HUNGARIAN TEACHERS PREACH HATRED OF JEWS, PARLIAMENT TOLD

BUDAPEST, May 19. (JTA) -- EXTENT OF NAZI PROPAGANDA IN HUNGARY WAS REVEALED TODAY DURING A DISCUSSION IN THE CHAMBER OF DEPUTIES OF A BILL IMPOSING FINES ON ILLEGAL ASSOCIATIONS.

KARL PEYER, LEADER OF THE SOCIAL DEMOCRATIC PARTY, CHARGED THAT SECONDARY SCHOOLS
THROUGHOUT THE NATION WERE COMPLETELY NAZIFIED, WITH TEACHERS PREACHING HATRED OF JEWS
TO THEIR PUPILS. HE ASSERTED THAT NAZI AGITATORS WERE APPEALING TO THE LOWEST INSTINCTS
OF THE MASSES, PROMISING EXECUTIVE JOBS TO ADMERENTS AFTER THE NAZI REVOLUTION.

A PROPOSAL TO BAN USE OF THE CROSS IN POLITICAL BADGES WAS WITHDRAWN BY DEPUTY REIBEL, CHRISTIAN SOCIALIST, WHEN HE WAS INFORMED OF THE GOVERNMENT'S INTENTION TO INTRODUCE A SIMILAR MEASURE.

ARABS ATTACK JEWS ERECTING BORDER BARRICADE

JERUSALEM, MAY 19. (JTA) -- A BRISK EXCHANGE OF SHOTS BETWEEN ARAB TERRORISTS AND JEWISH WORKERS ERECTING THE BARBED-MIRE BARRICADE ON THE PALESTINE-SYRIAN BORDER OCCURRED TODAY NEAR HANITA, NORTHERN-MOST JEWISH COLONY. THERE WERE NO CASUALTIES.

POLICE ENGAGED AN ARAB BAND ATTEMPTING TO DAMAGE A BRIDGE ON THE JERUSALEM-TEL AVIV ROAD, CAPTURING ONE BANDIT.

LABOR UNREST CONTINUED TO SPREAD. SCORES OF UNEMPLOYED DEMONSTRATED AT THE JEWISH COLORY OF PETACH TIKVAH, INVADING THE LOCAL COUNCIL OFFICE. POLICE ARRESTED NINE OF THEM. AT HEDERA, JOBLESS PICKETED THE LOCAL COUNCIL CARRYING SIGNS READING, "WE WANT WORK."

REICH FOREIGN TRADE SHOWS DEFICIT IN APRIL

ZERLIN, MAY 19. (HAVAS) -- GERMANY'S FOREIGN TRADE BALANCE SHOWED A DEFICIT IN APRIL, ACCORDING TO FIGURES RELEASED TODAY IN WHICH AUSTRIA NO LONGER FIGURES AS A FOREIGN COUNTRY. IN MARCH THE BALANCE WAS FAVORABLE BUT APRIL SHOWED AN IMPORT EXCESS OF 2C,000,000 MARKS. (THE MARK IS NOMINALLY WORTH 40 CENTS.) IMPORTS FOR "GREATER GERMANY TOTALLED 477,000,000 MARKS AND EXPORTS 451,000,000 MARKS.

IMPORTS FOR GERMANY WITHOUT AUSTRIA WERE 429,000,000 MARKS, OR 26,000,000 MARKS LESS THAN IN THE MONTH OF MARCH. THE DROP WAS MAINLY IN INDUSTRIAL PRODUCTS. IMPORT OF GRAINS INCREASED, HOWEVER, BY 5,500,000 MARKS. EXPORTS OF GERMANY WITHOUT AUSTRIA TO OTHER COUNTRIES (EXCLUDING AUSTRIA) TOTALLED 422,000,000 MARKS IN CONTRAST TO 466,000,000 MARKS IN MARCH. EXPORT OF FINISHED PRODUCTS DROPPED 34,000,000 MARKS.

FOREIGN INTERVENTION CHARGE TO FIGURE IN CODREANU TRIAL

BUCHAREST, May 19. (Havas) -- Charges of attempted foreign intervention in this country's domestic affairs will play a part unprecedented in modern Rumanian history when Corneliu Zelea Codreanu goes on trial for treason before a court martial next monnay.

THE HEARINGS FOR THE MOST PART WILL BE OPEN TO THE PUBLIC, BUT SECRET SESSIONS WILL BE HELD WHEN EVIDENCE IS HEARD OF THE FOREIGN FINANCIAL AND MORAL SUPPORT WHICH ALLEGEDLY HAD ENABLED THE PRO-FASCIST IRON GUARD LEADER TO PURSUE HIS ADVENTUROUS CAREER DURING THE LAST FEW YEARS.

IDENTITY OF THESE FOREIGN ELEMENTS IS BEING SCRUPULOUSLY WITHHELD, AND CENSOR-SHIP HAS EVIDENTLY BEEN RESPONSIBLE FOR THE BLANK SPACES APPEARING IN THE DOCUMENTARY MATERIAL MADE PUBLIC THUS FAR. IT IS WIDELY NOTED, HOWEVER, THAT ONE DOCUMENT, IN WHICH CODREANU ANNOUNCED THE SUCCESS OF HIS RUMANIAN "NATIONAL SOCIALIST" MOVEMENT, WAS LEFT UNTOUCHED BY AUTHORITIES.

FIRST JEWISH WOMAN NAMED TO SOUTH AFRICAN PARLIAMENT; HERTZOG PARTY LEADS

CAPE TOWN, MAY 19. (JTA) -- THE FIRST JEWISH WOMAN TO HOLD A SEAT IN THE SOUTH AFRICAN PARLIAMENT, BERTHA SOLOMON, LAWYER AND SOCIAL WORKER, WAS ELECTED YESTERDAY. SHE IS A PROVINCIAL COUNCILLOR. OTHER JEWS RETURNED IN YESTERDAY'S GENERAL ELECTION ARE MORRIS ALEXANDER OF CAPE TOWN, MORRIS KENTRIDGE OF JOHANNESBURG AND DR. HENRY GLUCKMAN OF JOHANNESBURG, ALL OF THE UNITED FUSION PARTY. ABRAHAM GOLDBERG OF DURBAN WAS THE ONLY JEWISH MEMBER ELECTED BY THE DOMINION PARTY.

THE UNITED PARTY OF PRIME MINISTER J.B.M. HERTZOG HELD A WIDE LEAD TODAY OVER ALL ITS OPPONENTS IN THE ELECTION WITH THE COUNT IN THE URBAN DISTRICTS COMPLETED AND WITH THE RURAL RETURNS JUST BEGINNING TO COME IN. THE URBAN CENTERS GAVE THE UNITED PARTY 51 SEATS; THE NATIONALISTS, 0; THE DOMINION PARTY, 6; LABOR,3; SOCIALIST, 1; INDEPENDENTS, 0. FIRST RURAL RETURNS GAVE THE UNITED PARTY THREE MORE SEATS RAISING ITS TOTAL TO 54, AND LEFT THE STANDING OF THE OTHERS UNCHANGED.

POLISH TOWN TO RENAME STREETS NAMED FOR JEWS

WARSAW, MAY 19. (JTA) -- THE MUNICIPAL COUNCIL OF MIEDZYRZEC NEAR BREZESC-LITEWSKI HAS DECIDED TO RENAME I.L. PERETZ, SHOLEM ASCH AND ADLER STREETS, WHICH WERE NAMED FOR FAMOUS JEWS. JEWISH MEMBERS OF THE COUNCIL WALKED OUT IN PROTEST AGAINST THE ACTION.

A CONFERENCE OF RADICAL STUDENTS ASSOCIATIONS IN WILNO SENT A RESOLUTION TO THE RECTOR OF WILNO UNIVERSITY DEMANDING A COMPLETE BAN ON ADMISSION OF JEWS TO UNIVERSITIES. THE RESOLUTION SAID THAT THE SEGREGATION OF JEWINH STUDENTS IN "GHETTO BENCHES" WAS ONLY A PRELIMINARY STEP TO EXCLUSION.

CHURCH IN BELGIUM BANS CATHOLIC GROUP FIGHTING ANTI-SEMITISM

ANTWERP, BELGIUM, MAY 19. (JTA) -- THE "KATHOLIEK BUREAU VOOR ISRAEL," A CATHOLIC ORGANIZATION DEVOTED TO FIGHTING ANTI-SEMITISM, HAS BEEN ORDERED BY VAN CAUMELAERT, ASSISTANT TO CARDINAL VAN ROEY, THE ARCHBISHOP OF MECHELEN, HEAD OF THE CATHOLIC CHURCH IN BELGIUM, TO DISCONTINUE ITS ACTIVITIES. THE ORDER FOLLOWED THE BREAKING UP BY ANTI-SEMITES OF A LECTURE OF THE FRENCH CATHOLIC WRITER, OSCAR DEFERENZIE. CATHOLIC LEADERS ARE APPARENTLY UNNILLING TO ANTAGONIZE THE ANTI-SEMITES IN VIEW OF THE FORTHCOMING MUNICIPAL ELECTIONS.

HITLER REPORTED CONSIDERING APPROACHING ROOSEVELT ON GOERING DECREE

NEW YORK, MAY 19. (JTA) -- CHANCELLOR HITLER IS CONSIDERING A SUGGESTION THAT HE APPROACH PRESIDENT ROOSEVELT DIRECTLY TO LIQUIDATE DIFFERENCES OVER APPLICATION OF MARSHAL HERMANN GOERING'S PROPERTY REGISTRATION DECREE TO AMERICANS AND OVER SALE OF AMERICAN HELIUM TO THE REICH, ACCORDING TO A NEW YORK TRIBUNE DISPATCH FROM BERLIN.

RUMANIAN JEWS HERE PROTEST TO CAROL ON ATTACKS BY CHURCH GROUP

NEW YORK, MAY 19. (JTA) -- THE UNITED RUMANIAN JEWS OF AMERICA HAS SENT A LETTER TO KING CAROL OF RUMANIA PROTESTING AGAINST ATTACKS ON THE JEWS OF AMERICA BY THE EPISCOPATE OF THE RUMANIAN CHURCH IN AMERICA AND ITS OFFICIAL NEWSPAPER, SOLIA. DECLARING THAT SUCH ATTACKS ARE DESTROYING RELATIONS BETWEEN RUMANIAN CHRISTIANS AND JEWS, THE LETTER ASKS KING CAROL TO "TAKE SUCH MEASURES AS WILL PREVENT THE REPETITION OF MISLEADING AND UNFAVORBLE PROPAGANDA AFFECTING THE GOOD NAME OF RUMANIA."

AUSTRIA REQUIRES SPECIAL PERMISSION TO DEAL IN JEWS' PROPERTY

PRAHA, MAY 19. (JTA) -- AN ORDER PROHIBITING BUYING AND SELLING OF JEWS' PROPERTY WITHOUT SPECIAL PERMISSION HAD BEEN ISSUED BY THE NAZI AUTHORITIES IN VIENNA, IT WAS REPORTED HERE TODAY.

PETITION IN PARLIAMENT SEEKS GREATER PALESTINE IMMIGRATION

LONDON, MAY 19. (JTA) -- COMMANDER OLIVER LOCKER-LAMPSON, CONSERVATIVE, IS ORGANIZING A PETITION MOVEMENT AMONG MEMBERS OF PARLIAMENT TO OBTAIN PERMISSION FOR ENLARGED PALESTINE JEWISH IMMIGRATION. MANY HAVE ALREADY SIGNED.

POLAND AWARDS MEDAL TO HEAD OF JEWISH TRADERS

WARSAW, MAY 19. (JTA) -- THE GOVERNMENT'S MEDAL OF MERIT FOR SOCIAL ACTIVITIES WAS TODAY AWARDED TO ABRAHAM GEPNER, WELL-KNOWN JEWISH INDUSTRIALIST AND CHAIRMAN OF THE JEWISH TRADERS' ASSOCIATION.

DEAN INGE DENIES EXISTENCE OF "ELDERS OF ZION"

LONDON, MAY 19. (JTA) -- DEAN WILLIAM RALPH INGE, "THE GLOOMY DEAN," STRONGLY DENIED TODAY THE EXISTENCE OF AN "ELDERS OF ZION" GROUP SEEKING WORLD DOMINATION. WRITING IN THE EVENING STANDARD, HE DECLARED THAT NOT A JEWISH BUT A SCOTTISH STRANGLEHOLD EXISTED IN LONDON. HE ASKED SARCASTICALLY WHY CHANCELLOR HITLER, WANTING TO GET RID OF THE JEWS, DID NOT IMPORT A FEW THOUSAND SCOTS, WHO WERE UNQUESTIONABLY "ARYAN."

THOMAS MANN LAYS CORNERSTONE FOR FAIR'S PALESTINE PAVILION

NEW YORK, MAY 19. (JTA) -- Using a stone from a Third Century Synagogue Brought From the site of Hanita, Palestine's newest colony, Thomas Mann, the author, Today Laid the Cornerstone for the Palestine Pavilion at the New York World's Fair in the Presence of 800 Government and fair officials, Jewish Leaders and others.

"AS THE HAMMER STRIKES ITS SYMBOLIC BLOW, I ACCOMPANY IT WITH MY SINCEREST WISHES FOR THE OUTSTANDING SUCCESS OF THE EXHIBIT PLANNED HERE," DR. MANN SAID IN A DEDICATION ADDRESS. "IT WILL PRESENT A PICTURE OF THE CULTURAL AND SOCIAL CONSTRUCTIVE WORK OF THE JEWS IN PALESTINE, AN UNDERTAKING FOR THE SUCCESS OF WHICH MEN OF CHRISTIAN BIRTH CAN AND MUST HOPE AS DEEPLY AS DOES THE JEW. THAT COUNTRY, WHICH WE CHRISTIANS, TOO, KNOW AS THE HOLY LAND, IS ONE OF THE FOUNTAINHEADS OF OCCIDENTAL CIVILIZATION AND RELIGIOUS LIFE."

HE CONTINUED: "THE PERSECUTION AND OPPRESSION WHICH JEWRY MUST SUFFER TODAY LEAVE QUITE UNSHAKEN MY CONVICTION THAT THIS RACE, WITH ITS MIXTURE OF SPIRITUALITY AND EARTH-INESS WILL PLAY AN IMPORTANT -- PERHAPS A DECISIVE -- PART IN THE SHAPING OF THE FUTURE."

MAYOR LAGUARDIA GREETED THE PALESTINE PAVILION WARMLY ON BEHALF OF NEW YORK CITY.

JOSEPH GOURION GREETED THE EXHIBIT FOR THE VAAD LEUM! (PALESTINE JEWISH NATIONAL COUNCIL),
AND STEPHEN VOORHEES, CHAIRMAN OF THE FAIR'S BOARD, EXTENDED THE WELCOME OF THE UNITED
STATES TO THE FIRST EXHIBIT OF THE NEW PALESTINIAN CULTURE HERE, ON BEHALF OF GROVER
WHALEN, PRESIDENT OF THE FAIR. MESSAGES WERE READ FROM DR. CHAIM WEIZMANN, PRESIDENT OF
THE JEWISH AGENCY; GOVERNOR LEMMAN, JAMES G. MCDONALD, CHAIRMAN OF PRESIDENT ROSSEVELT'S
ADVISORY COMMITTEE ON REFUGEES; GEORGE BACKER, CO-CHAIRMAN OF THE PALESTINE EXHIBIT
COMMITTEE; AND SIR RONALD LINDSAY, BRITISH AMBASSADOR, AND MGR. M.J. LAVELLE.

AN HONOR GUARD OF 100 YOUNG MEN AND WOMEN OF THE PALESTINE PIONEER ORGANIZATION ASSISTED IN THE CEREMONY. THE JEWISH CHORAL SOCIETY OF THE Y.M.H.A. UNDER THE DIRECTION OF A.W. \$3,000 RAISED AT MEETING FOR JEWISH EDUCATION FUND

NEW YORK, MAY 19. (JTA) -- THE KINDERGARTEN ENDOWMENT FUND OF IVRIAH, THE WOMEN'S DIVISION OF THE JEWISH EDUCATION ASSOCIATION, TO ESTABLISH EXPERIMENTAL CENTERS FOR CHILDREN OF PRE-SCHOOL AGE, WHO WILL RECEIVE PRELIMINARY TRAINING BOTH IN SECULAR AND IN JEWISH SUBJECTS, WAS AUCHENTED BY \$3,000 TODAY THROUGH THE PROCEEDS OF THE ORGANIZATION'T TWELFTH ANNUAL SPRINGTIME BREAKFAST AT THE WALDORF-ASTORIA. MORE THAN 1,200 WOMEN, EACH PAYING \$25, ATTENDED THE EVENT, WHICH AIDED AS WELL THE GRANTING OF TUITION FEES TO UNDERPRIVILEGED CHILDREN TO ATTEND JEWISH RELIGIOUS SCHOOLS IN NEW YORK.

MRS. GABRIEL HAMBURGER, CHAIRMAN OF IVRIAH, PRESIDED. MRS. MAX LAZARE, WHO WAS
CHAIRMAN OF THE BREAKFAST, AND OF THE KINDERGARTEN ENDOWMENT AND SCHOLARSHIP FUND, SPOKE
BRIEFLY ON THE PLANS FOR THE EXPERIMENTAL CENTERS, WHICH IT IS HOPED WILL BE ESTABLISHED
THIS WINTER.
