ANTI-JEWISH TERROR MOUNTS IN RUMANIA; YIDDISH CURBED IN BUKOVINA

BUCHAREST, DEC. 1. (JTA) -- SPECIAL ORDERS FOR THE PROVINCE OF BUKOVINA, WHERE A MAJORITY OF RUMANIA'S JEWS LIVE, WERE ANNOUNCED TODAY FOR THE ASSERTED PURPOSE OF REMOVING ANY PRETEXT FOR ANTI-JEWISH ACTION AGAINST PERSONS OR PROPERTY.

TEN FIRES WERE STARTED LAST NIGHT IN SYNAGOGUES AND FACTORIES AND SHOPS BELONGING TO JEWS AT CZERNOWITZ. TWO PERSONS ARRESTED FOR INCENDIARISM WERE IDENTIFIED AS MEMBERS OF THE BANNED IRON GUARD, WHOSE LEADER, CORNELIU ZELEA CODREANU, AND 13 AIDES WERE KILLED YESTERDAY.

UNDER THE NEW ORDER ONLY THE RUMANIAN LANGUAGE MUST BE USED IN PUBLIC OFFICES AND IN PLACES OF BUSINESS IN BUKOVINA. JEWS NOT ABLE TO USE RUMANIAN WILL LOSE THEIR RUMANIAN NATIONALITY, AND THEREAFTER WILL BE UNABLE TO FIND EMPLOYMENT. BUSINESS MEN WHO FAIL TO DISPLAY THE SIGN "RUMANIAN SPOKEN HERE" IN THEIR OFFICES AND SHOPS WILL BE FORCED TO CLOSE THEIR PLACES OF BUSINESS FOR THREE DAYS. UPON A SECOND OFFENSE THEY WILL BE FORCED TO CLOSE FOR EIGHT DAYS, AND UPON A THIRD OFFENSE THE CLOSING WILL BE FINAL.

MEANWHILE, ALL JEWS DENATIONALIZED IN THE RECENT REVISION OF CITIZENSHIPS WERE FOR-BIDDEN TO ENGAGE IN ANY BUSINESS OR TO BE EMPLOYED IN ANY FIRMS.

(ACCORDING TO THE UNITED PRESS, MEASURES AGAINST THE IRON GUARD INCLUDED:

(ORDERS TO POLICE TO "SHOOT TO KILL" IF IRON GUARDISTS RESIST ARREST. A ROUND-UP OF ALL MEMBERS WAS ORDERED. HUNDREDS WERE SEIZED IN BUCHAREST, MANO AND OTHER CITIES.

(RETIREMENT ON PENSION OF MORE THAN TWENTY ARMY OFFICERS, INCLUDING A NUMBER OF COLONELS AND LIEUTENANT COLONELS, WHO WERE SUSPECTED OF BEING SYMPATHETIC TOWARD CODREANU.

(SEIZURE AT CLUJ, ACCORDING TO UNOFFICIAL REPORTS, OF ONE OF THE ASSASSINS OF DR. FRANCIS STEFANESCU-GOANGA, RECTOR OF CLUJ UNIVERSITY.

(REDOUBLING OF GUARDS AT CENTERS OF JEWISH POPULATION, ESPECIALLY AT CZERNOWITZ AND TEMESVAR, WHERE POLICE REPORTED FEARS THAT THE IRON GUARD EXTREMISTS WOULD ATTEMPT NEW TERRORISTIC ACTS AGAINST JEWS.)

AUSTRALIA TO ADMIT 15,000 REFUGEES IN 3 YEARS; PLAN WINS SUPPORT OF ALL PARTIES

CAMBERRA, AUSTRALIA, DEC. I. (JTA) -- PREMIER JOSEPH A. LYONS ANNOUNCED TO THE FEDERA PARLIAMENT TONIGHT THAT THE GOVERNMENT HAD SET A QUOTA OF 15,000 REFUGEES FOR THE NEXT THREE YEARS. THE PLAN, HE SAID, HAD THE APPROVAL OF ALL PARTIES, INCLUDING THE LABOR OPPOS-

ITION. LABOR LEADER JOHN CURTIN AGREED THAT THE FIGURE WAS A REASONABLE ONE. EARLIER IN THE DAY A BILL WAS INTRODUCED IN THE SENATE PROVIDING THAT ALL FOREIGNERS MUST REGISTER AND PLACING RESTRICTIONS UPON THEIR MOVEMENTS WITHIN AUSTRALIA.

MEANWHILE, E17,000 (ABOUT \$65,000) TO AID REFUGEES WAS RAISED TONIGHT AT A MEETING OF JEWS IN MELBOURNE AT WHICH EX-GOVERNOR-GENERAL SIR ISAAC SPRESIDED. INTERIOR MINISTER JOHN MCEWEN WROTE COMMENDING THE APPÉAL. HE SAID: "IT IS NECESSARY IN THE INTERESTS OF THE REFUGEES THAT AN ADEQUATE ORGANIZATION ASSIST IN FINDING A PLACE FOR LAND SETTLEMENT AND ESTABLISHMENT IN INDUSTRY. I FEEL SURE THAT AUSTRALIAN CITIZENS DEVOTING THEMSELVES TO THE INTERESTS OF THE UNFORTUNATE REFUGEES ARE PERFORMING A SERVICE OF REAL VALUE TO AUSTRALIA."

U.S. STUDIES RELIEF PLAN; FURD BACKS HAVEN HERE; J.D.C. DONATIONS RISE; ORT GETS COLONY OFFER

NEW YORK, DEC. I. (JTA) -- SECRETARY OF LABOR FRANCES PERKINS WAS REPORTED TODAY TO BE STUDYING A PLAN FOR CREATION OF A GIANT INTERNATIONAL RELIEF CORPORATION TO RESETTLE THE JEWISH YOUTH OF EUROPEAN PERSECUTION LANDS AND SUPPORT THE AGED, AS A STATEMENT BY HENRY FORD SUPPORTING THE UNITED STATES AS A HAVEN FOR REFUGES FEATURED THE GROWING MOVEMENT TO AID THE OPPRESSED. AT THE SAME TIME, THE JOINT DISTRIBUTION COMMITTEE ANNOUNCED INCREASED CONTRIBUTIONS FROM ALL OVER THE COUNTRY AS A RESULT OF THE NEW PERSECUTIONS.

THE EVACUATION PLAN, ACCORDING TO AN EXCLUSIVE New YORK TIMES DISPATCH FROM WASHINGTON, WAS PREPARED BY A LABOR DEPARTMENT OFFICIAL AND HAS NOT YET BEEN ACTED UPON BY SECRETARY PERKINS. IT CONTEMPLATES SYSTEMATIC REMOVAL OF YOUNG JEWS FROM CENTRAL AND EASTERN EUROPE TO AVAILABLE LANDS AFTER THEY HAVE RECEIVED TRAINING FOR AGRICULTURAL PURSUITS. THE UNITED STATES AND GREAT BRITAIN WOULD FINANCE THE SCHEME WITH THE COOPERATION OF INDIVIDUALS IN MANY COUNTRIES. ANOTHER PART OF THE PLAN CONTEMPLATES THE STRENGTHENING OF THE MODERATE ELEMENTS, IN CENTRAL EUROPE SO THAT THE PLAN CONTEMPLATES THE STRENGTHEN IN THE INTENT AND PROTECTION. AT THE SAME TIME ANTI-SEMITISM WOULD BE TREATED AT ITS SOURCE BY PUTTING THE ACTIVE DISAPPROVAL OF THE WORLD BEFORE THE PEOPLE INSTEAD OF BEFORE THEIR GOVERNMENTS.

NEGOTIATIONS ARE PROCEEDING ON THE OFFER OF AN UNNAMED CENTRAL AMERICAN NATION TO THROW OPEN 10,000 SQUARE MILES OF TERRITORY FOR SETTLEMENT OF 25,000 JEWISH FAMILIES, IT WAS DISCLOSED TODAY BY PHILIP BLOCK, EXECUTIVE DIRECTOR OF THE AMERICAN ORT FEDERATION. THE OFFER MADE TO THE ORT, MR. BLOCK TOLD THE JEWISH TELEGRAPHIC AGENCY, PROVIDES THAT 40 PER CENT OF THE FAMILIES BE AGRICULTURISTS, 40 PER CENT ARTISANS AND 20 PER CENT PROFESSIONALS. THESE WOULD BE DRAWN LARGELY FROM THE GERMAN JEWS, BUT ALSO FROM JEWS OF OTHER EUROPEAN COUNTRIES TRAINED BY THE ORT, MR. BLOCK SAID.

THE PROSPECTS FOR ACCEPTANCE OF THE PLAN LOOK FAVORABLE, MR. BLOCK SAID, BUT NO FINAL ARRANGEMENT WILL BE MADE PENDING THE ARRIVAL IN NEW YORK ON DEC. 10 OF DR. DAVID LVOVITCH, VICE-PRESIDENT OF THE INTERNATIONAL ORT FEDERATION, WHO WILL ASSIST IN MAKING THE FINAL ARRANGEMENT.

MR. FORD, IN A STATEMENT AUTHORIZED AT A CONFERENCE IN DETROIT YESTERDAY WITH RABBI LEO M. FRANKLIN, EXPRESSED THE OPINION THAT THE GERMAN PEOPLE DID NOT SYMPATHIZE WITH THEIR RULERS IN THE ANTI-JEWISH POLICIES AND PROMISED TO DO EVERYTHING POSSIBLE TO GIVE REFUGEES A CHANGE TO REBUILD THEIR LIVES IN THIS COUNTRY.

HENRY FORD'S STATEMENT

THE AUTOMOBILE MAGNATE STATED: "I BELIEVE THAT THE UNITED STATES CANNOT FAIL AT THIS TIME TO MAINTAIN ITS TRADITIONAL ROLE AS A HAVEN FOR THE OPPRESSED. I AM CONVINCED NOT ONLY THAT THIS COUNTRY COULD ABSORB MANY OF THE VICTIMS OF OPPRESSION WHO MUST FIND A REFUGE OUT-

SIDE OF THEIR NATIVE LANDS, BUT THAT AS MANY OF THEM AS COULD BE ADMITTED UNDER OUR SELECT-IVE QUOTA SYSTEM WOULD CONSTITUTE A REAL ASSET TO OUR COUNTRY.

"Because of their special adaptability in the fields of production, distribution and agriculture, they would offer to the business of this country a new impetus at a time like this, when it is badly needed. Hundreds of Jewish men now employed in our plants show marked ability and loyalty, and if the turnover among them is sometimes comparatively high, it is indicative of their ambition to improve themselves.

"IT IS MY OPINION THAT THE GERMAN PEOPLE, AS A WHOLE, ARE NOT IN SYMPATHY WITH THEIR RULERS IN THEIR ANTI-JEWISH POLICIES, WHICH IS THE WORK OF A FEW WAR-MAKERS AT THE TOP.

"MY ACCEPTANCE OF A MEDAL FROM THE GERMAN PEOPLE DOES NOT, AS SOME PEOPLE SEEM TO THINK, INVOLVE ANY SYMPATHY ON MY PART WITH NAZISM. THOSE WHO HAVE KNOWN ME FOR MANY YEARS REALIZE THAT ANYTHING THAT BREEDS HATE IS REPULSIVE TO ME.

"I AM CONFIDENT THAT THE TIME IS NEAR WHEN THERE WILL BE SO MANY JOBS AVAILABLE IN THIS COUNTRY THAT THE ENTRANCE OF A FEW THOUSAND JEWS, OR OTHER EMIGRANTS, WILL BE NEGLIGIBLE.

"I BELIEVE THAT THE RETURN-TO-THE-LAND MOVEMENT IS ONE OF THE ULTIMATE SOLUTIONS OF OUR ECONOMIC PROBLEMS, AND IN THIS MOVEMENT THE JEWS OF THE OLD WORLD CAN PLAY A SIGNIFICANT PART. I AM WHOLLY SYMPATHETIC WITH THE MOVEMENT TO GIVE THE OPPRESSED JEW AN OPPORTUNITY TO REBUILD HIS LIFE IN THIS COUNTRY AND I MYSELF WILL DO EVERYTHING POSSIBLE TOWARD THAT END."

INTENSIFIED PERSECUTION ABROAD HAS STIMULATED CONTRIBUTIONS TO FUND-RAISING ORGANIZ-ATIONS FOR OVERSEAS JEWISH CAUSES, ISIDOR COONS, CAMPAIGN DIRECTOR OF THE JOINT DISTRIBUTION COMMITTEE, REPORTED TODAY. ALL COMMUNITIES CONDUCTING CAMPAIGNS THIS FALL HAVE REACHED THEIR GOALS AND SOME HAVE EXCEEDED THEM, MR. COONS SAID. CAMPAIGNS NOW UNDER WAY HAVE GOTTEN OFF TO ADVANTAGEOUS STATTS, HE ADDED.

EXAMPLES CITED BY MR. COONS ARE: THE PHILADELPHIA UNITED JEWISH APPEAL, WITH A \$500,000 GOAL, HAS COLLECTED OVER \$600,000; ATLANTIC CITY, IN A CAMPAIGN FOR \$39,352, NOT YET COMPLETED, HAS RAISED \$36,128; IN TORONTO OVER \$200,000 HAS BEEN RAISED OF THE \$240,000 QUOTA; ROCHESTER HAS INCREASED ITS QUOTA FROM \$73,000 TO \$100,000, WITH \$60,000 RAISED IN ONE DAY; IN CINCINNATI, THE \$231,795 QUOTA HAS BEEN EXCEEDED BY \$44,105, AND A TOTAL OF CLOSE TO \$300,000 IS EXPECTED.

THE HADASSAH NATIONAL BOARD, ANNOUNCING A \$250,000 EMERGENCY CAMPAIGN TO TRANSFER JEWISH YOUTHS TO PALESTINE, DECIDED TO CALL FOR A "ONE-DISH DINNER" OF HADASSAH'S 75,000 MEMBERS ON DEC. 21, THE 78TH BIRTHDAY OF MISS HENRIETTA SZOLD, FOUNDER OF HADASSAH. THE ESTIMATED \$25,000 WHICH IS EXPECTED THUS TO BE RAISED WILL BE SENT TO MISS SZOLD IN JERUSALEM AS A "BIRTHDAY PRESENT" TO MAINTAIN AND REEDUCATE CHILDREN ARRIVING IN PALESTINE. THE BOARD ACTED AFTER HEARING A REPORT FROM MMS. DAVID DE SOLA POOL, VICE-PRESIDENT OF HADASSAH, WHO HAS JUST RETURNED FROM THE ZIONIST GENERAL COUNCIL SESSION IN LONDON. SHE STRESSED THAT IMMEDIATE SETTLEMENT POSSIBILITIES OFFERED BY PALESTINE MADE THE COUNTRY OF FIRST-RANK IMPORTANCE IN ANY SOLUTION OF THE REFUGEE PROBLEM.

THE GENERAL COUNCIL OF THE NORTHERN BAPTIST CONVENTION ADOPTED A RESOLUTION ASKING PRESIDENT ROOSEVELT TO TAKE THE LEAD IN CALLING AN INTERNATIONAL CONFERENCE TO DEAL WITH THE REFUGEE PROBLEM ON A LARGER SCALE. STUDENTS REPRESENTING SEVEN UP-STATE COLLEGES, AT A CONFERENCE IN SCHENECTADY, ADOPTED A RESOLUTION PLEDGING STUDENT SUPPORT FOR ANY PROJECT TO RELIEVE THE DISTRESS OF OPPRESSED GROUPS IN GERMANY.

MANY PROMINENT PERSONS HAVE ACCEPTED MEMBERSHIP IN AN ORGANIZATION NOW IN FORMATION TO DEFEND DEMOCRACY AND THE RIGHTS OF MINORITIES, IT WAS ANNOUNCED IN WASHINGTON BY MATTHEW WOLL, VICE-PRESIDENT OF THE AMERICAN FEDERATION OF LABOR. HE SAID THAT A DEFINITE ORGANIZATION AND PROGRAM OF WORK WOLLD BE ANNOUNCED WITHIN THE NEXT WEEK. MR. WOLLD BECAMED THE ORGANIZATION WOLLD BE A CHALLENGE TO THE DESTRUCTION OF FREEDOM IN GERMANY, WOLLD WORK WITH OTHER MAJOR ORGANIZATIONS IN THE FIELD AND WOULD SEEK MEMBERSHIP THROUGHOUT THE UNITED STATES.

PETITION ASKS BRITAIN TO OPEN PALESTINE

LONDON, DEC. 1. (JTA) -- A PETITION BEARING 100,000 SIGNATURES AND DEMANDING IMMEDIATE STEPS TO ESTABLISH A HAVEN FOR GERMAN JEWISH REFUGEES IN PALESTINE WAS PRESENTED TO THE GOVERNMENT TODAY. THE PETITION WAS SIGNED BY PEOPLE OF ALL CREEDS AND IN ALL WALKS OF LIFE.

THE COUNCIL FOR GERMAN JEWRY PUBLISHED A LIST OF 46 INDIVIDUAL CONTRIBUTIONS OF MORE THAN \$5,000. READING THE LIST WERE DONATIONS OF \$250,000 EACH BY THE FAMILIES OF LORD SAMUEL, ISRAEM M. SIEFF AND LORD ROTHSCHILD. THE CONTRIBUTIONS TOTALLED MORE THAN \$1,200,000.

SELECTED ENTRY TO CANADA URGED

OTTAWA, DEC. I. (JTA) -- A RESOLUTION URGING THAT A LIMITED NUMBER OF CAREFULLY SELECTED GERMAN-JEWISH STUDENTS BE INVITED TO CONTINUE THEIR STUDIES AT MOUNT ALLISON UNIVERSITY WAS ADOPTED TODAY BY A STUDENT MASS MEETING AT SACKVILLE, N.B. THE RESOLUTION, WHICH HAS THE APPROVAL OF THE UNIVERSITY PRESIDENT, ALSO REQUESTS RELAXATION OF THE LAWS TO PERMIT CONTROLLED ENTRY OF REFUGESS.

TOKYO PAPERS ASK BARRING OF REFUGEES

TOKYO, Dec. I. (JTA) -- NATIONALIST NEWSPAPERS TODAY URGED THE GOVER MENT TO BAR ADMISSION OF GERMAN-JEWISH REFUGEES TO EAST ASIA. THE KOKUMIN SHIMBUN ATTRIBUTED THE NEW SOVIET-POLISH AGREEMENT TO THE MANEUVERS OF COMMUNISTIC JEWS" AND DECLARED THERE WAS DANGER IN THE EASTWARD MIGRATION OF JEWS TO FOREIGN CONCESSIONAL AREAS IN CHINA.

FRENCH JEWS PLEDGE RELIEF AID

PARIS, Dec. I. (JTA) -- Denouncing the Nazi pogroms as "shameful acts that will reMain branded on the shoulders of the criminals responsible," the Consistoire Israelite,
Central representative body of French Jewry, resolved today to do everything in its power to
Ensure the most satisfactory possible relief action. The resolution expressed "pain and
Indignation" at the persecutions which, it stated, had occurred under orders of the present
HEADS of the Reich. The organization met for the first time since the pogroms.

12 NAZIS IMPRISONED FOR 'PROFITING' FROM POGROM

BERLIN, DEC. 1. (HAVAS) -- TWELVE NAZIS WILL SPEND SIX MONTHS IN A CONCENTRATION CAMP "FOR HAVING PROFITED FROM THE RECENT ANTI-JEWISH DEMONSTRATIONS TO ENRICH THEMSELVES PERSON-ALLY," AND JOSEPH BUERCKEL, NAZI PARTY LEADER FOR AUSTRIA, HAS ORDERED THAT THEY BE EXCLUDED FROM THE PARTY WHEN RELEASED.

THIS WAS DISCLOSED TODAY BY VIENNA NEWSPAPERS, WHICH PRAISED "THE SPEEDY DECISION" OF THE PARTY LEADER AS INDICATING THE HIGH MORAL ATTITUDE DEMANDED OF PARTY MEMBERS. SINCE NEWSPAPERS IN OTHER PARTS OF GERMANY DID NOT PRINT THIS REPORT, IT WAS INTERPRETED AS VIENNA'S REPLY TO REPORTS RECENTLY PRINTED ABROAD THAT A PARTY PURGE RECENTLY OCCUPED THERE.

IN FRANKFURT-AM-MAIN WORKMEN TODAY WERE COMPLETING THE DESTRUCTION OF THREE SYNAGOGUES BURNED THERE DURING THE POGROM.

MACDONALD TO ANNOUNCE DATE SOON FOR PALESTINE PARLEYS

LONDON, DEC. I. (JTA) -- BEFORE PARLIAMENT ADJOURNS FOR THE CHRISTMAS RECESS, COLONIAL SECRETARY MALCOLM MACDONALD WILL ANNOUNCE A DATE, PROBABLY THE SECOND WEEK IN JANUARY, FOR THE CONFERENCES ON PALESTINE, IT WAS LEARNED TODIGHT BY THE HAVAS NEWS AGENCY. NEARLY ALL THE ARAB GOVERNMENTS INVITED TO THE CONFERENCE HAVE ALREADY SENT THEIR ACCEPTANCES, WITH THE PROVISO THAT THE HOLY LAND'S ARABS SHOULD HAVE ADEQUATE REPRESENTATION. THE JEWISH AGENCY FOR PALESTINE, IT WAS LEARNED TODAY, HAS APPROACHED THE AGUDATH ISRAEL, NON-ZIONIST RELIGIOUS ORGANIZATION, ON THE QUESTION OF PARTICIPATION IN THE FORTHCOMING PALESTINE CONFERENCES HERE.

CAIRO, DEC. 1. (JTA) -- THE EGYPTIAN GOVERNMENT TODAY FORMALLY ACCEPTED THE BRITISH GOVERNMENT'S INVITATION TO ATTEND THE BRITISH-ARAS-JEWISH CONFERENCES IN LONDON ON THE POLITICAL FUTURE OF PALESTINE. THE EGYPTIAN DELEGATION HAS NOT YET BEEN SELECTED.

JERUSALEM, DEC. 1. (JTA) -- SEVEN ARABS WERE KILLED AND FOUR WERE CAPTURED TODAY IN A CLASH BETWEEN A REDEL BAND AND BRITISH TROOPS IN THE VICINITY OF HEBRON.

RIGHTIST GROUP DEMANDS NEW CURBS ON JEWS IN HUNGARY

BUDAPEST, Dec. 1. (JTA) -- THE BAROSS FEDERATION -- A GROUP OF HUNGARIAN MERCHANTS AND INDUSTRIAL ISTS OF EXTREME RIGHTIST TENDENCIES -- TODAY PETITIONED THE GOVERNMENT TO BAN JEWISH CONCERNS FROM RECEIVING STATE ORDERS. THE ORGANIZATION ALSO REQUESTED THAT JEWS BE BANNED FROM THE EXPORTING AND IMPORTING BUSINESS AND THAT BIG JEWISH CORPORATIONS BE DISSOLVED AND REORGANIZED INTO SMALL PRIVATE ESTABLISHMENTS. THE FEDERATION'S REQUEST COINCIDED WITH AN APPEAL FROM THE HUNGARIAN LANDOWNER'S ASSOCIATION FOR SEVERE MEASURES AGAINST COMBINES REPRESENTING JEWISH INTERESTS.

COUGHLIN CHARGES JEWS DO NOT AID PROTESTS ON PERSECUTION OF CHRISTIANS

NEW YORK, Dec. I. (JTA) -- Father Charles E. Coughlin, whose charges of Jewish influence in the Russian revolution have aroused widespread controversy, today defended his assertions and accused the American Jews of not cooperating in protesting persecution of Christians abroad although Christians were protesting oppression of Jews in Germany, in a statement dictated to the New York Post by telephone from Royal Oak, Mich. Heywood Broun, in his syndicated columpublished in the World-Telegram here, criticized newspapers for publishing Father Coughlin's charges regarding the Jews before verifying them.

JEWISH LEADERS, ARRIVING FROM LONDON, URGE CAUTION ON COLONIZATION PROJECTS

NEW YORK, Dec. 1. (JTA) -- WARNINGS THAT CAUTION IS NECESSARY ON LARGE-SCALE JEWISH COLONIZATION PROJECTS NOW BEING AIRED WERE GIVEN TODAY BY DR. SOLOMON GOLDMAN, PRESIDENT OF THE ZIONIST ORGANIZATION OF AMERICA; LOUIS LIPSKY, VICE-PRESIDENT OF THE Z.O.A., AND DR. NAHUM GOLDMANN, CHAIRMAN OF THE ADMINISTRATIVE COMMITTEE OF THE WORLD JEWISH CONGRESS, ALL OF WHOM ARRIVED ON THE QUEEN MARY.

DR. SOLOMON GOLDMAN AND MR. LIPSKY, IN A STATEMENT, PROPOSED THAT THE INTERGOVERNMENTAL REFUGEE COMMITTEE ESTABLISH A COMMITTEE OF EXPERTS TO ACT AS A CLEARING HOUSE ON COLONIZATION PROJECTS AND THAT PUBLIC DISCUSSION OF THEM BE AVOIDED UNTIL THIS COMMITTEE WOULD HAVE ACTED ON THEIR SUITABILITY.

DR. NAHUM GOLDMANN DECLARED THAT THE COLONIZATION PROJECTS WERE ACTUALLY HAVING A HARM-FUL EFFECT IN THAT EUROPEAN COUNTRIES WHICH OTHERWISE MIGHT HAVE ACCEPTED THOUSANDS OF REFUG-EES, AT LEAST FOR TEMPORARY STAY, WERE NOW RELUCTANT TO ACCEPT REFUGEES, BELIEVING THAT THESE COLONIZATION PROJECTS WOULD ABSORB THEM.
