### DISORDERS CONTINUE IN POLAND; TRADERS THREATENED WITH DEATH FOR PROTESTING BOYCOTT

WARSAW, SEPT. 12. (JTA) -- A NUMBER OF JEWS WERE INJURED TODAY IN A RECURRENCE OF DISORDERS IN BYDGOSEJCZ, FORMERLY BROMBERG, POMERANIA. SEVERAL POLES EVIDENTLY MISTAKEN FOR JEWS WERE BEATEN AS TERRORIST BANDS ATTACKED PEDESTRIANS. ONE OF THE JEWS INJURED IS A MANUFACTURER EMPLOYING 100 WORKERS WHO DISMISSED HIS STAFF AND SAID HE WOULD NOT OPEN HIS FACTORY BEFORE CONDITIONS IMPROVED. THE WORKERS SENT A DELEGATION TO THE GOVERNOR AND ALSO WROTE TO PREMIER SKLADKOWSKI.

CONTINUED ATTACKS ON JEWISH PASSERS-BY WERE REPORTED FROM LWOW. THE FIRST CASE OF INTRODUCTION OF "GHETTO BENCHES" FOR JEWISH SCHOOL CHILDREN WAS REPORTED FROM SONAK, IN THE LWOW DISTRICT, WHERE A WOMAN ELEMENTARY SCHOOL TEACHER ISOLATED THE JEWISH PUPILS ON THE LEFT SIDE OF THE CLASSROOM.

DELEGATES OF THE BIALYSTOK DISTRICT COMMITTEE OF THE JEWISH SMALL TRADERS UNION RECEIVED LETTERS ADVISING THEM THEY HAD BEEN "SENTENCED" TO DEATH FOR PARTICIPATING IN CONFERENCES OF JEWISH TRADERS WHICH PROTESTED AGAINST THE ANTI-SEMITIC BOYCOTT AND PICKETING OF THEIR ESTABLISHMENTS. THE UNION'S CENTRAL EXECUTIVE COMMITTEE IS CALLING THE INTERIOR MINISTRY'S ATTENTION TO THE THREATS.

### BERNARD SHAW TO CAMPAIGN AGAINST ANTI-SEMITISM

WILNO, SEPT. 12. (JTA) -- CHALLENGED AS TO HIS ATTITUDE TOWARD ANTI-SEMITISM, GEORGE BERNARD SHAW, BRITISH PLAYWRIGHT, HAS ANNOUNCED HIS INTENTION OF CAMPAIGNING AGAINST IT IN THE PRESS AND ON THE STAGE, IT WAS REVEALED TODAY.

A JEWISH NEWSPAPER MAN HERE, CORRESPONDENT OF ENGLISH PAPERS, WROTE TO SHAW ASKING WHY HE HAD NOT EXPRESSED HIS OPINION OF JEW-BAITING. HE RECEIVED A REPLY IN WHICH THE DRAMATIST WHOLE-HEARTEDLY CONDEMNED ANTI-SEMITISM, STATING THAT HE WOULD SOON PUBLISH A SERIES OF ARTICLES ON THE SUBJECT AS WELL AS A PLAY SHOWING UP ANTI-SEMITES IN THEIR TRUE LIGHT.

### PAN-ARAB CONGRESS REJECTS PARTITION; ASKS TREATY WITH BRITAIN

JERUSALEM, SEPT. 12. (JTA) -- RESOLUTIONS INCORPORATING ARAB EXTREMIST DEMANDS WERE ADOPTED AT THE CLOSING SESSION OF THE PAN-ARAB CONGRESS AT BLUDAN, SYRIA. THE CONFERENCE, ACCORDING TO REACTIONS HERE, ALTHOUGH SUMMONED TO LAY THE FOUNDATIONS OF PAN-ARABISM FAILED IN THIS BY RESTRICTING ITSELF TO PALESTINE AFFAIRS AND NOT EVEN DISCUSSING BROADER ARAB AIMS.

AMONG THE RESOLUTIONS WAS ONE THANKING FAWZI BEY EL KAUKAJI, SYRIAN TERRORIST LEADER, FOR HIS ACTIVITIES IN PALESTINE. (THE RESOLUTIONS, ACCORDING TO A NEW YORK TIMES JERUSALEM DISPATCH, CALL FOR (1) ABOLITION OF THE BALFOUR DECLARATION, (2) ABOLITION OF THE BRITISH MANDATE, (3) STOPPAGE OF JEWISH IMMIGRATION, (4) CONCLUSION OF A TREATY BETWEEN THE ARABS IN PALESTINE AND BRITAIN ALONG THE LINES OF THE ANGLO-IRAQ TREATY. THE ARAB POLITICIANS DECIDED TO "REFUSE THE SOLUTION OFFERED BY THE REPORT OF THE BRITISH ROYAL COMMISSION FOR THE SETTLEMENT OF THE PALESTINE PROBLEM.")

DESPITE THE PROMINENCE GIVEN TO THE CONGRESS BY THE PALESTINE ARAB PRESS, IT RECEIVED LITTLE ATTENTION IN OTHER COUNTRIES. LEBANESE NEWSPAPERS EVEN WENT SO FAR AS TO WARN THE POPULATION TO PAY NO ATTENTION TO THE MEETING.

MEANWHILE, ARAB TERRORISM IN PALESTINE CONTINUED. FOUR BRITISH CONSTABLES ENGAGED NINE MOUNTED ARABS NEAR SAFED, ARRESTING EIGHT OF THEM. THE NINTH OF THE ARMED BAND ESCAPED. ONE CONSTABLE SUFFERED A BROKEN ARM IN THE CLASH. A PUNITIVE POLICE STATION WAS ESTABLISHED IN THE FARAJ VILLAGE BECAUSE INHABITANTS ATTEMPTED TO RELEASE THE ARRESTED ARABS.

LIEUT.-GEN. JOHN G. DILL IS LEAVING TODAY FOR ENGLAND. HE WAS REPLACED AUG. 31 AS COMMANDER OF BRITISH FORCES IN PALESTINE BY MAJ.-GEN. ARCHIBALD P. WAVELL.

OF £30,000 (ABOUT \$150,000) ASSIGNED BY THE GOVERNMENT FOR CLAIMS ARISING FROM LAST YEAR'S DISTURBANCES, £18,000 (ABOUT \$90,000) HAS BEEN ALLOTTED TO JEWS, IT WAS ANNOUNCED.

#### LEAGUE ASSEMBLY MAY BE ASKED TO DISCUSS PALESTINE PROBLEM

LONDON, SEPT. 12. (JTA) -- A REQUEST IS LIKELY TO BE MADE THAT THE LEAGUE OF NATIONS ASSEMBLY, AS WELL AS THE COUNCIL, DISCUSS THE BRITISH GOVERNMENT'S PROPOSED THREE-WAY PARTITION OF PALESTINE, IT IS UNDERSTOOD HERE.

SIR JOHN SHUCKBURGH, DEPUTY PERMANENT UNDER-SECRETARY OF STATE FOR THE COLONIES, IS GOING TO GENEVA TO ATTEND THE COUNCIL'S DISCUSSION OF THE MANDATES COMMISSION REPORT ON PALESTINE.

#### WEIZMANN ARRIVES IN GENEVA

GENEVA, SEPT. 12. (JTA) -- DR. CHAIM WEIZMANN, PRESIDENT OF THE WORLD ZIONIST ORGANIZATION AND THE JEWISH AGENCY FOR PALESTINE, ARRIVED HERE TODAY AS THE LEAGUE OF NATIONS COUNCIL PREPARED TO TAKE UP THE BRITISH PROPOSAL TO PARTITION PALESTINE.

#### CONGRESS AGAINST RACISM OPENS IN PARIS

PARIS, SEPT. 12. (JTA) -- WITH ITS SLOGAN "OUR REPLY TO NUREMBERG," THE INTERNATIONAL CONGRESS AGAINST RACISM AND ANTI-SEMITISM OPENED HERE IN THE PRESENCE OF 300 DELEGATES FROM 22 NATIONS. GREETING THE CONGRESS IN BEHALF OF THE FRENCH GOVERNMENT, MINISTER OF STATE MAURICE VIOLLETTE ASSERTED THE GOVERNMENT SYMPATHIZED WITH ALL OPPRESSED PEOPLES AND WISHED THE CONGRESS SUCCESS.

MESSAGES READ AT THE OPENING SESSION INCLUDED THOSE FROM SAMUEL UNTERMYER, OF NEW YORK, EMIL LUDWIG AND THOMAS MANN. BERNARD M. LECACHE, PRESIDENT OF THE FRENCH LEAGUE TO COMBAT ANTI-SEMITISM, PRESIDED AND MADE THE OPENING ADDRESS. THE DELEGATES STOOD IN TRIBUTE TO VICTIMS OF RACIAL PERSECUTION.

AUSTRIA SANCTIONS "ARYAN PARAGRAPH" FOR BLIND MUSICIANS ASSOCIATION

VIENNA, SEPT. 12. (JTA) -- THE AUSTRIAN GOVERNMENT HAS SANCTIONED THE "ARYAN PARAGRAPH" FOR THE FIRST TIME BY CONFIRMING INTRODUCTION INTO THE STATUTES OF THE ASSOCIATION FOR BLIND MUSICIANS AND PIANO TUNERS OF A PROVISION BARRING JEWS FROM MEMBERSHIP.

THE ACTION WAS TAKEN DESPITE INTERVENTION WITH THE GOVERNMENT BY THE JEWISH RELIEF COMMITTEE AND THE UNION OF AUSTRIAN SOCIETIES FOR THE BLIND, WHICH WARNED OF THE PRECEDENT CREATED. THE UNION HAS NOW WARNED THE ASSOCIATION THAT IT WILL BE EXCLUDED FROM MEMBERSHIP UNLESS IT EXPUNGES THE "ARYAN PARAGRAPH" FROM ITS STATUTES BY OCT. 15.

SPANISH REBELS FIGHTING WORLD JEWRY, FRANCO AIDE SAYS

LONDON, SEPT. 12. (JTA) -- EVIDENCE OF NAZI PROPAGANDA IN THE REBEL-CONTROLLED PART OF SPAIN WAS SEEN TODAY IN AN ANTI-SEMITIC SPEECH BROADCAST OVER THE SEVILLE RADIO STATION BY GENERAL GONZALO QUIEPO DE LLANO, AIDE OF GENERAL FRANCISCO FRANCO.

"OUR FIGHT IS NOT A SPANISH CIVIL WAR, BUT A WAR FOR WESTERN CIVILIZATION AGAINST WORLD JEWRY," GENERAL LLANO SAID.

JEWS THE WORLD OVER, HE ASSERTED, BELONG TO A SUPREME COUNCIL OF JEWRY CALLED THE KAHAL AND PAY TO IT ONE-TENTH OF THEIR INCOME TO ACHIEVE WORLD DOMINATION. WITH ALLEGED QUOTATIONS FROM THE TALMUD, HE ACCUSED THE JEWS OF SEEKING EXTERMINATION OF CHRISTIANS.

LABOR GROUP FIGHTS PROPOSED FASCIST MARCH IN LONDON

LONDON, SEPT. 12. (JTA) -- THE TRADE UNION COUNCIL TODAY INSTRUCTED ITS SECRETARY, A. M. WALL, TO TAKE ALL POSSIBLE STEPS TO SECURE THE BANNING OF THE SCHEDULED FASCIST MARCH THROUGH THE EAST END OF LONDON.

ANTI-JEWISH PARTY BANNED IN LODZ

LODZ, POLAND, SEPT. 12. (JTA) -- MUNICIPAL AUTHORITIES TODAY BANNED A NEW POLITICAL GROUP CALLING ITSELF THE POLISH NATIONAL SOCIALIST PARTY, THE HAVAS NEWS AGENCY REPORTED. ITS INSIGNIA IS THE SWASTIKA IN RED ON A WHITE FIELD.

MEMBERS OF THE NEW PARTY HAVE BEEN ACTIVE FOR SOME TIME IN ANTI-JEWISH PROPAGANDA.

MANY INJURED IN DISORDERS IN RUMANIAN TOWN

CERNAUTI, RUMANIA, SEPT. 12. (JTA) -- MANY JEWS WERE INJURED IN ATTACKS IN SUZAWA, IN THE BUKOWINA PROVINCE. ANTI-SEMITES ASSAULTED THEM IN THE STREETS SHOUTING, "DOWN WITH THE JEWS!" AMONG THE SERIOUSLY WOUNDED ARE RABBI KALMAN HELD AND A MERCHANT, FAIVISH WEIDENFELD. THE POLICE ARE INVESTIGATING.

STREICHER DEDICATES BRIDGE IN GUSTLOFF'S NAME

NUREMBERG, SEPT. 12. (JTA) -- JULIUS STREICHER, HIGH PRIEST OF GERMAN ANTI-SEMITISM, PERFORMED THE CEREMONY OF RE-NAMING THE HALLER BRUECKE INTO THE BRIDGE OF WILHELM GUSTLOFF IN HONOR OF THE SWISS NAZI LEADER SLAIN BY A JEWISH MEDICAL STUDENT. A LARGE OBELISK WAS ERECTED AT ONE OF THE PILLARS OF THE BRIDGE SURMOUNTED BY A BUST OF GUSTLOFF AND BEARING THE INSCRIPTION, "WILHELM GUSTLOFF, JAN. 30, 1895 - FEB. 4, 1936; KILLED BY A JEW."

### DIZENGOFF HONORED IN TEL AVIV ON ANNIVERSARY OF DEATH

TEL AVIV, SEPT. 12. (JTA) -- A TOMBSTONE WAS UNVEILED HERE THIS AFTERNOON ON THE FIRST ANNIVERSARY OF THE DEATH OF MAYOR MEIER DIZENGOFF. REPRESENTATIVES OF JEWISH GROUPS FROM ALL OVER THE COUNTRY PARTICIPATED IN THE CEREMONIES. HEBREW NEWSPAPERS DEVOTED EDITORIALS TO THE TRIBUTE OF MR. DIZENGOFF.

AFTER THE UNVEILING OF THE TOMBSTONE MANY PASSED BEFORE MR. DIZENGOFF'S GRAVE. THE LATE MAYOR WAS EULOGIZED BY MAYOR ISRAEL ROKACH AND TEL AVIV'S CHIEF RABBI AT SERVICES IN THE GREAT SYNAGOGUE.

### 3 ARRESTED IN ATTEMPTED HOLD-UP IN TEL AVIV

TEL AVIV, SEPT. 12. (JTA) -- THREE YOUTHS WERE ARRESTED TODAY IN A DARING ATTEMPTED DAYLIGHT HOLD-UP OF AN OFFICIAL OF THE WORKERS' BANK CARRYING \$25,000 ON ONE OF TEL AVIV'S BUSIEST STREETS. POLICE ANSWERED THE VICTIM'S CALLS FOR HELP AND ARRESTED THE YOUTHS.

### ZIONIST LEADERS REPORT ON ZURICH CONGRESS TO RALLY HERE

NEW YORK, SEPT. 12. (JTA) -- SEVERAL AMERICAN ZIONIST LEADERS REPORTED TONIGHT ON THE ROLE OF UNITED STATES DELEGATES TO THE WORLD ZIONIST CONGRESS AT A MEETING CALLED BY THE ZIONIST ORGANIZATION OF AMERICA AT THE HOTEL ASTOR. THE SCHEDULED SPEAKERS INCLUDED DR. STEPHEN S. WISE, LOUIS LIPSKY, RABBI ABBA HILLEL SILVER, RABBI ISRAEL GOLDSTEIN AND ROBERT SZOLO.

### FEDERAL BUREAU INVESTIGATING NAZI ACTIVITIES

WASHINGTON, SEPT. 12. (JTA) -- AN "EXTENDED REPORT" ON NAZI ACTIVITIES IN THE UNITED STATES HAS BEEN PROMISED BY J. EDGAR HOOVER, CHIEF OF THE FEDERAL BUREAU OF INVESTIGATION. MR. HOOVER SAID HE COULD NOT FIX A DATE WHEN THE REPORT WOULD BE READY FOR ATTORNEY-GENERAL HOMER CUMMINGS, BUT SAID IT WOULD TAKE SEVERAL WEEKS "BECAUSE WE ARE GOING INTO THE MATTER VERY THOROUGHLY." MR. CUMMINGS ORDERED THE INVESTIGATION SIX WEEKS AGO, HE SAID, AND IT WAS BEGUN AT ONCE.

### GINZBURG, SOVIET ARTIST, RESUMES BAS-RELIEF HALTED 30 YEARS AGO

Leningrad (JTA) -- I. J. GINZBURG, FAMOUS JEWISH SCULPTOR AND MEMBER OF THE LENINGRAD ACADEMY, IS COMPLETING A LARGE BAS-RELIEF DEPICTING A JEWISH FAMILY IN THE MIDST OF A POGROM, WHICH HE STARTED THIRTY YEARS AGO BUT WAS NOT ALLOWED TO FINISH.

THE WORK, ENTITLED "POGROM," SHOWS A FAMILY GROUP ATTACKED BY A BAND OF THE "BLACK HUNDREDS," WHO RAIDED JEWISH COMMUNITIES IN THE EARLY YEARS OF THE TWENTIETH CENTURY. GINZBURG STARTED THE BAS-RELIEF AFTER THE RUSSIAN REVOLUTION IN 1905, BUT WAS UNABLE TO COMPLETE IT AT THAT TIME OWING TO CENSORSHIP.
