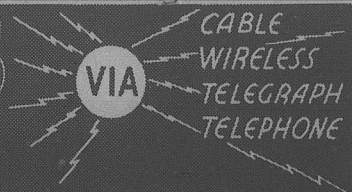

POPE TO APPEAL FOR CESSATION OF VIOLENCE IN PALESTINE

VATICAN CITY, Nov. 21. (JTA) -- POPE PIUS, IT WAS RELIABLY LEARNED TODAY, INTENDS TO APPEAL FOR THE HALTING OF VIOLENCE AND BLOODSHED AND SAFEGUARDING OF HOLY PLACES IN PALESTINE AT THE NEXT CONSISTORY OF THE COLLEGE OF CARDINALS. HIS PRONOUNCEMENT WILL NOT TOUCH ON THE CAUSES OF THE PALESTINE CRISIS.

THE FACT OF THE ANTICIPATED ELEVATION OF ARTHUR SHINSLEY, ARCHBISHOP OF WESTMINSTER, TO CARDINAL IS REGARDED AS INDICATING THAT THE VATICAN WILL AVOID MAKING ADDITIONAL DIFFICULTIES FOR GREAT BRITAIN AND WILL CONFINE ITSELF TO THE SAFEGUARDING OF THE HOLY PLACES.

THE SEMI-OFFICIAL OSSERVATORE ROMANO PUBLISHES TWO ARTICLES ON THE TWENTIETH ANNIVERSARY OF THE BALFOUR DECLARATION. THEY GIVE THE HISTORY, AN ANALYSIS AND VARIOUS OPINIONS ON THE DECLARATION. THE ARTICLES ARE MODERATE IN TONE AND ENDEAVOR TO GIVE AN IMPARTIAL ACCOUNT OF THE ARAB AND JEWISH ATTITUDES TO THE DECLARATION.

10 ARABS ARRESTED IN ANDREWS MURDER

JERUSALEM, Nov. 21. (JTA) -- TEN ARABS WERE ARRESTED TODAY AT THE VILLAGE OF SHAFRAM IN NORTHERN PALESTINE AND BROUGHT TO JERUSALEM REPORTEDLY IN CONNECTION WITH THE ASSASSINATION OF DISTRICT COMMISSIONER LEWIS ANDREWS.

AN ARAB WAS ARRESTED HERE IN CONNECTION WITH THE SHOOTING YESTERDAY OF ALEX PRINGLE, INSPECTOR IN CHARGE OF POLICE DOGS, AS HE WAS PASSING THE POST OFFICE. POLICE SEARCHES OF BUILDINGS NEAR THE SCENE OF THE SHOOTING HAD NOT BROUGHT ANY IMMEDIATE RESULT.

A SECTION OF THE BEERSHEBA ROAD AND A PASSING PUBLIC WORKS DEPARTMENT TRUCK WERE DAMAGED IN A MINE EXPLOSION. THERE WERE NO CASUALTIES.

MUKHTARS (NATIVE CHIEFTAINS) OF VILLAGES AROUND HAIFA WERE INVITED TO THE GOVERNMENT OFFICES AND SUPPLIED WITH COPIES OF THE REGULATIONS ESTABLISHING MILITARY COURTS FOR DISTRIBUTION TO FELLAHEEN (PEASANTS). THE HAIFA MILITARY COURT WAS EXPECTED TO TRY ITS FIRST CASE TODAY, INVOLVING AN ARAB ARRESTED NEAR JENIN WITH A RIFLE AND TWENTY ROUNDS OF AMMUNITION IN HIS POSSESSION.

NIGHT RAILWAY TRAFFIC WAS ORDERED RESUMED YESTERDAY FOR THE FIRST TIME SINCE THE ARAB DISORDERS BROKE OUT FIVE WEEKS AGO.

COUNCILLOR HASSAN SIDKY EL DAJANI IN A STATEMENT TO FALASTIN, CHRISTIAN ARAB PAPER, REPUDIATED THE JERUSALEM MUNICIPAL COUNCIL'S APPEAL FOR PEACE ISSUED MONDAY. HE DECLARED THE COUNCIL'S MEETING WAS UNOFFICIAL AND HAD BEEN CONVOKED BY THE DISTRICT COMMISSIONER. ACTING MAYOR DANIEL AUSTER TOLD THE J.T.A. THE COUNCIL HAD MET IN EXTRAORDINARY SESSION AND HAD BEEN CONVOKED BY HIM FOR THE SOLE PURPOSE OF ISSUING THE APPEAL.

ITALY BLAMED FOR PALESTINE UNREST

NEW YORK, Nov. 21. (JTA) -- A JERUSALEM DISPATCH BY JOSEPH M. LEVY TO THE NEW YORK TIMES TODAY STATES THAT UNLESS THERE IS AN END OF BRITAIN'S STRAINED RELATIONS WITH ITALY, IT IS DOUBTFUL WHETHER PEACE WILL BE RESTORED IN PALESTINE.

THE DISPATCH SAYS THAT ARAB FARMERS AND BUSINESS MEN WISH PEACE, THAT PRESENT TROUBLES ARE DUE TO A HANDFUL OF SYRIAN TERRORISTS SMUGGLED INTO THE COUNTRY AND FINANCED FROM A MYSTERIOUS SOURCE AND CONCLUDES THAT "THE TROUBLE IS THE WORK OF ITALY, FISHING IN TROUBLED WATERS TO IRRITATE BRITAIN."

PALESTINE IMMIGRATION DROPS SHARPLY; DEPRESSION HITS TEL AVIV BUDGET

JERUSALEM, Nov. 21. (JTA) -- A PRECIPITOUS DROP IN JEWISH IMMIGRATION TO PALESTINE WAS RECORDED IN SEPTEMBER AND FOR THE NINE MONTHS STARTING JANUARY, 1937, ACCORDING TO FIGURES MADE PUBLIC TODAY BY THE OFFICE OF STATISTICS.

A TOTAL OF 961 IMMIGRANTS ENTERED THE COUNTRY IN SEPTEMBER, OF WHOM 773 WERE JEWS. THIS COMPARES WITH 4,695 JEWISH IMMIGRANTS IN THE SAME MONTH THE PREVIOUS YEAR.

THE NINE-MONTH FIGURE WAS 10,077, OF WHOM 8,385 WERE JEWS, COMPARED WITH 26,528 JEWISH IMMIGRANTS IN THE 1936 PERIOD. THE JEWISH IMMIGRANTS INCLUDED 1,085 CAPITALISTS, COMPARED TO 2,583 IN THE SAME PERIOD LAST YEAR, AND 3,106 WORKERS AND DEPENDENTS, AS AGAINST 10,742 LAST YEAR. THE NUMBER OF JEWISH NATURALIZATIONS, HOWEVER, INCREASED, TOTALLING 13,038 IN THE JANUARY-SEPTEMBER PERIOD AS COMPARED WITH 6,753 IN THE CORRESPONDING PERIOD LAST YEAR.

THE ECONOMIC DEPRESSION HAS AFFECTED THE BUDGET OF THE TEL AVIV MUNICIPALITY, WHOSE REVENUE IN THE APRIL-OCTOBER PERIOD FELL BELOW ESTIMATES. THE GOVERNMENT CONSEQUENTLY REDUCED THE TEL AVIV BUDGET BY ABOUT \$145,000, BESIDES THE \$250,000 KEPT IN RESERVE TO BE UTILIZED ONLY IF REVENUE JUSTIFIES ADDITIONAL EXPENDITURES.

LAND PURCHASES OF JEWS FROM ARABS WERE VALUED AT APPROXIMATELY \$1,645,000 IN NINE MONTHS. IN SEPTEMBER, 5,632 DUNAMS CHANGED HANDS. DESPITE THE DEPRESSION, CONSUMPTION OF ELECTRICITY DURING THE JANUARY-AUGUST PERIOD INCREASED MARKEDLY OVER THE CORRESPONDING PERIOD LAST YEAR.

"POLONIZATION" WILL UNDERMINE TRADE, POLISH JEWS' BOARD WARIS

WARSAW, Nov. 21. (JTA) -- THE PROVISIONAL BOARD OF POLISH JEWRY TODAY STRUCK BACK VIGOROUSLY AT THE UNION OF POLISH TRADERS FOR ITS RECENT DECISION TO PRESS FOR "POLONIZATION" OF COMMERCE AT THE EXPENSE OF THE JEWS.

THE BOARD, IN A RESOLUTION, SAID THE UNION'S ACTION, MEANING ELIMINATION AND DESTRUCTION OF JEWISH TRADERS BY MEANS OF LEGAL DISCRIMINATION, VIOLATED THE SPIRIT OF THE POLISH CONSTITUTION, WHICH GUARANTEES ALL CITIZENS THE RIGHT OF WORK AND THE POSSIBILITY OF ECONOMIC DEVELOPMENT.

TO CONTINUE IN THE COURSE THE UNION HAS MAPPED, THE RESOLUTION DECLARES, MEANS UNDERMINING THE ECONOMIC FOUNDATION OF TRADE, BASED ON THE PRINCIPLES OF FREE TRADE, AND WILL LEAD TO WEAKENING OF THE ENTIRE ECONOMIC STRUCTURE. THE RESOLUTION REJECTS INDIGNANTLY "THE INSINUATIONS AND INSULTS AGAINST JEWS AND JEWISH TRADESMEN, INSPIRED BY THE SPIRIT OF COMPETITION, ENVY AND HATRED," AND CALLS ON JEWISH MERCHANTS TO RESIST ACTS OF VIOLENCE AND FALSEHOOD.

U.S. ASKED TO INTERCEDE FOR POLISH JEWS

WASHINGTON, Nov. 21. (JTA) -- A PETITION APPEALING FOR AMERICAN INTERCESSION IN BEHALF OF THE "DOWNTRODDEN" POLISH JEWS WAS PRESENTED TO SECRETARY OF STATE CORDELL HULL YESTERDAY BY A DELEGATION REPRESENTING THE JEWISH PEOPLE'S COMMITTEE. THE MEMORANDUM PROTESTED "THE STATE OF LAWLESSNESS PERMITTED AND ENCOURAGED BY THE POLISH GOVERNMENT."

THE PRESENTATION OF THE APPEAL FOLLOWED A NATIONAL CONFERENCE OF THE COMMITTEE, ATTENDED BY 1,000 DELEGATES, AT WHICH SENATOR THOMAS OF UTAH DECLARED THAT "WHEN A NATION BEGINS KILLING ITS OWN, THAT NATION IS COMMITTING SUICIDE." HE PLEADED FOR "BETTER CONSIDERATION OF MINORITIES."

STREICHER TO VISIT DANZIG TO AID ANTI-JEWISH DRIVE

DANZIG, Nov. 21. (HAVAS) -- INTENSIFICATION OF ANTI-SEMITIC ACTIVITY WAS PREDICTED TODAY FOLLOWING A STATEMENT BY ALBERT FOERSTER, DANZIG NAZI LEADER, THAT THE FREE CITY WOULD SOON PLAY HOST TO JULIUS STREICHER, GERMANY'S LEADING JEW-BAITER. STREICHER'S VISIT WAS LINKED BY OBSERVERS WITH THE EXPECTED PROMULGATION OF NEW LAWS TO SAFEGUARD THE PURITY OF BLOOD AND RACE, WHICH FOERSTER FORECAST LAST MONDAY.

VON PAPEN REPORTED SUBSIDIZING AUSTRIAN ANTI-SEMITES' BOYCOTT DRIVE

BRUSSELS, Nov. 21. (JTA) -- GERMAN MINISTER FRANZ VON PAPEN, LE SOIR REPORTED TODAY FROM VIENNA, HAS GIVEN 250,000 SCHILLINGS TO THE AUSTRIAN ANTI-SEMITIC UNION TO INTENSIFY ANTI-JEWISH PROPAGANDA, PARTICULARLY THE PRE-CHRISTMAS BOYCOTT DRIVE.

VON PAPEN WAS SAID TO HAVE RECEIVED A DELEGATION OF THE UNION RECENTLY AND TO HAVE PROMISED A LARGE CONTRIBUTION AS A CHRISTMAS PRESENT. HE WAS ELECTED AN HONORARY MEMBER OF THE ORGANIZATION, THE DISPATCH SAID.

EUROPEAN JEWS IN "NIGHTMARE OF FEAR," RABBI WISE TELLS J.D.C. LEADERS

PHILADELPHIA, Nov. 21. (JTA) -- RABBI JONAH B. WISE, FUND-RAISING CHAIRMAN OF THE JOINT DISTRIBUTION COMMITTEE, TOLD THE 250 JEWISH LEADERS ATTENDING THE MIDDLE-ATLANTIC STATES REGIONAL CONFERENCE OF THE COMMITTEE TODAY THAT JEWS IN EUROPE WERE EXISTING IN A "NIGHTMARE OF CONSTANT FEAR."

"I WISH I COULD TELL YOU THAT WE ARE SEEING DAYLIGHT," SAID RABBI WISE. "THERE IS NO GLIMMER OF DAWN IN THE EASTERN HORIZON. DARKEST NIGHT STILL REIGNS OVER THE MAJOR PORTIONS OF THOSE HUMAN BEINGS WHOM WE SALUTE AS BRETHREN AND FOR WHOM WE HAVE A RESPONSIBILITY. THEY ARE EXISTING NOT ONLY IN DARKNESS BUT IN A NIGHTMARE OF CONSTANT FEAR."

AID TO OPPRESSED AND IMPOVERISHED JEWISH POPULATIONS OVERSEAS AND THE PARTICIPATION OF AMERICAN COMMUNITIES IN SUCH AID WAS THE TOPIC OF A ROUND-TABLE DISCUSSION. OTHERS ON THE PROGRAM INCLUDED ALBERT H. LIEBERMANN OF PHILADELPHIA, WHO, TOGETHER WITH JUSTICE HORACE STERN AND DR. CYRUS ADLER, SPONSORED THE GATHERING; PAUL BAERWALD, CHAIRMAN OF THE J.D.C. AND JOSEPH C. HYMAN, EXECUTIVE DIRECTOR.

MEMBERSHIP IN NAZI GROUPS HERE HELD BAR TO CITIZENSHIP

HACKENSACK, N.J., Nov. 21. (JTA) -- MEMBERS OF THE GERMAN-AMERICAN BUND, PRO-NAZI ORGANIZATION, WILL NOT BE GRANTED CITIZENSHIP IF THEY APPLY TO COMMON PLEAS JUDGE J. WALLACE LEYDEN, HE INDICATED HERE IN ADDRESSING A CLASS OF 124 NEW CITIZENS IN BERGEN COUNTY NATURALIZATION COURT.

"IT SEEMS OBVIOUS," THE JURIST SAID, "THAT A PERSON BELIEVING IN DICTATORSHIPS CAN NOT ALSO BELIEVE IN THE AMERICAN FORM OF GOVERNMENT. YOU CAN'T BE BOTH AN AMERICAN AND A GERMAN. YOU MUST BE EITHER ONE OR THE OTHER. I CONSIDER MEMBERSHIP IN THE GERMAN-AMERICAN BUND SUFFICIENT GROUNDS FOR DENYING CITIZENSHIP."

TEACHING OF HEBREW BANNED IN SAXONY'S UNIVERSITIES.

LONDON, Nov. 21. (JTA) -- EXCHANGE TELEGRAPH AGENCY REPORTED TODAY FROM BERLIN THAT THE MINISTER OF EDUCATION IN SAXONY HAS FOLLOWED THE EXAMPLE OF BAVARIA BY FORBIDDING THE TEACHING OF HEBREW IN UNIVERSITIES. HEBREW WAS PREVIOUSLY A REQUIRED SUBJECT FOR THEOLOGICAL STUDENTS.

HENRI CAIN, DRAMATIZER OF "THE POLISH JEW," DIES IN PARIS

PARIS, Nov. 21. (Havas) -- HENRI CAIN, MEMBER OF A WELL-KNOWN FRENCH FAMILY OF ARTISTS AND WRITERS, DIED HERE TODAY AT THE AGE OF 78. A PAINTER AND PLAYWRIGHT, CAIN ACHIEVED HIS GREATEST DISTINCTION IN DRAMATIZATIONS OF SUCH WORKS AS "THE POLISH JEW."

WORLD JEWISH CONGRESS CONGRATULATES CECIL ON NOBEL AWARD

PARIS, Nov. 21. (JTA) -- THE WORLD JEWISH CONGRESS SENT A MESSAGE OF CONGRATULATIONS TODAY TO LORD CECIL, NOTED PACIFIST AND OUTSPOKEN FOE OF NAZISM, WHO WAS AWARDED THE NOBEL PEACE PRIZE FOR 1937.
