ROOSEVELT SEEKS MAXIMUM RESULTS FROM EVIAN PARLEY, U. S. GROUP REVEALS IN PARIS

PARIS, JUNE 24. (JTA) -- THE AMERICAN DELEGATION TO THE 31-POWER REFUGEE-AID CONFERENCE OPENING AT EVIAN-LES-BAINS ON JULY 6 REVEALED TO THIS CORRESPONDENT TODAY DETAILS OF THE FORTHCOMING MEETING WHICH INDICATE THAT PRESIDENT ROOSEVELT IS TAKING A PERSONAL INTEREST IN THE PREPARATIONS AND WILL CLOSELY WATCH THE PROCEEDINGS FROM WASHINGTON.

DETERMINED TO OBTAIN THE BEST POSSIBLE RESULTS, WITH A MINIMUM OF TALK AND A MAXIMUM OF WORK, THE PRESIDENT HAS INSTRUCTED THE DELEGATION TO SUGGEST THAT THE MEETING BE HELD IN CAMERA, EXCEPT FOR THE OPENING AND CLOSING SESSIONS, IT WAS DISCLOSED.

SETTING UP TEMPORARY HEADQUARTERS AT THE UNITED STATES EMBASSY HERE, THE AMERICAN GROUP VOICED THE EXPECTATION THAT THE CONFERENCE WOULD LAST TEN OR TWELVE DAYS, CONCLUDING WITH THE ESTABLISHMENT OF A PERMANENT INTER-GOVERNMENTAL OFFICE, WITH ITS SEAT IN PARIS, TO REALIZE THE DECISIONS OF THE MEETING. THIS OFFICE WILL ALSO DEAL WITH PRIVATE ORGANIZATIONS INTERESTED IN REFUGEE WORK.

HOWEVER, MYRON C. TAYLOR, THE AMERICAN DELEGATE TO THE CONFERENCE, MADE CLEAR TO-DAY THAT HE WILL NOT SEE ANY DELEGATION FROM EUROPEAN ORGANIZATIONS NOR ACCEPT THEIR MEMORANDA. SUCH MEMORANDA, THE AMERICAN DELEGATION EMPHASIZED, CAN BE SUBMITTED ONLY THROUGH THE RESPECTIVE GOVERNMENTS OF THE COUNTRIES WHERE THE ORGANIZATIONS OPERATE, SINCE THE CONFERENCE IS NOT PRIVATE, BUT INTER-GOVERNMENTAL.

REGARDING THE MEMORANDA OF AMERICAN REFUGEE-AID ORGANIZATIONS, IT WAS DISCLOSED THAT SUCH HAVE ALREADY BEEN SUBMITTED BY THE VARIOUS ORGANIZATIONS TO PRESIDENT ROOSE-VELT'S ADVISORY COMMITTEE ON POLITICAL REFUGEES IN New YORK, WHICH, AFTER SUMMARIZING THEIR PROPOSALS, SUBMITTED THEM TO THE PRESIDENT. MR. ROOSEVELT APPROVED SOME OF THEM AND TRANSMITTED THESE TO MR. TAYLOR FOR INCLUSION IN THE CONFERENCE AGENDA, WHICH IS ALREADY IN THE HANDS OF ALL PARTICIPATING GOVERNMENTS, BUT IS BEING KEPT SECRET.

SINCE THE CONFERENCE WAS BROUGHT ABOUT BY THE UNITED STATES GOVERNMENT, MR. TAYLOR WILL PLAY A LEADING PART AT THE MEETING. HE WILL HAVE THE ASSISTANCE OF JAMES G. MCDONALD, CHAIRMAN OF THE PRESIDENT'S ADVISORY COMMITTEE, WHO IS SALING FOR EUROPE ON SATURDAY FROM QUEBEC, AND THO STATE DEPARTMENT OFFICIALS — ROBERT PELL, EXPERT ON INTERNATIONAL CONFERENCES, AND GEORGE BRANDTHIMMIGRATION EXPERT.

JEWS SEEN INCLUDED IN GOERING DECREE FOR FORCED LABOR

BERLIN, JUNE 24. (JTA) -- THE POSSIBILITY THAT JEWS MAY BE BROUGHT INTO THE NAZI LABOR DRAFT SYSTEM WAS SEEN TODAY IN FIELD MARSHAL HERMANN GOERING'S DECREE FOR CONSCRIPTION OF LABOR WHICH EXTENDS THE LEGAL BASIS FOR LABOR SERVICE TO ALL GERMAN NATIONALS AND "REICHSANGEHOERIGE" (WARDS OF THE STATE).

SIGNIFICANTLY, THE DECREE USES THE WORD "STAATSANGEHOERIGE," WHICH IS CONTRADICT-ORY TO THE PRESENT LABOR SERVICE LAW WHICH SPECIFICALLY EXCLUDES JEWS, STILL NATIONALS ALTHOUGH NOT CITIZENS.

WHETHER THE DECREE HAS ANY CONNECTION WITH THE RECENT WHOLESALE ARRESTS OF JEWS, MANY OF WHOM HAVE BEEN INTERNED IN CONCENTRATION CAMPS, IS NOT YET DEFINITELY KNOWN.
JEWISH CIRCLES HOPE THAT IF THE DECREE MEANT TO INCLUDE JEWS IT WILL SERVE AS A REGULARIZING AND HUMANIZING INFLUENCE, CONTRARY TO THE PRESENT PROCEDURE WHICH IS CARRIED OUT SUMMARILY AND ARBITRARILY, CREATING TERROR AMONG GERMAN JEWRY.

THE DECREE, PROVIDING UNIVERSAL CONSCRIPTION FOR SHORT-TERM LABOR SERVICE ON "NATIONALLY URGENT TASKS," GOES INTO EFFECT JULY I AND APPLIES EQUALLY TO ALL CLASSES OF WORKERS AND EMPLOYERS. ALTHOUGH ITS EXACT PURPOSE IS STILL UNKNOWN, REPORTS THAT THE EDICT IS A "WAR MEASURE" ARE DENIED.

IT WAS REVEALED TODAY THAT DURING DISORDERS TUESDAY EVENING IN PANKOW, BERLIN SUBURB, A CROWD OF 100 YOUNGSTERS ENTERED A JEWISH ORPHAN HOME AND SMASHED PICTURES AND FLOWER VASES. THE DIRECTOR OF THE HOME HID HIS CHARGES IN THE CELLAR. AFTERWARDS THE YOUTHS SMASHED THE WINDOWS IN A JEWISH TRAINING SCHOOL IN THE SAME TOWN.

THESE DEVELOPMENTS, TOGETHER WITH THE SITUATION IN NORTH BERLIN WHERE SIGNS POSTED ON "ARYAN" SHOPS BY STORM TROOPERS BAN SALE OF FOOD AND MEDICINE TO JEWS, ARE PARTICULARLY ILLUMINATING IN VIEW OF THE VOELKISCHER BEOBACHTER'S EDITORIAL REITERATING THAT ONLY LEGAL METHODS SHOULD BE EMPLOYED AGAINST JEWS.

2,000 JEWS SEIZED IN NEW VIENNA MASS ARRESTS

LONDON, JUNE 24. (JTA) -- BETWEEN 2,000 AND 2,500 JEWS HAVE BEEN ARRESTED IN A RENEWED CAMPAIGN OF MASS SEIZURES IN VIENNA, IT WAS RELIABLY REPORTED HERE TODAY. WOMEN WERE AMONG THE VICTIMS FOR THE FIRST TIME, IT WAS REPORTED, BUT IT WAS BELIEVED THAT MOST OF THE FEMALE PRISONERS WERE RELEASED SOON AFTER THEIR ARREST.

MEANWHILE, ALL "ARYAN" FIRMS IN VIENNA HAVE BEEN ORDERED TO DISMISS THEIR REMAIN-ING JEWISH EMPLOYES WITHIN A FORTNIGHT. INSTRUCTIONS TO THIS EFFECT WERE SENT OUT YESTERDAY OVER THE SIGNATURE OF THE NAZI GAULEITER (DISTRICT LEADER) FOR VIENNA, ODILO GLOBOTSCHNIGG.

DISAFFECTION IN THE AUSTRIAN POPULATION WAS STRIKINGLY DEMONSTRATED BY REPORTS THAT VIENNESS WOMEN LAST NIGHT ATTACKED STORM TROOPERS WHO WERE FORCING JEWISH WOMEN TO WASH AN AUTOMOBILE. THE ATTACK OCCURRED AFTER A PREGNANT JEWESS HAD FAINTED DURING THE WORK. POLICE QUELLED THEDISTURBANCE.

A DELEGATION OF THE RELIGIOUS ORGANIZATION, AGUDATH ISRAEL, TOOK UP WITH THE COUNCILLOR OF THE POLISH EMBASSY HERE THE SITUATION OF THE JEWS RESIDING IN AUSTRIA,

WHOSE STATUS, THEY DECLARED, IS JEOPARDIZED BY OBSTACLES TO EMIGRATION PLACED IN THEIR WAY BY THE POLISH CONSULAR AUTHORITIES IN VIENNA.

THE DELEGATION ALSO CALLED ATTENTION TO THE EXPULSION OF GERMAN AND AUSTRIAN STUDENTS OF RELIGIOUS SEMINARIES IN POLAND BY THE AUTHORITIES. THE POSSIBILITY OF POLAND'S SUPPORTING PROPOSALS OF JEWISH ORGANIZATIONS FOR REFUGEE-AID AT THE EVIAN CONFERENCE WAS ALSO DISCUSSED.

SIR WYNDHAM DEEDES, ARMY OFFICER AND FORMER COLONIAL ADMINISTRATOR, SUPPORTED AN APPEAL FOR ADMISSION OF A CERTAIN NUMBER OF GERMAN AND AUSTRIAN CHILDREN TO ENGLAND. HE ADDRESSED A MEETING HERE.

2 JEWS, 3 ARABS KILLED IN TEL AVIV-JAFFA BORDER RIOTS; CURFEW IMPOSED

JERUSALEM, JUNE 24. (JTA) -- THE PALESTINE GOVERNMENT TONIGHT IMPOSED A TWELVE-HOUR CURFEW ON THE BOUNDARY SECTION BETWEEN TEL AVIV AND JAFFA IN WHICH TWO JEWS AND THREE ARABS WERE KILLED AND FIVE JEWS AND FIVE ARABS WOUNDED.

WHILE BOMB AND RIFLE ATTACKS CONTINUED, THE AUTHORITIES PROHIBITED ALL CIVILIAN MOVEMENTS BETWEEN SIX P.M. AND SIX A.M. IN THE PART OF TEL AVIV FROM ALLEMBY ROAD TO THE JAFFA BOUNDARY AND IN THE ADJACENT SECTIONS OF JAFFA.

DESPITE AUGMENTED POLICE PATROLS AND BARBED-WIRE BARRICADES, SEVERAL BOMBS WERE THROWN FROM JAFFA INTO TEL AVIV AND RIFLE SHOTS WERE FIRED. A MILITARY LORRY PATROLLING THE BOUNDARIES WAS FIRED UPON FROM AN ARAB HOUSE, BUT NONE WAS HIT. TROOPS FRUITLESSLY SEARCHED THE HOUSE AND VICINITY.

BOTH CITIES WERE IN TURMOIL, REMEMBERING THAT THE SAME AREA SERVED AS THE SPAWN-ING PLACE FOR THE 1936 DISORDERS. A REPORTER TOURING THE BOUNDARY DISTRICTS SAM MOBS OF THOUSANDS MILLING ON BOTH SIDES OF THE BOUNDARY UNTIL DISPERSED BY VOLLEYS OF SHOTS FIRED INTO THE AIR. NEARBY HOUSES WERE EVACUATED BY BOTH JEWS AND ARABS AS POLICE CONDUCTED INTENSIVE SEARCHES FOR TERRORISTS.

THE RIOTING BEGAN LATE YESTERDAY WHEN ARABS FIRED AT JEWS SHOPPING FOR THE SABBATH IN THE CARMEL MARKET. IN THE ENSUING DISORDERS TWO JEWS WERE STABBED TO DEATH AND FIVE OTHERS SUFFERED KNIFE OR BULLET WOUNDS. THREE ARABS WERE KILLED AND FIVE OTHERS WERE WOUNDED.

THE JEWISH DEAD ARE: SHLOMO SHARABI, 25, STABBED BY ÁRABS IN A CAFE; NAHUM EZRA GINDI, 45, STABBED BY TWO ÁRABS AT THE BOUNDARY. THE WOUNDED ARE: NOAH FINKELSTEIN, 21; ABRAHAM KISHER, 19, BOTH IN SERIOUS CONDITION; ARIEH RUDIKOVSKY, 24; SHIMON STRIKOVSKY, AND ITZHAK COHEN, SLIGHTLY INJURED.

THE AUTHORITIES FORBADE LOCAL NEWSPAPERS, BOTH ARAB AND HEBREW, TO PLACE THE BLAME FOR THE RIOTING. A DELEGATION FROM JAFFA'S JEWISH QUARTERS ASKED THE PROTECTION OF THE TEL AVIV MUNICIPAL AUTHORITIES.

THE DEATH TOLL IN PALESTINE DISORDERS WAS RAISED BY THE MURDER OF THE REV. PIETRO ROSSINI, AN ITALIAN CITIZEN, PRINCIPAL OF A MISSION SCHOOL NEAR JAFFA, WHOSE BODY WAS FOUND NEAR THE SCHOOL, BEATEN TO DEATH. RECENTLY THE SCHOOL WAS LOOTED AND FATHER ROSSINI WAS SEVERELY BEATEN BY A BAND OF ARAB TERRORISTS.

GRAVE FEARS WERE FELT OVER THREE JEWISH YOUTHS KIDNAPED YESTERDAY BY AN ARAB BAND WHILE DRIVING A CART FROM THE FIELDS TO GIVAT ADA, NEAR HAIFA. POLICE LOST THE TRAIL OF THE ABOUCTORS IN THE DARK. THE YOUTHS ARE DAVID FRANK, 24, WHO IMMIGRATED FROM GERMANY 18 MONTHS AGO; ITZHAK KRUPIK, 19, AND DAVID AVERBUCH, 14, BOTH NATIVE PALESTINIANS.

MAJOR-GENERAL ROBERT H. HAINING, COMMANDER-IN-CHIEF OF BRITISH FORCES IN PALESTINE, CONFIRMED THE DEATH SENTENCE PASSED BY THE HAIFA MILITARY COURT ON SHLOMO BEN JOSEF, 22, FOR FIRING ON AN ARAB BUS AND CARRYING ARMS. GENERAL HAINING AT THE SAME TIME COMMUTED TO LIFE IMPRISONMENT THE DEATH SENTENCE PASSED BY THE SAME COURT ON BEN JOSEF'S COMPANION, ABRAHAM SHEIN, 20, BECAUSE OF HIS AGE. NO DATE WAS FIXED FOR BEN JOSEF'S EXECUTION.

MEANWHILE, TERRORISM CONTINUED IN OTHER PARTS OF PALESTINE. ARABS SET FIRE TO WHEAT FIELDS AT MISHMAR HAYARDEN, LAYING DOWN A BARRAGE OF RIFLE SHOTS AGAINST JEWS FIGHTING THE FLAMES AND SERIOUSLY WOUNDING SERGEANT HAYIM ZIPORI, 32, A SPECIAL POLICEMAN. OTHER BANDS ATTACKED THE JEWISH COLONIES OF ROSH PINA, MISHMAR HAEMEK AND KFAR HASSIDIM, AND UPROOTED 1,000 TREES IN A JEWISH-OWNED GROVE NEAR KAKUN.

Two Jews were arrested by police when found with pistols in their possession in the vicinity of an attack on an Arab bus in Mikveh Israel, a Jerusalem suburb.

ADDING MENACE TO THE GENERAL UNREST FOLLOWING THE NEWEST OUTBREAKS WAS SPREAD OF A STRIKE IN PROTEST AGAINST TURKEY'S OCCUPATION OF ALEXANDRETTA, A DISPUTED TERRITORY IN NORTHERN SYRIA. THE STRIKE WAS COMPLETE IN THE "BLOODY TRIANGLE" AREA OF NABLUS, JENIN AND TULKAREM. IT WAS CALLED BY POSTERS, BEARING THE SIGNATURE OF YOUSSEF ABU DATEH, LEADER OF NORTHERN TERRORIST BANDS, WHICH THREATENED DEATH TO ALL ARABS FAILING TO COMPLY. SIMILAR POSTERS HAVE APPEARED IN HAIFA.

SCANDINAVIAN PARLEY AIRED REFUGEE PROBLEM; UNITED STAND SEEN AT EVIAN

COPENHAGEN, JUNE 24. (JTA) -- IT WAS ANNOUNCED OFFICIALLY TODAY THAT THE REFUGEE PROBLEM WAS DISCUSSED AT A SCANDINAVIAN INTERGOVERNMENTAL CONFERENCE HELD HERE AND AT FREDENSBORG ON JUNE 21 AND 22. NATIONS REPRESENTED AT THE MEETING WERE DEMMARK, SWEDEN, NORWAY AND FINLAND. IT IS BELIEVED THAT JOINT ACTION AT THE EVIAN, FRANCE, REFUGEE-AID CONFERENCE OPENING JULY 6 WAS DECIDED UPON.

JUSTICE MINISTER K. STEINCKE, SOCIAL DEMOCRAT, IS EXPECTED TO HEAD THE DANISH DELEGATION TO THE EVIAN GATHERING.

ACCORDING TO AN OFFICIAL REPORT, THERE ARE 1,278 GERMAN REFUGEES IN DENMARK, 2,000 IN SWEDEN AND 100 IN NORWAY.

WINTERTON APPOINTMENT STIRS COMMENT

LONDON, JUNE 24. (JTA) -- LORD WINTERTON'S APPOINTMENT AS A BRITISH DELEGATE TO THE EVIAN REFUGEE-AID CONFERENCE, OPENING JULY 6, "ILLUSTRATES THE SPIRIT OF COMPROMISE WITH WHICH THE BRITISH GOVERNMENT IS ENTERING THE CONFERENCE, THE YORKSHIRE OBSERVER, IMPORTANT PROVINCIAL DAILY, COMMENTED TODAY, ASSERTING THAT BRITAIN "GRUDGINGLY ACQUIESCED" TO PRESIDENT ROOSEVELT'S PROPOSAL FOR THE CONFERENCE.

THE JEWISH CHRONICLE DEMANDED EDITORIALLY THAT PALESTINE BE GIVEN AN OPPORTUNITY TO AFFORD THE MAXIMUM POSSIBILITY TO ASSIST IN SOLVING THE IMMEDIATE REFUGEE PROBLEM. IT EXPRESSED THE HOPE THAT LORD WINTERTON'S APPOINTMENT WOULD NOT PREJUDICE THE POSSIBILITY OF USING PALESTINE TO THE UTMOST IN ASSISTING REFUGEES.

"THE APPOINTMENT OF WINTERTON CANNOT FAIL TO AROUSE SERIOUS MISGIVINGS," THE EDIT-ORIAL DECLARED, POINTING TO LORD WINTERTON'S PRO-ARAB UTTERANCES AND STATEMENTS AS CREAT-ING THE IMPRESSION THAT HE WAS "OUT OF SYMPATHY WITH THE JEWS IN GENERAL."

RABBIS REAFFIRM RIGHT TO VOICE VIEWS ON SOCIAL PROBLEMS

ATLANTIC CITY, June 24. (JTA) -- THE CENTRAL CONFERENCE OF AMERICAN RABBIS, AT ITS 49TH ANNUAL MEETING HERE, TODAY REAFFIRMED THE RIGHT OF RABBIS TO VOICE THEIR CONSIDERED OPINIONS ON SOCIAL QUESTIONS, AND APPOINTED A COMMITTEE OF FIVE TO COME TO THE AID OF RABBIS WHO HAVE TROUBLE WITH THEIR CONGREGATIONS." BY REASON OF THEIR CONGREGATIONS."

THE MEETING, APPROVING THE REPORT OF ITS SOCIAL JUSTICE COMMISSION, ALSO CONDEMNED STRONGLY "THE SUPPRESSION OF THE TRADITIONAL AMERICAN RIGHTS OF FREE ASSEMBLY AND FREE SPEECH IN JERSEY CITY" AND ELSEWHERE, ATTACKED DISCRIMINATION BY JEWS AGAINST JEWS, ASSAILED THE NUMERUS CLAUSUS IN UNIVERSITIES AND RECOMMENDED A STUDY BY ITS INTER-RACIAL COMMISSION OF THE RECENT RISE OF ANTI-SEMITISM AMONG NEGROES.

DEALING ALSO WITH BROAD QUESTIONS OF SOCIAL JUSTICE, THE MEETING REAFFIRMED ITS STAND FOR A FEDERAL ANTI-LYNCHING BILL, A FEDERAL STUDY OF UNEMPLOYMENT AND A FEDERAL VOCATIONAL RETRAINING PROGRAM. IT REAFFIRMED ITS ACCEPTANCE OF THE PRINCIPLES OF COLLECTIVE BARGAINING, URGED THE CIO AND AFL TO RENEW EFFORTS TOWARD UNITY AND REASSERTED SYMPATHY WITH THE SHARECROPPERS.

CHURCH OF ENGLAND URGES AID FOR PERSECUTED IN REICH

LONDON, JUNE 24. (JTA) -- THE ASSEMBLY OF THE CHURCH OF ENGLAND UNANIMOUSLY ADOPTED A RESOLUTION TODAY URGING CHRISTIANS EVERYWHERE TO EXPRESS FELLOWSHIP WITH THOSE SUFFERING IN GERMANY AND AUSTRIA BY MATERIAL GIFTS, AS WELL AS'BY SYMPATHY AND PRAYER. EXPRESSING SYMPATHY WITH THE DISTRESS OF JEWS AND OTHER "NON-ARYANS" IN THE REICH, THE ASSEMBLY ASKED. THE BRITISH GOVERNMENT TO DO EVERYTHING POSSIBLE TO ASSIST THEIR EMIGRATION TO OTHER COUNTRIES

THE RESOLUTION WAS INTRODUCED BY THE BISHOP OF CHICHESTER AND SECONDED BY LORD WOLMER, WHO DECLARED: "I AM ONE WHO IS MOST ANXIOUS FOR A BETTER UNDERSTANDING BETWEEN OUR COUNTRY AND OUR GREAT NEIGHBOR, GERMANY, BUT WE CANNOT BE SILENT ON THIS ISSUE. IT IS RIGHT THAT GERMANS SHOULD REALIZE THAT THIS MATTER IS ONE OF THE GREATEST BARS TO BETTER UNDERSTANDING, AND NOT ONLY WITH ANGLO-SAXON RACE, BUT WITH THE CHRISTIAN OPINION THE WORLD OVER. WE CANNOT BE CHRISTIANS AND BE NEUTRAL ON THIS ISSUE."

BAR CANDIDATES END HUNGER STRIKE IN WARSAW

WARSAW, JUNE 24. (JTA) -- THREE HUNDRED JEWISH CANDIDATES FOR THE BAR, 50 OF THEM WOMEN TODAY ENDED A 24-HOUR HUNGER STRIKE IN PROTEST AGAINST THE RECENTLY ENACTED SEVEN-YEAR BAN ON ADMISSIONS TO THE LAW PROFESSION. THEY DECIDED TO CONTINUE THE FIGHT ON THE BAN BY OTHER METHODS. JEWISH LAWYERS AT LWOW ANNOUNCED THEIR DECISION TO LAUNCH A SIMILAR HUNGER STRIKE.
