REVOLT GOES ON UNLESS ARAB DEMANDS ARE GRANTED, CAIRO CONGRESS WARIS BRITAIN

CAIRO, Oct. 11. (JTA) -- NULLIFICATION OF THE BALFOUR DECLARATION, STOPPAGE OF JEWISH IMMIGRATION AND CREATION OF A CONSTITUTIONAL ARAB GOVERNMENT WERE AMONG EIGHT DEMANDS MADE OF GREAT BRITAIN TODAY AT THE CONCLUDING SESSION OF THE FIVE-DAY PAN-ARAB CONGRESS ON PALESTINE, ATTENDED HERE BY 2,500 DELEGATES FROM TEN COUNTRIES.

THE CONGRESS WARNED THAT UNLESS THE DEMANDS WERE MET, THE PALESTINE REVOLT WOULD CONTINUE AND BOTH BRITONS AND JEWS WOULD BE CONSIDERED AND TREATED AS ENEMIES. THE RESOLUTIONS, MOVED BY MOHAMMED ALI ALLOUBA, FORMER EGYPTIAN EDUCATION MINISTER AND PRESIDENT OF THE PARLIAMENTARY COMMITTEE ON PALESTINE, WHICH SPONSORED THE CONGRESS, WERE:

(1) NULLIFICATION OF THE BALFOUR DECLARATION; (2) STOPPAGE OF JEWISH IMMIGRATION; (3) NO PARTITION OF PALESTINE; (4) A CONSTITUTIONAL ARAB GOVERNMENT ALLIED TO BRITAIN BY A TREATY SIMILAR TO THE ANGLO-IRAQ PACT; (5) RELEASE OF DEPORTEES AND INTERNEES; (6) APPLICATION OF THESE RESOLUTIONS THE ONLY WAY TO END THE PALESTINE REVOLT, OTHERWISE THE ENGLISH AND THE JEWS TO BE CONSIDERED AND TREATED AS ENEMIES; (7) THE ARAB GOVERNMENTS TO NOTIFY THE BRITISH GOVERNMENT AND THE LEAGUE OF NATIONS OF THESE DECISIONS; (8) A PERMANENT COMMITTEE TO BE FORMED TO CARRY OUT THE DECISIONS.

KING FAROUK INVITED THE DELEGATES TO VISIT HIM AT HIS PALACE THURSDAY AND ORDERED A SPECIAL TRAIN TO TAKE THEM TO ALEXANDRIA.

CHAMBERLAIN PROMISES "JUST SOLUTION"

DAMASCUS, Oct. 11. (Havas) -- A PROMISE THAT THE PALESTINE PROBLEM WOULD CONTINUE TO OCCUPY "THE FULL ATTENTION" OF THE BRITISH GOVERNMENT IN THE SEARCH FOR A JUST SOLUTION WAS CONTAINED IN A MESSAGE FROM PRIME MINISTER NEVILLE CHAMBERLAIN TO HASHEM BEK EL ATTASSY, PRESIDENT OF SYRIA, IT WAS LEARNED TODAY.

THE SYRIAN PRESIDENT HAD SENT THE PRIME MINISTER A PERSONAL MESSAGE APPEALING FOR HIS INTERVENTION TO RELIEVE "THE MORAL AND MATERIAL SUFFERINGS" OF THE ARABS IN PALESTINE.

HIS MESSAGE TO CHAMBERLAIN WAS AS FOLLOWS: "AT A TIME WHEN YOUR NAME IS TAKING ITS DEFINITIVE PLACE IN THE ANNALS OF HUMANITY, SYRIA JOINS WITH ALL NATIONS WHICH LOOK

UPON YOU WITH ADMIRATION AND GRATITUDE FOR THE GREAT SERVICES YOU HAVE RENDERED TO PEACE. THESE GRAVE AND HISTORIC HOURS ENABLE ME TO ADDRESS A SUPREME APPEAL TO A GREAT STATESMAN, TO A NOBLE HEART, TO PUT AN END TO THE MORAL AND MATERIAL SUFFERINGS OF THE ARAB, CHRISTIAN, AND NON-MOSLEM POPULATION OF PALESTINE AND TO ASSURE PEACE AND TRANQUILITY IN JUSTICE TO THE HOLY LAND NOW TORN BY BLOODY EVENTS."

CHAMBERLAIN'S REPLY READ AS FOLLOWS: "I THANK YOU SINCERELY FOR YOUR MESSAGE AND YOUR GENEROUS APPRECIATION OF MY EFFORTS FOR PEACE. I CAN ASSURE YOU THAT THE QUESTION OF PALESTINE OCCUPIES THE FULL ATTENTION OF HIS MAJESTY'S GOVERNMENT, WHICH ARE SPARING NO EFFORT TO ARRIVE AT A JUST SOLUTION OF THE PROBLEM OF THAT COUNTRY."

REICH PAPERS HAIL 'ARAB REVOLUTION'

BERLIN, Oct. 11. (HAVAS) -- FOLLOWING THE COURSE CHARTED BY CHANCELLOR HITLER'S SAARBUECKEN SPEECH, THE REICH PRESS TURNED AVID ATTENTION TONIGHT TO PALESTINE, REPORTING THE DISORDERS THERE UNDER SUCH SENSATIONAL HEADLINES AS "ENGLAND COMPLETELY OVERWHELMED!" AND "ARAB REVOLUTION!"

D.N.B., OFFICIAL REICH NEWS AGENCY, REPORTED IN A DISPATCH FROM CAIRO THAT A NATIONAL ARAB GOVERNMENT HAD BEEN ESTABLISHED IN THE HOLY LAND. WITH A "FREE CORPS" OF 15,000 AT THEIR DISPOSAL, THE UNDERGROUND GOVERNMENT WAS CREDITED WITH ALREADY HAVING BROUGHT THREE-FOURTHS OF THE COUNTRY UNDER ITS SWAY.

SPECIAL ATTENTION WAS GIVEN BY THE NEWSPAPERS TO THE PAN-ARAB CONGRESS AT CAIRO. THE VOELKISCHER BEOBACHTER AND KOELNISCHE ZEITUNG INTERPRETED THE ANTI-ZIONIST AND ANTI-SEMITIC ATMOSPHERE THERE AS A CONCRETE CRYSTALLIZATION OF PAN-ARABISM.

DISORDERS GO ON IN PALESTINE

JERUSALEM, Oct. 11. (JTA) -- BRITISH FORCES TONIGHT PRESSED PUNITIVE MEASURES AGAINST ARABS AFTER THE ATTEMPTED ASSASSINATION OF A HIGH GOVERNMENT OFFICIAL HAD CLIMAXED A DAY OF DISORDERS IN WHICH TWO ARABS WERE KILLED AND FOUR WOUNDED, AND SEVEN JEWS WERE INJURED.

FOUR BOMBS WERE HURLED FROM THE CITY WALLS AS EDWARD KEITH-ROACH, DISTRICT COMMISSIONER FOR THE JERUSALEM AREA, WAS MOTORING NEAR THE ROCKEFELLER ARCHAEOLOGICAL MUSEUM ALONGSIDE THE OLD CITY WALL, ACCOMPANIED BY TWO MILITARY CARS AND A POLICE VEHICLE. TWO OF THE BOMBS EXPLODED, BUT DID NO DAMAGE.

BRITISH TROOPS FIRED INTO AN ARAB MOB ON THE STREETS OF NABLUS, KILLING TWO AND WOUNDING FOUR, WHEN THE CROWD ATTACKED WITH PISTOLS, STONES AND OTHER WEAPONS, ENRAGED AT THE ACTION OF THE SOLDIERS IN DRAFTING PASSERS-BY TO REMOVE BARRICADES.

TROOPS DESTROYED 25 HOUSES IN MAJDAL AND 21 IN LYDDA IN PUNISHMENT FOR ATTACKS ON TROOPS. SOLDIERS DYNAMITING FOUR HOUSES IN NABLUS WERE HEAVILY FIRED UPON, PROMPTING THE GOVERNMENT TO IMPOSE CURFEW FROM 3:30 P.M. AMIN NUEIMAR, ASSISTANT MANAGER OF BARCLAYS BANK AT NAZARETH, WAS SHOT AND SLIGHTLY INJURED.

FOUR JEWISH CONSTABLES AND A COLONIST WERE WOUNDED LAST NIGHT WHEN THE NESS ZIONA SETTLEMENT WAS TWICE ATTACKED. ANOTHER JEW, ISSACHAR GOLDSTEIN, 29, WAS SHOT AND SERIOUSLY WOUNDED NEAR JERUSALEM'S MEAH SHEARIM QUARTER. A 17-YEAR-OLD IRAQI JEW, EZRA SALACH, WAS SERIOUSLY WOUNDED WHEN SHOT BY SNIPERS NEAR THE OLD POST-OFFICE ON JERUSALEM'S JAFFA ROAD.

BRITISH PRESS STRESSES GRAVITY OF SITUATION

LONDON, Oct. 11. (JTA) -- IN EDITORIALS AND DISPATCHES FROM JERUSALEM, BRITISH NEWSPAPERS TODAY STRESSED THE GRAVITY OF THE SECURITY SITUATION IN PALESTINE AND THE TREMENDOUS LOSS OF PRESTIGE SUFFERED BY GREAT BRITAIN THROUGH ITS FAILURE TO MAINTAIN ORDER. THE GENERAL TENOR OF THE EDITORIALS WAS THAT UNTIL ORDER WAS RESTORED THERE COULD BE NO QUESTION OF IMPLEMENTING ANY PLAN LOOKING TOWARD A PERMANENT SOLUTION OF THE ARAB-JEWISH CONFLICT.

DESCRIBING THE SIZE OF THE BRITISH EXPEDITIONARY FORCE, THE DAILY TELEGRAPH DECLARED IT SEEMED "ASTONISHING" THAT ALTHOUGH THE ARAB INSURRECTION HAD ASSUMED CONSIDERABLE PROPORTIONS IN JULY IT WAS NOT UNTIL SEPTEMBER THAT THERE WAS A SUBSTANTIAL INFUX OF REINFORCEMENTS. THE NEWS-CHRONICLE ASSERTED THAT THE GOVERNMENT HAD HAD AMPLE WARNING FOR MANY YEARS THAT THE "PALESTINE POT ONE DAY WOULD BOIL OVER," ADDING THAT "ITS DILATORY HANDLING OF THE MATTER CONTRIBUTED IN NO SMALL DEGREE TO THE PRESENT CRISIS."

SEE JEWS USING GANDHI METHODS AGAINST BRITAIN

NEW YORK, Oct. 11. (JTA) -- THE POSSIBILITY THAT JEWS MIGHT USE THE METHODS EMPLOYED BY MOHANDAS K. GANDHI IN INDIA IF GREAT BRITAIN RESTRICTS JEWISH ACTIVITIES IN PALESTINE HAS BEEN VOICED BY OFFICIALS OF THE JEWISH AGENCY, THE ASSOCIATED PRESS REPORTED TODAY FROM JERUSALEM.

THE DISPATCH SAID AGENCY OFFICIALS, DECLARING WORLD JEWRY WOULD NEVER ACCEPT THE REPORTED PLAN, ASSERTED JEWS WOULD NEVER RESORT TO ARMED FORCE AGAINST THE BRITISH, BUT MIGHT ADOPT NON-VIOLENT METHODS SIMILAR TO THOSE EMPLOYED BY GANDHI, INCLUDING CIVIL DISOBEDIENCE, PASSIVE RESISTANCE AND POSSIBLE BOYCOTT OF THE BRITISH GOVERNMENT.

THE HERALD TRIBUNE'S LONDON CORRESPONDENT, JOSEPH DRISCOLL, SAID THAT "IT WAS TAKEN FOR GRANTED THAT THE BRITISH GOVERNMENT WOULD ABANDON THE PEEL COMMISSION'S PLAN FOR THE PARTITION OF PALESTINE." HE DECLARED IT WAS THOUGHT THAT A NEW SCHEME WOULD BE PROPOSED TO UNIFY PALESTINE UNDER BRITISH CONTROL, WITH CONSIDERABLE LOCAL AUTONOMY AND HOME RULE ALLOWED TO ARABS AND JEWS IN THEIR OWN TOWNS AND VILLAGES.

U.S. CHRISTIANS JOIN PROTEST MOVE

NEW YORK, Oct. 11. (JTA) -- CHRISTIAN LEADERS RALLIED TODAY TO SAVE THE PALESTINE JEWISH HOMELAND, ONE GROUP SENDING A CABLED APPEAL TO PRIME MINISTER NEVILLE CHAMBERLAIN THAT BRITAIN NOT ABANDON HER PLEDGES TO THE JEWS WHILE ANOTHER GROUP CALLED ON CHRISTIANS OF THE NATION TO SEEK UNITED STATES INTERCESSION WITH BRITAIN.

THE CABLE TO MR. CHAMBERLAIN WAS MADE PUBLIC BY THE NEWLY-FORMED PROVISIONAL COMMITTEE ON PALESTINE POLICY. IT DECLARED THAT ABANDONMENT OF THE PLEDGES TO THE JEWS "WOULD BE REGARDED BY THE ENTIRE WORLD AS A SURRENDER TO THE FORCES OF VIOLENCE AND HATRED NOW SWEEPING THE WORLD; IT WOULD BE A BLOW TO CHRISTIAN HONOR AND A MOST DAMAGING BLOW TO THE PRESTIGE OF GREAT BRITAIN WHICH HOLDS THIS HONOR IN HER KEEPING." IT WAS SIGNED BY 36 CHRISTIAN LAY AND CLERICAL LEADERS.

SEVERAL GOVERNORS AND SENATORS AND A LARGE NUMBER OF CLERGYMEN AND EDUCATORS SIGNED AN APPEAL, SPONSORED BY THE PRO-PALESTINE FEDERATION OF AMERICA, CALLING ON CHRISTIANS OF ALL DENOMINATIONS TO REQUEST THE UNITED STATES GOVERNMENT TO USE ITS GOOD OFFICES WITH BRITAIN TO REMOVE RESTRICTIONS ON JEWISH IMMIGRATION.

SENATOR WILLIAM H. SMATHERS OF NEW JERSEY TELEGRAPHED PRESIDENT ROOSEVELT AND SECRETARY OF STATE HULL FROM ATLANTIC CITY, CALLING UPON THE GOVERNMENT TO INSIST UPON "COMPLETE FULFILLMENT OF THE PALESTINE MANDATE IN VIEW OF THE PLIGHT OF GREAT MASSES OF JEWISH REFUGEES FROM MANY LANDS."

IN A STATEMENT YESTERDAY, REPRESENTATIVE EMANUEL CELLER OF NEW YORK URGED THE PRESIDENT TO INFORM PRIME MINISTER NEVILLE CHAMBERLAIN THAT THE UNITED STATES "VIEWS WITH GREAT CONCERN AND ALARM A DEPARTURE BY GREAT BRITAIN FROM ITS OBLIGATIONS" UNDER THE BALFOUR DECLARATION.

NAZIS WOULD FORCE ANTISEMITIC POLICY ON CZECHOSLOVAKIA

NEW YORK, Oct. 11. (JTA) -- NEW GERMAN DEMANDS UPON CZECHOSLOVAKIA WITH A HINT OF FURTHER MILITARY ENCROACHMENT UNLESS SATISFIED WERE REPORTED BY THE ASSOCIATED PRESS FROM PRAHA TODAY TO INCLUDE ADOPTION BY THE CZECH GOVERNMENT OF AN ANTI-SEMITIC POLICY SUFFICIENT TO PREVENT ANTI-NAZI ACTIVITIES BY JEWS IN CZECHOSLOVAKIA.

A NEW YORK TIMES CORRESPONDENT REPORTED FROM PRAHA TODAY THAT THE CZECH TOWN OF POLICKA, WHICH HAS BEEN OCCUPIED BY THE GERMAN TROOPS, NUMBERS ONLY TEN GERMANS, ALL OF THEM JEWS, AMONG ITS ENTIRE POPULATION OF 7,000.

AMERICAN AMBASSADOR JOSEPH P. KENNEDY HAS CABLED AN APPEAL TO PRESIDENT ROOSEVELT FROM LONDON IN BEHALF OF SUDETEN GERMAN REFUGEES, AND COLONIAL SECRETARY MALCOLM MACDONALD HAS CABLED TO VARIOUS DOMINIONS URGING THEM TO RECEIVE REFUGEES, TIMES CORRESPONDENT G.E.R. GEDYE REPORTED FROM PRAHA. THE ACTIONS WERE TAKEN AFTER WENZEL JAKSCH, LEADER OF THE DEMOCRATIC GERMANS IN CZECHOSLOVAKIA, HAD INTERVIEWED THEM, AMONG OTHER LEADERS IN BRITAIN AND ELSEWHERE.

KONRAD HENLEIN, GERMAN COMMISSIONER FOR SUDETENLAND, DECLARED IN A BROADCAST THAT HIS POLITICAL OPPONENTS WOULD GET NO MERCY. "WE SHALL IMPRISON THEM UNTIL THEY TURN BLACK," HE SAID. REFUGEES RETURNED TO SUDETENLAND AGAINST THEIR WILL BY THE CZECHS THUS FAR ARE BELIEVED TO NUMBER ABOUT 20,000, MR. GEDYE SAID.

BRITAIN QUERIES BERLIN ON EMIGRATION

LONDON, Oct. 11. (JTA) -- BRITAIN TONIGHT BEGAN SOUNDING THE GERMAN GOVERNMENT ON POSSIBLE LOOSENING OF RESTRICTIONS WHICH NOW PREVENT JEWS AND OTHERS FROM QUITTING THE REICH WITH ADEQUATE FUNDS. SIR NEVILLE HENDERSON, BRITISH AMBASSADOR TO BERLIN, WAS INSTRUCTED TO DETERMINE WHETHER THE REICH AUTHORITIES WOULD AID EMIGRATION BY ALLOWING THE REFUGEES TO DEPART WITH SUFFICIENT MEANS FOR SELF-SUPPORT IN COUNTRIES RECEIVING THEM.

ICKES DENIES PRESENCE OF JEWS IN PUBLIC LIFE FOSTERS BIAS; CITES CARDOZO RECORD

ST. LOUIS, Oct. 11. (JTA) -- SECRETARY OF INTERIOR HAROLD L. ICKES TOLD A MEMORIAL MEETING OF THE TEMPLE ISRAEL BROTHERHOOD LAST NIGHT THAT THE LATE BENJAMIN N. CARDOZO'S YEARS ON THE SUPREME COURT BENCH REFUTED THE CONTENTION THAT THE PRESENCE OF JEWS IN PUBLIC LIFE FOSTERS ANTI-SEMITISM.

"NOT A SINGLE GOSSAMER IN TODAY'S WEB OF ANTI-SEMITISM CAN BE TRACED TO HIS PRESENCE ON THE BENCH," MR. ICKES SAID. "RESPECTED, ADMIRING AND BELOVED BY ALL, HIS ACTIONS ANSWERED THOSE WHO PREACH THAT THE PRESENCE OF JEWS IN PUBLIC LIFE AIDS THE CAUSE OF ANTI-SEMITISM."

HE DID HIS PART TO PROVE THAT CARDOZOS AND BRANDEISES WILL ALWAYS SUPPORT THE CAUSE OF RIGHTEOUSNESS; WILL ALWAYS APPROACH THE PROBLEMS OF HUMANITY WITH UNDERSTANDING AND SYMPATHY."

THE SECRETARY OF INTERIOR ALSO ASSERTED THAT JEWS "ARE IN THE FOREFRONT OF THE FIGHT FOR PROGRESS AND CIVIL LIBERTIES," BUT DENIED THAT THEY WERE RADICALS IN THE SENSE THAT THEY WERE "VISIONARY UTOPIANS" OR SOUGHT TO OVERTHROW THE GOVERNMENT BY FORCE. HE SPOKE ON A PROGRAM WITH KENNETH TEASDALE, FORMER PRESIDENT OF THE MISSOURI BAR ASSOCIATION; JOSEPH A. McLAIN JR., DEAN OF WASHINGTON UNIVERSITY LAW SCHOOL, AND CHARLES G. ROSS, AN EDITOR OF THE ST. LOUIS POST-DISPATCH.

RECALLING THE OPPOSITION TO THE APPOINTMENT OF CARDOZO TO THE SUPREME COURT BECAUSE HE WAS A JEW, MR. ICKES SAID: "THERE ARE THOSE WHO ALWAYS OPPOSE THE APPOINTMENT OF A JEW TO ANYTHING; PERSONS, WHO, FOR ONE REASON OR ANOTHER, WEAR THEIR UNSAVORY PREJUDICES ON THEIR SLEEVES FOR ALL TO SEE, I WILL SAY NO MORE ON THIS THAN THAT I DETEST SUCH BIGOTRY."

THOSE WHO OPPOSED THE APPOINTMENT ON THE GROUND A SECOND JEWISH SUPREME COURT JUSTICE WOULD CREATE FURTHER ANTI-SEMITISM "SEEMED TO FORGET," HE DECLARED, "THAT THE COWARD WHO RUNS AWAY FROM HIS MORTAL ENEMY JUSTLY FORFEITS THE GUERDON OF THE BRAVE. THEY PROPOSED, IN EFFECT, A SELF-MADE GHETTO AND SOUGHT THE EAR OF PRESIDENT HOOVER TO GAIN PRESIDENTIAL SANCTION FOR THAT GHETTO. THESE JEWS WERE NO LESS BLIND IN THEIR OPPOSITION TO PROGRESS THAN WERE THE RICH JEWS IN DEMOCRATIC COUNTRIES IN EUROPE WHEN FASCISM STARTED IN MARCH TO POWER."

PRAHA JEWISH EDITOR DIES AFTER SUICIDE PACT WITH WIFE

PRAHA, Oct. 11. (JTA) -- DR. RUDOLF THOMAS, JEWISH EDITOR-IN-CHIEF OF THE PRAGER TAGBLATT WHO TOOK AN OVERDOSE OF SLEEPING POTION IN A SUICIDE PACT WITH HIS WIFE ON MONDAY, DIED TODAY. HIS WIFE WAS SINKING FAST.

DR. THOMAS SAID IN PARTING MESSAGES TO FRIENDS AND RELATIVES THAT HE AND HIS WIFE HAD DECIDED TO COMMIT SUICIDE IN DESPAIR OVER THE FATE WHICH HAS BEFALLEN GERMAN DEMOCRATS IN CZECHOSLOVAKIA FOLLOWING THE OCCUPATION OF SUDETENLAND. DR. THOMAS HAD BEEN WORKING FOR THE PRAGER TAGBLATT, ORGAN OF GERMAN DEMOCRATS, SINCE THE AGE OF 18.

POLISH ANTI-SEMITES ATTACK JEWS

WARSAW, Oct. 11. (JTA) -- ANTI-SEMITES YESTERDAY ATTACKED JEWS DURING MORNING PRAYERS IN WYSOKIE, IN THE LUBLIN DISTRICT. THEY BROKE WINDOWS AND DEMOLISHED SUCCOTH (BOOTHES BUILT IN CONNECTION WITH THE SUCCOTH FESTIVAL). THE DISTRICT GOVERNOR ARRIVED TO DIRECT POLICE IN RESTORING ORDER.

ELEVEN PERSONS WERE ARRESTED BY THE POLICE OF WILNO AND THE TOWNSHIP OF RYBNIK FOR ANTI-SEMITIC EXCESSES. SIX OF THEM WERE COMMITTED TO THE GOVERNMENT CONCENTRATION CAMP AT KARTUZ-BEREZA FOR ATTACKING JEWS ON THE STREETS OF WILNO. THE OTHERS WERE HELD FOR A BOMB ATTACK ON A RYBNIK SYNAGOGUE.

THREE JEWISH FAMILIES WERE EXPELLED FROM THE FRONTIER DISTRICT OF MIKOLOW AFTER BEING GIVEN TWO HOURS TO LIQUIDATE THEIR BUSINESS. TEN JEWISH FAMILIES WERE EXPELLED FROM THE FRONTIER DISTRICT OF PSZICZYNA.
