RUMANIA FOR RUMANIANS" IS NEW CABINET'S POLICY, GOGA ANNOUNCES

BUCHAREST, Dec. 29. (JTA) -- Premier Octavian Goga announced today that "The Guiding principle of the New Government is Rumania for the Rumanians, Based on Jesus Christ, the King and the Nation."

THE NEWLY-INDUCTED CABINET WILL RESPECT THE CONSTITUTION, BEARING IN MIND, HOWEVER, THE SUPREME NATIONAL INTERESTS, THE PRO-FASCIST, ANTI-SEMITIC NATIONAL CHRISTIAN PARTY LEADER ASSERTED IN A FORMAL STATEMENT.

ANNOUNCING THAT HIS PROGRAM WAS VAST AND WOULD BE REVEALED SOON, PROF. GOGA APPEALED FOR UNITY AND REQUESTED THE COOPERATION "OF ALL CONSCIENTIOUS CITIZENS OF RUMANIA," EMPHASIZING THAT THE APPEAL WAS ALSO DIRECTED TO "MINORITIES WHICH HONESTLY ADAPT THEMSELVES TO THE HISTORIC MISSION OF RUMANIA."

PREMIER GOGA PREPARED TO CARRY OUT THE PROGRAM OF THE NATIONAL CHRISTIAN PARTY AFTER TAKING THE DATH OF OFFICE AS HEAD OF THE RUMANIAN GOVERNMENT. SWORN IN WITH HIS CABINET LAST NIGHT BY KING CAROL, HE SAID THAT WHILE FULFILLING THE NATIONAL CHRISTIAN PROGRAM, HE WOULD RESPECT CONSTITUTIONAL FORMS AND HIS GOVERNMENT WOULD BE BASED ON ORDER AND HOMESTY.

KING CAROL, IN ADMINISTERING THE OATH TO THE MINISTERS, DECLARED: "I KNOW YOU WILL FULFILL THE PROGRAM WITH PRUDENCE AND WITHOUT HESITATION. I WISH YOU SUCCESS IN STRENGTHEN-ING THE NATION AND FATHERLAND."

ALEXANDER CUZA, CO-PRESIDENT WITH PREMIER GOGA OF THE NATIONAL CHRISTIAN PARTY, IS MINISTER WITHOUT PORTFOLIO IN SPECIAL CHARGE OF GOVERNMENT LEGISLATION IN THE NEW CABINET. OTHER MATIONAL CHRISTIANS IN THE CABINET ARE: FORREIGN AFFAIRS, ISTRATE MICESCU; FINANCE, M. SAYU; INDUSTRY, M. GIGARTU; Religion, Ion Lupas; Cooperation, Stan Chitzescu; Labor, George Cuza, (Alexander Cuza's Son); Health, M. BANU.

Right-Wing National Peasant Party members in the cabinet are: Interior, Arond Calinescu; Justice, Radulescu Mehedinti; Communications, Virgil Potalcee.

TITULESCU SEES HIS TIME COMING

VIEMA, Dec. 29. (JTA) -- Ex-Foreign Minister Nicholas Titulescu of Rumania, visiting Vienna before leaving for Switzerland tonight, is convinced that the new Goda cabinet in Bucharest is merely a stop-gap government and that his own time is coming, the Jewish Telegraphic Agency Learned.

THE LAST ELECTIONS, IN WHICH THE TATARESCU LIBERAL PARTY LOST CONTROL OF THE CHAMBER OF DEPUTIES AND NO PARTY GAINED A MAJORITY, PRODUCED ELECTORAL CHAOS, TITLESCU WAS QUOTED AS SAYING. HE DENIED IN A PRESS STATEMENT THAT HIS VISIT TO VIENNA WAS OCCASIONED BY THREATS OF THE FASCIST IRON GUARD ON HIS LIFE. WHILE IN VIENNA TITULESCU CONSULTED PROF. HEINRICH ** NEUMANN, FAMOUS JEWISH EAR AND NOSE SPECIALIST.

PALESTINE DISORDERS CONTINUE: 3 ARABS HURT IN BUS ATTACK

JERUSALEM, DEC. 29. (JTA) -- Sporadic disorders continued today as British troops and planes pressed searches for Arab bands in various parts of Palestine. Military cars and troops were fired upon, without casualties, Near Tulkarem and Nablus. Three Arab passengers were wounded slightly when an Arab bus was shot at near Tulkarem.

Three thousand Arabs were reported to have attended funeral services in a field near Safed for Arab resels slain in the engagement near Arraba. The Arab population held a one-day strike yesterday when the authorities refused to permit public services in Safed.

AN ARAB WAS ARRESTED NEAR THE KING DAVID HOTEL'IN JERUSALEM AND WILL BE TRIED BY THE MILITARY COURT FOR POSSESSION OF A REVOLVER. MAJOR-GENERAL A.P. WAVELL, BRITISH COMMAND-ER-IN-CHIEF, REDUCED FROM LIFE TO FIVE YEARS EACH THE SENTENCES OF TWO NABLUS ARABS AND FREED FIVE OTHERS TRIED BY THE NABLUS MILITARY COURT DEC. 20 FOR POSSESSION OF ARMS.

PALESTINE REGAINING BIBLICAL FERTILITY, NOTED ARCHAELOGIST REPORTS

LONDON, DEC. 29. (JTA) -- RAINFALL IS RETURNING TO PALESTINE AND THE HOLY LAND IS RE-GAINING ITS BIBLICAL FERTILITY SIR CHARLES MARSTON, FAMOUS ARCHAEOLOGIST REPORTED TODAY.

EXCAVATIONS, RESUMED NOV. 20 FOR THE FIFTH WINTER, TESTIFY AGAIN TO THE RETURN OF RAINFALL TO THE PARCHED AND DESOLATE SOIL OF THE HOLY LAND, SAID SER CHARLES, WRITING IN THE EVENING STANDARD ON HIS OPERATIONS AT THE SITE OF THE BIBLICAL CITY OF LACHISH.

"NATURE THERE IS BECOMING MORE BENEFICENT AND IT LOOKS AS IF THE SOIL AGA" IS BECOM-ING FERTILE AND FRUITFUL AS IN THE BIBLE DAYS," HE ASSERTED. DRIED RIVER BEDS TESTIFY TO A FORMER ABUNDANCE OF WATER. A BRIDGE BILT BY THE MARSTON EXPEDITION ACROSS A WADI (STREAM WHICH RUNS ONLY IN THE RAINY SEASON) WAS SWEPT IN THE AUTUMN BY FLOODS, HE SAID.

THE SYSTEM OF EXCAVATION USED BY THE EXPEDITION -- LAYING DAMP HEAPS IN TERRACES ON THE SIDE OF THE MOUND -- CONVERTED THE HILL INTO AN OASIS FOR CULTIVATION OF FIRST-CLASS TOMATOES, HE SAID.

NEW PALESTINE COMMISSION TO GET ORDERS NEXT WEEK, LONDON HEARS

LONDON, DEC. 29. (JTA) -- THE DAILY TELEGRAPH'S DIPLOMATIC CORRESPONDENT REPORTED TODAY: THE BRITISH GOVERNMENT WOULD PUBLISH NEXT WEEK A WHITE PAPER CONTAINING INSTRUCTIONS FORTHE GUIDANCE OF THE NEW COMMISSION TO BE SENT TO PALESTINE. THE COMMISSION WILL BE GIVEN
GREATER LATITUDE THAN THE PEEL ROYAL COMMISSION, IT WAS STATED, THE SCOPE OF ITS WORK WILL
BE EXTENDED, AND IT IS UNDERSTOOD THE GOVERNMENT HAS DECIDED NOT TO CLOSE THE DOOR TO ALL
POSSIBILITY OF MODIFICATION OF THE PARTITION PLAN.

LANSBURY BROACHES PLAN TO AID PERSECUTED 3; TO BE BASIS OF HIS NEW PEACE DRIVE

LONDON, DEC. 29. (JTA) -- A PLAN TO EASE THE SUFFERING OF JEWS AND OTHER MINORITIES IN POLAND, AUSTRIA AND OTHER COUNTRIES WILL BE THE BASIS OF A NEW PEACE CAMPAIGN TO BE CONDUCTED BY GEORGE LANSBURY, NOTED PACIFIST AND LABOR LEADER, IN A NATION-WIDE CAMPAIGN.

ECONOMIC CONDITIONS ARE DEPONSIBLE FOR ANTI-JEWISH FEELING, SAID MR. LANSBURY, WHO
HAS JUST RETURNED FROM A TOUR OF POLAND AND AUSTRIA, IN AN INTERVIEW WITH THE NEWS-CHRONICLE
TODAY. ONLY BY PUTTING THESE COUNTRIES ON THEIR FEET CAN THE JEWISH AND MINORITY PROBLEM
BE SOLVED AND WAR AVERTED. HE SAID.

HE PROPOSED THE FLOATING OF AN INTERNATIONAL LOAN TO WHICH BRITAIN, THE UNITED STATES, FRANCE AND ALSO GERMANY AND ITALY SHOULD CONTRIBUTE, WHICH, HE SUGGESTED, WOULD BE ADMINISTERED BY AN INTERNATIONAL COMMISSION TO HELP, PUT THE COUNTRIES IN QUESTION ON THEIR FEET.

THE News-Chronicle, Decrying Persecution of Jews, SAID EDITORIALLY THAT PALLIATIVES WERE OF NO VALUE, AND MEASURES WERE NEEDED FOR A REVIVAL OF ECONOMIC LIFE IN THE COUNTRIES OF JEWISH PERSECUTION, TOGETHER WITH THE PULLING DOWN OF TRADE BARRIERS AND A REVIVAL OF EMIGRATION TO LANDS WHERE THE STRUGGLE FOR SURVIVAL IS LESS ACUTE.

GOEBBELS CANCELS TRIP TO EGYPT; CAIRO PROTESTS SEEN RESPONSIBLE

CAIRO, Dec. 29. (JTA) -- Reich Propaganda Minister Goebbels has cancelled his projected trip to this country next month, it was announced officially here today. Although fear that the change in climate might have a detrimental effect on his health was given as the reason, it is reported here that the decision followed discreet protests by the Egyptian Government. A Goebbels aide, Schwartz von Berk recently visited Cairo and other cities in the Near East.

FASCIST PAPER SCORES REVISIONISTS FOR "BRUTAL LACK OF TACT"

ROME, DEC. 29. (JTA) -- THE TURIN NEWSPAPER LA STAMPA TODAY ATTACKED THE ZIONIST REVISIONIST MOVEMENT AS "PROVOKING WITH ITS BRUTAL LACK OF TACT A DANGEROUS REACTION AMONG THE ARABS, WHOSE RELIGIOUS AND PATRIOTIC SENTIMENTS ARE HURT BY THE JEWISH RACE." CONTINUING ITS SERIES FROM JERUSALEM, THE CORRIERE DELLA SERA OF MILAN DECLARES THE "PAN-ARABIC TORCH IS STILL BURNING" AND THE ARABS WILL "CONTINUE TO FIGHT STRENUOUSLY TO DEFEND THEIR COUNTRY."

DE VALERA FOUND SYMPATHETIC ON JEWISH AIMS IN PALESTINE

LONDON, DEC. 29. (JTA) -- PRESIDENT DE VALERA OF THE IRISH FREE STATE SHOWED "DEEP UNDERSTANDING BOTH OF THE JEWISH PROBLEM AND JEWISH AIMS IN PALESTINE," PROF. SELIG BRODETSKY, MEMBER OF THE JEWISH AGENCY FOR PALESTINE EXECUTIVE, SAID TODAY IN DESCRIBING A RECENT LITER-VIEW WITH HIM IN DIRLIN.

FIRST REVISIONIST GROUP FORMED IN IRELAND; BRISCOE IS LEADER

DUBLING, DEC. 29. (JTA) -- FORMATION OF THE FIRST ZIONIST REVISIONIST ORGANIZATION IN IRELAND, UNDER THE LEADERSHIP OF DEPUTY ROBERT BRISCOE, WAS ANNOUNCED HERE TODAY. OTHER MEMBERS OF THE DIRECTORATE ARE PROF. LEONARD ABRAHAMSON OF THE ROYAL COLLEGE OF SURGEONS AND PROF. JOSHUA DEMTER OF TRINITY COLLEGE. PRESIDENT DE VALERA WILL RECEIVE VLADIMIR JABOTINSKY, WORLD REVISIONIST LEADER, ON JANUARY 10.

REPORT CZECHOSLOVAKIA HITS ONLY AT REICH COMMUNIST REFUGEES

PRAHA, Dec. 29. (JTA) -- REPORTS OF GOVERNMENT ACTION AGAINST REFIGEES FROM GERMANY IN ORDER TO CONCILIATE THE NAZIS COULD NOT BE CONFIRMED TODAY. AVAILABLE INFORMATION, HOWEVER, INDICATED THAT ORLY COMMUNIST REFUGEES HAVE BEEN ORDERED TO VACATE STATE-OWNED BUILDINGS. ONE PUBLICATION, OTTO STRASSER'S SCHWARZ FRONT HAS STOPPED PUBLICATION, WHILE THE SOCIAL DEMOCRATIC NEW YORWAERTS WILL PROBABLY TRANSFER ITS HEADQUARTERS TO ANOTHER COUNTRY.

DONATH, POET, DEAD IN PRAHA AT 61

PRAHA, Dec. 29. (JTA) -- ADOLF DONATH, POET AND LITERARY CRITIC, DIED TODAY AT THE AGE OF 51. HIS TWO BEST-KNOWN BOOKS OF POETRY ARE "JUDENLIEDER" AND "TAGE UND NACCHTE." HE WAS BORN IN KREMSIER, MORAVIA, RECEIVED HIS UNIVERSITY EDUCATION IN VIENNA AND LIVED MANY YEARS IN BERLIN.

ORGANIZATION FORMED TO AID JEWISK YOUTH ON FARMS

NEW YORK, Dec. 29. (JTA) -- THE JEWISH RURAL YOUTH ORGANIZATION OF AMERICA, AIMING TO AID IN THE ECONOMIC ADJUSTMENT OF JEWISH YOUTHS ON FARMS AND IMPROVE THEIR SOCIAL AND CULT-URAL CONDITIONS, WAS FORMED SUNDAY AT A CONVENTION HELD AT THE AMALGAMATED COOPERATIVE HOUSES IN THE BRONX AND ATTENDED BY 200 DELEGATES FROM MANY PARTS OF THE COUNTRY.

A CONSTITUTION AND BY-LAWS WERE DRAWN UP AND RESOLUTIONS WERE ADOPTED ESTABLISHING A COMMITTEE TO SEEK A LOAN FUND OF ABOUT \$25,000 TO SUPPLY CAPITAL TO JEWISH YOUTHS WISHING TO BEGIN FARMING, TO STUDY ECONOMIC ADJUSTMENT PROBLEMS AND TO AFFILIATE WITH OTHER YOUTH ORGANIZATIONS SEEKING IMPROVED CONDITIONS IN RURAL DISTRICTS. THE ORGANIZATION HOPES TO ENROLL THOUSANDS OF MEMBERS AMONG JEWISH YOUTH IN FARMING AREAS.
