NEW COLONY OPENED DESPITE POLICE BAN; JEW SLAIN; CURFEW LIFTED; CENSORSHIP IMPOSED

JERUSALEM, JULY 19. (JTA) -- IN THE FACE OF CONTINUING DISORDERS WHICH ADDED ANOTHER JEWISH DEATH TO THE MOUNTING TOLL, AND WITH SPECIAL POLICE PROTECTION REFUSED, A BAND OF 150 JEWS EARLY THIS MORNING ESTABLISHED A NEW COLONY ON JEWISH NATIONAL FUND LAND ABOUT EIGHT MILES WEST OF THIS CITY.

THE SITE OF THE NEW SETTLEMENT IS NEAR THE COLONY OF KIRIAT ANAVIM, WHERE FIVE JEWISH WORKERS WERE SLAIN LAST FALL IN AN ARAB AMBUSCADE. POLICE HAVING REFUSED PERMISS-ION FOR THE OCCUPATION BECAUSE OF THE CURRENT TERRORISM, THE SETTLERS TOOK POSSESSION OF THE LAND SECRETLY AT FOUR A.M.

While the Situation in Jerusalem had eased Sufficiently for the Authorities this afternoon to Lift the two-week curfem, sporadic terrorism continued in other parts of Palestine. Arab terrorists this morning killed Mendel Lichtenstein, 23, a native of Polano, near Krár Saba.

THE GOVERNMENT TODAY CLAPPED DOWN A STRICT CENSORSHIP ON OUTGOING PRESS WIRES AND RESTRICTED THE HOURS OF FILING. NEWS SENT AFTER 11 P.M. (4 P.M. EASTERN STANDARD TIME) WILL NOT BE TRANSMITTED UNTIL THE FOLLOWING MORNING. THE CENSORSHIP FOLLOWED A RECENT BAN ON THE PUBLICATION WITHIN PALESTINE OF NEWS OF MILITARY MOVEMENTS. LAST NIGHT THE GOVERNMENT RADIO STATION BROADCAST A WARNING AGAINST THE SPREADING OF INCITING RUMORS.

AT THE SAME TIME A SPECIAL ISSUE OF THE OFFICIAL PALESTINE GAZETTE, SIGNED BY THE GOVERNMENT CENSOR, ANNOUNCED A PROHIBITION ON PUBLICATION OF A LETTER BY COL. JOSIAH WEGG-WOOD, BRITISH PRO-ZIONIST MEMBER OF PARLIAMENT, TO THE JEWISH UNION OF ARMY OFFICERS IN TEL AVIV, URGING ON THE JEWS A POLICY OF NON-COOPERATION WITH THE BRITISH AUTHORITIES.

DESPITE THE LIFTING OF CURFEW, THERE WERE STILL SIGNS OF UNREST IN THIS CITY. THIS MORNING SOLDIERS WITH FIXED BAYONETS SUDDENLY OCCUPIED JAFFA ROAD, IN THE HEART OF THE JEWISH BUSINESS SECTION, HALTING TRAFFIC AND DRIVING PASSERSBY INTO SIDE STREETS AT BAYONET-POINT. THE PURPOSE OF THE ACTION WAS NOT IMMEDIATELY DISCLOSED.

THE TEL AVIV MUNICIPAL COUNCIL, AT A CLOSED MEETING ON THE QUESTION OF SECURITY, ADOPTED A RESOLUTION CONDEMNING ACTS OF REVENGE AGAINST THE ARABS, CALLING ON THE JEWISH COMMUNITY FOR THE MOST RIGID DISCIPLINE, AND DEMANDING INCREASED PROTECTION.

SHEIKH AREF-EL-YOUNIS, CHIEF PREACHER OF THE MOSQUE OF OMAR AND AN ENEMY OF THE EXILED EX-MUFTI OF JERUSALEM, ESCAPED THE THIRD ATTEMPT ON HIS LIFE SINCE THE OUTBREAK OF THE CURRENT DISORDERS. TERRORISTS MADE A DAYLIGHT ATTEMPT TO ASSASSINATE HIM BY FIRING INTO HIS CAR NEAR HEROD'S GATE. THE SHEIKH'S BODYGUARD RETURNED THE FIRE, BUT NONE OF THE ASSAILANTS WAS HIT.

ARAB TERRORISTS LATE YESTERDAY BLEW UP A RAILWAY BRIDGE BETWEEN LYDDA AND HAIFA, CAUSING TRAFFIC TO BE SUSPENDED. TWO BOMBS EXPLODED HARMLESSLY IN ARAB-JEWISH QUARTERS OF HAIFA.

Four Jerusalem and four Tel Aviv Revisionists, who have been under arrest in connection with the disorders, were released on bail. They include Dr. Ephraim Washitz, Leader of the Jerusalem Revisionists, and E. Steimatzky, prominent bookseller.

PEEL COMMISSIONER CAUTIONS AGAINST REPRISALS

LONDON, JULY 19. (JTA) -- SIR LAURIE HAMMOND, A MEMBER OF THE PEEL ROYAL COMMISSION WHOSE PROPOSAL FOR THREE-WAY DIVISION OF PALESTINE IS NOW BEING EXAMINED BY A PARTITION COMMISSION IN JERUSALEM, CAUTIONED PALESTINE JEWRY TODAY AGAINST A POLICY OF REPRISALS FOR ARBS TERRORISM.

IN A LETTER TO THE TIMES, REPLYING TO COL. JOSIAH WEDGWOOD'S LETTER URGING PASSIVE RES STANCE, SIR LAURIE WARNED THAT REPRISALS WOULD DAMAGE THE JEWISH CAUSE, DEPRIVING IT OF "SYMPATHY JUSTLY EARNED."

"RETALIATION," HE SAID, "HAS ALREADY MADE THE SOLUTION OF THE PALESTINE PROBLEM MORE DIFFICULT. POURING OIL ON THE FLAMES OF HATRED IS A DANGEROUS EXPERIMENT."

DRIVE AGAINST "HAVLAGAH" LAUNCHED IN POLAND

WARSAW, JULY 19. (JTA) -- A NATION-WIDE CAMPAIGN AGAINST "HAVLAGAH" -- THE NON-RETALIATION POLICY PURSUED BY THE PALESTINE JEWS -- WAS LAUNCHED TODAY BY THE NEW ZIONIST ORGANIZATION. THE ORGANIZATION PROCLAIMED JULY 31 AS "BEN JOSEF DAY" MARKING THE END OF THE 30 DAYS' MOURNING PERIOD FOR THE JEWISH YOUTH EXECUTED IN PALESTINE DURING WHICH MEETINGS WILL BE HELD IN 30 TOWNS.

AT THE SAME TIME LEAFLETS WERE WIDELY CIRCULATED REPRODUCING A LETTER SENT TWO MONTHS AGO BY COL. JOSIAH WEDGWOOD, PRO-ZIONIST MEMBER OF THE BRITISH PARLIAMENT, TO THE JEWISH UNION OF ARMY OFFICERS IN TEL AVIV PURPORTEDLY DEMOUNCING THE SELF-RESTRAINT POLICY AND URGING NON-COOPERATION WITH THE GOVERNMENT, NON-PAYMENT OF TAXES AND DELIVERANCE OF JEWISH PRISONERS BY FORCE.

A MEETING OF THE BUND, JEWISH SOCIALIST PARTY, STRESSED THAT THE UPBUILDING OF PALESTINE DID NOT AFFORD A SOLUTION OF THE JEWISH PROBLEM.

NOTED BRITONS URGE NATIONS TO UNITED STAND AGAINST PERSECUTION OF JEWS

LONDON, JULY 19. (JTA) -- A GROUP OF PROMINENT BRITONS TODAY CONDEMNED NAZI PERSECUT-ION OF JEWS AS A "SYSTEMATIC ATTEMPT TO ROOT OUT AND DESTROY MEMBERS OF THE MOST GIFTED OF HUMAN RACES." A LETTER TO THE TIMES, SIGNED BY THE BISHOP OF CHICHESTER, LORD LYTTON, CAPT.

VICTOR CAZALET AND OTHERS, DECLARES THE PERSECUTION "HAS BECOME A CASE FOR THE CONSCIENCE
OF ALL HOLDING CHRISTIAN DOCTRINE AND HUMAN PERSONALITY SACRED." THE LETTER CONCLUDES
WITH AN APPEAL FOR GREAT BRITAIN TO JOIN THE UNITED STATES AND OTHER CIVILIZED NATIONS
IN "CHALLERGING WHAT IS OTHERWISE A DEGRADING REPROACH TO OUR HUMANITY AND CHRISTIANITY
ALIKE."

REICH STOCKS TUMBLE; CURBS ON JEWS SEEN AS FACTOR IN WORST BREAK SINCE 1933

NEW YORK, JULY 19. (JTA) -- GERMAN STOCK EXCHANGES YESTERDAY SUFFERED THEIR WORST DAY SINCE CHANCELLOR HITLER CAME TO POWER, THE NEW YORK TIMES REPORTED TODAY FROM BERLIN. OTTO D. TOLISCHUS, THE CORRESPONDENT ATTRIBUTED THE DROP TO THE GOVERNMENT'S PRE-EMPTION OF CAPITAL MARKETS, THE DRASTIC MEASURES AGAINST JEWS, THE DECLINE OF WORLD ECONOMY, AND GERMANY'S FORCEFUL POLITICAL MEASURES WHICH MAKE OTHER NATION'S WARY AND ENTAIL COUNTERMEASURES.

"HEAVY JEWISH LIQUIDATIONS CAUSED BY ENFORCED 'ARYANIZATIONS' AND THE NUMEROUS RESTRICTIONS IMPOSED ON JEWISH BUSINESSES, TOGETHER WITH THE SUDDEN EXCLUSION OF JEWISH BROKERS FROM STOCK EXCHANGES, HAVE GREATLY CONTRIBUTED TO THE SLUMP IN STOCKS, BUT ANTI-JEWISH EXCESSES IN VIENNA HAVE ALSO CONTRIBUTED TO THE SLUMP IN FOREIGN TRADE," THE CORRESPONDENT SAID.

DESPITE RIGID CONTROL, PRICES YESTERDAY TUMBLED FOUR, FIVE, SIX AND, IN INDIVIDUAL CASES, UP TO NIME POINTS, IN WHAT GERMAN NEWSPAPERS THEMSELYES CALLED A SENSATIONAL COCLAPSE. TODAY, ACCORDING TO THE ASSOCIATED PRESS, REICHSBANK SHARES CONTINUED TO DECLINE ON THE BERLIN BOERSE, BUT OTHER SHARES REGAINED SOME OF YESTERDAY'S LOSSES.

AIR PLANS FOR PAN-AFRICAN CONFERENCE TO COMBAT WAZISM

JOHAMIESSERG (JTA) — Possibility of a pan-African and Anglo-South African conference to consider the menace of intensified Nazi activities in South West Africa is being discussed by prominent South African Leaders, it is Learned Here.

THE PLANNED "ARMED CENSUS" AND RECENT DISCLOSURES OF NAZI ACTIVITIES HAVE FOCUSSED ATTENTION ON THE DANGER TO THE SECURITY OF THE UNION OF SOUTH AFRICA RESULTING FROM NAZI ACTIVITIES IN THE MANDATED SOUTH WEST TERRITORY. IT IS UNDERSTOOD THAT MEMBERS OF THE SOUTH AFRICAN UNITED PARTY PLAN'TO RAISE THE QUESTION IN PARTY CAUCUS AND IN THE HOUSE WHEN +T MEETS LATE THIS MONTH.

THE EXPOSE OF NAZI ACTIVITIES IN SOUTH WEST AFRICA HAS BEEN FOLLOWED BY NUMEROUS PRESS DEMANDS FOR STRONG ACTION AND AN APPEAL TO THE DUTCH REFORMED CHURCH, ISSUED "IN THE NAME OF MANY THOUSANDS OF GOD-FEARING AFRIKANERS," PROTESTING AGAINST PERSECUTION OF JEWS AND URGING A FIGHT AGAINST THE NAZI MENACE.

THE CAPE TIMES DECLARES EDITORIALLY THAT THE UNION GOVERNMENT CANNOT FOR A MOMENT ADMIT THE GERMAN CLAIM OF DUAL ALLEGIANCE. THE JOHANNESSURG STAR ADVOCATES LEGISLATION FORBIDDING PROPAGATION OF FOREIGN IDEOLOGIES, MOVEMENTS AGAINST RACIAL AND RELIGIOUS SECTIONS OF THE COMMUNITY AND QUASI-MILITARY ORGANIZATIONS. THE WINDHOEK ADVERTISER WARNS THAT UNLESS IMMEDIATE ACTION IS TAKEN A GERMAN MINORITY PROBLEM SIMILAR TO CZECHOSLOVAKIA'S MAY ARISE. THE SUNDAY TIMES QUOTES A PROMINENT SOUTH WEST AFRICAN LEADER AS STATING THAT THE GOVERNMENT IS RELUCTANT TO CURB NAZI ACTIVITIES, NOT WISHING TO ANTAGONIZE GERMANY "FOR TRADE REASONS."

FASCIST RACE DOCTRINE SPURRED BY ANTI-ITALIAN ACTIVITIES OF FOREIGN JEWS, EDITOR HOLDS

NEW YORK, JULY 19. (JTA) -- VIRGINIO GAYDA, AUTHORITATIVE FASCIST SPOKESMAN, TODAY BLAMED "ANTI-ITALIAN" ACTIVITIES OF JEMS ABROAD FOR THE ISSUANCE OF THE RACIAL DOCTRINE LAST WEEK UNDER THE SPONSORSHIP OF THE MINISTRY OF POPULAR CULTURE, ACCORDING TO AN ASSOCIATED PRESS DISPATCH FROM ROME. ...

WRITING IN GIORNALE D'ITALIA, GAYDA DENIED THAT ITALY'S POLICY WAS INFLUENCED BY GERMANY'S. HE SAID THAT "ITALY FINDS ITSELF EVER CONFRONTED BY ANTI-ITALIAN AND ANTI-EUROPEAN ACTIVITIES OF THE JEWRY OF THE GREAT PRESS OF TWO WORLD, OF THE GREAT BANKS WHICH DOMINATE EVEN STATESMEN AND POLITICIANS...THE HISTORY OF THIS BATTLE DOES NOT INVOLVE GERMANY, BUT IT INVOLVES INSTEAD FRANCE, GREAT BRITAIN, THE UNITED STATES AND SOVIET RUSSIA."

\$18,000 RAISED FOR YOUTH ALIYAH THROUGH WESTCHESTER BAZAAR

MT. VERNON, N.Y., JULY 19. (JTA) -- APPROXIMATELY \$18,000 WAS RAISED FOR THE YOUTH ALIYAH MOVEMENT THROUGH A THREE-DAY BAZAAR HELD ON THE ESTATE OF HARRY M. WARNER, MOTION PICTURE PRODUCER. THE BAZAAR, WHICH ENDED LAST NIGHT, WAS SPONSORED BY WESTCHESTER COUNTY CHAPTERS OF HADASSAH. IT ATTRACTED MORE THAN 30,000 PERSONS, AMONG THEM MANY CHRISTIANS.

ZIONIST CONGRESS MAY BE HELD IN DECEMBER TO WEIGH PARTITION PLAN

LONDON (JTA) -- THE CONVENING OF THE TWENTY-FIRST ZIONIST CONGRESS IN DECEMBER IS REGARDED IN ZIONIST CIRCLES HERE AS VERY PROBABLE, THE JTA LEARNS FROM RELIABLE SOURCES.

IT IS EXPECTED THAT THE PALESTINE PARTITION COMMISSION WILL COMPLETE ITS WORK IN PALESTINE BY THE END OF JULY AND WILL RETURN TO LONDON AT THE BEGINNING OF AUGUST, SUPPLEMENTARY EVIDENCE WILL BE HEARD BY THE COMMISSION IN LONDON DURING THE BEGINNING OF AUGUST, AND IT IS EXPECTED THAT THE REPORT OF THE COMMISSION WILL BE IN THE HANDS OF THE GOVERNMENT NOT LATER THAN SEPTEMBER.

IT IS POINTED OUT IN THIS CONNECTION THAT THE OPINION OFTEN EXPRESSED IN THE BRITISH PRESS, THAT THE ADOPTION BY THE BRITISH GOVERNMENT OF A DEFINITE AND UNAMBIGUOUS SOLUTION OF THE PALESTINE PROBLEM IS ESSENTIAL FOR THE RESTORATION OF ORDER IN THE COUNTRY, HAS ALSO GAINED GROUND AMONG THE MEMBERS OF THE CABINET, AND THAT CONSEQUENTLY THE GOVERNMENT WILL URGE THE PALESTINE PARTITION COMMISSION TO SUBMIT ITS REPORT WITH THE LEAST POSSIBLE DELAY.

THE BRITISH GOVERNMENT, THE J.T.A. UNDERSTANDS, IS EASER THAT THE PALESTINE PROPOS-ALS SHOULD BE DISCUSSED BY THE LEAGUE OF NATIONS AT ITS SESSION IN JANUARY 1938. IT WILL-PROBABLY SUBMIT ITS FINAL PROPOSALS FOR THE APPROVAL OF PARLIAMENT IN OCTOBER OR NOVEMBER SO AS TO BE ABLE TO COME TO GENEVA WITH A PLAN TO WHICH PARLIAMENT HAS GIVEN ITS CONSENT.

UNDER SUCH CIRCUMSTANCES THE ZIONIST CONGRESS WILL HAVE TO BE CONVENED IN DECEMBER IN ORDER TO FORMULATE THE JEWISH ATTITUDE TO THE PLAN BEFORE THE SESSION OF THE LEAGUE OF NATIONS.

COMMISSION TO LEAVE FIRST WEEK IN AUGUST

JERUSALEM, JULY 19. (JTA) -- THE PALESTINE PARTITION COMMISSION TODAY VISITED THE JEZREEL VALLEY. IT WAS ANNOUNCED OFFICIALLY THAT THE COMMISSION INTENDS TO LEAVE PALESTINE THE FIRST WEEK IN AUGUST.
