DACHAU DEATHS MOUNT AS VIENNA SEIZURES CONTINUE

VIENNA, June 12. (JTA) -- THE NUMBER OF KNOWN DEATHS AMONG THE SEVERAL HUNDRED JEWS SHIPPED TO THE DACHAU CONCENTRATION CAMP ROSE TO SEVEN TODAY, WHILE FURTHER ARRESTS OF JEWS ON THE STREETS CONTINUED IN SEVERAL SCATTERED DISTRICTS.

A WOMAN NAMED LAZARUS WHOSE THREE SONS HAD BEEN SENT TO DACHAU RECEIVED A CURT NOTICE THAT ONE OF THEM, 22 YEARS OLD, HAD BEEN BURIED. IT WAS ALSO ANNOUNCED THAT GEORGE KLIPERT, 30, WHO WAS ARRESTED A FORTNIGHT AGO, HAD DIED. FIVE OTHER DEATHS WERE REPORTED PREVIOUSLY.

MEANWHILE, THE ARREST OF MORITZ DESTERREICHER AND HIS SON WAS REVEALED. DESTER-REICHER WAS THE HEAD OF THE JEWELRY FIRM WHICH SUPPLIED KING ZOG OF ALBANIA WITH THE DIADEM WORN BY HIS BRIDE AT THEIR RECENT MEDDING. IT WAS RELIABLY INDICATED THAT JEWISH JÉWELERS HAVE BEEN HARD HIT BY RECENT MASS SEIZURES, WITH AN ESTIMATED 90 PER CENT OF THEM UNDER ARREST. IT IS CERTAINLY TRUE THAT MANY JEWISH JEWELRY SHOPS NOW DISPLAY SIGNS ANNOUNCING THAT THEY ARE "ARYAN ENTERPRISES."

POSTCARDS FROM NEW ARRIVALS AT DACHAU BEGAN TO DRIBBLE THROUGH THE MAILS, DISPELLING ANY DOUBTS AS TO THE FATE OF SEVERAL HUNDRED OF THE MANY JEWS ARRESTED IN THE PAST FORTNIGHT. FOR THE MOST PART, THE CAREFULLY CENSORED CARDS MERELY STATE THAT THE WRITERS ARE WELL AND COULD USE SMALL SUMS OF MONEY.

ASIDE FROM THE OMNIPRESENT THREAT OF INTERNMENT IN DACHAU FACING EVERY JEW UNDER 50 YEARS OF AGE, JEWISH MORALE SUFFERED INCREASINGLY IN THE PAST WEEK FROM THE TYRANNY OF SMALL CHIEFTAINS OF THE NAZI PARTY AND STORM TROOPS, WHO CONTINUALLY HARASS JEWS IN THEIR DISTRICTS.

FOR EXAMPLE, JEWS WERE REPEATEDLY CHASED OFF SIDEWALKS ON THE WALLENSTEINSTRASSE IN THE JEWISH QUARTER AND FORCED TO WALK IN THE ROADWAY. SIGNS ERECTED IN TURKENSCHANZ PARK BARRING JEWS AND DESIGNATING "GHETTO BENCHES" ON THE POPULAR ELISABETH PROMENADE DO NOT BEAR THE INSIGNIA OF THE NAZI PARTY NOR OF THE AUTHORITIES, BUT THEY HAVE NOT BEEN ORDERED REMOVED BY OFFICIAL SOURCES.

ON SEVERAL OCCASIONS JEWS WERE CHASED OUT OF OTHER PARKS, NOTABLY QUAY PARK ALONG THE DANUBE CANAL, BY STORM TROOPERS AND YOUTHS WEARING SWASTIKA ARMBANDS. DURING THE

WEEK ONE PAPER WITH A LARGE CIRCULATION DEMANDED JIM-CROW CARS FOR JEWS IN THE CITY TRAMMAY SYSTEM. WHILE IT IS NOT BELIEVED THAT THIS PROPOSAL HAS OFFICIAL SUPPORT, THE PUBLICATION OF THE DEMAND IN A POPULAR PAPER IS TAKEN AS INDICATION OF THE TEMPER OF THE AUSTRIAN NAZIS.

CITIZENSHIP PURGE PREPARED

PRAHA, JUNE 12. (JTA) -- JOSEPH BUERCKEL, REICH COMMISSAR FOR ADMINISTRATION OF AUSTRO-GERMAN REUNION, IS NOW PREPARING A LIST OF SEVERAL THOUSAND AUSTRIAN JEWS WHO WILL BE DEPRIVED OF CITIZENSHIP, IT WAS REPORTED FROM VIENNA TODAY.

BERLIN REPORTS SAID THAT FORMS FOR REGISTRATION OF JEWISH PROPERTY UNDER FIELD MARSHALL HERMANN WILHELM GOERING'S DECREE HAD BEEN DRAWN UP AND THEIR DISTRIBUTION BY THE POLICE BEGUN.

100,000 JEWS QUIT REICH IN 3 YEARS, NAZI BODY REPORTS

BERLIN, JUNE 10. (HAVAS) -- THE TRAGIC PLIGHT OF JEWS IN GERMANY WAS FURTHER STRESSED TODAY IN A STATISTICAL REPORT PUBLISHED BY THE INSTITUTE FOR THE STUDY OF THE JEWISH QUESTION. WHICH SHOWED A SHARP FALLING OFF OF JEWISH EMIGRATION IN 1937.

FROM FEBRUARY 1, 1933, THE DAY AFTER CHANCELLOR ADOLF HITLER TOOK POWER, TO MARCH 31, 1936, NEARLY 100,000 JEWS LEFT GERMANY AT THE RATE OF 33,000 ANNUALLY. IN 1937 ONLY 15,000 JEWS EMIGRATED TO FOREIGN SHORES, THE REPORT SAID.

DURING THE FIRST THREE YEARS, 15,000 JEWS LEFT FOR PALESTINE. LAST YEAR SOME 4,000 WERE ADMITTED TO THE HOLY LAND.

THE INSTITUTE CONCLUDED THAT AT THE PRESENT RATE OF EMIGRATION IT WOULD TAKE 30 YEARS TO EVACUATE THE ENTIRE JEWISH POPULATION FROM GERMANY. PRIOR TO THE NAZI REGIME, THE JEWISH POPULATION IN GERMANY WAS PUT AT ABOUT 600,000.

UNCERTAIN OUTLOOK KEEPS CAPITAL ON SIDELINES, MANDATES BODY TOLD AS PALESTINE QUIZ ENDS

GENEVA, JUNE 12. (JTA) -- THE PERMANENT MANDATES COMMISSION OF THE LEAGUE OF NATIONS YESTERDAY CONCLUDED ITS EXAMINATION OF THE REPORTS ON PALESTINE AND TRANSJORDAN AFTER QUESTIONING BRITISH REPRESENTATIVES AT LENGTH ON THE ECONOMIC SITUATION, EDUCATION AND OTHER QUESTIONS.

AN OFFICIAL COMMUNIQUE BY THE COMMISSION TOOK NOTE OF THE MANDATORY POWER'S DECLAR-ATION THAT QUESTIONS ABOUT THE PROPOSED PARTITION OF PALESTINE COULD NOT BE DISCUSSED AT THE PRESENT SESSION BECAUSE THE PALESTINE PARTITION COMMISSION WAS NOW AT WORK. CONSIDER-ATION OF PETITIONS ON THE QUESTION WAS DEFERRED.

REPLYING TO QUERIES, THE BRITISH REPRESENTATIVES SAID THAT UNEMPLOYMENT AND GENERAL ECONOMIC DETERIORATION IN PALESTINE WERE DUE TO POLITICAL CONDITIONS. CAPITAL WAS AVAILABLE, THEY SAID, BUT CAPITALISTS WERE HESITANT TO INVEST BECAUSE OF UNCERTAINTY ABOUT THE FUTURE. THEY EXPRESSED THE OPINION THAT CONDITIONS WOULD IMPROVE WHEN THE POLITICAL SITUATION WAS CLARIFIED.

CRITICISM OF THE OPEN DOOR COMMERCIAL POLICY IN PALESTINE WAS VOICED BY SEVERAL MEMBERS OF THE COMMISSION, WHO CALLED ATTENTION TO THE NEED OF MEASURES TO PROTECT PALESTINE INDUSTRY FROM UNFAIR FOREIGN COMPETITION. COMMISSIONERS ALSO CRITICIZED THE POLICY OF HIGHER GRANTS BY THE PALESTINE GOVERNMENT FOR ARAB EDUCATION THAN FOR JEWISH, SUGGESTING IT MOULD BE MORE EQUITABLE IF THE GRANTS WERE MADE IN PROPORTION TO POPULATION.

AT THE END OF THIS WEEK THE COMMISSION WILL FORMULATE ITS REPORT TO THE LEAGUE COUNCIL.

LEAGUE BODY "CAPTIOUS," TIMES HOLDS

LONDON, JUNE 12. (JTA) -- THE TIMES, IN AN EDITORIAL ON "PALESTINE AT GENEVA,"
DECLARES THAT THE LEAGUE OF NATIONS MANDATES COMMISSION IS "A SOMEWHAT CAPTIOUS BODY"
SOME OF WHOSE MEMBERS REPRESENT COUNTRIES NOT HAVING COLONIAL AND MANDATORY INTERESTS AND
RESPONSIBILITIES, WHO THEREFORE OFTEN EXPERIENCE DIFFICULTY IN GETTING EVENTS AND MOTIVES
IN TRUE PERSPECTIVE.

THE PAPER EXPRESSES REGRET THAT IN PREVIOUS ANNOUNCEMENTS OF THE BRITISH GOVERNMENT THERE HAD TO BE UNCERTAINTY REGARDING THE DETAILS OF THE PROPOSED PARTITION OF PALESTINE UNTIL THE TECHNICAL COMMISSION IN PALESTINE RECOMMENDED A SCHEME REGARDED AS EQUITABLE AND PRECTICABLE.

"Such a qualification might give the impression that the technical commission conceivably will not follow the Royal Commission's recommendation regarding partition as the ONLY Solution of the present Deadlock," The Editorial States, adding that this certainly would not assist the pacification of the country.

THE SOLUTION OF THE PALESTINE QUESTION DEPENDS ON THE BELIEF THAT "HIS MAJESTY'S GOVERNMENT WILL NOT SWERVE FROM THE POLICY TO WHICH THEY HAVE PUBLICLY ADHERED," THE TIMES DECLARES.

2 JEWS, 3 ARABS DIE AS DISCRDERS CONTINUE

JERUSALEM, JUNE 12. (JTA) -- TWO JEWS AND THREE ARABS WERE DEAD TODAY AND SEVERAL OTHER PERSONS WOUNDED IN CONTINUING VIOLENCE.

TERRORIST BULLETS KILLED A SEPHARDIC JEWISH CARPENTER, HAIM NAKA, 30, AS HE WALKED NEAR THE MONTEFIORE QUARTER THIS EVENING ON HIS WAY HOME. YESTERDAY, JOSEPH SAPHIR, 21, WAS SHOT DEAD WHILE GUARDING THE PALESTINE JEWISH COLONIZATION ASSOCIATION FOREST NEAR MIZPEH, IN THE VICINITY OF TIBERIAS. SAPHIR WAS BORN IN MIZPEH. HANCH LEVINSON, 27, WAS WOUNDED WHILE GUARDING JEWISH PLOWMEN NEAR MADZ IN THE JORDAN VALLEY. AN ARAB SHOTHIM, SEIZED HIS RIFLE AND ESCAPED. LEVINSON WAS AN IMMIGRANT FROM GERMANY.

TWO ARABS WERE EXECUTED IMMEDIATELY AFTER A TERRORIST "TRIBUNAL" HAD CONVICTED THEM OF INFORMING. THEIR WIVES WERE SERIOUSLY WOUNDED. AN ARAB BAND FIRED INTO A GROUP OF ARAB LABORERS ENGAGED IN ROAD CONSTRUCTION NEAR NABLUS WHEN THEY REFUSED TO ABANDON THE JOB. TWO WORKERS WERE WOUNDED.

A SYRIAN BAND VESTERDAY SERIOUSLY DAMAGED A SECTION OF THE BARBED WIRE BARRICADE BEING CONSTRUCTED ALONG THE PALESTINE-SYRIAN FRONTIER. AFTER CUTTING 50 KILOMETERS OF WIRE AND DESTROYING CONCRETE FOUNDATIONS, THE BAND SAFELY RETIRED TO SYRIA. ANOTHER

TERRORIST BAND DYNAMITED A BRIDGE AND WRECKED SECTIONS OF THE MILITARY ROAD NEAR THE NORTHERN BORDER. POLICE ENGAGED THE BAND, REPORTEDLY INFLICTING A NUMBER OF CASUALTIES. ONE TERRORIST WAS KILLED AND SIX OTHERS CAPTURED WHEN TROOPS SURPRISED A BAND IGNITING THE IRAQ PETROLEUM COMPANY'S PIPELINE NEAR AIN HAROD.

MEANWHILE, THE PARTITION COMMISSION CONTINUED ITS HEARINGS, WITH GOVERNMENT OFF-ICIALS TESTIFYING AT IN CAMERA SESSIONS. AMONG THOSE HEARD WERE EDUCATION DIRECTOR WIL-FRED J. FARRELL AND INSPECTOR GENERAL OF POLICE ALLAN SAUNDERS.

PRESIDENT JUDAN L. MAGNES OF THE HEBREW UNIVERSITY APPEALED TO MAJOR GENERAL ROBERT HAINING TO EXERCISE CLEMENCY IN THE CASE OF TWO JEWISH YOUTHS SENTENCED BY A MILITARY COURT TO DEATH FOR FIRING AT AN ARAB BUS.

TWELVE EUROPEAN JENS WERE ARRESTED AT THE NORTHERN BORDER TODAY WHEN CAUGHT TRYING ILLEGALLY TO CROSS INTO PALESTINE FROM LEBANON.

MANY JEWS WOUNDED IN 2-DAY TARNAPOL EXCESSES

WARSAW, JUNE 12. (JTA) -- A LARGE NUMBER OF JEWS WERE BEATEN AND SOME PROPERTY WAS DAMAGED IN TARNAPOL, EAST GALICIA, IN TWO DAYS OF EXCESSES ORGANIZED BY MEMBERS OF THE NATIONAL DEMOCRATIC PARTY AFTER A FIGHT BETWEEN A JEW AND A POLE IN WHICH THE LATTER WAS STABBED, IT WAS REPORTED HERE TODAY.

AN OFFICIAL COMMUNIQUE SAID THE JEW HAD PROVOKED THE QUARREL AND HAD STABBED THE POLE IN ORDER TO PREVENT HIM FROM PARTICIPATING IN A FOOTBALL GAME AGAINST A JEWISH CLUB. THE JEWISH PRESS CRITICIZED THE AUTHORITIES, CHARGING THAT THE RACE OF THE PERSONS INVOLVED WAS DELIBERATELY GIVEN, AND POINTING OUT THAT THE VICTIM WAS NOT A MEMBER OF THE TEAM WHICH WAS SCHEDULED TO PLAY AGAINST THE JEWISH CLUB.

DEPUTY EMIL SOMMERSTEIN GAVE NOTICE THAT HE WOULD QUESTION THE GOVERNMENT IN THE SEUM ON THE REACTION OF THE AUTHORITIES TO THE INCIDENT.

LEAGUE AID TO REFUGEES FROM REICH EXTENDED TO COVER AUSTRIA

GENEVA, JUNE 12. (JTA) -- AUSTRIAN EMIGRANTS WERE TODAY BROUGHT UNDER THE PROTECTION OF THE INTER-GOVERNMENT CONVENTION ON GERMAN REFUGEES WHEN A PROTOCOL SUPPLEMENTING THE CONVENTION WAS COMPLETED BY SIR NEILL MALCOLM, LEAGUE OF NATIONS HIGH COMMISSIONER FOR GERMAN REFUGEES, AND FORWARDED BY SECRETARY GENERAL JOSEPH C. AVENOL TO MEMBERS OF THE LEAGUE COUNCIL. THE PROTOCOL ADDS TWO PARAGRAPHS TO THE CONVENTION DEFINING THE TERM "AUSTRIAN REFUGEE."

DUTCH OFFICIAL BARS OPEN DOOR TO REFUGEES; CITES UNEMPLOYMENT

AMSTERDAM, JUNE 12. (JTA) -- MINISTER OF JUSTICE C.M. GOSELING TOLD THE SECOND CHAMBES YESTERDAY THAT WHILE THE METHERLANDS WAS WILLING TO DISCUSS MEASURES FOR RELIEF OF VICTIMS FROM NAZISM AT THE REFUGEE-AID CONFERENCE OPENING AT EVIAN, FRANCE, JULY 6, THE COUNTRY WAS UNABLE TO PERMIT AN INCREASE IN THE NUMBER FINDING REFUGE HERE.

IT IS IMPOSSIBLE FOR THE NETHERLANDS, WHERE UNEMPLOYMENT IS GREAT, TO HOLD OPEN ITS DOORS TO REFUGEES, DR. GOSELING SAID IN REPLY TO AN INTERPELLATION OF COMMUNIST DEPUTY DEVISSER ON THE PRESENT POLICY REGARDING GERMAN REFUGEES. THE JUSTICE MINISTER POINTED OUT THAT 25.000 JEWS HAD ALREADY CROSSED THE NETHERLANDS! FRONTIERS.

AFTER CRITICAL SPEECHES BY SEVERAL DEPUTIES, DR. GOSELING PROMISED TO MITIGATE THE PRESENT RESTRICTIVE MEASURES IN EXTRAORDINARY CASES.

GERMAN MINORITIES WOULD SEEK REICH'S AID IF TREATED LIKE JEWS, BERLIN TELLS LAW EXPERTS

LONDON, JUNE 12. (JTA) -- THE SUNDAY TIMES REPORTS FROM BERLIN TODAY THAT EXPERTS ON INTERNATIONAL LAW WHO ASKED THE GERMAN GOVERNMENT WHAT WOULD HAPPEN IF GERMAN MINORITIES IN POLAND AND CZECHOSLOVAKIA WERE DRIVEN OUT WITH THE METHODS USED IN GERMANY AGAINST THE JEWS, WERE TOLD THAT THE GERMAN MINORITIES WOULD TURN TO GERMANY FOR HELP WHILE THE GERMAN JEWS "DO NOT HAVE A NATIONAL STATE WILLING AND STRONG ENOUGH TO FIGHT FOR THEM."

NAZI STUDENTS AT GENEVA U. STRIKE; WANT RACIAL LECTURES

GENEVA, JUNE 12. (JTA) -- GERMAN STUDENTS AT GENEVA UNIVERSITY WERE ON STRIKE TODAY AND BOYCOTTING LECTURES OF HERR HAMBURGER, PROFESSOR OF GERMAN LAW, ON THE GROUND THAT HE WAS NOT STRESSING IN HIS LECTURES THE RACIAL LEGISLATION OF THE THIRD REICH.

BRITISH M.P. PLEDGES SIXTH OF HIS 5-YEAR SALARY TO JEWISH RELIEF FUNDS

LONDON (JTA) -- A BRITISH M.P. HAS ANNOUNCED HIS DECISION TO PUT ASIDE ONE SIXTH OF HIS SALARY FOR THE NEXT FIVE YEARS TO CONTRIBUTE TO JEWISH RELIEF FUNDS. ADDRESSING A MEETING AT SHEFFIELD IN SUPPORT OF THE COUNCIL FOR GERMAN JEWRY'S CAMPAIGN FOR AUSTRIAN JEWRY, COMMANDER OLIVER LOCKER-LAMPSON SAID THAT OF HIS LEGOD PER YEAR SALARY AS AN M.P., HE WAS PUTTING ASIDE LIOO EACH YEAR FOR JEWISH FUNDS.

"THE CALL OF JEWRY IS PARAMOUNT," HE DECLARED. "HELPLESS, HOMELESS, MISERABLE, THE TRAGIC WANDERERS LOOK TO US FOR HELP AND SANCTUARY; AND THE SAME GOD, YOURS AND THE ONE I WORSHIP, WILL NOT FORGET THOSE WHO ARE GOOD TO THE STRANGER AT THE GATE.

"THE DAY WILL COME," HE PROPHESIED, "WHEN THE BULLY OF BERLIN WILL BE SEATEN AND WHE!

SO. AFRICAN REGIME PLANS BILL TO CURB POLITICAL UNIFORMS

CAPETOWN, SOUTH AFRICA, (JTA) -- THE SOUTH AFRICAN GOVERNMENT IS CONSIDERING INTROD-UCTION IN THE NEW PARLIAMENT OF LEGISLATION AIMED AT CHECKING THE USE OF POLITICAL UNIFORMS IT WAS REPORTED HERE TODAY IN AUTHORITATIVE CIRCLES.

PROHIBITION OF PARA-MILITARY ORGANIZATIONS AND THE WEARING OF UNIFORMS BY POLITICAL GROUPS HAS LONG BEEN ADVOCATED BY INFLUENTIAL GROUPS WITHIN THE UNITED (GOVERNMENT) PARTY. DISORDERS BY UNIFORMED MEMBERS OF POLITICAL GROUPS DURING THE RECENT ELECTION CAMPAIGN, DURING WHICH MANY MEETINGS WERE INTERRUPTED, ARE NOW SAID TO HAVE SWUNG SEVERAL MEMBERS OF THE CABINET TO THE VIEW THAT SOME SUCH STEPS ARE NOW NECESSARY.

IT IS BELIEVED THAT THE LEGISLATION, WHEN INTRODUCED, WILL BE MODELLED AFTER THE BRITISH PUBLIC ORDER ACT, WHICH FORBIDS THE WEARING OF UNIFORMS BY POLITICAL ORGANIZATIONS. SUCH A BILL WOULD, IT IS BELIEVED, BE A SEVERE BLOW TO THE GREYSHIRTS AND RIVAL FASCIST ORGANIZATIONS HERE.
