21 JEWS SLAIN IN TIBERIAS MASSACRE, WORST SINCE 129; SYNAGOGUE, HOMES RAZED

JERUSALEM, OCT. 3. (JTA) -- AN INVASION OF ANCIENT TIBERIAS ON THE SHORE OF THE GALILEE, IN WHICH AT LEAST 21 JEWS -- INCLUDING AN AMERICAN CITIZEN AND HIS WIFE -- WERE MASSACRED BY AN ARAB BAND WIELDING BOMB, RIFLE AND TORCH, SENT A WAVE OF INDIGNATION SURGING THROUGH JEWISH PALESTINE TODAY. THE MASSACRE WAS THE WORST SINCE THE HEBRON ONSLAUGHT IN 1929.

WHILE THE GOVERNMENT CLAMPED A 22-HOUR CURFEW ON THE TOWN AND SEARCHES OF RUINED HOUSES WENT AHEAD -- AN OFFICIAL COMMUNIQUE PREDICTING THAT MORE VICTIMS WOULD PROBABLY BE FOUND IN THE DEBRIS -- TROOPS PURSUED THE ARAB BAND AND WAS REPORTED TO HAVE CONTACTED IT AT LUSIA VILLAGE.

A GENERAL WORK STOPPAGE WAS STAGED BY CENTRAL JEWISH ORGANIZATIONS FROM TWO TO FOUR O'CLOCK THIS AFTERNOON DURING THE FUNCHAL SERVICES FOR THE SEVEN MEN, THREE WOMEN AND ELEVEN CHILDREN SLAIN IN LAST NIGHT'S TWO-HOUR ASSAULT, TERMED THE WORST ONSLAUGHT SINCE THE RIOTS OF 1929.

THE VICTIMS WERE MOURNED AS MARTYRS BY JEWISH LEADERS WHO WENT TO TIBERIAS FROM JERUSALEM FOR THE SERVICES. THOSE ATTENDING THE FUNCHAL INCLUDED MOSHE SHERTOK, OF THE JEWISH AGENCY, REPRESENTATIVES OF THE JEWISH NATIONAL COUNCIL, THE RELIGIOUS AGUDATH ISRAEL AND OTHER GROUPS.

"PALESTINE JEWRY IS DEEPLY HORRIFIED AT THE TIBERIAS MASSACRE AND SACRILEGE," DE-CLARED PALESTINE'S CHIEF RABBIS, DR. ISAAC HERZOG AND DR. JACOB MEIR, IN A CABLE TO COLON-IAL SECRETARY MALCOLM MACDONALD. "IN GOD'S NAME, WE APPEAL TO YOU TO END THE TERROR."

GHAFFIRS (SUPERNUMERARY POLICE) REPORTED HEARING THE BANDSMEN SPEAK ENGLISH DURING THE RAID. IT WAS OFFICIALLY ANNOUNCED THAT WHILE THE CASUALTIES TOTAL AMONG THE RAIDERS WAS NOT YET KNOWN, SIX BANDITS WERE KILLED BY JEWISH CONSTABLES WHO WERE RUSHING TO TIBERIAS FROM THE MIZPAH SETTLEMENT WHEN THEY MET ANOTHER BAND ALSO BOUND FOR TIBERIAS. THE CONSTABLES SEIZED ONE GERMAN AND FOUR ENGLISH RIFLES AND A QUANTITY OF AMMUNITION.

THE ATTACK WAS LAUNCHED AT NINE O'CLOCK LAST NIGHT, ACCORDING TO THE OFFICIAL ACCOUNT, WHEN AN ARMED BAND ENTERED TIBERIAS IN TWO PARTIES, FROM THE NORTH AND FROM THE

SOUTH. THEY CUT TELEPHONE LINES, THEN, AT A SIGNAL OF SHRILL WHISTLES FROM THE HILLS AROUND THE TOWN, BEGAN TO SHOOT, ATTACKING FIRST THE GOVERNMENT DISTRICT OFFICES AND POLICE BILLETS. THEY WRECKED THE DISTRICT OFFICES, THE CENTRAL SYNAGOGUE AND SIX HOUSES.

POLICE REINFORCEMENTS ARRIVED WITHIN 25 MINUTES FROM SAMAKH AFTER BEING HEAVILY FIRED UPON ON THE ROAD. GUMFIRE IN THE TOWN CONTINUED UNTIL ELEVEN O'CLOCK, WHEN POLICE, BRITISH TROOPS AND A DETACHMENT OF THE TRANSJORDAN FRONTIER FORCE DROVE OFF THE BAND, TAKING THE SITUATION IN HAND.

ACCORDING TO SUPPLEMENTARY UNOFFICIAL DETAILS, THE LOCAL POLICE FORCE WAS TAKEN BY SURPRISE AND WAS UNABLE TO PREVENT THE RAID. THE NEW JEWISH QUARTER OF KIRIAT SAMUEL BORE THE BRUNT OF THE ONSLAUGHT.

TWO OF THE JEWISH VICTIMS WERE NOT IMMEDIATELY FOUND. THE OTHERS WERE AS FOLLOWS:

JOSHUA BEN-ARIEH, HIS WIFE, SHOSHANAH, AND A SON, ARIEH, STABBED AND BURNED TO DEATH; ANOTHER SON, MOSHE, ONE-AND-A-HALF YEARS OLD, SHOT DEAD.

RIVKA LEIMER, 10, AND HER BROTHERS, CHAIM, 12, AND EZRA, 8, STABBED AND BURNED TO DEATH. BOTH FAMILIES WERE IN THE BEN-ARIEH HOUSE AT THE TIME OF THE ATTACK.

RACHEL MIZRACHI, 26, AND HER FIVE CHILDREN, EZRA, MIRIAM, YOCHEBED, SAMUEL AND HEPHZIBAH, AGED 12, 5, 3, 2 AND I, RESPECTIVELY, KILLED WHILE THE FATHER, SHIMON YOCHANAN MIZRACHI, WAS ON GUARD DUTY IN A DISTANT PART OF THE CITY.

MENACHEM KABNI, AN AMERICAN CITIZEN, AND HIS WIFE STABBED AND BURNED TO DEATH. HIS SISTER ESCAPED. WHAT PART OF THE UNITED STATES KABNI CAME FROM WAS NOT ASCERTAINED IMMEDIATELY.

EZEKIEL KATZ, 42, KILLED WHEN THE SYNAGOGUE WAS BURNED DOWN.

Two Jewish constables, Israel Bookman and ZVI Chatzkelevitz, Killed During the shooting, and also Jacob Gross.

THE WOUNDED ARE HANKA LEIMER, 37, IN SERIOUS CONDITION; RAHAMIN HALEVY AND HANNA SABACH, SLIGHTLY INJURED.

THE MASSACRE CLIMAXED A WEEKEND OF DISORDERS IN WHICH THREE JEWS WERE KILLED IN VAR-IOUS ATTACKS, 70 ARAB REBELS WERE SLAIN IN ENGAGEMENTS WITH TROOPS AND AN ARAB FAMILY OF SIX WAS WIPED OUT BY A LAND MINE EXPLOSION IN THE MANSHIEH QUARTER OF JAFFA.

A JEWISH RAILWAY WORKER, MEIR WORONSKI, 38, AN IMMIGRANT FROM POLAND, WAS SHOT AND KILLED BY SNIPERS IN HAIFA. LEO SÉIDNER, 35, A PUBLIC WORKS DEPARTMENT ENGINEER WAS SHOT DEAD WHILE RIDING IN HIS CAR ON THE NAZARETH-TIBERIAS ROAD. A JEWISH-OWNED TRUCK STRUCK A LAND MINE NEAR KFAR SYRKIN, FATALLY WOUNDING GITA GOLDENBERG, 26, AND INJURING ZEV POK-ROISKY, 26.

IT WAS ANNOUNCED OFFICIALLY THAT 27 ARABS WERE KILLED IN YESTERDAY'S ENGAGEMENT BETWEEN A REBEL BAND AND BRITISH TROOPS AT SHAFARAM. IN ANOTHER CLASH AT RAMALLAH, TROOPS AND WARPLANES KILLED 40 BANDSMEN. THREE ARAB REBELS WERE KILLED AND SIX WERE CAPTURED WHEN'S A THIRD BAND ATTACKED A DETACHMENT OF THE ROYAL SCOTS REGIMENT BETWEEN KALKILLIAH AND TULK-AREM.

FIVE JEWS, THREE OF THEM CONSTABLES, WERE WOUNDED IN CLASHES IN OTHER PARTS OF THE UND COUNTRY. A BAND AMBUSHED A GROUP OF JEWISH LABORERS ESCORTED BY CONSTABLES, NEAR BATH LLETS. SHLOMO, WOUNDING TWO OF THE CONSTABLES. CONSTABLE MOSHE MELNICK, 30, WAS SHOT AND SLIGHTLY INJURED WHILE MOTORCYCLING NEAR NESS ZIONA. ELIAHU GUTKIN, 15, WAS SHOT AND SERIOUSLY WOUNDED ON THE JAFFA-TEL AVIV BORDER. JOSEPH TRABLOFF, 35, AN ORIENTAL JEW, WAS SHOT AND SERIOUSLY WOUNDED WHILE WALKING IN JERUSALEM'S COMMERCIAL CENTER.

A MILITARY COURT TODAY SENTENCED ABRAHAM KOTIK, 25, A JEW, TO DEATH FOR CARRYING ARMS IN VIOLATION OF EMERGENCY REGULATIONS. KOTIK WAS SEIZED AT A ZIONIST-REVISIONISTS CLUB IN TEL AVIV ON AUG. 20 IN POSSESSION OF A SATCHEL CONTAINING THREE REVOLVERS, 400 ROUNDS OF AMMUNITION AND A STICK OF DYNAMITE. IF EXECUTED, HE WILL BE THE SECOND JEW TO DIE UNDER ARMY COURT SENTENCE.

FUNERAL PASSES RUINS OF BURNED SYNAGOGUE

TIBERIAS, OCT. 3. (JTA) -- THE DEATHLY STILLNESS OF CURFEW-BOUND TIBERIAS WAS PIERCED THIS AFTERNOON BY THE CHANTING OF EL MOLE! RACHAMIM, THE PRAYER FOR THE DEAD, AS THE FUNERAL PROCESSION PASSED BEFORE THE BURNED RUINS OF THE CENTRAL SYNAGOGUE, WHICH STILL COVERED THE BODY OF ITS BEADLE, JACOB SALTZ, AND THE HOLY SCROLLS. THE FUNERAL STARTED AT THREE O'CLOCK UNDER THE AUSPICES OF THE LOCAL CHEVRAH KADISHAH (BURIAL SOCIETY). ONLY A FEW OUTSIDERS WERE PRESENT, BECAUSE OF THE CURFEW.

BERENGER URGES REFUGEE TALKS WITH REICH ON STRENGTH OF MUNICH PACT

PARIS, Oct. 2. (JTA) -- Negotiations with the German Government to solve the refugee problem, aggravated by the exodus from Sudetenland, were asked today by Senator Henri His Berenger, French Vice-chairman of the Intergovernmental Refugee Committee, in a letter to Foreign Minister Georges Bonnet.

M. BERENGER, WHO IS HEAD OF THE SENATE FOREIGN AFFAIRS COMMITTEE, URGED THAT M. BONNET FOLLOW UP THE MUNICH FOUR-POWER AGREEMENT ON CZECHOSLOVAKIA BY INSTITUTING IMMEDIATE NEGOTIATIONS WITH THE REICH REGARDING JEWISH AND OTHER REFUGEES IN WHOM PRESIDENT ROOSEVELT WAS INTERESTED.

"The international tension, which is now fortunately over, imposed a long period of waiting upon the intergovernmental Committee and upon the hundreds of thousands of human beings to whom our meetings in Evian and London, due to President Roosevelt's generous initiative, intended to Bring indispensable ald," the letter said. "The refugees from Sudetenland are even widening this fieldwork of human solidarity.

"AS VICE-CHAIRMAN OF THE INTERGOVERNMENTAL COMMITTEE I HAVE APPROACHED DIRECTLY CHAIRMAN WINTERTON (OF BRITAIN) FOR IMMEDIATE RESUMPTION OF OUR ACTIVITIES. AT THE SAME TIME, HOWEVER, I HAVE THE HONOR TO INQUIRE OF YOU WHETHER YOU DO NOT CONSIDER IT OPPORTUNE TO DRAW THE ATTENTION OF THE STATES REPRESENTED IN THE INTERGOVERNMENTAL COMMITTEE TO THE URGENCY OF SUCH IMMEDIATE ACTION IN ACCORD WITH THE REICH GOVERNMENT IN THE ATMOSPHERE OF PEACE NOW CREATED BY THE MUNICH AGREEMENT FOR REGULATING THIS PAINFUL PROBLEM WHICH WE MUST SOLVE."

LONDON SEES ATMOSPHERE FAVORABLE TO PARLEY ON REFUGEES

LONDON, Oct. 3. (JTA) -- THE ALTERED INTERNATIONAL SITUATION WAS HAILED TODAY INTERCLES CONNECTED WITH THE INTERGOVERNMENTAL REFUGEE COMMITTEE AS CREATING AN ATMOSPHERE FAVORABLE TO NEGOTIATIONS WITH THE GERMAN GOVERNMENT ON THE REFUGEE SITUATION.

IT WAS UNDERSTOOD THAT THE RUBLEE BUREAU IS ALREADY COMMUNICATING WITH LEADING MEMBERS

IT WAS UNDERSTOOD THAT THE RUBLEE BUREAU IS ALREADY COMMUNICATING WITH LEADING MEMBERS OF THE COMMITTEE, STRESSING THE POSSIBILITIES OF ACTION FURNISHED BY THE NEW SITUATION. FOR THE PRESENT, THE COMMITTEE HAS NO MEETING SCHEDULED AND IT IS STILL TOO EARLY TO STATE WHEN GEORGE RUBLEE, AMERICAN DIRECTOR OF THE BUREAU, IS PROCEEDING TO BERLIN FOR DIRECT NEGOTIATIONS ON THE QUESTION OF PERMITTING EMIGRANTS TO TAKE WITH THEM A PORTION OF THEIR CAPITAL.

CIRCLES CONNECTED WITH REFUGEE WORK ENTHUSIASTICALLY GREETED THE LETTER BY SENATOR HENRI BERENGER TO FRENCH FOREIGN MINISTER GEORGES BONNET.

CANADIAN LEAGUE BODY TO FORM GROUP TO AID REFUGEES

OTTAWA, Oct. 3. (JTA) -- AID FOR THE VICTIMS OF "POLITICAL PERSECUTION AND UNPROVOKED AGGRESSION" WILL BE MADE A MAJOR FEATURE OF "NATIONAL PEACE ACTION WEEK," TO BE INAUGURATED IN CANADA ON NOV. 6 BY THE CANADIAN LEAGUE OF NATIONS SOCIETY, IT WAS ANNOUNCED HERE TODAY BY SENATOR CAIRINE WILSON, PRESIDENT. SENATOR WILSON IN A STATEMENT CONDEMNED THE "SPREAD OF NEW BARBARISM AS REPRESENTED BY GERMANY."

JEWISH AND OTHER CANADIAN LEADERS, SHE SAID, WILL BE INVITED BY THE SOCIETY TO SIT ON A NATIONAL COMMITTEE TO AID IN SOLUTION OF THE REFUGEE PROBLEM BY AROUSING CANADIAN PUBLIC OPINION AND REQUESTING IMMEDIATE GOVERNMENT ACTION. MYRON C. TAYLOR, AMERICAN VICE-CHAIRMAN OF THE INTERGOVERNMENTAL REFUGEE COMMITTEE, WILL BE INVITED TO CANADA DURING OBSERVANCE OF THE PEACE WEEK.

HULL QUERTED ON CZECH REFUGEES

WASHINGTON, Oct. 3. (JTA) -- ASKED TODAY WHETHER THE INTERGOVERNMENTAL REFUGEE
COMMITTEE WOULD UNDERTAKE TO HELP REFUGEES FROM THE CEDED SUDETEN AREAS OF CZECHOSLOVAKIA,
SECRETARY OF STATE CORDELL HULL REPLIED THAT THE SETTLEMENT OF REFUGEE PROBLEMS WAS ENTIRELY
UP TO THE COMMITTEE ITSELF. THE COMMITTEE, HE SAID, WILL PASS ON NEW CONDITIONS AS THEY
ARISE.

1,119 JEWS DENATIONALIZED BY REICH IN 3 MONTHS; 3,845 LOSE CITIZENSHIP SINCE '33

BERLIN, Oct. 3. (JTA) -- ESTABLISHING A NEW RECORD, THE REICH AUTHORITIES HAVE DEPRIVED OF CITIZENSHIP 1,119 JEWS IN THE THREE MONTHS ENDING SEPT. 30, IT WAS ANNOUNCED TODAY.

ALTOGETHER, 3,845 JEWS HAVE BEEN DENATIONALIZED SINCE THE ADVENT OF THE NAZI REGIME IN 1933. BETWEEN JANUARY, 1933, AND JANUARY, 1937, THE DENATIONALIZATIONS AVERAGED 50 A MONTH. FROM JANUARY TO JUNE, 1938, THE RATE JUMPED SHARPLY TO 250 MONTHLY, AND FROM JUNE TO SEPTEMBER, 1938, THE RATE INCREASED TO 375. THE BULK OF THOSE DENATIONALIZED ARE EMIGRES.

IT WAS REPORTED WITHOUT VERIFICATION HERE THAT THE BELGIAN GOVERNMENT IS DETERMINED TO DEPORT ALL JEWS WHO ENTERED THE COUNTRY ILLEGALLY AFTER AUG. 27. REFUGEES, IT WAS SAID, WILL BE SENT BACK ACROSS THE SAME BORDER THEY ENTERED. HITHERTO, THE BELGIAN POLICE HAVE BEEN GRANTING TEMPORARY RESIDENTIAL PERMITS TO ILLEGAL IMMIGRANTS WHO WERE REGISTERED WITH JEWISH WELFARE ORGANIZATIONS.

A FRESH SETBACK TO JEWISH EMIGRATION HOPES WAS REPORTED HERE FROM HAITI, WHICH IS SAID TO HAVE DECIDED TO REFUSE ENTRY TO JEWS PENDING WORKING OUT OF A NEW IMMIGRATION LAW. THE PRESIDENT OF HAITI HAS BEEN ASKED TO INTERVENE FOR SEVERAL AUSTRIAN JEWS WHO HAVE NOT BEEN PERMITTED TO ENTER DESPITE THE FACT THAT THEY HAVE THE NECESSARY VISAS.

IT WAS ANNOUNCED IN VIENNA THAT THE FAMOUS SCHOENBRUNN ACTORS SEMINARY, FOUNDED AND FORMERLY DIRECTED BY MAX REINHARDT, HAS NOW BEEN INCORPORATED INTO THE NAZI STATE ACADEMY OF MUSIC AND DRAMATIC ART. REINHARDT WAS OUSTED FROM CONTROL OF THE SCHOENBRUNN SCHOOL AND THE JOSESTAADT THEATRE IN THE FIRST DAYS AFTER ANSCHLUSS.

FRIEDMANN REMOVED TO BUCHENWALD CAMP; TO TESTIFY IN SCHUSCHNIGG TRIAL

BERLIN, Oct. 3. (JTA) -- DR. DESIDER FRIEDMANN, FORMER PRESIDENT OF THE VIENNA
JEWISH COMMUNITY WHO HAS BEEN UNDER ARREST SINCE MARCH 18, HAS BEEN TRANSFERRED TO THE
BUCHENWALD CONCENTRATION CAMP IN THURINGIA, IT WAS LEARNED TODAY, AND WILL BE HELD THERE AS
A WITNESS IN THE FORTHCOMING "TREASON" TRIAL OF DR. KURT SCHUSCHNIGG, PRE-ANSCHLUSS CHANCELLOR
OF AUSTRIA. DR. FRIEDMANN WAS ARRESTED SHORTLY AFTER ANSCHLUSS ON A CHARGE OF RAISING FUNDS
FOR THE SCHUSCHNIGG GOVERNMENT, WAS REMOVED TO THE DACHAU CONCENTRATION CAMP, RETURNED TO
VIENNA, RELEASED AND RE-ARRESTED ON UNDISCLOSED CHARGES A FEW DAYS LATER.

DANZIG BANS SERVICES AT 2 SYNAGOGUES

DANZIG, Oct. 3. (JTA) -- THE AUTHORITIES OF THIS NAZI-CONTROLLED FREE CITY TODAY PROHIBITED THE HOLDING OF SERVICES AT THE MATTERBUDEN AND THE OHEL ITZHAK SYNAGOGUES FOR "REASONS OF SECURITY." BOTH SYNAGOGUES HAVE BEEN THE TARGET OF DESTRUCTIVE RAIDS BY UNIFORMED BANDS OF HITLER YOUTHS.

HEBREW U. SPURNS ANNUAL \$2,000 GRANT BY ITALY, BUT WILL CONTINUE ITALIAN LITERATURE COURSE

JERUSALEM, OCT. 3. (JTA) -- THE HEBREW UNIVERSITY WILL NOT ACCEPT THIS YEAR THE ITALIAN GOVERNMENT'S ANNUAL \$2,000 GRANT IN VIEW OF ANTI-JEWISH LEGISLATION IN ITALY, PRESIDENT JUDAN L. MAGNES NOTIFIED THE ITALIAN CONSULATE TODAY.

THE DECISION WAS MADE BY THE UNIVERSITY'S BOARD OF GOVERNORS AT ITS RECENT LONDON MEETING, DR. MAGNES SAID. HE ADDED THAT TEACHING OF ITALIAN LITERATURE WOULD CONTINUE. THE GRANT HAD BEEN MADE BY ROME SINCE 1933 FOR THE UNIVERSITY'S DEPARTMENT OF ROMANCE LANGUAGE AND LITERATURE.

FISCHEL ENDS SO. AMERICAN TOUR

NEW YORK, OCT. 3. (JTA) -- DR. WALTER FISCHEL, OF THE ORIENTAL DEPARTMENT AT THE HEBREW UNIVERSITY IN JERUSALEM, ARRIVED HERE TODAY AFTER COMPLETING A SUCCESSFUL FIVE-MONTH TOUR OF SOUTH AMERICAN COUNTRIES ON BEHALF OF THE UNIVERSITY.

During his tour, Dr. Fischel said he organized committees to aid the Hebrew University in every country he visited. He also established contacts for the Jerusalem institution at a number of Leading universities, including those at Buenos Aires, Sao Paulo, Rio de Janeiro and others. He declared many non-Jewish Leaders in Political, economic and educational life attended receptions for him and cooperated in formation of the committees.

TAYLOR URGES HITLER TO EASE PERSECUTION; SEES EMIGRATION PLAN POSSIBLE

NEW YORK, Oct. 3. (JTA) -- Myron C. Taylor, American vice-chairman of the Intergovernmental Refugee Committee, tonight expressed hope that Hitler would ease the "extreme persecution" and relax the "increasing pressure" on emigrants, and voiced confidence that means could be found, acceptable to Germany and Nations of Refuge, to save a portion of emigrants' wealth. MR. TAYLOR, WHO RECENTLY RETURNED FROM EUROPE, WHERE HE PLAYED THE LEADING ROLE IN ORGANIZING THE REFUGEE COMMITTEE, ADDRESSED A DINNER IN HIS HONOR AT THE RITZ-CARLTON HOTEL GIVEN BY THE COUNCIL ON FOREIGN RELATIONS. IT WAS STATED THAT THIS WAS THE ONLY ADDRESS MR. TAYLOR WOULD MAKE ON THE REFUGEE QUESTION AT THIS TIME.

"THE PRESENT SITUATION HAS BROUGHT DEATH TO HUNDREDS, DISASTER TO HUNDREDS AND FEAR TO MILLIONS," MR. TAYLOR SAID. "IT HAS FANNED THE FLAMES OF HATRED AND ADDED NEW FEARS AND PREJUDICES TO A WORLD ALREADY BURDENED WITH GIGANTIC UNEMPLOYMENT PROBLEMS, ECONOMIC UNCERTAINTY, AND DISTRESS."

"TO ANYONE WHO HAS COME INTO CONTACT AT FIRST HAND WITH THIS TRAGIC EXODUS, THERE CAN BE NO APATHY OR PREJUDICE, ONLY A DEEP FEELING OF COMPASSION AND THE REALIZATION THAT WE ARE WITNESSING ONE OF THE MOST TRAGIC HAPPENINGS OF MODERN TIMES; A TRAGEDY, MOREOVER, WHICH IS FOR THE MOST PART ENTIRELY UNNECESSARY AND AVOIDABLE." HE CONTINUED.

HE STATED THAT THE PROBLEM INVOLVED THE QUESTION OF PLACEMENT AND PREPARATION OF EMIGRANTS, PARTICULARLY YOUTHS, FOR NEW LIFE IN NEW LANDS.

"Despite the difficulties involved, I am confident means can be found which will be acceptable both to the German Governments and the Governments of refuge whereby a considerable portion of this wealth (the refugees') can be saved for emigrants to enable them to find, reach and establish themselves in New Homes," Mr. Taylor declared.

PLIGHT OF SUDETEN JEWS NOTED BY EDEN IN COMMONS

LONDON, Oct. 3. (JTA) -- THE SITUATION OF JEWS IN THE SUDETENLAND WAS RAISED IN THE HOUSE OF COMMONS TODAY BY FORMER FOREIGN SECRETARY ANTHONY EDEN, WHO DECLARED THAT ALTHOUGH GERMAN JEWS AND SOCIALISTS WERE NOT COMPELLED TO LEAVE BEFORE THE EXPIRATION OF THE TEN-DAY LIMIT, IF HE WERE ONE, HE WOULD MAKE THE ASSURANCE DOUBLY SURE BY LEAVING IMMEDIATELY.

"FRESH MISERIES" FOR JEWS SEEN

NEW YORK, Oct. 3. (JTA) -- THE New York Herald Tribune Declared Today, in an editorial on the prospects for the future following the Munich agreement: "Undoubtedly the New World will mean fresh miseries for the Harried Jews and for the Many New Minorities which are created with the excision of the old ones." The editorial added that it might encourage the spread of dictatorship to France.

LABOR COMMITTEE SENDS FUNDS

NEW YORK, Oct. 3. (JTA) -- THE JEWISH LABOR COMMITTEE ANNOUNCED TODAY THAT IT HAD CABLED A "SUBSTANTIAL SUM" FOR THE RELIEF OF SOCIALISTS AND LABOR LEADERS IN SUDETENLAND, ADDING THAT IT WAS SEEKING TO RAISE ADDITIONAL FUNDS.

ITALIAN JEWS ENCOUNTER DIFFICULTIES IN TURKEY

ISTANBLE, OCT. 3. (JTA) -- HUNDREDS OF JEWS OF ITALIAN CITIZENSHIP RESIDING IN TURKEY ARE FINDING THEMSELVES IN AN AWKWARD LEGAL POSITION BECAUSE OF THE INSISTENCE OF THE POLICE AUTHORITIES THAT THEY PRESENT CERTIFICATES FROM THE ITALIAN CONSULATE ESTABLISHING THAT THEIR CITIZENSHIP WAS OBTAINED BEFORE 1919 IN ORDER TO SECURE RENEWAL OF RESIDENTIAL PERMITS. MANY JEWS, UNABLE TO OBTAIN SUCH CERTIFICATES, ARE AWAITING A DEFINITE RULING FROM THE ITALIAN GOVERNMENT ON THEIR NATIONALITY STATUS. THE ITALIAN CONSULATE SO FAR HAS TAKEN NO ACTION WITH REGARD TO JEWS AUTOMATICALLY DEPRIVED OF THEIR CITIZENSHIP BY THE SEPTEMBER DECREE.

TEACHERS HIT ROME ANTI-SEMITISM

LONDON, OCT. 3. (JTA) -- A RESOLUTION CONDEMNING DISMISSAL OF JEWS FROM ITALY'S EDUCATIONAL SYSTEM HAS BEEN PLACED ON THE AGENDA OF THE NOVEMBER CONFERENCE OF THE LONDON TEACHERS' ASSOCIATION, IT WAS ANNOUNCED TODAY BY THE ORGANIZATION'S GENERAL COMMITTEE.

"THE RESOLUTION CONDEMNS THE "DEPARTURE FROM THE COSMOPOLITAN OUTLOOK ON LEARNING AND CULTURE WHICH IN THE PAST HAS ALWAYS BEEN ASSOCIATED WITH THIS ANCIENT CENTER OF CIVILIZATION" AND EXPRESSES SYMPATHY WITH JEWISH COLLEAGUES "UNJUSTLY AND PEREMPTORILY DISMISSED FROM STATE SCHOOLS" IN ITALY.

GERMAN DAY CELEBRATION HIT BY SPLIT OVER NAZISM

NEW YORK, Oct. 3. (JTA) -- LAST-MINUTE BOLTS BY PARTICIPATING GROUPS AND THE FAILURE OF GERMAN OFFICIAL REPRESENTATIVES TO SEND GREETINGS HIT THE GERMAN DAY CELEBRATION OF THE UNITED GERMAN SOCIETIES AT THE MADISON SQUARE GARDEN LAST NIGHT, IN WHICH THE PRO-NAZI GERMAN-AMERICAN BUND HAD BEEN REFUSED PARTICIPATION, AND EMPHASIZED THE GROWING SPLIT AMONG GERMANS IN THE UNITED STATES ON THE QUESTION OF NAZISM.

THE GERMAN-AMERICAN COMMERCIAL LEAGUE BACKED OUT OF THE CELEBRATION, IN WHICH IT HAD AGREED TO TAKE A LEADING PART, TOGETHER WITH 150 PERSONS WHO WERE TO HAVE ACTED HISTORICAL TABLEAUX. OTHER PARTICIPANTS FOLLOWED SUIT. SPEAKERS AT THE CELEBRATION DEMOUNCED THESE ACTIONS, THEODORE HOFFMAN, PRESIDENT OF THE STEUBEN SOCIETY, WARNING THAT FOREIGN POLITICS ON OUR SHORES "CAN HAVE NO OTHER RESULT THAN TO CREATE A FEELING OF HOSTILITY AGAINST THOSE WHO EXHIBIT IT AND THE COUNTRY WHICH THEY CLAIM TO REPRESENT."

No representative of the German Government appeared at the rally, and not even the usual message was sent. However, it was decided to send greetings to Berlin, expressing satisfaction with the position of Germany under Hitler and with the acquisition of Austria and Superem and.

DIES SEEKS FUNDS TO PROBE NAZI FINANCING

WASHINGTON, OCT. 3. (JTA) -- CHAIRMAN MARTIN DIES OF THE HOUSE COMMITTEE INVESTIGATING UN-AMERICAN ACTIVITIES DECLARED TODAY THAT HIS COMMITTEE NEEDED AT LEAST \$150,000 AND TWO YEARS' TIME TO INVESTIGATE FINANCING OF NAZI AND FASCIST ACTIVITIES BY "CERTAIN HIGH INDUSTRIALISTS."

THE ASSERTION WAS MADE IN REPLY TO A LETTER FROM CHARLES R. HOOK, PRESIDENT OF THE NATIONAL ASSOCIATION OF MANUFACTURERS, WHO SAID THE CHARGE THAT INDUSTRIALISTS WERE FINANCING NAZIS WITHOUT MENTION OF NAMES "MUST INEVITABLY BE A REFLECTION ON ALL INDUSTRIALISTS."

CARDOZO EULOGIZED AS SUPREME COURT OPENS SESSION

WASHINGTON, Oct. 3. (JTA) -- CHIEF JUSTICE CHARLES EVANS HUGHES OPENED THE SUPREME COURT SESSION TODAY BY DECLARING THAT THE COURT HAD SUFFERED AN IRREPARABLE LOSS IN THE DEATH OF BENJAMIN N. CARDOZO, AND REFERRING TO HIS CAREER AS "ONE OF THE MOST ILLUSTRIOUS IN JUDICIAL ANNALS."
