3 JEWS SLAIN IN CONTINUING ARAB DISORDERS

JERUSALEM, Aug. 29 (JTA) -- ARAB RAIDERS AND SNIPERS ADDED THREE JEWS LAST NIGHT AND TODAY TO THE MOUNTING DEATH TOLL IN THE CURRENT DISORDERS.

Two Jews were killed and a third was seriously wounded this morning during an attack on the Jewish cooperative settlement of Ein Shemer, near Karkur. The dead were David Schneider, 28, of Poland, and Dov Hendel, 30. Kolman Sitner, 28, was removed to a hospital in a critical condition.

ARAB SNIPERS FIRED INTO A GROUP OF JEWS STROLLING ON THE BEACH AT ACRE, KILLING EPHRAIM ZILBERMAN, 31. HIS THREE COMPANIONS ESCAPED UNHIT. ARI SCHULMAN, 40, A SPECIAL POLICEMAN, WAS SERIOUSLY MOUNDED WHEN ARAB SNIPERS FIRED INTO TEL AVIV SUBURBS DURING THE NIGHT.

TWO ARAB TERRORISTS WERE REPORTED TO HAVE BEEN KILLED BY JEWISH SPECIAL POLICEMEN WHEN THEY WERE AMBUSHED WHILE PATROLLING A ROAD NEAR MOTZA. URI ORSHANSKI, 18, A MEMBER OF THE PATROL, WAS SLIGHTLY WOUNDED. A JEWISH SPECIAL POLICEMAN WHO WAS KILLED YESTERDAY NEAR GAN YAVNEH WAS IDENTIFIED TODAY AS ITZHAK HABERCORN, 19, A RESIDENT OF GAN YAVNEH.

A GREEK MONK AND HIS BROTHER, KIDNAPED AUG. 24 FROM A MONASTERY NEAR CESARIA, WERE FOUND DEAD LAST NIGHT NEAR TULKAREM.

JUDGE MUSTAPHA BEY KHALIDI, A MEMBER OF THE PALESTINE SUPREME COURT, TODAY BECAME MAYOR OF JERUSALEM, TAKING OVER THE DUTIES PERFORMED BY ACTING MAYOR DANIEL AUSTER, A JEW, SINCE EXILE LAST OCTOBER OF MAYOR HUSSEIN KHALIDI, A RELATIVE OF MUSTAPHA BEY. APPOINTMENT OF AN ARAB MAYOR HAS STIRRED RESENTMENT AMONG JERUSALEM'S JEWS, WHO COMPRISE A MAJORITY.

ARABS LIST DEMANDS

LONDON (JTA) -- THE PRINCIPAL POINTS OF THE ARAB DEMANDS WITH REGARD TO THE POLITICAL FUTURE OF PALESTINE ARE LAID DOWN IN A STATEMENT, TERMED "THE ARAB CHARTER FOR PALESTINE" AND SIGNED BY THE ARAB DELEGATE IN LONDON, DR. IZZAT TANNOUS. THE STATEMENT FOLLOWS:

- "I AM ASKED ON BEHALF OF MY COMPATRIOTS TO SET FORTH THE ARAB CHARTER AS FOLLOWS:
- "I. THAT THE PEOPLE ALREADY IN PALESTINE, WHETHER ARAB OR JEW, SHALL BE REGARDED AS THE TRUSTEES OF THE HOLY LAND.
- "2. THAT A NATIONAL GOVERNMENT SHALL BE FORMED, ACCORDING EQUAL, POLITICAL, C.VIL AND RELIGIOUS RIGHTS TO ALL, INDEPENDENT OF RACE AND CREED.
- "3. THAT REPRESENTATION IN SUCH GOVERNMENT SHALL BE IN PROPORTION TO POPULATION, BUT THAT MINORITY RIGHTS SHALL BE GUARANTEED.
- "4. That a Treaty safeguarding the Legitimate interests of Great Britain, on Lines similar to those of Egypt or Irao, shall be made between Great Britain and Palestine.
- "5. THAT THE MANDATE SHALL END WITH THE SIGNING OF THE TREATY, ALL FURTHER IMMIGRATION INTO PALESTINE BEING SUSPENDED UNTIL ITS SIGNATURE, THE ASSUMPTION BEING THAT THE BRITISH GOVERNMENT HAS FULFILLED ITS OBLIGATION TO THE JEWS IN REGARD TO THE 'NATIONAL HOME' IN PALESTINE."

HUNGARY SUPPRESSES PAPER FOR ANTI-JEWISH INCITEMENT

BUDAPEST, Aug. 29 (JTA) -- THE AUTHORITIES HAVE ORDERED CONFISCATION OF THE NEWS-PAPER VOCSES ESVIDENCE, ORGAN OF THE PRO-NAZI ARROW-CROSS ORGANIZATION, FOR PUBLISHING ARTICLES INCITING AGAINST THE JEWISH RELIGION.

MEANWHILE, THE MAYOR OF BUDAPEST DISMISSED 21 OMNIBUS WORKERS FOR PARTICIPATING IN AN ARROW-CROSS POLITICAL DEMONSTRATION DURING WORKING HOURS. AN ORGANIZER OF THE HUNGARIST NAZI PARTY AND THREE OTHERS WERE ARRESTED FOR INCITING WORKERS TO JOIN THE DEMONSTRATION. MUNICIPAL AUTHORITIES ALSO WARNED OTHER CITY EMPLOYERS THAT A SIMILAR FATE AWAITED EMPLOYEES CONNECTED WITH EXTREMIST ORGANIZATIONS.

CHURCH WARNED ON ANTI-SEMITISM

DEBRECEN, HUNGARY, AUG. 29 (JTA) -- DR. CONRAD HOFFMAN JR., ASSISTANT SECRETARY OF THE PRESBYTERIAN BOARD OF NATIONAL MISSIONS OF AMERICA, WARNED A CONFERENCE OF THE HUNGARIAN REFORM EVANGELIC CHURCH TODAY THAT CHRISTIANITY MAY BE DESTROYED BY THE FORCES OF ANTI-SEMITISM. ANTI-SEMITISM CANNOT BE SUPPORTED BY CHRISTIAN ARGUMENTS, DR. HOFFMAN DECLARED, AND CHRISTIANITY THE WORLD OVER IS ON TRIAL BECAUSE OF THE SITUATION OF THE JEWS. OTHER SPEAKERS ASSERTED THAT THERE WAS NO PLACE FOR RACIALISM WITHIN THE CHURCH.

"PASSPORT TAX" LEVIED ON AUSTRIAN JEWS TO FINANCE EMIGRATION OF POOR

PRAHA, Aug. 29 (JTA) -- EMIGRATING AUSTRIAN JEWS MUST PAY A SPECIAL "PASSPORT TAX," FIXED INDIVIDUALLY ACCORDING TO THE AMOUNT OF CAPITAL EACH POSSESSES, IT WAS LEARNED HERE TODAY. PROCEEDS OF THE TAX, NOTICE OF WHICH HAS BEEN SENT OUT BY THE VIENNA JEWISH COMMUNITY, WILL BE USED TO HELP FINANCE EMIGRATION OF PERSONS WITHOUT MEANS. LEYYING OF THE TAX FOLLOWS ESTABLISHMENT OF THE NEW CENTRAL GOVERNMENT OFFICE FOR EMIGRATION OF JEWS.

THIRTY-THREE VIENNA SYNAGOGUES HAVE BEEN DISSOLVED SINCE ANSCHLUSS, ACCORDING TO INFORMATION REACHING HERE. LARGE HALLS PREVIOUSLY USED FOR OVERFLOW SERVICES WILL NOT BE

AVAILABLE FOR THE HIGH HOLY DAYS, THE VIENNA JEWISH COMMUNITY ANNOUNCING THAT SERVICES WILL BE CONFINED TO SYNAGOGUES OPERATED BY THE COMMUNITY.

REICH RESTRICTS TRANSIT VISAS

WARSAW, Aug. 29 (JTA) -- Special transit visas for Jews Wishing to Cross Germany are now being issued by the Reich consul here valid for only 24 hours, compared with the three-day period allowed in the customary transit visa. The measure is apparently aimed at preventing Jewish trayelers from stopping over in Germany when crossing.

MUSSOLINI'S PAPER HITS PROPORTION OF JEWS IN INDUSTRY

ROME, Aug. 29 (JTA) -- POPOLO D'ITALIA OF MILAN, PREMIER BENITO MUSSOLINI'S NEWS-PAPER, DECLARED TODAY THAT THE PRESENCE OF 3,000 JEWS AMONG THE 47,000 WORKERS IN LOWBARD IN-DUSTRIES AND 1,000 JEWS AMONG THE 5,000 EMPLOYEES OF COMMERCIAL HOUSES CONSTITUTED AN "ALARM-ING SITUATION." THE PAPER ALSO ASSAILED THE PRESENCE AT PISA UNIVERSITY OF FIVE JEWISH PRO-FESSORS AND PROF. PAUL OSCAR KRISTELLER, GERMAN JEWISH LECTURER IN GERMAN LANGUAGE, AT PISA NORMAL SCHOOL.

REPORT OF JEWISH STATE PLAN RIDICULED IN WARSAW

WARSAW, Aug. 29 (JTA) -- OFFICIAL CIRCLES TODAY RIDICULED REPORTS OF A PROJECTED JEWISH STATE TO BE ESTABLISHED BY RUMANIA AND POLAND ON THEIR MUTUAL BORDER, REPORTED YESTERDAY BY THE LONDON SUNDAY CHRONICLE.

POLAND BANS JEWISH ARTISANS! UNION

WARSAW, Aug. 29 (JTA) -- THE AUTHORITIES HAVE ORDERED THE DISSOLUTION OF THE CENTRAL UNION OF JEWISH ARTISANS, WHICH HAS 100,000 MEMBERS IN 530 BRANCHES, ON THE GROUNDS THAT NON-ARTISANS WERE MEMBERS OF THE EXECUTIVE COMMITTEE AND THAT THE ORGANIZATION WAS NEGLIGENT IN COLLECTING DUES. EFFORTS TO SECURE REVOCATION OF THE ORDER ARE PROCEEDING.

ANTI-SEMITIC EDITOR NAMED AS 'POLISH GOEBBELS'

WARSAW, Aug. 29 (JTA) -- COLONEL BOGUSLAW MIEDZINSKI, CO-EDITOR OF THE OFFICIAL GAZETA POLSKA, WHO RECENTLY PUBLISHED A SERIES OF ARTICLES DIRECTED AGAINST THE POLISH JEWS, HAS BEEN SELECTED BY THE GOVERNMENT PARTY, CAMP OF NATIONAL UNITY, TO BECOME MINISTER OF PROPAGANDA WHEN THE CAMP COMES TO POWER, IT WAS REPORTED TODAY BY ASC, ORGAN OF THE ANTI-SEMITIC NATIONAL RADICAL PARTY.

REICH SEEKS INFORMATION ON PROPERTY FROM JEWS IN SOUTH AFRICA

LONDON, Aug. 29 (JTA) -- A QUESTIONNAIRE DIRECTED TO JEWS OBLIGING THEM UNDER THREAT OF HEAVY PENALTIES TO DECLARE PROPERTY AND OTHER ASSETS IN THE REICH HAS BEEN ISSUED BY THE GERMAN GOVERNMENT AND IS NOW BEING CIRCULATED IN THE UNION OF SOUTH AFRICA, THE TIMES REPORTED TODAY FROM JOHANNESBURG. ANOTHER QUESTIONNAIRE ASKS ALL BEARERS OF GERMAN PASSPORTS TO FURNISH INFORMATION ABOUT THEMSELVES, PARTICULARLY WITH REFERENCE TO MILITARY SERVICE, THE REPORT SAID.

KEREN HAYESOD PARLEY OPENS IN ANTWERP SUNDAY

ANTWERP, Belgium, Aug. 29 (JTA) -- A world conference of the Keren Hayesod (Palestine Foundation Fund) will open here on Sept. 3 with delegates from all European countries and some overseas delegates participating. Dr. Chaim Weizmann, Dr. Selig Brodetsky and other members of the World Zionist Executive are expected to report on the situation in Zionism.

J.N.F. SENDS \$75,000 TO USSISHKIN

NEW YORK, Aug. 29 (JTA) -- ZIONISTS THROUGHOUT THE WORLD ARE JOINING IN CELE-BRATING THE 75TH BIRTHDAY OF MENACHEM MENDEL USSISHKIN, WORLD PRESIDENT OF THE JEWISH NATION-AL FUND. THE JEWISH NATIONAL FUND HERE SENT A RADIOGRAM TO MR. USSISHKIN IN VICHY, FRANCE, PLACING \$75,000 AT HIS DISPOSAL "AS TOKEN OUR RECOGNITION AND DEEP APPRECIATION OF YOUR MANI-FOLD BATTLES AND ACHIEVEMENTS N OUR NATHONAL RENAISSANCE MOVEMENT OVER MORE THAN HALF A CENTURY, AND PARTICULARLY IN COGNIZANCE ACHIEVEMENTS OF KEREN KAYEMETH, WHICH, UNDER YOUR LEADERSHIP, HAŞ RENDERED GREAT SERVICE IN LAYING FOR HOMELAND THROUGH PALESTINE LAND RE-DEMPTION."

INSCRIBED IN GOLDEN BOOK

MONTREAL, Aug. 29 (JTA) -- THE CONVENTION OF HABONIM, ZIONIST ORDER, DECIDED YESTERDAY TO SEND GREETINGS TO MENACHEM M. USSISHKIN ON HIS 75TH BIRTHDAY AND TO INSCRIBE HIS NAME IN THE JEWISH NATIONAL FUND'S GOLDEN BOOK.

LATE PALESTINE NEWS

JERUSALEM, Aug. 29 (JTA) ... FURTHER DEATHS AS A RESULT OF THE BOMB EX-PLOSION IN A JAFFA VEGETABLE MARKET LAST FRIDAY TODAY RAISED THE ARAB FATAL TY TOTAL TO 32. A GOVERNMENT COMMUNIQUE DENIED RUMORS SPREAD AMONG THE ARABS THAT POLICE WERE IMPL-CATED IN THE BOMBING.

AN ARAB POLICEMAN WAS SHOT AND WOUNDED AS HE LEFT A CAFE BY UNIDENTIFIED ASSAILANTS WHO ALSO WOUNDED THREE PATRONS, ONE OF THEM SERIOUSLY. THE POLICEMAN FIRED AT THE ATTACKERS, BUT MISSED. A POST OFFICE VAN FROM HAIFA WAS HELD UP NEAR JERUSALEM AND MAIL CONSIGNED TO JERUSALEM WAS STOLEN.

ARAB NEWSPAPERS REPORTED THAT 200 ARABS WERE ARRESTED NEAR KARKUR AFTER TEN MILES OF TELEPHONE LINE HAD BEEN CUT NEAR ASHOUD. ARABS HAVE DECIDED TO POST THEIR OWN QUARDS AT VEGETABLE MARKETS THROUGHOUT THE COUNTRY, IT WAS REPORTED. POLICE IN NABLUS DYNAMITED THE HOUSE OF A PROMINENT SHEIKH FOR HARBORING A WOUNDED BANDSMAN.

THE ARAB PRESS PUBL SHED AN INTERVIEW WITH IZZAT TANNOUS, ARAB LEADER WHO IS NOW IN LONDON, WHO WAS QUOTED AS DECLARING THAT BRITAIN'S PALESTINE PARTITION COMMISSION WOULD DROP THE PARTITION PLAN AND PROPOSE A NEW SOLUTION OF THE PALESTINE PROBLEM. MEANWHILE, RAGHEB BEY NASHASHIBI, LEADER OF THE ARAB DEFENSE PARTY, LEFT BY AIRPLANE FOR A STAY OF SEVERAL MONTHS IN EUROPE.

AKZIN, SCHWARTZMAN RESIGN N. Z.O. POSTS

LONDON, Aug. 29 (JTA) -- PROF. BENJAMIN AKZIN, HEAD OF THE POLITICAL DE-PARTMENT OF THE New ZIONIST ORGANIZATION, AND DR. M. SCHWARTZMAN, MEMBER OF THE ORGANIZATION'S PRESIDENCY, HAVE RESIGNED THEIR POSITIONS, BUTLARE RETAINING THEIR MEMBERSHIP IN THE ORGANIZATION. BOTH ADVOCATED RE-UNITING THE N.Z.O. WITH THE WORLD ZIONIST ORGANIZATION, FROM WHICH THE DISSIDENT GROUP SPLIT IN 1933.
