SIX ARABS, ONE JEW SLAIN IN NEW JERUSALEM DISORDERS

JERUSALEM, Nov. 14. (JTA) -- SIX ARABS AND ONE JEW WERE KILLED TODAY AS DISORDERS FLARED IN VARIOUS PARTS OF JERUSALEM. THE CASUALTIES, THE GREATEST NUMBER IN ANY ONE DAY IN THE CURRENT DISTURBANCES, ADDED TO A TOLL OF FIVE JEWS, TWO BRITISH SOLDIERS AND SEVEN ARABS KILLED LAST WEEK.

ONE JEW WAS KILLED AND THREE INJURED, AND ONE ARAB KILLED AND ONE WOUNDED IN A CLASH IN THE BETH ISRAEL QUARTER OF JERUSALEM WHICH BEGAN WHEN ARAB BUILDING WORKERS ATTACKED JEWISH LABORERS. THE JEW, OVADIA JOSEF, 30, A YEMENITE, DIED OF GUNSHOT WOUNDS. THE OTHER THREE JEWS WERE INJURED BY STONES.

SHOTS FIRED FROM AN AUTOMOBILE INTO A BUS PASSING THROUGH THE ROMEMA QUARTER RESULTED IN THE DEATHS OF TWO ARABS AND TWO ARAB CHRISTIAN GIRLS. AS RESULT OF THE ATTACK ON THE BUS, THE HAVAS NEWS AGENCY REPORTED, A DETACHMENT OF BLACK WATCH TROOPS WAS RUSHED TO THE SCENE, WITH SUBMACHINE GUNS. ARMED POLICE WERE ORDERED TO ESCORT ALL AUTOBUSES.

ONE ARAB WAS KILLED AND ONE WOUNDED BY SHOTS FIRED ON GAZA STREET IN THE REHAVIA SUBJURB. AN ARMED ARAB WHO REFUSED A COMMAND TO HALT WAS WOUNDED BY POLICE, IN THE AZAR-IEH VILLAGE.

HAVAS SAID A BOMB WAS HURLED AT A BUS CARRYING ARAB PASSENGERS, KILLING ONE WOMAN AND WOUNDING FOUR MEN. THE DESPATCH ALSO DECLARED A YOUNG JEW WAS STABBED, BUT NOT SERIOUSLY WOUNDED, BY AN UNIDENTIFIED ASSAILANT. TONIGHT MACHINE GUNS WERE INSTALLED AT ALL THE GATES OF JERUSALEM AND AND SOLDIERS AND POLICE, WEARING STEEL HELMETS, PATROLLED THE STREETS TO SEE THAT THE STRICT CURFEW WAS OBSERVED THROUGHOUT. SUPPLEMENTARY JEWISH POLICE GUARDS WERE POSTED AT STRATEGIC POINTS IN THE JEWISH DISTRICTS.

THE JEWISH NATIONAL COUNCIL DECIDED AT A MEETING TODAY, HAVAS REPORTED, TO CONVOKE A CONFERENCE OF THE ENTIRE JEWISH POPULATION TUESDAY TO DISCUSS THE PRESENT SITUATION. AT THE SAME TIME TWO MODERATE ARB LEADERS, RACHED BEY NASHASHIBI AND ELIAS MOGHANEM, WERE GRANTED AN INTERVIEW WITH ACTING HIGH COMMISSIONER WILLIAM D. BATTERSHILL TOMORROW. YESTERDAY TWO JERUSALEM MUNICIPAL OFFICIALS WERE ARRESTED AND TAKEN TO THE ACRE CONCENTRATION CAMP.

LAST WEEK CONSIDERED BLOODIEST OF YEAR

WITH FOURTEEN PERSONS KILLED LAST WEEK AND ELEVEN WOUNDED, THE WEEK WAS CONSIDERED THE BLOODIEST PALESTINE HAS EXPERIENCED THIS YEAR. CUTTING OF TELEPHONE WIRES AND OTHER ACTS OF SABOTÁGE CONTINUED THE COUNTRY OVER, FEATURED BY THE RAZING OF AN ENTIRE JEWISH BUSINESS BLOCK IN TEL AVIV THROUGH FIRE BELIEVED SET BY ARABS. THE WEEK'S TERRORISM WAS CONFINED MAINLY TO THE JERUSALEM AREA, WHERE AN AMBUSCADE, AN ASSASSINATION AND A BOMBING ACCOUNTED FOR TWELVE OF THE DEAD.

APPARENTLY AS A RESULT OF A TIGHTENING OF STRICT MILITARY AND POLICE PATROL IN THE NORTH AND SOUTH, ARAB BANDS CONCENTRATED THEIR FIRE ON THE JERUSALEM DISTRICT, WHICH HAS BEEN THEIR SAFEST HIDEOUT. THE AUTHORITIES' FEAR OF FURTHER VIOLENCE IN THE SECTION RESULTED IN PROMULGATION OF THE MILITARY COURTS AND THE STRICTEST TWELVE-HOUR CURFEW IN JERUSALEM ITSELF. EVEN NEWSPAPERMEN, NORMALLY EXCEPTED FROM CURFEW REGULATIONS, HAVE NOT RECEIVED PASSES THIS TIME. THE OFFICER IN CHARGE OF PRESS RELATIONS FOR THE GOVERNMENT FORBADE NEWSPAPERMEN TO VISIT A BRIDGE ON THE JERUSALEM-TEL AVIV ROAD, NEAR MOTZA, WHERE TWO BOMBS EXPLODED AFTER SIX O'CLOCK LAST NIGHT, CAUSING A TRAFFIC TIE-UP.

As a result of last Thursday's bombing of an Arab bus, in which two Arabs Died, the Arab bus companies have posted private detectives in the Bus terminal here. The Jewish Telegraphic Agency Learns, however, that the Bombing was the result of a quarrel between Arab bus operators. Wires linking Palestine and Egypt were cut Friday night. A children's COLONY, Handar Hadved, was fired on, no casualties resulting. Guards repetiled an Arab band trying to invade the Settlement of Artur. No casualties were reported. An Arab band, after failing to extort money from an Arab grange grove, Dahaged the water pumping station.

A SECRETLY-PUBLISHED MANIFESTO URGING ARABS TO OPPOSE BRITISH IMPERIALISM WITH "UNSHAKABLE RESISTANCE" WAS CIRCULATED HERE TODAY, HAVAS REPORTED. THE DOCUMENT WAS PUBLISHED
BY AN ORGANIZATION TERMING ITSELF "THE NEW ARAB HIGH COMMITTEE." IT CALLED UPON ARABS TO
HOLD FAST IN THE "LAST BATTLE BETWEEN THE ARABS OF PALESTINE AND THE IMPERIALISTS." THE
MANIFESTO EMPHASIZED THAT THE ENTIRE MOSLEM WORLD WAS SUFFORTING THE PALESTINE ARABS AND
STRONGLY PROTESTED THE BRITISH ATTITUDE IN THE HOLY LAND.

JEWISH ECONOMIC POSITION SEEN RESISTING BLOCKADE!

TEL AVIV, Nov. 14. (JTA) -- THE JEWISH ECONOMIC POSITION HAS SUCCESSFULLY RESISTED WHAT WAS TERMED AN EIGHTEEN-MONTH "BLOCKADE," THE THIRTY-SLXTH ANNUAL CONFERENCE OF HIST-ADRUTH, PALESTINE JEWISH LABOR FEDERATION, WAS TOLD BY J. FRIMKIN, HEAD OF ITS STATISTICAL DEPARTMENT.

MR. FRUMKIN SAID THE BANKS WERE IN A VERY STRONG POSITION AND THE MONTHLY INFLUX OF CAPITAL TOTALLED \$2,500,000. WHILE THE CITRUS INDUSTRY HAS BEEN BADLY AFFECTED, HE DECLARED IT IS EXPECTED TO REFLECT AN IMPROVED DISTRIBUTING ORGANIZATION. UNEMPLOYED IN THREE LARGE CITIES -- JERUSALEM, HAIFA AND TEL AVIV -- TOTAL 3,000, MR. FRUMKIN SAID, BUT THE HISTADRUTH EXPECTS TO PROVIDE WORK SHORTLY FOR 2,500 OF THE JOBLESS.

THE POSITION OF THE COLONIES WAS DESCRIBED AS MUCH WORSE, CHIEFLY DUE TO SEASONAL CAUSES WHICH, IT WAS STATED, WILL CLEAR UP AS SOON AS THE CITRUS SEASON OPENS ON NOV. 20. THE NEW TEL AVIV PORT EMPLOYS 900 WORKERS, ACCORDING TO MR. FRUMKIN'S REPORT, WHILE 500 OF THE HAIFA PORT EMPLOYES ARE JEWISH AND AN ADDITIONAL 400 ARE EXPECTED TO OBTAIN JOBS THERE.

WAUCHOPE TO LEAVE FOR JERUSALEM NOV. 20

LONDON, Nov. 14. (JTA) -- PALESTINE HIGH COMMISSIONER SIR ARTHUR GRENFELL WAUCH-OPE, RECOVERED FROM AN ILLNESS, WILL LEAVE FOR JERUSALEM Nov. 20, IT WAS ANNOUNCED TODAY. SIR ARTHUR WILL RELINQUISH HIS POST EARLY NEXT YEAR.

U.S. TO SEEK PERMISSION FOR REOPENING OF J.T.A. BERLIN BUREAU, HULL SAYS

NEW YORK, Nov. 14. (JTA) -- SECRETARY OF STATE CORDELL HULL, IN A TELEGRAM TO GEORGE BACKER, PRESIDENT OF THE JEWISH TELEGRAPHIC AGENCY YESTERDAY, DECLARED THE GOVERNMENT WOULD ENDEAVOR TO ASSIST IN OBTAINING PERMISSION FOR THE REOPENING OF THE J.T.A. BUREAU IN BERLIN, WHICH WAS CLOSED LAST WEDNESDAY BY THE GESTAPO (GERMAN STATE SECRET POLICE).

MR. HULL'S TELEGRAM WAS IN REPLY TO TELEGRAMS SENT BY MR. BACKER TO THE SECRETARY OF STATE AND TO GEORGE S. MESSERSHITH, ASSISTANT SECRETARY OF STATE, FRIDAY PEQUESTING THAT THE UNITED STATES EMBASSY IN BERLIN BE ADVISED TO ASSIST IN OBTAINING PERMISSION FOR THE J.T.A. BUREAU TO REOPEN.

MR. HULL'S TELEGRAM FOLLOWS: "THE AGENCIES OF THIS GOVERNMENT WILL RENDER EVERY APPROPRIATE ASSISTANCE TO YOUR BERLIN BUREAU IN CONNECTION WITH THE CLOSING OF THAT OFFICE BY THE GERMAN AUTHORITIES AND IN ENDEAVORING TO ASSIST IN OBTAINING PERMISSION FOR IT TO REOPEN. HOWEVER, IN VIEW OF YOUR TELEGRAMS OF NOVEMBER 12, 1937, TO ME AND MR. MESSERSMITH, I AM INFORMING OUR OFFICIALS IN BERLIN BY CABLE OF THE CONTENTS OF YOUR MESSAGE, AND UPON THE RECEIPT OF FURTHER INFORMATION I SHALL COMMUNICATE WITH YOU PROMPTLY."

NAZIS SEEN ACTING TO DEPRIVE REICH JEWISH PRESS OF FOREIGN SERVICE

LONDON, Nov. 14. (JTA) -- THE MANCHESTER GUARDIAN, COMMENTING YESTERDAY ON CLOSING OF THE BERLIN BUREAU OF THE J.T.A., SAID THE NAZI AUTHORITIES ACTED "TO DEPRIVE THE JEW-ISH PRESS THERE σ ITS FOREIGN SERVICE."

"THERE ARE THREE JEWISH PAPERS," THE GUARDIAN STATED, "WITH A COMBINED CIRCULATION OF 100,000. THEY ARE NOT ALLOWED TO RECEIVE THE GERMAN NEWS AGENCY SERVICE, NOR MAY THEY PUBLISH NEWS FROM GERMAN SOURCES ABOUT FOREIGN AFFAIRS. THE JEWISH TELEGRAPHIC AGENCY'S BERLIN OFFICE IN THE PAST HAD BEEN ALLOWED TO SUPPLY THEM WITH A FOREIGN NEWS SERVICE."

TATARESCU AGAIN HEADS RUMANIAN COVERNMENT; ANTI-SEMITE MAY ENTER CABINET

BUCHAREST, Nov. 14. (JTA) -- AFTER ION MIHALACHE, LEADER OF THE NATIONAL PEASANTS PARTY, HAD REFUSED TO FORM A COALITION WITH PROF. ALEXANDER VAIDA-VOEVOD, HEAD OF THE VIOLENTLY ANTI-SEMITIC RUMANIAN FRONT, KING CAROL TODAY AGAIN ENTRUSTED THE FORMATION OF A GOVERNMENT TO EX-PREMIER GEORG TATARESCU, WHOSE CABINET RESIGNED YESTERDAY.

PREMIER TATARESCU WAS EXPECTED TO SEEK THE SUPPORT OF THE "DISSIDENT LIBERAL" GROUP, WHOSE PROGRAM IS STRONGLY ANTI-SEMITIC, AND GEORG BRATANIU, ITS LEADER, WAS EXPECTED TO BE INCLUDED IN THE NEW CABINET.

MEANWHILE, THE POLITICAL TENSION PREVAILING HERE IS GIVING RISE TO ANTI-SEMITIC PROPAGANDA OF UNPRECEDENTED FEROCITY. IT IS FEARED THAT ANTI-JEWISH DISTURBANCES WILL OCCUR DURING THE GENERAL ELECTIONS, WHICH ARE SCHEDULED TO SE HELD SOME TIME IN DECEMBER.

STAMPS PORTRAYING FAMOUS JEWS TO BE ISSUED IN FIGHT AGAINST RACE HATRED

BUDAPEST, Nov. 14. (JTA) -- FIFTY SERIES OF STAMPS BEARING PORTRAITS OF FAMOUS
JEWS WHO HAVE HELPED MANKIND WILL BE ISSUED BY THE WORLD ORGANIZATION TO COMBAT RACE HATRED,
A CHRISTIAN BODY, FOR WORLD-WIDE DISTRIBUTION, IT WAS ANNOUNCED HERE TODAY.

THE STAMPS, ACCORDING TO THE ANNOUNCEMENT, ARE THE ORGANIZATION'S ANSWER TO THE ANTI-JEWISH LIBELS BEING FEATURED BY THE NAZI EXHIBITION AT MUNICH, "THE ETERNAL JEW." THEY WILL CARRY INSCRIPTIONS IN FRENCH, ENGLISH AND GERMAN, EXPLAINING THE SUBJECT'S CONTRIBUT-ION TO THE WELFARE OF HUMANITY.

THE FIRST OF THE SERIES, ISSUED YESTERDAY, BEARS THE PORTRAIT OF DR. PAUL EHRLICH, GERMAN-JEWISH DISCOVERER OF A SPECIFIC FOR SYPHILIS. IT CARRIES THE INSCRIPTION: "REPLY TOMUNICH EXHIBITION, 'THE ETERNAL JEW.' PAUL EHRLICH, WINNER OF THE NOBEL PRIZE, GERMAN JEW. SAVED MILLIONS OF PEOPLE BY HIS DISCOVERIES TO FIGHT DISEASES."

TRADE UNIONS, SOCIALISTS GREET POLISH BUND ON FORTIETH ANNIVERSARY

VIENTA, Nov. 14. (JTA) -- THE JEWISH COMMUNITY IS CONDUCTING A WINTER RELIEF APPEAL FOR FUNDS TO ALD 1,800 NEEDY JEWS DAILY. AN ANNUAL FINANCIAL REPORT, JUST ISSUED, REVEALS THAT EXPENDITURES IN 1936 TOTALLED OVER 1,600,000 SCHILLINGS IN THE FORM OF CASH GRANTS, FOODSTUFFS, FUEL, CLOTHING AND MEDICAL ASSISTANCE.

CROWD SILENCES ANTI-SEMITES AS GENNETT DECORATES PARIS WAR MEMORIAL

PARIS, Nov. 14. (JTA) -- ISIDOR GENNETT, New York Jewish Newsdealer who upset Nazi oficialdom when he placed a wreath on the German war memorial in Berlin two weeks ago, has deposited a wreath on the grave of the unknown soldier here. Anti-Jewish slogans were shouted by a group of young men as Gennett placed the wreath, inscribed "To Hospitable France," on behalf of the Jewish members of the American Legion. The youths were silenced by the crowd watching the germany.
