### JERUSALEM CURFEW LIFTED AFTER 5 DAYS; 2 DIE OF WOUNDS

JERUSALEM, Oct. 19. (JTA) -- CURFEW, IN EFFECT SINCE LAST THURSDAY NIGHT, WAS LIFTED IN JERUSALEM TODAY, WHILE THE DEATH OF TWO PERSONS FROM INJURIES RECEIVED EARLIER ADDED TO THE LIST OF FATALITIES.

MRS. ZELZION, WIFE OF THE FORMER PRESIDENT OF THE OLEI POLANIA (POLISH IMMIGRANTS' ORGANIZATION), DIED OF INJURIES RECEIVED SUNDAY NIGHT WHEN A BUS WAS FIRED UPON AND OVERTURNED NEAR MOTZA. AN ARMENIAN PHOTOGRAPHER, SHOT IN FRONT OF THE GOVERNMENT OFFICES IN JERUSALEM YESTERDAY WHEN EVIDENTLY MISTAKEN FOR A JEW, ALSO SUCCEMBED TO HIS WOUNDS.

A COLLECTIVE FINE OF \$750 WAS LEVIED UPON THE ARAB VILLAGE OF TAYIBA FOR DISORDERS WHICH OCCURRED THERE. AGENTS SENT TO COLLECT THE FINE RETURNED, HOWEVER, WITHOUT THE MONEY.

ZEVE EPSTEIN, AN OFFICIAL OF THE JEWISH AGENCY FOR PALESTINE, AND A MAN NAMED GREENBERG WERE DETAINED IN CONNECTION WITH THE FIRING UPON ARAB LABORERS YESTERDAY IN THE SANDHEDRIA SUBURB OF JERUSALEM.

ARABS SURROUNDED AND FIRED UPON THE NEWLY-ESTABLISHED COLONY OF KFAR MENACHEM, NAMED FOR MENACHEM M. USSISHKIN, WORLD PRESIDENT OF THE JEWISH NATIONAL FUND. NO CASUALTIES WERE REPORTED.

RETURN OF PROMINENT ARAB LEADERS FROM THEIR EXILE IN THE SEYCHELLES ISLANDS IS DEMANDED OF THE BRITISH AND PALESTINE GOVERNMENTS IN A MEMORANDUM BY THE RULERS OF NEIGHBORING MOSLEM COUNTRIES, IT WAS REPORTED BY THE ARAB NEWS AGENCY. ARAB JUDGES AT THE SAME TIME SENT A MEMORANDUM TO THE COLONIAL OFFICE IN LONDON THREATENING TO RESIGN IN THE EVENT THE AUTHORITIES DID NOT DISCONTINUE "STRONG MEASURES AGAINST THE ARABS." A COPY OF THE MEMORANDUM WAS SENT TO THE BRITISH GOVERNMENT.

### LONDON HOLDS DISORDERS ONLY SPORADIC

LONDON, Oct. 19. (JTA) -- OFFICIAL CIRCLES TODAY DEPRECATED ANY PANICKY VIEW OF THE PRESENT SITUATION IN PALESTINE, MAINTAINING THAT THE INCIDENTS OF THE LAST FEW DAYS WERE ONLY OF A SPORADIC CHARACTER.

THE DISTURBANCES, IT WAS POINTED OUT, HAVE HAD NO EFFECT ON THE GOVERNMENT'S PLANS TO SEND A SECOND COMMISSION TO PALESTINE TO NEGOTIATE A DETAILED PARTITION PLAN, AS AUTHORIZED BY THE LEAGUE OF NATIONS COUNCIL. MEMBERS OF THE COMMISSION ARE EXPECTED TO BE APPOINTED SOON AFTER RESUMPTION OF PARLIAMENT.

IT WAS AUTHORITATIVELY EMPHASIZED THAT THE GOVERNMENT IS IN NO HASTE TO SEND THE COMMISSION BEFORE PRELIMINARY WORK HAS BEEN THOROUGHLY PREPARED.

### NO TROOPS PLANNED FOR PALESTINE

LONDON, OCT. 19. (JTA) -- THE BRITISH GOVERNMENT, IT WAS REPORTED TODAY, HAS NO INTENTION AT PRESENT OF SENDING FURTHER TROOPS TO PALESTINE TO SUPPRESS THE OUTBREAK OF TERRORISM. IT IS CONSIDERED THAT THE FORCES NOW THERE ARE ADEQUATE TO DEAL WITH THE SITUATION.

IT IS UNDERSTOOD THAT COLONIAL SECRETARY WILLIAM ORMSBY-GORE WILL MAKE A LENGTHY STATEMENT IN THE HOUSE OF COMMONS TOMORROW ON RECENT EVENTS IN THE HOLY LAND.

### SPICER, PALESTINE POLICE CHIEF, NOT TO RETURN TO POST

LONDON, OCT. 19. (JTA) -- IT WAS ANNOUNCED OFFICIALLY TODAY THAT ROY GODFREY BULLEN SPICER, PALESTINE INSPECTOR-GENERAL OF POLICE AND PRISONS, WILL NOT RETURN TO JERUSALEM. MR. SPICER WAS RECENTLY THE TARGET OF AN ASSASSINATION ATTEMPT BY ARABS WHO AMBUSHED HIS CAR NEAR AN ARAB CAFE BEHIND POLICE HEADQUARTERS. HE HAS BEEN IN ENGLAND ON LEAVE OF ABSENCE.

### NEW ANGLO-ITALIAN TENSION FEARED OVER DISORDERS

PARIS, OCT. 19. (JTA) -- FRESH ANGLO-ITALIAN TENSION MAY RESULT FROM THE PALESTINE DISORDERS, IT WAS PREDICTED HERE TODAY, AS FRENCH OBSERVERS COMMENTED UNEASILY ON PREMIER BENITO MUSSOLINI'S ALLEGED PROPAGANDA AMONG THE ARABS AND HIS "DREAM OF COMPLETE MASTERY" OVER THE MEDITERRANEAN.

THE NOTED COMMENTATOR PERTINAX ASSERTED IN THE NEWSPAPER ECHO DE PARIS THAT DURING RECENT WEEKS THE IMAN YAHYA OF YEMEN AND LIBYAN NOTABLES "TURNED TOWARD MUSSOLINI AND URGED HIM TO ASSUME THE ROLE OF PROTECTOR OF THE ARABS, WHOSE RIGHTS ARE BEING VIOLATED IN PALESTINE."

"THE REPERCUSSIONS IN PALESTINE MAY EASILY AGGRAVATE THE ANGLO-ITALIAN DIFFERENCES," PERTINAX ADDED.

ACCORDING TO THE CATHOLIC ORGAN L'AUBE, "MUSSOLINI'S DREAM OF COMPLETE MASTERY OVER THE MEDITERRANEAN FROM GIBRALTAR TO SUEZ IS BEING GIVEN FORM AND SHAPE IN INSANE GESTURES."

MUSSOLINI "WANTS TO TRY BRITISH PATIENCE TO THE LIMIT," THE CATHOLIC ORGAN ADDED.

POLISH JEWRY IN ANTI-GHETTO STRIKE; 200 SEIZED; CHRISTIANS JOIN WALKOUT

WARSAW, Oct. 19. (JTA) -- MORE THAN 3,000,000 POLISH JEWS AND SEVERAL THOUSAND CHRISTIAN WORKERS SUSPENDED ALL ACTIVITIES FOR HALF A DAY TODAY IN PROTEST AGAINST GOVERNMENT-SANCTIONED SEGREGATION OF JEWISH STUDENTS IN WARSAW UNIVERSITIES.

POLICE ARRESTED 200 PERSONS IN CONNECTION WITH THE DEMONSTRATION. THE MAJORITY WERE RELEASED, BUT THE REMAINDER WILL BE PROSECUTED. IN LODZ, FOUR JEWISH DEMONSTRATORS WERE SENTENCED BY AN ADMINISTRATIVE COURT TO PRISON TERMS OF SIX WEEKS EACH.

THE STRIKE, DECLARED BY LEADERS TO BE THE MOST EFFECTIVE EVER STAGED BY POLISH JEWRY AGAINST ANTI-SEMITISM, RESULTED IN COMPLETE SHUTDOWN OF ALL JEWISH SHOPS, FACTORIES, BANKS, OFFICES, CAFES AND RESTAURANTS. POLISH CHRISTIAN WORKERS EMPLOYED IN MANY FACTORIES HAVING MIXED PERSONNEL JOINED THE JEWISH STRIKERS.

JEWISH SCHOOL CHILDREN, UNDER ADVICE OF THE UNION OF JEWISH PARENTS, ABSTAINED FROM CLASSES IN THE MORNING. WORK WAS SUSPENDED BY ALL JEWISH COMMUNAL ORGANIZATIONS. EVEN FUNERALS WERE POSTPONED UNTIL THE AFTERNOON.

A SCORE OF JEWISH YOUTHS WERE ARRESTED HERE FOR PARTICIPATING IN SPONTANEOUS STREET DEMONSTRATIONS AND DISTRIBUTING LEAFLETS. POLICE DISPERSED THE DEMONSTRATORS.

OVERFLOW MEETINGS WERE HELD IN WARSAW AND OTHER LARGE CITIES. THEY ADOPTED RESOLUTIONS DEMANDING FULL CITIZENSHIP RIGHTS FOR JEWS AND ABOLITION OF THE "GHETTO" MEASURES.

POLISH DOCTORS' UNION TO ADMIT ONLY CHRISTIANS FROM BIRTH

WARSAW, Oct. 19. (JTA) -- A CONFERENCE OF THE POLISH DOCTORS' UNION AT POZNAN ADOPTED A RESOLUTION TODAY BARRING MEMBERSHIP TO ALL EXCEPT CHRISTIANS FROM BIRTH. NATIONALIST NEWSPAPERS HAIL THE RESOLUTION AS "THE FIRST STEP IN FREEING THE POLISH INTELLIGENTSIA FROM JEWISH INFLUENCE." THE UNION'S ACTION IS EXPECTED TO RESULT IN FORMATION OF A RIVAL BODY SINCE ITS DEMOCRATIC MEMBERS ABSTAINED FROM THE CONFERENCE.

DENMARK BANS MARRIAGES FORBIDDEN IN GERMANY

COPENHAGEN, Oct. 19. (JTA) -- BOWING TO NAZI GOVERNMENT PRESSURE, DENMARK TODAY FORBODE ISSUANCE OF MARRIAGE CERTIFICATES TO PERSONS WHOSE MARRIAGES ARE PROHIBITED IN THEIR NATIVE COUNTRIES. THE MINISTER OF JUSTICE, IT WAS DISCLOSED, HAS CIRCULATED INSTRUCTIONS TO THAT EFFECT TO REGISTRARS THROUGHOUT THE COUNTRY.

DANISH NEWSPAPERS REPORT THE ORDER UNDER THE HEADLINE, "GERMAN ARYANS AND GERMAN JEWS MAY NOT MARRY IN DENMARK." REPRESENTATIONS BY THE BERLIN AUTHORITIES ARE UNDERSTOOD TO HAVE LED TO ISSUANCE OF THE ORDER.

KING GEORGE GIVEN SYMBOLS OF PALESTINE JEWRY'S AFFECTION

LONDON, Oct. 19. (JTA) -- KING GEORGE VI WAS TODAY PRESENTED WITH SYMBOLS OF PALESTINE JEWRY'S AFFECTION AND LOYALTY BY DR. CHAIM WEIZMANN, PRESIDENT OF THE WORLD ZIONIST ORGANIZATION, ACTING ON BEHALF OF THE JEWISH NATIONAL COUNCIL OF PALESTINE. DR. WEIZMANN WAS ACCOMPANIED BY COLONIAL SECRETARY WILLIAM ORMSBY-GORE.

THE SYMBOLS INCLUDED A TORAH, A VELLUM-BOUND VOLUME OF PHOTOGRAPHS ILLUSTRATING UPBUILDING OF PALESTINE, AND A LOYAL ADDRESS.

1,984 JEWS FIRED FROM REICH CIVIL SERVICE SINCE 1933

BERLIN, Oct. 19. (JTA) -- THE GERMAN GOVERNMENT EMPLOYEES' ASSOCIATION ANNOUNCED TODAY THAT 1,984 JEWS HAVE BEEN DISMISSED FROM THE CIVIL SERVICE SINCE 1933.

SCHNEIDLER NAMED KARESKI'S SUCCESSOR ON BERLIN JEWISH BOARD

BERLIN, Oct. 19. (JTA) -- DR. I. SCHNEIDLER WAS TODAY ELECTED TO THE EXECUTIVE BOARD OF THE BERLIN JEWISH COMMUNITY AT A SPECIAL MEETING. HE REPLACES GEORG KARESKI, HEAD OF THE GERMAN STATE ZIONIST ORGANIZATION, WHO RECENTLY RESIGNED.

NATHAN STRAUS NAMED U.S. HOUSING AUTHORITY ADMINISTRATOR

HYDE PARK, N.Y., Oct. 19. (JTA) -- NATHAN STRAUS, SON OF THE LATE FAMOUS PHILANTHROPIST AND A VICE-PRESIDENT OF THE ZIONIST ORGANIZATION OF AMERICA, WAS APPOINTED YESTERDAY BY PRESIDENT ROOSEVELT AS ADMINISTRATOR OF THE UNITED STATES HOUSING AUTHORITY AND AS SUCH TO DIRECT THE GOVERNMENT'S \$526,000,000 SLUM CLEARANCE PROGRAM.

MR. STRAUS, FORMER STATE SENATOR AND NRA ADMINISTRATOR, WILL RECEIVE A \$10,000 ANNUAL SALARY. HE HAS LONG BEEN AN AUTHORITY ON LOW-COST HOUSING AND SLUM CLEARANCE.

KATZNELSON, PALESTINE EDITOR, HERE FOR POALE-ZION PARLEY

NEW YORK, Oct. 19. (JTA) -- BERL KATZNELSON, EDITOR OF THE HEBREW LABORITE NEWSPAPER, DAVAR, AND A LEADER OF THE PALESTINE JEWISH LABOR MOVEMENT, ARRIVED HERE ON THE QUEEN MARY YESTERDAY AS A GUEST OF THE POALE-ZION ORGANIZATION, WHICH IS HOLDING A CONVENTION IN PHILADELPHIA THIS WEEK.

MR. KATZNELSON, WHO SPENT SOME TIME IN LONDON BEFORE COMING HERE, WAS OPTIMISTIC ABOUT THE FUTURE OF ZIONISM. HE SAID THAT AS A RESULT OF THE MURDER OF DISTRICT COMMISSIONER LEWIS Y. ANDREWS IN PALESTINE, GREAT BRITAIN HAD FOR THE FIRST TIME DIRECTLY AND OPENLY BLAMED THE ARABS FOR TERRORISM, RESULTING IN THE CREATION OF A NEW SITUATION WHICH HE HELD FAVORABLE TO THE JEWS.

FOREST IN PALESTINE TO HONOR REBEKAH KOHUT

NEW YORK, Oct. 19. (JTA) -- ADASSAH ANNOUNCED TODAY THAT A GROVE OF THOUSANDS OF TREES WOULD BE PLANTED ON JEWISH NATIONAL FUND LAND IN PALESTINE IN HONOR OF THE FIFTY-YEAR CAREER IN NEW YORK OF REBEKAH KOHUT, AUTHOR AND SOCIAL WORKER. MRS. IRMA L. LINDHEIM IS CHAIRMAN OF A NATIONAL COMMITTEE LEADING A DRIVE FOR THE PROJECT.

ANTI-JEWISH PROPAGANDA IN FRANCO PRESS REPORTED ABATING

NEW YORK, Oct. 19. (JTA) -- ADVICES RECEIVED HERE TODAY FROM THE SPANISH LOYALIST MINISTRY OF PROPAGANDA BY THE JEWISH FRONTIER, LABORITE PERIODICAL, DECLARE THAT ANTI-JEWISH PROPAGANDA IN THE FRANCO NEWSPAPERS HAS ABATED. ACCORDING TO THE FRONTIER, A LETTER SIGNED MILLY BENNETT SAID THIS WAS A RESULT OF THE PUBLICITY ACCORDED THE PROPAGANDA ABROAD.
