# 2,500 JEWS ARRESTED IN BRATISLAVA; MANY FACE DEPORTATION

PRAHA, Nov. 6. (JTA) -- REPORTS FROM BRATISLAVA, CAPITAL OF AUTOMOUS SLOVAKIA, SAID TODAY THAT 2,500 JEWS HAVE BEEN ROUNDED UP BY THE AUTHORITIES. EARLY DEPORTATION WAS REPORTEDLY SLATED FOR THOSE WITH IMPROPERLY STAMPED POLICE PASSESS. AND THOSE COMING FROM AREAS JUST TURNED OVER TO HUNGARY.

ANTI-SEMITIC VIOLENCE FLARED IN BRATISLAVA LAST NIGHT DESPITE CRASTIC PRECAUTIONS TAKEN BY THE POLICE. THE CITY IS SEPARATED ONLY BY THE DANGE FROM TERRITORY GIVEN THE REICH BY THE MUNICH ACCORD. GLEAMING ACROSS THE RIVER WAS A HUGE, L'GHTED SWASTIKA SET UP ON THE RUINS OF AN OLD CASTLE.

POLICE ARMED WITH TRUNCHEONS PATROLLED THE CITY IN AUTOMOBILES, SCATTERING GROUPS AS FAST AS THEY FORMED. CIVILIANS WEARING SWASTIKA ARMSANDS STOOD AT ALMOST EVERY STREET CORNER THROUGHOUT THE NIGHT. MANY WINDOWS BROKEN IN RECENT DISTURBANCES HAVE BEEN BOARDED UP OR STUFFED WITH RAGS. "PAYAN" MERCHANTS STRETCHED RED, WHITE AND BLUE RIBBONS -- THE SLOVAK COLORS -- ACROSS THEIR STORE FRONTS.

MEANWHILE, THE SLOVAK AUTHORITIES WERE TAKING VIGOROUS ACTION AGAINST JEWISH ELEMENTS WHO ALLEGEDLY HAD ADOPTED A HOSTILE ATTITUDE TOWARD THE SLOVAK STATE AND PEOPLE DURING THE PERIOD OF NEGOTIATION WHICH CULMINATED IN THE ITALO-GERMAN AWARD TO HUNGARY. SPECIAL POLICE UNITS WERE ORGANIZED TO CHECK ON THE ACTIVITIES OF THESE JEWS, A NUMBER OF WHOM ARE EXPECTED TO BE EXPELLED.

### 155,000 JEWS COME UNDER HUNGARIAN RULE

BUDAPEST, Nov. 6. (JTA) -- IT WAS ESTIMATED HERE TODAY THAT THE JEWISH POPULATION OF HUNGARY HAS BEEN LIFTED TO 600,000, OR AN INCREASE OF 155,000, BY THE CESSION OF SLOVAKIAN TERRITORY UNDER THE ITALO-GERMAN ARBITRATION AMARO. JEWS WOULD THUS FORM SIX PER CENT OF THE TOTAL HUNGARIAN POPULATION. THE LAW RESTRICTING JEWISH PARTICIPATION IN THE CULTURAL AND ECONOMIC LIFE OF THE NATION TO 20 PER CENT WILL BE EXTENDED TO THE NEWLY ACQUIRED DISTRICTS. IT WAS STATED.

DISSATISFACTION WITH THE ITALO-GERMAN AWARD, WHICH WAS LESS THAN DEMANDED BY HUNGARY, IS BEING UTILIZED FOR ANTI-SEMITIC PROPAGANDA, SOME CIRCLES SUGGESTING THAT THE JEWS SHOULD BE MADE TO PAY FOR THE ALLEGED INJUSTICES OF THE ARBITRAGE. HOWEVER, STRENGTHENING OF PREMIER BELA IMREDY'S POSITION WAS REGARDED AS FAVORABLE FOR COMBATING EXTREMISTS.

THE EXTREME RIGHTIST NEWSPAPER HARC, ORGAN OF THE NATIONAL FRONT, PROTESTED BITTERLY AGAINST THE VIENNA SETTLEMENT, SAYING: "WE ARE PROFOUNDLY DISSATISFIED. WE COULD HAVE OBTAINED THE TERRITORIES FORMERLY BELONGING TO HUNGARY IF WE HAD A STRONG ARMY, IF THE PRESENT REGIME HAD NOT FOR 20 YEARS PREVENTED SETTLEMENT OF HUNGARIAN PROBLEMS, IF WE HAD NO GREAT ESTATES, IF THE GREED OF THE GREAT JEWISH MAGNATES WERE NOT KEEPING 10,000,000 HUNGARIANS IN A VERY LOW STANDARD OF LIVING."

# U.S. URGED TO COMBINE SEVERAL YEARS QUOTAS TO AID REICH JEWS

BERLIN, Nov. 6. (JTA) -- THE JUEDISCHE RUNDSCHAU, ORGAN OF THE GERMAN ZIONIST FEDERATION, TODAY APPEALED TO THE UNITED STATES GOVERNMENT TO COMBINE ITS GERMAN IMMIGRATION QUOTAS FOR SEVERAL YEARS IN ORDER TO REDUCE THE WAITING TIME OF APPLICANTS FOR AMERICAN VISAS.

THE ZIONIST WEEKLY STRESSED "THE INEXPLICABLE AND INTOLERABLE DISCRÉPANCY" BETWEEN GERMAN JEWRY'S PRESSING NEED FOR EMIGRATION AND THE INACTIVITY OF THE INTERGOVERNMENTAL REFUGEE BUREAU, HEADED BY GEORGE RUBLEE, OF WASHINGTON. PROVIDING OF NEW POSSIBILITIES FOR LIVING AND WORKING FOR THE GERMAN JEWS REMAINS THE MAIN PROBLEM OF CENTRAL EUROPEAN JEWRY, THE PAPER ASSERTED.

#### POLISH JEWISH WRITERS HELP DEPORTEES

WARSAW, Nov. 6. (JTA) -- THE UNION OF JEWISH WRITERS AND JOURNALISTS DECIDED TODAY TO ASSESS ALL MEMBERS AT LEAST ONE DAY'S PAY FOR THE FUND TO HELP 12,000 POLISH JEWS DUMPED BY GERMANY INTO POLAND LAST WEEK.

#### NEW ITALIAN LAWS ON JEWS DUE TODAY; 15,000 EXEMPTED

ROME, Nov. 6. (JTA) -- LEGISLATION ON THE JEWS GROWING OUT OF RECENT DISCUSSIONS OF THE FASCIST GRAND COUNCIL WILL BE PASSED BY THE CABINET TOMORROW, IT WAS LEARNED TONIGHT.

IT WAS ANNOUNCED OFFICIALLY THAT 3,522 JEWISH FAMILIES, OF A TOTAL OF APPROXIMATELY 15,000, ARE EXEMPT FROM APPLICATION OF THE ITALIAN ANTI-JEWISH LAWS UNDER RULINGS BY THE FASCIST GRAND COUNCIL. THE EXEMPTIONS WERE LISTED AS FOLLOWS: FAMILIES OF MAP DEAD, 406; OF WAR VOLUNTEERS, 721; OF SOLDIERS DECORATED WITH THE CROSS OF MILITARY MERIT, 1,597; OF THOSE WHO DIED DURING THE FASCIST REVOLUTION, 3; OF THOSE CRIPPLED OR WOUNDED IN THE CAUSE OF FASCISM, 20; OF FASCISTS BELONGING TO PARTY BEFORE THE MARCH ON ROME, OR WHO JOINED IN THE SECOND HALF OF 1924, 724; AND FAMILIES OF FIUME LEGIONNAIRES, 51.

### YOUNG JEWESS SLAIN AS PALESTINE DISORDERS GOES ON

JERUSALEM, Nov. 6. (JTA) -- A 19-YEAR-OLD JEWESS WAS KILLED YESTERDAY WHITE DEFENDING THE ZIONIST YOUTH SETTLEMENT OF TEL ITZHAK, NEAR EVEN YEHUDA IN THE SHARON VALLEY, FROM AN ATTACK BY A BAND OF ARAB REBEL RAIDERS. SHE WAS EDDA ROSHWALD, AN IMMIGRANT FROM LWOW, POLANG

VIOLENCE CONTINUED, MEANWHILE, IN OTHER PARTS OF PALESTINE. TROOPS SHOT DEAD AN ARAB IN THE ACT OF CUTTING TELEPHONE WIRES BETWEEN AFFULEH AND JENIN. A SOLDIER WAS SERIOUSLY WOUNDED WHEN A PATROL SURPRISED AND ENGAGED A BAND OF ARABS DEMOLISHING AN ARAB HOUSE NEAR BETHLEHEM. CONTINUING SEARCHES IN THE SAMARIA DISTRICT, TROOPS DISCOVERED EQUIPMENT FOR THE MANUFACTURE OF LAND MINES IN THE VILLAGES OF ANZA AND SANUR.

JEWISH POLICE CORPORAL LUBERA WAS SERIOUSLY INJURED WHEN HE AND HIS COMPANION, SERGEANT BENDOR, WERE AMBUSHED BY ARABS WHILE MOTORCYCLING ON THE JENIN ROAD NEAR HAIFA. AN ARAB

POST OFFICE CLERK WAS SHOT AND KILLED IN HAIFA, HIS ASSAILANT ESCAPING. AN AUSTRIAN JEW, MOSHE BLUM, 19, WAS SERIOUSLY WOUNDED WHEN A BUS EN ROUTE FROM TEL AVIV TO REHOBOTH WAS AMBUSHED NEAR RISHON-LE-ZION.

AN INCENDIARY FIRE WHICH RAGED FOR FIVE HOURS TODAY CAUSED SERIOUS DAMAGE TO THE LEVANT BONDED WAREHOUSE IN HAIFA. A BAND RAIDED A PARCEL OFFICE AND ESCAPED WITH \$3,875 IN GOLD BARS. TWO ARMY TRUCKS WERE FIRED UPON FROM AN ARAB CAFE. SOLDIERS REPLIED, WOUNDING ONE ARAB AND ARRESTED FOUR OTHERS.

CURFEW FROM TEN P.M. TO FIVE A.M. WAS IMPOSED ON JAFFA. TROOPS SEARCHED AQUARABA NEAR NABLUS, DETAINING 100 ARABS, AND ALSO HALHUL IN THE VICINITY OF JERUSALEM, ARRESTING 81 SUSPECTED BANDSMEN. ARAB BANDS IN A DRIVE FOR DISRUPTION OF JEWISH CITRUS SHIPMENTS, SET FIRE TO A NUMBER OF PACKING HOUSES, INCLUDING TWO AT BENYAMINA AND ONE AT NATHANIA.

JEWISH PRISONERS IN THE ACRE CONCENTRATION CAMP ANNOUNCED TODAY THEY WOULD RESUME THEIR HUNGER-STRIKE IN PROTEST AGAINST CONDITIONS IN THE CAMP. THEY HAD ENDED A FAST YESTERDAY AFTER 40 HOURS UPON RECEIVING AN APPEAL SENT BY CHIEF RABBI MOSHE AVIGDOR AMIEL OF TEL AVIV BY A SPECIAL EMISSARY.

#### STUDENTS DEMONSTRATE IN CAIRO

CAIRO, Nov. 6. (JTA) -- MOSLEM STUDENTS DISREGARDED POLICE PRECAUTION YESTERDAY AND HELA STORMY CONGRESS AT UNIVERSITY HALL, CALLED TO DEMONSTRATE THEIR SYMPATHY FOR THE ARAB REBELLION IN PALESTINE. THE CONGRESS ADOPTED A RESOLUTION PROTESTING BRITISH POLICY IN PALESTINE, ZIONISM AND THE ATTITUDE OF THE UNITED STATES, SUPPORTING THE "JUST CLAIMS" OF THE PALESTINE ARABS AND DEMANDING THAT EGYPTIAN JEWS TAKE AN ANTI-ZIONIST STANC.

-INDIAN, EGYPTIAN, TRACIAN AND YEMENITE STUDENT SPEAKERS URGED COLLECTION OF FUNDS FOR THE REBELS. THEIR SPEECHES WERE PUNCTUATED BY CRIES OF "DOWN WITH BRITAIN, ENEMY OF THE ARABS!"

AT THE SAME TIME JEWISH UNIVERSITY STUDENTS ISSUED A MANIFESTO DECLARING THAT JEWS
WERE ENTITLED TO LIFE AND LIBERTY AND ASKING THAT THE COLONIAL POWERS FIND NEW TERRITORY THAT
IS UNCULTIVATED AND UNINHABITED TO SETTLE THE JEWISH PROBLEM. THE MANIFESTO RECOGNIZED THE
PALESTIME ARABS' RIGHT TO INDEPENDENCE AND PROTESTED ILL-TREATMENT OF JEWS.

# POLAND ELECTS NEW CHAMBER; BOYCOTT HITS BALLOTING

WARSAW, Nov. 6. (JTA) -- RESULTS OF NATION-WIDE ELECTIONS FOR THE NEW SEJM (CHAMBER OF DEPUTIES) WERE AWAITED TONIGHT AFTER A STRONG ELECTION CAMPAIGN. JEWISH CANDIDATES RAN IN WARSAW, LODZ, KRAKOW AND LWOM. THE POLLS CLOSED AT NINE P.M.

VICTORY FOR THE GOVERNMENTAL CAMP OF NATIONAL UNITY BEING CONCEDED IN ADVANCE, INTEREST IN THE ELECTIONS CENTERED ON THE EFFECTIVENESS OF THE BOYCOTT ORDERED BY THE THREE LARGE OPPOSITION PARTIES, NATIONAL DEMOCRATIC, UNITED PEOPLE'S, AND SOCIALIST. IN 1935, WHEN A SIMILAR BOYCOTT WAS CARRIED OUT IN PROTEST AGAINST THE ELECTORAL SYSTEM, ONLY 37 PER CENT OF THE VOTERS EXERCISED THEIR FRANCHISE. SUPPORTERS OF THE GOVERNMENT HOPED THAT A BETTER RESPONSE WOULD BE OPTAINED THIS YEAR AS A RESULT OF A PROPAGANDA CAMPAIGN PRESENTING THE BOYCOTT AS A CRIME AGAINST THE STATE. MOST OF THE CANDIDATES HAVE NO POLITICAL PAST, AND ARE LITTLE KNOWN TO THE VOTERS.

HALF THE POPULATION, OR 17,413,274 VOTERS, WERE ELIGIBLE TO GO TO THE POLLS IN 104 DISTRICTS TO ELECT 206 MEMBERS OF THE SIXTH SEJM. CERTAINTY OF A GOVERNMENTAL VICTORY WAS

ON THE FACT THAT CANDIDATES WERE NAMED BY PRO-GOVERNMENT COMMISSIONS AS WELL AS THE FACT OF THE OPPOSITION BOYCOTT. A 70 PER CENT MAJORITY WAS PREDICTED. OF THE 440 CANDIDATES, 376 ARE MEMBERS OF THE CAMP OF NATIONAL UNITY, 40 ARE UKRAINIANS, FIVE ARE JEWS, AND SEVERAL ARE FROM THE OPPOSITION GROUPS. DESPITE THE BOYCOTT.

#### JEWISH VETERANS HOLD REMEMBRANCE DAY SERVICE IN LONDON .

LONDON, Nov. 6. (JTA) -- More than 7,000 Jewish war veterans from London and the provinces participated today in the Ninth National Remembrance Service in the Horse Guards Parade, watched by 20,000 Jewish men, women and children. A huge growd also lined whitehall when the ex-servicemen, led by Jacon Keysor, a holder of the Victoria Cross, marched to the Cenotaph and Laid a wreath.

LORD READING, ADDRESSING A REUNION TEA AT ALBERT HALL LATER, APPEALED TO THE BRITISH GOVERNMENT TO MAKE SOME EFFORT TO MITIGATE THE HORRORS AND DANGERS OF THE JEWISH PROBLEM IN MANY PARTS OF THE WORLD. DECLARING SUCH EFFORT WOULD BE "NOT ONLY IN THE INTERESTS OF THE JEWS," HE ASSERTED THAT "ANY GENERAL APPEASEMENT MUST BE FOUNDED UPON THE ETERNAL PRINCIPLES OF FREEDOM, JUSTICE AND TOLERANCE."

#### ROOSEVELT RENEWS ATTACK ON DICTATORSHIPS IN RADIO TALK FOR LEHMAN

HYDE PARK, N.Y. Nov. 6. (JTA) -- PRESIDENT ROSEVELT RENEWED HIS ATTACK ON DICTATOR-SHIPS FRIDAY NIGHT IN THE COURSE OF A RADIO BROADCAST URGING RE-ELECTION OF GOVERNOR HERBERT H. LEMMAN AND OTHER DEMOCRATIC NOMINEES. HE SAID, IN PART:

"IN OTHER LANDS ACROSS THE WATER THE FLARES OF MILITARISM AND CONQUEST, TERRORISM AND INTOLERANCE, HAVE VIVIDLY REVEALED TO AMERICANS FOR THE FIRST TIME SINCE THE REVOLUTION HOW PRECIOUS AND EXTRAORDINARY IT IS TO BE ALLOWED THIS FREE CHOICE OF FREE LEADERS FOR FREE NEW. . . BUT WE CANNOT CARELESSLY ASSUME THAT A NATION IS STRONG AND GREAT MERELY BECAUSE IT HAS A DEMOCRATIC FORM OF GOVERNMENT. WE HAVE LEARNED THAT A DEMOCRACY WEAKENED BY INTERNAL DISSENSION, BY HUTUAL SUSPICION BORN OF SOCIAL INJUSTICE, IS NO MATCH FOR AUTOCRACIES WHICH ARE RUTHLESS ENOUGH TO REPRESS INTERNAL DISSENSION.

"DEMOCRACY IN ORDER TO LIVE MUST BECOME A POSITIVE FORCE IN THE DAILY LIVES OF ITS
PEOPLE. IT MUST MAKE MEN AND WOMEN WHOSE DEVOTION IT SEEKS FEEL THAT IT REALLY CARES FOR THE
SECURITY OF EVERY INDIVIDUAL; THAT IT IS TOLERANT ENOUGH TO INSPIRE AN ESSENTIAL UNITY AMONG
ITS CITIZENS; AND THAT IT IS MILITANT ENOUGH TO MAINTAIN LIBERTY AGAINST SOCIAL OPPRESSION
AT HOME AND AGAINST MILITARY AGGRESSION ABROAD. . . .

"As of today, fascism and communism -- and old-line Tory Republicanism -- are not. Threa to the continuation of our form of government. But I venture the challenging statement that if American Democracy ceases to move formand as a living force, seeking day and night by peace ful means to better the lot of our citizens, Fascism and Communism, aideo, unconsciously perhaps, by old-line Tory Republicanism, will grow in strength."

# EX-CONGRESSMAN MEMBER OF SILVER SHIRTS, DIES COMMITTEE TOLD

WASHINGTON, Nov. 6. (JTA) -- A FORMER REPUBLICAN CONGRESSMAN FROM MILWAUKEE, JOHN C. SCHAEFER, PUBLICLY BOASTED THAT HE WAS A MEMBER OF THE ANTI-SEMITIC SILVER SHIRTS, THE DIES COMMITTEE ON UN-AMERICAN ACTIVITIES WAS TOLD YESTERDAY. THE CHARGE WAS CONTAINED IN AN AFFIDAVIT SIGNED BY A MILWAUKEE RESTAURANT EMPLOYEE NAMED IRVING RABMUSSEN.

THE COMMITTEE ALSO HEARD TESTIMONY THAT THE GERMAN-AMERICAN BUND HAD THREATENED AND TRIED TO INTIMIDATE GERMAN AMERICANS IN WISCONSIN. BERNHARD HOFFMAN, PRESIDENT OF THE WISCONSIN FEDERATION OF GERMAN-AMERICAN SOCIETIES CHARGED THAT THE BUND HAD WARNED MENBERS OF HIS ORGANIZATION OF REPRISALS AGAINST RELATIVES IN GERMANY OF PERSONS WHO CRITICIZED THE NAZI REGIME. #### ABRAHAM LIESSIN, YIDDISH POET AND EDITOR, DEAD AT 68

NEW YORK, Nov. 6. (JTA) -- ABRAHAM LIESSIN, WELL-KNOWN YIDDISH POET AND EDITOR OF ZUKUNFT, LITERARY AND POLITICAL MONTHLY, DIED YESTERDAY MORNING OF A HEART ATTACK. HE WAS 68 YEARS OLD. BORN IN MINSK, RUSSIA, HE CAME TO THIS COUNTRY IN 1897. LIESSIN, WHOSE REAL NAME WAS WALT, COLLAPSED WEDNESDAY WHILE READING A POEM AT THE FUNERAL SERVICES FOR HIS FRIEND AND ASSOCIATE. B. CHARNEY VLADECK.

FUNERAL SERVICES WERE HELD TODAY IN FORWARD HALL, WHICH WAS CROWDED TO ITS 1,000 CAPACITY, WHILE A THRONG OF ABOUT 5,000 GATHERED IN THE SQUARE OUTSIDE DESPITE RAIN. SPEAKERS WERE HILLEL ROGOFF, WHO PRESIDED, SHOLEM ASCH, DAVID PINSKI, ABRAHAM REISIN, H. LEIVICK, ALEXANDER KAHN, J. WEINBERG, N. CHANIN, RABBI SAUL TSCHNEROWITZ, TZIVYON, JOSEPH SCHLOSSBERG AND TAUSNER, BROTHER-IN-LAW OF LIESSEN. LIESSIN WAS BURIED IN WORKMEN'S CIRCLE CEMETERY NEXT TO B.C. VLADECK.

# 21 REFUGEES BARRED FROM MEXICO LAND IN HAVANA

HAVANA, Nov. 6. (JTA) -- CUBA HAS ACCEPTED 21 GERMAN-JEWISH REFUGEES TURNED AWAY FROM MEXICO LAST WEEK. THE GROUP ARRIVED HERE FRIDAY ON THE S. S. ORINOCO AND WERE PERMITTED TO LAND FOLLOWING APPEALS TO THE AUTHORITIES BY CUBAN NEWSPAPERS, LABOR UNIONS AND POLITICAL PARTIES.

LEADING THE NEWSPAPER CAMPAIGN FOR THEIR ADMISSION WAS THE CUBAN DEMOCRATIC DALLY HOY, WHICH IN AN EDITORIAL URGED THE CUBAN PEOPLE TO APPEAL TO THE GOVERNMENT ON THEIR BEHALF. TELEGRAMS URGING THAT THE REFUGEES BE PERMITTED TO REMAIN IN CUBA WERE SENT BY 100 LABOR UNIONS AND FIVE POLITICAL PARTIES TO COL. FULGENCIO BATISTA, ARMY CHIEF OF STAFF, AND THE MINISTERS OF LABOR AND FOREIGN AFFAIRS.

# \$10,000,000 CANADIAN LOAN URGED TO SETTLE REFUGEES

OTTAWA, Nov. 6. (JTA) -- DECLARING CANADA NEEDED 25,000,000 PEOPLE TO RESTORE HER PROSPERITY, THE INFLUENTIAL WEEKLY, SATURDAY NIGHT, ADVOCATED IN AN ARTICLE A GOVERNMENT LOAN OF \$10,000,000 TO BE USED IN FACILITATING ADMISSION AND SETTLEMENT OF REFUGEES. THE ARTICLE SAID THE REFUGEES APPRECIATED A FREE COUNTRY AND THEIR ADMISSION WOULD BE A BLOW AGAINST NAZI ANTI-SEMITISM AND A VICTORY FOR WESTERN CIVILIZATION.

# HUNGARIAN CATHOLIC GIRLS OFFER TO CLEAN SYNAGOGUE

BUDAPEST, Nov. 6. (JTA) -- CATHOLIC MORKING GIRLS IN THE WESTERN HUNGARICY CITY OF SPORON HAVE OFFERED TO CLEAN A JEWISH SCHOOL BUILDING AND THE ENTRANCE TO A SYNAGOGUE THERE WHICH HAD BEEN SPATTERED BY MUD THROWN BY "VILE INDIVIDUALS."
