WOODHEAD REPORT IN GOVERNMENT'S HANDS, COMMONS TOLD; POLICY STATEMENT TO BE ISSUED AFTER NOV. 8

LONDON, Nov. 1. (JTA) -- THE LONG-AWAITED PALESTINE PARTITION COMMISSION'S REPORT HAS BEEN RECEIVED BY THE GOVERNMENT AND IS BEING CAREFULLY CONSIDERED, THE HOUSE OF COMMONS WAS INFORMED TODAY BY COLONIAL SECRETARY MALCOLM MACDONALD. HE SAID THE WOODHEAD REPORT WOULD BE PUBLISHED TOGETHER WITH A STATEMENT OF THE GOVERNMENT'S INTENTIONS SHORTLY AFTER THE BEGINNING OF THE NEW SESSION, NOV. 8.

DETAILING THE REINFORCEMENTS SENT TO PALESTINE AND THE MEASURES FOR HANDING OVER CONTROL TO THE MILITARY AUTHORITIES, MR. MACDONALD DECLARED THERE WERE SUFFICIENT FORCES AT THE DISPOSAL OF THE GENERAL OFFICER IN COMMAND (MAJOR-GENERAL ROBERT H. HAINING) TO RESTORE ORDER, BUT THE PROCESS OF SUPPRESSING REBELS AND REESTABLISHING CIVIL ADMINISTRATION IN OUTLYING AREAS "MAY TAKE A CONSIDERABLE TIME."

CASUALTIES FOR THE THREE MONTHS ENDING YESTERDAY WERE 29 BRITISH, 144 JEWS AND 231 ARABS KILLED; 75 BRITISH, 230 JEWS AND 179 ARABS WOUNDED. IN ADDITION, MORE THAN 400 KNOWN ARAB REBELS WERE KILLED AND A LARGE NUMBER WERE WOUNDED.

MEANWHILE, THE ARAB DELEGATION SENT BY THE RECENT CAIRO ARAB CONGRESS TO PRESENT A SERIES OF RESOLUTIONS CONCERNING THE SITUATION IN PALESTINE TO THE BRITISH GOVERNMENT ARRIVED HERE TODAY. THE DELEGATION IS LED BY MOHAMMED ALI ALLUBI, FORMER MEMBER OF THE EGYPTIAN CABINET, AND INCLUDES FARIS BEY EL KHURY, OF SYRIA, AS WELL AS REPRESENTATIVES OF INDIA. IT IS EXPECTED THEY WILL BE RECEIVED DURING THE WEEK BY MR. MACDONALD.

ESTABLISHMENT OF AN ARAB STATE IN PALESTINE WOULD MAKE THE EX-MUFTI OF JERUSALEM THE GENERAL FRANCO OF A FASCIST EASTERN MEDITERRANEAN, L. BANGANSKY, GENERAL SECRETARY OF THE ZICNIST ORGANIZATION OF GREAT BRITAIN AND IRELAND, DECLARED TONIGHT AT A MEETING OF THE "1912 CLUB." BRITAIN MUST BE CAREFUL, HE WARNED, TO FIND OUT WHETHER AN ARAB PALESTINE WITH FASCIST TENDENCIES WOULD COLLABORATE WITH THE DEMOCRACIES OR WITH THE ROME-BERLIN AXIS.

ARABS STRIKE PROTESTING TRAVEL CURBS

JERUSALEM, Nov. I. (JTA) -- ARABS TODAY LAUNCHED A NATION-WIDE THREE-DAY GENERAL STRIKE IN PROTEST AGAINST THE TRAVEL RESTRICTION ORDINANCE, AS TROOPS BEGAN ENFORCEMENT OF THE DECREE. PATROLS HALTED INTERUBBAN TRAFFIC AT FREQUENT INTERVALS TO EXAMINE TRAVELLERS' IDENTITY CARDS. CITY STREETS WERE BLOCKED BY JEWISH BUSSES AND ARMY TRUCKS WHILE DRIVERS' CARDS WERE INSPECTED.

THE STRIKE, WHICH WAS COMPLETE, WAS OBSERVED BY MERCHANTS AND WORKERS. IT FORCED CLOS-ING DOWN OF THE RAILWAY SHOPS AT HAIFA. THE IRAQ PETROLEUM COMPANY ALSO WAS AFFECTED BY THE WALKOUT, 400 EMPLOYES JOINING THE STRIKE. CURFEW WAS IMPOSED IN HAIFA FROM SEVEN P.M. JEWS AND BRITISH CARRIED ON ESSENTIAL SERVICES.

BARCLAYS' BANK IN JAFFA TODAY SHIFTED VALUABLES TO TEL AVIV IN SIX ARMORED CARS UNDER STRONG MILITARY ESCORT. IN HAIFA, II ARAB NOTABLES WERE ARRESTED DURING SEARCHING OPERATIONS. FIGHTING WAS REPORTED AT NABLUS AND LYDDA, WHERE ARAB RAIDERS WERE EASILY REPULSED. MOPPING UP OPERATIONS CONTINUED IN JAFFA.

TROOPS INVESTED HEBRON, KILLING TWO ARABS WHO RESISTED ARREST. A JEWISH BUS WAS AMBUSHED NEAR JAGUR, BETWEEN REHOVOTH AND TEL AVIV. THE DRIVER, JEREMIAH SMILANSKY, 31, WAS SERIOUSLY WOUNDED AND A PASSENGER, ABRAHAM LUBITSCH, SLIGHTLY INJURED.

JEWS INDIGNANT OVER WALLING WALL DESECRATION

JERUSALEM, Nov. I. (JTA) -- INDIGNATION SWEPT JEWISH PALESTINE TODAY OVER ARAB DES-ECRATION OF THE WAILING WALL DURING THE PERIOD IT HAD BEEN BARRED TO WORSHIPPERS. WHEN THE BAN WAS LIFTED OVER THE WEEK-END, WORSHIPPERS FOUND SECTIONS OF THE WALL BLACKENED BY FIRE, OTHERS WITH STONES CHIPPED AS BY EXPLOSIONS AND THE CHARRED REMAINS OF WORSHIPPING APPURTEN-ANCES THAT HAD BEEN SET AFIRE.

THE ORIGINAL DISPATCHES ABOUT THE DESECRATION, DESTINED FOR ABROAD, AS WELL AS ABOUT A PROTEST BY THE JEWISH NATIONAL COUNCIL, WERE SUPPRESSED BY THE GOVERNMENT CENSOR, WHO SAID THE PROTEST HAD NOT BEEN RECEIVED. THE PROTEST, FORWARDED TO THE AUTHORITIES ON SUNDAY, DESCRIBED THE "WORSHIPPERS' BITTERNESS AT THE DESECRATION" AND URGED THE GOVERNMENT TO INCREASE THE GUARD IN THE VICINITY OF THE WALL.

A JEWISH TELEGRAPHIC AGENCY REPORTER WHO VISITED THE WALL ON SUNDAY FOUND TRACES OF BONFIRES AND OTHER EVIDENCES OF DESECRATION. THE NEIGHBORHOOD WAS STILL WITHOUT POLICE PROTECTION AND THE USUALLY WELL-KEPT PRECINCTS WERE LITTERED. ONLY ARABS WERE PRESENT AT THE WALL AND ARAB URCHINS WERE SPRAWLED IN FRONT OF IT, PLAYING MARBLES.

JEWS ARE BARRED FROM THE WALL NOW EXCEPT ON THE SABBATH, WHEN A SPECIAL POLICE GUARD IS PROVIDED.

CHURCHMEN HOLD REFUGEE AID ESSENTIAL TO PEACE

LONDON, Nov. 1. (JTA) -- AID TO REFUGES WAS ADVANCED TODAY AS A CARDINAL PART OF A THREE-POINT PROGRAM FOR LASTING PEACE MAPPED AT A CONFERENCE OF LEADERSOF THE ANGLICAN CHURCH AND THE FREE CHURCHES, UNDER THE CHAIRMANSHIP OF THE ARCHBISHOP OF CANTERBURY.

THE PROGRAM, ISSUED IN THE FORM OF A MANIFESTO ENTITLED "LEST WE FORGET 1914-1918,"
ADVOCATED SUBSTITUTION OF PRINCIPLES OF REASON AND CONFERENCES FOR METHODS OF VIOLENCE IN
SETTLEMENT OF INTERNATIONAL CONFLICTS, VOICED GENERAL DISAPPROVAL OF ANY POLICY BASED SOLELY
ON REARMAMENT AND URGED: "AID TO MULTITUDES OF MEN, WOMEN AND CHILDREN, WHO FOR RACIAL,
RELIGIOUS OR INTELLECTUAL REASONS ARE WITHOUT SHELTER AND WITHOUT HOPE. INSPIRED BY A SPIRIT
OF COMPASSION AND GRATITUDE THAT THEIR HOMES WERE SPARED THE HORRORS OF WAR, CHRISTIANS SHOULD
REPLY TO THEIR APPEALS FOR AID."

LORD MAYOR'S CZECH FUND BARS EMIGRATION ALD

PRAHA, NOV. I. (JTA) -- THE LONDON LORD MAYOR'S FUND WILL BE USED ONLY FOR MAINTENANCE OF REFUGEES AND NOT FOR EMIGRATION PROJECTS, IT WAS LEARNED TODAY FOLLOWING A CONFERENCE BETWEEN SIR RONALD MACLEAY, FORMER BRITISH MINISTER TO CZECHOSLOVAKIA, AND REPRESENTATIVES OF REFUGEE-AID ORGANIZATIONS. JEWISH ORGANIZATIONS HAVE BEEN INFORMED THAT THE MONEY FROM THE FUND WILL NOT BE USED FOR SUPPORT OF REFUGEES FROM GERMANY PROPER, BUT SOLELY FOR REFUGEES FROM GERMANY PROPER, BUT SOLELY FOR REFUGEES

150 REFUGEES ARRIVE DESTITUTE IN SHANGHAL

SHANGHAI, Nov. I. (JTA) -- A group of 150 Jewish professionals and businessmen, refugees from Austria and Germany, arrived in war-torn Shanghai on the S.S. Conte di Rosso today. Many of them, coming directly from concentration camps, were without funds. The Jewish Community is arranging accomposations for them in abandoned bomb-damaged Chinese Houses in Japanese-controlled Hongkew.

EXILES REFUSED PERMISSION TO LAND IN MEXICO

NEW YORK, Nov. 1. (JTA) -- TWENTY-ONE GERMAN AND AUSTRIAN JEWISH REFUGEES ABOARD THE ORINOCO WERE REFUSED PERMISSION TO LAND AT VERACRUZ, MEXICO, AND THE SHIP WAS TO PROCEED TODAY TO HAVANA, ACCORDING TO INFORMATION CABLED TO HIAS HERE BY THE HIAS OFFICE IN MEXICO CITY, WHICH SAID EFFORTS TO OBTAIN PERMISSION FOR THE REFUGEES TO LEAVE THE SHIP HAD BEEN UNAVAILING. (THE HAMBURG-AMERICAN LINE IN MEXICO CITY YESTERDAY HAD ANNOUNCED THAT THE REFUGES WOULD BE PERMITTED TO LAND WHEN THE SHIP ARRIVED AT VERACRUZ FROM TAMPICO.)

HADASSAH VOTES \$244,500 FOR PALESTINE MEDICAL AID, \$51,000 FOR CHILD WELFARE

ST. LOUIS, Nov. 1. (JTA) -- THE HADASSAH CONVENTION TODAY ACCEPTED A BUDGET OF \$244,500 FOR THE HADASSAH MEDICAL ORGANIZATION IN PALESTINE NEXT YEAR, INCLUDING MAINTENANCE OF THE JERUSALEM MEDICAL CENTER, AND AN ADDITIONAL \$51,000 FOR CHILD WELFARE.

MRS. ROSE JACOBS, FORMER PRESIDENT OF HADASSAH AND NOW MEMBER OF THE JEWISH AGENCY EXECUTIVE, SPEAKING FROM LONDON IN LAST NIGHT'S NOC BROADCAST, SAID A MILLION JEWS IN EUROPE WERE LIVING AS IN A CONCENTRATION CAMP. SHE SPOKE OF RUMORS CURRENT IN ENGLAND THAT AN EQUABLE PARTITION SCHEME WAS IMPOSSIBLE, BUT ADDED THAT "WE MUST ASSUME THAT NOTHING IRRETRIEVABLE HAS HAPPENED YET." REGARDING THE NEW PALESTINE IMMIGRATION SCHEDULE, SHE DECLARED THAT ALTHOUGH YOUTH ALIYAH WAS UNLIMITED, FINANCIAL ARRANGEMENTS FOR YOUTH IMMIGRATION WOULD CERTAINLY BE CAREFULLY SCRUTINIZED.

IT WAS UNANIMOUSLY DECIDED TO SEND AN OPEN LETTER TO PRESIDENT ROOSEVELT THANKING HIM FOR HIS CHAMPIONSHIP OF DEMOCRACY AND HIGH MORAL ITY AMONG NATIONS. MISS HENRIETTA SZOLD, FOUNDER OF HADASSAH, IN A MESSAGE FROM JERUSALEM, AFFIRMED FAITH IN THE INDESTRUCTIBILITY OF THE SETTLEMENT WORK ACHIEVED IN PALESTINE.

POLISH DRIVE FOR COLONIES IN FULL SWING; VICE-PREMIER HITS TOTALITARIANISM

WARSAW, Nov. 1, (JTA) -- A CAMPAIGN PRESSING POLISH COLONIAL CLAIMS WAS IN FULL SWING HERE TODAY WITH GOVERNMENT LEADERS AND PRESS VIGOROUSLY PARTICIFATING. KEYNOTE OF THE CAMPAIGN WAS SOUNDED IN AN ELECTORAL ADDRESS LAST NIGHT BY EUGEN KWIATKOWSKI, VICE-PREMIER AND FINANCE MINISTER, WHO DECLARED THE WORLD'S WEALTH MUST BE RE-DISTRIBUTED INSTEAD OF BEING KEPT AMONG A FEW NATIONS.

M. KWIATKOWSKI STATED THAT 88 PER CENT OF THE WORLD GOLD SUPPLY WAS IN THE HANDS OF THREE STATES WHICH HAD CLOSED OFF IMMIGRATION BOTH AT HOME AND IN THEIR COLONIES. HE ASSERTED THAT WORLD ECONOMIC EQUILIBRIUM WAS IMPOSSIBLE UNDER THESE CONDITIONS.

TOTALITARIANISM AND THE ONE-PARTY SYSTEM ALSO CAME IN FOR ATTACK BY M. KWIATKOWSKI AS "THE ENEMIES OF NATIONAL CONSOLIDATION."

THE ILLUSTROWARY KURJER CODZIENNY, CRACOW LIBERAL DAILY, IN AN EDITORIAL ASSERTED POLAND MUST HAVE COLONIES IN CONFORMITY WITH ITS POSITION AS AN INDUSTRIALIZED EUROPEAN POWER REQUIRING RAW MATERIALS.

POINTING OUT THAT WARSAW HAD MADE KNOWN ITS WANTS CLEARLY BEFORE THE LEAGUE OF NATIONS ON A NUMBER OF OCCASIONS, THE NEWSPAPER SAID: "POLAND IS A STATE OF 35 MILLION INHABITANTS WHOSE INDUSTRY LACKS RAW MATERIALS AND WHOSE CONSTANTLY INCREASING POPULATION HAS NO OUTLETS FOR EMIGRATION. ITALO-POLISH CONVERSATIONS ON THIS SUBJECT ARE UNDERSTOOD TO HAVE BEEN HELD AT ROME AND THE SUPPORT OF THE ITALIAN GOVERNMENT FOR THE POLISH COLONIAL DEMANDS HAS REPORTEDLY BEEN ASSURED. POLAND CANNOT IGNORE ANY OPPORTUNITY THAT PRESENTS ITSELF TO THIS END."

SO. AFRICAN LEADERS OPPOSE TRANSFER OF COLONIES, TO REICH

JOHANNESBURG, Nov. I. (JTA) -- Strong opposition to any project for return of African colonies to Germany was voiced here today by two prominent political leaders, former Interior Minister J.H. Hormeyer, and Leslie Blackwell, well-known member of Parliament. Views of Both were contained in formal statements.

MR. HOFMEYER SAID: "IT IS NOT ONLY BECAUSE GERMANY IS NOT A MEMBER OF THE LEAGUE OF NATIONS THAT WE OBJECT TO THE TRANSFER. IT IS CHIEFLY BECAUSE OF THE MANNER IN WHICH GERMANY IS TREATING HER MINORITIES, RELIGIOUS AND POLITICAL, WHICH IS ENTIRELY AT VARIANCE WITH THE COVENANT OF THE LEAGUE OF NATIONS. THERE MUST BE A CHANGE OF HEART AND SPIRIT IN THE LEADERS OF GERMANY BEFORE ANY CONSIDERATION IS GIVEN TO TRANSFERRING MANDATES TO GERMANY."

MR. BLACKWELL ADVANCED PRACTICAL CONSIDERATIONS FOR HIS OPPOSITION TO A TRANSFER OF COLONIES, DECLARING: "WE MUST PUT OUR FOOT DOWN AND SAY 'NO, NEVER." WE MUST KEEP SOUTHWEST AFRICA NOT FOR ECONOMIC REASONS BUT BECAUSE OF THE TERRITORY'S STRATEGIC AND GEOGRAPHICAL IMPORTANCE. AS A REPUBLIC WE WOULD NOT BE STRONG ENOUGH TO HOLD SOUTHWEST AFRICA. THE ONLY WAY WE CAN DO IT IS THROUGH OUR MEMBERSHIP AND ALLEGIANCE TO THE BRITISH COMMONWEALTH OF NATIONS. WE DO NOT EXPECT TO REAP WHERE WE DON'T SOW. WE CANNOT ASK GREAT BRITAIN TO PROTECT US UNLESS WE ARE PREPARED TO DO OUR SMALL AND HUMBLE SHARE TO PROTECT HER."

ITALY BROADCASTS FALSEHOODS ABOUT BLUM, JOUHAUX

PARIS, Nov. 1. (JTA) -- FALSE ASSERTIONS CONCERNING FORMER PREMIER LEON BLUM AND SECRETARY-GENERAL LEON JOUHAUX OF THE GENERAL CONFEDERATION OF LABOR WERE MADE IN A RECENT ITALIAN RADIO BROADCAST, IT WAS REVEALED HERE TODAY.

IN A STATEMENT PROTESTING "MALEVEENT INSINUATIONS" AGAINST THE WORKING CLASS, ASSERT-EDLY CONTAINED IN A SPEECH BY PREMIER EDOUARD DALADIER AT THE RADICAL SOCIALIST CONGRESS, THE CONFEDERATION, WHICH REPRESENTS NEARLY 5,000,000 FRENCH WORKERS, DECLARED:

"THERE MIGHT BE SOME EX-CONVICTS AMONG THE WORKERS' DELEGATES. IN THIS CASE, THEY SHOULD BE DENOUNCED AND DISMISSED IN COMPLIANCE WITH THE LAW. BUT ONE HAS NO RIGHT, IN PUBLIC DEBATE, TO THROW SUSPICION ON THE ENTIRETY OF REPUBLICAN WORKERS. SUCH METHODS ARE ONLY ADMISSIBLE IN FASCIST REGIMES. FURTHERMORE, WE ARE OBLIGED TO NOTE THAT AT THE VERY MOMENT THE PREMIER PROFERRED HIS OUTRAGEOUS INSINUATIONS AGAINST THE WORKERS' DELEGATES, THE ITALIAN RADIO PROPAGANDA BROADCAST THAT: 'THE PUBLIC PROSECUTOR HAS DEMANDED THE ARRAIGNMENT OF BLUM AND JOUHAUX, IMPLICATED IN A VAST CRIMINAL AFFAIR DISCOVERED IN MARSEILLE AND IN WHICH 150 POLICEMEN AND LOCAL OFFICIALS WERE REPORTED TO BE INVOLVED."

STREICHER ATTRIBUTES MUNICH PACT TO FACT PREMIERS WERE NOT JEWS

LONDON, NOV. 1. (JTA) -- JULIUS STREICHER, SPEAKING AT GREDING, GERMANY, DECLARED TO-DAY THAT THE MUNICH AGREEMENT WAS POSSIBLE BECAUSE "THE PREMIERS OF FRANCE AND ENGLAND WERE NOT JEWS." HE ADDED THAT "WHENEVER DECENT FRENCHMEN AND ENGLISHMEN GET TOGETHER WITH AN ADOLF HITLER AND A MUSSOLINI THERE ARE GOOD RESULTS." STREICHER DECLARED THAT MISFORTUNE YOULD ATTEND GERMANY SO LONG AS A SINGLE JEW REMAINED IN THE COUNTRY.

MUSSOLINI OPENS NEW SHORT-WAVE STATION, HELD STRONGEST IN WORLD

ROME, Nov. 1. (JTA) -- Premier Benito Mussolini Yesterday Inaugurated a New Radio Short-wave transmitting station, described as the most powerful in the world, at Prato Smeraldo about seven miles outside Rome. The station, whose broadcasts can be picked up throughout the world but which are destined particularly for Listeners in Italy's East African Empire, has a power of 100 kilowatts and can broadcast four programs simultaneously. It has 12 wave-lengths and 14 antennae ranging from about 180 to 300 feet in Height.

BOOK DEPICTING LIFE UNDER NAZISM BANNED BY REICH

BERLIN, Nov. 1. (HAVAS) -- "SAVAGE SYMPHONY," BY EVA LIPS, THE BOOK DEPICTING LIFE UNDER NAZISM, WAS BANNED FROM GERMANY TODAY. ANOTHER BOOK "CHANTAGE A LA GUERRE" (BLACKMAIL FOR WAR), BY GENEVIEVE TABOUIS, WELL-KNOWN FOREIGN AFFAIRS COMMENTATOR FOR THE PARIS NEWS-PAPER L'OEUVRE, WAS ALSO BANNED.

FLAGS AT HALF STAFF FOR VLADECK; HUNDREDS VIEW BODY

NEW YORK, Nov. 1. (JTA) -- HUNDREDS OF PERSONS FROM EVERY WALK OF LIFE PASSED BY THE BODY OF B.C. VLADECK, LYING IN STATE IN THE FORWARD AUDITORIUM. FLAGS ON ALL CITY BUILDINGS FLEW AT HALF STAFF. THE AMERICAN ORT FEDERATION, OF WHICH MR. VLADECK WAS PRESIDENT, WILL CLOSE ITS OFFICES DURING HIS FUNERAL TOMORROW. THE New YORK TIMES, HERALD TRIBUNE AND POST TODAY PUBLISHED EDITORIALS LAUDING HIS PUBLIC SERVICES. TRIBUTES CONTINUED TO COME FROM INDIVIDUALS AND ORGANIZATIONS WITH WHOM MR. VLADECK HAD BEEN ASSOCIATED.

REFUGEE TO ERECT ENGLAND'S FIRST STATUE OF RALEIGH

LONDON, Nov. I. (JTA) -- BENNO ELKAN, NOTED GERMAN-JEWISH SCULPTOR WHO SETTLED IN ENGLAND AFTER ADVENT OF THE NAZI REGIME IN GERMANY, HAS BEEN ASSIGNED THE TASK OF MAKING ENGLAND'S FIRST STATUE OF SIR WALTER RALEIGH. THE STATUE WILL BE ERECTED IN LONDON, NEAR THE I VERBOOL STATION.

DIES COMMITTEE MAY END HEARINGS FOR LACK OF FUNDS

WASHINGTON, Nov. 1. (JTA) -- THE HOUSE COMMITTEE ON UN-AMERICAN ACTIVITIES MAY HAVE TO END ITS HEARINGS SOON BECAUSE ITS \$25,000 IS RUNNING LOW, WITH LITTLE PROSPECT OF AN ADDITIONAL APPROPRIATION, CHAIRMAN MARTIN DIES ANNOUNCED TODAY. HE CONDEMNED ATTACKS BY PRESIDENT ROOSEVELT AND OTHER ADMINISTRATION MEMBERS ON THE COMMITTEE.

AGED JEW DIES AFTER RIOTING IN BIALYSTOK AREA

WARSAW, Nov. I. (JTA) -- A 72-YEAR-OLD JEW, ALTER DYMOWSKI, DIED TODAY OF WOUNDS SUFFERED SEVERAL DAYS AGO DURING ANTI-JEWISH EXCESSES IN THE TOWN OF SOKOLY, IN THE BIALYSTOK DISTRICT. A MAN CHARGED WITH HIS SLAYING IS UNDER ARREST. ANTI-SEMITIC STREET ATTACKS WERE REPORTED TODAY FROM LWOW, WITH A JEWISH JOURNALIST, BEN ZION GINSBURG, AMONG THE WOUNDED.

ACTION AGAINST ANTI-JEWISH AGITATION DEMANDED IN PORTUGAL

LISSON, NOV. 1. (JTA) -- POLICE ACTION AGAINST ILLEGAL DISTRIBUTION OF A GERMAN-EDITED PAMPHLET, "PROCLAMATION AGAINST THE UNIVERSAL ENEMY," AMONG RAILWAY PASSENGERS, WAS DEMANDED TODAY BY THE DIARIO DE NOTICIAS, LEADING DAILLY NEWSPAPER HERE. THE PAPER POINTED OUT THAT UNAUTHORIZED CIRCULATION OF THE PAMPHLET, WHICH CONTAINS A NUMBER OF ANTI-JEWISH ALLEGATIONS, CONSTITUTED INFRINGEMENT UPON THE LAWS OF HOSPITALITY UNDER WHICH FOREIGNERS ARE WELCOMED REGARDLESS OF THEIR RELIGION.

MUSSOLINI OPENS NEW SHORT-WAVE STATION, HELD STRONGEST IN WORLD

ROME, Nov. 1. (JTA) -- PREMIER BENITO MUSSOLINI YESTERDAY INAUGURATED A NEW RADIO SHORT-WAVE TRANSMITTING STATION, DESCRIBED AS THE MOST POWERFUL IN THE WORLD, AT PRATO SMERALDO ABOUT SEVEN MILES OUTSIDE ROME. THE STATION, WHOSE BROADCASTS CAN BE PICKED UP THROUGHOUT THE WORLD BUT WHICH ARE DESTINED PARTICULARLY FOR LISTENERS IN ITALY'S EAST AFRICAN EMPIRE, HAS A POWER OF 100 KILOWATTS AND CAN BROADCAST FOUR PROGRAMS SIMULTANEOUSLY. IT HAS 12 WAVE-LENGTHS AND 14 ANTENNAE RANGING FROM ABOUT 180 TO 300 FEET IN HEIGHT.

BERLIN, Nov. 1. (HAVAS) -- "SAVAGE SYMPHONY," BY EVA LIPS, THE BOOK DEPICTING LIFE UNDER NAZISM, WAS BANNED FROM GERMANY TODAY. ANOTHER BOOK "CHANTAGE A LA GUERRE" (BLACKMAIL FOR WAR), BY GENEVIEVE TABOUIS, WELL-KNOWN FOREIGN AFFAIRS COMMENTATOR FOR THE PARIS NEWS-PAPER L'OEUVRE, WAS ALSO BANNED.

FLAGS AT HALF STAFF FOR VLADECK; HUNDREDS VIEW BODY

NEW YORK, Nov. 1. (JTA) -- HUNDREDS OF PERSONS FROM EVERY WALK OF LIFE PASSED BY THE BODY OF B.C. VLADECK, LYING IN STATE IN THE FORWARD AUDITORIUM. FLAGS ON ALL CITY BUILDINGS FLEW AT HALF STAFF. THE AMERICAN ORT FEDERATION, OF WHICH MR. VLADECK WAS PRESIDENT, WILL CLOSE ITS OFFICES DURING HIS FUNERAL TOMORROW. THE NEW YORK TIMES, HERALD TRIBUNE AND POSTOTODAY PUBLISHED EDITORIALS LAUDING HIS PUBLIC SERVICES. TRIBUTES CONTINUED TO COME FROM INDIVIDUALS AND ORGANIZATIONS WITH WHOM MR. VLADECK HAD BEEN ASSOCIATED.

REFUGEE TO ERECT ENGLAND'S FIRST STATUE OF RALEIGH

LONDON, Nov. 1. (JTA) -- BENNO ELKAN, NOTED GERMAN-JEWISH SCULPTOR WHO SETTLED IN ENGLAND AFTER ADVENT OF THE NAZI REGIME IN GERMANY, HAS BEEN ASSIGNED THE TASK OF MAKING ENGLAND'S FIRST STATUE OF SIR WALTER RALEIGH. THE STATUE WILL BE ERECTED IN LONDON, NEAR THE LIVERPOOL STATION.

DIES COMMITTEE MAY END HEARINGS FOR LACK OF FUNDS

(JTA) -- THE HOUSE COMMITTEE ON UN-AMERICAN ACTIVITIES MAY HAVE TO END ITS HEARINGS SOON BECAUSE ITS \$25,000 IS RUNNING LOW, WITH LITTLE PROSPECT OF AN ADDITIONAL APPROPRIATION, CHAIRMAN MARTIN DIES ANNOUNCED TODAY. HE CONDEMNED ATTACKS BY PRESIDENT ROOSEVELT AND OTHER ADMINISTRATION MEMBERS ON THE COMMITTEE.

AGED JEW DIES AFTER RIOTING IN BIALYSTOK AREA

WARSAW, Nov. I. (JTA) -- A 72-YEAR-OLD JEW, ALTER DYMOWSKI, DIED TODAY OF WOUNDS SUFFERED SEVERAL DAYS AGO DURING ANTI-JEWISH EXCESSES IN THE TOWN OF SOKOLY, IN THE BIALYSTOK DISTRICT. A MAN CHARGED WITH HIS SLAYING IS UNDER ARREST. ANTI-SEMITIC STREET ATTACKS WERE REPORTED TODAY FROM LWOW, WITH A JEWISH JOURNALIST, BEN ZION GINSBURG, AMONG THE WOUNDED.
