KING CAROL ASKS GOGA, ANTI-SEMITIC LEADER, TO FORM NEW CABINET

BUCHAREST, Dec. 28. (JTA) -- King CAROL TODAY INVITED PROF. OCTAVIAN GOGA, CO-LEADER OF THE ANTI-SEMITIC NATIONAL CHRISTIAN PARTY AND ONE OF THE NATION'S MOST OUTSPOKEN ANTI-SEMITES, TO FORM A NEW CABINET. THE NEW MINISTERS ARE EXPECTED TO BE SWORN IN WITHIN 24 HOURS.

THE KING'S ACTION FOLLOWED OFFICIAL ANNOUNCEMENT OF THE RESIGNATION OF THE TATARESCU GOVERNMENT, WHICH FAILED TO RETAIN CONTROL OF PARLIAMENT IN THE RECENT NATIONAL ELECTIONS.

PORUNCA VREMI, ORGAN OF THE GOGA PARTY, DECLARED THE CABINET WOULD IMMEDIATELY SUPPRESS ALL JEWISH-OWNED NEWSPAPERS, PROHIBIT JEWISH JOURNALISTS FROM WRITING FOR ROMANIAN PAPERS, AND NATIONALIZE ROMANIAN TRADE AND INDUSTRY. THE LATTER WILL BE ACCOMPLISHED, THE PAPER STATES, BY ENACTING A LONG-PROJECTED MEASURE TO MAKE EMPLOYMENT BY ALL ENTERPRISES OF 90 PER CENT "PURE-BLOOD" ROMANIANS OBLIGATORY.

THE NEWSPAPER LISTED THE FOLLOWING AS THE PROBABLE CABINET LINE-UP: PREMIER AND INTERIOR MINISTER, PROF. GOGA; FOREIGN MINISTER, ISTRADE MICESCU; FINANCE MINISTER, GEORGE CUZA; MINISTER WITHOUT PORTFOLIO, PROF. ALEXANDER CUZA, CO-LEADER WITH GOGA OF THE NATIONAL CHRISTIAN PARTY.

THE GOGA PARTY OBTAINED ONLY NINE PER CENT OF THE TOTAL VOTE CAST IN THE DEC. 20 ELECTION, AS AGAINST AN ESTIMATED 37 PER CENT FOR THE GOVERNMENT PARTY, 21 PER CENT FOR THE "ALL FOR THE FATHERLAND" PARTY -- THE FASCIST IRON GUARD -- AND 24 PER CENT FOR THE NATIONAL PEASANTS PARTY.

IN A PRE-ELECTION STATEMENT, PROF. GOGA DECLARED THAT ANTI-SEMITIC FEELING IN ROMANIA WAS SO STRONG THAT NOTHING COULD PREVENT IT FROM ACHIEVING ITS OBJECT EVEN IF GRAVE DISTURBANCES SHOULD RESULT.

THE BELIEF THAT GOGA'S CABINET WOULD LEAN TOWARD THE ROME-BERLIN AXIS WAS STRENGTHENED WHEN IT WAS RECALLED THAT LAST SUMMER HE WENT ON A TOUR OF THE CAPITALS OF GERMANY, ITALY AND YUGOSLAVIA TO CONFER WITH THE LEADERS OF THEIR GOVERNMENTS. THE NATIONAL CHRISTIAN PARTY HAS BEEN VIGOROUSLY PRO-NAZI AND PRO-FASCIST.

VAAD LEUMI HITS "NON-COMPETENT" NEGOTIATORS, BARS PLANS NEGATING STATE

JERUSALEM, Dec. 28. (JTA) -- PALESTINE JEWRY WILL NEVER ACCEPT A PROPOSAL PREVENTING THE JEWS FROM "BUILDING A STATE ON THEIR OWN LAND," THE JEWISH NATIONAL COUNCIL (VAAD LEUMI) ASSERTED TODAY IN A STATEMENT COMMENTING ON REPORTS OF ARAB-JEWISH NEGOTIATIONS.

THE STATEMENT HELD THE REPORTS PROVED "ANTI-ZIONIST INTRIGUES IN JEWISH AND NON-JEWISH CIRCLES" FOR INTRODUCTION OF A NUMERUS CLAUSUS FIXING THE JEWS AS A PERMANENT MINORITY.

ONLY THE JEWISH AGENCY AND THE COUNCIL ARE COMPETENT TO NEGOTIATE ON POLITICAL QUESTIONS, THE STATEMENT DECLARED, AND THEY REPUDIATE THE "NON-COMPETENT" NEGOTIATIONS, WHICH WERE HELD TO BE CAUSING CONSTERNATION AMONG PALESTINE JEWRY, JEWS OF THE DIASPORA AND ALSO DECEIVING BRITISH PUBLIC OPINION.

FIFTY ARAB REFUGEES FROM NEIGHBORING VILLAGES ARRIVED AT SAFED AND RECOUNTED THAT THE VILLAGES OF ACHSANIA AND ARRABA HAD BEEN COMPLETELY ABANDONED BY THEIR INHABITANTS AS A RESULT OF RECENT BATTLES IN THE DISTRICT.

A SECOND ARAB WAS DETAINED IN TEL AVIV IN CONNECTION WITH THE MURDER OF THE AGED COUPLE FROM NEW YORK, MR. AND MRS. SAMUEL LEWIS. BOTH WERE REMANDED FOR A FORTNIGHT.

NINE JEWS OF KARKUR AND HEDERA WERE SCHEDULED TO BE RELEASED TODAY FROM ACRE CONCENTRATION CAMP AFTER THREE MONTHS' INTERNMENT. TWENTY-FIVE ARABS WERE ALSO TO BE FREED.

THE GOVERNMENT CATEGORICALLY DENIED A REPORT THAT FIVE BRITISH SOLDIERS HAD BEEN CAPTURED BY ARAB BANDS IN THE NORTH AND EXECUTED IN REPRISAL FOR THE HANGING OF SHEIKH FARHAN ESSADI LAST MONTH UNDER SENTENCE OF AN ARMY COURT. THE REPORT WAS CONTAINED IN A COMMUNIQUE SIGNED BY ABDULLAH AZBAD, DESCRIBED AS COMMANDER OF THE NORTHERN BANDS, ACCORDING TO WHICH ONLY TWO ARABS WERE KILLED IN RECENT FIGHTING. UNOFFICIAL ESTIMATES HAVE PUT THE ARAB SLAIN AT 43.

AN ARAB BOY WAS SLIGHTLY WOUNDED LAST NIGHT WHEN AN ARAB BUS, MISTAKEN FOR JEWISH, WAS SHOT AT NEAR JERUSALEM.

BRITAIN MAY POSTPONE PARTITION FOR DECADE, LONDON HEARS

LONDON, Dec. 28. (JTA) -- THE LIKELIHOOD THAT THE BRITISH GOVERNMENT WILL DECIDE TO CONTINUE TO ADMINISTER PALESTINE ON THE PRESENT BASIS AND POSTPONE PARTITIONING THE COUNTRY AT LEAST FOR A DECADE WAS DISCUSSED TODAY BY THE EVENING STANDARD.

WHILE NO DECISION HAS BEEN REACHED, IT IS LIKELY THAT THE NEW COMMISSION WHICH BRITAIN WILL SEND TO PALESTINE WILL BE GIVEN WIDER TERMS OF REFERENCE THAN THE LAST ROYAL COMMISSION AND ENCOURAGED TO MAKE ITS OWN ALTERNATIVE PROPOSALS TO PARTITION, THE STANDARD SAID.

A STRONG SECTION OF FOREIGN OFFICE OPINION IS BECOMING INCREASINGLY ALARMED OVER REACTIONS IN THE MOSLEM WORLD TO PARTITION, THE REPORT SAID, AND THIS SECTION HOLDS THAT AMID DANGERS IN THE FAR EAST BRITAIN CANNOT AFFORD FRESH DIFFICULTIES IN PALESTINE.

THE JERUSALEM CORRESPONDENT OF THE TIMES REPORTS THAT SOME HOPES ARE BEING EXPRESSED THAT THE LESSON INFLICTED ON ARMED ARAB BANDS WILL RESULT IN IMPROVEMENT IN THE GENERAL SITUATION BUT PUBLIC OPINION IS NOT OPTIMISTIC. HE ASSERTS IT IS NOT APPARENT ON WHAT GROUNDS THE COLONIAL SECRETARY BASED HIS STATEMENT IN COMMONS LAST WEEK THAT THERE WAS NOTICEABLE IMPROVEMENT IN SECURITY.

ROME WARNS BRITAIN ON ARABIC BROADCASTS

ROME, Dec. 28. (HAVAS) -- BRITISH PLANS TO BROADCAST FOREIGN LANGUAGE PROGRAMS AS AN ANTIDOTE TO ITALY'S ALLEGED ANTI-BRITISH RADIO PROPAGANDA CAMPAIGN BROUGHT FORTH A WARNING FROM VIRGINIO GAYDA, AUTHORITATIVE FASCIST SPOKESMAN, IN THE GIORNALE D'ITALIA TODAY.

THE SPOKESMAN SAID THAT THE BROADCASTS, WHICH WILL BEGIN NEXT MONDAY, WILL BE FOLLOWED WITH THE CLOSEST ATTENTION BY ITALY. ROME WILL KNOW HOW TO RETALIATE FOR THESE PROGRAMS SHOULD THEY ASSUME A "PROVOCATIVE AND DISTURBING TENOR," GAYDA WARNED. "BRITAIN IS TAKING THE INITIATIVE AGAINST ITALY IN THIS ATTACK," HE ADDED.

DECLARING THAT A BRITISH NEWSPAPER HAD DESCRIBED THESE BROADCASTS AS THE "FIRST COUNTER-ATTACK" AGAINST ITALY, GAYDA SAID THE BARI STATION DID NOT SPREAD ANTI-BRITISH PROPAGANDA, CONTRARY TO CHARGES BY FOREIGN SECRETARY ANTHONY EDEN.

DR. BERTHOLD FEIVEL, PIONEER ZIONIST, DIES AT 62

JERUSALEM, Dec. 28. (JTA) -- DR. BERTHOLD FEIVEL, WRITER, EDITOR AND PIONEER ZIONIST LEADER, DIED TODAY AT THE AGE OF 62. HE WAS AMONG THE DELEGATES ATTENDING THE FIRST ZIONIST CONGRESS AT BASLE IN 1897 AND WAS ASSOCIATED WITH DR. THEODOR HERZL IN EDITING THE CHIEF ZIONIST ORGAN, DIE WELT.

BORN IN CZECHOSLOVAKIA, HE WENT TO BERLIN AND IN 1902 HE HELPED FOUND THE JUEDISCHES VERLAG, WELL-KNOWN JEWISH PUBLISHING HOUSE. WHEN THE PALESTINE FOUNDATION FUND WAS ORGANIZED IN 1919, DR. FEIVEL BECAME ITS EXECUTIVE DIRECTOR IN LONDON AND HELD THE POST UNTIL 1926. HE WAS ALSO A MEMBER OF THE FINANCE COMMITTEE OF THE WORLD ZIONIST ORGANIZATION. TOGETHER WITH DR. MARTIN BIBER AND DR. CHAIM WEIZMANN, DR. FEIVEL OUTLINED THE PROJECT FOR A HEBREW UNIVERSITY.

MAURICE RAVEL, NOTED COMPOSER, DEAD

PARIS, Dec. 28. (JTA) -- MAURICE RAVEL, COMPOSER OF THE "BOLERO" AND OTHER WORLD-FAMOUS MUSICAL WORKS DIED HERE TODAY. THE RENOWNED JEWISH COMPOSER WAS 62. HIS DEATH OCCURRED AFTER A TWO-WEEK ILLNESS WHICH FOLLOWED A SERIOUS INTESTINAL OPERATION.

BESIDES HIS FAMOUS WORKS, RAVEL ARRANGED SEVERAL JEWISH FOLK SONGS. BORN MARCH 7, 1875 AT CIBOURNE, BASSES-PYRENEES, RAVEL SUCCEEDED BETTER THAN ALMOST ANY CONTEMPORARY FIGURE OF EQUAL STATURE IN KEEPING HIS PRIVATE LIFE STRICTLY PRIVATE.

HENRI BODENHEIMER, PRESIDENT OF ORT BOARD, DIES

PARIS, Dec. 28. (JTA) -- HENRI BODENHEIMER, BANKER, PRESIDENT OF THE CENTRAL BOARD OF THE INTERNATIONAL ORT UNION AND A MEMBER OF THE JEWISH CONSISTORY, DIED TODAY AT THE AGE OF 72.

MR. BODENHEIMER WAS THE HEAD OF THE BODENHEIMER BANQUE. HE WAS ACTIVE IN THE ALLIANCE ISRAELITE, THE FRENCH COMMITTEE FOR GERMAN REFUGEES. HE WAS ELECTED PRESIDENT OF THE ORT BOARD FIVE YEARS AGO WHEN THE ORT OFFICE WAS MOVED FROM BERLIN TO PARIS. IN 1935, M. AND MME. BODENHEIMER VISITED THE UNITED STATES IN THE INTERESTS OF THE WORLD ORT.

AMERICAN JEWISH CONGRESS PLANS DRIVE ON JOB DISCRIMINATION

NEW YORK, Dec. 28. (JTA) -- The American Jewish Congress announced today the publication of a report on Jewish non-employment as a result of economic discrimination, and also a nation-wide program to deal with the problem.

The program outlined in the pamphlet includes establishment of bureaus in communities where the Congress has branches to deal with discrimination, development of a program of educating employers, legislative correction of agency abuses, elimination of questions on religion from employment application blanks and formation of an advisory council of Christian liberals.

The report, the second of its kind, was prepared by Rabbi J.X. Cohen, chairman of the Congress's Commission on Economic Problems, and is entitled "Helping to End Economic Discrimination." It surveys cases of discrimination against Jewish job-seekers and warns this is "socially dangerous."

The pamphlet reports that the president of American Telephone and Telegraph Company, Walter S. Gifford, at the last national conference of presidents of local companies, advised his associates against permitting personnel managers to reject Jewish applicants because of prejudice, and shortly thereafter one of the departments of A.T. & T. "almost unprecidently" engaged a Jewish applicant.

POLISH RECTORS TO DISCUSS "GHETTO BENCHES"

WARSAW, Dec. 28. (JTA) -- A conference of all college rectors was convoked today for Jan. 15, at which time it is reported the question of "ghetto benches" will be discussed. Segregation of Jewish students is now enforced in nearly all Polish universities under government sanction. The system has drawn protests from educators and liberals all over the world.

DANZIG ANTI-SEMITIC CAMPAIGN HELD AIMED AT POLAND

WARSAW, Dec. 28. (JTA) -- A leading anti-semitic newspaper today warned that the anti-Jewish drive being pressed by the Danzig authorities is in reality directed against Poland. The warning is sounded by Kurjer Warszawski, organ of the moderate faction in the National Democratic Party. Quoting a long report in the Gdynia newspaper, Kurjer Baltycki, in support of its caution, the Endek organ declares: "Expropriation of Polish Jews in Danzig is directed against Poland."

POLISH ZIONISTS SUPPORT CONGRESS STAND ON PARTITION

WARSAW, Dec. 28. (JTA) -- After a two-day discussion, the Council of Polish Zionist Organizations adopted a resolution today expressing confidence in the World Zionist Executive and support of the Zionist Congress' political resolutions on creation of a Jewish state in part of Palestine.

BULLETINCAROL SWEARS IN GOGA'S CABINET

BUCHAREST, Dec. 28. (Havas) -- Octavian Goga succeeded tonight in forming a new government, which it was believed would swing Rumania away from Europe's democratic powers toward the Rome-Berlin axis. Goga and his ministers immediately went to the palace and took the oath of office before King Carol. National Christian Party members made up most of the new cabinet.
