FELIX M. WARBURG DEAD AT 66

NEW YORK, OCT. 20. (JTA) -- FELIX MORITZ WARBURG, JEWISH LEADER, AMERICA'S OUTSTANDING JEWISH PHILANTHROPIST AND A LEADING FINANCIER, DIED OF A HEART ATTACK EARLY THIS AFTERNOON AT HIS HOME, 1109 FIFTH AVENUE, AFTER A FEW DAYS' ILLNESS.

SENIOR PARTNER IN KUHN, LOEB AND COMPANY, MR. WARBURG WAS AN INFLUENTIAL BANKER, BUT HE WAS BETTER KNOWN FOR HIS COUNTLESS BENE-FACTIONS WHICH SUCCORED JEWS IN MANY PARTS OF THE WORLD, AND WHICH HELPED TO FOSTER NUMEROUS BRANCHES OF THE ARTS, SCIENCES AND EDUCATION.

More than a philanthropist, Mr. Warburg played an active part in Jewish affairs, helping to guide the destines of the Jewish Agency for Palestine, the Joint Distribution Committee, the American Jewish Committee, the United Palestine Appeal, and Many other organizations, Jewish and Non-Jewish. The last great public issue in which he was concerned reached a climax last month at the Jewish Agency Council session in Zurich, where he was instrumental in having included in the Political resolution a provision for an effort to make peace with the Arabs without the partition of Palestine.

ONE OF HIS LAST ACTS IN JEWISH AFFAIRS WAS TO ATTEND THE ANN-UAL MEETING OF THE BOARD OF DIRECTORS OF THE JEWISH TELEGRAPHIC AGENCY, OF WHICH HE WAS VICE-CHAIRMAN, HELD ON OCT. 12 AT THE CHATHAM HOTEL.

MR. WARBURG IS SURVIVED BY HIS WIFE, MRS. FRIEDA SCHIFF WARBURG, WHOM HE MARRIED IN 1895; FIVE CHILDREN, MRS. CAROLA WARBURG ROTHSCHILD, FREDERICK M., GERALD F., PAUL F. AND EDWARD M.M.; AND A BROTHER, MAX WARBURG, THE HAMBURG (GERMANY) BANKER.

HE WAS A MEMBER OF CONGREGATION TEMPLE EMANU-EL. HIS CLUBS WERE: BANKERS, BEACH POINT, BOND, BROAD STREET, CENTURY, COUNTRY, CITY ATHLETIC, CITY MIDDAY, EASTERN YACHT, HARMONIE, LOTOS, METROPOLIS, RECESS, NATIONAL ARTS, NATIONAL REPUBLICAN, RUMSON COUNTY, ST. ANDREWS GOLF, TOWN HALL AND WESTCHESTER COUNTRY.

Some of the positions Mr. Warburg held in Jewish Life were: Honorary Chairman of the Joint Distribution Committee, head of the American Section of Council for German Jewry, member of the Executive committee of the American Jewish Committee, Chairman of the United Jewish Appeal in 1934, member of the Jewish Agency Council, and Honorary Chairman of the United Palestine Appeal.

BORN IN HAMBURG, CAME TO U.S. AT 23

MR. WARBURG WAS BORN JAN. 14, 1871, IN HAMBURG, THE SON OF MORITZ AND CHARLOTTE (OPPENHEIM) WARBURG, AND WAS EDUCATED IN HAMBURG SCHOOLS. HIS FAMILY, WHICH HAS BEEN TRACED BACK TO THE SEVENTEENTH CENTURY, HAD RAMIFICATIONS IN AMERICA AND ENGLAND. FELIX WAS ONE OF FIVE SONS. HIS FATHER WAS AN ACTIVE COMMUNAL WORKER.

FELIX M. WARBURG CAME TO THE UNITED STATES WHEN HE WAS 23 YEARS OLD AND BECAME NAT-URALIZED IN 1900 AS A CITIZEN. SHORTLY AFTER HIS ARRIVAL IN AMERICA HE MARRIED FRIEDA SCHIFF, DAUGHTER OF THE LATE BANKER AND PHILANTHROPIST, JACOB, AND IN 1896 JOINED HIS BANKING HOUSE OF KUHN, LOEB AND COMPANY. HIS RISE IN THE FIELD OF FINANCE WAS RAPID.

FROM THE BEGINNING HE DEVOTED MUCH OF HIS ACTIVITY TO SOCIAL WORK. HE INTERESTED HIMBELF IN EAST SIDE WELFARE SOCIETIES, WHICH WERE DEALING WITH THE PROBLEM PRESENTED BY THE GREAT JEWISH IMMIGRATION. HE TOOK AN ACTIVE PART IN THE WORK OF THE EDUCATIONAL ALLIANDE, THE IMMIGRANT EDUCATIONAL INSTITUTION AND THE UNIVERSITY SETTLEMENT. MR. WARBURG WAS THE FOUNDER AND FIRST PRESIDENT OF THE FEDERATION FOR THE SUPPORT OF JEWISH PHILANTHROPIC SOCIETIES AND WAS AT THE TIME OF HIS DEATH CHAIRMAN OF THE BOARD OF TRUSTEES. HE WAS A FOUNDER OF THE JEWISH WELFARE BOARD AND WAS ITS VICE-PRESIDENT. HE WAS A VICE-DIRECTOR AND MEMBER OF THE EXECUTIVE BOARD OF THE JEWISH THEOLOGICAL SEMINARY. HE WAS ALSO RESPONSIBLE FOR THE ESTABLISHMENT OF THE GRADUATE SCHOOL FOR JEWISH SOCIAL WORK AND WAS CLOSELY CONNECTED WITH THE BUREAU OF JEWISH SOCIAL RESEARCH.

LED POST-WAR RELIEF DRIVES

When the World War and post-war distress created the problem of the Jewish war victims in Eastern Europe, and all sections of American Jewry United in Organizing the Joint Distribution Committee for Jewish War Victims, Mr. Warburg was chairman of its administrative committee, overseeing the tremendous job of establishing credit cooperatives, extending relief and helping to train Jewish youth in productive occupations.

THE OPPORTUNITIES FOR SETTLEMENT IN PALESTINE OPENED BY THE BALFOUR DECLARATION AND THE MANDATE FOUND MR. WARBURG, ALTHOUGH A NON-ZIONIST, AN ENTHUSIASTIC SUPPORTER OF THE COLONIZATION. HE VISITED THE HOLY LAND SEVERAL TIMES AND WAS ONE OF THE ORGANIZERS OF THE PALESTINE ECONOMIC CORPORATION. HE PLAYED AN IMPORTANT PART IN THE ORGANIZATION OF THE JEWISH AGENCY, OF WHOSE ADMINISTRATIVE COMMITTEE HE WAS CHAIRMAN, FROM WHICH POSITION HE RESIGNED IN 1930 IN PROTEST AGAINST THE PASSFIELD WHITE PAPER.

"My DEVOTION TO THE JEWISH CAUSE AND TO PALESTINE IS UNABATED," HE STATED ON HIS RESIGNATION, "AND I SHALL CONTINUE TO LEND MY BEST EFFORTS TO SUPPORT OUR WORK, WHICH CHALLENGES OUR DEEPEST INTEREST. TO DEVELOP PALESTINE, ZIONISTS AND NON-ZIONISTS COME TO-GETHER IN A PERIOD OF HOPE AND ENTHUSIASM. THEY WILL UNITE MORE CLOSELY IN THE FACE OF TRAGIC DISAPPOINTMENT."

GIFTS IN 10 YEARS PUT AT \$10,000,000

THE HEBREW UNIVERSITY WAS OF PARTICULAR INTEREST TO MR. WARBURG, AND HE DONATED A HALF MILLION DOLLARS IN GIFTS TO THE INSTITUTION ON MT. SCOPUS. HE HEADED THE AMERICAN ADVISORY COMMITTEE FOR THE UNIVERSITY.

ALTHOUGH EXACT_FIGURES_ON_MRs_WARBURG'S_JOTAL_BENEFACTIONS ARE NOT AVAILABLE,
MANY OF HIS DONATIONS HAVING BEEN_ANONYMOUS, JT_JS_ESTIMATED THAT IN THE DECADE ENDING
1930 HE GAVE TO CHARITABLE CAUSES AT LEAST \$10,000,000.

IN THE PALESTINE PARTITION ISSUE MR. WARBURG WAS A STAUNCH SUPPORTER OF THE PROPOSAL FOR A ROUND-TABLE CONFERENCE BETWEEN ARABS AND JEWS AS THE WAY OUT OF THE DIFFICULTIES IN PALESTINE.

"WE BELIEVE THAT NO LASTING PEACE IN PALESTINE CAN BE OBTAINED UNTIL THE PARTIES DIRECTLY AFFECTED, NAMELY THE ARABS AND THE JEWS, HAVE BEEN GIVEN A FULL OPPORTUNITY TO ENDEAVOR TO ARRIVE AT A PEACEFUL UNDERSTANDING," HE SAID ON LEAVING FOR ZURICH ON AUG. 11.

AND RETURNING ON SEPT. 3, AFTER THE JEWISH AGENCY COUNCIL HAD ADOPTED A RESOLUTION PROVIDING FOR AN EFFORT TO REACH AGREEMENT WITH THE ARABS, AS WELL AS FOR NEGOTIATIONS ON A JEWISH STATE, MR. WARBURG STATED ON BEHALF OF THE AMERICAN NON-ZIONIST DELEGATION THAT THE AGENCY RESOLUTION "WILL SHOW THE WORLD GENERALLY AND THE ARABS IN PARTICULAR THAT WE ARE IN EARNEST IN TRYING TO REACH AN UNDERSTANDING AROUND THE TABLE IF THE BRITISH GOVERNMENT WILL SUGGEST SUCH A CONFERENCE WHICH WILL BRING THE TWO GROUPS TOGETHER."

Mr. Warburg's Philosophy of Jewish Leadership may be summed up in a statement he made in 1930, "I consider myself a servant of the Jewish people and my duty is to help carry out those measures which are wanted by them," he said.

IT WAS IN THIS SPIRIT-THAT HE WENT TO LONDON IN 1936 TO HELP ORGANIZE THE COUNCIL FOR GERMAN JEWRY, OF WHOSE AMERICAN SECTION HE WAS CHAIRMAN.

MR. WARBURG'S INTERESTS WERE WIDE, AND HE COULD HARDLY FIND THE TIME TO DEVOTE TO ALL THE CULTURAL ACTIVITIES TO WHICH HE WOULD HAVE LIKED TO GIVE HIS ATTENTION. HE EXERCISED A CONSIDERABLE INFLUENCE ON THE MUSICAL LIFE OF AMERICA, SERVING AS ONE OF THE FOUNDERS OF THE INSTITUTE OF MUSICAL ART, A SUPPORTER OF THE NEW YORK AND PHILADELPHIA SYMPHOMY ORCHESTRAS AND A FOUNDER OF THE WARBURG QUARTET, IN WHICH HIS SON, GERALD, PLAYED THE 'CELLO

IN 1930, HE WAS AWARDED THE GOTTHEIL MEDAL FOR THE GREATEST SERVICE TO AMERICAN JEWRY, AND HE ALSO RECEIVED IN THE SAME. YEAR ONE OF THE THREE MEDALS FOR "DISTINGUISHED SOCIAL SERVICE TO THE CITY OF NEW YORK" GIVEN BY "BETTER TIMES."

"FELIX M. WARBURG, FINANCIER, PHILANTHROPIST, PATRON OF THE ARTS, A CITIZEN WHOSE HUMANITARIANISM IS WITHOUT FRONTIERS," SAID THE INSCRIPTION.

WORLD LEADERS JOIN IN TRIBUTE

HIGH GOVERNMENT OFFICIALS, JEWISH LEADERS IN EVERY FIELD OF LIFE, AND SCORES OF ORGANIZATIONS, IN MANY COUNTRIES OF THE WORLD, JOINED IN EXPRESSING REGRET AT MR. WARBURG'S PASSING AND VOICING HIGH TRIBUTE TO HIS SERVICE TO HUMANITY.

BRITISH JEWS VOICE GRIEF

LONDON, Oct. 20. (JTA) -- JEWISH LEADERS HERE WERE PROFOUNDLY SHOCKED TODAY AT NEWS OF THE SUDDEN DEATH IN NEW YORK OF FELIX M. WARBURG.

DR. CHAIM WEIZMANN, PRESIDENT OF THE WORLD ZIONIST ORGANIZATION AND THE JEWISH.
AGENCY FOR PALESTINE, WHITH WHOM MR. WARBURG WAS J. N. DISAGREEMENT ON THE ISSUE OF PARTITION
OF PALESTINE, SAID IN A STATEMENT TO THE JEWISH TELEGRAPHIC AGENCY:

"IT IS A TERRIBLE TRAGEDY AND AN IRREPARABLE LOSS TO THE JEWS OF THE WORLD, AMERICAN JEWRY, PALESTINE AND ALL OF HIS FRIENDS, AMONG WHOM I COUNT MYSELF. WE CAN ILL SPARE HIM JUST NOW. HIS DEATH IS A GREAT LOSS TO THE WORLD GENERALLY, NOT ONLY TO THE JEWS. WARBURG WAS A GREAT CITIZEN AND A GREAT JEWS." DR. WEIZMANN CABLED CONDOLENCES TO MRS. WARBURG.

LORD SAMUEL SAID: "I HAVE HEARD WITH THE GREATEST SORROW OF FELIX WARBURG'S SUDDEN DEATH. HE WAS A MAN OF SPLENDID, PUBLIC SPIRIT, UNWEARYING IN SERVICE AND ANIMATED BY THE HIGHEST PHILANTHROPY. HIS DEATH IS A LOSS THAT IS IMMEASURABLE."

Neville Laski, president of the Board of Deputies of British Jews, Declared:
"There is no one in the Jewish world who will not tonight tender respectfully, affectionately, sincerely to Mrs. Warburg and her children, their deepest sympathy."

LEGNARD G. MONTEFIORE, PRESIDENT OF THE ANGLO-JEWISH ASSOCIATION, PAID TRIBUTE TO HIS GENEROSITY AND SINCERITY BOTH IN JEWISH AND NON-JEWISH CAUSES, SAYING, "HE TOOK THE MIDDLE PATH IN ITS BEST SENSE. HE WAS GENEROUS AND COURTEOUS TO BOTH FRIENDS AND OPPONENTS."

POLISH ORGANIZATIONS TO HOLD SERVICES

WARSAW, Oct. 20. (JTA) -- FELIX M. WARBURG'S DEATH DEEPLY SHOCKED ALL JEWISH CIRCLES PARTICULARLY SOCIAL WORKERS. A MEETING OF THE CENTRAL COMMITTEE OF THE JEWISH FREE LOAN BANKS WAS SUSPENDED. CONDOLENCES WERE CABLED TO THE JOINT DISTRIBUTION COMMITTEE OFFICES IN PARIS AND NEW YORK. ALL JEWISH ORGANIZATIONS AND INSTITUTIONS WILL HOLD MEMORIAL SERVICES TOMORROW.

GOVERNOR LEHMAN

ALBANY, Oct. 20. (JTA) -- GOVERNOR HERBERT LEHMAN MADE THE FOLLOWING STATEMENT:

"I AM SHOCKED AND GRIEVED BEYOND WORDS TO HEAR OF THE UNTIMELY DEATH OF ONE OF MY DEAREST FRIENDS -- FELIX WARBURG. HE WAS ONE OF MY BELOVED FRIENDS AND I TOOK DEEP PRIDE IN HIS FRIENDSHIP. FOR MORE THAN THIRTY YEARS I HAVE BEEN PRIVILEGED TO WORK WITH

HIM IN CLOSEST ASSOCIATION IN CIVIC, CHARITABLE AND RELIGIOUS ACTIVITIES. HE WAS IN EVERY WAY A WONDERFUL MAN, A GREAT AMERICAN AND A GREAT JEW, BELOVED AND RESPECTED BY ALL WHO KNEW HIM. HE WAS LOYAL, DEVOTED, GENEROUS AND UNTIRING IN SUPPORT OF ALL WORTH WHILE MOVEMENTS WITHOUT REGARD TO RACE, COLOR OR CREFO. NEW YORK HAS LOST ONE OF ITS FOREMOST SONS AND THE WORLD AN OUTSTANDING AND IRREPLACEABLE CHARACTER. I CANNOT EXPRESS THE GREAT PERSONAL LOSS I HAVE SUSTAINED IN HIS PASSING."

DR. CYRUS ADLER

PHILADELPHIA, Oct. 20. (JTA) .-- Dr. Cyrus Adler, president of the American Jewish Committee, stated: "The death of Felix M. Warburg is a great blow to all Israel and to Innumerable Public causes. In Philanthropy, Learning, Education, music and art. For nearly a generation, and without any dissent, his leadership in American Israel has been accepted, and he was a worlo-wide figure. I am so overcome at this sad news that I cannot at the moment adequately estimate his numerous and great public labors. My deepest sympathy goes to his family, and they know that I share their grief. Felix Warburg has been my friend for over forty years. The world will be a poorer place for me without him."

MAYOR LAGUARDIA

MAYOR LAGUARDIA'S STATEMENT FOLLOWS: "I AM SADDENED TO HEAR OF THE UNTIMELY DEATH OF FELIX WARBURG. WE WERE CLOSE FRIENDS FOR MANY YEARS. HIS INTEREST AND DEVOTION TO ART CONTRIBUTED GREATLY TO THE ARTISTIC DEVELOPMENT OF OUR CITY. MR. WARBURG WAS SOCIALLY MINDED AND EVERY WORTHWHILE CAUSE MET HIS IMMEDIATE AND GENEROUS RESPONSE. THE CITY HAS LOST A DISTINGUISHED CITIZEN, AND HE LEAVES A LARGE CIRCLE OF FRIENDS WHO ADMINED AND LOVED HIM.

DR. STEPHEN S. WISE

DR. STEPHEN S. WISE, PRESIDENT OF THE ZIONIST ORGANIZATION OF AMERICA, SAID IN PART: "IT IS DIFFICULT TO SPEAK IN TERMS OF MODERATION OF FELIX WARBURG. HE WAS SUCH AN OUTSTANDING FIGURE IN THE WORLD WHICH HE SERVED WITH GENEROSITY, WITH PERSONAL KINDLINESS AND WITH GENUINE GRACE THAT HIS PASSING MEANS A TRULY GREAT LOSS. FELIX WARBURG LOVED THE BEST AND HIGHEST IN LIFE IN THE ARTS AND IN THE REALM OF HUMAN SERVICE. ART, MUSIC, OUR CITY, OUR COUNTRY AND WORLD ISRAEL ARE THE POORER FOR THE PASSING OF WARBURG, WHOSE MEMORY WILL NOT BE SUFFERED TO DIE OUT OF THE HEART OF HUMANITY."

DR. MAURICE J. KARPF

DR. MAURICE J. KARPF, HEAD OF THE GRADUATE SCHOOL FOR JEWISH SOCIAL WORK, SAID IN A STATEMENT: "I DARE NOT BEGIN TO THINK WHAT THE DEATH OF THIS ONE MAN MAY MEAN TO COUNTLESS ORGANIZATIONS, MOVEMENTS AND PERSONS IN THIS COMMUNITY AND THROUGHOUT THE WORLD. I CAN THINK OF NO ONE WHOSE ACTIVITY COVERS SUCH A WIDE SPHERE AS DID THAT OF MR. WARBURG THE CIVIC, ARTISTIC, EDUCATIONAL, PHILANTHROPIC AND OTHER PROBLEMS ON WHICH HE WORKED AND TOWARD WHICH HE MADE PROFOUND CONTRIBUTIONS WILL ALL BE SEVERELY AFFECTED BY HIS PASSING. SOME MAY NEVER SURVIVE THE LOSS."

UNITED PALESTINE APPEAL

THE OFFICERS OF THE UNITED PALESTINE APPEAL ADOPTED A RESOLUTION, WHICH SAID IN PART: "THE UNITED PALESTINE APPEAL IS DISMAYED BY THE NEWS OF THE DEATH OF FELIX M. WARBURG, GREAT-HEARTED AMERICAN AND JEW. THE CAUSE OF THE UPBUILDING OF THE JEWISH NATIONAL HOME DERIVED GREAT STRENGTH FROM THE DEVOTED SERVICE OF MR. WARBURG, WHOSE PROFOUND COMPASSION WAS TOUCHED BY THE PLIGHT OF MILLIONS OF JEWS OVERSEAS SEEKING A HAVEN OF SECURITY."

PAUL BAERWALD

PAUL BARRWALD, CHAIRMAN OF THE JOINT DISTRIBUTION COMMITTEE, SAID IN A STATEMENT:
"ONLY THOSE WHO WORKED CLOSELY WITH FELIX WARBURG WILL EVER BE ABLE TO APPRECIATE FULLY
THE EXTENT AND VARIETY OF HIS ACTIVITIES AND THE FULL MEANING OF HIS WORK. THE AMERICAN
JEWISH JOINT DISTRIBUTION COMMITTEE, REPRESENTING THOUSANDS OF BENEFICIARIES ABROAD AND
THOUSANDS OF CONTRIBUTIONS TO ITS FUNDS IN THE UNITED STATES, WILL NEVER FORGET THE EPOCHMAKING CONTRIBUTION OF FELIX WARBURG TO EVERY PHASE OF OUR SERVICE, AND THEIR DEVOTION
AND LOVE FOR HIM WILL LAST LONG BEYOND THEIR PRESENT GENERATION. OUR SENSE OF LOSS IS
GREAT BEYOND WORDS."

HERBERT BAYARD SWOPE SENT THE FOLLOWING TELEGRAM TO MRS. WARBURG: "I AM SHOCKED AT THE BLOW WHICH HAS FALLEN UPON YOU AND UPON THE ENTIRE COMMUNITY IN THE DEATH OF YOUR HUBBAND. ALWAYS IMPORTANT IN THE LIFE OF THE NATION, HE WAS NEVER MORE SO THAN AT THIS MOMENT. HIS KINDLINESS, HIS HONOR, HIS WISDOM AND HIS BROAD UNDERSTANDING GAVE HIM AN EQUIPMENT THAT FEW HAVE EQUALLED. MY WIFE AND I SEND YOU AND YOUR CHILDREN OUR DEEP SYMPATHY.

MRS. EDWARD JACOBS

MRS. EDWARD JACOBS, NATIONAL PRESIDENT OF HADASSAH, SAID: "THE DEATH OF FELIX M. WARBURG, WHO WAS REGARDED FOR YEARS AS A FOREMOST LEADER OF AMERICAN JEWRY, IS A TRAGIC LOSS TO THE JEWISH PEOPLE....HIS CONSTANT STRIVING TO BRING TOGETHER ZIONISTS AND NON-ZIONISTS IN THE COMMON TASK OF BUILDING THE JEWISH HOMELAND WILL UNDOUBTEDLY BE REGARDED AS ONE OF HIS MOST CONSTRUCTIVE ENDEAVORS."

B.C. VLADECK

B. C. VLADECK, CHAIRMAN OF THE JEWISH LABOR COMMITTEE: "FELIX WARBURG'S DEATH IS A REAL BLOW TO THE JEWISH COMMUNITY OF NEW YORK AND THE COUNTRY AT LARGE. SCATTERED DISORDERS KEEP TENSION HIGH IN HOLY LAND

JERUSALEM, Oct. 20. (JTA) -- SCATTERED DISORDERS CONTINUED TODAY TO KEEP TENSION HIGH THROUGHOUT PALESTINE.

TROOPS REMOVED A BARRICADE PLACED ACROSS THE TEL AVIV ROAD. JERUSALEM'S SLAUGHTER-HOUSE WAS FIRED UPON, AND ELEVEN OXEN WERE KILLED.

A BOMB, EVIDENTLY INTENDED FOR A JEWISH GROCERY IN THE SHIMON HAZADIK QUARTER OF JERUSALEM, EXPLODED PREMATURELY, BLOWING OFF THE HAND OF THE ARAB THROWING IT.

A BOMB WAS HURLED AT THE SAFED POLICE STATION, BUT DID NOT EXPLODE. A GIRLS' SCHOOL AT ÁFULEH AND AMERICAN-OWNED STONE QUARRIES AT MOTZA WERE FIRED UPON. JEWISH WORKERS REPAIRING TELEPHONE LINES, AND ALSO A JEWISH BUS PASSING RAMALLAH WERE MADE TARGETS FOR ÁRAB SHOTS.

Police prepared to seize produce and other property in the village of Dahariya unless the first installment of a \$10,000 fine, imposed in punishment for the attack on a police post Monday, is paid.

THE DISTRICT COMMISSIONER WARNED JEWISH COLONIES IN THE SHARON PLAIN THAT THEY WOUL BE HELD RESPONSIBLE FOR SABOTAGE IN THE VICINITY. REPRESENTATIVES OF THE COLONIES DENIED RESPONSIBILITY FOR THE SABOTAGE.

NAZ'I PRESS ASSAILS BRITISH "VIOLENCE" IN PALESTINE

BERLIN, OCT. 20. (JTA) -- THE REICH PRESS HEATEDLY ACCUSED GREAT BRITAIN TONIGHT OF UNNECESSARY VIOLENCE IN ITS REPRESSION OF ARAB TERRORISM IN THE HOLY LAND, THE HAVAS NEWS AGENCY REPORTED.

POLISH EDUCATOR - SENATOR BALKS AT "GHETTO BENCHES" IN HIS CLASS

WARSAW, OCT. 20. (JTA) -- ANTI-SEMITIC CIRCLES WERE INDIGNANT TODAY AT REFUSAL OF SENATOR PROF. MIECZYSLAW MICHALOWICZ, DIRECTOR OF THE CHILDREN'S DISEASES CLINIC AT PILSUDSKI UNIVERSITY, TO INTRODUCE "GHETTO BENCHES" IN HIS CLASSROOM. PROF. MICHALOWICZ' LECTURE ROOM IN THE CLINIC IS THE ONLY ONE IN THE UNIVERSITY WHERE SEGREGATION OF JEWISH STUDENTS, SANCTIONED BY THE GOVERNMENT, HAS NOT BEEN INSTITUTED.

EXPLAINING HIS STAND BEFORE A LECTURE TODAY, PROF. MICHALOWICZ DECLARED:

"THE RECTOR, AS HEAD OF THE UNIVERSITY ELECTED BY ALL THE PROFESSORS, MAY HAVE HIS OWN VIEWS, BUT I, AS A SENATOR OF THE POLISH REPUBLIC, HAVE TAKEN AN OATH TO ABIDE BY THE CONSTITUTION AND I REFUSE TO VIOLATE IT."

NATIONALIST NEWSPAPERS EXPRESSED INDIGNATION AT HIS ATTITUDE, CHARGING PROF. MICHALOWICZ WITH CHALLENGING NOT ONLY THE RECTOR BUT THE GOVERNMENT AS WELL. THE SENATOR IS AN OLD-TIME DEMOCRAT AND WAS A FRIEND OF THE LATE MARSHAL PILSUDSKI.

"GHETTO" MARKETS STARTED IN DANZIG

DANZIG, Oct. 20. (JTA) -- DANZIG'S NAZI AUTHORITIES ARE SYSTEMATICALLY PURSUING THEIR ANTI-CATHOLIC AND ANTI-SEMITIC CAMPAIGN, THE HAVAS NEWS AGENCY REPORTED TODAY.

"GHETTO" RESTRICTIONS WERE PLACED ON ALL MARKET PLACES, WITH SPECIAL STANDS SET ASIDE FOR JEWISH PEASANTS AND DEALERS. BLACKSHIRTED NAZI POLICE PICKETED JEWISH SHOPS, PHOTOGRAPHING ALL CUSTOMERS WHO ENTERED.

RABBI H. PEREIRA MENDES DIES AT 85; FOUNDED SPANISH CONGREGATION

NEW YORK, Oct. 21. (JTA) -- HENRY PEREIRA MENDES, RABBI EMERITUS OF THE SPANISH AND PORTUGUESE SYNAGOGUE, DIED TODAY AT HIS WESTCHESTER HOME AT THE AGE OF 85. HE WAS ONE OF THE FOUNDERS OF THE CONGREGATION IN 1886.

BORN IN BIRMINGHAM, ENGLAND, HE OCCUPIED A PULPIT THERE BEFORE COMING TO THE UNITED STATES. HE HELD IMPORTANT POSITIONS WITH THE JEWISH THEOLOGICAL SEMINARY AND THE RABBINICAL COLLEGE, WAS A FOUNDER OF THE NEW YORK BOARD OF JEWISH MINISTERS AND A PAST PRESIDENT OF THE UNION OF ORTHODOX JEWISH CONGREGATIONS. HE WAS AUTHOR OF SEVERAL BOOKS.
