENT FOR JEWS WHO "SOIL THE RACE" WAS DEMANDED BY DER STUERMER, ORGAN OF JULIUS STREICHER, THE HAVAS NEWS AGENCY REPORTED TODAY.

THE NEWSPAPER CALLED ON THE THIRD REICH'S LEGISLATORS TO TAKE SWIFTEST POSSIBLE MEASURES TOWARD THIS END, COMPLAINING THAT THE NUREMBERG LAWS HAD PROVED INADEQUATE TO WIPE OUT "RACE SOILING."

"SO LONG AS A JEW REMAINS AMONG US, THE JEWS WILL CONTINUE, TO BE RACE SOILERS,"
DER STUERMER SAID. "THE JEW IS A DEMON. TOWARD A DEMON IT IS IMPOSSIBLE TO BE TOO
SEVERE. THE ONLY WAY IS TO KEEP HIM IN PRISON ALL HIS LIFE.

THE NEWSPAPER ALSO ASKED THE GOVERNMENT TO CASHIER JUDGES WHO, BY SHOWING THEM-SELVES "TOO INDUIGENT TOWARD JEW RACE SOILERS," PROVE "THEY DO NOT YET UNDERSTAND THE JEW QUESTION," AND THEREFORE "WILL NEVER BE ABLE TO BECOME NATIONAL SOCIALISTS."

22 JEWISH CAFES CLOSED IN GERMAN SILESIA

GLEIWITZ, GERMANY, AUG. 26. (JTA) -- TWENTY-TWO JEWISH-OWNED CAFES WERE CLOSED IN THE SURROUNDING INDUSTRIAL REGION TODAY BY ORDER OF THE GLEIWITZ POLICE PREFECT, ALLEGEDLY FOR VIOLATING SANITARY AND POLICE RESTRICTIONS, THE HAVAS NEWS AGENCY REPORTED A NUMBER OF OTHER JEWISH-OWNED CAFES WERE CLOSED AT OPPELN, RATIBOR AND PEISKRETSCHAM.

JEWISH COMMUNIST LEADERS OUSTED IN KALININDORF REGION

ODESSA, U.S.S.R., Aug. 26. (JTA) -- Two Jewish Communist Leaders named Rabitchev and Avram have been excluded from the Communist Party in the Kalinindorf Jewish autonomous region. The district committee of the party accused them of misdirection of the region's national policy by excluding Ukrainians from Jewish collective farms and recommending for admission to the party an "enemy of the people conducting Trotskyist activities."

WITHDRAWS AS FASCIST CANDIDATE CALLING MOSLEY GROUP ANTI-SEMITIC

LONDON, Aug. 26. (JTA) -- C. PERTWEE, PROSPECTIVE CANDIDATE FOR PARLIAMENT OF THE BRITISH UNION OF FASCISTS IN SWAMSEE WEST, WITHDREW HIS CANDIDACY TODAY BECAUSE, HE SAID, ANTI-SEMITISM HAD BECOME THE FASCISTS' OFFICIAL POLICY.

OSE TO REVIEW FIGHT FOR JEWISH HEALTH AT PARIS CONGRESS

PARIS (JTA) --- THE WORLD OSE UNION, FACED WITH "THREATENING SYMPTOMS OF DECLINE OF THE PHYSICAL CONDITION OF THE BULK OF THE JEWISH POPULATION IN EASTERN EUROPE," WILL REVIEW ITS 25-YEAR STRUGGLE FOR JEWISH HEALTH AT A SPECIAL CONFERENCE WHICH WILL OPEN HERE AUG. 28.

THE UNION, OF WHICH PROF. ALBERT EINSTEIN IS HONORARY PRESIDENT, PLAYS A LEADING PART IN HEALTH WELFARE WORK AMONG THE JEWS OF EASTERN EUROPE, MAINTAINING CLINICS AND OTHER INSTITUTIONS, PROVIDING FOOD RELIEF AND PLANNING HEALTH EDUCATION. ITS CHIEF AFFILIATE IS THE TOZ IN POLANO.

"Further Physical Deterioration and reduced resistance against disease" among Jews in Eastern Europe as a result of unemployment, privation and chronic undernourishment are recorded in the union's annual report for 1936.

WITH "THE POOR CLASSES OF THE JEWISH POPULATION LIVING AS THEY DO IN NON-SANITARY SLUMS," THE UNION REPORTED OUTS UNERTS OF EPIDEMICS IN VARIOUS LOCALITIES, FOR EXAMPLE SPOTTED FEVER IN POLAND AND BESSARABIA.

"ALL INSTITUTIONS OF THE OSE AND TOZ REPORT A CONSIDERABLY INCREASED NUMBER OF ATTENDANCES," THE REPORT SAYS. "ABOUT 70,000 PATIENTS HAVE BEEN REGISTERED IN THE CLINICS, DISPENSARIES AND CHILD WELFARE CENTERS AS COMPARED WITH 57,000 IN 1935. THE NUMBER OF ATTENDANCES AMOUNTED TO 295,000 AS AGAINST 240,000 IN 1937."

REPORTS RECEIVED BY THE UNION FROM DIFFERENT LOCALITIES IN POLAND AND RUMANIA "NOT ONLY TESTIFY TO THE INCREASE OF ILLNESS AND GROWING DETERIORATION OF THE PHYSIQUE OF THE CHILDREN, BUT SIGNALIZE THE IMMINENT DANGER FOR THEIR LIVES INHERENT IN THEIR CHRONIC UNDERNOURISHMENT, WHICH IS SOMETIMES TANTAMOUNT TO COMPLETE BTARVATION," THE OSE DECLARES.

DESPITE ATTEMPTS OF CHILDREN TO FIGHT THE EFFECTS OF FILTH, AN "ABRUPT DECLINE IN THE PERSONAL HYGIENE OF THE CHILDREN" WAS INDICATED IN REPORTS PROM SCHOOL PHYSICIANS. ONE SAID:

"IN DAMP, COLD DWELLINGS, 5 TO 6 PEOPLE LIVING IN A SMALL ROOM WHICH SERVES ALSO AS A KITCHEN, THE CHILDREN STAY FOR WEEKS WITHOUT TAKING OFF THEIR CLOTHES. THEY SLEEP, SEVERAL PEOPLE CLUSTERED TOGETHER, ON THE HARD SLEEPING STOVE. IT IS A GREAT MIRACLE, IN THESE CONDITIONS, THAT INFECTIOUS DISEASES ARE NOT WIDESPREAD."

IN MANY SCHOOLS THE OSE AND TOZ PROVIDED MODESTMEALS FOR CHILDREN, THIS RELIEF BEING EXTENDED TO 43,500 CHILDREN QURING 1936. IN ADDITION, 17, 045 CHILDREN SPENT THE SUMMER MONTHS IN COLONIES AND SEMI-COLONIES OF THE HEALTH ORGANIZATIONS.
