TATARESCU AIRS REGIME'S POLICY ON MINORITIES; TO PROMOTE MAJORITY WELFARE

BUCHAREST, Oct. II. (JTA) -- PREMIER GEORG TATARESCU, IN A STATEMENT OF POLICY ON MINORITIES, DECLARED THE POLICY OF PROMOTING THE "RUMANIAN ELEMENT" WOULD BE PURSUED BY EVERY FUTURE GOVERNMENT, BUT ADDED THAT THIS WOULD NOT BE DIRECTED AGAINST MINORITIES.

THE PREMIER'S DECLARATION, MADE SATURDAY IN AN ADDRESS IN THE TOWN OF ORADEA, CAME ON THE HEELS OF A STATEMENT BY KING CARCL, WHO TOLD THE RUMANIAN BOY SCOUT CONGRESS: "WE MUST CULTIVATE SPIRITUAL PEACE; EVERY INHABITANT OF THE LAND HAS A MISSION TO FULFILL FOR THE COLLECTIVE INTEREST."

THE PREMIER'S FRANK ASSERTION THAT THE MAJORITY WOULD BE FAVORED WAS INTERPRETED IN POLITICAL CIRCLES AS INDICATING THAT THE GOVERNMENT WOULD CONTINUE ITS POLICY OF PROMOTING THE THAN AND THE THAT BEING MEASURES IN THIS DIRECTION WOULD NOT BEAR HARSHLY ON MINORITIES. ON THE OTHER HAND IT WAS POINTED OUT THAT A NATIONAL ELECTION IS COMING AT THE END OF THE YEAR.

MR. TATARESCU STRESSED THE GOVERNMENT'S DESIRE TO ESTABLISH CONDITIONS OF RECIP-ROCAL CONFIDENCE WITH MINORITY NATIONALITIES, GIVING ASSURANCES THAT CONDITIONS NECESSARY. FOR THE DEVELOPMENT OF THESE GROUPS WITHIN THE FRAMEWORK OF LAW WOULD BE PROVIDED.

"MISUNDERSTANDING AND DIFFICULTIES WHICH NATURALLY ARISE IN INTERCOURSE BETWEEN A MAJORITY AND MINORITIES CAN ALWAYS BE SETTLED," HE SAID, "IN AN ATMOSPHERE OF UNDERSTANDING AND CONCILIATION."

AT THE SAME TIME, THE PREMIER DECLARED THAT MINORITIES MUST NOT OPPOSE ACTIONS AIMED AT PROMOTING THE RUMANIAN ELEMENT. THE MINORITIES MUST LOYALLY FULFILL THEIR OBLIGATION TO RUMANIA, HE DECLARED, AND "HAVE A DUTY NOT TO REGARD WITH UNFAVORABLE EYES ACTION FOR THE PROMOTION OF THE PUMANIAN ELEMENT, WHICH MUST BE HELPED TO REACH THE LEVEL OF MATERIAL AND CULTURAL DEVELOPMENT TO WHICH THE MAJORITY IS ENTITLED IN EVERY STATE."

ANNOUNCING THAT THE MAJORITY'S WELFARE WOULD BE AIDED BY EVERY FUTURE GOVERNMENT, MR. TATARESCU WARNED THAT "MINORITIES MUST, IN THEIR OWN INTERESTS, COLLABORATE SINCERELY IN THIS WORK OF RECONSTRUCTION.

HE CONCLUDED WITH THE STATEMENT: "PEACE AND UNDERSTANDING OUTSIDE AND PEACE AND UNDERSTANDING WITHIN THE COUNTRY: THIS IS THE PERMANENT COMMANDMENT WHICH GUIDES THE LIFE OF THE ROMANIAN STATE."

POP HEDGES ON EMPLOYMENT CURB

BUCHAREST, Oct, II. (JTA) -- VALERIUS POP, MINISTER OF COMMERCE AND INDUSTRY NOTIFIED INDUSTRIALISTS IN A CIRCULAR TODAY THAT PREVIOUS INSTRUCTIONS ON RESTRICTING THE EMPLOYMENT OF FOREIGNERS AND MEMBERS OF NATIONAL MINORITIES WERE NOT TO BE CONSIDERED AS A COMPULSORY ORDER BUT AS AN URGENT RECOMMENDATION.

RUMANIAN SOCIALISTS AND TRADE UNIONISTS DECIDED TO PROTEST AGAINST MR. POP'S INSTRUCTIONS. THE PRINTERS' UNION ORDERED ITS MEMBERS NOT TO TAKE A JOB FROM WHICH A MEMBER OF A NATIONAL MINORITY IS DISMISSED.

SCHOOLCHILDREN VICTIMS OF INCITEMENT

BUCHAREST, Oct. II. (JTA) -- THE NEWSPAPER CURIERUL ISRAELIT, ORGAN OF THE UNION OF JEWISH COMMUNITIES, REPORTS TODAY THAT JEWISH PUPILS IN RUMANIAN STATE SCHOOLS WERE BEING HUMILIATED AS A RESULT OF INCITEMENT BY TEACHERS OF RUMANIAN SCHOOLCHILDREN AGAINST JEWISH CLASSMATES. THIS HAS OCCURED DESPITE THE EDUCATION MINISTER'S RECENT REQUEST TO SCHOOL TEACHERS TO REFRAIN FROM POLITICAL ACTIVITIES, THE NEWSPAPER SAID.

ROOSEVELT'S TALK BOLSTERED LIBERAL HOPES IN POLAND, RUMANIA, J.D.C. MAN REVEALS

PARIS, Oct. II. (JTA) -- FOREIGN-FINANCED JEW-BAITING IS ASSUMING ANNIHILATING PROPORTIONS IN POLAND AND RUMANIA AND MAKING LIFE UNSAFE FOR THE JEWS, HERBERT J. SELIGMANN, OF THE AMERICAN JEWISH JOINT DISTRIBUTION COMMITTEE, REPORTED TODAY AFTER HIS RETURN FROM A TOUR OF INVESTIGATION IN THESE COUNTRIES.

PRESIDENT ROOSEVELT'S ADDRESS INSPIRED HOPE AMONG LIBERAL ELEMENTS IN POLAND AND RUMANIA, WHO CONSIDER THE INDEFINITUDE OF THE SITUATION THERE AS TANTAMOUNT TO A GROWTH OF TOTALITARIANISM, MR. SELIGMANN EMPHASIZED IN A PRESS CONFERENCE ARRANGED FOR AMERICAN CORRESPONDENTS.

DECLARING THAT ANTI-SEMITISM HAD MADE GREAT HEADWAY IN POLAND WHILE IN RUMANIA FEW DARED TO OPPOSE ANTI-JEWISH PROPAGANDA, HE SAID THAT THE MAJORITY OF THE MORE THAN 4,000,-000 JEWS IN THESE COUNTRIES NEEDED RELIEF.

MR. SELIGMANN, WHOSE ADDRESS WAS REPLETE WITH PERSONAL EXPERIENCES AND EYE-WITNESS ACCOUNTS, WAS PRECEDED BY DAVID J. SCHWEITZER, EUROPEAN VICE-CHAIRMAN OF THE JOINT DIST-RIBUTION COMMITTEE, WHO EXPLAINED THE ACTIVITIES THE J.D.C. IS CARRYING ON IN BEHALF OF THE JEWS.

13 WOUNDED, 50 SHOPS PILLAGED IN POLISH EXCESSES

WARSAW, Oct. II. (JTA) -- REPORTS REACHED HERE TODAY OF SERIOUS ANTI-JEWISH EXCESSES YESTERDAY IN THE TOWN OF SUCHOWOLA, IN GRODNO PROVINCE, DURING WHICH THIRTEEN JEWS WERE WOUNDED, ONE OF THEM GRAVELY, AND MORE THAN FIFTY JEWISH-OWNED SHOPS PILLAGED.

A LARGE CROWD WHICH HAD ASSEMBLED FOR CHURCH SERVICES STONED JEWISH HOMES AND RAIDED THE TOWN'S SHOPPING CENTER. ABOUT 300 JEWISH FAMILIES LIVE IN SUCHOWOLA.

JEWISH STUDENT ORGANIZATIONS WERE STILL CONFERRING TODAY ON THE ADVISABILITY OF CALLING A NATION-WIDE STRIKE TO PROTEST AGAINST INSTITUTION OF "GHETTO BENCHES" IN WARSAW UNIVERSITIES WITH OFFICIAL SANCTION OF THE EDUCATION MINISTRY. PLANS TO CALL AN EIGHT-DAY STRIKE HAVE BEEN SHELVED, IT WAS LEARNED, IN FAVOR OF ONE TO LAST ONLY TWO DAYS.

HUBERMAN CONTRACTS PNEUMONIA AFTER AIR CRASH INJURIES

AMSTERDAM, Oct. 11. (JTA) -- BRONISLAW HUBERMAN, NOTED VIOLINIST AND FOUNDER OF THE PALESTINE SYMPHONY ORCHESTRA, HAS DEVELOPED PNEUMONIA AFTER BEING INJURED IN THE CRASH OF A DUTCH AIRLINER IN SUMATRA, IT WAS REPORTED TODAY FROM BADDENG.

FASCIST PRESS MAKING MOST OF PALESTINE DEVELOPMENTS; WARNS BRITAIN OF MOSLEM HATRED

ROME, Oct. II. (JTA) -- THE ITALIAN PRESS CONTINUES TO FEATURE DEVELOPMENTS IN PALESTINE, EMPHASIZING LENGTHY PROTESTS FROM ARAB CENTERS AGAINST "BRITISH TERRORISM" IN ARRESTING ARAB LEADERS AND SUPPRESSING POLITICAL ORGANIZATIONS. PHOTOGRAPHS OF THE EXGRAND MUFTI HAVE BEEN PROMINENTLY DISPLAYED BY MOST PAPERS, WHICH DO NOT CONCEAL THEIR SYMPATHY WITH THE ARAB NATIONALISTS.

THE NEWSPAPER AZIONE COLONIAL, WHICH IS CONSIDERED CLOSE TO THE GOVERNMENT, PUBLISHES AN ARTICLE ON WHAT IT CALLS THE FAILURE OF BRITISH POLICY IN PÂLESTINE. IT CRITICIZES THE BRITISH FOR CONTINUATION OF THIS "POLICY OF FAILURE" AND WARNS THAT BRITAIN IS MAKING POLITICAL MARTYRS OF EXILED ÂRAB LEADERS.

"SHE PLAYS WITH FIRE IN THE WHOLE MOSLEM WORLD IF SHE CONTINUES THIS BLIND AND BRUT-AL POLICY, WELL REPAID BY THE HATRED OF ALL ARABS," THE PAPER SAYS. IT WARNS OF GRAVE CON-SEQUENCES, EVEN IN INDIA, RESULTING IN A LOSS OF PRESTIGE FOR BRITAIN GREATER THAN FROM A LOST WAR.

ITALIAN AIR TALKS TO PALESTINE ARABS GROW IN VIOLENCE

LONDON, OCT. 11. (JTA) -- THE JERUSALEM CORRESPONDENT OF THE DAILY HERALD REPORTED TODAY THAT ITALIAN PROPAGANDA BROADCASTS FROM THE BARI STATION TO THE PALESTINE ARABS ARE GROWING IN VIOLENCE.

THE STATION IS SPREADING FALSE REPORTS CALCULATED TO INCITE THE ARABS, THE DISPATCH SAID, ADDING THAT PALESTINE EXTREMIST LEADERS WHO HAVE ESCAPED TO SYRIA ARE MAINTAINING CLOSE CONTACT WITH ITALIAN AGENTS.

PALESTINE SET TO FORM IMMIGRATION CONTROL COMMISSION; BRIGANDAGE RESUMED

JERUSALEM, OCT. 11. (JTA) -- THE PALESTINE GOVERNMENT, IT WAS LEARNED TODAY, IS CONTEMPLATING THE IMMEDIATE ESTABLISHMENT OF A SPECIAL IMMIGRATION COMMISSION OF NINE MEMBERS COMPRISING JEWS, ARABS AND BRITONS IN EQUAL NUMBER TO STUDY THE COUNTRY'S CAPACITY TO ABSORD IMMIGRANTS AND REGULATE JEWISH IMMIGRATION.

A RESUMPTION OF BRIGANDAGE WAS REPORTED TODAY ON THE NORTHERN FRONTIER AS SIX ARMED ARABS HELD UP AND ROBBED SEVEN AUTOMOSILES IN THE SECTION KNOWN AS NO MAN'S LAND NEAR RAS-EL-NAKURA ON THE SYRIAN BORDER.

TWENTY-FOUR ARABS WERE ARRESTED IN RAMLEH ON CHARGES OF BEING MEMBERS OF A "BLACKHAND" TERRORIST ORGANIZATION. IN HEBRON, POLICE WERE PRESSING A SEARCH FOR THE LOCAL MUFTI (MOSLEM-RELIGIOUS LEADER) WHO HAD ESCAPED.

PARLEYS ON CREATION OF ARAB AGENCY REPORTED LAUNCHED

JERUSALEM, OCT. 11. (JTA) -- DAVAR, HEBREW LABORITE DAILY, REPORTS TODAY THAT
NEGOTIATIONS LOOKING TOWARD ESTABLISHMENT OF AN ARAB AGENCY TO REPLACE THE OUTLAWED ARAB
SUPREME COMMITTEE HAVE BEEN STARTED WITH ARAB NOTABLES OF MODERATE VIEWS.

EXILED ARAB LEADERS ARRIVE AT INDIAN OCEAN ISLANDS

LONDON, OCT. 11. (UTA) -- A GROUP OF DEPORTED PALESTINE ARAB LEADERS, ARRESTED BY THE BRITISH ADMINISTRATION IN A DRIVE AGAINST AGITATORS AND TERRORISTS, HAS ARRIVED ABOARD THE BRITISH DESTROYER ACTIVE, AT THE SEYCHELLES ISLANDS IN THE INDIAN OCEAN, REUTERS NEWS AGENCY PEPORTED TODAY.

J.N.F. VOTES \$2,000,000 BUDGET, \$250,000 GIFT BOND DRIVE FOR GALILEE PROJECT

DETROIT, OCT. II. (JTA) -- RESPONDING TO THE PLEA, "ON TO THE GALILEE!" THE NAT-IONAL CONFERENCE ON PALESTINE LAND REDEMPTION LAST NIGHT VOTED A \$250,000 GIFT-BOND CAMP-AIGN FOR DEVELOPMENT OF THE HULEH CONCESSION, IN ADDITION TO A \$2,000,000 JEWISH NATIONAL FUND BUDGET FOR THE CURRENT YEAR.

THE "BONDS" WILL BE SOLD, IT IS HOPED, WITHIN THREE MONTHS IN THE \$2,500,000 CAMPAIGN FOR THE HULEH, HALF OF WHICH SUM IS ASKED AS SPEEDILY AS POSSIBLE.

MORGAN JONES, MEMBER OF THE BRITISH PARLIAMENT, ADDRESSING YESTERDAY AFTERNOON'S SESSION, CONDEMNED THE PROPOSED PARTITION OF PALESTINE. DECLARING WESTERN NATIONS WERE HONOR-BOUND TO ESTABLISH A JEWISH HOMELAND, HE CALLED IT A CRIME FOR NATIONS TO ALLOW THE GREAT WORK OF JEWISH REDEMPTION TO BE ARRESTED. HE SAID THE ROYAL COMMISSION'S SUGGESTIONS WERE UNWORKABLE, AND EMPHASIZED THAT EUROPEAN NATIONS AND THE UNITED STATES COULD NOT ESCAPE THEIR PLEDGE TO THE JEWS.

OTHER SPEAKERS INCLUDED RABBI JOACHIM PRINZ, Dr. WISE, WHO SPOKE BY TELEPHONE FROM New Haven, and Abraham Goldberg.

LABOR ZIONIST DELEGATES, AT A SPECIAL CONFERENCE, PLEDGED ESTABLISHMENT OF A COL-ONY IN PALESTINE IN THE NAME OF VICE-PREMIER LEON BLUM OF FRANCE, AND RESOLVED TO MAKE AN EFFORT TO RAISE THE GREATEST PORTION OF THE NECESSARY FUNDS THE FIRST YEAR.
