### 3,440 CERTIFICATES SET AS 6-MONTH ENTRY SCHEDULE; 440 FOR CHRISTIANS

JERUSALEM, May 5. (JTA) -- THE GOVERNMENT TODAY ANNOUNCED A SIX-MONTH IMMIGRATION SCHEDULE OF 3,440 CERTIFICATES, OF WHICH 3,000 ARE EARMARKED FOR JEWS AND THE REMAINDER FOR CHRISTIANS.

THE CERTIFICATES FOR JEWS ARE TO BE ALLOTTED IN THE PROPORTION OF 2,000 FOR CAPITALISTS POSSESSING A MINIMUM OF \$5,000 AND 1,000 FOR LABORERS. IN THE LATTER CATEGORY, 830 CERTIFICATES WILL BE DISTRIBUTED BY THE JEWISH AGENCY FOR PALESTINE, WITH THE REMAINDER RESERVED FOR DISTRIBUTION BY THE GOVERNMENT IMMIGRATION DEPARTMENT.

FOUR HUNDRED OF THE LABOR CERTIFICATES ARE EARMARKED FOR USE OF CHALUTZIM, PIONEER YOUTHS IN TRAINING FOR PALESTINE WORK, 250 FOR SPECIALISTS, AND 180 FOR HOLDERS OF TEMPORARY VISAS WHO MIGHT OTHERWISE BE EXPELLED. TWO HUNDRED AND FIFTY CERTIFICATES ARE RESERVED FOR DEPENDENTS.

OF THE CERTIFICATES FOR CHRISTIANS, 20 ARE FOR CAPITALISTS, 150 FOR LABORERS, 50 FOR DEPENDANTS, TEN FOR PENSION HOLDERS, TEN FOR ORPHANS, AND 200 FOR CLERGYMEN.

# TROOPS PURSUE ARABS WHO RAIDED POLICE STATION

JERUSALEM, May 5. (JTA) -- Five hundred British troops were today pursuing a large Arab band which had attacked a police station at Karkur, a Jevish colony in the Sharon Valley. The Arabs had been held off by Machine-gun fire until arrival of the troops. Extent of casualties was not immediately ascertained.

## DENY IBN SAUD PROTESTED PARTITION

CAIRO, MAY 5. (JTA) -- EMIR IBN SAUD OF SAUDI ARABIA HAS NOT PROTESTED PROPOSED PARTITION OF PALESTINE TO BRITAIN'S NEW COMMISSION, AS REPORTED, AN ORIENT ARABE DESPATCH DECLARED TODAY. THE EMIR WAS REPRESENTED AS NOT HAVING FORMULATED HIS OPINION YET.

## RUMANIA ASKS LITTLE ENTENTE TO BALK LEAGUE ACTION ON JEWS

BUCHAREST, May 5. (JTA) -- A CONFERENCE OF THE LITTLE ENTENTE HAD BEFORE IT TODAY RUMANIA'S DEMAND THAT CZECHOSLOVAKIA AND YUGOSLAVIA JOIN HER IN REJECTING LEAGUE OF NATIONS "INTERFERENCE" IN THE JEWISH PROBLEM. THE DEMAND WAS MADE AT YESTERDAY'S OPENING SESSION, HELD AT SINAIA, FOLLOWING DISCUSSION OF RUMANIA'S ANTI-SEMITIC MEASURES BY FOREIGN MINISTER NICHOLAS PETRESCU-COMMEN.

#### ENTENTE STRESSES 'INDIVIDUAL SOVEREIGNTY'

SINAIA, MAY 5. (HAVAS) -- THE FOREIGN MINISTERS OF THE LITTLE ENTENTE -- RUMANIA, CZECHOSLOVAKIA AND YUGOSLAVIA -- REAFFIRMED THEIR COMMUNITY OF INTERESTS TONIGHT AFFER A TWO-DAY SESSION HERE. POINTS TOUCHED UPON IN THE COMMUNIQUE ISSUED AT THE END OF THE DELIB ERATIONS AND IN SPECCHES BY SPOKESMEN FOR THE GROUP MERE AS FOLLOWS:

- I -- THE THREE COUNTRIES WILL WORK TOGETHER FOR GOOD RELATIONS WITH ALL OTHER COUNTRIES AND WILL REFRAIN AS FAR AS POSSIBLE FROM GIVING CAUSE FOR DISPUTE.
- 2-- THE ENTENTE CONSIDERS THE RECENTLY CONCLUDED ANGLO-ITALIAN RECONCILIATION A CONTRIBUTION OF HIGH IMPORTANCE TO LASTING PEACE.
- 3-- ALL THREE GOVERNMENTS DESIRE TO PURSUE NEGOTIATIONS TOWARD CORDIAL RELATIONS WITH HUNGARY.
- 4-- THE ENTENTE REMAINS FAITHFUL TO THE LEAGUE OF NATIONS, BUT STRESSES THAT INDIVID-UAL SOVEREIGNTY OVER DOMESTIC PROBLEMS MUST BE BORNE IN MIND -- AN EVIDENT ALLUSION TO COMPLAINTS AGAINST GOVERNMENT MEASURES LODGED IN REGARD TO RUMANIA'S JEWISH MINORITY. RUMANIAN FOREIGN MINISTER PETRESCU-COMNEN DECLARED IN THIS CONNECTION HE HAD BEEN PROMISED THE SUPPORT OF CZECHOSLOVAKIA AND YUGOSLAVIA AT GENEVA.
- 5-- THE STATUS OF THE INTERNATIONAL COMMISSION TO REGULATE NAVIGATION ON THE DANGE WAS STUDIED IN THE LIGHT OF AUSTRIA'S DEPARTURE. IT WAS DECIDED TO MAINTAIN THE BODY, BUT HEADQUARTERS WILL BE MOVED FROM VIENNA, PROSABLY TO BELGRADE. ON RUMANIA'S SUGGESTION, THE LITTLE ENTENTE MAY SOON DISCUSS EXTENDING THE COMMISSION'S JURISDICTION TO THE BLACK SEA FROM ITS PRESENT TERMINUS AT BRAILA, IN INLAND RUMANIA.

### DARANY! HOLDS HUNGARIANS FAVOR ANTI-JEWISH BILL; NOTABLES PROTEST MEASURE

BUDAPEST, May 5. (JTA) -- PREMIER KOLOMAN DARANYI TODAY TOLD THE BUDAPEST CORRESPONDENT OF THE BELGRADE NEWSPAPER, VREME, THAT APART FROM THE AFFECTED JEWISH POPULATION THE HUNGALIAN PUBLIC HAD RECEIVED THE BILL CURBING JEWS WITH "GREAT SATISFACTION."

PARTICIPATION OF JEWS IN THE ECONOMIC AND CULTURAL LIFE OF THE COUNTRY IN PROPORTION WITH THEIR NUMBERS, DR. DARAMY DECLARED, WAS IN ACCORD WITH HUNGARIAN IDEAS OF FAIRNESS AND HUMANITY. HE SAID THAT REGULATION OF THE JEWISH PROBLEM WAS TO ENABLE CHRISTIAN HUNGARIAN YOUTH TO FIND MORE OPENINGS IN THE ECONOMIC SPHERE.

MEANWHILE, 37 OF HUNGARY'S MOST PROMINENT ARTISTS, MUSICIANS AND JOURNALISTS PUBLISHED A JOINT PROTEST AGAINST THE PROPOSED LEGISLATION.

### 500 AUSTRIAN JEWS REPORTED EMIGRATING TO MEXICO

VIENNA, MAY 5. (HAVAS) -- FIVE HUNDRED AUSTRIAN JEWISH EMIGRANTS SOON WILL LEAVE FOR MEXICO UNDER THE TERMS OF AH AGREEMENT CONCLUDED HERE BETWEEN GERMAN AND MEXICAL AUTHORITIES, IT WAS REPORTED TODAY. NEGOTIATIONS FOR THE EMIGRATION OF AUSTRIA'S JEWISH RESIDENTS TO MEXICO HAVE BEEN UNDERWAY FOR SOME TIME.

## \$830,000 RAISED IN ENGLAND FOR AUSTRIAN JEWS

LONDON, MAY 5. (JTA) -- A TOTAL OF E126,000 (ABOUT \$830,000) HAS BEEN RAISED IN THE BRITISH APPEAL FOR AUSTRIAN JEWS, ACCORDING TO THE FIFTH LIST PUBLISHED TODAY.

#### REICH REPORTED CURBING PRACTICE OF JEWISH DOCTORS, LAWYERS WHO SERVED IN WAR

BASEL, SWITZERLAND, MAY 5. (JTA) -- THE EXCEPTIONS FOR JEWISH PHYSICIANS AND LAWYERS IN GERMANY WHO WERE FRONT-FIGHTERS HAVE BEEN ALTERED AND THEIR ACTIVITY RESTRICTED TO JEWISH PATIENTS AND CLIENTS, THE NATIONAL ZEITUNG REPORTED TODAY FROM BERLIN.

LIQUIDATION OF JEWISH CAPITAL IN GERMANY AND AUSTRIA WITHIN TWO YEARS IS EXPECTED BY WELL-INFORMED CIRCLES, THE DISPATCH SAID. POOR JEWS WILL BE COMPELED TO EMIGRATE, IT WAS STATED, HOWEVER THE AUTHORITIES REALIZE THE DIFFICULTIES REGARDING IMMIGRATION RESTRICTIONS OF VARIOUS COUNTRIES.

According to the Zeitung, the decree for the registration of Jewish capital had been grafted at the time of the trial in December, 1936, arising out of the assassination of Wilhelm Gustloff, Swiss Nazi Leader, but its promulgation was postponed because other means of financing the German four-year plan were hitherto sufficient.

### GERMAN FIRMS IN DENMARK DISCHARGE JEWS

COPENHAGEN, MAY 5. (JTA) -- GERMAN FIRMS IN DEMMARK HAVE BEGUN DISCHARGING ALL THEIR JEWISH EMPLOYES, IT WAS LEARNED TODAY, FOLLOWING ADVICE GIVEN BY THE GERMAN CHAMBER OF COMMERCE OF COPENHAGEN. THIS WAS DONE "TO CREATE A FAVORABLE IMPRESSION IN GERMANY," ACCORDING TO NEWSPAPER ACCOUNTS.

### SUDETEN GERMANS BOYCOTT JEWS, CZECHS

PRAHA, MAY 5. (JTA) -- A BOYCOTT OF JEWISH AND CZECHOSLOVAK FIRMS IS BEING SYSTEMATICALLY CONDUCTED BY THE HENLEIN PARTY, WITH MEMBERS BEING FINED TEN CROWNS FOR VIOLATIONS, IT WAS LEARNED TODAY. SEVERAL SUCH CASES HAVE BEEN ESTABLISHED AT TEGLITZ-SCHOENAU BY THE POLICE.

### NEW POLISH ANTI-SEMITIC ORGANIZATION BOASTS OF BOMBINGS

WARSAW, May 5. (JTA) -- Existence of a New ANTI-Semitic terrorist organization KNOWN as the National Revolutionary Fight Organization was revealed today.

IN A COMMUNIQUE SENT TO RIGHT-WING NATIONALIST PAPERS, THE GROUP BOASTS OF RESPONSIB-ILITY FOR SEVERAL RECENT BOMBINGS, INCLUDING THE MAY DAY EXPLOSION IN THE JEWISH QUARTER. BELIEVING IT TO BE A DISSIDENT BODY OF THE NATIONAL RADICAL PARTY, THE AUTHORITIES ARE EX-PECTED TO TAKE ENERGETIC MEASURES FOR ITS LIQUIDATION.

POLICE, MEANWHILE, ARRESTED THREE NARAS FOR POSSESSION OF EXPLOSIVES. THEY ARE SUSPECTED OF PARTICIPATING IN THE MAY DAY BOMBING. NAHUM BOXNE, A JEW WOUNDED DURING THE ANTI-SEMITIC EXCESSES AT TARNOPOL SEVERAL WEEKS AGO, DIED IN A HOSPITAL TODAY.

A BIELSKO COURT TODAY SENTENCED SEVEN MEMBERS OF THE POLISH SOCIALIST PARTY TO PRISON TERMS OF SIX MONTHS EACH FOR PARTICIPATING IN A ROUT OF NARA PICKETS FROM JEWISH SHOPS IN SOSNOWIEC. EXECUTION OF THE SENTENCE, HOWEVER, WAS POSTPONED FOR TWO YEARS.

### CROAT LEADER DENDUNCES ANTI-SEMITISM; SEES JEWS AS 'SCAPEGOATS'

BELGRADE, May 5. (JTA) -- ANTI-SEMITISM WAS DENOUNCED BY DR. VLADIMIR MACEK, LEADER OF THE CROATIAN PEASANT PARTY AND HEAD OF THE UNITED OPPOSITION, IN AN INTERVIEW PUBLISHED TODAY.

"WE CROATS," DR. MACEK IS QUOTED AS STATING, "DO NOT HATE JEWS; NEITHER IS JEW-HATRED KNOWN IN DEMOCRACIES THROUGHOUT THE WOPLD. ANTI-SEMITISM IS CHARACTERISTIC OF THE MORALS OF CERTAIN CIRCLES WHICH ARE TODAY LEADING THE WORLD. JEWS ARE MADE THE SCAPEGOATS OF ANY FAILURE. WE CROATS WILL NOT FOLLOW THAT EXAMPLE."

REGENT PRINCE PAUL TODAY EXPRESSED SYMPATHY FOR THE JEWISH PEOPLE AND PALESTINE UPBUILDING DURING AN AUDIENCE GRANTED TO DR. DAVID ALBALA, VICE-PRESIDENT OF THE UNION OF JEWISH COMMUNITIES.

#### MAX PINTER, JOURNALIST, DIES IN BUDAPEST

BUDAPEST, MAY 5. (JTA) -- MAX PINTER, WELL-KNOWN JEWISH JOURNALIST, DIED HERE TODAY AT THE AGE OF 60. HE WAS EDITOR-IN-CHIEF OF ORSZAGOS EGYETERTES, A JEWISH WEEKLY, SINCE 1926. PINTER WAS FORMERLY ASSOCIATED WITH THE DAILY EGYETERTES AND LATER EDITOR OF THE NEUES POLITISCHES VOLKBLATT.

### BRITAIN OUSTS REICH FROM POSITION AS BIGGEST SELLER TO PALESTINE

JERUSALEM (JTA) -- GREAT BRITAIN HAS REGAINED ITS POSITION AS BIGGEST SELLER OF GOODS TO PALESTINE FROM GERMANY, WHICH LAST YEAR CAPTURED FIRST PLACE FOR THE FIRST TIME IN HISTORY.

OF TOTAL IMPORTS OF E1,203,164 IN FEBRUARY, 1938, THE UNITED KINGDOM SUPPLIED L245,348, OR 20.4 PER CENT, WHILE GERMANY FURNISHED L158,689, OR 13.2 PER CENT. THE REICH WAS EVEN NOSED OUT OF SECOND PLACE BY RUMANIA BY THE MARGIN OF L7. THE SITUATION WAS MUCH DIFFERENT IN FEBRUARY, 1937, WHEN, OF TOTAL PALESTINE IMPORTS OF L1,363,168, GERMANY HELD FIRST PLACE WITH L226,230, OR 16.6 PER CENT, AND BRITAIN FOLLOWED WITH L198,979, OR 14.6 PER CENT.

THE UNITED STATES HAS DROPPED FROM FOURTH TO FIFTH PLACE AS A SELLER TO THE HOLY LAND. IN FEBRUARY, 1937, SHE SUPPLIED \$\( 106,340\), OR 7.8 PER CENT, WHILE A YEAR LATER THE FIGURE WAS \$\( 63,569\), OR 5.3 PER CENT.

## JEWISH WORKERS ARMED, GUARDED IN BUILDING ELECTRIC LINES IN GAZA

GAZA, PALESTINE (JTA) -- IN THIS ANCIENT FISHING TOWN, A LARGE GROUP OF JEWS ARE LIVING FOR THE FIRST TIME IN 2,000 YEARS.

THEY ARE THE CREW OF JEWISH WORKMEN WHO ARE ERECTING THE POWER LINE TO BRING THE MODERN WORLD INTO GAZA. UNDER A CONTRACT RECENTLY SIGNED WITH THE PALESTINE ELECTRIC CORPORATION, GAZA IS BEING ELECTRIFIED. THE WORKERS WHO ARE PUTTING UP THE POLES, STRINGING THE LINES AND INSTALLING THE LIGHTS ARE JEWS.

To assure the safety of the workers, the Mayor published a proclamation pointing out the useful service they were performing for the town and urging the populace to receive them in a friendly manner. This notice was supplemented by a police guard and by allowing some of the workers to carry revolvers.
