ORMSBY-GORE BACKS CURBS ON ARABS; TELLS HOUSE NEW COMMISSION AWAITS PEACE

LONDON, OCT. 21. (JTA) -- THE BRITISH GOVERNMENT TODAY BACKED THE STRINGENT MEASURES TAKEN BY ITS PALESTINE ADMINISTRATION TO SUPPRESS ARAB TERRORISM AND OUTLINED FUTURE PLANS FOR EFFECTING A TRIPARTITE DIVISION OF THE HOLY LAND.

THE NEW COMMISSION WHICH WILL BE SENT TO PALESTINE TO FORMULATE A CONCRETE PARTITION SCHEME WILL NOT BE APPOINTED UNTIL ORDER IS COMPLETELY RESTORED, WILLIAM G.A. ORMSBY-GORE, COLONIAL SECRETARY, INFORMED COMMONS, WHICH CONVENED AFTER A THREE-MONTH RECESS.

REPLYING TO A QUESTION BY GEOFFREY MANDER, LIBERAL, MR. ORMSBY-GORE STATED:

"IN VIEW OF THE RESOLUTIONS OF THE COUNCIL AND THE ASSEMBLY OF THE LEAGUE OF NATIONS, HIS MAJESTY'S GOVERNMENT REGARD THEMSELVES FREE TO UNDERTAKE THE INVESTIGAT—TONS REQUIRED FOR THE PURPOSE OF WORKING OUT A SCHEME OF TRIPARTITE PARTITION OF PALESTING ON THE LINES RECOMMENDED BY THE ROYAL COMMISSION.

"ACCORDINGLY, IT IS PROPOSED TO APPOINT IN DUE COURSE A FURTHER SPECIAL BODY TO SUBMIT PROPOSALS AFTER A LOCAL ENQUIRY FOR A DETAILED SCHEME OF TRIPARTITE PARTITION. THE COUNCIL AND ASSEMBLY WILL BE INVITED TO APPROVE SUCH A SCHEME."

REFERRING TO THE RECRUDESCENCE OF TERRORISM IN SEPTEMBER IN PALESTINE, THE COLON-IAL SECRETARY SAID THAT PROMPT AND FIRM ACTION HAVE BEEN TAKEN TO DEAL WITH POLITICAL ORGANIZATIONS, WHICH HELD MAINLY RESPONSIBLE FOR THESE CRIMES AND OUTRAGES.

"I AM SURE THE HOUSE WILL AGREE THAT THE IMMEDIATE AND PRIMARY DUTY OF THE GOVERNMENT AND OF THE PALESTINE ADMINISTRATION IS TO TAKE THE MOST STRENUOUS MEASURES TO CONQUER TERRORISM, PROTECT THE LIVES OF BRITISH OFFICERS AND RESTORE THE EFFECTIVE AUTHORITY OF THE CIVIL BRITISH ADMINISTRATION THROUGHOUT PALESTINE," Mr. ORNSY-GORE SAID.

HE REFUSED TO GIVE A DEFINITE ANSWER TO A QUESTION FROM THE FLOOR AS TO WHETHER THE RECOMMENDATIONS OF THE NEW COMMISSION WOULD BE SUBMITTED TO A JOINT PARLIAMENTARY COMMITTEE. HE LIMITED HIMSELF TO DECLARING THAT THE COMMISSION WOULD NOT BE APPOINTED UNTIL ORDER WAS RESTORED.

REPLYING TO A QUESTION BY ANEURIN BEVAN, LABORITE, MR. ORMSBY-GORE SAID THE MILITARY AUTHORITIES IN PALESTINE HAVE THE FULLEST SUPPORT OF THE BRITISH GOVERNMENT IN ITS REPRISALS AGAINST ARABS. HE DECLARED HIMSELF SATISFIED THAT HAJ AMIN EL HUSSEINI, THE MUFTI OF JERUSALEM, HAD BEEN OPERATING AGAINST BRITAIN DURING HIS WHOLE PERIOD IN OFFICE.

INSPECTOR-GENERAL SAUNDERS OF THE NIGERIA POLICE HAS BEEN APPOINTED INSPECTOR-GENERAL OF POLICE AND PRISONS IN PALESTINE, THE COLONIAL SECRETARY ANNOUNCED, TO REPLACE ROY G.B. SPICER. SIR CHARLES TREGART, FORMERLY OF THE INDIA POLICE, WILL GO TO PALESTINE ON A TEMPORARY MISSION TO ADVISE THE GOVERNMENT ON POLICE ORGANIZATION.

PALESTINE SETS POLITICAL LIMITS ON IMMIGRATION; JEWS CLASSIFIED AS "FOREIGNERS"

JERUSALEM, Oct. 21. (JTA) -- HEBREW NEWSPAPERS AND ZIONIST CIRCLES EXPRESSED IN-DIGNATION TODAY OVER A LONG-EXPECTED ORDINANCE PROMULGATED IN THE OFFICIAL PALESTINE GAZ-FITE EMPOWERING THE BRITISH HIGH COMMISSIONER TO SET POLITICAL LIMITS ON IMMIGRATION.

THE ORDINANCE, WHICH WAS ISSUED IN LINE WITH THE ROYAL COMMISSION'S RECOMMENDATIONS ON PALESTINE, ALSO CHANGES THE DEFINITION OF A DEPENDENT AND RESTRICTS THE NUMBER OF INHABITANTS' RELATIVES ALLOWED TO ENTER THE COUNTRY. RELATIVES UNDER EIGHTEEN YEARS OF AGE WILL PERMANENTLY BE CONSIDERED IN THE CATEGORY OF DEPENDENTS.

THE HIGH COMMISSIONER IS AUTHORIZED TO PRESCRIBE A MAXIMUM AGGREGATE NUMBER OF "FOREIGN" IMMIGRANTS FOR ANY PERIOD; SECONDLY, TO ESTABLISH CATEGORIES OF IMMIGRANTS, FIX-ING THE MAXIMUM IN EACH CATEGORY; THIRDLY, TO ESTABLISH A JEWISH PROPORTION OF THE MAXIMUM AND TO FIX MAXIMUMS IN EACH CATEGORY OF JEWS.

THE GOVERNMENT DIRECTOR OF IMMIGRATION IS TO DECIDE IN CASES WHERE A DISPUTE ARISES OVER WHETHER OR NOT A PERSON IS JEWISH.

IT WAS POINTED OUT THAT THIS ORDINANCE FOR THE FIRST TIME OFFICIALLY CHANGES THE BASIS FOR IMMIGRATION FROM THE PRINCIPLE OF "ECONOMIC ABSORPTIVE CAPACITY" LAID DOWN BY THE BRITISH GOVERNMENT IN THE EARLY DAYS OF THE PALESTINE MANDATE TO A POLITICAL PRINCIPLE.

COMMENTING ON THE ORDINANCE, THE PALESTINE POST STRESSED THAT IN THIS DECREE FOR THE FIRST TIME SINCE THE CREATION OF THE JEWISH NATIONAL HOME AND IN THE HISTORY OF THE BRITISH MANDATE, JEWS ARE DESCRIBED AS "FOREIGNERS."

2 JEWISH GOVERNMENT OFFICIALS SERIOUSLY WOUNDED

JERUSALEM, Oct. 21. (JTA) -- Two Jewish Government officials were seriously wounded by Arab terrorists today as sporadic disorders, aimed against the British Proposal to Partition Palestine and rigorous repressive measures against Arab agitators, entered their second week.

AVINDAM YELLIN, A GOVERNMENT EDUCATION INSPECTOR, WAS SHOT THIS MORNING AS HE WAS ENTERING HIS OFFICES AT MT. ZION. HE IS THE SON OF DAVID YELLIN, PROFESSOR OF HEBREW POETRY AT THE HEBREW UNIVERSITY HERE.

DETECTIVE SHITREET WAS SHOT IN THE BEDROOM OF HIS HOME AT HAIFA.

AN ARMED ARAB BAND ATTACKED A POLICE STATION AT ABUGOSH, NEAR JERUSALEM. ANOTHER BAND BARRICADED THE JERUSALEM-TEL AVIV ROAD AT BAB-EL-WAD AND FOUGHT AN ENGAGEMENT WITH POLICE. NO CASUALTIES WERE REPORTED.

THE TOWN OF GAZA WAS NOTIFIED BY THE DISTRICT OFFICER THAT A PUNITIVE POLICE POST OF 25 WILL BE ESTABLISHED THERE AT ITS EXPENSE IN CONNECTION WITH THE MINING OF RAILWAYS. THE OFFICER WARNED THAT REPETITION OF SABOTAGE WOULD RESULT IN DYNAMITING OF THE HOMES OF ARAB NOTABLES.

NON-JEWS JOIN WORLD JEWRY IN MOURNING WARBURG'S PASSING; FUNERAL TODAY

NEW YORK, Oct. 21. (JTA) -- Newspapers, Jewish and non-Jewish organizations and leaders in all walks of life today eulogized Felix M. Warburg, who died yesterday at the age of 66, for his contributions in behalf of the Jews, Finance and the arts.

FUNERAL SERVICES WILL BE HELD AT 10 O'CLOCK TOMORROW MORNING AT TEMPLE EMANU-EL WITH RABBI SAMUEL H. GOLDENSON OFFICIATING AND DR. SAMUEL SCHULMAN, RABBI EMERITUS OF THE TEMPLE, PARTICIPATING. A CAPACITY CROWD OF 2,400 IS EXPECTED TO ATTEND. HIS FOUR SONS AND PERHAPS OTHER CLOSE RELATIVES WILL BE THE PALLBEARERS. PRIVATE BURIAL SERVICES WILL BE HELD AT SALEM FIELD, CYPRESS HILLS, BROOKLYN.

MANY JEWISH ORGANIZATIONS WILL BE CLOSED FOR ALL OR PART OF THE DAY. THE JOINT DISTRIBUTION COMMITTEE, THE AMERICAN JEWISH COMMITTEE, THE NEW YORK FEDERATION FOR THE SUPPORT OF JEWISH PHILANTHROPIC SOCIETIES AND THE PALESTINE ECONOMIC CORPORATION WILL BE CLOSED ALL DAY. THE ZIONIST ORGANIZATION OF AMERICA, THE UNITED PALESTINE APPEAL AND THE JEWISH NATIONAL FUND WILL REMAIN CLOSED FOR AN HOUR IN THE MORNING AND HOLD JOINT MEMORIAL SERVICES.

TRIBUTE TO MR. WARBURG WAS PAID BY DAVID WERTHEIM, SECRETARY OF THE POALE ZION-ZEIRE ZION, AT THE ORGANIZATIONS ANNUAL CONVENTION IN PHILADELPHIA.

THE New York Times said in an editorial on Mr. Warburg: "He was a bond between the East and the West, a bridge between divergent views, a brother to millions in distress, and especially those of his own ancestral lineage."

THE HERALD TRIBUNE SAID, "THE FINANCIAL COMMUNITY AND THE COUNTRY AT LARGE ARE MUCH THE POORER FOR THE DEATH OF MR. WARBURG."

THE NEW YORK SUN SAID, "HE HAS LEFT A PLACE NOT READILY FILLED IN THE COMMUNITY, BUT HIS EXAMPLE SHOULD REMAIN A SOURCE OF INSPIRATION."

YIDDISH NEWSPAPERS, THE DAY, THE FORWARD AND THE MORNING JOURNAL, DEVOTED THE LARGER PART OF THEIR EDITIONS TO EDITORIALS AND FEATURE ARTICLES ON HIS MANIFOLD ACTIVITIES AND INTERESTS.

Scores of messages of condolence continued, meanwhile, to be sent to his home, and statements of tribute were made public by many persons and organizations.

NATIONAL CONFERENCE OF JEWS AND CHRISTIANS

A TRIBUTE TO THE WORK OF MR. FELIX M. WARBURG IN THE CAUSE OF BETTER UNDERSTANDING AMONG THE VARIOUS RELIGIOUS AND RACIAL GROUPS IN THIS COUNTRY WAS PAID BY THE CO-CHAIRMEN OF THE NATIONAL CONFERENCE OF JEWS AND CHRISTIANS IN A MESSAGE SENT TO MRS. WARBURG. THE MESSAGE, SIGNED BY HON. NEWTON D. BAKER, GENERAL CHAIRMAN, PROF. CARLTON J. H. HAYES, CATHOLIC CO-CHAIRMAN AND ROGER W. STRAUS, JEWISH CO-CHAIRMAN, SAID:

"IN THE DEATH OF MR. FELIX M. WARBURG THE CAUSE OF UNDERSTANDING, TOLERATION, AND JUSTICE AMONG DIFFERING RACIAL AND RELIGIOUS GROUPS THROUGHOUT THE WORLD HAS SUFFERED AN IRREPARABLE LOSS. HIS WISE COUNSEL, ACTIVE EFFORT AND GENEROUS SUPPORT WERE POTENT AND DEPENDABLE FACTORS IN THE PROMOTION OF WHOLESOME HUMAN RELATIONS AMONG PROTESTANTS, CATHOLICS AND JEWS IN AMERICA AND WERE THE REFLECTION OF A CHARACTER SINGULARLY FREE FROM DISFIGURING PREJUDICE AND BIGOTRY."

JEWISH WELFARE BOARD

IRVING LEHMAN, ASSOCIATE JUSTICE OF THE NEW YORK COURT OF APPEALS, AND PRESIDENT OF THE JEWISH WELFARE BOARD, ISSUED THE FOLLOWING STATEMENT: "FOR MANY YEARS WE WORKED TOGETHER IN CLOSEST CO-OPERATION. HIS BROAD SYMPATHIES MADE HIM AN ACTIVE AND INSPIRING LEADER IN MANY FIELDS, BUT I BELIEVE THAT HIS DEEPEST AND MOST ABIDING INTEREST WAS IN YOUNG MEN AND WOMEN. THE JEWISH WELFARE BOARD IS THE RESULT OF HIS FINE EFFORTS TO ENLIST COMMUNAL RESOURCES TO HELP THEM. I MOURN HIM AS A GREAT LEADER, BUT I MOURN HIM EVEN MORE AS A LOVED FRIEND."

MORRIS ROTHENBERG

MAGISTRATE MORRIS ROTHENBERG, CO-CHAIRMAN OF THE COUNCIL OF THE JEWISH AGENCY AND A NATIONAL CHAIRMAN OF THE UNITED PALESTINE APPEAL, SAID: "IT WAS LARGELY THE HOLD WHICH MR. WARBURG HAD UPON HIS FOLLOWING THAT KEPT NON-ZIONIST FORCES BY THE SIDE OF ZIONIST LEADERSHIP IN TIMES OF CRISES. MR. WARBURG WAS THE GREATEST SINDLE UNIFYING PERSONALITY IN AMERICAN JEWISH LIFE. THE SPIRIT OF COOPERATION WHICH HE AWAKENED IN THE AMERICAN JEWISH COMMUNITY WILL BE AN ENDURING MONUMENT TO HIS MEMORY."

LAUDED IN PALESTINE AS FRIEND OF HOMELAND

JERUSALEM, OCT. 21. (JTA) -- BLACK-BORDERED HEBREW NEWSPAPERS ANNOUNCED TO PALESTINE TODAY THE DEATH OF FELIX M. WARBURG, AND THROUGHOUT THE COUNTRY HE WAS EULOGIZED AS A FRIEND OF THE JEWISH HOMELAND. A FLAG DROOPED AT HALF-STAFF OVER THE OFFICES OF THE JEWISH AGENCY, WHICH MR. WARBURG HELPED TO FOUND IN 1929, AND THE AGENCY HALTED ITS ACTIVITIES AT NOON TO HOLD MEMORIAL SERVICES.

DR. KURT BLUMENFELD, FORMER PRESIDENT OF THE GERMAN ZIONIST FEDERATION, LAUDED THE PHILANTHROPIST AT A PRESS CONFERENCE OF THE PALESTINE FOUNDATION FUND, WHICH HAD BEEN AIDED BY COUNTLESS GIFTS FROM MR. WARBURG. THE NEWSPAPERMEN PRESENT ROSE IN TRIBUTE TO HIM.

THE HEBREW LABORITE DAILY, DAVAR, DECLARED HIS DEATH "IS A GREAT SHOCK, AND A LOSS TO THE JEWISH PEOPLE, THE JEWISH AGENCY AND THE UPBUILDING OF PALESTINE, ESPECIALLY

IN THESE HARD DAYS." HARRETZ SAID, "IT IS UNBELIEVABLE THAT THIS BIG, WARM HEART, RESPONDING TO HIS DEPRESSED BRETHREN'S AGONY, IS STOPPED. IT IS NO ACCIDENT THAT HE WAS AN ON-ZIONIST, BUT ALSO NO ACCIDENT THAT HE WAS ON OF THE FOUNDERS OF THE JEWISH AGENCY, BECAUSE HE WHOLEHEARTEDLY DESIRED TO ASSIST IN THE BUILDING OF THE JEWISH NATIONAL HOME." HABOKER STATED, "PALESTINE WILL CERTAINLY MISS ONE OF THE JEWISH AGENCY'S PILLARS AND FRIENDS."

MAGNES IN TEARS

THE HEBREW UNIVERSITY HELD A MEMORIAL MEETING, ATTENDED BY THE ENTIRE STUDENT BODY AND ALL FACULTY MEMBERS. PRESIDENT JUDAN L. MAGNES, WEEPING, DELIVERED THE EULOGY. HE SAID: "I AM PHYSICALLY UNABLE TO EULOGIZE A MAN WITH WHOSE SOUL I HAVE BEEN BOUND FOR DECADES. I WISH TO REMIND OUR STUDENTS THAT BUT FOR HIS AND HIS WIFE'S MUNIFICENCE, THE HEBREW UNIVERSITY WOULD NOT EXIST TODAY, AT LEAST IN ITS PRESENT STATE. THEY NOT ONLY GAVE MORE THAN ANYBODY, THEY UNDERSTOOD THE UNIVERSITY'S IDEA! ONE THING IS CERTAIN -- WARBURG'S SPIRIT IS EVERLASTINGLY UNITED TO THE HEBREW UNIVERSITY."

THE MEMORIAL MEETING AT THE HEADQUARTERS OF THE JEWISH AGENCY FOR PALESTINE WAS ATTENDED BY MEMBERS OF THE AGENCY EXECUTIVE, THE JEWISH NATIONAL COUNCIL, THE HEBREW UNIVERSITY, VARIOUS FUND REPRESENTATIVES AND OTHER ORGANIZATION LEADERS. SPEAKERS INCLUDED DR. MAURICE HEXTER, DR. WERNER SENATOR, DR. ARTHUR RUPPIN. A CANTOR INTONED EL MOLEI RACHMIM, PRAYER FOR THE DEAD.

THE MUNICIPAL COUNCIL OF TEL AVIV CABLED CONDOLENCES TO THE WARBURG FAMILY.

J.D.C. OFFICES IN EUROPE CLOSED

PARIS, Oct. 21. (JTA) -- OFFICES OF THE JOINT DISTRIBUTION COMMITTEE HERE AND IN OTHER EUROPEAN CAPITALS, INCLUDING MOSCOW, WERE CLOSED TODAY IN MOURNING FOR FELIX M. WARBURG, ONE OF THE COMMITTEE'S FOUNDERS AND ITS HONDRARY CHAIRMAN. THE OFFICES IN MOSCOW AND OTHER CITIES WERE ORDERED TO KEEP CLOSED UNTIL AFTER THE FUNERAL SERVICES FRIDAY. TELEGRAMS OF CONDOLENCE ARE POURING INTO THE J.D.C. OFFICES HERE FROM POLAND, RUMANIA, AUSTRIA, CZECHOSLOVAKIA AND OTHER COUNTRIES.

MEMORIAL SERVICES IN WARSAW

W.SAW, Oct. 21. (JTA) -- MEMORIAL SERVICES FOR FELIX M. WARBURG WERE HELD HERE TODAY WITH JEWISH PARLIAMENTARIANS AND REPRESENTATIVES OF ALL JEWISH ORGANIZATIONS IN ATTENDANCE. CHIEF RABBI SENATOR MOSES SCHORR PRESIDED.

HEBREW U. OPENS 13TH YEAR; DR. KAPLAN TAKES EDUCATION POST

JERUSALEM, Oct. 21. (JTA) -- Dr. Mordecai M. Kaplan, on Leave from the Jewish Theological Seminary of New York, was inducted yesterday as Professor of the Philosophy of Education at the Hebrew University on Mount Scopus.

PROFESSOR KAPLAN, A LEADER OF THE SOCIETY FOR THE ADVANCEMENT OF JUDAISM IN NEW YORK AND A FORMER PRESIDENT OF THE ZIONIST ORGANIZATION OF AMERICA, DELIVERED THE CONCLUDING ADDRESS AT CEREMONIES MARKING THE OPENING OF THE UNIVERSITY'S THIRTEENTH YEAR.

Dr. Judah L. Magnes, president of the university, announced that the French Government was considering offering a grant for establishment of a chair of French Literature, and also two prizes.

ZALMAN SCHOCKEN, CHAIRMAN OF THE UNIVERSITY'S EXECUTIVE COUNCIL, ANNOUNCED THAT THE INSTITUTION'S BUDGET HAD BEEN BALANCED. THE BOARD OF GOVERNORS DID NOT MEET THIS YEAR BECAUSE OF THE POLITICAL SITUATION, HE SAID, ADDING THAT THE NEXT MEETING WOULD BE HELD IN PAIRSTINE.

DR. HUGO BERGMANN, RECTOR, REPORTED ON THE UNIVERSITY'S DEVELOPMENT AND GREETED THE NEW STUDENTS. THE ASSEMBLY ASSE IN MEMORY OF THE LATE THOMAS MASARYK, FOUNDER OF THE CZECHOSLOVAKIAN REPUBLIC, AFTER AS HAD BEEN EULOGIZED BY DR. MAGNES.

RUMANIAN LEADER HITS AT PROPOSED LEAGUE ACTION ON MINORITIES ISSUES

BUCHAREST, Oct. 21. (JTA) -- Warning against proposed League of Nations intervention in Rumanian internal affairs, as regards protection of minorities, was sounded today during an election speech at Cluj by Valerius Pop. Minister of Industry and Commerce.

DISCUSSING HIS PLANS FOR THE PROMOTION OF THE LABOR INTERESTS OF "PURE-BLOODED RUMANIANS" AT THE EXPENSE OF MINORITIES, M. POP DECLARED:

"I SHALL CONTINUE THIS POLICY. NOBODY HAS THE RIGHT TO INTERFERE, NOT EVEN THE LEAGUE OF NATIONS, WHICH IS SO MUCH LOVED BY CERTAIN PEOPLE."

THE MINISTER'S REFERENCE TO THE LEAGUE IS BELIEVED PROMPTED BY THE RECENT PROTEST TO GENEVA BY REPRESENTATIVES OF THE HUNGARIAN POPULATION, WHICH COMPLAINED THAT M. POP'S MEASURES AGAINST MINORITIES CONSTITUTED VIOLATION OF THE TRIANON PEACE TREATY.

NO JEWS ADMITTED TO BUCHAREST BAR ASSOCIATION IN 2 YEARS

BUCHAREST, Oct. 21. (JTA) -- Figures made public today by the Bucharest Bar Association reveal that for nearly two years a numerus nullus has been in effect against Jew-18H Attorneys. Not a single Jew was admitted to the association, membership in which is required before attorneys may practice, from December, 1935, to September, 1937. In the same period the association admitted 1,919 non-Jews.

FORMER JERUSALEM GOVERNOR URGES ARAB-JEWISH ROUNDTABLE PARLEY

LONDON, OCT. 21. (JTA) -- SIR RONALD STORRS, FORMER GOVERNOR OF JERUSALEM, URGED HERE THAT ARABS AND JEWS MEET AROUND A TABLE IN AN EFFORT TO SETTLE THEIR DIFFICULTIES WITHOUT THE PARTITION OF PALESTINE.

ADDRESSING MEMBERS OF THE 1912 CLUB, SIR RONALD SAID HE DID NOT BELIEVE THE SIT-UATION WAS SO HOPELESSLY BAD THAT SOMETHING COULD NOT BE DONE TO MAKE THE MANDATE WORK-ABLE.

THE JERUSALEM CORRESPONDENT OF THE TIMES, IN A LENGTHY ARTICLE ON THE PAN-ARAB MOVEMENT, SAID THERE WERE INDICATIONS THAT THE MOVEMENT WAS STAGED BY POLITICIANS TO DIVERT PUBLIC ATTENTION FROM THE GRAVE INTERNAL PROBLEMS OF ARAB STATES.

THE SITUATION DEVELOPING IN SYRIA IS LIKELY TO EMBARRASS FRENCH AND BRITISH AUTHORITIES, HE SAID, HOLDING THEY WERE FACED WITH THE POSSIBILITY THAT ARAB TERROR-ISTS FROM PALESTINE WOULD ESTABLISH A BASE IN SYRIA WITH THE LOCAL GOVERNMENT UNABLE OR UNWILLING TO PREVENT THEIR ACTIVITIES.

BRITISH EXPERTS SHOULD REALIZE THAT THE ARAB IMAGINATION IS SOARING AT POSSIB-ILITIES FOR POLITICAL INTRIGUE, THE CORRESPONDENT DECLARED, AND PREMATURE ENCOURAGEMENT OF PAN-ARABISM MIGHT HAVE UNPLEASANT CONSEQUENCES.

ITALIAN COLONIES RAISING FUND FOR PALESTINE ARABS

ROME, Oct. 21. (JTA) -- ITALIAN NEWSPAPERS TODAY REPORTED A COLLECTION FUND FOR PALESTINE ARABS STARTED BY ITALIAN COLONIES AS FURTHER MANIFESTATION OF ITALIAN SOLIDAR-ITY WITH THE MOSLEM WORLD. MONEY RAISED IN THE CAMPAIGN WILL BE TURNED OVER TO THE ARABS, IT WAS ANNOUNCED, DURING RAMADAN, NINTH MONTH IN THE MOSLEM CALENDAR, OBSERVED AS A FAST MONTH.

HOPEFUL VIEW ON PALESTINE AIRED AT POALE-ZION PARLEY IN PHILADELPHIA

PHILADELPHIA, Oct. 21. (JTA) -- A HOPEFUL VIEW ON THE SITUATION IN PALESTINE WAS EXPRESSED BY BERL KATZNELSON, TEL AVIV EDITOR AND LABOR LEADER, AT THE OPENING SESSION LAST NIGHT OF THE THIRTY-FIRST ANNUAL CONVENTION OF THE AMERICAN POALE-ZIONIST ORGANIZATION. FIFTEEN HUNDRED DELEGATES AND QUESTS FROM ALL PARTS OF THE COUNTRY ARE IN ATTENDANCE AT THE MEETING, WHICH IS TO CONTINUE AT THE ADELPHIA HOTEL UNTIL SUNDAY NIGHT.

MR. KATZNELSON, EDITOR OF DAVAR AND SECRETARY OF THE JEWISH AGENCY'S POLITICAL COMMISSION, ASSERTED THAT DESPITE THE PRESENT VIOLENCE, THE BACKBONE OF THE TERRORISTS HAD BEEN BROKEN.

ENGLAND'S DECISION NO LONGER TO CONDONE TERRORISM, EVIDENCED BY BANNING OF THE ARAB SUPREME COMMITTEE AND DEPOSITION OF THE MUFTI, HE DECLARED, IMPLIED A DISTINCT CHANGE IN THE GOVERNMENTAL POLICY.

"GHETTO" PROTEST BY LUBLIN JEWS BRINGS OFFICIAL WARNING

WARSAW, Oct. 21. (JTA) -- THE DISTRICT GOVERNOR OF LUBLIN WARNED THE JEWISH COMMUNITY THERE TODAY THAT A RESOLUTION IT HAD ADOPTED IN PROTEST AGAINST SEGREGATION OF JEWS IN COLLEGES WAS OUTSIDE ITS POWERS. THE JEWISH COMMUNITY, THE GOVERNOR SAID, ADMINISTERS RELIGIOUS AFFAIRS AND HAS NO RIGHT TO INTERFERE IN POLITICAL MATTERS.

Members of Col. Adam Koc's youth organization distributed large numbers of Leaf-Lets in Warsaw streets calling for a "national regeneration" and a fight against Jewry.

20 ORGANIZATIONS BACK PROJECT FOR REBEKAH KOHUT

NEW YORK, Oct. 21. (JTA) -- TWENTY JEWISH ORGANIZATIONS HAVE UNITED TO SPONSOR A DRIVE FOR ESTABLISHMENT OF A REBEKAH KOHUT GROVE ON JEWISH NATIONAL FUND LAND IN PALESTINE IN HONDR OF THE NOTED SOCIAL WORKER'S FIFTY-YEAR CAREER IN NEW YORK, IT WAS ANNOUNCED TODAY. AN ITEM IN THE JTA NEWS OF OCT. 20 INCORRECTLY STATED THAT THE ANNOUNCEMENT THAT THE GROVE WOULD BE ESTABLISHED WAS MADE BY HADASSAH.

AUSTRIAN HIGH COURT UPHOLDS 23 JEWISH DOCTORS' CLAIMS TO HOSPITAL POSTS DENIED THEM

VIENNA, Oct. 21. (JTA) -- THE SUPREME COURT HAS RECOGNIZED THE RIGHT OF 23
JEWISH DOCTORS, WHO HAD WORKED FOR A LONG TIME IN VIENNA HOSPITALS, TO CLAIM EMPLOYMENT FROM THE CITY AS ASSISTANT PHYSICIANS.

THE JEWISH DOCTORS, EMPLOYED IN VARIOUS VIENNA HOSPITALS FOR A CONSIDERABLE TIME, WERE IGNORED WHEN VACANCIES IN POSITIONS AS ASSISTANT PHYSICIANS OCCURRED, WHICH WERE

THEIR CLAIM FOR DAMAGES AGAINST THE VIENNA HEALTH FUND WAS ORIGINALLY DENIED IN THE COURT OF FIRST INSTANCE, WHICH AGREED WITH THE DEFENSE CONTENTION THAT THE FUND WAS ENTITLED TO USE ITS OWN JUDGMENT IN MAKING APPOINTMENTS. THE HIGH COURT HAS NOW REVERSED THIS DECISION, BUT DOUBT WAS EXPRESSED THAT THE VERDICT WOULD HAVE ANY PRACTICAL EFFECT FOR THE JEWISH DOCTORS.

MACDONALD EULOGIZES WARBURG AS CONCILIATOR AT DINNER HERE

NEW YORK, Oct. 21. (JTA) -- JAMES G. McDonald, Former League of Nations High Commissioner for German Refugees, declared tonight at a joint dinner of the American Christian Committee for German Refugees and the Joint Distribution Committee at the Hotel Biltmore that "Felix Warburg was a world statesman who strove unremittingly for international and inter-religious understanding, a humanitarian whose sympathies were as broad as all manking, a friend who was warm and unfailing."

"WITHOUT COMPROMISING BASIC PRINCIPLES," MR. MACDONALD SAID, "HE ENDEAVORED WITH INFINITE PATIENCE TO HARMONIZE CONFLICTING INTERESTS AND VIEWS, SO THAT A DISTANT OBJECT-IVE - OFTEN ONLY DIMLY DISCENNED BY OTHERS - MIGHT THE MORE QUICKLY BE ATTAINED. HE WAS A TRUE SON OF MAN, WHOSE GENEROSITY RECOGNIZED NO DIVIDING LINES OF NATIONALITY, RACE OR CREED."
