6 JEWS, 7 ARABS WOUNDED IN JAFFA BORDER AREA; VIOLENCE CONTINUES ELSEWHERE

JERUSALEM, JUNE 26. (JTA) -- SIX JEWS AND SEVEN ARABS WERE WOUNDED TODAY AS TERRORISM CONTINUED IN THE BORDER AREA BETWEEN ALL-JENISH TEL AVIV AND PREDOMINANTLY ARAB JAFFA. A PERSIAN JEW, AMON PACHER, 60, WAS STABBED AND SERIOUSLY INJURED. DAVID ZIPKIN, 30, WAS STABBED AND SERIOUSLY MOUNDED IN THE SAME AREA. SOON AFTER THESE EVENTS, A BOMB EXPLODED, SERIOUSLY WOUNDING FOUR ARABS AND SLIGHTLY INJURING THREE OTHERS. LATER ON A BOMB WAS THROWN INTO THE AREA UNDER CURFEW, SERIOUSLY INJURING SHOSHANA ZARMATI, A THREE-YEAR-OLD GIRL, DANGEROUSLY WOUNDING ESTHER LEVI, 60, AND SLIGHTLY HURTING MIRIAM COHEN, 33, AND JOSEPH MALISADDO, 70.

MEANWHILE ARIEH RUDIKOVSKY, 26, WHO WAS WOUNDED IN RIOTING ON FRIDAY, DIED THIS AFTERNOON. AT HIS FUNERAL, MAYOR ISRAEL ROKACH OF TEL AVIV CALLED FOR SELF-RESTRAINT AMONG THE JEWS, WHILE TEL AVIV'S CHIEF RABBIS ASKED FOR GREATER PROTECTION AGAINST TERRORISM. LATER, MAYOR ROKACH VISITED DISTRICT COMMISSIONER CROSSBIE TO URGE ENLISTMENT OF AN ADDITIONAL 200 AUXILIARY JEWISH POLICEMEN TO INCREASE SECURITY IN THE BORDER AREA.

DISORDERS CONTINUED IN OTHER PARTS OF THE COUNTRY. AN ARAB BAND ENGAGED TROOPS NEAR DEIR GHOUSSOUN. ONE ARAB WAS KILLED, ONE BERIOUSLY INJURED AND THREE CAPTURED BY TROOPS. THE GOVERNMENT CLOSED ALL NORTHERN FRONTIER STATIONS FROM SEVEN P.M. TODAY FOR SECURITY. IN TIBERIAS, AN ARAB CROWD RETURNING FROM THE FUMERAL OF AN ARAB KILLED ACCIDENTALLY BY A JEWISH AUTOMOBILE DRIVER STONED JEWISH HOUSES AND BROKE WINDOWS, SLIGHTLY INJURING TWO JEWS. A JEWISH AUXILIARY POLICEMAN FIRED INTO THE AIR AND DISPERSED THE ATTACKERS.

YESTERDAY, TERRORISTS KILLED A JEWISH WORKER IN AN AMBUSH OF A GROUP EMPLOYED IN CONSTRUCTING A BARBED-WIRE BARRICADE ON THE PALESTINE-SYRIA FRONTIER. THE VICTIM WAS ELIMELECH REZNICK, 24, WHO CAME TO PALESTINE FROM RUMANIA THREE YEARS AGO. SPECIAL POLICEMEN GUARDING THE GROUP RETURNED THE ARAB FIRE, REPORTEDLY KILLING THREE TERRORISTS.

AS AN ARAB STRIKE CONTINUED IN NABLUS, TULKAREM AND JENIN, THE DISTRICT COMMISSIONER WARRED THAT TROOPS WOULD OCCUPY THE AREA IF THE STRIKE WAS NOT ENDED IN THREE HOURS. NABLUS INHABITANTS MET IN A LARGE MOSQUE AND DECIDED TO CONTINUE THE STRIKE, HOLDING A DEMONSTRATION AFTER THE MEETING.

PARTITION COMMISSION CONCERNED OVER DEFENSE OF PROPOSED JEWISH STATE

JERUSALEM, JUNE 26. (JTA) -- THE QUESTION OF DEFENSE OF THE PROPOSED JEWISH STATE IS TROUBLING BRITAIN'S PALESTINE PARTITION COMMISSION, JUDGING BY QUESTIONS ASKED OF WITNESSES BY THE COMMISSIONERS. IT WAS LEARNED THAT PERSONS TESTIFYING FOR THE RELIGIOUS AGUDATH ISRAEL WERE QUESTIONED AT LENGTH ON THIS POINT.

THE COMMISSION IS EXPECTED TO WIND UP ITS INQUIRY HERE WITHIN A FORTNIGHT AND RETURN TO LONDON FOR FURTHER HEARINGS. THE COMMISSION, IT WAS LEARNED, HAS BEEN CAREFULLY STUDYING THE POSSIBILITIES OF JEWISH SETTLEMENT IN TRANSJORDAN AND ALSO THE DEVELOPMENT AND EXPLOITATION OF THE NEGEV, IN SOUTHERN PALESTINE, BY A BRITISH COMPANY SIMILAR TO THE HUDSON BAY COMPANY, WITH JEWISH WORKERS AND SETTLERS.

THE COMMISSION DEVOTED MUCH ATTENTION TO THE QUESTION OF THE ARAB POPULATION LIVING WITHIN THE PROPOSED JEWISH STATE, IT WAS LEARNED, AND WAS REPORTED TO HAVE ASKED THE JEWISH AGENCY TO SIGMIT A WRITTEN STATEMENT OF POLICY TO BE PURSUED TOWARD THE ARAB INHABITANTS. IT WAS LEARNED THAT AGUDATH ISRAEL WITNESSES WERE QUESTIONED ON THIS ISSUE.

APPEALS, DEMONSTRATIONS SEEK CLEMENCY FOR CONDEMNED YOUTH IN PALESTINE

JERUSALEM, JUNE 26. (JTA) -- APPEALS AND DEMONSTRATIONS FOR CLEMENCY SPREAD THROUGH-OUT PALESTINE TODAY IN BEHALF OF SHLOMO BEN-JOSEPH, 22-YEAR-OLD ZIGNIST-REVISIONIST, SENTENCED TO DEATH BY THE HAIFA MILITARY COURT FOR FIRING ON AN ARAB BUS AND POSSESSING ARMS, WHOSE SENTENCE WAS CONFIRMED FRIDAY BY THE COMMANDER OF BRITISH TROOPS IN PALESTINE.

ALTHOUGH IT WAS SUNDAY, HIGH COMMISSIONER SIR HAROLD A. MACMICHAEL RECEIVED CHIEF RABBIS ISAAC HERZOG AND JOSEPH ZVI DUSHINSKY, AND RABBI MOSHE BLAU, LEADER OF THE AGUDATH ISRAEL, WHO APPEALED FOR CLEMENCY FOR THE CONDEMNED YOUTH. THE AGUDATH ISRAEL CABLED KING GEORGE URGING ROYAL INTERVENTION. COLONISTS DEMONSTRATED AT HADAR HACARMEL, NEAR HAIFA, DEMANDING COMMUTATION OF THE SENTENCE, AND ALSO ARMS FOR SELF-DEFENSE AGAINST TERRORISM. THE POLISH CONSUL-GENERAL APPEALED TO THE HIGH COMMISSIONER FOR CLEMENCY FOR THE MOUTH.

DEMONSTRATION IN WARSAW

WARSAW, JUNE 26. (JTA) -- YOUTHFUL ZIONIST-REVISIONISTS DEMONSTRATED OUTSIDE THE BRITISH EMBASSY HERE TODAY, AND SENT A STONE CRASHING THROUGH A WINDOW WRAPPED IN A SHEET OF PAPER WHICH SAID: "WE SHALL NOT REST UNTIL BEN-JOSEPH IS RELEASED." EARLIER, A ZIONIST-REVISIONIST DELEGATION WAS RECEIVED BY THE BRITISH AMBASSADOR AND PROTESTED THE DEATH SENTENCE, APPEALING TO THE KING TO EXERCISE HIS PARDON PREROGATIVE. THE WOMEN'S INTERNATIONAL ZIONIST ORGANIZATION AND THE JEWISH UNION OF NATIONAL WOMEN APPEALED TO QUEEN ELIZABETH, IN MEMORY OF HER MOTHER; TO ASK THE KING TO INTERCEDE AND PREVENT THE HANGING OF BEN-JOSEPH. THE RABBINICAL ASSOCIATION CABLED THE ARCHBISHOP OF CANTERBURY REQUESTING THAT HE INTERVENE WITH THE KING TO OBTAIN COMMUTATION OF THE YOUTH'S SENTENCE.

REJECT PROPOSAL TO BAR POLISH JEWS OF MUNICIPAL VOTING RIGHTS

WARSAW, JUNE 26. (JTA) -- A CONFERENCE OF LOCAL GOVERNMENT REPRESENTATIVES TODAY REJECTED A PROPOSAL BY ANTI-SEMITIC NATIONAL DEMOCRATS TO DEPRIVE JEWS OF MUNICIPAL VOTING RIGHTS. THE MINISTRY OF INTERIOR HAS PROHIBITED IMPORTS AND DISTRIBUTION IN POLAND OF A NUMBER OF GERMAN ANTI-SEMITIC PUBLICATIONS.

600 EXPELLED IN REICH DRIVE ON SOVIET CITIZENS; 400 ARE JEWS

BERLIN, JUNE 26. (JTA) -- THE REICH GOVERNMENT IS SYSTEMATICALLY MOVING TO EXPEL ALL SOVIET CITIZENS, IT WAS REVEALED HERE TODAY. SIX HUNDRED HAVE BEEN EXPELLED SINCE FEBRUARY, OF WHOM 400 ARE JEWS. THE TOTAL NUMBER OF SOVIET CITIZENS IN THE REICH IS 1,200, OF WHOM TWO-THIRDS ARE JEWS. SOVIET JEWS WHO HAVE RECEIVED LETTERS OF EXPULSION HAVE BEEN WARNED THAT PROTEST WILL BE UNAVAILING, SINCE THE ACTION AGAINST THEM IS COLLECTIVE.

IN SOME CASES THE AUTHORITIES HAVE GRANTED RETURN VISAS TO THOSE ORDERED EXPELLED, IN ORDER TO FACILITATE OBTAINING OF VISAS FROM OTHER COUNTRIES, BUT THEY HAVE FORCED THE RECIPIENTS TO SIGN A SECRET AGREEMENT THAT THESE WILL NOT BE UTILIZED UNDER PENALTY OF INTERNMENT IN A CONCENTRATION CAMP.

MANY FAMILIES HAVE BEEN BROKEN UP BY THE EXPULSION ORDERS. IN ONE CASE, A SOVIET JEW MARRIED TO A NON-JEWESS WAS PERMITTED TO REMAIN WHILE THE WIFE AND ONE OF THEIR SONS WERE EXILED. AN 80-YEAR-OLD JEWESS WAS SERVED WITH HER NOTICE AT AN ALMSHOUSE WHERE SHE LIVED. SOME WEALTHY EXPORTERS, WHOSE BUSINESSES HAVE BROUGHT IN GREAT SUMS OF FOREIGN CURRENCY, HAVE NEVERTHELESS BEEN EXPELLED. ON THE OTHER HAND, SCORES OF PERSONS LIVING ON PUBLIC RELIEF HAVE SO FAR ESCAPED EXPULSION.

LAST WEEK, THE POLICE EXTENDED THE SPHERE OF ACTIVITY TO SOVIET CITIZENS REGARDLESS OF RACE. SOVIET "ARYANS" WHO HAD RECEIVED MIMEOGRAPHED LETTERS ORDERING THEM TO APPLY TO THE SOVIET CONSUL FOR PERMITS TO RETURN TO RUSSIA WERE INFORMED THAT THEY COULD NOT BE OBTAINED UNTIL AUGUST WHEN THEY WILL BE SERVED WITH EXPULSION ORDERS.

UNLIKE THE LETTERS RECEIVED BY JEWS, THE "ARYANS" ARE NOT THREATENED WITH PUNISHMENT IF THEY FAIL TO COMPLY. SOME QUARTERS BELIEVE THE LETTERS TO SOVIET "ARYANS" SERVE TO ENABLE THE POLICE TO DISCOVER WHO CAN OBTAIN PERMISSION TO ENTER RUSSIA, SUCH PERSONS BEING AUTOMATICALLY PERSONA NON GRATA IN GERMANY. IN FACT, MOST SOVIET CITIZENS HERE, WHETHER JEWS OR NON-JEWS, WHITE RUSSIANS OR OPPOSITIONISTS, DO NOT DESIRE TO RETURN TO THEIR FATHERLAND.

JEWS INCLUDED IN LABOR DECREE

BERLIN, JUNE 26. (JTA) -- THAT JEWS FALL WITHIN THE SCOPE OF THE LEW UNIVERSAL LABOR CONSCRIPTION DECREE WHICH GOES INTO EFFECT JULY I WAS ACKNOWLEDGED TODAY BY AUTHORITATIVE NAZI QUARTERS. "THE LAW," IT WAS STATED, "AFFECTS TWO CLASSES OF GERMAN CITIZENS," THE GERMAN JEWS BEING RATED AS SECOND-CLASS CITIZENS. GOVERNMENT SOURCES, HOWEVER, REFUSE TO CONFIRM OR DENY THAT THE LAW ACTUALLY WILL BE USED FOR DRAFTING JEWISH LABOR. EDITORIAL COMMENT SO FAR STUDIOUSLY AVOIDS USE OF THE WORD "JEW" IN CONNECTION WITH THE LAW AND IT IS BELIEVED HERE THAT THE AVOIDANCE IS NOT ACCIDENTAL.

"ARYAN," JEW SENTENCED FOR RACE DEFILEMENT

BERLIN, JUNE 26. (JTA) -- ONE OF THE RARE INSTANCES IN WHICH "ARYANS" WERE PUNISHED FOR "RASSENSCHANDE" (RACIAL DEFILEMENT) WAS RECORDED TODAY AT STETTIN WHEN A PHYSICIAN WAS SENTENCED TO THREE YEARS' IMPRISONMENT AND LOSS OF CIVIL RIGHTS FOR FIVE YEARS. HE WAS CONVICTED OF CARRYING ON RELATIONS WITH A MARRIED JEWESS.

SAAPBRUCKEN, GERMANY, JUNE 26. (HAVAS) -- HUGO HEYDT, A JEWISH MERCHANT FROM COLOGNE, WAS SENTENCED TO THREE YEARS IN JAIL BY A LOCAL COURT ON CHARGES OF HAVING HAD INTIMATE RELATIONS WITH AN "ARYAN" CHAMBERMAID IN A HOTEL HERE, AND THUS "SOILING THE RACE."

JEWS BARRED FROM VIENNA PARKS

VIENNA, JUNE 26. (HAVAS) -- A POLICE ORDER BANNED JEWS FROM ALL VIENNA PUBLIC PARKS AND GARDENS "IN ORDER TO PROTECT THE POPULATION FROM CONTINUOUS PROVOCATIONS."

U.S. JEWS, EXCEPT EMIGRANTS FROM REICH, EXEMPTED FROM PROPERTY REGISTRATION

WASHINGTON, JUNE 26. (JTA) -- THE GERMAN GOVERNMENT WILL EXEMPT FROM THE PROVISIONS OF THE GOERING DEGREE FOR REGISTRATION OF JEWISH PROPERTY AMERICAN NATIONALS "PERMANENTLY DOMICILED ABROAD," THE STATE DEPARTMENT ANNOUNCED VESTERDAY. THE EXEMPTION, HOWEVER, SPECIFICALLY EXCLUDES "FORMER GERMAN NATIONALS WHO HAVE EMIGRATED."

SECRETARY OF STATE CORDELL HULL, AT A PRESS CONFERENCE, READ A BRIEF SUMMARY OF THE GERMAN NOTE HANDED BY THE GERMAN FOREIGN OFFICE TO UNITED STATES AND ASSADOR HUGH R. WILSON IN REPLY TO THE AMERICAN PROTEST ON APPLICATION OF THE GOERING DECREE TO AMERICAN NATIONALS. THE SUMMARY SAID THAT THE FOREIGN OFFICE HAD ORALLY EXPLAINED THE EXEMPTION LIMITATION AS REFERRING TO "THOSE WHO HAD EMIGRATED FOR POLITICAL REASONS SINCE 1933."

MR. HULL ADDED THAT THE AMERICAN GOVERNMENT HAS ASKED THE GERMAN FOREIGN OFFICE FOR PERMISSION TO RELEASE FULL TEXT OF THE NOTE AND FOR CLARIFICATION OF "CERTAIN IMPLICATIONS" IN IT.

FRANCE, MEXICO NAME REPRESENTATIVES TO EVIAN PARLEY

PARIS, JUNE 26. (JTA) -- IT WAS ANNOUNCED OFFICIALLY THAT SENATOR HENRI BERENGER, CHAIRMAN OF THE SENATE FOREIGN AFFAIRS COMMISSION, WILL HEAD THE FRENCH DELEGATION TO THE REFUGEE-AID CONFERENCE WHICH CONVENES JULY 6 AT EVIAN-LES-BAINS. SENATOR BERENGER WILL BE ASSISTED BY MINISTER PLENIPOTENTIARY DE REFFYE AND M. ARNAL, DIRECTOR OF THE QUAI D'ORSAY'S LEAGUE OF NATIONS SECTION.

MEXICO CITY, JUNE 26. (JTA) -- PRIMO VILLA MICHEL, MEXICAN REPRESENTATIVE AT GENEVA, HAS BEEN NAMED TO REPRESENT THE MEXICAN GOVERNMENT AT THE EVIAN INTERGOVERNMENTAL REFUGEE-AID CONFERENCE, IT WAS ANNOUNCED HERE TODAY. HIGH GOVERNMENT OFFICIALS HAVE BEEN CONFERENING WITH REPRESENTATIVES OF JEWISH REFUGEE COMMITTEE HERE TO OUTLINE A SUGGESTED COURSE OF ACTION FOR THE MEXICAN DELEGATE. THE JEWISH REPRESENTATIVES WERE SHOWN WRITTEN PROTESTS BY ANTI-SEMITIC GROUPS AND EVEN LABOR SYNDICATES AGAINST ADMISSION OF REFUGEES. THE PROTESTS CITE FEARS AS TO THE EFFECT OF NEW COMPETITION.

BARCELONA JEWISH COMMUNITY HOLDS FIRST ELECTIONS SINCE OUTBREAK OF WAR

BARCELONA, JUNE 26. (JTA) -- FOR THE FIRST TIME SINCE THE OUTBREAK OF THE CIVIL WAR, THE JEWISH COMMUNITY OF BARCELONA TODAY HELD ELECTIONS FOR ITS EXECUTIVE COMMITTEE. EDMUNDO GRUENBAUM WAS RE-ELECTED PRESIDENT, AND A SLATE OF FOUR SEPHARDIC JEWS AND FOUR ASHKENAZIC JEWS WAS ELECTED. THE MIXED LIST WAS OPPOSED BY A SLATE COMPOSED ENTIRELY OF SEPHARDIM.

RELIEF NEEDS OF VIENNA JEWS SEEN INCREASING DAILY; MORE KITCHENS REQUIRED

NEW YORK, JUNE 26. (JTA) -- DECLARING RELIEF NEEDS OF VIENNESE JEWS WERE INCREASING DAILY, JOSEPH C. HYMAN, EXECUTIVE DIRECTOR OF THE JOINT DISTRIBUTION COMMITTEE, TODAY REPORTED IN A STATEMENT ON AID TO JEWS IN AUSTRIA THAT IT MAY BE NECESSARY TO OPEN ADDITIONAL FREE KITCHENS TO PREVENT STARVATION OF MANY.

MR. HYMAN SAID EFFORTS WERE BEING MADE TO SECURE FOR AUSTRIAN JEWRY "THE EXPERIENCE AND FACILITIES OF THE JEWISH ORGANIZATIONS IN GERMANY THAT HAVE ENGAGED IN VOCATIONAL TRAINING, ECONOMIC AID AND THE FACILITATION OF EMIGRATION." HE ADDED: "TO THE EXTENT THAT CONTACT BETWEEN THE GERMAN JEWISH CENTRAL COMMITTEE OF RELIEF AND RECONSTRUCTION AND THE VIENNA JEWISH COMMUNITY IS AUTHORIZED, MEASURES LEADING TOWARD RETRAINING AND THE BEGINNING OF PLANNED EMIGRATION WILL BE UNDERTAKEN."

CONFERENCES IN VIENNA BETWEEN REPRESENTATIVES OF THE J.D.C. AND OTHER JEWISH ORGANIZATIONS, AND OFFICIALS OF THE VIENNA JEWISH COMMUNITY, WERE FOLLOWED, MR. HYMAN SAID, BY EMERGENCY MEASURES TO AID PENNILESS THOUSANDS.

"THE BURDEN OF KEEPING THE GROWING NUMBER OF VIENNESE JEWS FROM STARVATION IS INCREASING DAILY AND IT MAY BE NECESSARY FOR THE GEMEINDE TO OPEN ADDITIONAL FREE KITCHENS.
THE PRESENT ECONOMIC COMPOSITION OF THE JEWISH COMMUNITY OF VIENNA IS MUCH WORSE THAN
IT WAS IN THE LARGER GERMAN CITIES. THE PROPORTION OF POOR PEOPLE WHO FOUND THEMSELVES
PENNILESS AND FOODLESS WITHIN A FEW DAYS AFTER LOSING THEIR REGULAR INCOME IS MUCH GREATER.
THE INCOME OF THE COMMUNITY, FURTHERMORE, HAS ALWAYS BEEN MUCH SMALLER AND NOW MOST OF
ITS SOURCES OF SUPPORT ARE BLOCKED. TO THE EXTENT THAT THE JEWS OF AUSTRIA CANNOT MEET
THEIR NEEDS, THEY WILL REQUIRE THE ASSISTANCE OF OUTSIDE ORGANIZATIONS."

LACK OF IMMIGRATION HITS CANADIAN RAILWAYS

OTTAWA, June 26. (JTA) -- Lack of immigration to Canada was one of the principal reasons why the Canadian National Railways, owned and operated by the Canadian Government, is and has been in financial debt for nearly two decades. This was revealed in the Turgeon Report on the Canadian Railways when the Canadian Senate discussed the problem at its session last week. The Canadian National Railway, built at the opening of the twentieth century to accompate the rush of settlers to Western Canada, enjoyed its only prosperous years while the huse immigration wave, before the Great War, populated many centers and districts of Canada. From the very moment immigration ceased to flow into Canada, the C.N.R. started to show an annual deficit.

A LESS RESTRICTIVE IMMIGRATION POLICY WAS URGED IN THE HOUSE OF COMMONS BY H.A. MCKENZIE, LIBERAL, WHILE SPEAKING ON THE CANADIAN BUDGET. HE SAID THERE WAS A SHORTAGE OF FARM LABOR IN CANADA AND THAT A GREAT DEAL OF GOOD FARMING LAND AWAITED SETTLEMENT.

RABBI CURRICK RE-ELECTED PRESIDENT OF C.C.A.R. AS ANNUAL MEETING CLOSES

ATLANTIC CITY, June 26. (JTA) -- THE CENTRAL CONFERENCE OF AMERICAN RABBIS TODAY CLOSED ITS 49TH ANNUAL MEETING, RE-ELECTING RABBI MAX C. CURRICK, OF ERIE, PA., AS PRESIDENT, AND ALL OTHER OFFICERS. THE CONFERENCE ADOPTED THE RECOMMENDATIONS OF ITS MARRIAGE AND FAMILY COMMITTEE URGING REFORM RABBIS TO REQUIRE A FIVE-DAY INTERVAL BETWEEN APPLICATION FOR MARRIAGE AND PERFORMANCE OF THE CEREMONY, A GENERAL MEDICAL EXAMINATION BY BOTH PARTIES AND PREPARATION FOR AN UNDERSTANDING OF THE PROBLEMS OF MARRIAGE AND FAMILY LIFE.
