RUMANIAN ANTI-SEMITES THREATEN CIVIL WAR IF NATIONAL PEASANTS PARTY WINS ELECTION

BUCHAREST, Nov. 4. (JTA) -- OPEN THREATS OF CIVIL WAR IF THE NATIONAL PEASANTS PARTY ATTAINS POWER IN THE FORTHCOMING ELECTIONS WERE VOICED TODAY BY PROF. OCTAVIAN GOOA, ONE-TIME INTERIOR MINISTER, AND PROF. ALEXANDER CUZA, FATHER OF RUMANIAN ANTI-SEMITISM, IN THE COURSE OF ADDRESSES AT A SESSION OF THE NATIONAL CHRISTIAN PARTY'S GRAND COUNCIL.

"THERE WILL BE REVOLUTION IF THE NATIONAL PEASANTS PARTY, WHICH SOLD ITSELF
TO THE JEWS, IS BROUGHT TO POWER," PROF. GOGA DECLARED. "IF NECESSARY TO USE VIOLENCE,
I WILL BE THE LEADER OF THE MOVEMENT. IT IS BETTER TO SHAKE THE COUNTRY OUT OF ITS
STAGNATION THAN TO SUFFOCATE."

Speaking in the same vein, Prof. Cuza demanded the National Christian Party, of which he is co-leader with Prof. Goga, Be returned to power. He asserted the time had come to apply the principle of "ethnical Rumanianism," citing the Bar Association's recent elimination of Jews to prove it was possible.

COMMENTING ON THE THREATS, THE NEWSPAPER DREPTATEA, ORGAN OF THE NATIONAL PEASANTS PARTY, DECLARED: "THE PRE-REVOLUTIONARY ATMOSPHERE DESCRIBED BY GOGA CONFIRMS THE DESPERATE SITUATION IN WHICH HE FINDS HIMSELF AS A CONSEQUENCE OF HIS CONNECTION WITH ROSENBERG'S BUREAU OF FOREIGN AFFAIRS IN BERLIN. WE ADVISE GOGA TO CALM HIS REVOLUTIONARY ZEAL."

DISORDERS CLOSE LWOW COLLEGE; EDUCATORS REAFFIRM OPPOSITION TO "GHETTO"

WARSAM, Nov. 4. (JTA) -- THE LWOW POLYTECHNIC INSTITUTE WAS CLOSED TODAY AFTER FOUR JEWS WERE INJURED, TWO OF THEM SERIOUSLY ENOUGH TO REQUIRE HOSPITALIZATION, IN RIOTS RESULTING FROM NATIONALISTS' ATTEMPTS TO OBTAIN SEGRECATION OF JEWS IN CLASSROOMS.

DESPITE ANTI-SEMITIC DISORDERS INTENDED TO EXERT PRESSURE ON LWOW UNIVERSITY AUTH-ORITIES, THE UNIVERSITY SENATE REFUSED BY A UNANIMOUS VOTE TO ACCEPT THE PROFFERED RESIG-NATION OF PROFESSOR KULCZYNSKI, THE RECTOR, THUS ENDORSING HIS STAND AGAINST SEGREGATION OF JEWS. DR. TADEUSZ KOTARBINSKI, AGED PROFESSOR OF PHILOSOPHY AT WARSAW UNIVERSITY,
TOLD A DELEGATION OF NATIONALISTS HE WOULD CONTINUE TO STAND WHILE DELIVERING LECTURES
AS A SIGN OF SYMPATHY WITH THE JEWS SO LONG AS THE OFFICIALLY-SANCTIONED SEGREGATION
CONTINUED IN EFFECT.

BRITAIN PLANS ARABIC BROADCASTS TOCOUNTERACT PROPAGAIDA

LONDON, Nov. 4. (JTA) -- VIGOROUS MEASURES TO COUNTERACT FOREIGN ANTI-BRITISH PROP-AGANDA IN PALESTINE AND THE NEAR EAST WILL BE TAKEN BY THE BRITISH GOVERNMENT IN THE NEXT FEW MONTHS, IT WAS LEARNED HERE TODAY.

ONE STEP TO BE TAKEN WILL BE BROADCASTS IN ARABIC FROM THE BRITISH BROADCASTING COMPANY'S POWERFUL TRANSMITTER AT DAYENTRY. PLANS FOR THIS SPECIAL SERVICE ARE NOW BEING WORKED OT AND WILL BE PUT INTO EFFECT AT THE EARLIEST POSSIBLE MOMENT.

THE BRITISH GOVERNMENT HOPES BY THESE MEANS TO COUNTERACT THE EFFECT OF THE ITALIAN BROADCASTS TO PALESTINE IN THE ARABIC LANGUAGE, THE TONE OF WHICH HAS BEEN HOST-ILE TO BRITISH INTERESTS AND ENCOURAGING TO ARAB EXTREMISTS.

THIS STEP IS BEING TAKEN AFTER REPEATED DIPLOMATIC DEMARCHES TO MUSSOLINI HAVE FAILED TO RESULT IN ANY PERMANENT IMPROVEMENT IN THE SITUATION. FOREIGN MINISTER ANTHONY EDEN HAS ON SEVERAL OCCASIONS PROTESTED TO ITALY AGAINST THE BARI BROADCASTS, AND HE SECURED FROM MUSSOLINI AT THE TIME OF THE PUBLICATION OF THE ROYAL COMMISSION REPORT AN ASSURANCE THAT ITALY WOULD DO NOTHING TO CREATE DIFFICULTIES FOR THE BRITISH ADMINISTRATION.

FOREIGN PROPAGANDA BROADCASTING HAS BEEN THE CAUSE OF SEVERAL COMPLAINTS IN THE HOUSE OF COMMONS, AND MEMBERS HAVE CRITICIZED THE GOVERNMENT SEVERELY FOR FAILING TO TAKE MEASURES TO CHECK OR COUNTERACT IT. THERE HAS ALSO BEEN CONSIDERABLE COMPLAINT THAT THE GOVERNMENT, ALTHOUGH AWARE OF THE PROPAGANDA ACTIVITIES CONDUCTED BY ITALIAN AND GERMAN AGENTS IN PALESTINE, HAS NOT TAKEN MEASURES AGAINST IT. IN PARLIAMENTARY AND CERTAIN GOVERNMENT CIRCLES THERE IS ALSO CRITICISM OF THE CABINET FOR ITS POLICY OF DE-CLINING TO REVEAL ANY OF THE INFORMATION IT IS KNOWN TO POSSESS REGARDING SUPPORT OF THE ARBONATIONALISTS IN PALESTINE AND FOR ITS POLICY OF PERMITTING THESE ACTIVITIES TO CONTINUE

IT IS NOW REPORTED HERE IN WELL-INFORMED CIRCLES THAT SIR CHARLES TEGART, THE NEW ADVISER TO THE PALESTINE GOVERNMENT ON POLICE MATTERS, WILL HAVE AS ONE OF HIS TASKS THE RECONSTITUTION OF THE GOVERNMENT'S INTELLIGENCE SERVICE IN PALESTINE NOT ONLY FOR THE PURPOSE OF TRACKING DOWN THE TERRORIST BANDS, BUT ALSO TO LOCATE AND IDENTIFY THE FOREIGN AGENTS SUPPORTING AND ENCOURAGING THEM AND THUS MAKE POSSIBLE THE NULLIFICATION OF THEIR ACTIVITIES.

MUFTI MOVING TO SYRIAN VILLAGE, LONDON HEARS

LONDON, Nov. 4. (JTA) -- THE FUGITIVE MUFTI OF JERUSALEM WILL SHORTLY LEAVE BEIRUT, THE EVENING STANDARD REPORTED FROM THE SYRIAN CAPITAL TODAY, AND ESTABLISH RESIDENCE, WITH THE CONSENT OF THE FRENCH AUTHORITIES, AT DJOUNICH, TEN MILES NORTH OF BEIRUT. HIS WIFE AND THREE CHILDREN HAVE ALREADY MOVED THERE, THE REPORT SAID.

(THE HAVAS NEWS AGENCY, IN A BAGHDAD DISPATCH, QUOTED AN OFFICIAL ANNOUNCEMENT THAT THE IRAQ GOVERNMENT WOULD HAVE NO OBJECTION TO THE MUFTI'S VISITING THERE.)

LONDON, Nov. 4. (JTA) -- A NEWLY-FORMED ANTI-PARTITION LEAGUE, COMPRISING THE GROUP "B" FACTION OF THE GENERAL ZIONISTS, THE MIZRACHI, ORTHODOX ZIONIST ORGANIZATION, THE SHOWER HATZAIR, LABOR ZIONIST YOUTH BODY, AND OTHER GROUPS OPPOSING THE PROPOSED PARTITION IN PALESTINE, WILL MEET IN LONDON Nov. 9 WITH MENACHEM M. USSISHKIN, LEADER OF GROUP B. PRESIDING.

J.D.C. TO AID JEWISH TRADERS IN DANZIG

WARSAW, Nov. 4. (JTA) -- THE JOINT DISTRIBUTION COMMITTEE HAS DECIDED TO ASSIST JEW-ISH MARKET TRADERS IN DANZIG DRIVEN INTO A GHETTO, IT WAS ANNOUNCED HERE TODAY. JEWISH AND POLISH EXPORTERS FROM DANZIG APPROACHED THE POLISH MINISTRY OF TRADE WITH A REQUEST THAT THEFE INTERESTS BE SAFEGUARDED.

THE RIGHT AND LEFT POLISH OPPOSITION PRESS DECLARES THAT THE DANZIG SENATE'S AVOW-ED DESIRE TO VIOLATE THE FREE CITY CONSTITUTION AND UNITE DANZIG WITH GERMANY IS A GREAT DANGER TO POLAND, WHILE GAZETA POLSKA, FOREIGN MINISTER JOSEF BECK'S ORGAN, STATES THAT POLISH RELATIONS WITH DANZIG HAVE NEVER BEEN BETTER IN THE PAST FIVE YEARS.

BILL TO BAR JEWS INTRODUCED IN TURKISH PARLIAMENT

ISTANBUL, Nov. 4. (JTA) -- A BILL TO BAR ADMISSION OF ALL FOREIGN JEWS INTO TURKEY WAS INTRODUCED IN PARLIAMENT TODAY.

POLISH JEWISH LEADERS URGE SEPARATE DRIVE HERE BE CONTINUED

NEW YORK, Nov. 4. (JTA) -- THE FEDERATION OF POLISH JEWS IN AMERICA MADE PUBLIC TO-DAY A COMMUNICATION SIGNED BY THIRTEEN PROMINENT POLISH JEWISH LEADERS URGING THE FEDERAT-ION TO CONTINUE ITS RELIEF WORK.

RECEIPT OF THE APPEAL WAS ANNOUNCED BY ZELIG TYGEL, EXECUTIVE SECRETARY OF THE FEDERATION, AT A LUNCHEON TO THE PRESS, IN THE COURSE OF WHICH HE CHARGED THAT THE RECENT ATTACK BY THE JOINT DISTRIBUTION COMMITTEE ON ITS SEPARATE CAMPAIGN AS "UNWISE AND UNDESTRABLE" WAS A VIOLATION OF AN INFORMAL PLEDGE GIVEN BY J.D.C. LEADERS NOT TO INTERFERE WITH THE FEDERATION'S ACTIVITIES.

Mr. Tygel Asserted the communication of the Polish-Jewish Leaders was a sufficient reply to the J.D.C. criticism, made last month by Executive Director Joseph C. Hyman, in an address at Pittsburgh.

DECLARING APPROXIMATELY \$100,000 HAD BEEN DISTRIBUTED FOR THE RELIEF OF POLISH
JEWS IN THE MORE THAN A YEAR OF THE FEDERATION'S CAMPAIGN, THE COMMUNICATION STATES THE
SUM "HAS PENETRATED THE REMOTEST CORNERS OF THE LAND IN AN ATTEMPT TO RELIEVE THE DIRECT
NEEDS OF THE THREE AND A HALF MILLION POLISH JEWS."

"WE REGARD IT AS OUR DUTY," IT CONTINUES, "ONCE MORE TO AWAKEN YOU AND TO APPEAL TO YOU, OUR BRETHREN, TO CONTINUE THE RELIEF WORK BEGUN BY YOU, THE RELIEF WORK SO BADLY NEEDED AND CARRIED ON BY THE FEDERATION OF POLISH JEWS IN AMERICA IN BEHALF OF THE JEWS IN POLAND."

THE SIGNERS INCLUDE CHIEF RABBI SCHORR, DEPUTY ISAAC RUBINSTEIN, EX-SENATOR RAFAEL SZERESZEWSKI, DEPUTY EMIL SOMMERSTEIN, REPRESENTING THE DISTRIBUTING COMMITTEE AND NUMEROUS INDIVIDUAL ORGANIZATIONS.

CHURCH GROUPS CALL FOR FIGHT AGAINST ANTI-SEMITISM

NEW YORK, Nov. 4. (JTA) -- "ONE OF THE BLACKEST PAGES IN THE HISTORY OF RELIGION IS THE PERSECUTION OF JEWS BY CHRISTIANS AND CHRISTIAN NATIONS," DECLARE THE AMERICAN COUNCIL OF THE WORLD ALLIANCE FOR INTERNATIONAL FRIENDSHIP THROUGH THE CHURCHES AND THE CHURCH PEACE UNION IN A NEWS LETTER TO MEMBERS.

THE LETTER URGES RELIGIONISTS OF ALL TYPES NOT ONLY TO PROTEST AGAINST ANTI-SEMITISM "BUT DO EVERYTHING IN THEIR POWER TO STOP IT." IT DENOUNCES SPECIFICALLY THE PERSECUTION OF JEWS IN POLAND AND RUMANIA.

"WITH ALL THE MISERY IN THE WORLD AT THE PRESENT TIME AND THE DIFFICULT SITUATIONS IN WHICH SO MANY PEOPLE FIND THEMSELVES, THERE ARE NO PEOPLE WHO ARE BEING HARDER HIT AND MORE UNJUSTLY DEPRIVED OF THEIR RIGHTS AND PRIVILEGES THAN THE JEWS THROUGHOUT THE WORLD," THE CHURCH BODIES ASSERT. "ANTI-SEMITISM IN ANY FORM IS AN UGLY MANIFESTATION.

"THE POLISH PEOPLE HAVE REASON TO BE ASHAMED OF WHAT IS BEING DONE AND WHAT IS PRO-POSED AS A FURTHER DEPRESSIVE ACTION AGAINST THE JEWS. THERE ARE 3,000,000 JEWS IN POLAND. WHEN POLAND WAS REUNITED AND ESTABLISHED AFTER HER LONG PARTITION, THE PEOPLE OF THE UNITED STATES FELT THAT AT LAST JUSTICE HAD BEEN DONE.

"Now we find that these people who suffered so much are themselves becoming chief among those who are persecuting the weak. Whatever may be the economic conditions and whatever may be the economic conditions and whatever may be the economic ties so thing to justify a nation driving out from its borders and setting adrift in the world a million or more of its citizens -- men and women without land, home, or country.

"THE ATTITUDE IN RUMANIA IS NO BETTER. GERMAN ANTI-DEWISH INFLUENCE IS BEING FELT WHEREVER THE GERMAN LANGUAGE IS SPOKEN AND WHEREVER THE THIRD REICH MAKES ANY PRETENSE OF HOLDING ITS PEOPLE TOGETHER."

ARMY OFFICER APOLOGIZES TO COL. KISCH FOR ANTI-SEMITIC LIBEL

LONDON, Nov. 4. (JTA) -- LIEUT.-COL. GRAHAM SETTON HUTCHISON OFFERED A FULL AND UNEQUIVOCAL APOLOGY IN THE HIGH COURT TODAY TO LIEUT.-COL. FREDERICK H. KISCH, FORMER CHAIRMAN OF THE PALESTINE ZIONIST EXECUTIVE, FOR HAVING LIBELLED HIM BY SUGGESTING HE BETRAYED GOVERNMENT SECRETS TO THE BOLSHEVISTS AND THAT THE REASON FOR THE ALLEGED BETRAYAL WAS THAT COL. KISCH IS A JEW.
