

JEWS DESPERATE AS RIOT WAVE SWEEPS POLAND; MANY FLEE VILLAGES

PARIS, SEPT. 2. (JTA) -- THE WAVE OF ANTI-JEWISH EXCESSES IN POLAND, WHICH IS REACHING UNPRECEDENTED DIMENSIONS, IS BEING GUIDED BY SOME CENTRAL AGENCY, IT WAS INDICATED TODAY BY A SURVEY RECEIVED BY JEWISH ORGANIZATIONS HERE.

ANTI-SEMITIC DISORDERS WERE RENEWED IN POLAND ON AUG. 15, WITH NATIONWIDE DEMONSTRATIONS BY ENDEKS. THE SURVEY REVEALS THAT EXCESSES OCCURRED IN 28 CITIES, TOWNS AND VILLAGES IN ALL PARTS OF THE COUNTRY. THE WIDESPREAD CHARACTER OF THE DISORDERS AND THE SIMILARITY OF THE METHODS EMPLOYED IN DIFFERENT PLACES LEND SUBSTANTIATION TO THE BELIEF THAT THEY WERE DIRECTED BY SOME CENTRAL GUIDING HAND.

ALTHOUGH THE SURVEY AUTHENTICATES REPORTS OF DISORDERS FROM 28 LOCALITIES THERE IS NO QUESTION THAT THESE REPRESENT ONLY A FRACTION OF THE TOTAL NUMBER OF INCIDENTS OF VIOLENCE AGAINST JEWS IN THE PAST FORTNIGHT. DELEGATIONS ARE ARRIVING IN WARSAW DAILY FROM OUTLYING PROVINCES, VILLAGES AND HAMLETS TO COMPLAIN ABOUT ANTI-JEWISH DISTURBANCES AND IMPORE PROTECTION, EVIDENCE THAT A FAR-REACHING POGROM MOVEMENT IS UNDER WAY.

ACCORDING TO INFORMATION FROM SEVERAL PROVINCIAL TOWNS THE JEWS ARE DESERTING NEARBY VILLAGES IN A BODY OWING TO LOSS OF THEIR PROPERTY BY FIRE AND OTHER MEANS OF DESTRUCTION AND LOOTING, AND THE CONSTANT DANGER TO LIFE AND LIMB.

FACED WITH THE APPARENT INERTIA OF THE POLISH GOVERNMENT AGAINST TAKING STEPS TO PROTECT LIFE AND PROPERTY, POLISH JEWS ARE REPORTED TO HAVE REACHED A NEW LOW OF DISTRESS AND DISCOURAGEMENT, AND TO BE LIVING IN ANTICIPATION OF EVEN WORSE DEVELOPMENTS.

60 INJURED IN BYDOGOSZCZ

WARSAW, SEPT. 2. (JTA) -- ANTI-SEMITIC TERROR STILL GRIPPED THE CITY OF BYDOGOSZCZ, FORMERLY BROMBERG, POMERANIA, TODAY; AFTER AN OUTBREAK WHICH LATE REPORTS INDICATED HAD REACHED POGROM PROPORTIONS.

MORE THAN SIXTY JEWS WERE BEING TREATED FOR INJURIES, WITH SEVERAL IN SERIOUS CONDITION, ACCORDING TO THE REPORT OF AN INVESTIGATOR WHO RETURNED HERE AFTER VISITING BYDOGOSZCZ TO SURVEY THE CONDITION OF THE JEWISH POPULATION FOLLOWING THE RIOTS.

WITH BANDS OF ANTI-SEMITES CONTINUING TO ROVE THE STREETS, JEWS DID NOT VENTURE TO LEAVE THEIR HOUSES. AS A RESULT THEIR BUSINESS WAS AT A STANDSTILL. JEWISH SHOPS HAD BEEN LOOTED BY THE RAIDERS.

NIGHTLY RAIDS IN POZNAN

POZNAN, SEPT. 2. (JTA) -- ARAID BY ANTI-SEMITES ARMED WITH KNIVES ON THE JEWISH SECTION OF THIS CITY LEFT A LONG LIST OF INJURED TODAY. TWO OF THE VICTIMS WERE THIRTEEN AND FIFTEEN YEARS OLD.

THE ATTACK WAS ONE OF A SERIES OF NIGHTLY INVASIONS WHICH HAS REDUCED POZNAN'S JEWISH COMMUNITY OF 500 FAMILIES TO DESPERATION. EVERY EVENING THE ANTI-SEMITES ROAM THE STREETS BEATING JEWISH PASSERS-BY, WHILE ENDEKS DAUB THE WORD "JEW" ON JEWISH SHOPS WITH IRREMOVABLE PAINT.

THE JUVENILE VICTIMS OF THE KNIFE GANG WERE A 13-YEAR-OLD CHILD NAMED DUNKELMAN AND A 15-YEAR-OLD NAMED RAPOPORT. A 45-YEAR-OLD TAILOR FROM THE CITY OF LODZ, NAMED PASTERNAK, WAS ALSO AMONG THE INJURED.

U.S. RABBIS SET DAY OF PROTEST

NEW YORK, SEPT. 2. (JTA) -- THE AGUDATH HARABONIM, RABBINICAL ASSOCIATION, AT A CONFERENCE HERE, APPEALED TO THE JEWS OF THE UNITED STATES AND CANADA TO OBSERVE ZOM GEDALIAH SEPT. 9 AS A FAST DAY IN PROTEST AGAINST PERSECUTION OF JEWS IN EASTERN EUROPE, PARTICULARLY IN POLAND.

APPROXIMATELY \$50,000 IS EXPECTED TO BE RAISED IN BEHALF OF THE POLISH JEWS THROUGH AN AGREEMENT REACHED BETWEEN NEW YORK GARMENT UNIONS AND EMPLOYERS' ASSOCIATIONS WHEREBY JEWISH WORKERS WILL WORK A HALF DAY ON SATURDAY, SEPT. 11, TO MAKE UP FOR THE ROSH HASHONAH HOLIDAY. THEY WILL BE PAID AT THE RATE OF TIME AND A HALF. THE EXTRA HALF-TIME WILL BE GIVEN TO THE JEWISH LABOR COMMITTEE TO AID THE POLISH JEWS.

BRITAIN REPORTED READY TO DECLARE MARTIAL LAW IN PALESTINE

LONDON, SEPT. 2. (JTA) -- REUTERS (BRITISH) NEWS AGENCY REPORTS FROM JERUSALEM THAT MARTIAL LAW WILL BE PROCLAIMED IN PALESTINE IF SERIOUS DISORDERS OCCUR AND THE MARTIAL LAW PROCLAMATIONS HAVE ALREADY BEEN PRINTED.

ARABS, JEWS URGED TO USE RESTRAINT

JERUSALEM, SEPT. 2. (JTA) -- AN APPEAL TO THE JEWISH POPULATION NOT TO ANSWER PROVOCATION AND NOT TO ATTACK INNOCENT PERSONS, BUT PEACEFULLY TO CONTINUE DAILY WORK, WAS ISSUED TODAY BY THE JEWISH NATIONAL COUNCIL, WHICH REMINDED THE JEWS OF THEIR "HEROIC SELF-RESTRAINT" DURING LAST YEAR'S RIOTS.

THE ARAB HIGH COMMITTEE ISSUED A STATEMENT, THE CORRESPONDENT OF THE TIMES OF LONDON REPORTED, DEPLORING THE SLAYINGS OF ARABS AS APPARENTLY REPRISALS FOR OUTRAGES WHOSE AUTHORS WERE UNKNOWN.

THE STATEMENT APPEALED TO THE ARABS FOR SELF-RESTRAINT AND RELIANCE ON THE EFFORTS OF FOREIGN ARAB RULERS IN THEIR BEHALF; ADDING THAT THE ARABS HAD GREAT HOPES FOR INTERVENTION BY NEIGHBORING ARAB STATES AND TURKEY WITH THE LEAGUE OF NATIONS. THEREFORE, THE ARABS SHOULD NOT BE LED BY EXTREMISTS INTO VIOLENCE, THE STATEMENT CONCLUDED, EXPRESSING THE HOPE THE DISORDERS WOULD QUICKLY SUBSIDE.

ARABS REPORTED BUYING ARMS IN SYRIA

NEW YORK, SEPT. 2. (JTA) -- WHILE THE ARAB SUPREME COMMITTEE IN JERUSALEM HAS APPEALED TO PALESTINE ARABS TO REFRAIN FROM VIOLENCE, ITS REPRESENTATIVES IN DAMASCUS HAVE BEEN BUYING ARMS TO BE SMUGGLED INTO PALESTINE AND ORGANIZING MERCENARIES TO CROSS THE BORDER WHEN REBELLION BREAKS OUT, ACCORDING TO A DISPATCH FROM JOSEPH M. LEVY TO THE NEW YORK TIMES FROM JERUSALEM TODAY.

PREMIER JAMIL BEY MARDAM OF SYRIA ADMITTED, THE TIMES SAID, THAT HE WAS AWARE OF THE ARMS SMUGGLING, BUT DECLARED IT WAS ALMOST IMPOSSIBLE TO STOP IT.

THE DISPATCH ALSO REPORTED THAT "AN IMPORTANT MEDITERRANEAN POWER" WHICH HAS BEEN SEEKING ARAB FRIENDSHIP, HAS TRANSFERRED ITS ACTIVITIES WITH REGARD TO PALESTINE FROM JERUSALEM TO DAMASCUS AND IS SPENDING LARGE AMOUNTS IN THE SYRIAN CITY.

GERMAN CONSUL IN SHANGHAI AIDS JEWISH REFUGEES

SHANGHAI, SEPT. 2. (JTA) -- THE CONSULATE OF NAZI GERMANY IS AIDING JEWISH REFUGEES FROM THE REICH AND PAYING THEIR EVACUATION EXPENSES FROM WAR-STRICKEN SHANGHAI, IT WAS DISCLOSED TODAY.

RABBI JACOB M. ALKOW, OF SOUTHERN CALIFORNIA, REPRESENTATIVE OF SEVERAL JEWISH ORGANIZATIONS ON BEHALF OF JEWISH REFUGEES AND PROFESSIONALS IN CHINA, LAUDED THE GERMAN CONSUL'S "HUMANITARIAN ACTIVITIES" IN AN ADDRESS TO A ROTARY CLUB MEETING.

A RABBI WILDMAN AND SEVEN OTHER REFUGEES HAVE BEEN SENT TO MANILA AND ONE POLISH-BORN JEW TO EUROPE THROUGH THE ASSISTANCE OF THE REICH CONSUL, RABBI ALKOW SAID.

REICHSVERTRETUNG NEW YEAR MESSAGE URGES COURAGE IN FACE OF ADVERSITY

BERLIN, SEPT. 2. (JTA) -- A CALL TO THE JEWS OF GERMANY TO SHOW COURAGE IN THE FACE OF THEIR PRESENT ADVERSITY WAS CONTAINED IN THE ROSH HASHONAH MESSAGE ISSUED TODAY BY THE REICHSVERTRETUNG, CENTRAL ORGANIZATION OF GERMAN JEWRY.

URGING ITS PEOPLE TO TAKE A LONG VIEW AND NOT DESPAIR, THE JEWISH ORGANIZATION DECLARED:

"WE LIVE IN TIMES OF RUSH AND CHANGE. EVERY YEAR APPEARS TO US TO BE A SEPARATE CHAPTER IN OUR HISTORY. WHAT WILL BEFALL US IS IN THE HANDS OF THE ALMIGHTY, BUT OUR BEHAVIOR, WHATEVER IS IN STORE FOR US, DEPENDS UPON OURSELVES. MAN MUST SHOW HIS WORTH IN HIS EVERY TRIAL AND MUST STRIVE TO MAKE GOD'S WILL A REALITY. OUR WISH TO ALL AND SUNDRY IS SUMMED UP IN THE VERSE OF THE PSALM WITH WHICH THE JEWS USHER IN THEIR NEW YEAR:

"WAIT ON THE LORD AND BE OF GOOD COURAGE AND HE SHALL STRENGTHEN THINE HEART." "WAIT, I SAY, ON THE LORD."

"HALF-BREED JEWS" BARRED FROM GERMAN JURISTS' LEAGUE

BERLIN, SEPT. 2. (JTA) -- RUDOLF HESS, CHANCELLOR HITLER'S DEPUTY IN THE NAZI PARTY, TODAY ISSUED AN ORDER BANNING ALL "JEWISH HALF-BREEDS" FROM MEMBERSHIP IN THE LEAGUE OF GERMAN JURISTS, THE HAVAS NEWS AGENCY REPORTED. A STATEMENT ISSUED BY HESS POINTED OUT THAT HITHERTO THIS "NATIONAL SOCIALIST LEAGUE OF LAW GUARDIANS" WAS NOT AUTHORIZED TO MAINTAIN ITS RACIAL REQUIREMENTS ON THE SAME LEVEL AS THE HITLER YOUTH AND OTHER NAZI PARTY ORGANIZATIONS.

JERUSALEM, SEPT. 2. (JTA) -- FIFTEEN JEWISH YOUTHS WERE EXILED TO ACRE FOR ONE YEAR BY ADMINISTRATIVE ORDER TODAY, UNDER THE CRIME PREVENTION ORDINANCE, REPORTEDLY IN CONNECTION WITH THE MURDER OF TWO ARABS IN THE VICINITY OF JERUSALEM EARLIER THIS WEEK.
