### MARTIAL LAW NOW DEEMED NOT NEEDED IN PALESTINE

LONDON, Oct. 22. (JTA) -- MARTIAL LAW IS NOT NECESSARY IN PALESTINE AT THIS TIME IN THE VIEW OF BOTH THE COLONIAL OFFICE AND MILITARY LEADERS ON THE SPOT, THE HOUSE OF COMMONS WAS INFORMED TODAY.

REPLYING IN WRITING TO A QUESTION BY COL. JOSIAH WEDGWOOD, LABORITE, COLONIAL SECRETARY WILLIAM ORMSBY-GORE SAID HE WAS "ENTIRELY SATISFIED" WITH THE HIGH COMMISSIONER'S USE OF POWERS UNDER THE DEFENSE ORDER IN COUNCIL. HE DECLARED PALESTINE MILITARY LEADERS SHARED HIS VIEW.

### ARAB KILLED IN JERUSALEM AS DISORDERS CONTINUE

JERUSALEM, Oct. 22. (JTA) -- ONE ARAB WAS KILLED AND TWO OTHERS WOUNDED TODAY AS SCATTERED DISORDERS CONTINUED IN SEVERAL PARTS OF PALESTINE. THE ARAB WAS SHOT DEAD ON KING GEORGE AVE. IN THE CENTER OF JERUSALEM. TWO WERE SHOT AND WOUNDED IN HAIFA.

A PETROLEUM PIPELINE WAS DAMAGED AND ESCAPING OIL IGNITED NEAR EIN DOR. SHELL OIL CO. TANKS AT A RAILWAY STATION WERE SHOT AT, BUT NOT DAMAGED.

THREE BOMBS EXPLODED IN THE HERZLIAH QUARTER OF TEL AVIV ON THE JAFFA BOUNDARY. NO CASUALTIES WERE REPORTED.

TELEPHONE LINES BETWEEN RAS-EL-EIN AND KALKILLIA WERE CUT. POLICE ARRESTED SEVERAL ARAB NOTABLES IN KALKILLIA.

JEWS, CATHOLICS FEAR CURBS AS NAZIS TAKE OVER DANZIG RULE

DANZIG, Oct. 22. (JTA) -- JEWISH AND CATHOLIC CIRCLES EXPRESSED FEARS TODAY OF RESTRICTIVE MEASURES AFTER THE FREE CITY HAD COME COMPLETELY UNDER NAZI DOMINATION WITH THE DISSOLUTION OF THE CATHOLIC CENTER PARTY.

"GHETTO STALLS" WERE INTRODUCED IN THE MARKET PLACE AND JEWS WERE ORDERED TO OCCUPY STALLS ON A SIDE STREET. A FIGHT ENSUED WHEN JEWISH TRADERS REFUSED TO COMPLY WITH THE ORDER, SEVERAL GERMAN TRADERS SIDING WITH THE JEWS.

THE JEWISH COMMUNITY OF DANZIG APPEALED TO THE JEWISH POPULATION, IN A STATEMENT, TO ACT WITH DIGNITY AND CALM. THE STATEMENT SAID THE COMMUNITY ADMINISTRATION FULLY REALIZED THE SERIOUSNESS OF THE SITUATION FOR THE JEWS.

THE CENTER PARTY WAS DECLARED ILLEGAL AND MEMBERSHIP IN IT WAS MADE PUNISHABLE BY IMPRISONMENT. CATHOLIC MEMBERS OF THE LANDTAG WERE REQUESTED TO TENDER THEIR RESIGNATIONS. SEVERAL CENTRIST DEPUTIES ESCAPED ABROAD.

FREDERICK T. BIRCHALL, IN A BERLIN DISPATCH TO THE NEW YORK TIMES TODAY, SAID:

"A DIFFICULT TIME, HOWEVER, IS INDICATED FOR DANZIG JEWS NOW THAT THE FORMER FREE CITY HAS PASSED UNDER EXCLUSIVE NAZI DOMINATION. THE NATIONAL SOCIALIST GOVERNMENT HAS BEEN PROCEEDING STRONGLY AGAINST JEWS, AND ONLY A WEEK AGO HERR FOERSTER DECLARED THAT THENCEFORTH THE JEWISH QUESTION WOULD BE MUCH IN THE FOREGROUND.

"HE WENT ON TO SAY THAT, SINCE DANZIG COULD NOT DEFEND ITSELF AGAINST 'JEWISH BRAZENNESS' UNDER EXISTING LAWS, THE BATTLE WOULD BE TAKEN UP 'BY MEANS OF EDUCATION AND MEASURES WHICH THE POPULATION ITSELF WILL ADOPT SPONTANEOUSLY.' MOREOVER, IN THESE 'SELF-HELP' MEASURES OF THE GERMAN POPULATION, HE SAID, NO DIFFERENCE COULD BE MADE BETWEEN JEWS WHO ARE DANZIG CITIZENS AND THOSE OF FOREIGN CITIZENSHIP."

2,600 ATTEND SIMPLE WARBURG RITES AT TEMPLE EMANU-EL

NEW YORK, Oct. 22. (JTA) -- MORE THAN 2,600 PERSONS FROM EVERY WALK OF LIFE CROWDED TEMPLE EMANU-EL TODAY TO ATTEND FUNERAL SERVICES FOR FELIX M. WARBURG, WHO DIED WEDNESDAY. HUNDREDS MORE WERE TURNED AWAY AT THE DOOR.

AFTER A SIMPLE CEREMONY THAT LASTED ONLY 25 MINUTES, THE CARNATION-SHROUDED CASKET WAS CARRIED OUT OF THE TEMPLE, WITH HIS FOUR SONS AND OTHER CLOSE RELATIVES ACTING AS PALLBEARERS, AND TAKEN WITH AN ESCORT OF MOTORCYCLE POLICE ALONG A ROUTE LINED PART OF THE WAY BY THOUSANDS OF PEOPLE TO SALEM FIELDS CEMETERY, BROOKLYN, WHERE A PRIVATE BURIAL WAS HELD IN THE SCHIFF VAULT.

SCORES OF PERSONS PROMINENT IN SOCIETY, POLITICS, FINANCE, EDUCATION, SOCIAL WELFARE WORK, ATTENDED THE SERVICES. THEY INCLUDED GOVERNOR LEHMAN, MAYOR LAGUARDIA AND AL SMITH, JOHN D. ROCKEFELLER, MRS. VINCENT ASTOR, THOMAS DEWEY, JUSTICE IRVING LEHMAN, U.S. HOUSING ADMINISTRATOR NATHAN STRAUS, PERCY S. STRAUS, PRESIDENT NICHOLAS MURRAY BUTLER OF COLUMBIA UNIVERSITY, JULES S. BACHE, DR. CYRUS ADLER AND MANY OTHERS.

THE CEREMONY BEGAN PROMPTLY AT TEN O'CLOCK, WITH DR. SAMUEL SCHULMAN, RABBI EMERITUS OF THE TEMPLE, A LIFE-LONG FRIEND OF MR. WARBURG, AND RABBI SAMUEL GOLDENSON OFFICIATING, AND SIX OTHER RABBIS ASSISTING. THERE WERE NO EULOGIES.

TO THE HUSHED MUSIC OF BACH'S ORGAN PRELUDE, "ARIA," MR. WARBURG'S CLOSE RELATIVES FILED INTO FRONT SEATS, HIS WIDOW AND DAUGHTER IN HEAVY BLACK VEILS.

AFTER THE REV. MOSHE RUDINOW HAD CHANTED "ADONAY MOH ODOM? (LORD, WHAT IS MAN?), DR. SCHULMAN, HIS VOICE BREAKING AT TIMES, RECITED THE NINETIETH PSALM. MISS RITA SEBASTIAN SANG BACH'S "KOMM, SUESSER TOD" (COME, SWEET DEATH).

DR. GOLDENSON READ FROM THE BOOK OF JOB - "...I WAS EYES TO THE BLIND, FEET TO THE LAME, FATHER TO THE NEEDY...."

CONCEALED FROM VIEW, THE STRADIVARIUS AND MUSICAL ART QUARTETS, USING MR. WARBURG'S PRICELESS STRADIVARI, PLAYED BRAHMS' "ROMANZA."

DR. GOLDENSON RECITED THE TWENTY-THIRD PSALM OF DAVID: "THE LORD IS MY SHEPHERD, I SHALL NOT WANT..." THE CASKET WAS THEN LIFTED FROM THE MARBLE PLATFORM, THE PALLBEARERS FOLLOWING. THEY WERE MR. WARBURG'S SONS, PAUL F., FREDERICK M., GERALD F. AND EDWARD M.; HIS NEPHEWS, GEORGE BACKER, ERICH WARBURG, WALTER DERMBERG AND JOHN M. SCHIFF, AND A GRANDSON, WALTER N. ROTHSCHILD JR.

A BRIEF MEMORIAL SERVICE FOR MR. WARBURG WAS HELD IN THE OFFICES OF THE JOINT DISTRIBUTION COMMITTEE AT 1 P.M. BY MEMBERS OF THE STAFF WHOSE WORK MR. WARBURG HAD GUIDED SINCE THE INCEPTION OF THE ORGANIZATION IN 1914. THE SERVICE WAS HELD FOR THE BENEFIT OF THOSE STAFF MEMBERS UNABLE TO ATTEND THE RITES AT TEMPLE EMANU-EL. SERVICES WERE ALSO HELD AT THE ZIONIST OFFICES, 111 FIFTH AVE. WITH OFFICIALS OF THE U.P.A., J.N.F. AND Z.O.A. PARTICIPATING.

#### NONE TO REPLACE HIM, WEIZMANN HOLDS AT LONDON AGENCY SERVICES

LONDON, Oct. 22. (JTA) -- DR. CHAIM WEIZMANN, PRESIDING TODAY AT A JEWISH AGENCY MEMORIAL MEETING FOR FELIX M. WARBURG, LAUDED HIS SERVICES TO WORLD JEWRY AND SAID, "FRANKLY, I CANNOT SEE ANYONE WHO CAN ADEQUATELY REPLACE HIM."

DR. WEIZMANN MOURNED THE LOSS OF A GREAT FRIEND, A GREAT CITIZEN OF THE UNITED STATES, AND LAUDED HIS WORK FOR THE REHABILITATION OF JEWS OF EASTERN EUROPE. REFERRING TO THE JEWISH AGENCY COUNCIL SESSION IN ZURICH, HE SAID:

"IT WAS A NOBLE SACRIFICE ON HIS PART, COMING FROM NEW YORK TO ZURICH AT A TIME WHEN HIS HEALTH WAS GREATLY IMPAIRED. THE LAST FEW DAYS WE SPENT TOGETHER. WE RETURNED HOME HAPPY IN THE FEELING OUR WORK WOULD GO ON AND PROSPER DESPITE ALL DIFFICULTIES AHEAD.

"WARBURG WAS A MAN WHO WAS ALWAYS POURING OIL ON TROUBLED WATERS, ALWAYS TRYING TO FIND A PEACEFUL WAY OUT. HE CAN ILL BE SPARED BY AMERICA AND THE ZIONIST MOVEMENT. FRANKLY, I CANNOT SEE ANYONE WHO CAN ADEQUATELY REPLACE HIM. JEWRY THE WORLD OVER MOURNS WARBURG.

WARBURG CONCERNED OVER JEWS TO END, KAHN REVEALS

PARIS, Oct. 22. (JTA) -- ONLY A FEW HOURS BEFORE HIS DEATH FELIX M. WARBURG CABLED ANXIOUSLY TO THE OFFICE OF THE AMERICAN JEWISH JOINT DISTRIBUTION COMMITTEE ABOUT THE SITUATION OF THE JEWS IN EASTERN AND CENTRAL EUROPE OFFERING SUGGESTIONS FOR RELIEF.

THIS WAS REVEALED TODAY BY DR. BERNHARD KAHN, EUROPEAN DIRECTOR OF THE COMMITTEE, IN PAYING TRIBUTE TO THE NEW YORK PHILANTHROPIST'S HIGH SENSE OF RESPONSIBILITY FOR THE SUFFERINGS OF JEWS IN POLAND, RUSSIA, PALESTINE AND OTHER COUNTRIES.

PALESTINE OFFICES CLOSED

JERUSALEM, Oct. 22. (JTA) -- PALESTINE JEWRY WAS DEEP IN MOURNING TODAY OVER THE DEATH OF FELIX M. WARBURG. SCORES OF JEWISH ORGANIZATIONS CLOSED THEIR OFFICES BECAUSE OF THE FUNERAL SERVICES BEING HELD IN NEW YORK.

POALE-ZIONIST PARLEY ASSAILS PALESTINE ENTRY CURB AS ILLEGAL

PHILADELPHIA, Oct. 22. (JTA) -- THE NEW PALESTINE ORDINANCE ESTABLISHING A POLITICAL BASIS FOR IMMIGRATION WAS DENOUNCED AS ILLEGAL IN A RESOLUTION ADOPTED BY A RISING VOTE AT THIS AFTERNOON'S SESSION OF THE THIRTY-FIRST ANNUAL CONVENTION OF THE POALE ZION-ZEIRE ZION.

THE RESOLUTION DEMANDS THAT THE BRITISH GOVERNMENT ABIDE BY THE DECISION OF THE LEAGUE OF NATIONS COUNCIL AND THE DECLARATION OF FOREIGN SECRETARY ANTHONY EDEN IN GENEVA THAT THE PRINCIPLE OF ECONOMIC ABSORPTIVE CAPACITY WOULD NOT BE ABANDONED.

"THE LATEST DECISION OF THE BRITISH GOVERNMENT," THE RESOLUTION SAID, "IS A BETRAYAL OF BINDING POLITICAL AND MORAL OBLIGATIONS AND AN INTOLERABLE ABUSE OF TRUST CONFIDED IN BRITAIN BY THE JEWISH PEOPLE AND THE LEAGUE MEMBERS."

BERL KATZNELSON, EDITOR OF DAVAR, ADDRESSING THE CONVENTION LAST NIGHT, DECLARED THAT THE FATE OF THE PARTITION PROJECT DEPENDS ON THE GENERAL INTERNATIONAL SITUATION AS WELL AS ON THE ACTION TAKEN BY THE JEWISH PEOPLE. HE SAID MUCH HINGED ON WHETHER THE DEMOCRATIC POWERS TOOK A VIGOROUS ATTITUDE TOWARD THE FASCIST FORCES.
