TROOPS PRESS HUNT FOR MURDERERS OF SOLDIERS; TRESPASSERS ON ARMY AREAS TO BE SHOT

JERUSALEM, Nov. 7. (JTA) -- TROOPS OF THE CELEBRATED BLACK WATCH REGIMENT, LEAVING BEHIND ONE ARAB KILLED AND TWO SERIOUSLY INJURED, PRESSED NORTHWARD FROM THE VILLAGE OF SILWAN NEAR JERUSALEM TODAY IN A RELENTLESS SEARCH FOR THE MURDERERS OF TWO OF THEIR COMRADES.

WHILE THE GOVERNMENT ANNOUNCED A \$5,000 REWARD FOR INFORMATION LEADING TO THE ARREST OF TERRORISTS WHO SHOT DOWN PRIVATES THOMAS HUTCHINSON AND ALBERT MILTON IN JERUSALEM FRIDAY, THE TROOPS CONTINUED THEIR SEARCH WITH BLOODHOUNDS AFTER UNCOVERING AMMUNITION AND BULLETS MATCHING THE MURDER MISSILES.

CURFEW WAS DECLARED FOR TONIGHT IN SILWAN, WHERE TROOPS HAD ENGAGED ARABS WHO FIRED ON THEM AFTER THE VILLAGE HAD BEEN SURROUNDED, KILLING ONE ARAB AND SERIOUSLY INJURING ANOTHER. THE SOLDIERS PURSUED THE FLEEING ATTACKERS WITH THE AID OF EYEWITNESSES AND CAME ON THREE HOUSES. THE OWNER OF ONE FELL OFF A CLIFF WHILE FLEEING AND WAS SERIOUSLY INJURED, WHILE THE OWNERS OF THE OTHERS WERE ARRESTED. IT WAS THERE THE AMMUNITION WAS FOUND. THE INHABITANTS OF SILWAN WERE INSTRUCTED, ACCORDING TO THE HAVAS NEWS AGENCY, TO MAKE DAILY APPEARANCES BEFORE THE BRITISH AUTHORITIES SO THAT POLICE CAN CHECK ON THEIR ACTIVITIES.

MEANWHILE, THE AUTHORITIES POSTED A WARNING PROHIBITING ENTRANCE INTO MILITARY AREAS, AIRDROMES AND BARRACKS. SENTRIES HAVE BEEN ORDERED TO SHOOT TO KILL AT TRESPASSERS. THE POSTERS WERE PUT UP AFTER TWO SUSPECTS HAD BEEN ARRESTED WITH CAMERAS. POLICE DECLINED TO REVEAL THEIR IDENTITIES.

IT WAS ANNOUNCED THAT AS A RESULT OF CURRENT DISORDERS THE MACCABIAD, JEWISH "OLYMPIC" GAMES, SCHEDULED FOR APRIL, 1938, HAS BEEN INDEFINITELY POSTPONED.

TWO NEW INCIDENTS, INVOLVING CLASHES BETWEEN THE AUTHORITIES AND ARABS, OCCURRED TO INCREASE PALESTINE TENSION, HAVAS REPORTED. IN LYDDA, AN ARAB DETECTIVE WAS GRAVELY WOUNDED DURING A GUN BATTLE WITH UNIDENTIFIED ASSAILANTS, AND A SENTINEL OF A BRITISH MILITARY CAMP IN HAIFA FIRED ON AN INDIVIDUAL WHO SOUGHT TO PENETRATE THE INTERIOR OF A GARRISON. AN ARAB BAND ATTACKED A TRAIN NEAR BEISAN, SCENE OF A RECENT BATTLE BETWEEN POLICE AND ARABS, BUT NO ONE WAS HURT.

UNIQUE USE OF ANTI-AIRCRAFT GUNS BY BRITISH TROOPS IN THEIR WAR ON ARAB GUERRILLISTS WAS REVEALED. THE GUNS ARE BROUGHT INTO PLAY TO FIRE UP HILLSIDES FROM WHICH ARAB TERRORISTS SNIPE AT BUSES, AUTOMOBILES AND MILITARY PATROLS. THEY ARE BEING USED CHIEFLY ON THE ROAD BETWEEN JERUSALEM AND JAFFA, WHOSE MANY CURVES AND GORGES ARE THE FAVORITES OF SNIPERS. THE ROAD IS NOW BEING PATROLLED BY MILITARY TRUCKS MOUNTING ANTI-AIRCRAFT GUNS, MACHINE GUNS AND TRENCH MORTARS WHICH THROW GRENADES ALMOST VERTICALLY.

NUREMBERG LAWS SLATED TO BE INTRODUCED IN DANZIG TOMORROW

WARSAW, Nov. 7. (JTA) -- THE DANZIG VOLKSTAG WILL ON TUESDAY PROCLAIM EXTENSION OF THE GERMAN NUREMBERG MARRIAGE AND CITIZENSHIP LAWS TO THE FREE CITY, IT WAS REPORTED HERE TODAY.

THE SWASTIKA WILL BE ADOPTED AS THE CITY'S FLAG AND THE NAZI PARTY WILL BE DECLARED THE ONLY LEGAL PARTY, POLISH NEWSPAPERS SAID. (PREVIOUS REPORTS HAD INDICATED THAT A POLISH PARTY WOULD ALSO BE PERMITTED.)

THE ANTI-JEWISH DRIVE CONTINUED, MEANWHILE, IN THE FREE CITY, WITH A NUMBER OF JEWS IN DANZIG AND NEARBY ZOPPOT ARRESTED AND THEIR PROPERTY CONFISCATED.

THE POLISH GOVERNMENT ANNOUNCED THAT IT HAD SENT A NEW PROTEST TO THE NAZI AUTHORITIES OF DANZIG AGAINST RECENT ASSAULTS ON POLISH CITIZENS, WITH A DEMAND FOR COMPENSATION, THE HAVAS NEWS AGENCY REPORTED. POLISH CITIZENS OF DANZIG HAVE SUFFERED PARTICULARLY DURING ANTI-SEMITIC RIOTS. LAST TUESDAY FOUR WERE SERIOUSLY INJURED WHEN NAZI STORM TROOPERS INVADDED THE SUBURB OF PIEKLO, BEATING UP THE POLES AND SACKING THEIR HOMES. POLAND'S PROTEST WAS SENT TO THE DANZIG SENATE THROUGH MARJAN CHODACKI, POLISH COMMISSIONER IN THE FREE CITY.

INTRODUCTION OF "GHETTO" ^{Not} AUTHORIZED IN WARSAW SECONDARY SCHOOLS

WARSAW, Nov. 7. (JTA) -- THE WARSAW BOARD OF SECONDARY SCHOOLS HAS ^{not} AUTHORIZED INTRODUCTION OF "GHETTO BENCHES" FOR JEWS, THE BOARD SAID TODAY IN A DECLARATION IN CONNECTION WITH REPORTS IN NATIONALIST NEWSPAPERS THAT SEGREGATION OF JEWS WOULD BE EXTENDED FROM WARSAW COLLEGES TO SECONDARY SCHOOLS.

THE RECTOR OF THE TECHNICAL HIGH SCHOOL AT POZNAN INTRODUCED A "GHETTO" FOR JEWS ALTHOUGH THERE ARE ONLY A FEW JEWISH STUDENTS IN THE SCHOOL. THE JEWS DECIDED TO FOLLOW THE EXAMPLE OF THEIR COMPATRIOTS IN WARSAW AND STAND DURING LECTURES RATHER THAN OCCUPY THE SEGREGATED SEATS.

THE RECTOR OF WILNO UNIVERSITY TOLD A DELEGATION OF JEWISH STUDENTS HE OPPOSED INTRODUCTION OF A "GHETTO" ON MORAL GROUNDS AND WOULD RESIGN IF LEFT NO OTHER ALTERNATIVE. HE SAID PRESSURE HAD BEEN EXERCISED FROM VARIOUS QUARTERS FOR SEGREGATING JEWS. THE DELEGATION CALLED ON HIM TO ASK ASSURANCE THAT "GHETTO BENCHES" WOULD NOT BE INTRODUCED THERE.

NATIONALIST AND JEWISH STUDENTS OF LWOV UNIVERSITY, WHERE RIOTS HAVE CLIMAXED NATIONALIST DEMANDS FOR SEGREGATION OF JEWS, WERE ASSIGNED BENCHES AT OPPOSITE SIDES OF CLASSROOMS IN A COMPROMISE SOLUTION OF THE CONFLICT BY RECTOR KULCZYNSKI. NEUTRAL STUDENTS WERE GIVEN THE CHOICE, UNDER THE COMPROMISE, OF SITTING WITH THE NATIONALISTS, THE JEWS, OR BY THEMSELVES BETWEEN THE TWO CONFLICTING GROUPS.

DISORDERS OCCURRED IN THE TOWNSHIP OF RAWA IN THE WARSAW DISTRICT WHEN 50 MEMBERS OF THE NATIONAL RADICAL PARTY STATIONED PICKETS BEFORE JEWISH SHOPS DURING MARKET-ING, ATTACKED A NUMBER OF POLES FOR BUYING FROM JEWS AND TURNED OVER JEWS' STALLS, DESTROYING A QUANTITY OF GOODS. POLISH WORKERS ARRIVED IN THE MARKET, DRIVING OUT THE NARAS. POLICE ARRESTED A NUMBER OF PICKETS.

TEL AVIV, HAVANA RALLIES PROTEST POLISH PERSECUTION

TEL AVIV, Nov. 7. (JTA) -- ATTACKS ON JEWS IN POLAND WERE PROTESTED LAST NIGHT IN A RESOLUTION ADOPTED BY A MASS MEETING OF THE MAPAI (JEWISH WORKERS' PARTY). I. NEUSTADT, SECRETARY OF THE HISTADRUTH, PROTESTED AGAINST THE ALLEGATION THAT THE JEWS WERE ENEMIES OF POLAND.

HAVANA, Nov. 7. (JTA) -- A RALLY OF 2,000 REPRESENTING ALL JEWISH GROUPS ADOPTED A RESOLUTION WEDNESDAY PROTESTING ANTI-SEMITIC EXCESSES IN POLAND AND PROCLAIMING A FUND-RAISING DRIVE FOR THE VICTIMS OF THE PERSECUTION.

36 ARRESTED IN RAIDS ON ZIONIST CENTERS IN BUDAPEST

BUDAPEST, Nov. 7. (JTA) -- THIRTY-SIX JEWISH YOUTHS AND GIRLS WERE UNDER ARREST TODAY FOLLOWING RAIDS BY POLICE TUESDAY NIGHT ON FOUR CENTERS WHERE YOUNG JEWS ARE TRAINED FOR EMIGRATION TO PALESTINE AFTER THEY HAD BEEN DENOUNCED AS ALLEGEDLY CARRYING ON BOLSHEVISTIC AND ATHEISTIC ACTIVITIES.

ALL THOSE ARRESTED ARE EXPECTED TO BE RELEASED AFTER FINAL EXAMINATION BY THE POLICE, BUT IT IS BELIEVED CHARGES WILL BE PREFERRED AGAINST THEM. ACCORDING TO ANTI-SEMITIC NEWSPAPERS, QUANTITIES OF SEDITIOUS LITERATURE WERE FOUND IN THE RAIDS. IN A STATEMENT TO THE J.T.A., THE EXECUTIVE OF THE HUNGARIAN ZIONIST FEDERATION INDIGNANTLY DENIED THE ALLEGATIONS THAT THE STUDENTS WERE COMMUNISTS, THAT THEY RECEIVED MONEY FROM MOSCOW OR THAT THEY WERE GUILTY OF IMMORAL PRACTICES.

FORMER JEWISH OFFICIAL REPORTED TORTURED TO DEATH IN NAZI CONCENTRATION CAMP

LONDON, Nov. 7. (JTA) -- "PRISONERS ARE STILL TORTURED TO DEATH IN GERMAN CONCENTRATION CAMPS," A SPECIAL CORRESPONDENT OF THE LABORITE DAILY HERALD DECLARED TODAY, CITING THE CASE OF A WEALTHY MAN OF JEWISH ORIGIN WHO, THE CORRESPONDENT SAID, DIED IN THE DACHAU CAMP.

DR. ASCHER, OF FRANKFORT, A FORMER HIGH OFFICIAL, WAS ARRESTED, ACCORDING TO THE HERALD, AFTER HE WAS HEARD TO SAY TO HIS SON, WHO PICKED UP THE NAZI ORGAN, DER ANGRIF, FROM A TABLE, IN A CAFE, "DO NOT TOUCH THAT RAG." ALTHOUGH ACQUITTED BY THE FRANKFORT CORRECTIONAL COURT, DR. ASCHER WAS IMMEDIATELY RE-ARRESTED BY THE GESTAPO (SECRET STATE POLICE) AND CONFINED IN THE DACHAU CONCENTRATION CAMP. THREE WEEKS LATER HIS FAMILY WAS ADVISED THAT HE HAD DIED.

8,000 JEWISH VETERANS HOLD MEMORIAL SERVICE IN LONDON

LONDON, Nov. 7. (JTA) -- Eight thousand Jewish war veterans, led by Defense Secretary Leslie Hore-Belisha, held the eighth annual Jewish Ex-Servicemen's National Remembrance Service today in the presence of 20,000 spectators. Chief Rabbi J.H. Hertz and Chaplain Gollop conducted the service. Lord Bearsted presided at a reunion tea at Albert Hall with Earl Athlone as guest of honor.

JOSEPH HOLLZER HEADS SHANGHAI JEWISH RELIEF COMMITTEE

SHANGHAI, Nov. 7. (JTA) -- Joseph Hollzer, brother of Federal Judge Harry Hollzer of Los Angeles, was today elected chairman of an emergency committee named by the Shanghai Jewish Community to relieve distress caused by the war. Community leaders recently issued an appeal to world Jewry, declaring all funds had been exhausted and that Shanghai's 5,000 Jews faced a winter of starvation.

JEWISH FARMERS PLAN NATIONAL ORGANIZATION; VICTORY OVER DEPRESSION CITED

NEW YORK, Nov. 7. (JTA) -- A conference of 350 representatives of Jewish farmers in the East decided today to form a national fraternal order of Jewish farmers. A committee was appointed to formulate plans for the organization and the Jewish Agricultural Society was asked to call a national convention as soon as the plans are ready.

The conference, which was held in the HIAS building, discussed problems of Jewish farmers. Speakers pointed out that Jewish farmers, numbering some 100,000 in this country, are leaders in the field and are the first to introduce new and more scientific agricultural methods. Dr. Gabriel Davidson, manager of the Jewish Agricultural Society, found that Jewish farmers had conquered the depression and were forging ahead rapidly.

Speakers during the morning session stressed the importance of keeping down production costs, and a number of scientific methods of feeding and several new ingredients were discussed. Home-made improvements not yet on the market were considered. A resolution was adopted calling on Jewish farmers to employ a better type of workmen, pointing out that the necessity of competing with poorer types of workmen often drove farmers' sons away from the farms.

CONFERENCE ADOPTS \$50,000 NEW YORK QLOTA IN HULEH DRIVE

NEW YORK, Nov. 7. (JTA) -- A resolution to raise \$50,000 in New York in the "Gift-Bond" drive for redemption of land in the Huleh region of Palestine was adopted today by about 700 delegates at a conference arranged by the Jewish National Fund at the Hotel Pennsylvania. Among those on the speakers' list were Berl Katznelson, Dr. Israel Goldstein and Dr. Stephen S. Wise.

BATHS FOR JEWISH CHILDREN OPENED IN KISHINEFF

KISHINEFF, Rumania, Nov. 7. (JTA) -- Modern public baths having a capacity of 500 per day were opened here today for Jewish school children by a committee of the Ose, Jewish Health Society. The baths were built with the aid of funds from the Joint Distribution Committee. Arrangements have been made with all Jewish schools for compulsory use of the baths. Three similar establishments will shortly be opened in other Rumanian cities.
