TENSION RELAXES IN WARSAW; EXAGGERATED REPORTS PUBLISHED HERE

WARSAW, SEPT. 24. (JTA) -- WITH THE AUTHORITIES SHOWING DETERMINATION TO SUPPRESS NEW OUTBREAKS, TENSION RESULTING FROM SEVERAL DAYS OF UNDEASING ANTI-JEWISH STREET ATTACKS RELAXED IN THE CAPITAL TODAY. NO MORE DISORDERS HAVE BEEN REPORTED SINCE LAST NIGHT.

MEANWHILE THE MUNICIPAL COURT SENTENCED TWELVE YOUTHFUL HOODLUMS TO JAIL TERMS RANGING FROM SEVEN TO FOURTEEN DAYS FOR ASSAULTING JEWS AND SMASHING WINDOWS.

REPORTS PUBLISHED ABROAD THAT SOLDIERS IN ARMORED CARS HAD BEEN CALLED IN TO PATROL WARSAW STREETS WERE ASCERTAINED TO BE UNTRUE. OTHER REPORTED DETAILS OF EVENTS OF THE LAST FEW DAYS WERE FOUND ON INVESTIGATION TO BE HIGHLY EXAGGERATED.

LAST NIGHT ANTI-SEMITIC GANGS ASSEMBLED BEFORE A JEWISH HOSPITAL IN THE CZYSTE DISTRICT OF WARSAW AND ATTACKED WOMEN VISITORS. EARLIER, OTHER GANGSTERS FELL UPON JEWISH FUNERAL PROCESSIONS.

TWENTY ENDEKS (NATIONALIST DEMOCRATS) WERE ARRESTED YESTERDAY FOR ATTACKS ON JEWS IN THE TOWNS OF OSMIANY AND NOWAWILEJKA IN THE WILNO DISTRICT.

IT WAS ASCERTAINED TODAY THAT OF THE MORE THAN 200 PERSONS ARRESTED FOR PARTIC-IPATION IN RECENT ANTI-SEMITIC DISORDERS, NEARLY HALF ARE JEWS.

OPTIMISTIC ON MADAGASCAR, POLISH INVESTIGATOR REVEALS

WARSAW, SEPT. 24. (JTA) -- A GENERALLY OPTIMISTIC IMPRESSION OF MADAGASCAR, FRENCH-OWNED ISLAND OFF THE EAST COAST OF SOUTH AFRICA, WAS CONVEYED TODAY BY MAJOR LEPECKI, HEAD OF A THREE-MAN GOVERNMENT COMMISSION SENT THERE RECENTLY TO SURVEY IMMIGRATION POSSIBILITIES.

THE ISLAND, MAJOR LEPECKI SAID, IS FERTILE AND RICH IN MINERALS. IT IS SPARSELY INHABITED AND THE POPULATION IS PEACEFUL AND WELL-DISPOSED TOWARDS WHITES, HE ADDED.

THE COMMISSION WAS SENT TO INVESTIGATE THE ISLAND'S POSSIBILITIES AFTER THE FRENCH GOVERNMENT HAD OFFERED OPPORTUNITIES FOR A LIMITED NUMBER OF JEWISH FAMILIES TO IMMIGRATE, PROVIDED THEY WERE FINANCED BY RECOGNIZED JEWISH ORGANIZATIONS.

LEAGUE ASSEMBLY URGED TO RESERVE OPINION ON PALESTINE PARTITION

GENEVA, SEPT. 24. (JTA) -- THE SIXTH (POLITICAL) COMMISSION RECOMMENDED TO THE ASSEMBLY OF THE LEAGUE OF NATIONS TODAY THAT OPINION ON THE BRITISH PROPOSAL TO CREATE INDEPENDENT JEWISH AND ARAB STATES IN PALESTINE BE RESERVED.

AFTER THREE DAYS OF DEBATE ON THE PALESTINE PROBLEM, DURING WHICH THE VIEWS OF NEARLY A SCORE OF NATIONS WERE PRESENTED, THE COMMISSION DRAFTED A REPORT FOR THE ASSEMBLY IN WHICH IT REQUESTS THE COUNCIL TO TAKE NOTE OF THE EXCHANGE OF VIEWS AND AGREES THAT THE PRESENT STUDY OF THE PROBLEM SHALL IN NO WAY PREJUDICE ITS SETTLEMENT.

THE RESOLUTION SUBMITTED FOR ACTION BY THE ASSEMBLY FOLLOWS:

"THE ASSEMBLY, HAVING NOTED THE ACTIVITIES OF THE MANDATORY POWER, THE MANDATES COMMISSION AND THE COUNCIL CONCERNING THE APPLICATION AND PRINCIPLES OF THE TWENTY-SECOND ARTICLE OF THE COVENANT. AS WELL AS OF THE MANDATE.

"FIRST, RENEWS ITS EXPRESSION OF CONFIDENCE IN THEM, AND PAYS TRIBUTE TO THE RESULTS ACHIEVED THANKS TO CLOSE, FRANK COOPERATION, WHICH IT IS ESSENTIAL TO MAINTAIN;

"SECONDLY, EXPRESSES THE CONVICTION THAT THE PALESTINE PROBLEM WILL BE EQUITABLY. SETTLED, ACCOUNT BEING TAKEN TO THE FULLEST POSSIBLE EXTENT OF ALL LEGITIMATE INTERESTS AT STAKE."

COMMENTING UPON THE RESOLUTION IRISH FREE STATE PRESIDENT EAMON DE VALERA DECLARED IT DOES NOT COMMIT THE ASSEMBLY TO PARTITION OF PALESTINE.

PALESTINE ALLOCATES \$400,000 FOR WATER PROJECTS URGED BY ROYAL COMMISSION

JERUSALEM, SEPT. 24. (JTA) -- ARRANGEMENTS FOR COMPLYING WITH THE BRITISH ROYAL COMMISSION'S RECOMMENDATIONS ON WATER RESEARCHES IN BEERSHEBA, THE JORDAN VALLEY AND TRANSJORDAN HAVE BEEN COMPLETED, IT WAS ANNOUNCED OFFICIALLY TODAY. THE SUM OF \$250,000 HAS BEEN ASSIGNED FOR THE WORK IN PALESTINE WITH AN ADDITIONAL \$150,000 FOR OPERATIONS IN TRANSJORDAN.

ARAB PRISONERS CALL HUNGER STRIKE; 3 WOUNDED AT ACRE

JEPUSALEM, SEPT. 24. (JTA) -- DISORDERS WERE REPORTED TODAY TO HAVE BROKEN OUT IN ACRE PRISON WHEN 150 ARABS PROCLAIMED A HUNGER STRIKE AGAINST ALLEGED "UNLAWFUL DETENTION." ACCORDING TO THE HEBREW DAILY, DAVAR, THREE OF THE PRISONERS WERE WOUNDED AND REMOVED TO A HOSPITAL.

COLONY IN PALESTINE TO HONOR MASARYK

JERUSALEM, SEPT. 24. (JTA) -- KFAR MACCABI, JEWISH COLONY, ANNOUNCED PLANS TODAY TO BUILD A CULTURAL HOME IN HONOR OF DR. THOMAS GARRIGUE MASARYK, FOUNDER OF THE CZECHO-SLOVAKIAN REPUBLIC WHO DIED RECENTLY.

DR. FRIEDRICH BRODNITZ, FORMER BERLIN JEWISH YOUTH LEADER, ARRIVES TO SETTLE HERE

NEW YORK, SEPT. 24. (JTA) -- DR. FRIEDRICH S. BRODNITZ, PHYSICIAN WHO ABANDONED HIS PRACTICE IN BERLIN WHEN THE HITLER REGIME TOOK POWER IN ORDER TO DEVOTE ALL HIS ENERGIES TO JEWISH ORGANIZATIONAL WORK, ARRIVED HERE TODAY ON THE FRENCH LINER DE GRASSE TO MAKE HIS PERMANENT HOME IN NEW YORK.

DR. BRODNITZ, IN AN INTERVIEW ON SHIPBOARD WITH A REPRESENTATIVE OF THE JEWISH TELEGRAPHIC AGENCY, DECLARED "SYSTEMATIC LIQUIDATION" WAS THE ONLY OUTLOOK FOR THE JEWS OF GERMANY. HE SAW BURDENS ON THE OLDER GENERATION, WHICH NOW COMPRISES MORE THAN SIXTY PER CENT OF THE TOTAL JEWISH POPULATION LEFT IN GERMANY, INCREASING AS EMIGRATION OF YOUTH CONTINUED.

TIME, DR. BRODNITZ ASSERTED, WAS NOW THE MOST IMPORTANT FACTOR IN THE GERMAN-JEWISH POSITION -- TIME TO PERMIT RETRAINING OF YOUTH AND PREPARATION FOR EMIGRATION.

DR. BRODNITZ IN BERLIN WAS CHAIRMAN OF THE EXECUTIVE OF THE UNION OF JEWISH YOUTH ORGANIZATIONS. HE ALSO ACTED AS PRESS CHIEF FOR BOTH THE HILFSVEREIN AND THE REICHSVETTRETUNG.

FEDERATION OF POLISH JEWS PROTESTS NEW WAVE OF DISORDERS IN LETTER TO POTOCKI

NEW YORK, SEPT. 24. (JTA) -- INDIGNATION OF AMERICAN JEWRY AGAINST THE NEW WAVE OF ANTI-JEWISH DISORDERS IN POLAND WAS EXPRESSED IN A LETTER TO POLISH AMBASSADOR COUNT POTOCK! MADE PUBLIC HERE TODAY BY THE FEDERATION OF POLISH JEWS IN AMERICA. COPY OF THE LETTER WAS SENT TO SECRETARY OF STATE CORDELL HULL. AT THE SAME TIME THE FEDERATION CABLED ITS NINETEEN AFFILIATED ORGANIZATIONS ABROAD CALLING UPON THEM TO LAY BEFORE THE POLISH AMBASSADORS IN THEIR RESPECTIVE COUNTRIES SIMILAR PROTESTS.

NAZIS SEEKING EVIDENCE TO BACK CHARGE JEWS AIM AT WORLD DOMINATION

ROME, SEPT. 24. (JTA) -- AN INTERNATIONAL ANTI-SEMITIC CONGRESS HELD EARLY IN SEPTEMBER IN ERRURT, GERMANY, DECIDED TO GATHER NEW MATERIAL TO SUPPORT ITS CONTENTION THAT WORLD JEWRY IS CARRYING ON AGITATION AIMED AT ACHIEVING WORLD DOMINATION, IT WAS REPORTED HERE TODAY.

J. EVOLA, ONE OF THE ITALIAN DELEGATES TO THE CONGRESS AND AUTHOR OF SEVERAL ANTI-JEWISH PAMPHLETS, SAID IN AN ARTICLE IN REGIME FASCISTA THAT THE MEETING HAD ALSO ADOPTED A RESOLUTION AFFIRM ING THE AUTHENTICITY OF "THE PROTOCOLS OF THE ELDERS OF ZION," DISCREDITED RECORD OF A PURPORTED JEWISH PLOT FOR WORLD DOMINATION.

THE CONGRESS EXPRESSED APPRECIATION OF ANTI-SEMITIC PROPAGANDA CARRIED ON IN
ITALY BY ROBERTO FARINACCI, FORMER SECRETARY OF THE FASCIST SUPREME COUNCIL AND PUBLISHER
OF REGIME FASCISTA, AND GIOVANNI PREZIONSI, EDITOR OF THE ANTI-SEMITIC MONTHLY DITTA
ITALIANA.

"Owing to a technical error" no representatives of the Islamic Peoples attended the congress, Evola Said.

"GERMAN REFUGEE" DEFINED AT GENEVA PARLEY; "OSTJUDEN" INCLUDED

GENEVA, SEPT. 24. (JTA) -- DEFINITION OF WHAT CONSTITUTES A "GERMAN REFUGEE" WAS SETTLED AT A CONFERENCE WEDNESDAY OF THE LIASON COMMITTEE AFFILIATED WITH THE LEAGUE OF NATIONS HIGH COMMISSION FOR REFUGEES FROM GERMANY, IT WAS DISCLOSED HERE TODAY.

THE CONFERENCE, IN WHICH REPRESENTATIVES OF 20 JEWISH AND NON-JEWISH ORGANIZATIONS PARTICIPATED, ADOPTED A RESOLUTION DEFINING A GERMAN REFUGEE AS:

"A PERSON WHO LIVED IN GERMANY AND DOES NOT AT THE PRESENT TIME ENJOY THE JURIDICAL OR ACTUAL PROTECTION OF THE GERMAN GOVERNMENT OF THE GOVERNMENT OF THE COUNTRY WHERE HE LIVED BEFORE SETTLING IN GERMANY." BY THIS DEFINITION, "OSTJUDEN" OR EAST EUROPEAN JEWS WHO LOST BOTH THEIR GERMAN AND PREVIOUS CITIZENSHIP ARE INCLUDED.

THE RESOLUTION, BASED ON A PROPOSAL FOR MODIFICATION OF THE STATUTES ON GERMAN REFUGES SUBMITTED BY MARK YARBLUM, REPRESENTING THE WORLD JEWISH CONGRESS, EMPHASIZES THAT DEPORTATION OF GERMAN REFUGES SHOULD NOT BE ALLOWED. IT STRESSES THAT SOLUTION OF THE REFUGE PROBLEM IS IMPOSSIBLE UNLESS THE REFUGES ARE PERMITTED TO WORK IN THE COUNTRIES OF PRESENT DOMICILE.

SIR NEILL MALCOLM, LEAGUE HIGH COMMISSIONER FOR REFUGEES FROM GERMANY, PROMISED FULL SUPPORT FOR THE RESOLUTION, WHICH HE SAID HE WOULD SUBMIT TO THE FORTHCOMING INTERGOVERNMENTAL REFUGEE CONFERENCE AND TO THE LEAGUE SECRETARIAT.

THE CONFERENCE ALSO ADOPTED A RESOLUTION VOICING SATISFACTION WITH SIR NEILL'S RE-CENT ANNUAL REPORT ON THE WORK OF THE COMMISSION, AND PROMISING TO SUPPORT EFFORTS TO FIND SUITABLE TERRITORIES FOR SETTLEMENT OF GERMAN REFUGEES. THE RESOLUTION APPEALS TO NATIONAL ORGANIZATIONS TO HELP IN THIS RESPECT.

NATHAN KATZ, FORMER NEW YORK ATTORNEY NOW AFFILIATED WITH THE EUROPEAN OFFICES OF THE AMERICAN JEWISH JOINT DISTRIBUTION COMMITTEE, WAS ELECTED PERMANENT SECRETARY OF THE LIASON COMMITTEE, WITH OFFICES IN PARIS. RUDOLF KATZ WAS APPOINTED ASSISTANT SECRETARY.

AMONG OTHERS ATTENDING THE CONFERENCE WERE PROF. PAUL GUGGENHEIM OF GENEVA, FOR THE WORLD JEWISH CONGRESS, AND PROF. FISCHER OF SWEDEN, WHO PRESIDED.

RIOTING RENEWED IN POLISH SILESIAN TOWNS

WARSAW, SEPT. 24. (JTA) -- ANTI-JEWISH DISORDERS MORE VIOLENT THAN THOSE OF LAST WEEK WERE RENEWED TODAY IN THE POLISH SILESIAN TOWNS OF BIELSKO AND BIALA. JEWISH SHOPS AND HOUSES WERE WRECKED AND PILLAGED. POLICE REINFORCEMENTS FROM CRACOW RESTORED ORDER.
